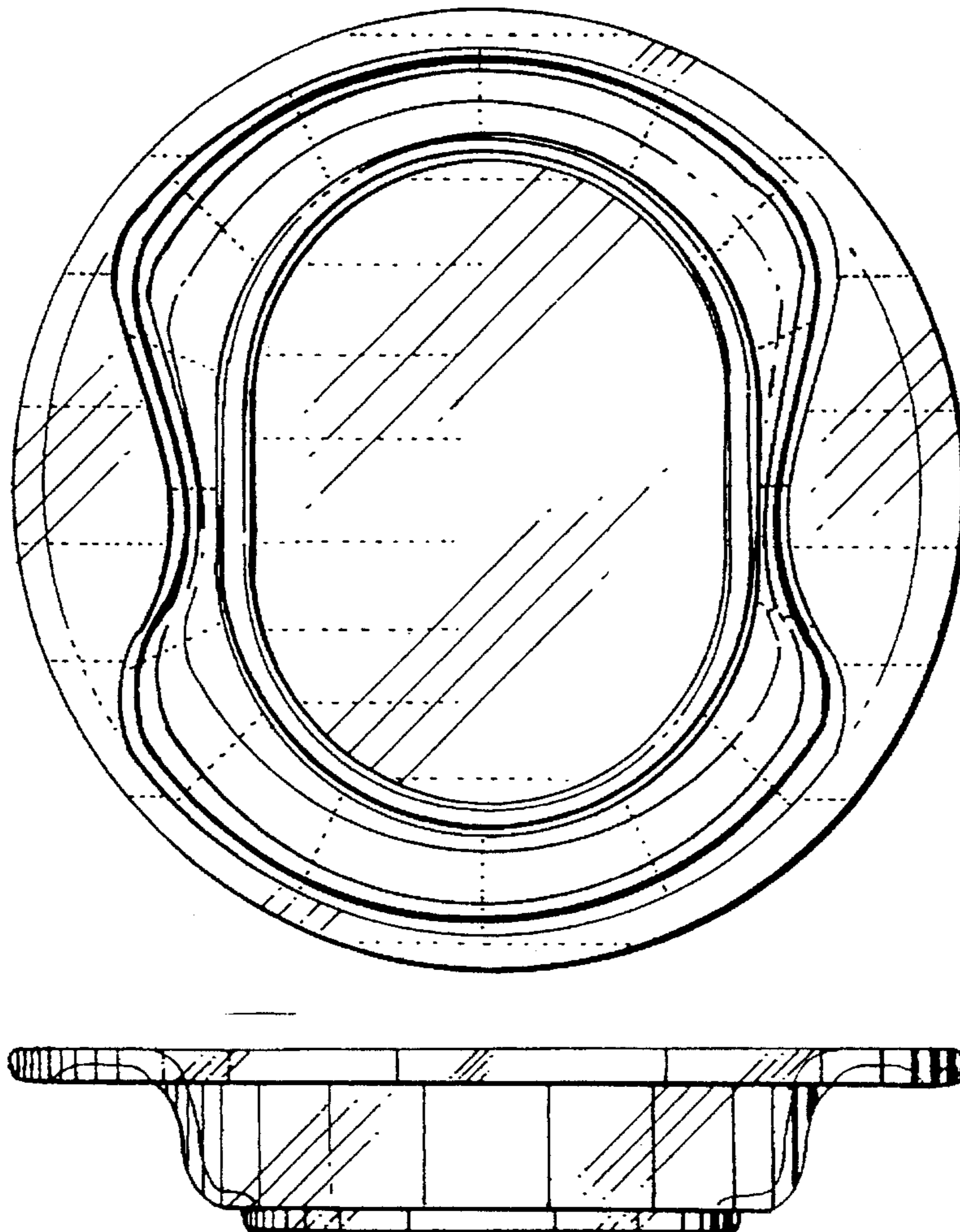
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a dinner plate showing my new design;

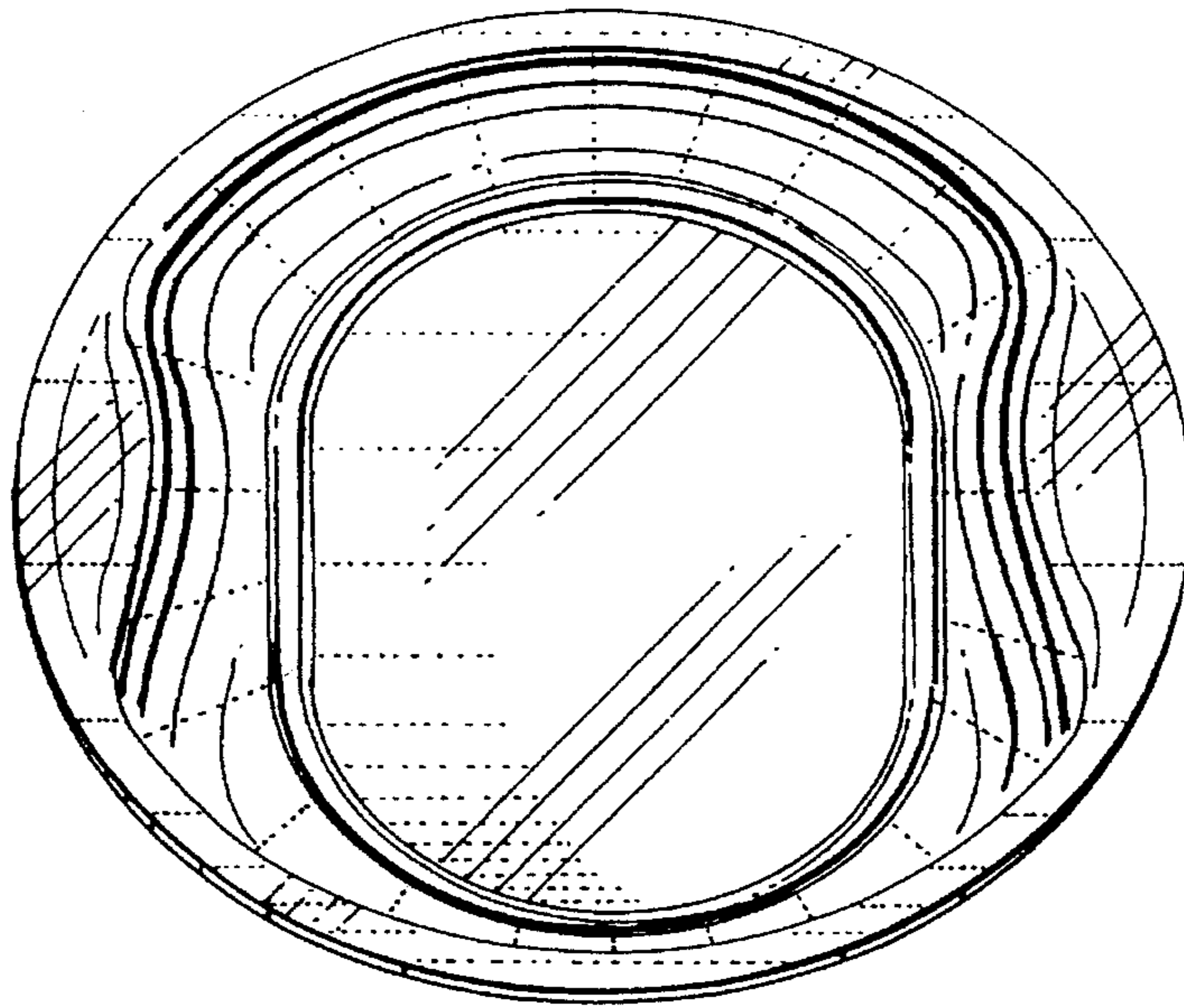

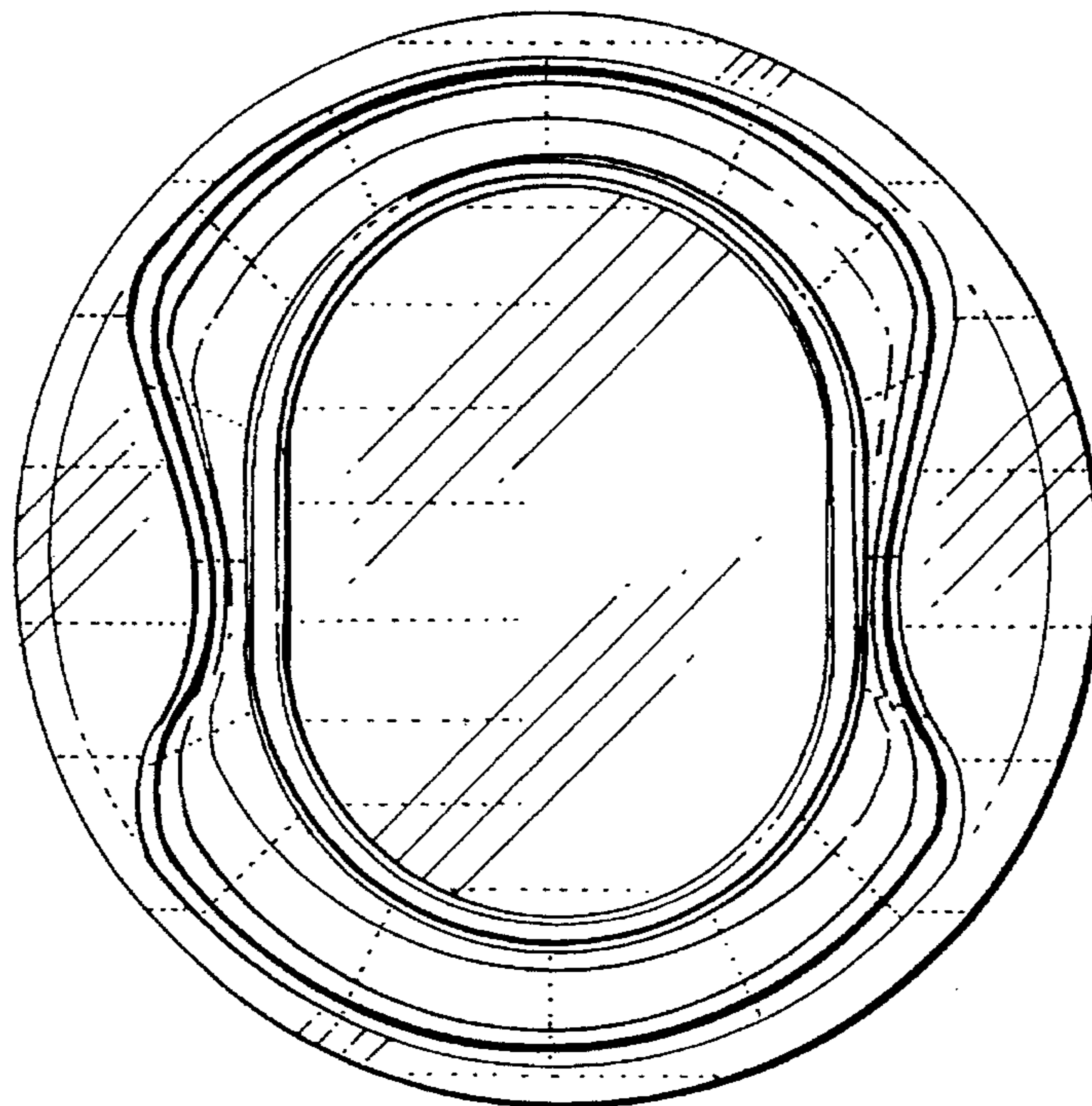

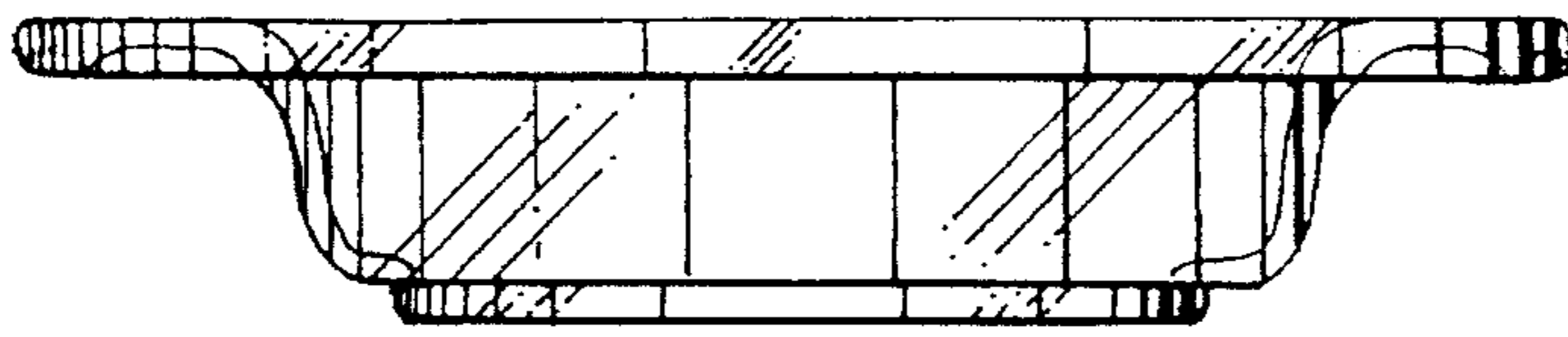

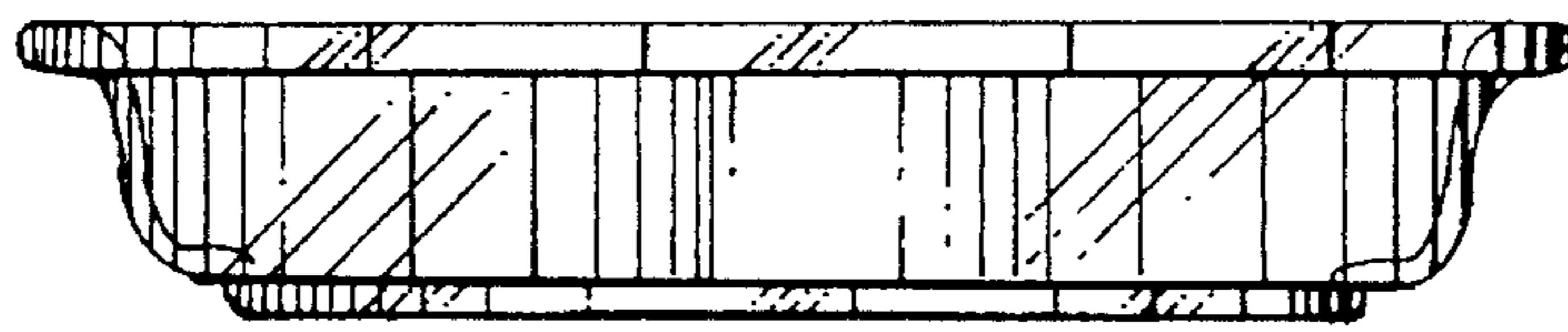

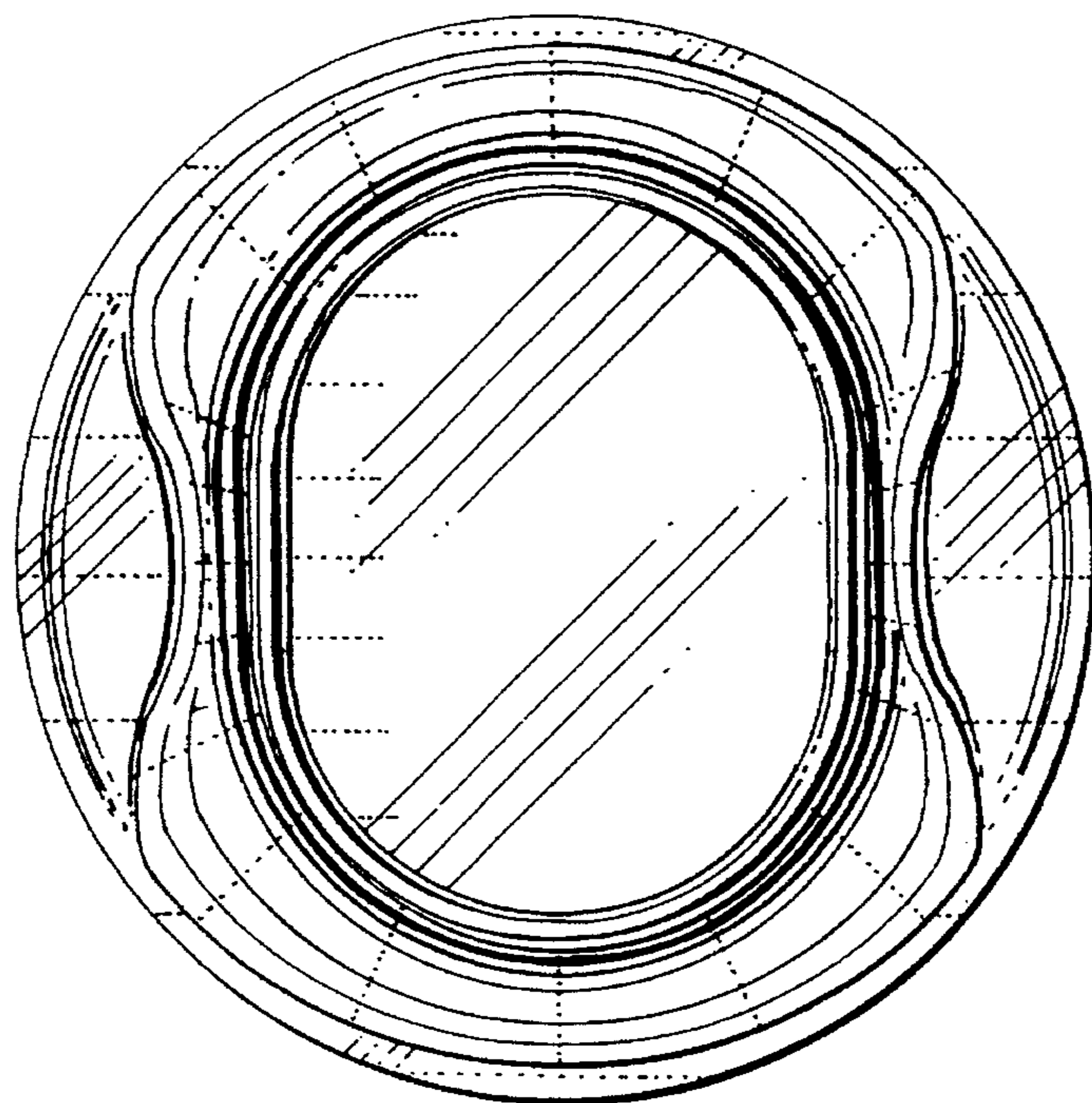
