FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, with the dashed line representing the profile rear elevational plane which does not form a part of the claimed design;

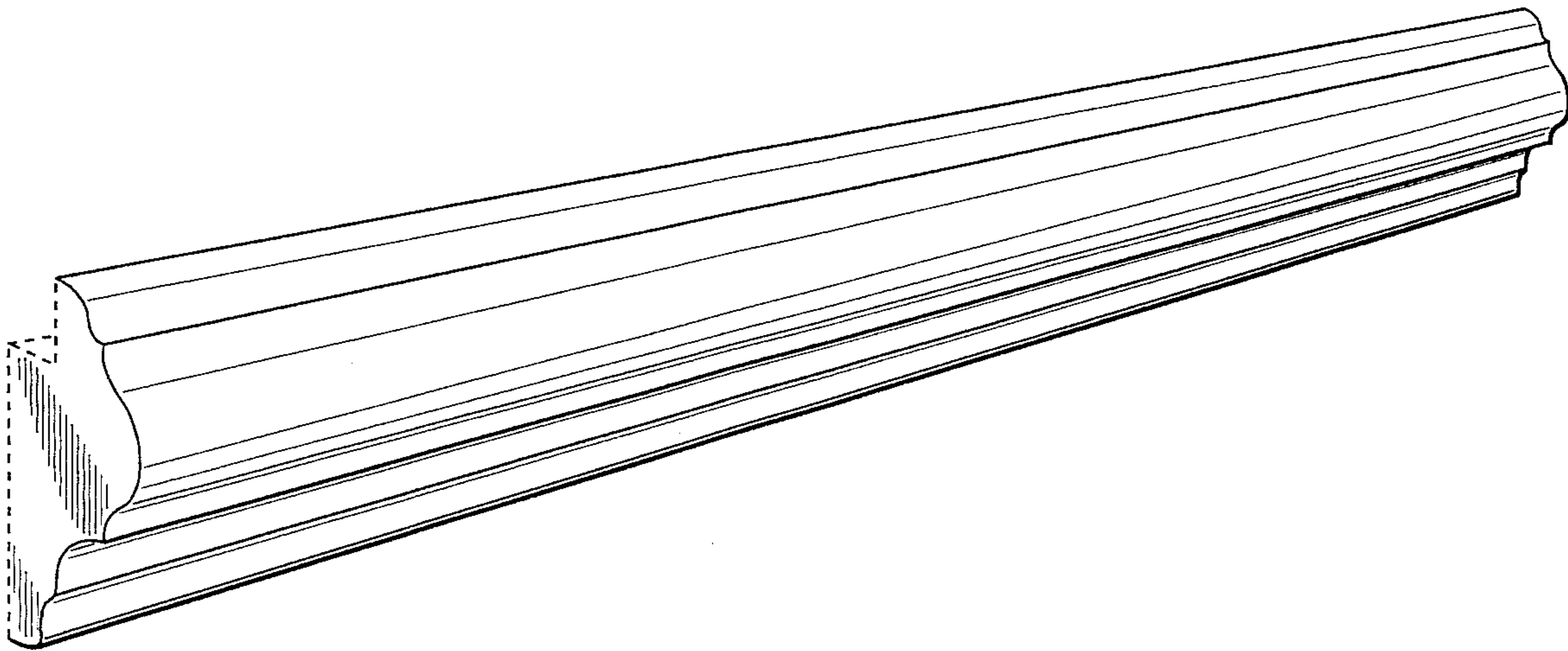
FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view thereof;

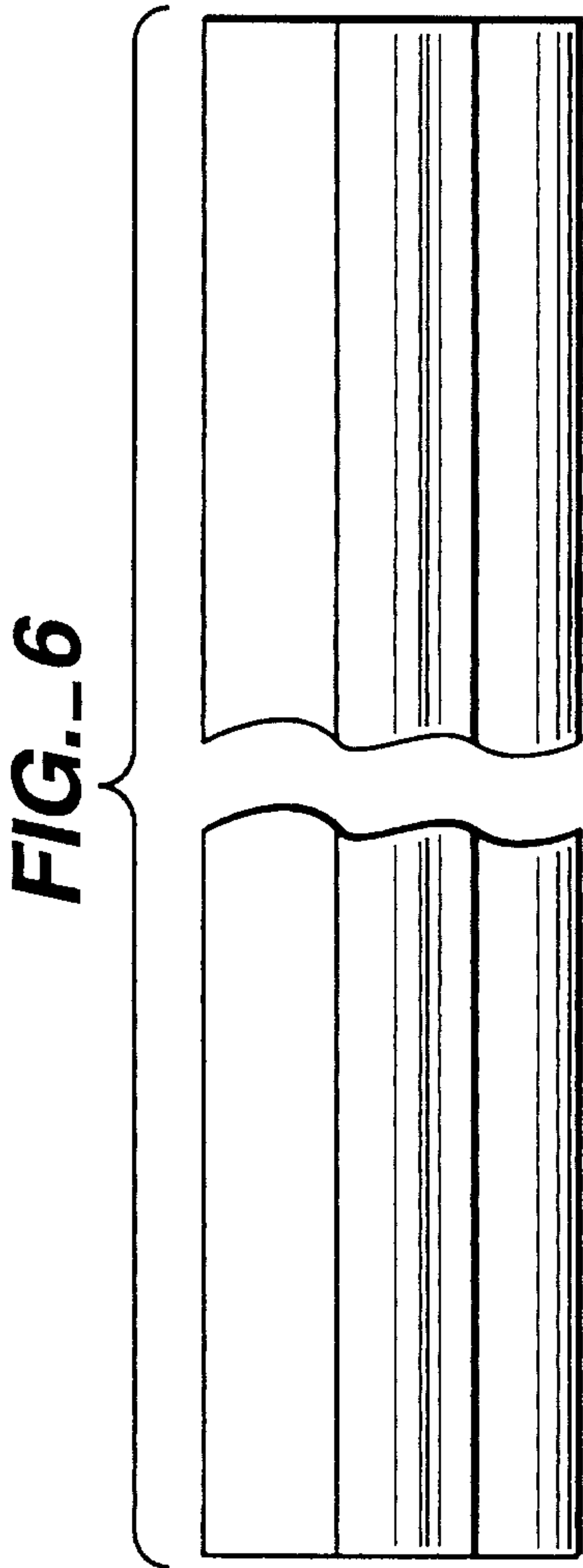
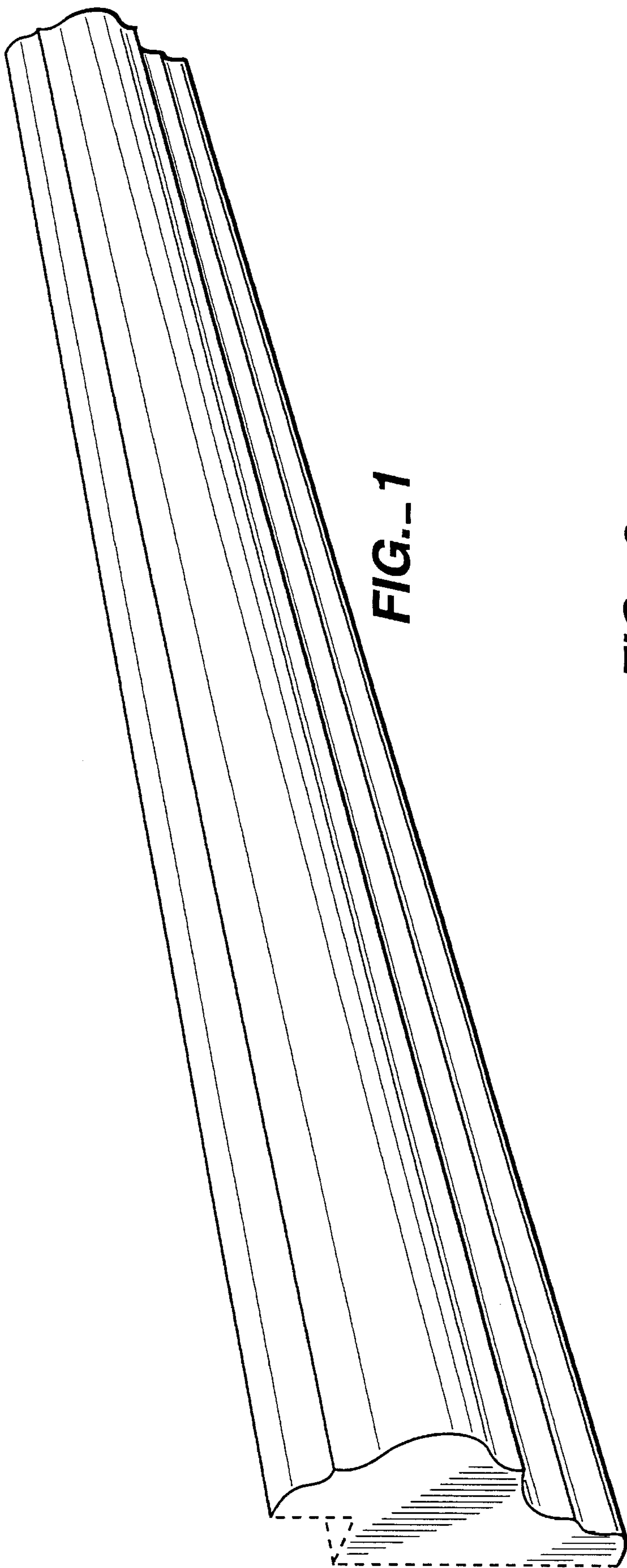
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

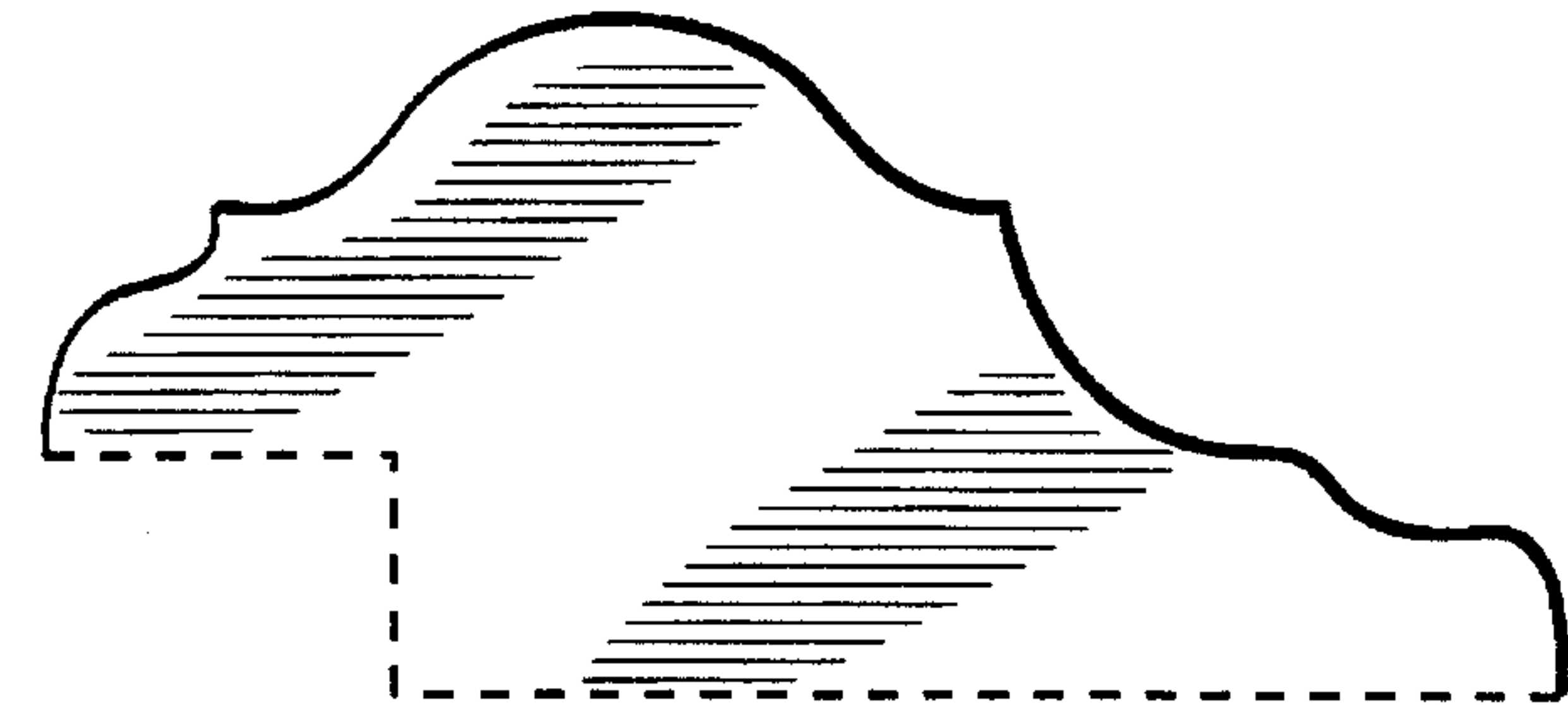

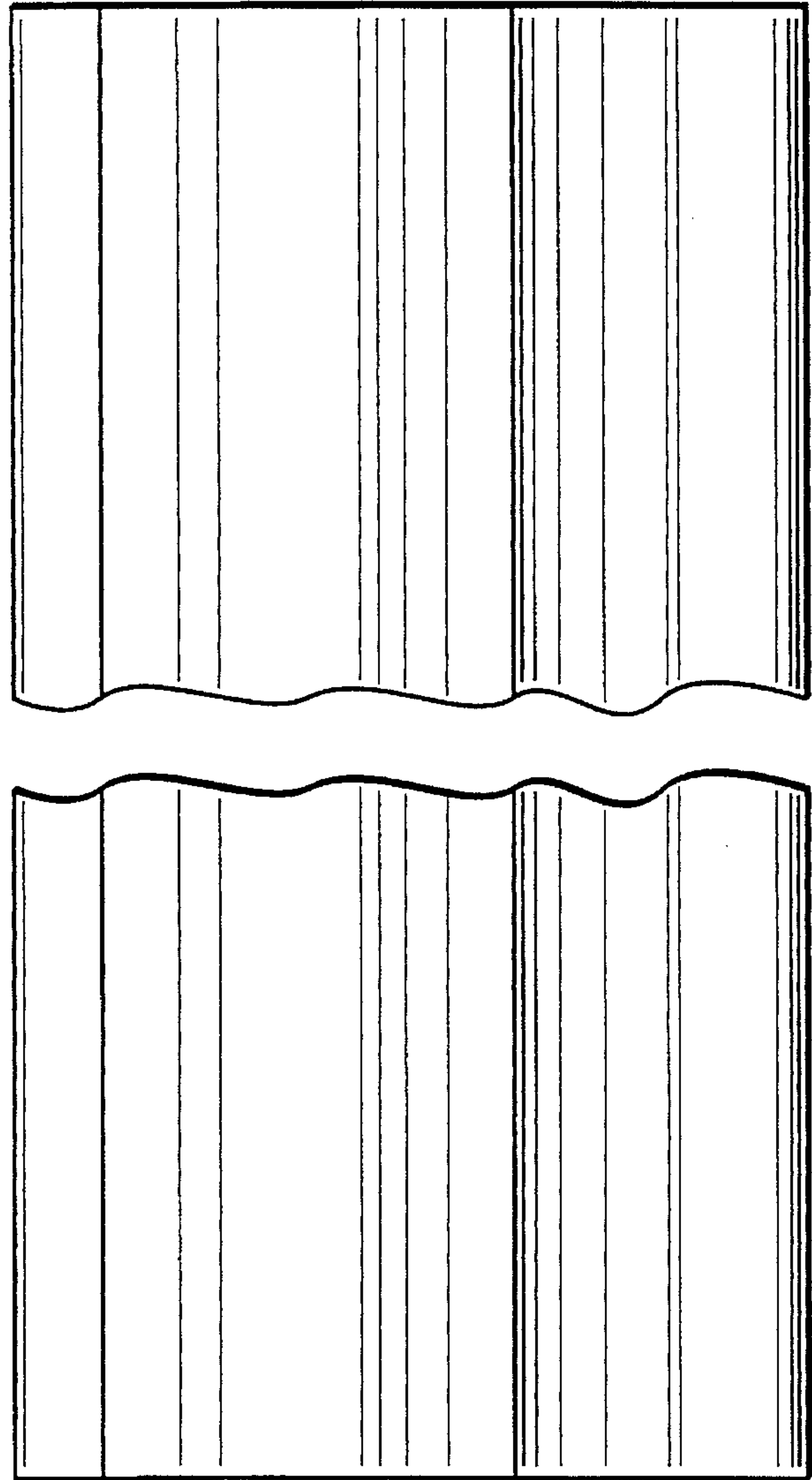

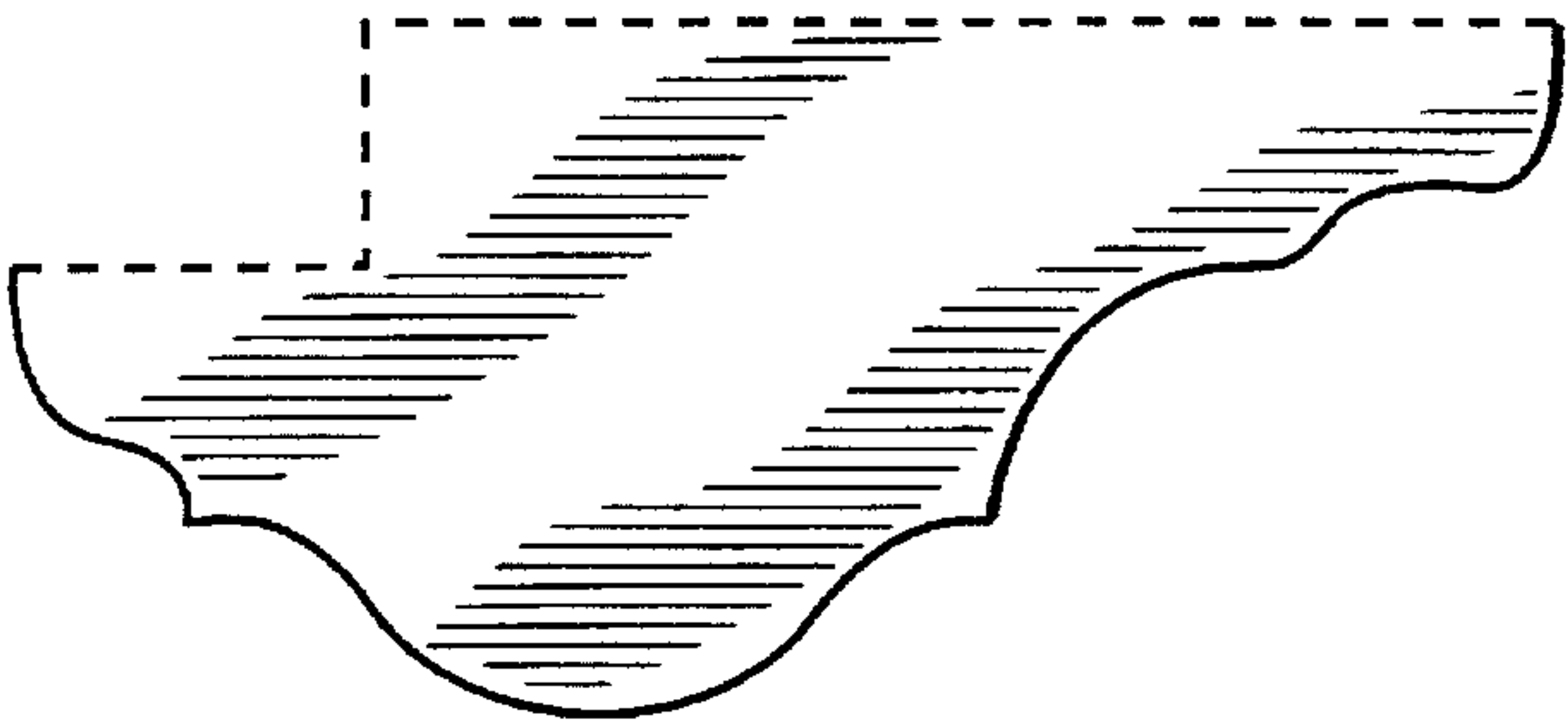

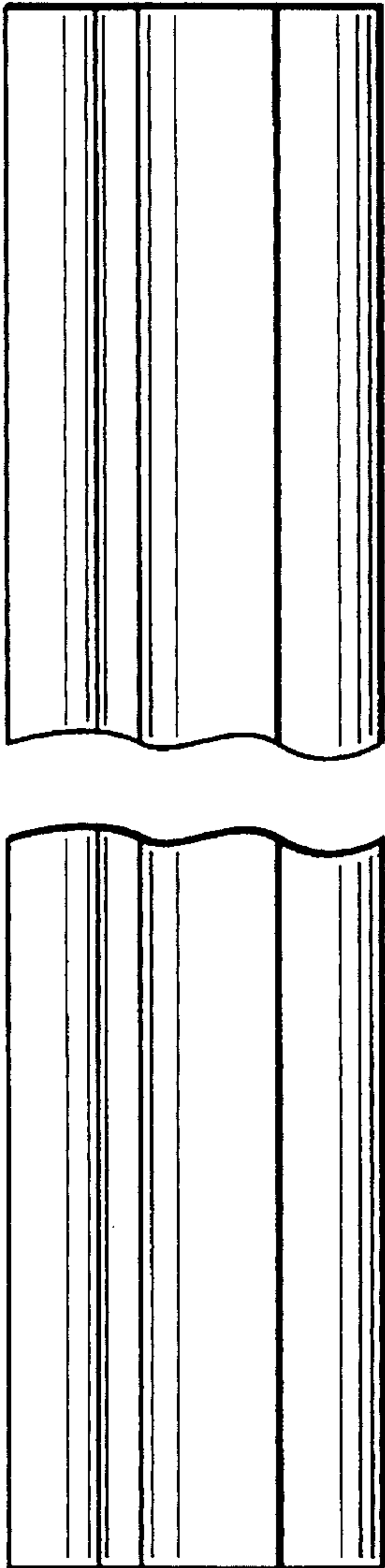
