The ornamental design for a shoe upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a first embodiment of a shoe upper according to my design;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a second embodiment of a shoe upper according to my design;

FIG. 7 is a top view of the second embodiment;

FIG. 8 is a right side view of the second embodiment;

FIG. 9 is a front view of the second embodiment; and,

FIG. 10 is a rear view of the second embodiment.

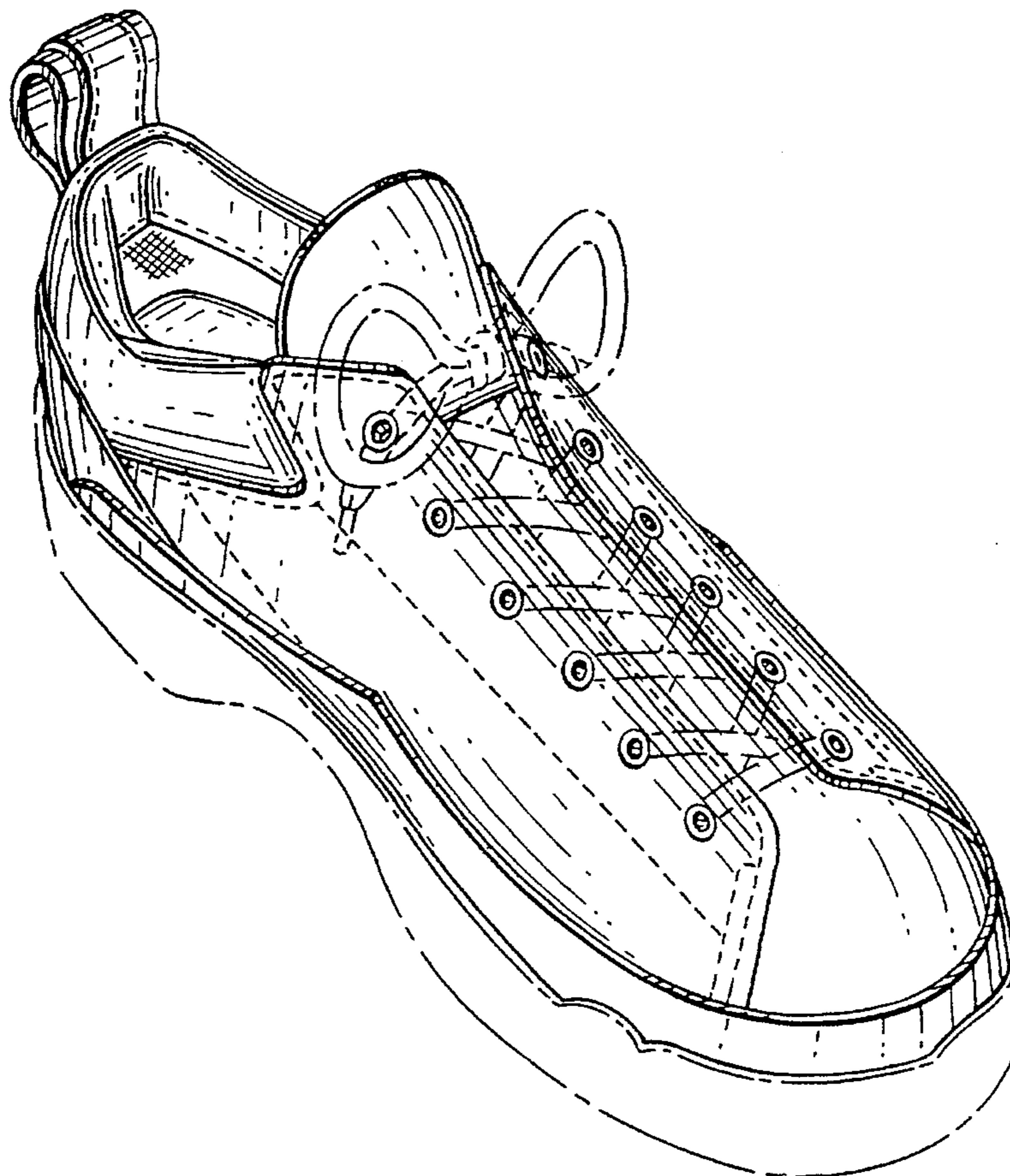

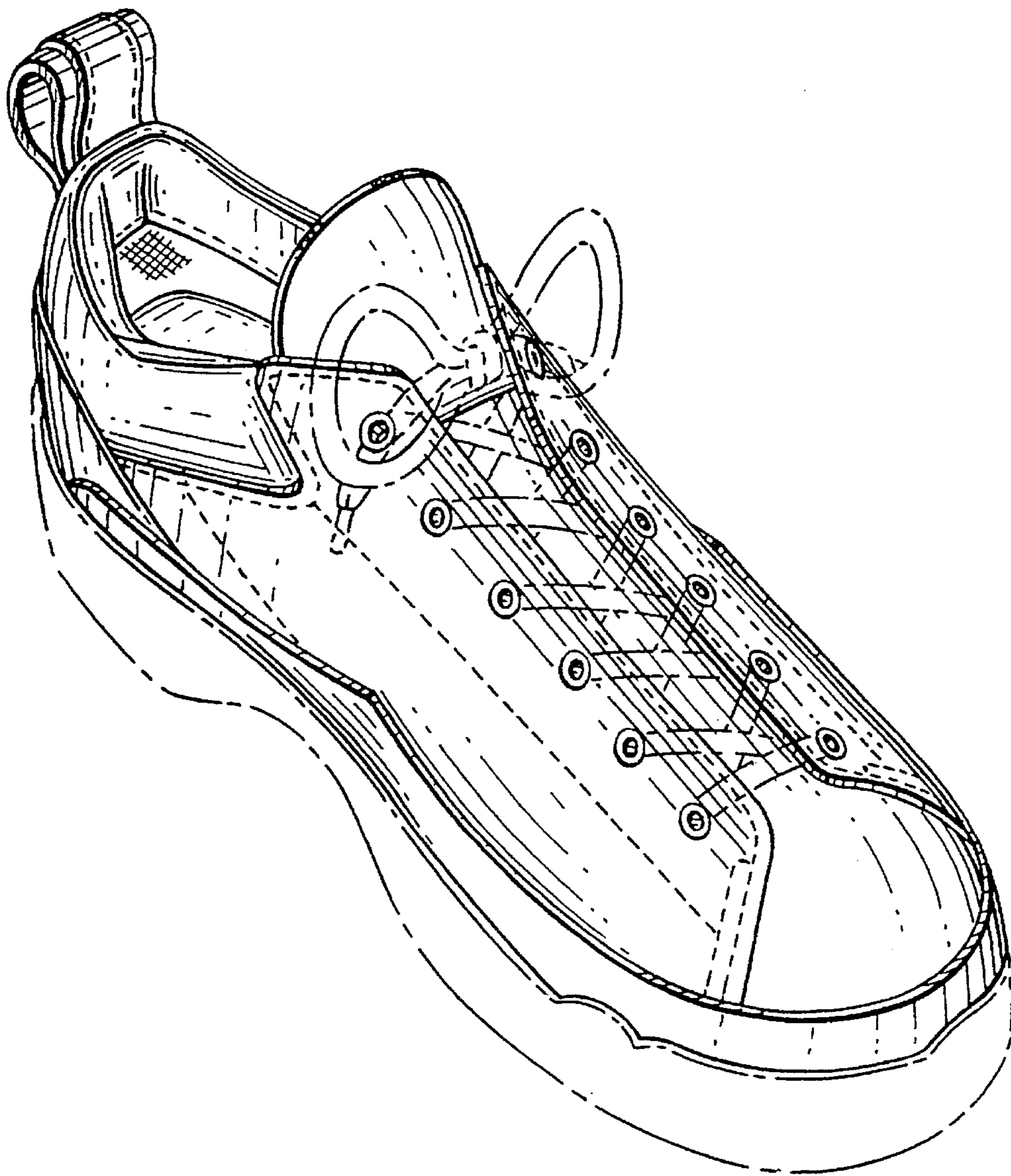

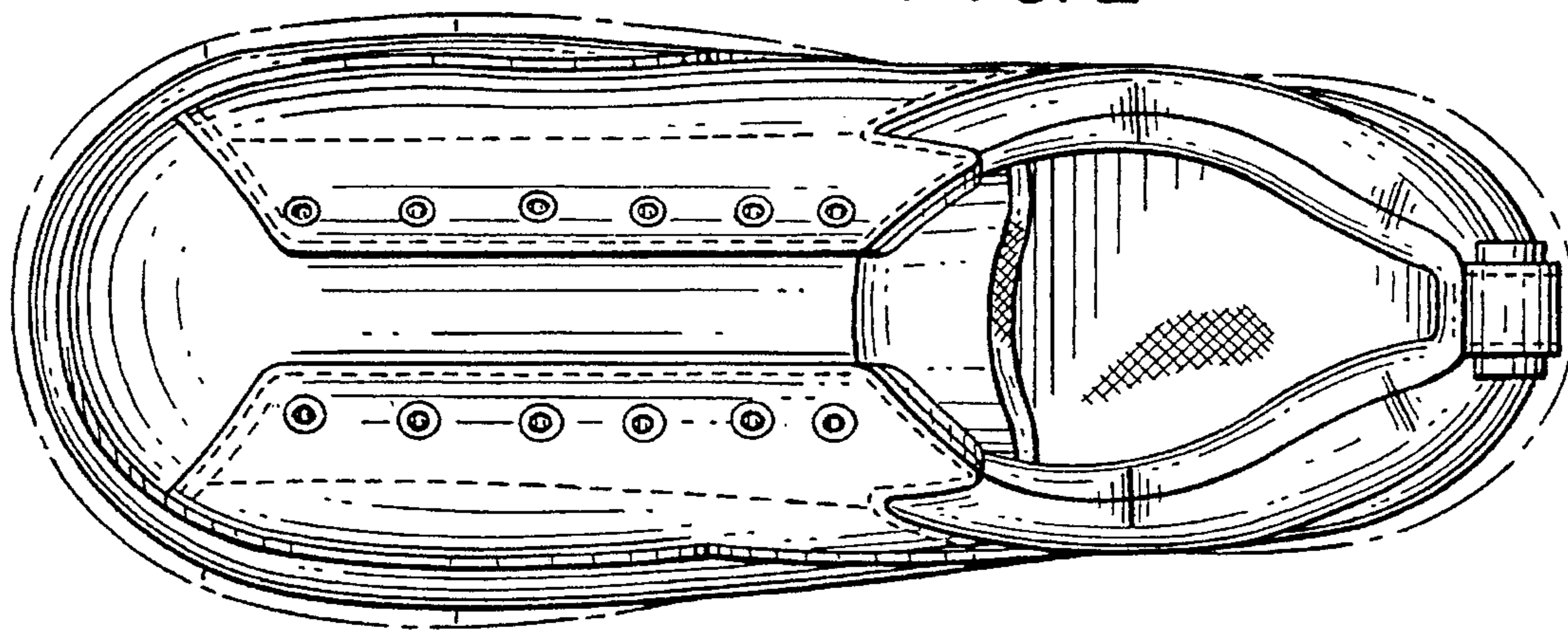

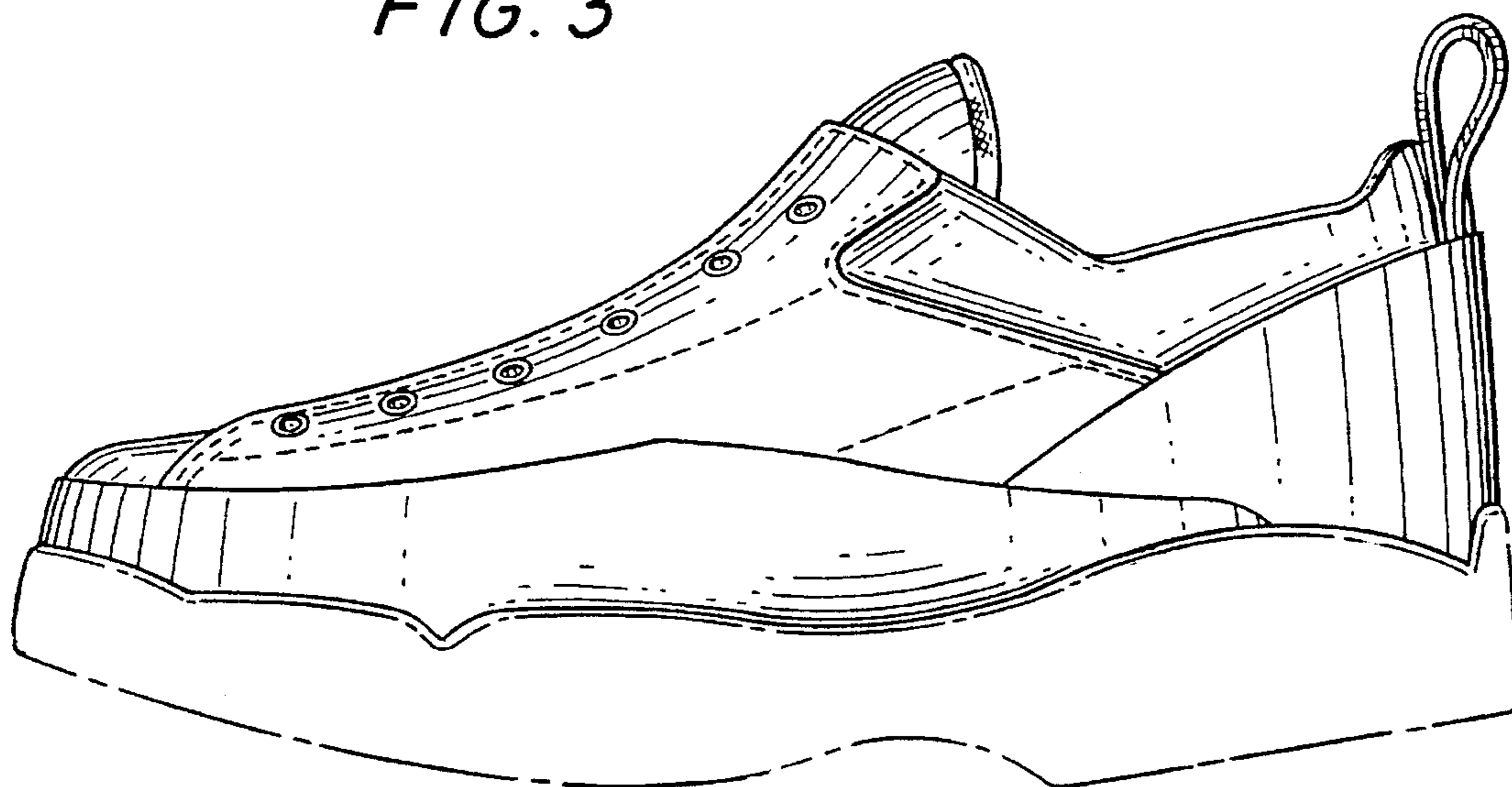

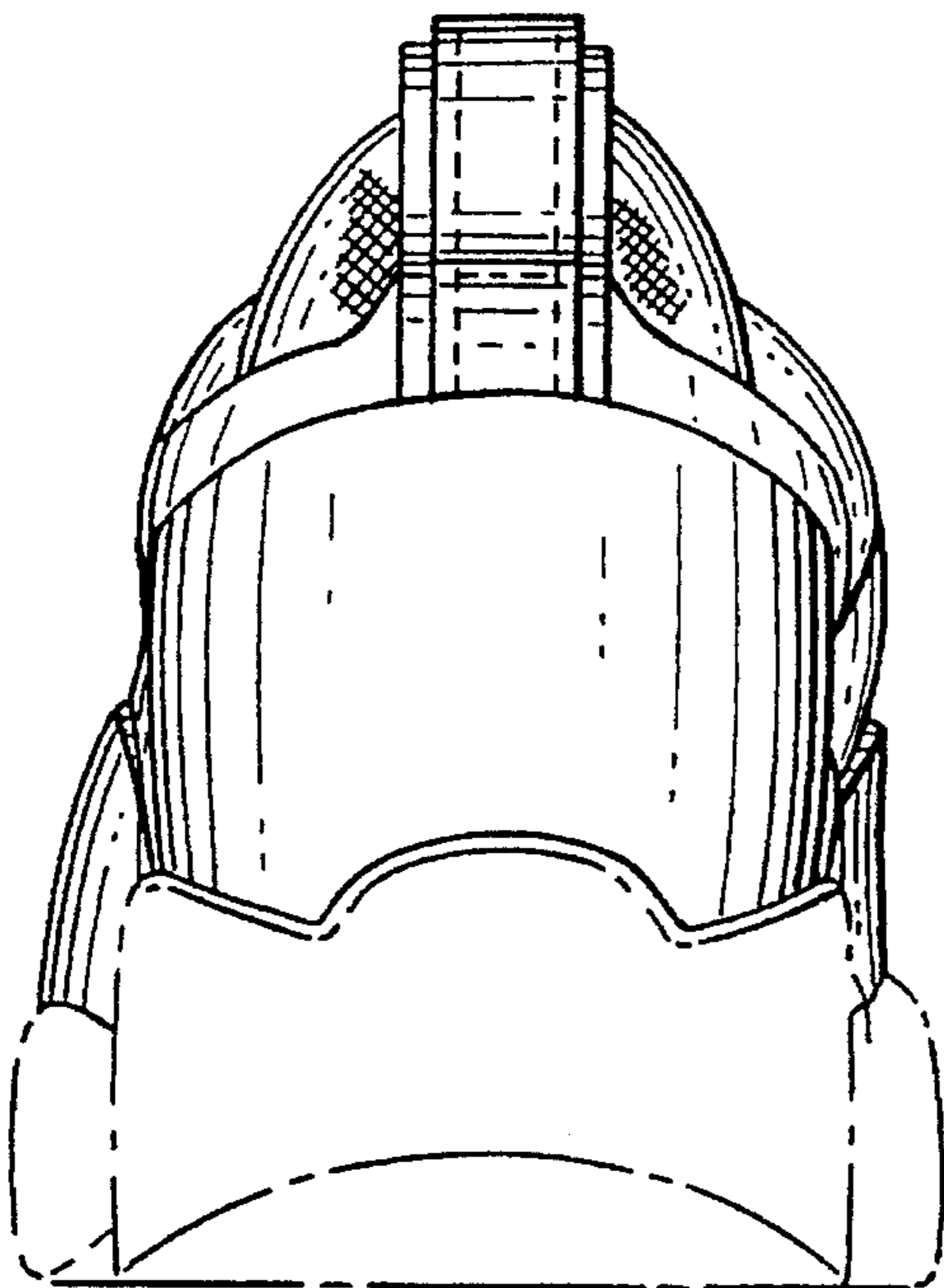
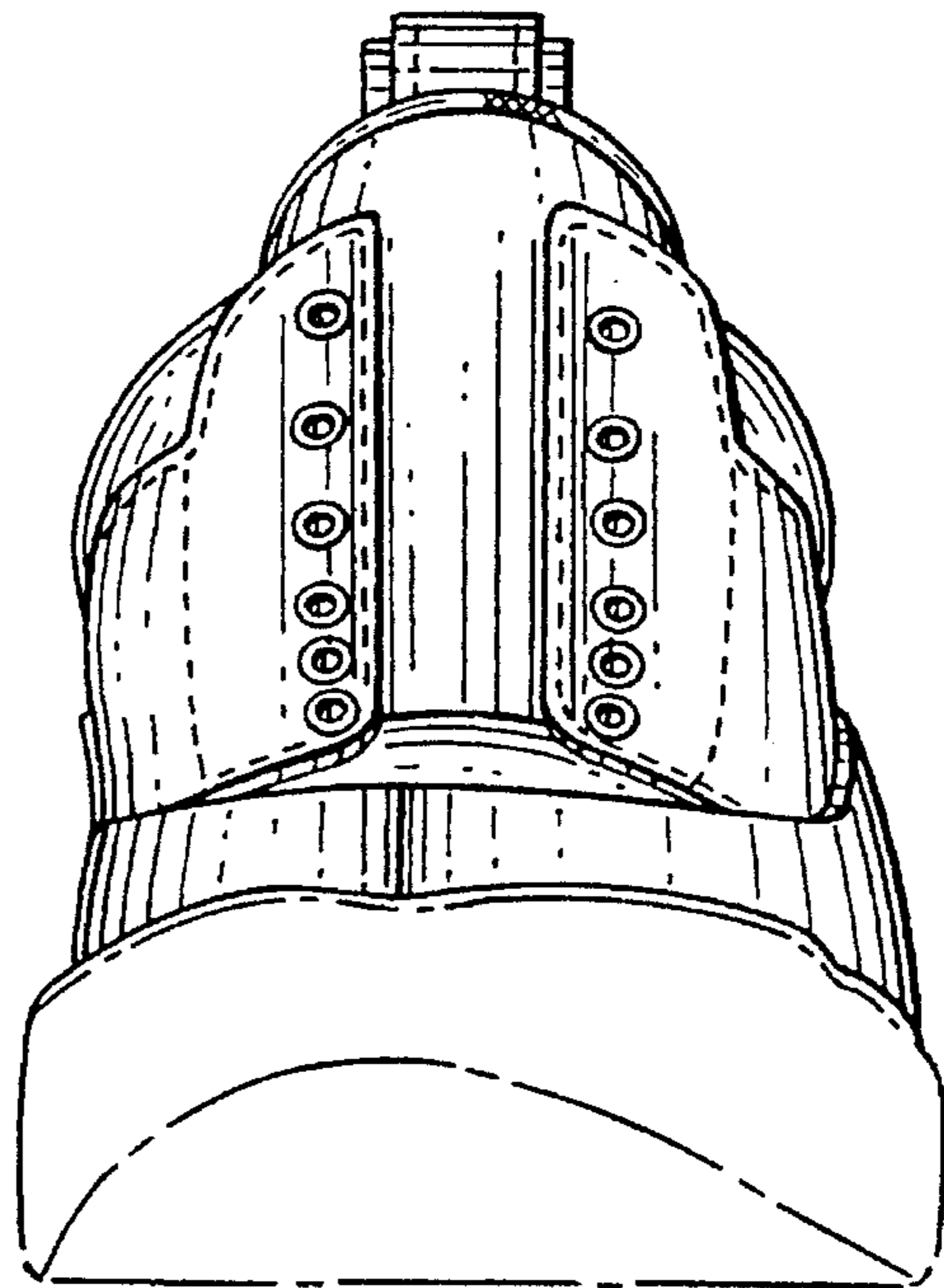

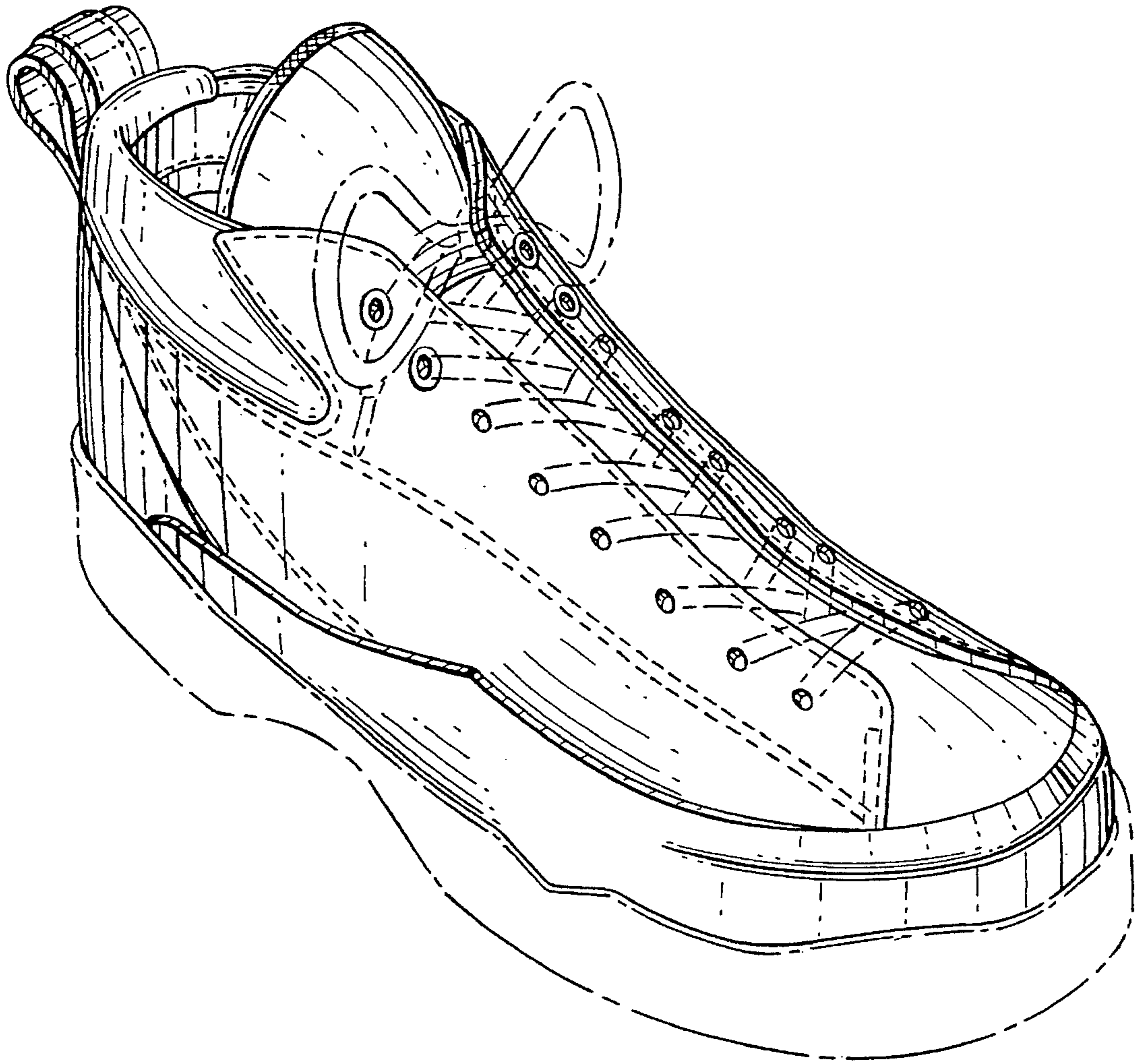

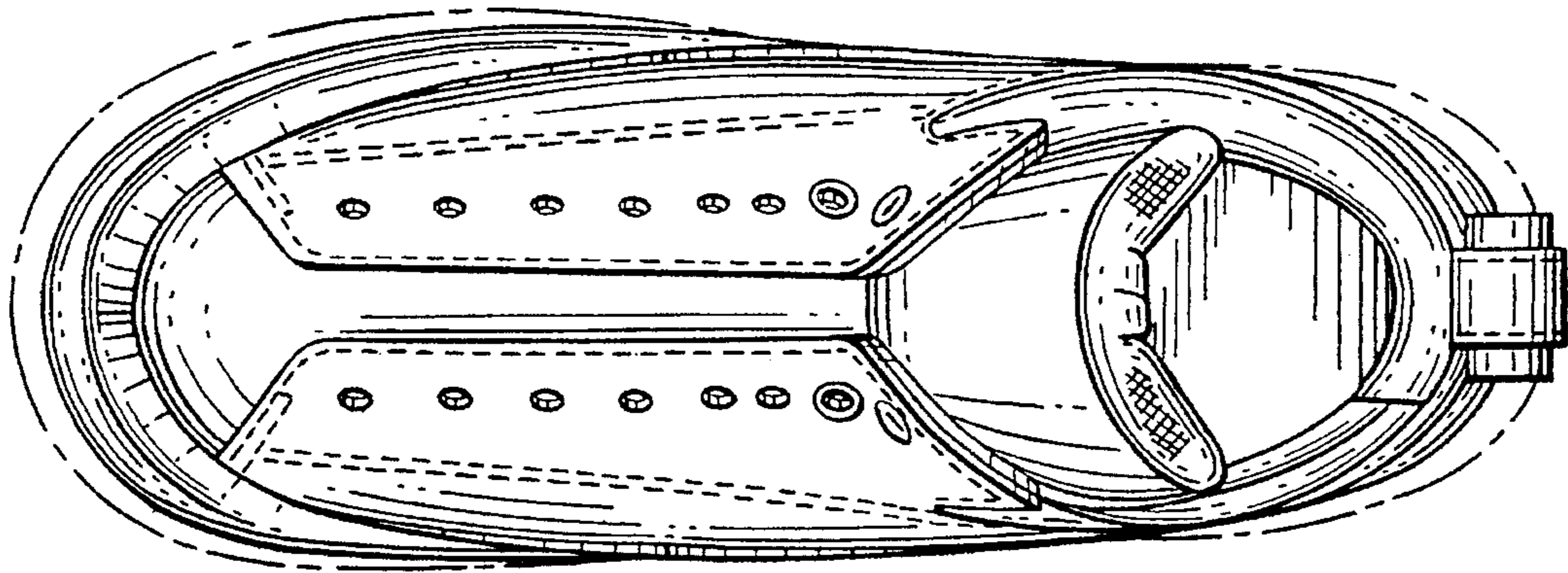

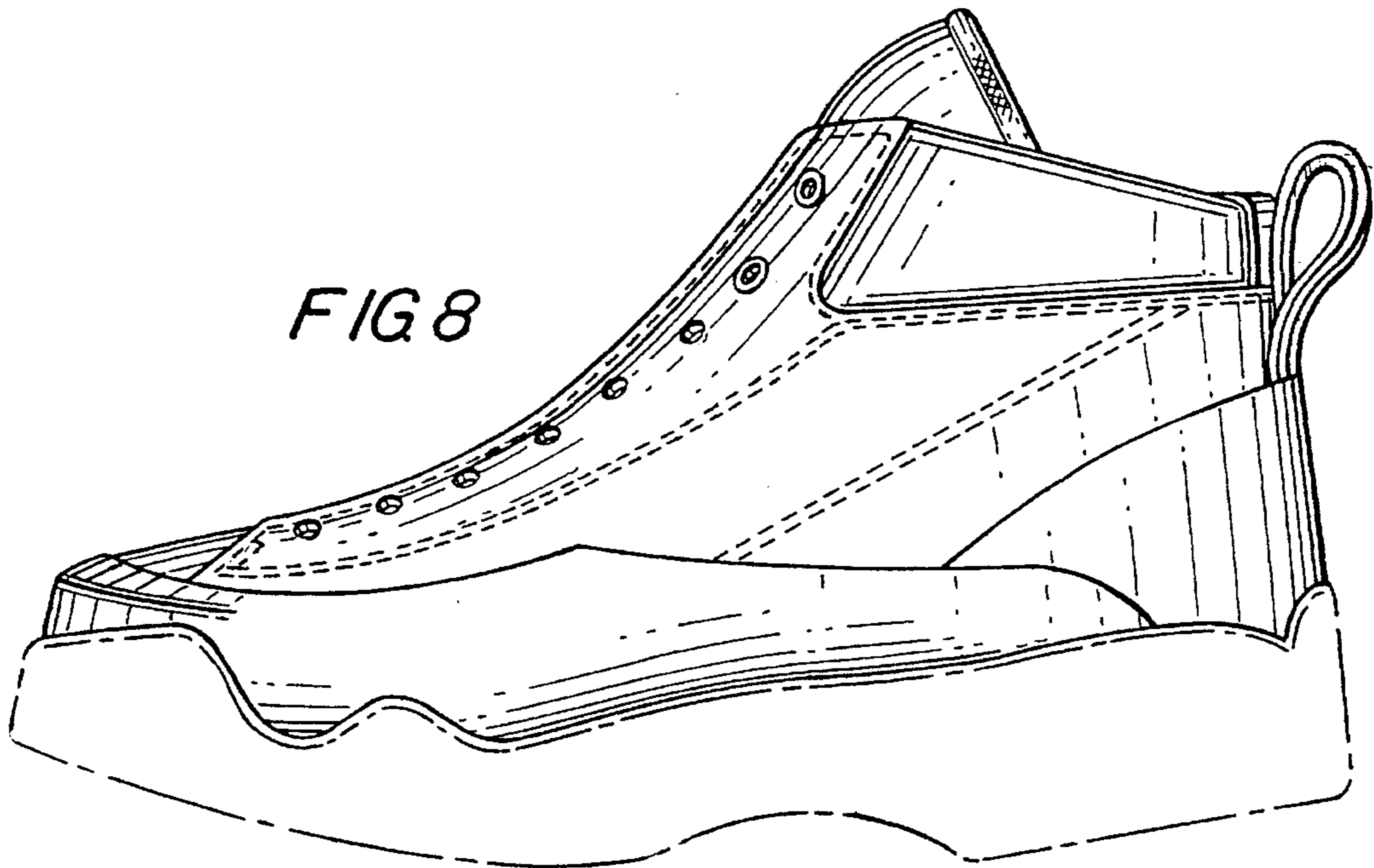

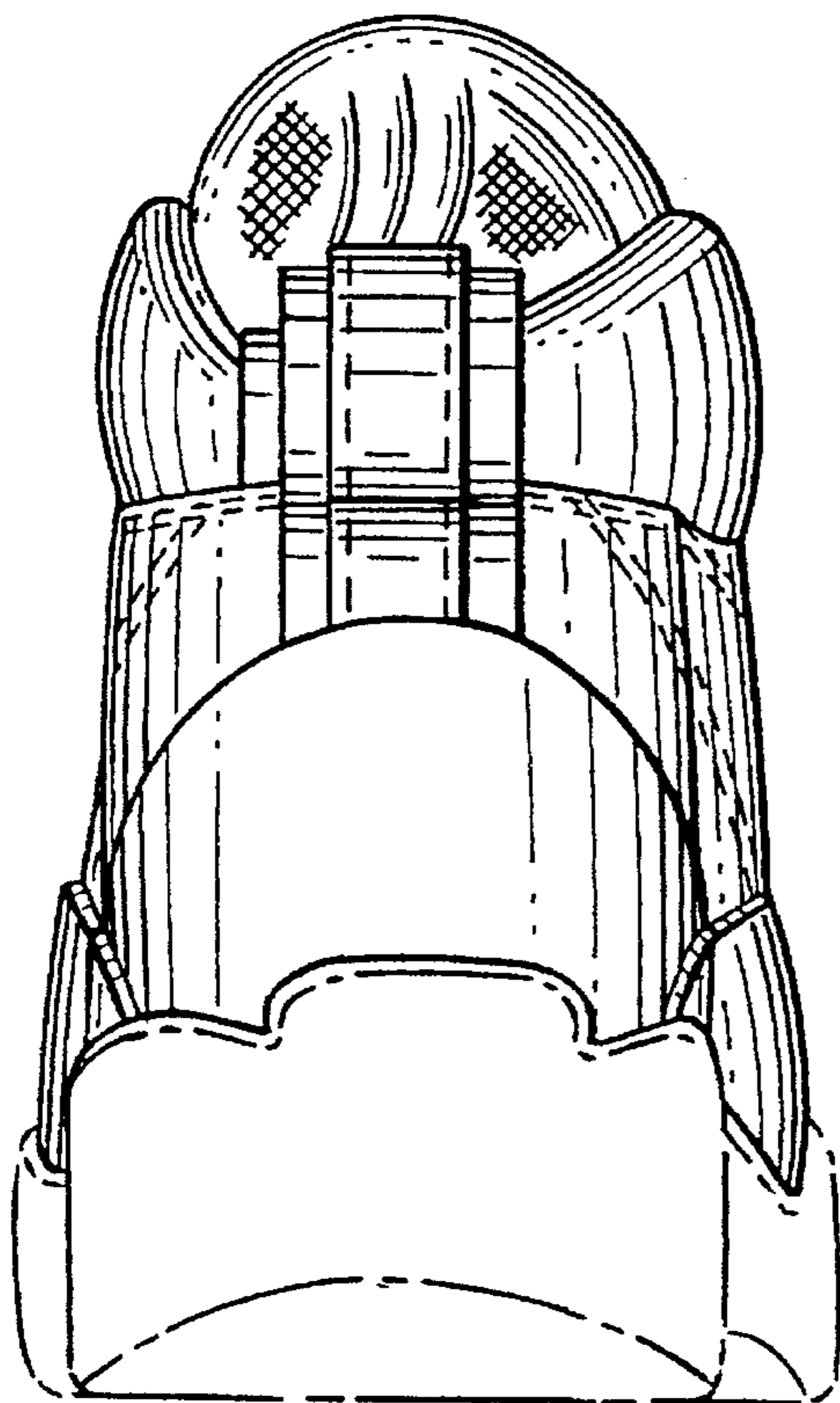
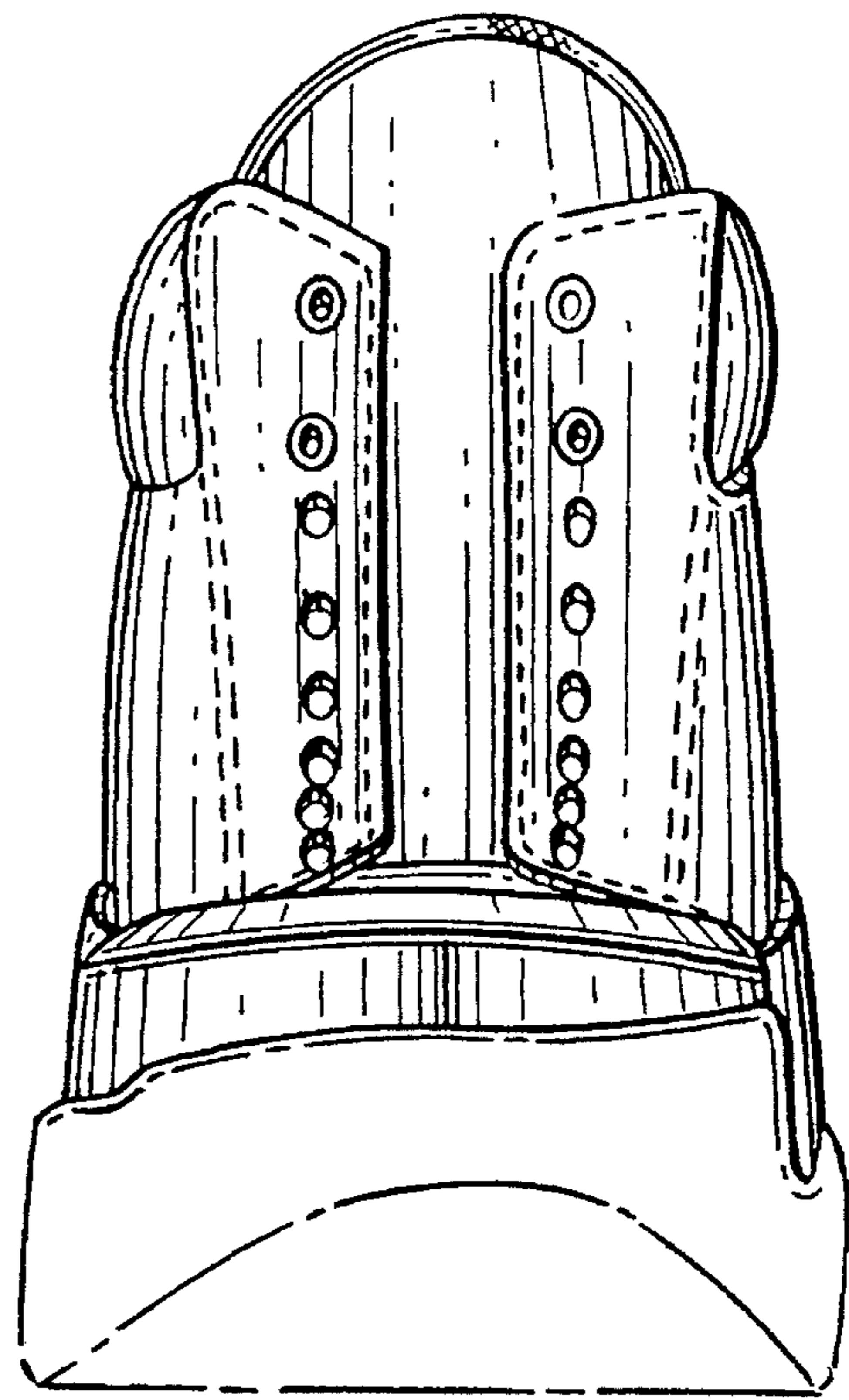
