design;

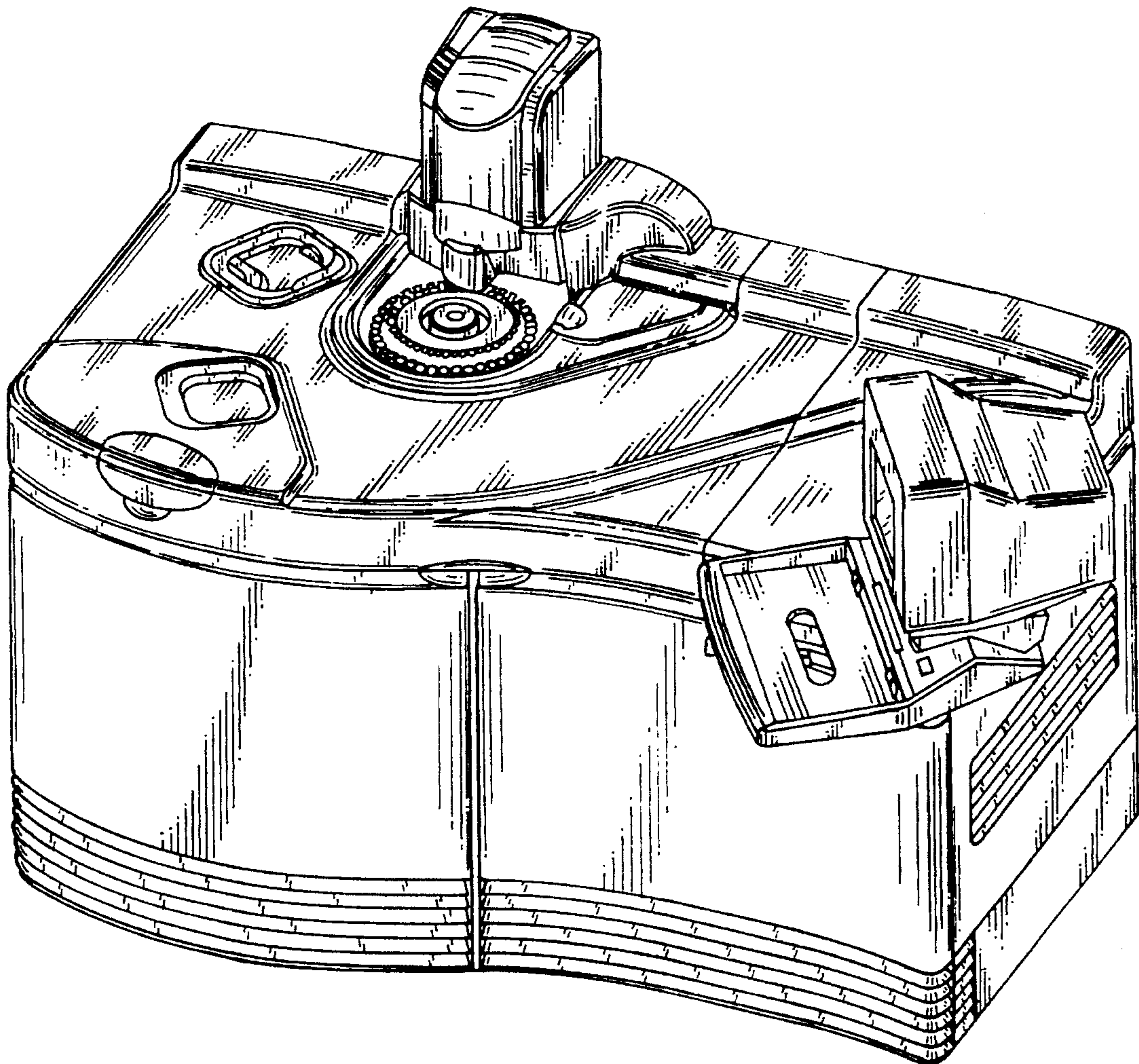
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the analyzer;

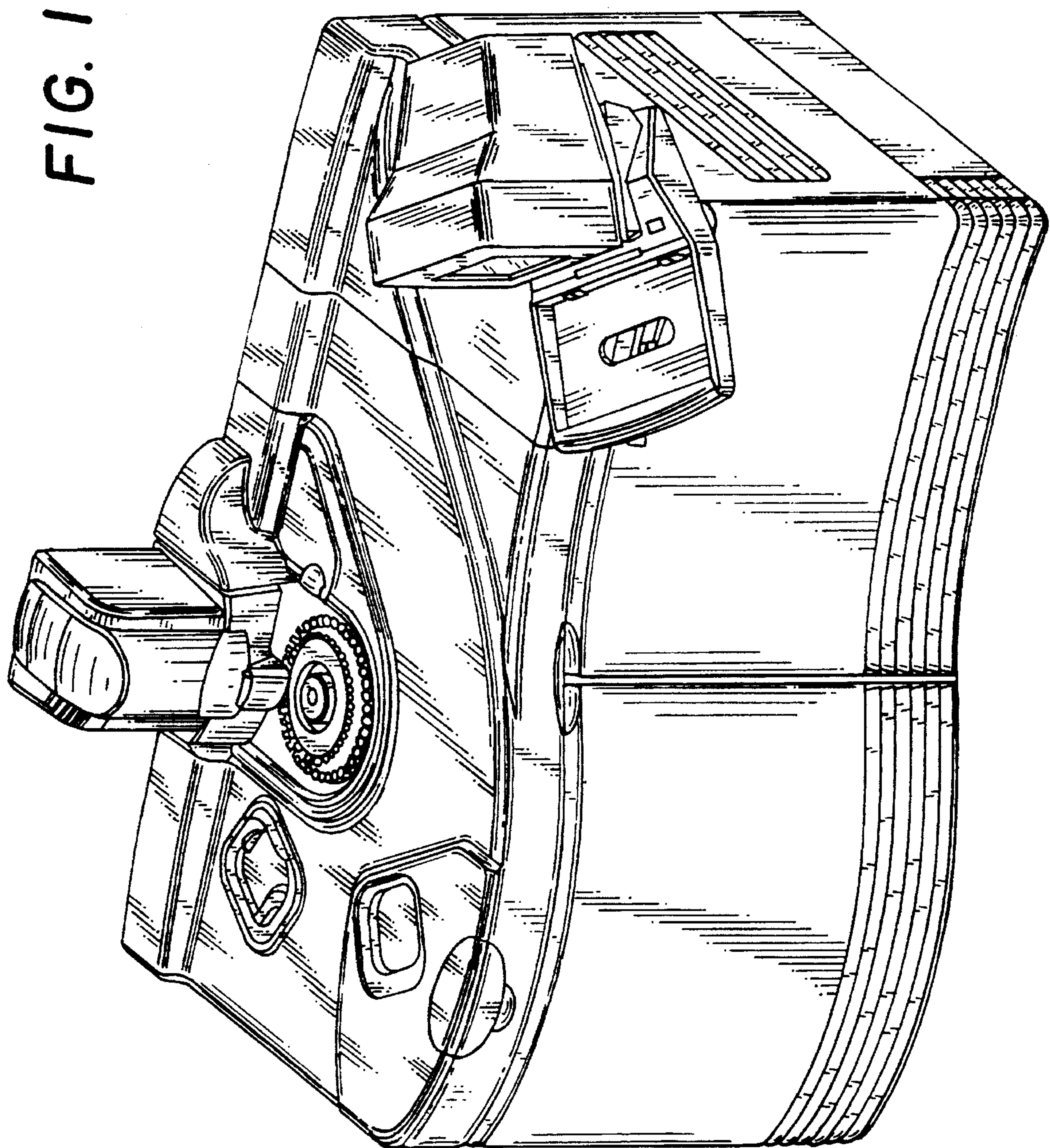
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the analyzer;

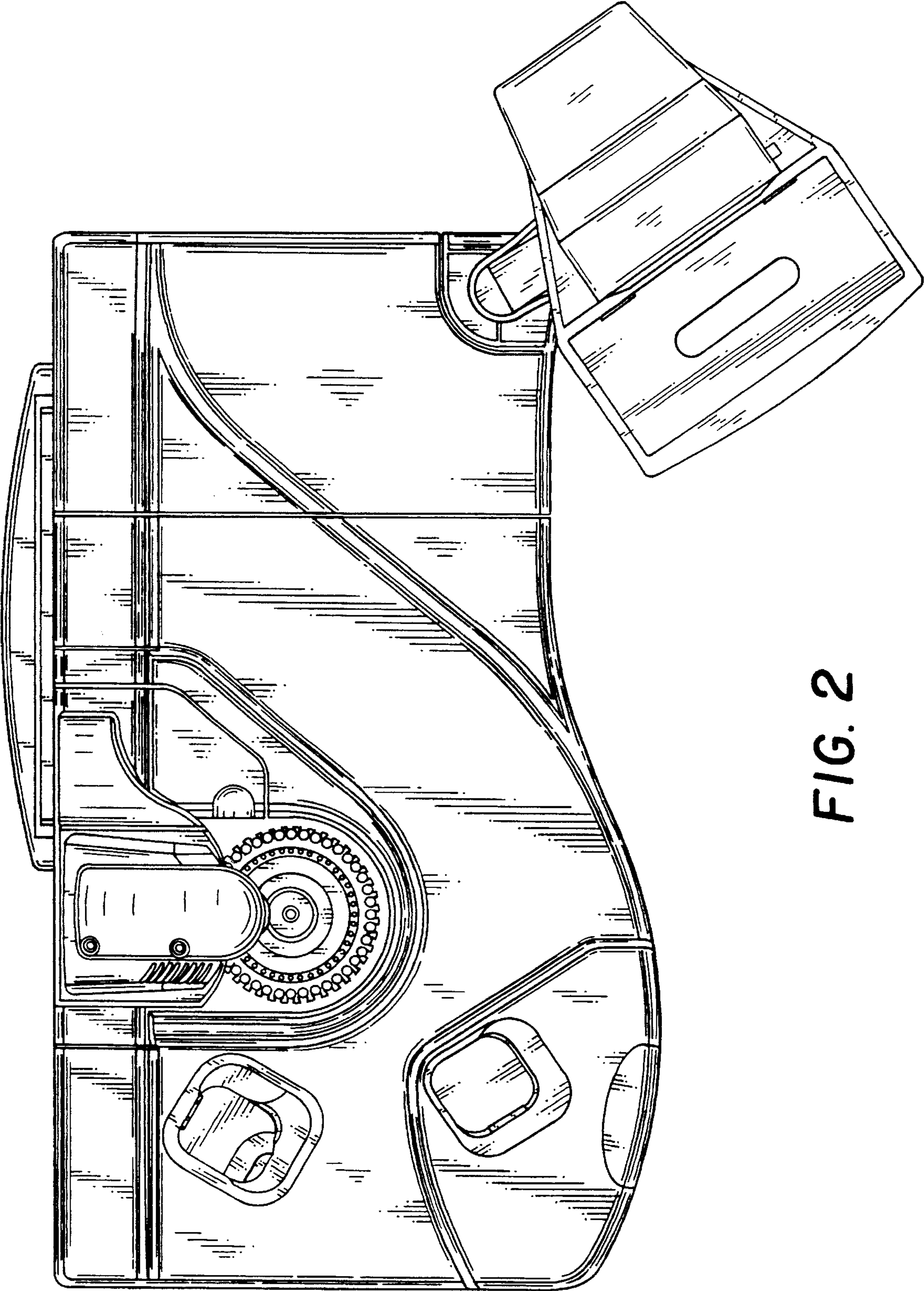

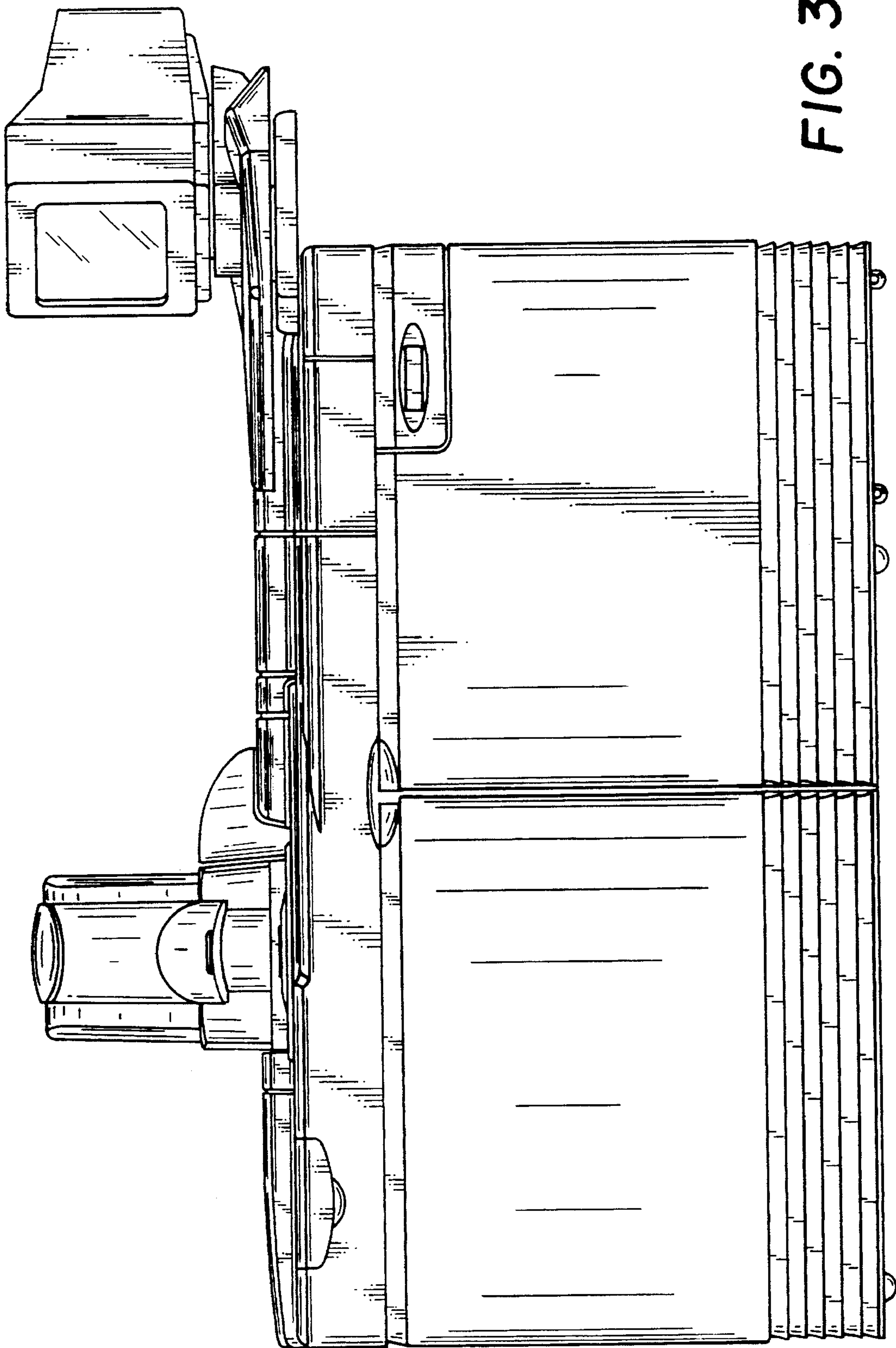

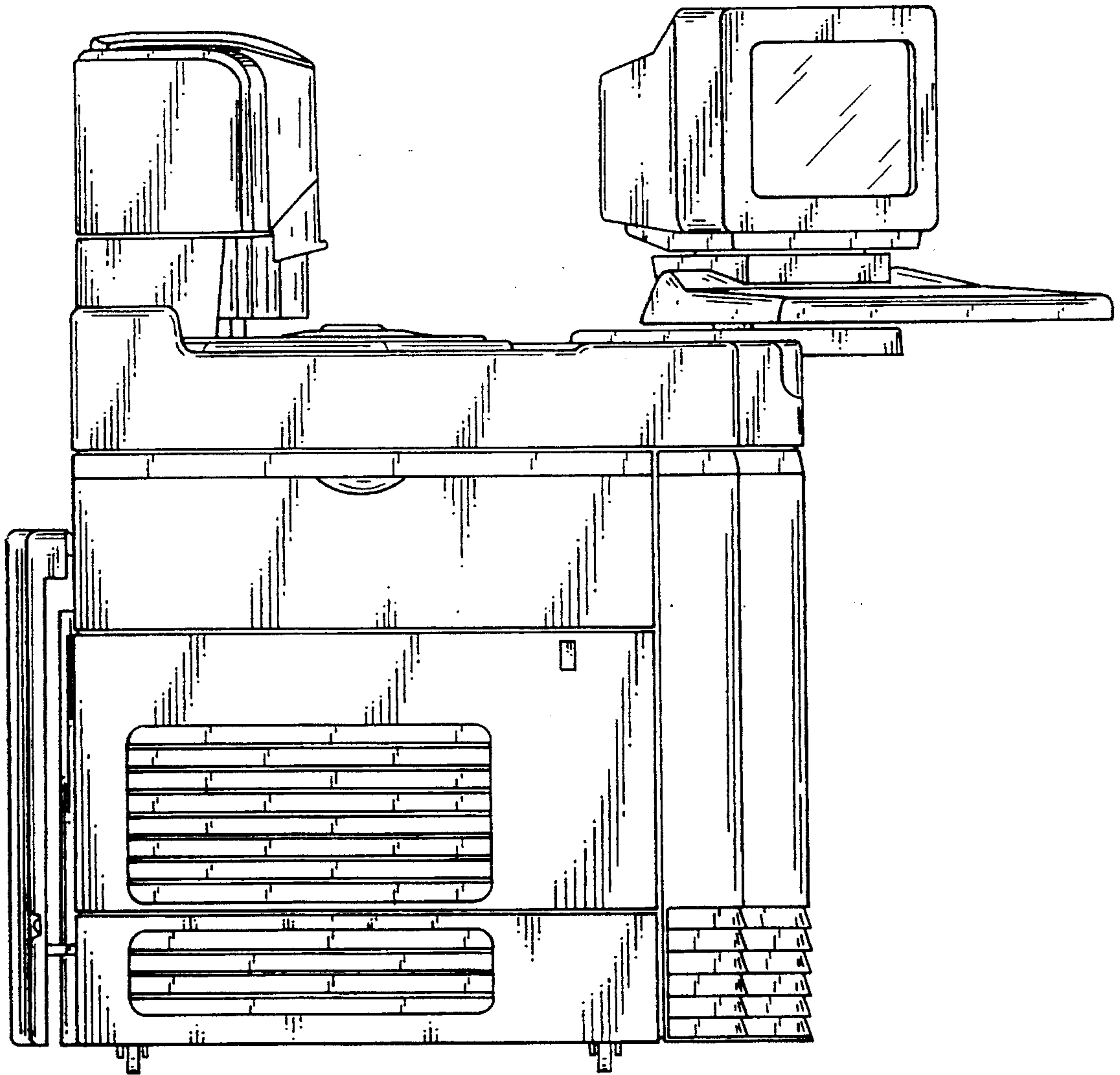

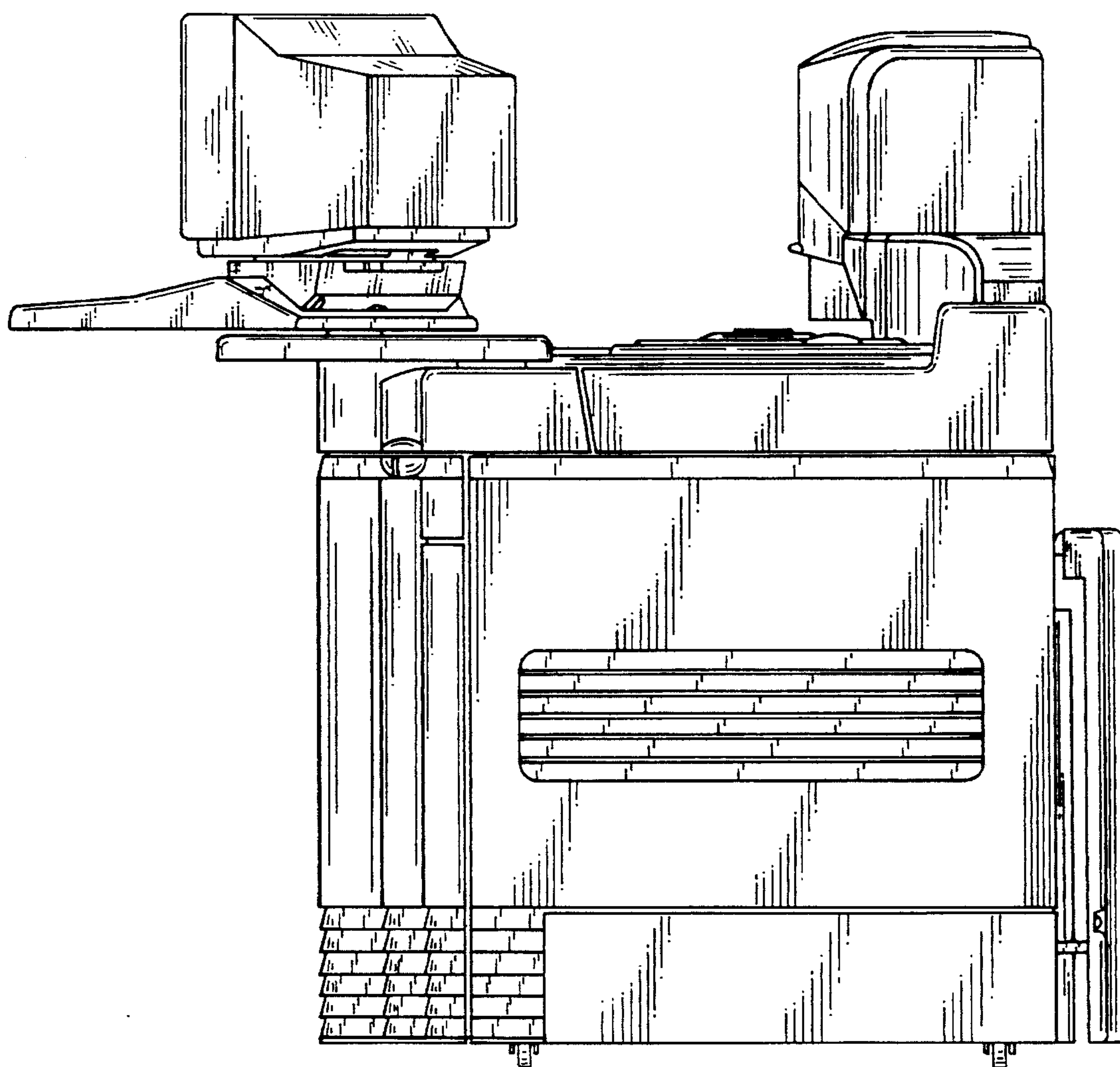

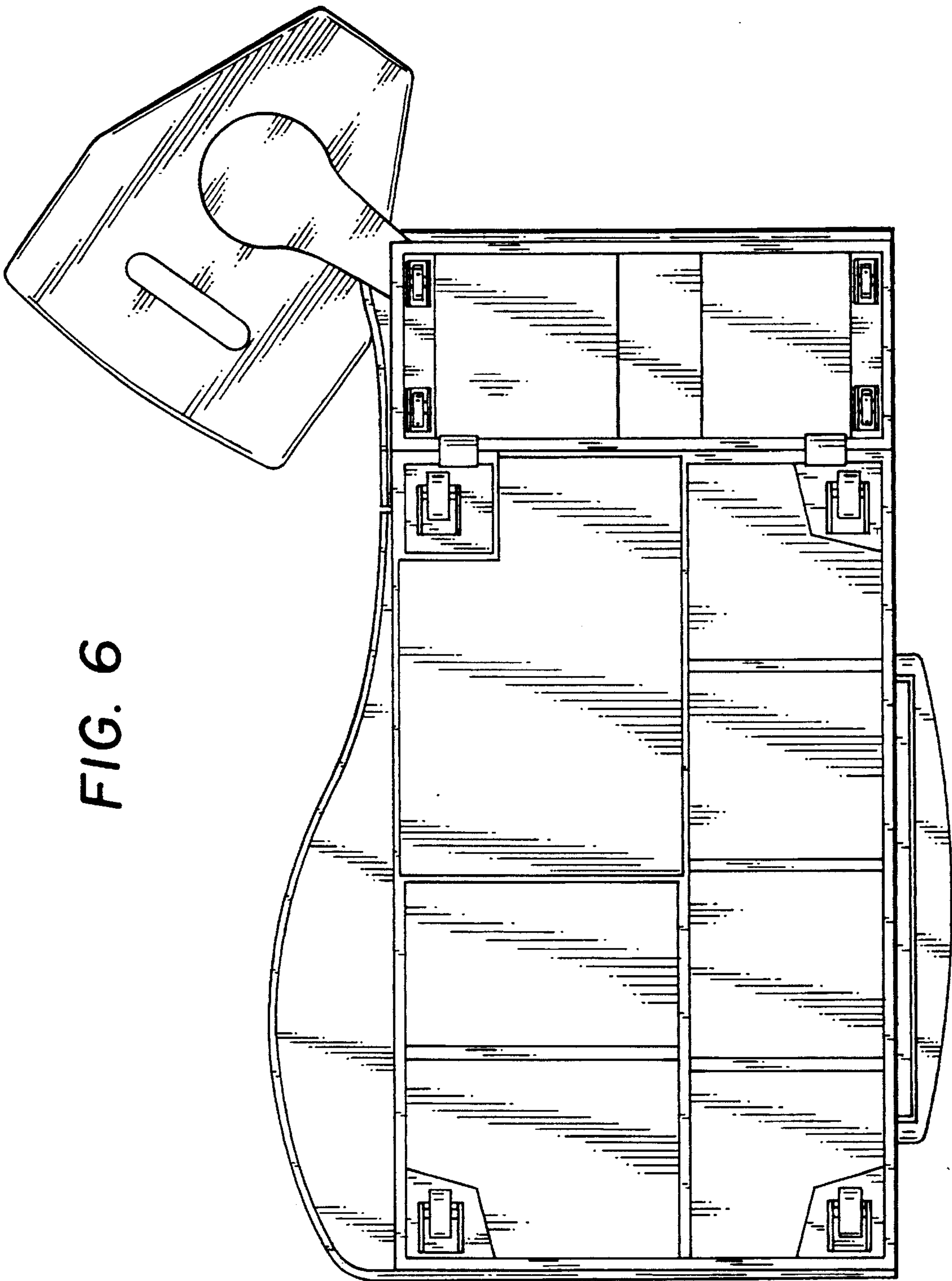
