The ornamental design for a combined ironing board and steam iron, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the combined ironing board and steam iron of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of the combined ironing board and steam iron of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front view in elevation of the combined ironing board and steam iron of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear view in elevation of the combined ironing board and steam iron of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a side view in elevation of the combined ironing board and steam iron of FIG. 1 as seen from the left-hand side of FIG. 3;


FIG. 6 is a side view in elevation of the combined ironing board and steam iron of FIG. 1 as seen from the right-hand side of FIG. 3;


FIG. 7 is a top lan view of FIG. 3; and,


FIG. 8 is a bottom view of FIG. 3.

The broken line showing of the cord in the drawings is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.




