DESCRIPTION

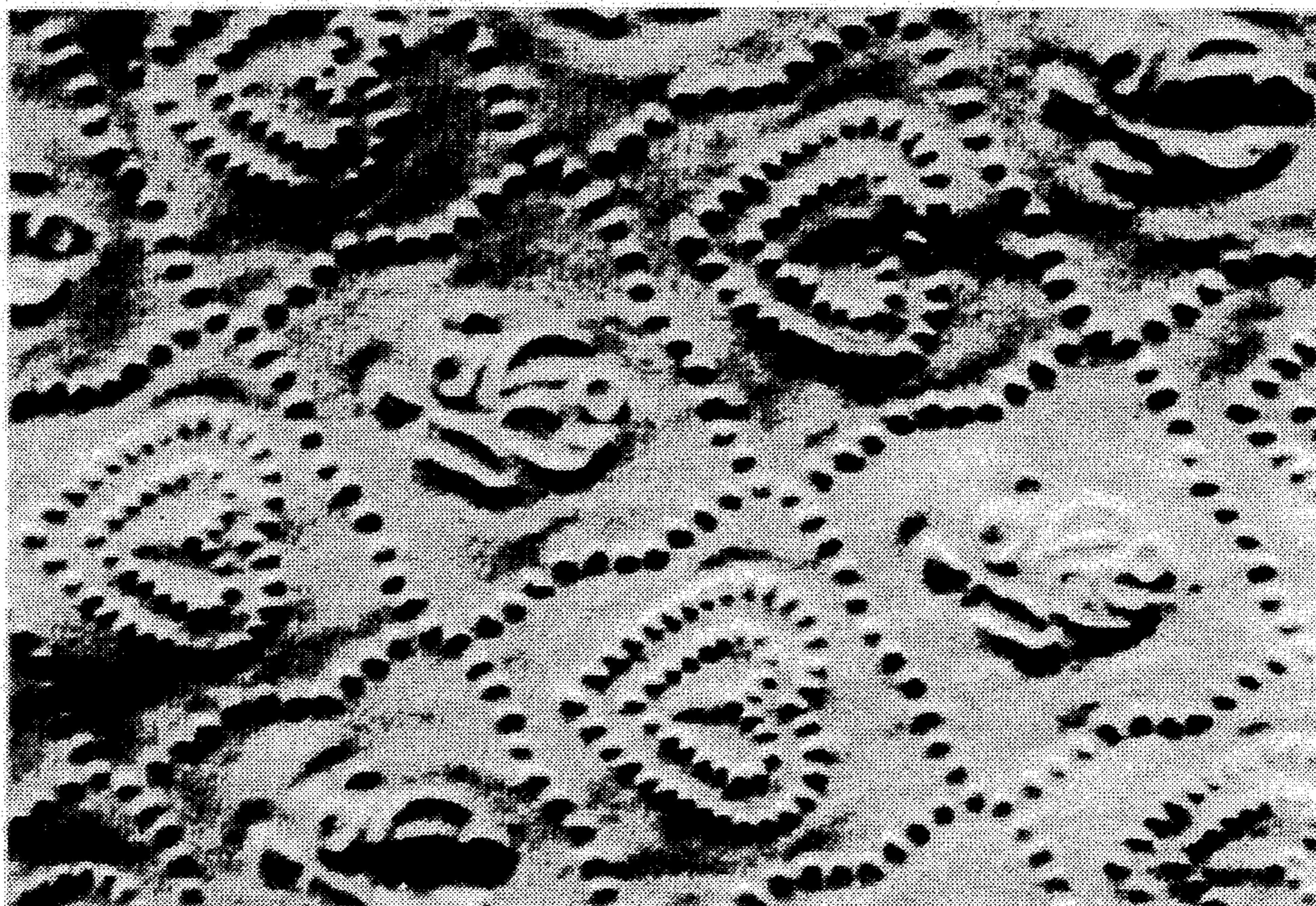
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an embossed paper product embodying my design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of a portion of an embossed paper product embodying my design, nd shown at an enlarged scale for ease of disclosure;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the design of FIG. 1 embodied in a roll; and,

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the design of FIG. 3 shown in a slightly altered position.

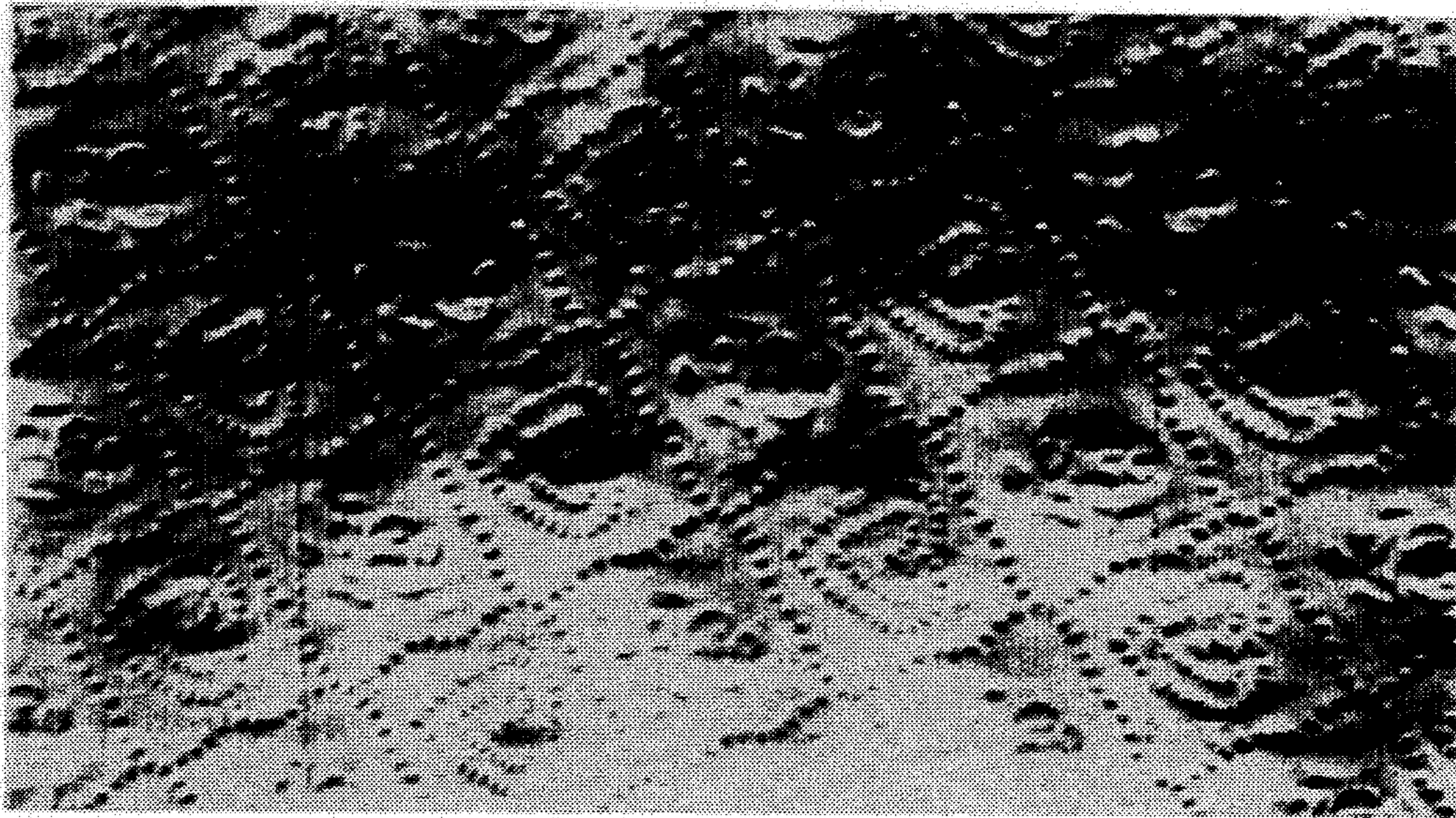

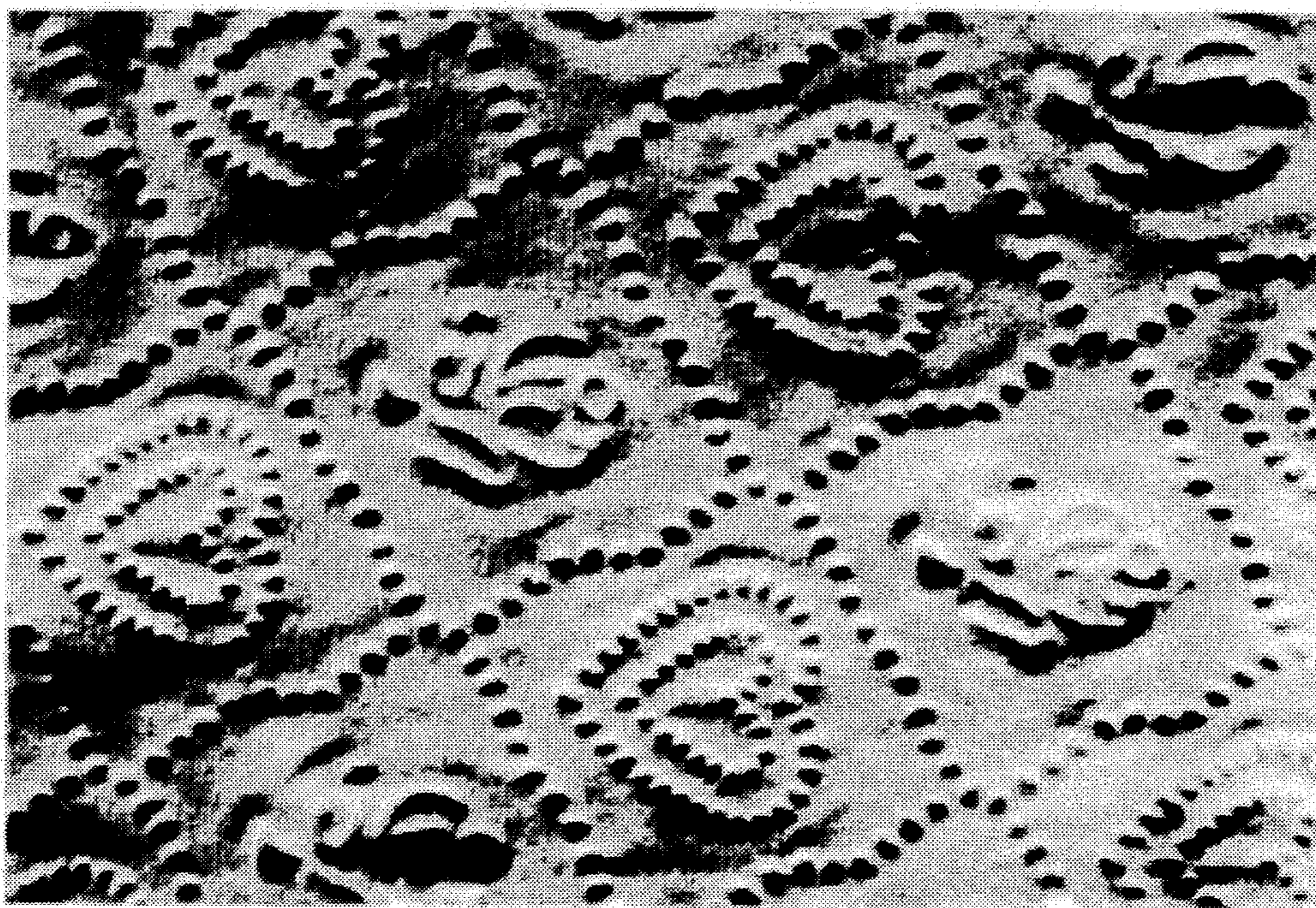

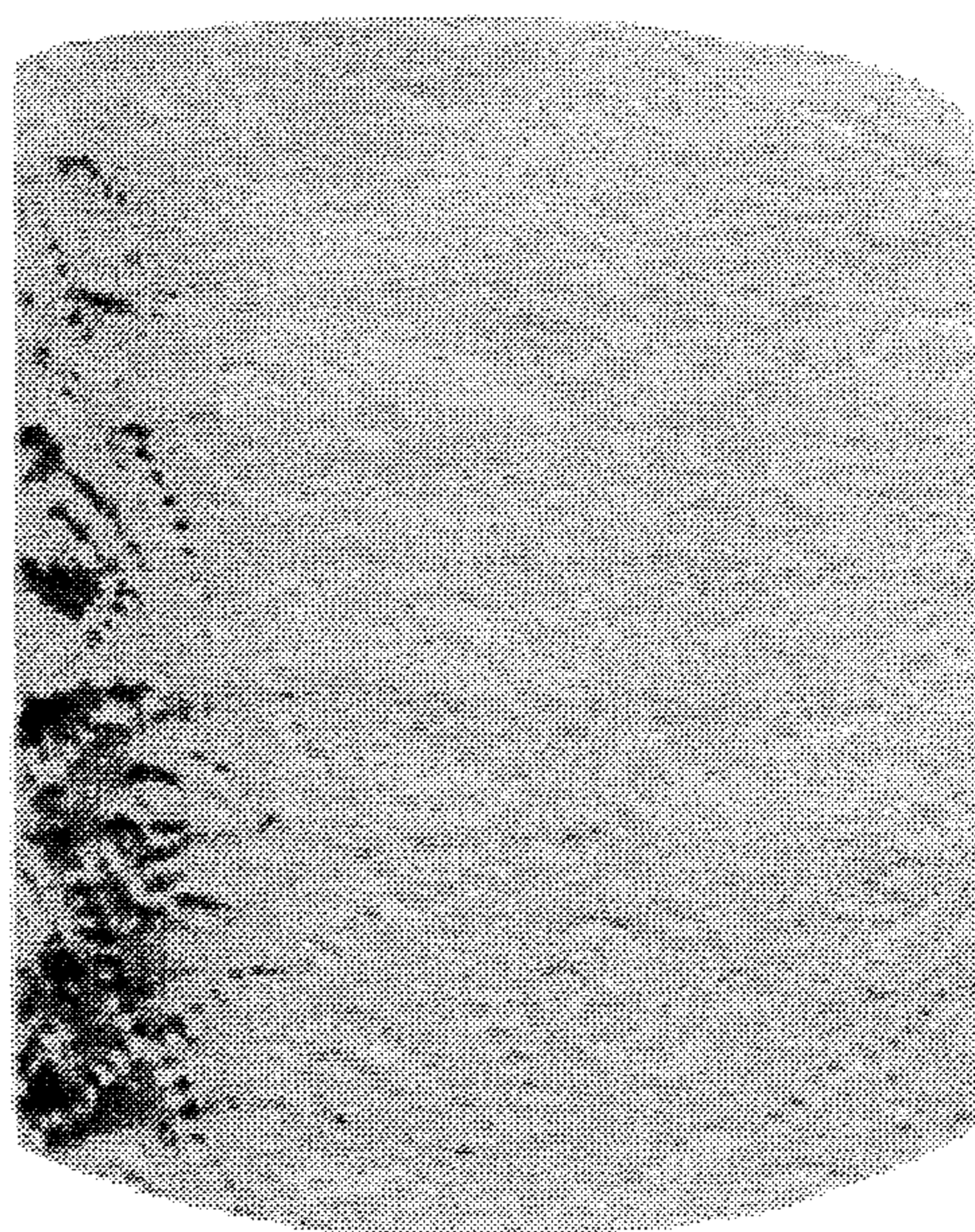

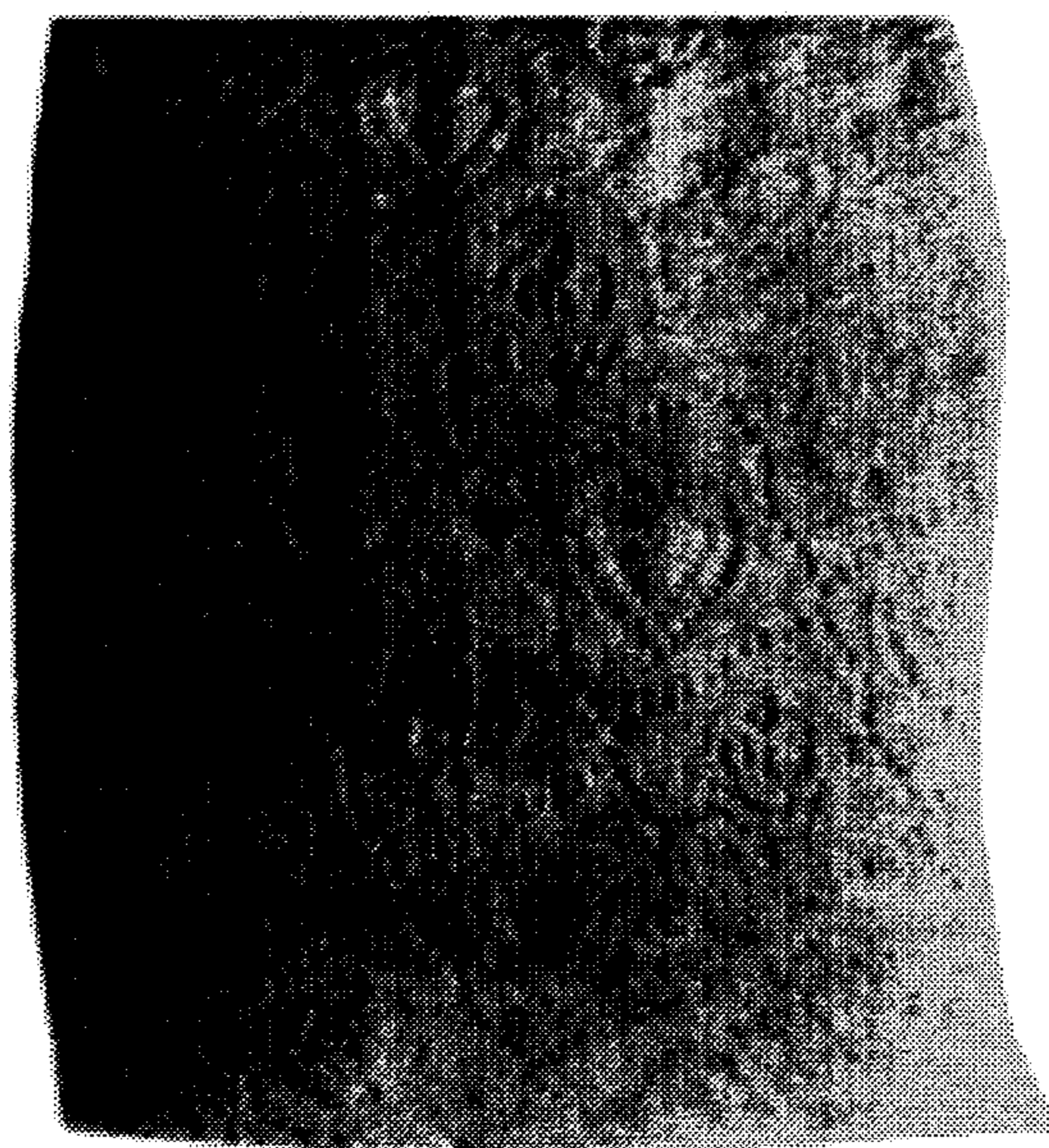
