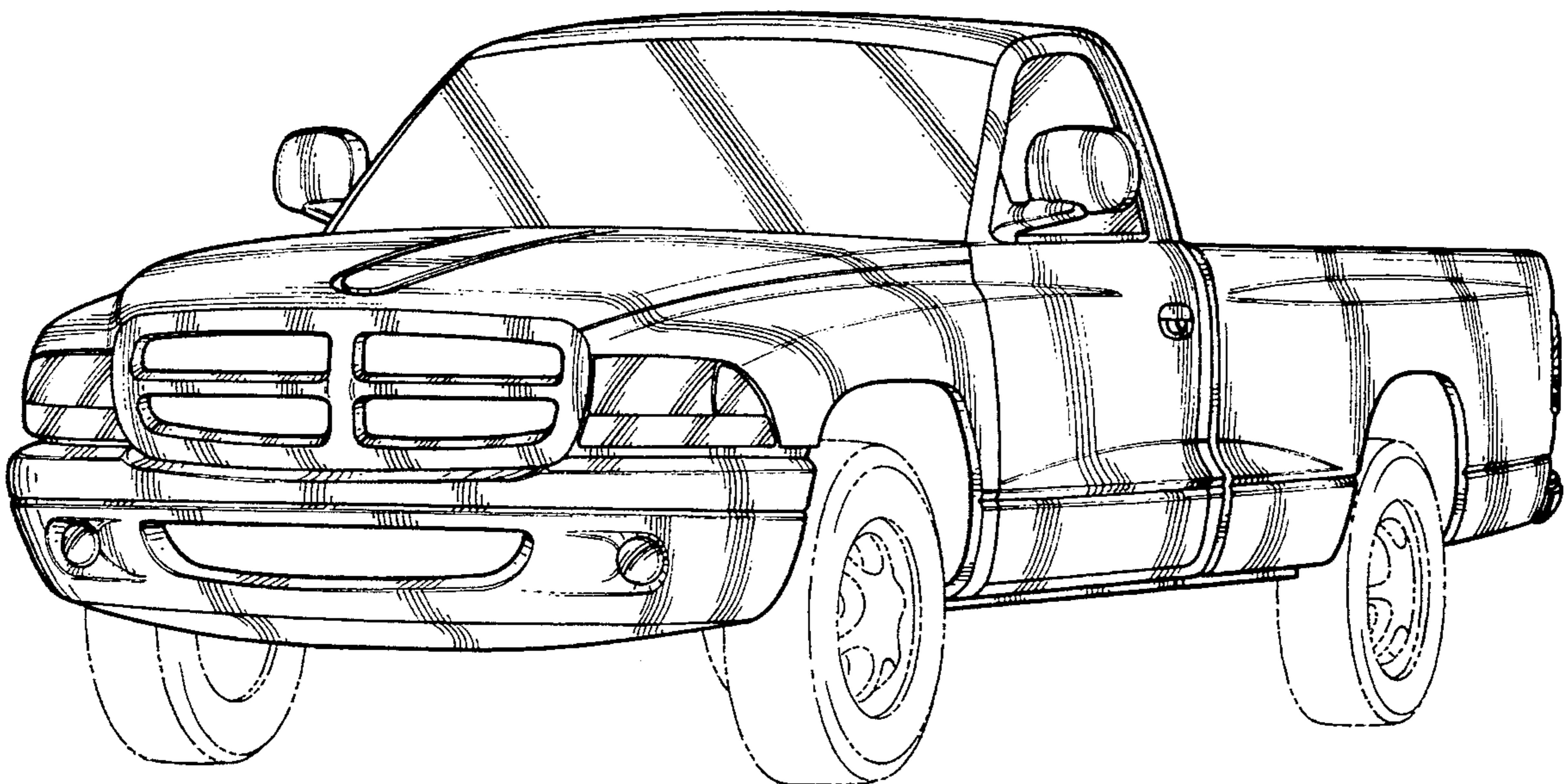
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pick-up truck body exterior surface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a pick-up truck body exterior surface showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of the pick-up truck body exterior surface shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a side view of the pick-up truck body exterior surface shown in FIG. 1, it being understood that the opposite side is substantially a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front view of the pick-up truck body exterior surface shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a rear view of the pick-up truck body exterior surface shown in FIG. 1; and,
 FIG. 6 is a side view of a pick-up truck body exterior surface showing a second embodiment of our new design, the sole difference being in the extended cab portion.
 The roof of the cab of both embodiments of the pick-up truck body exterior surface is understood to be plain and unornamented, and the interior of the bed thereof forms no part of the claimed design.
 The broken line showing of the tires and wheels in the drawing is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

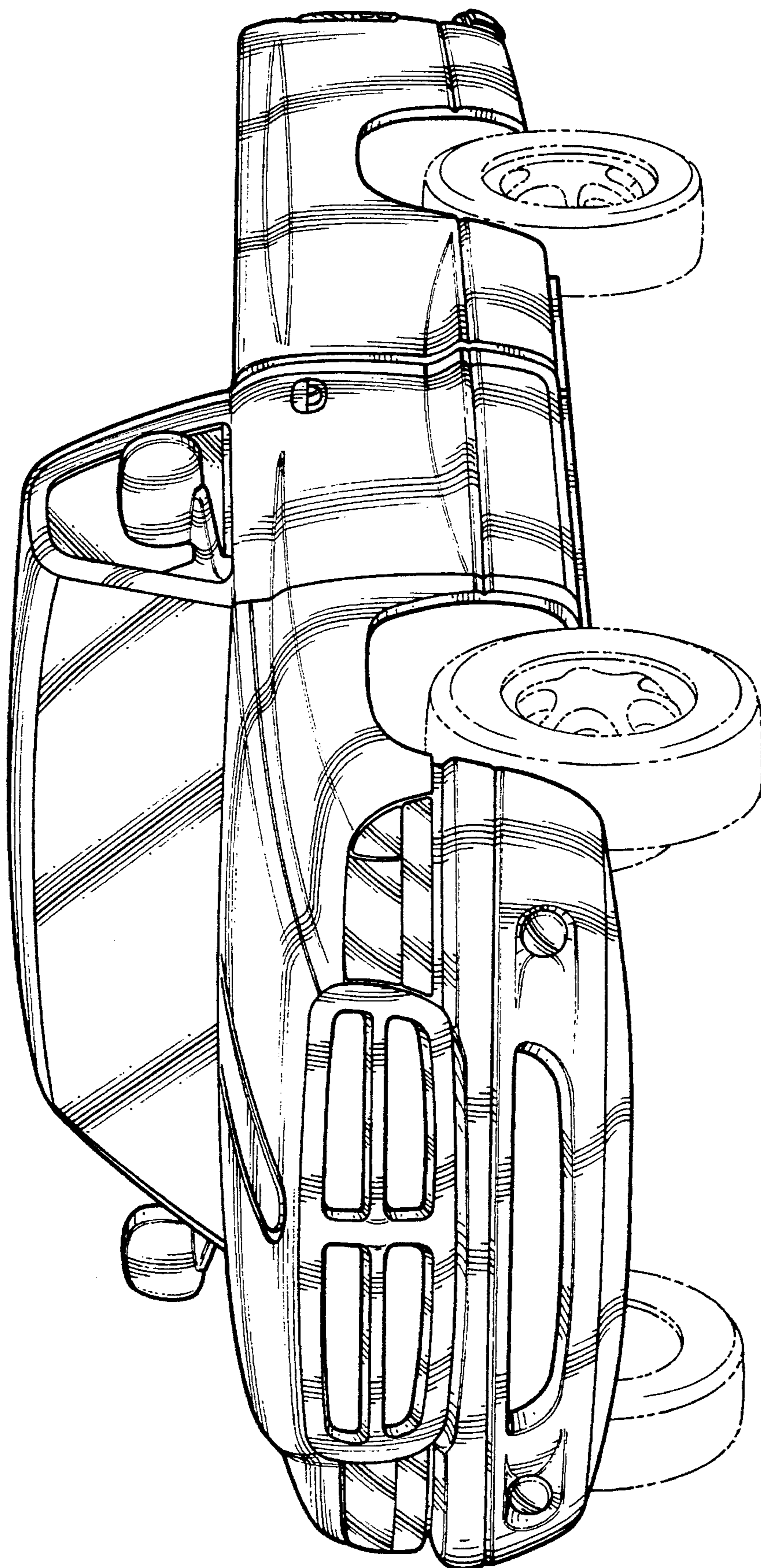

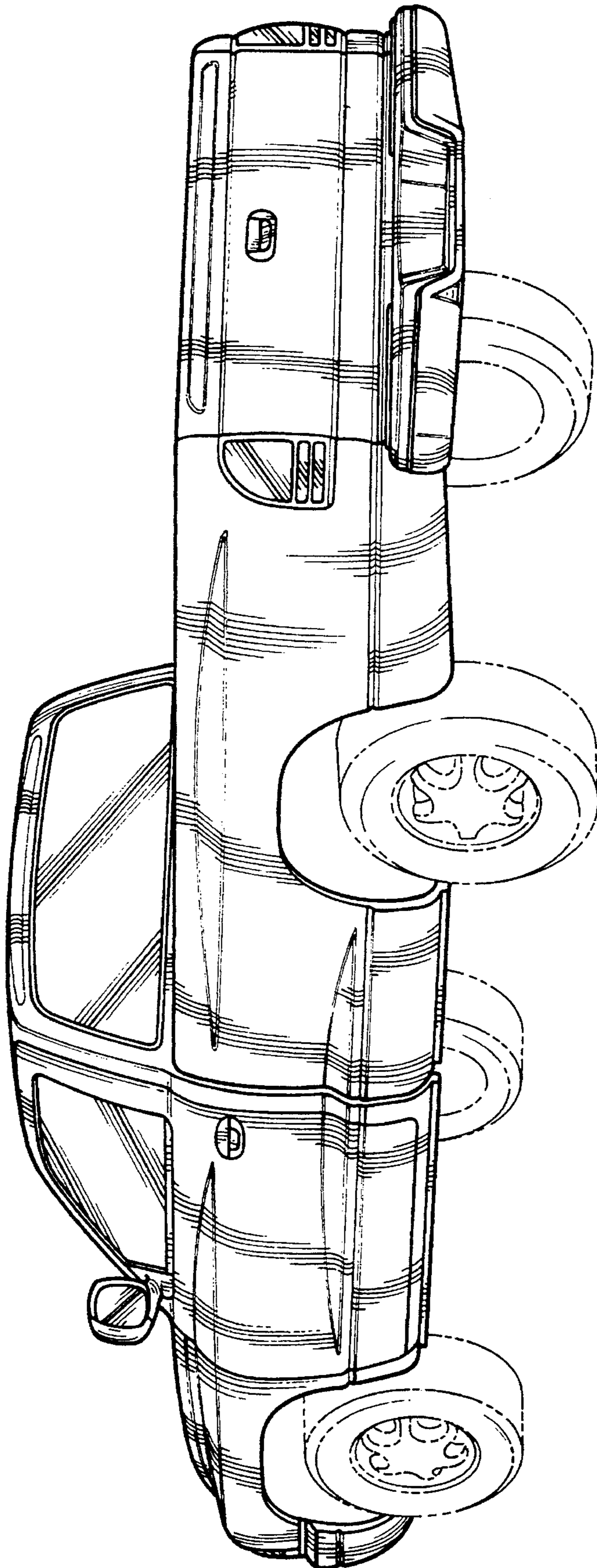

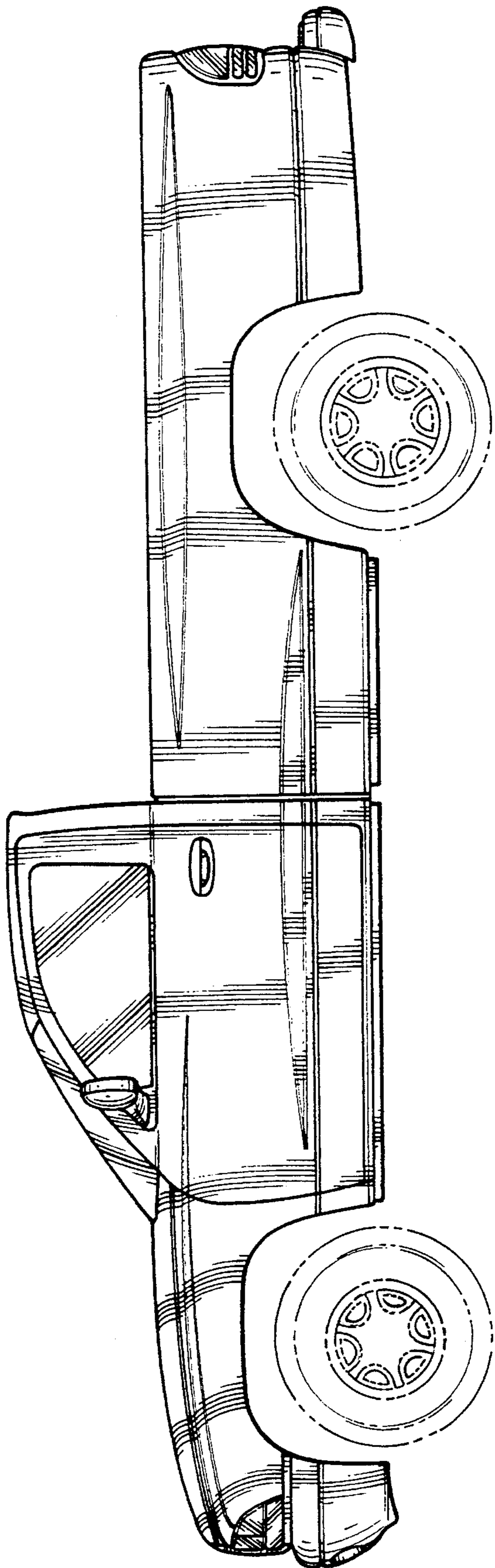

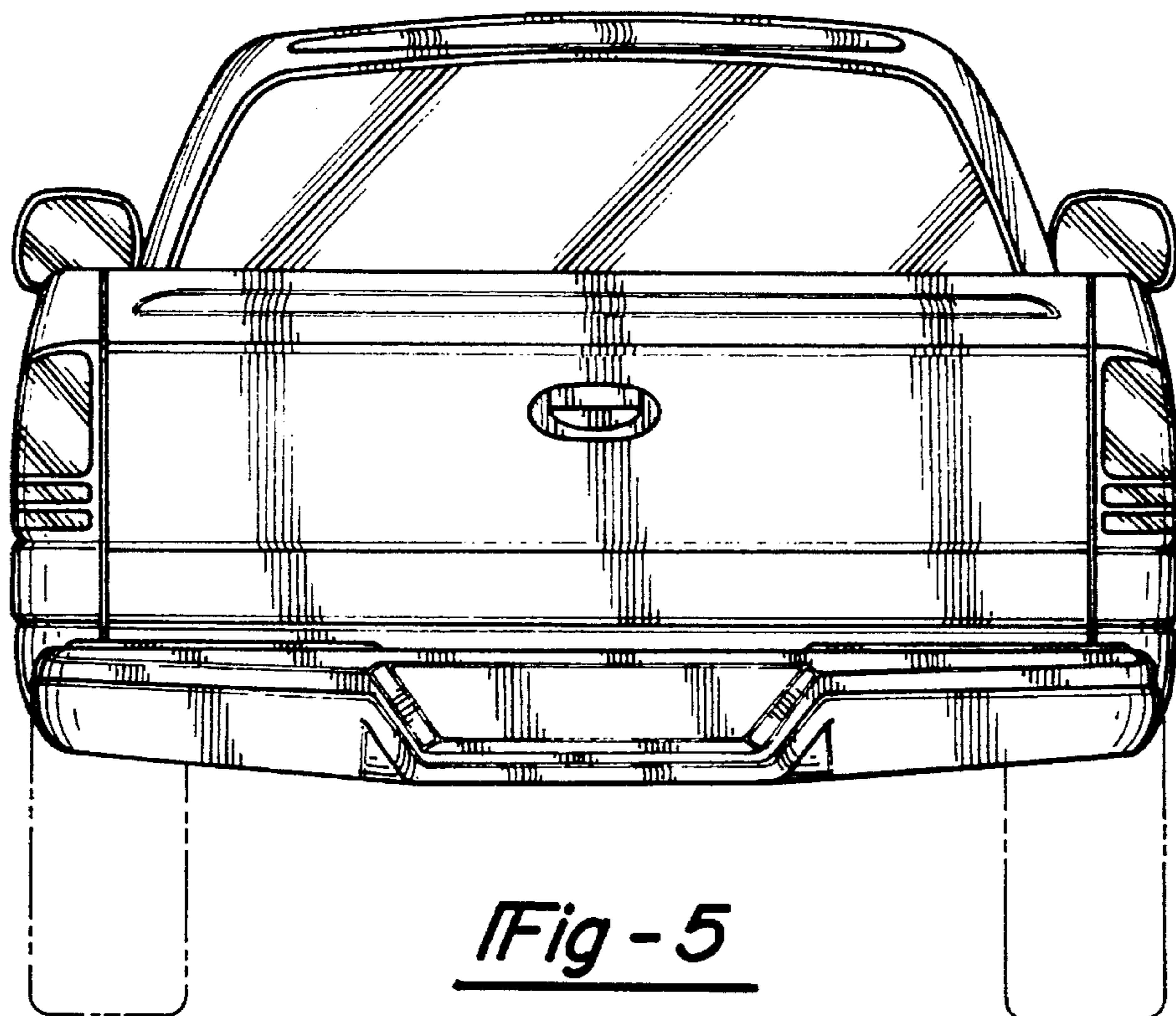
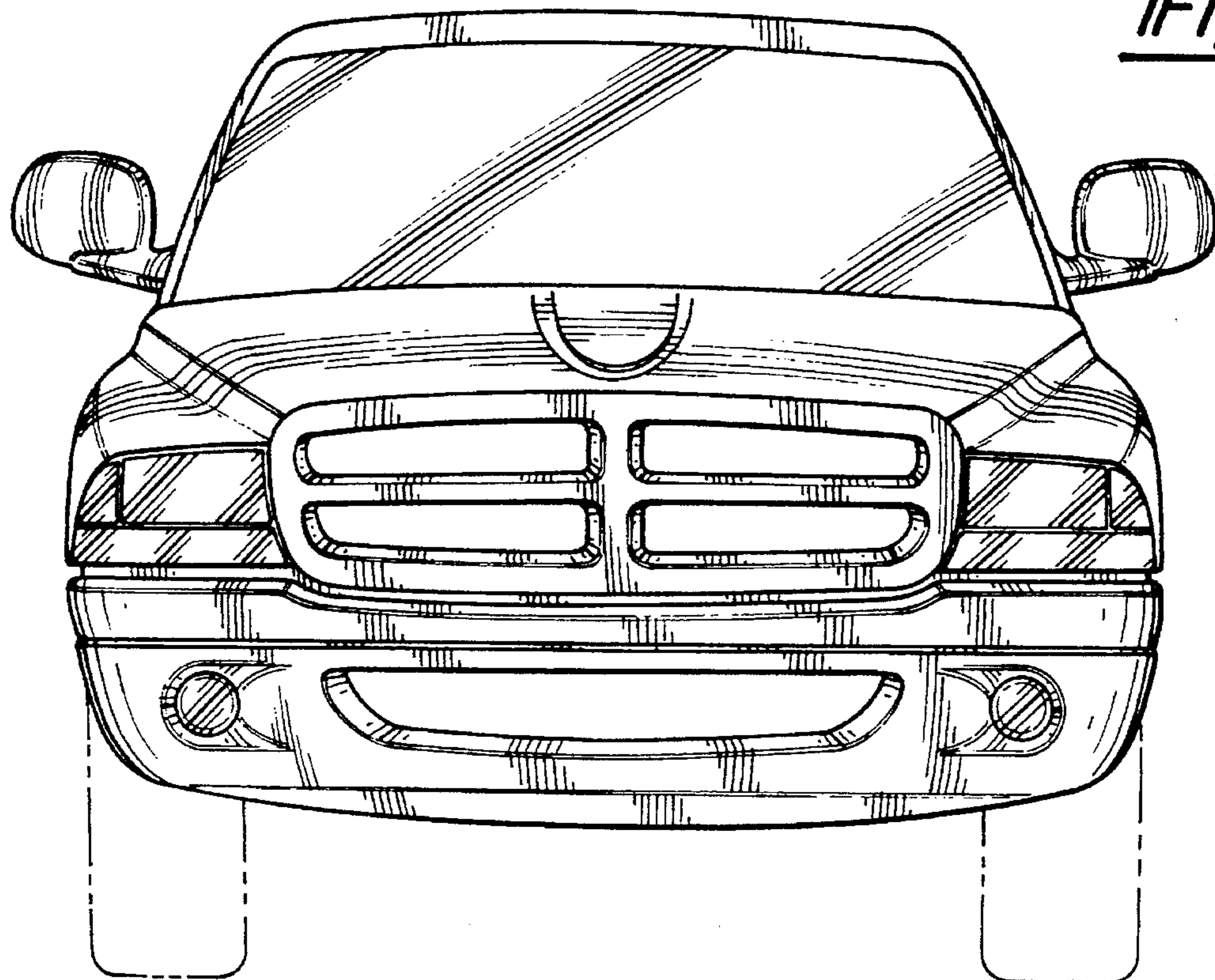

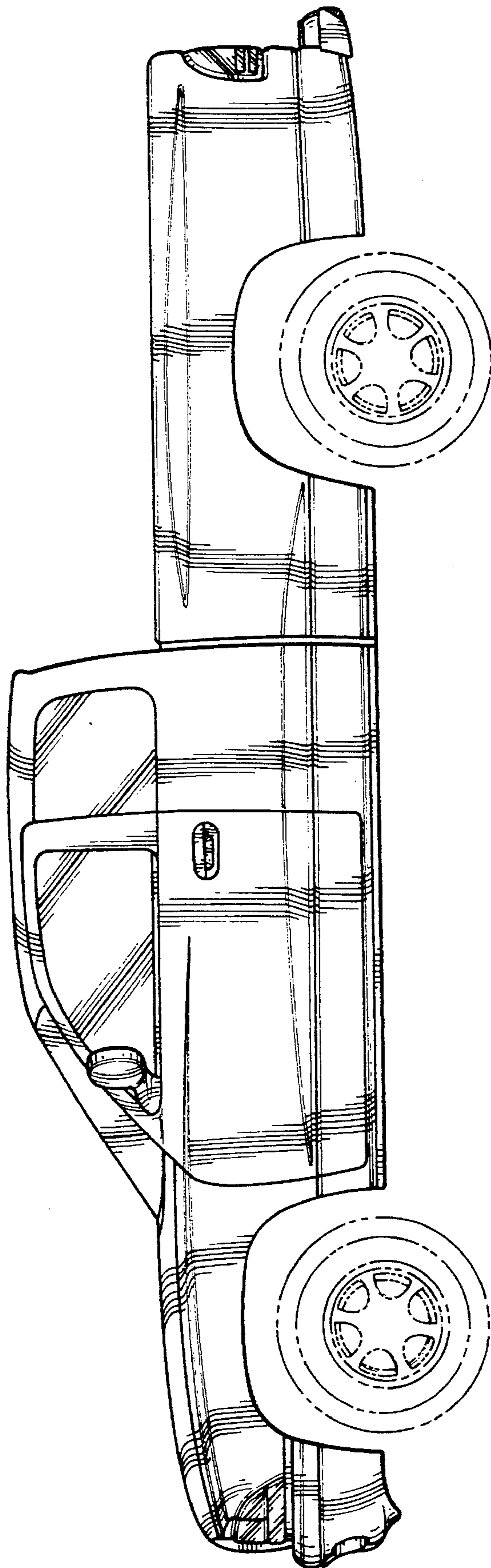
