DESCRIPTION

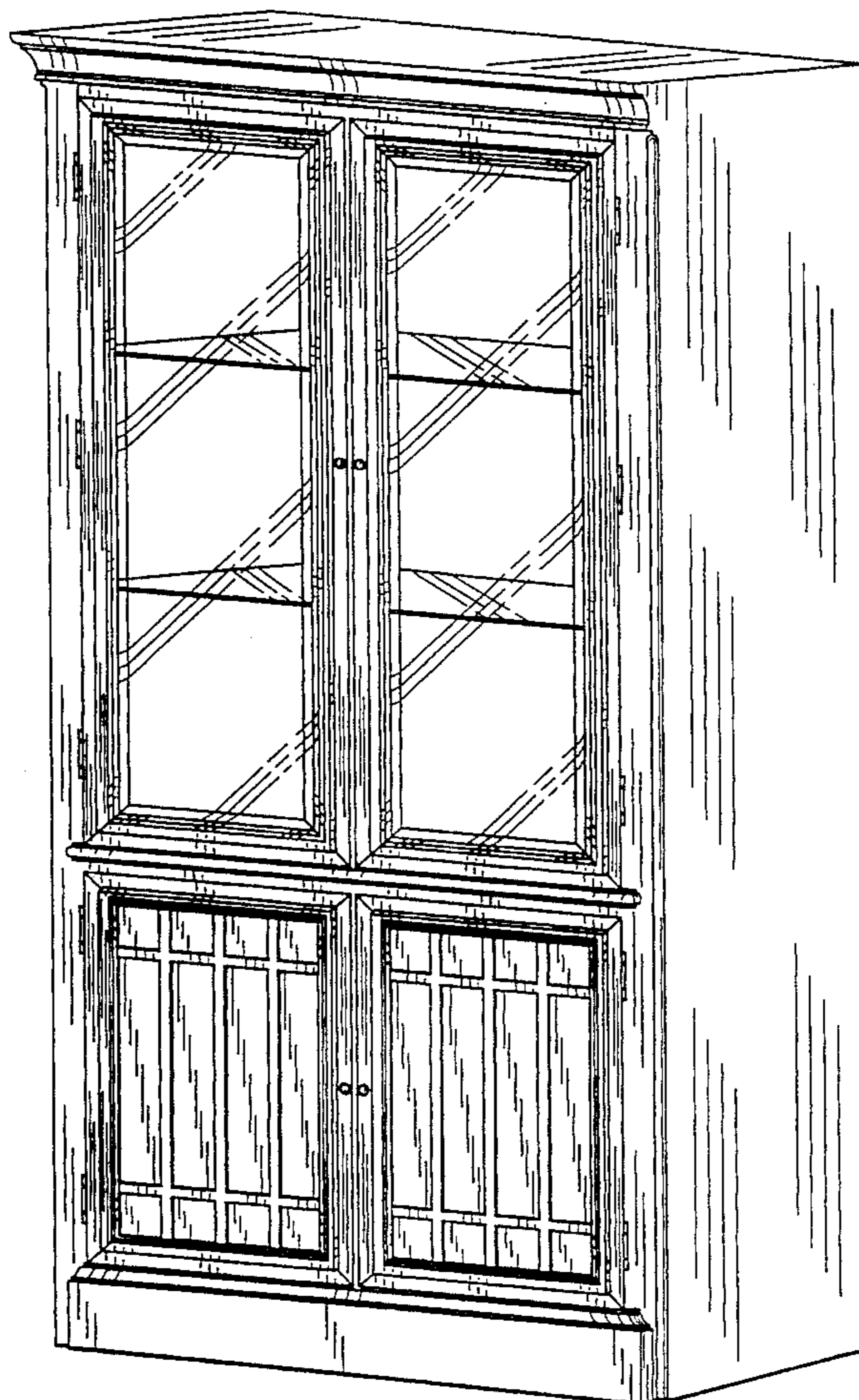
FIG. 1 is a front partial perspective view of a curio console showing our new design;

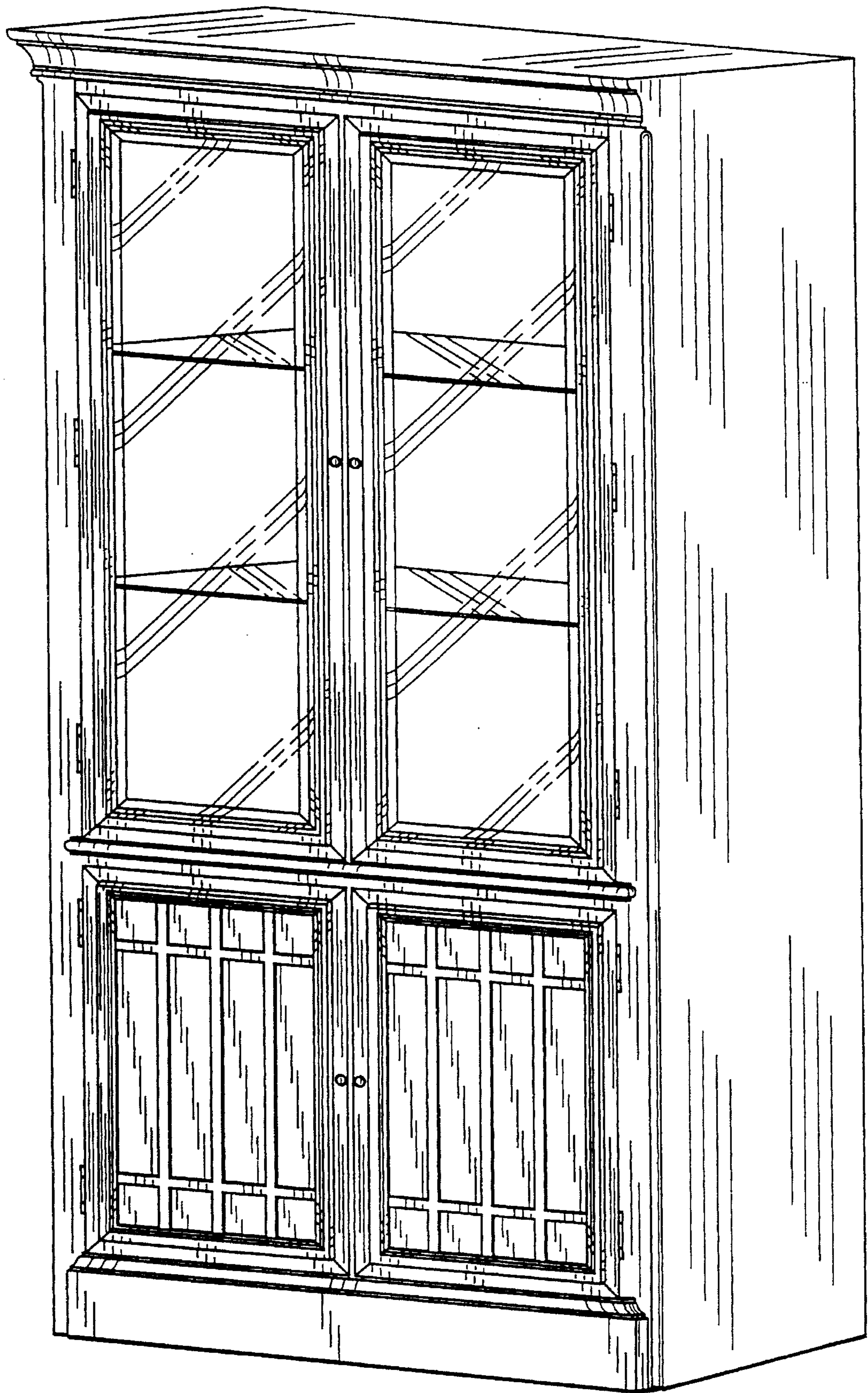

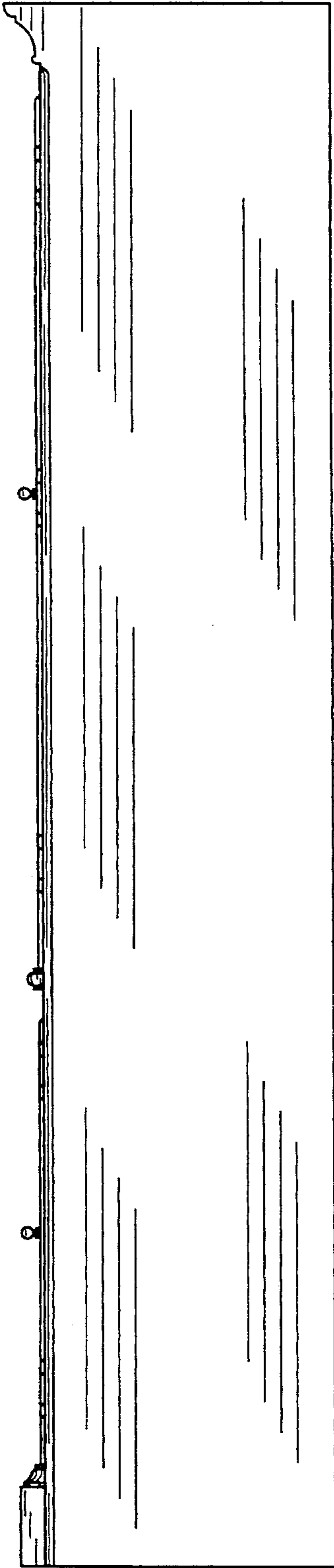

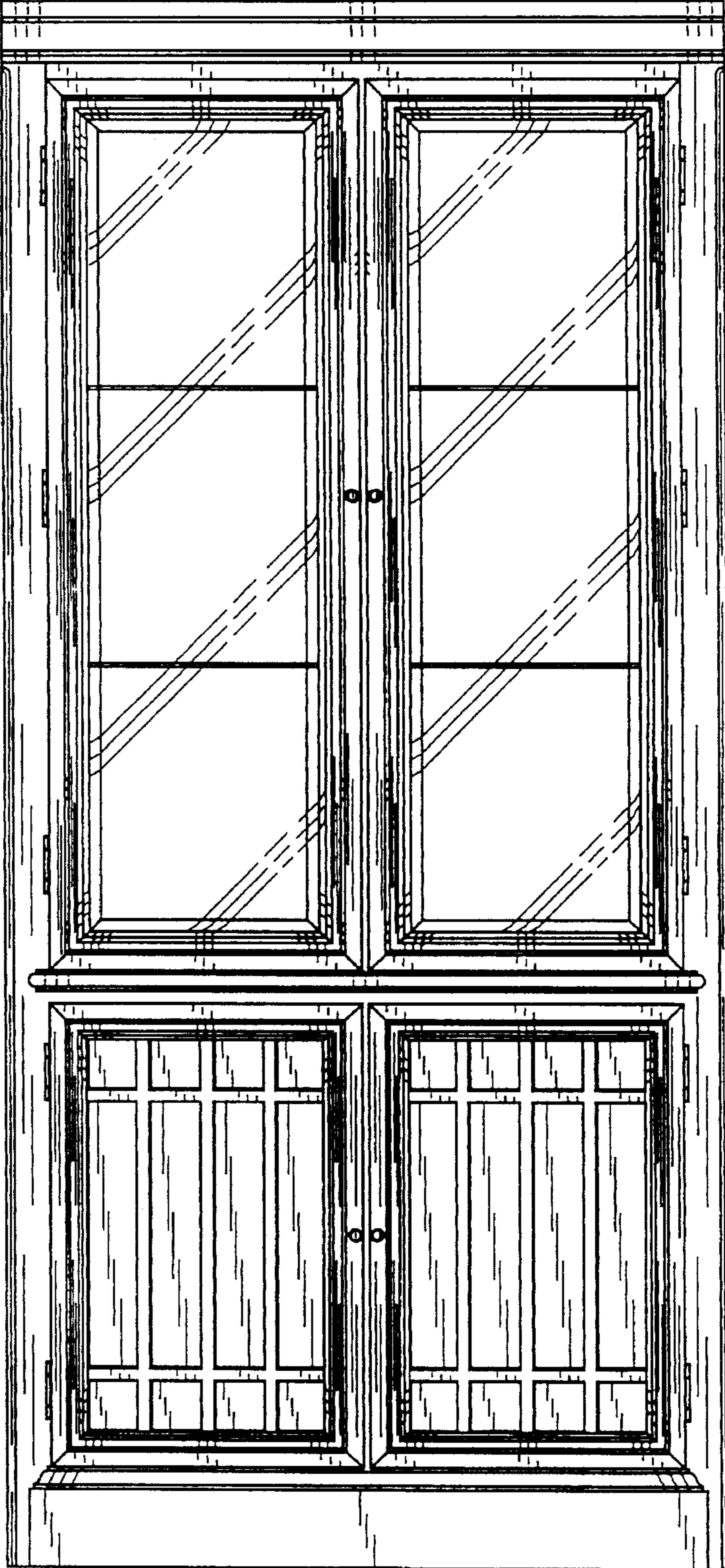
