 FIG. 15 is a side elevational view thereof, showing the narrow side, each narrow side being identical;

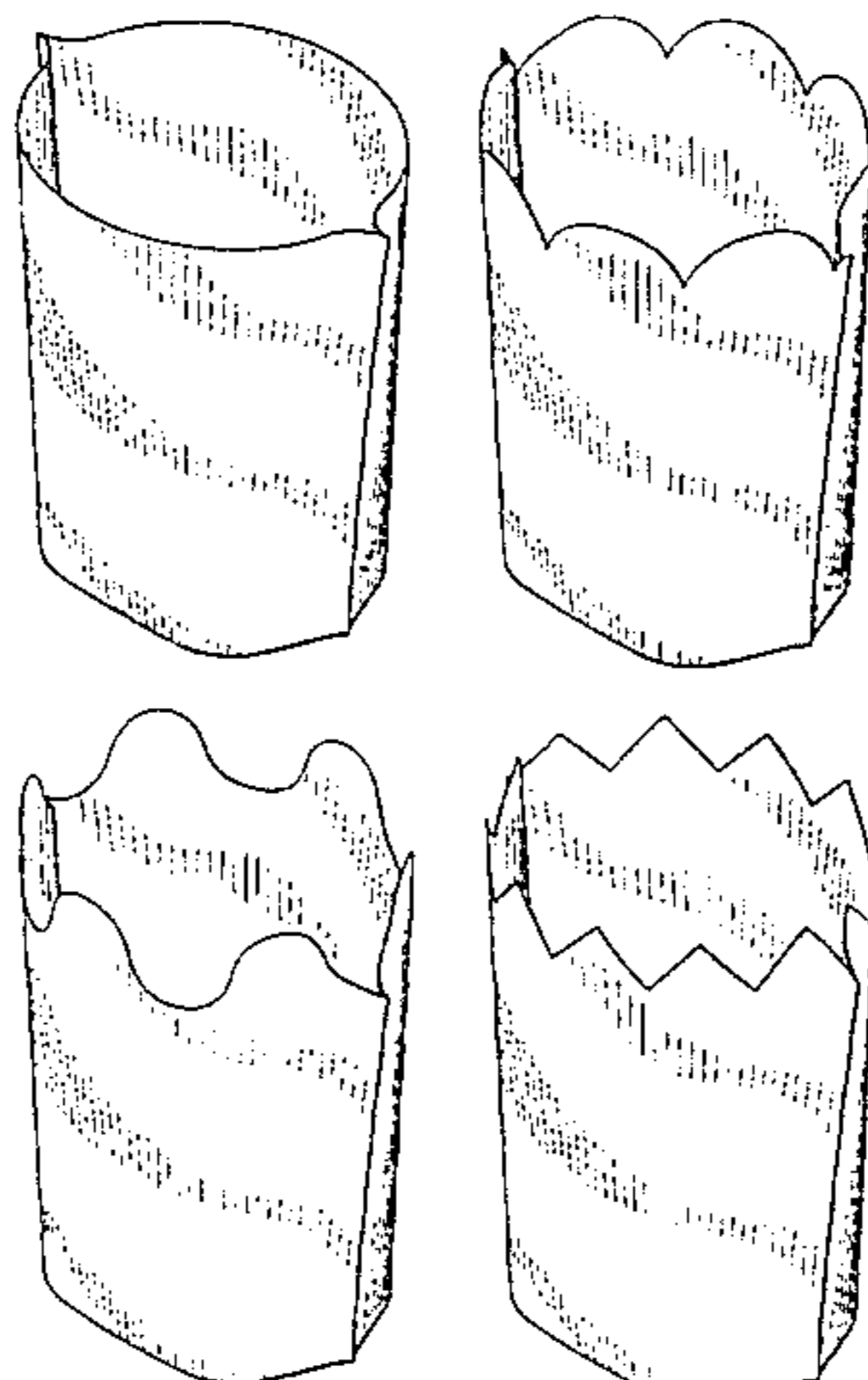


FIG. 16 is a transverse sectional view, showing the gusseted bottom thereof;

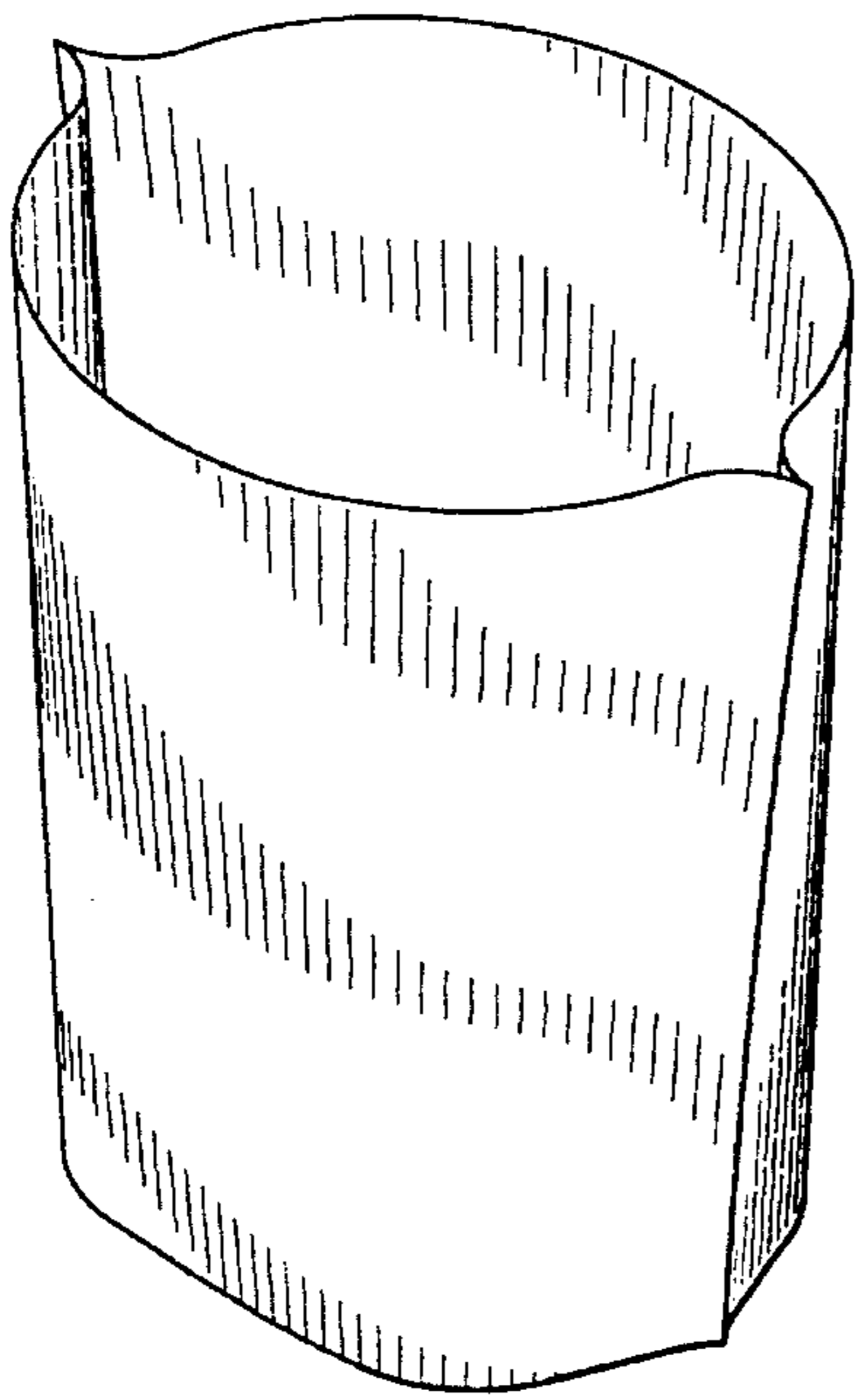

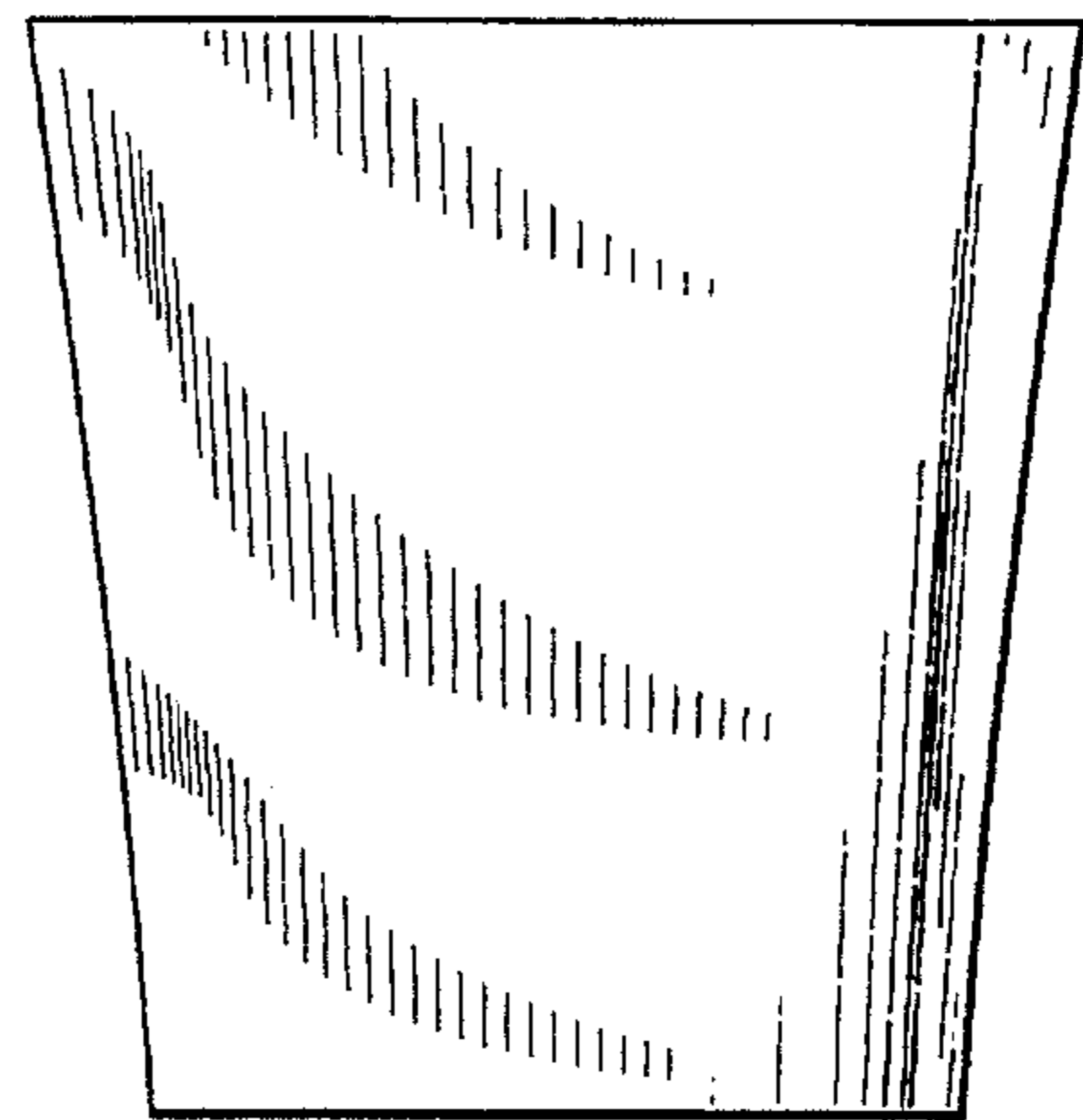

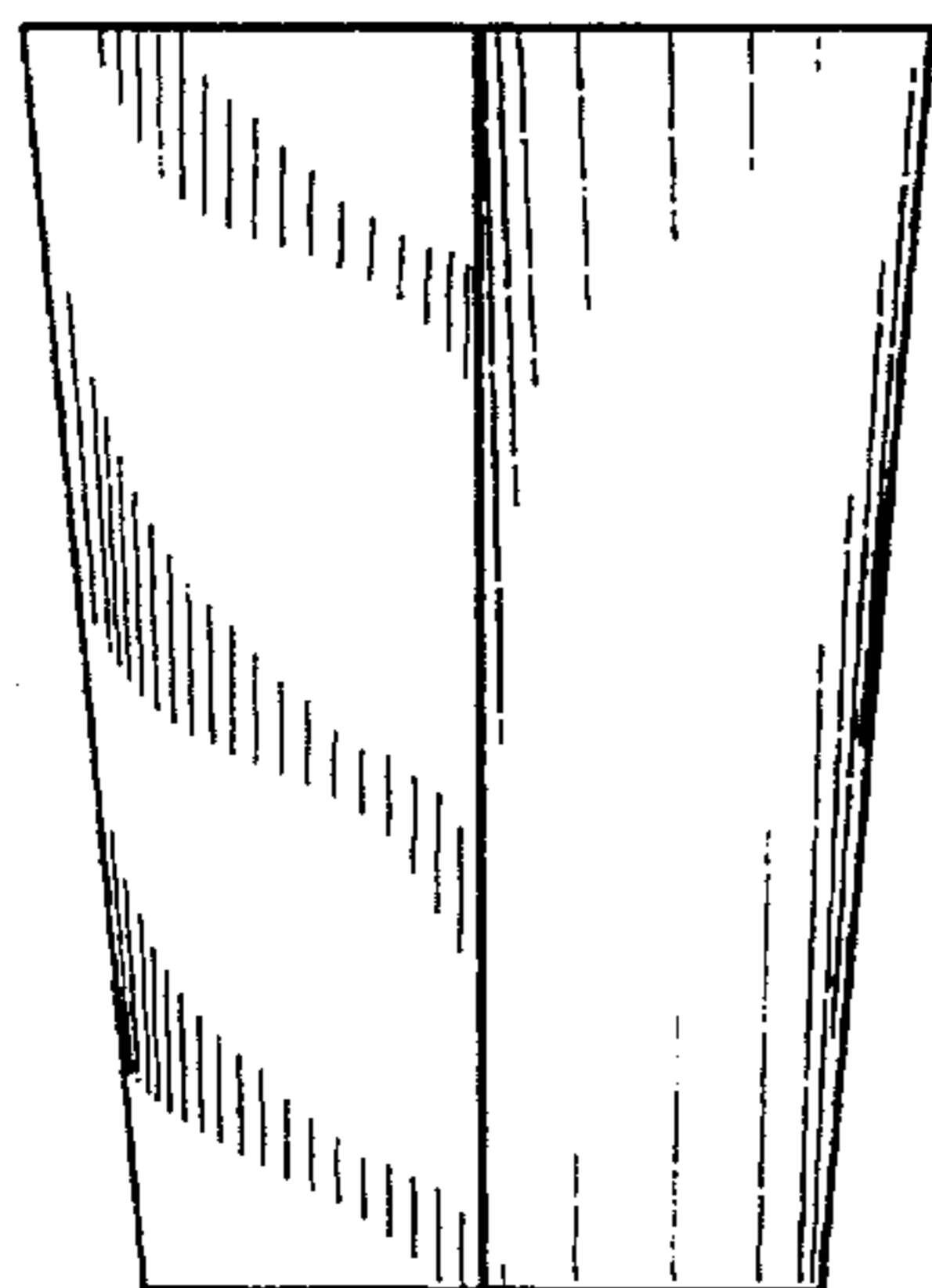

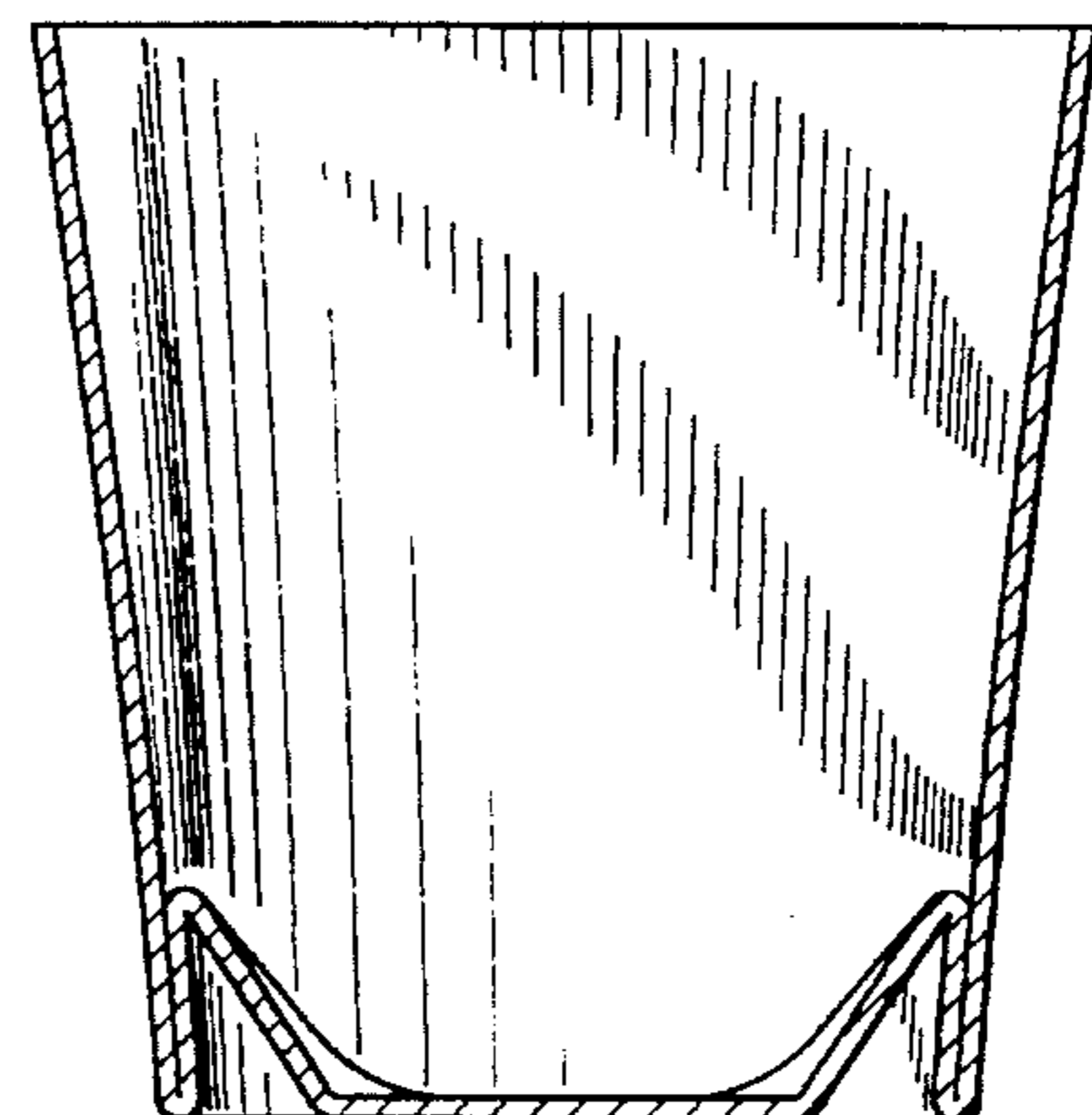

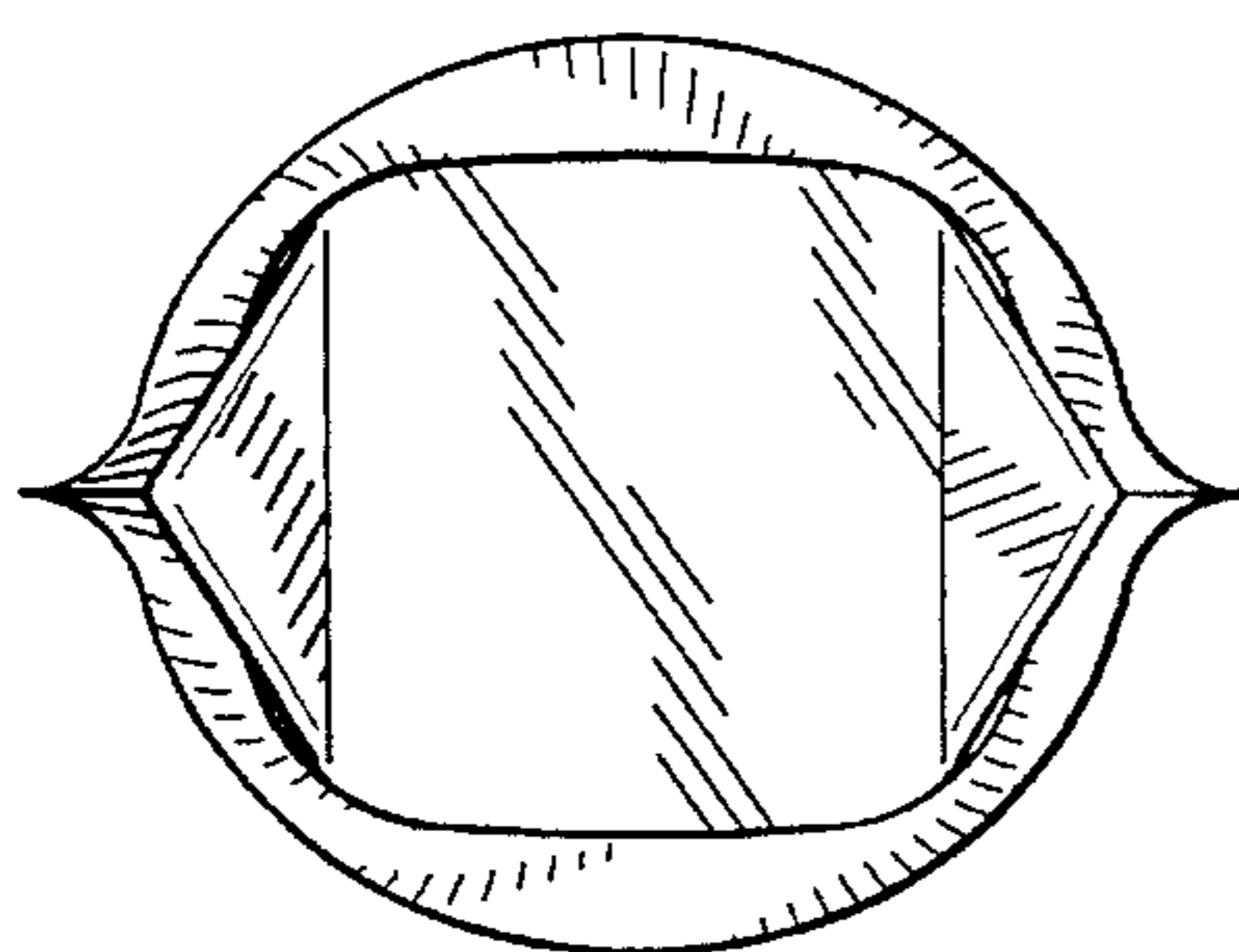

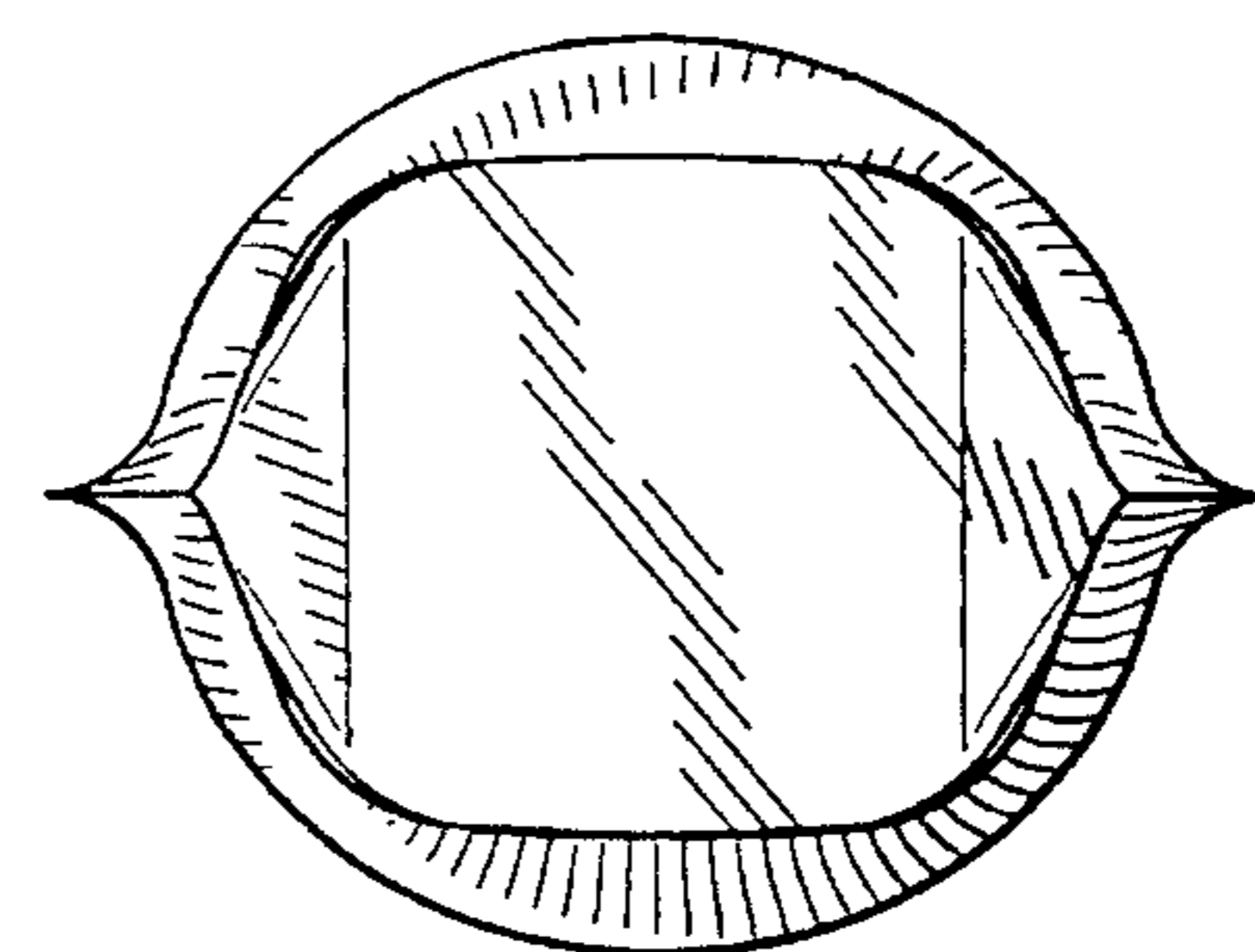

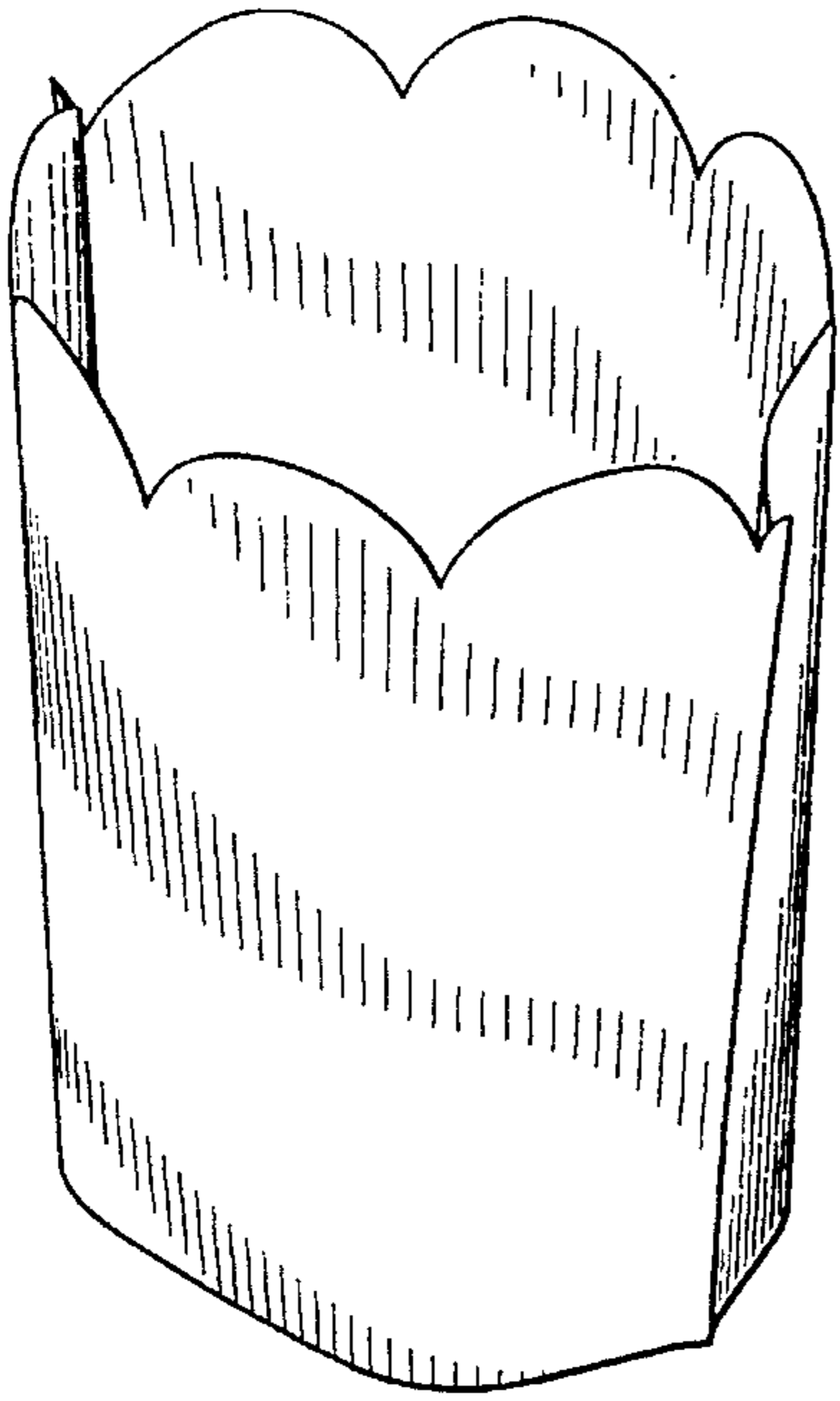

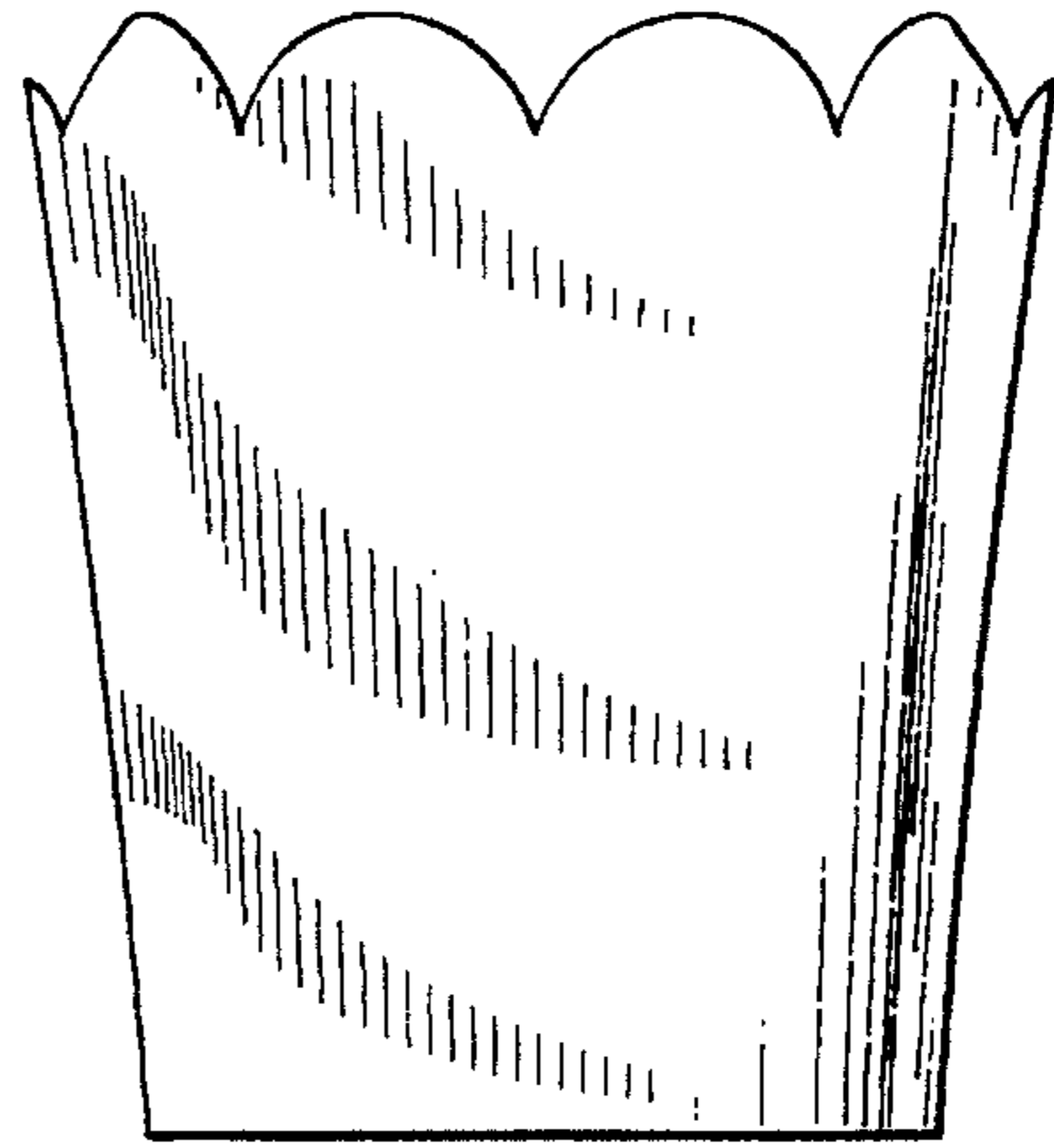

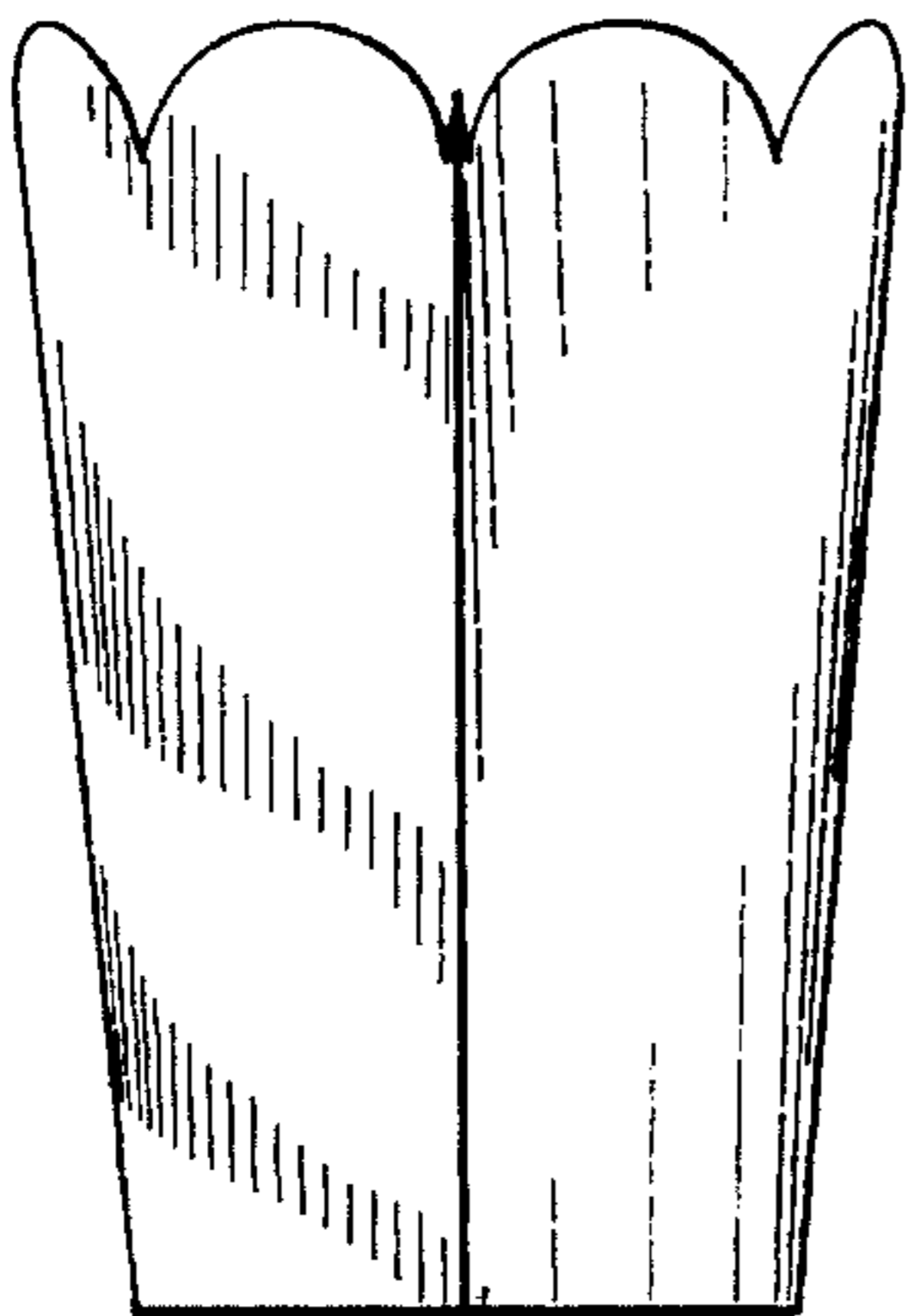

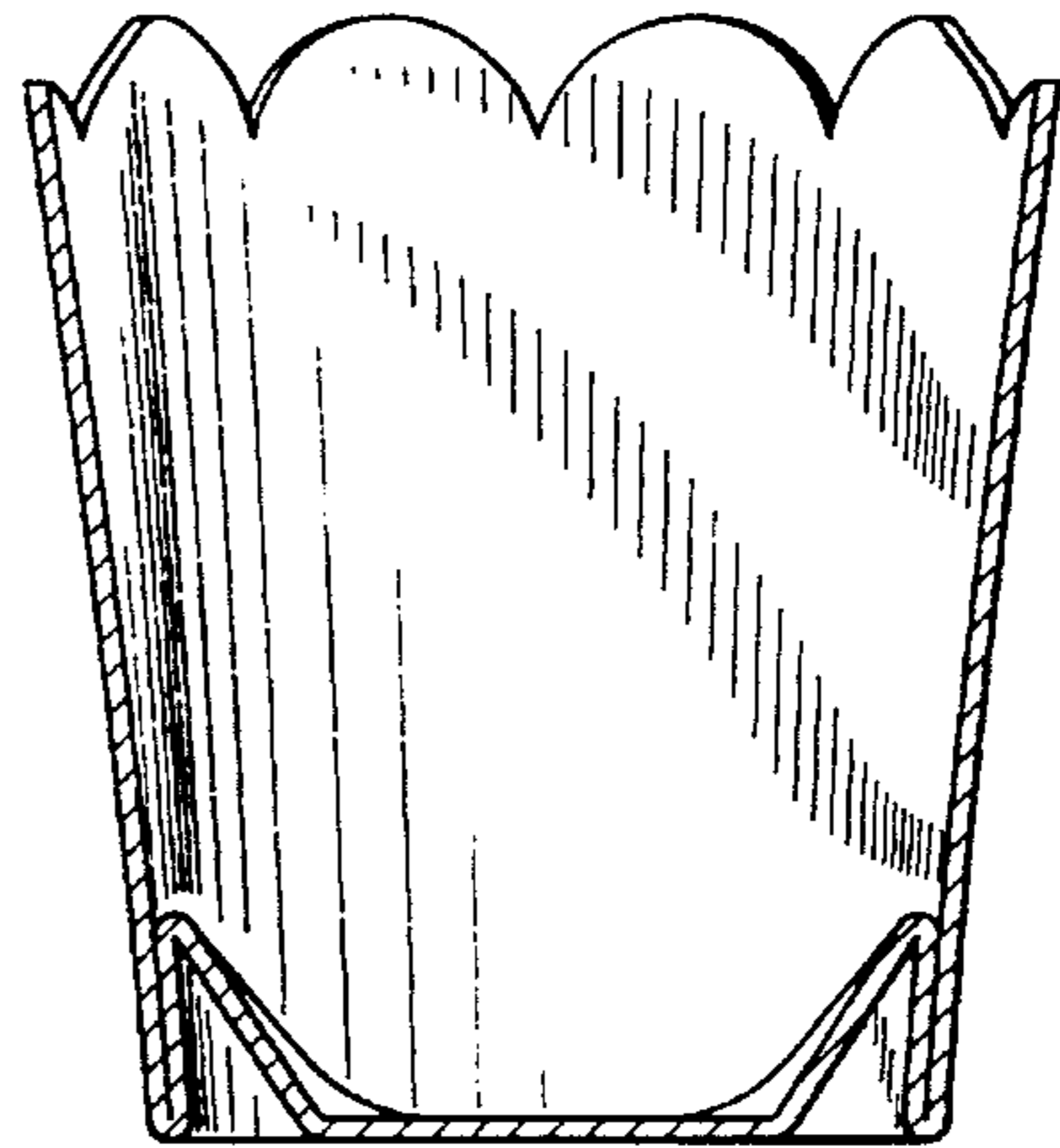

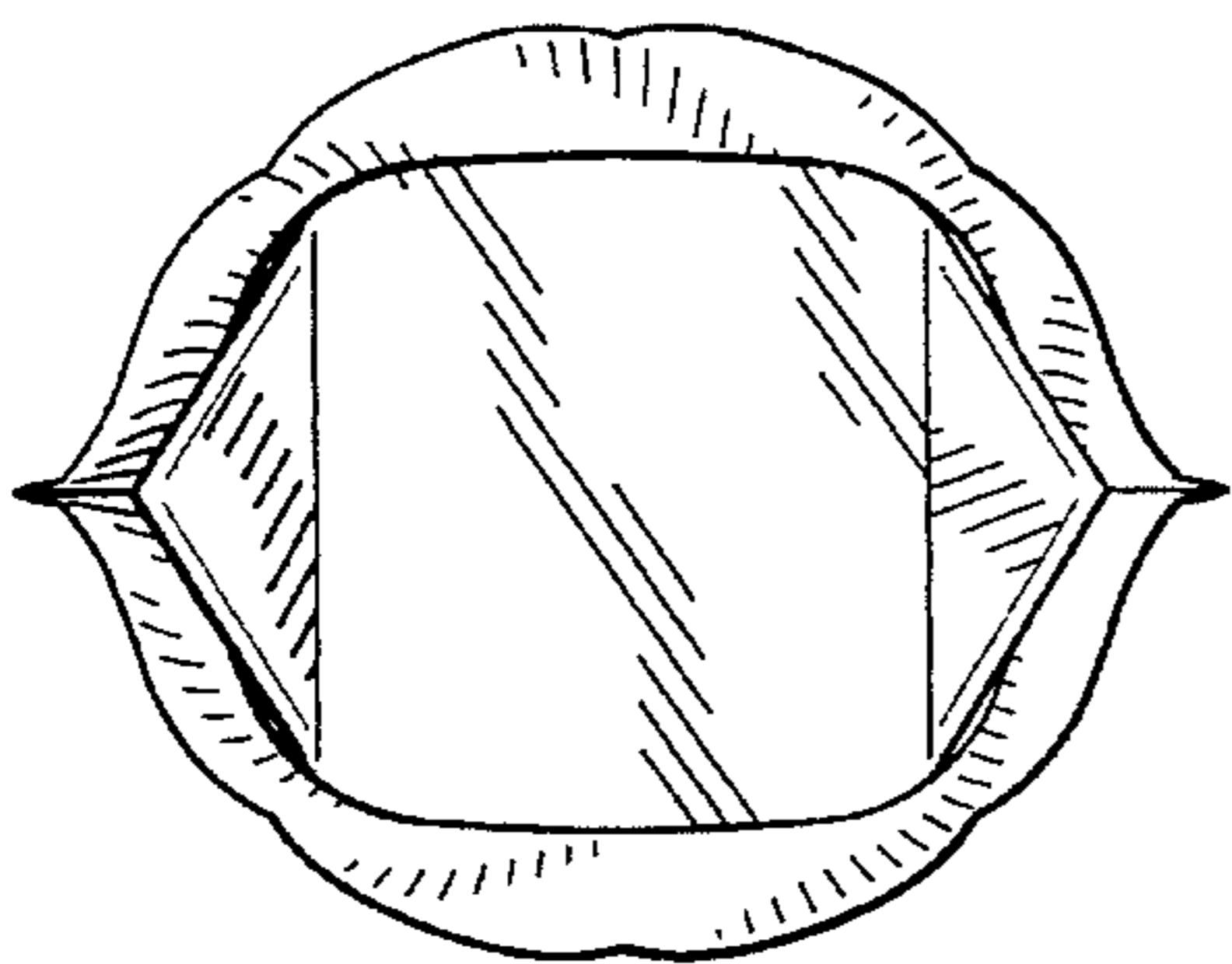

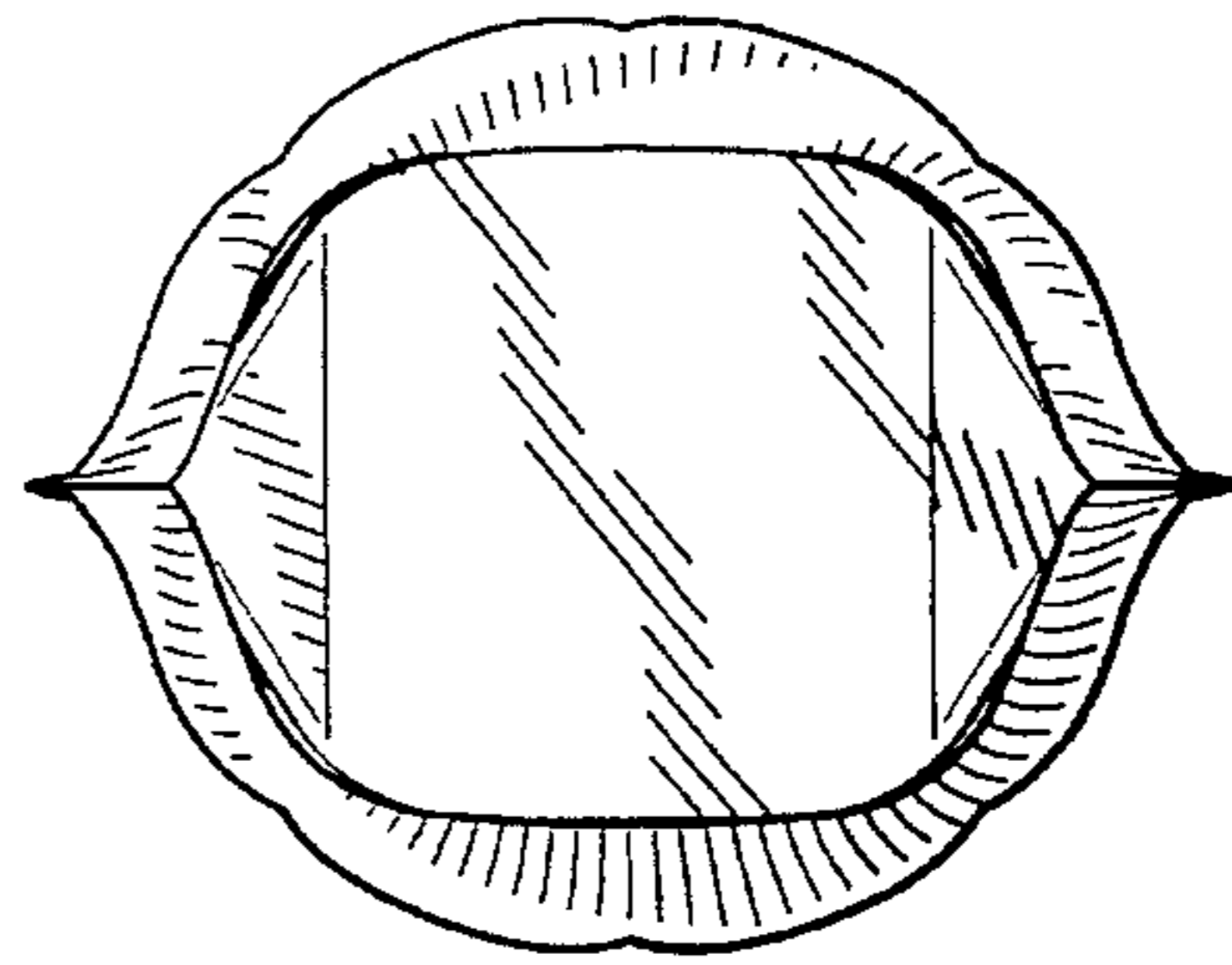

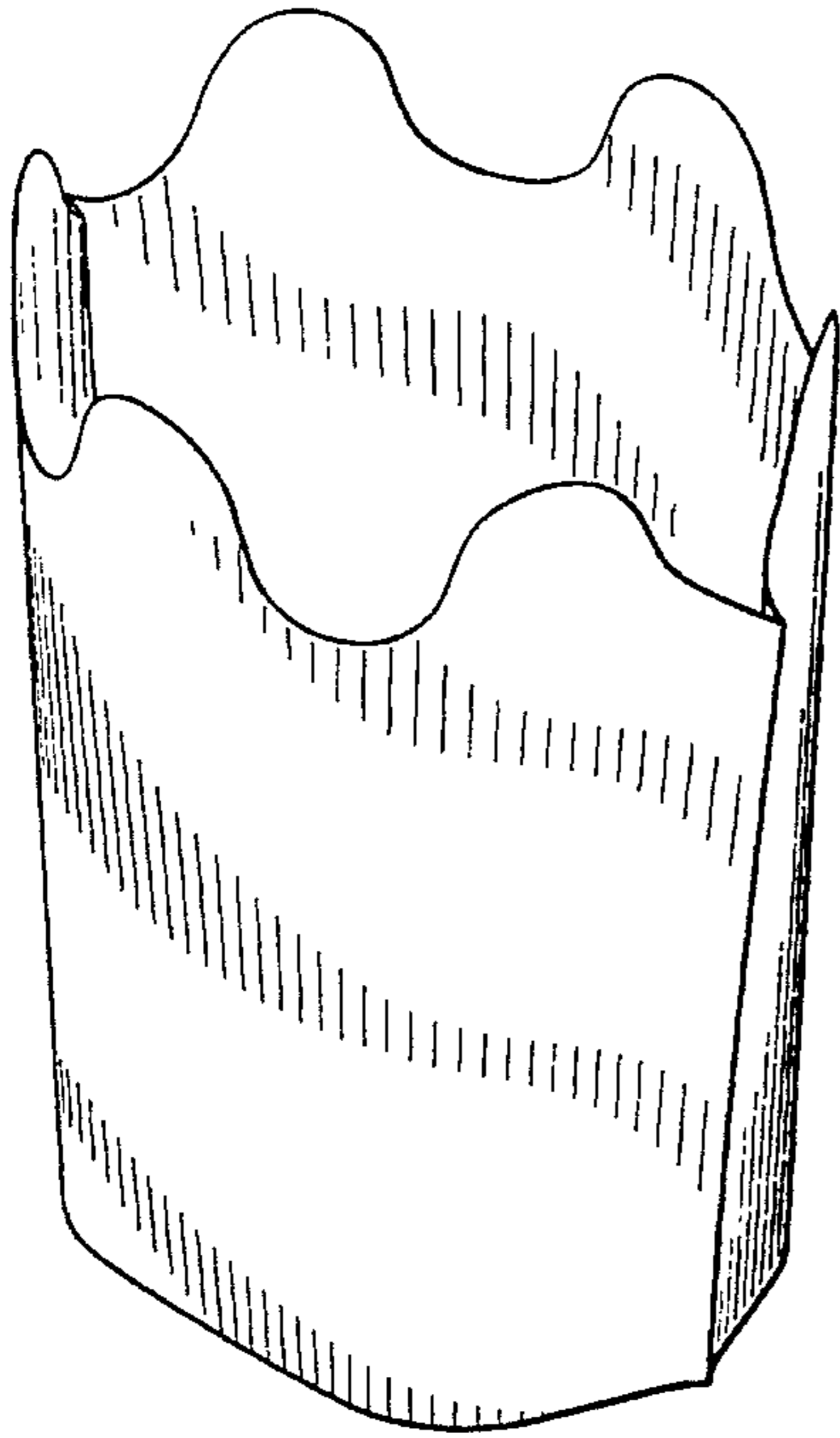

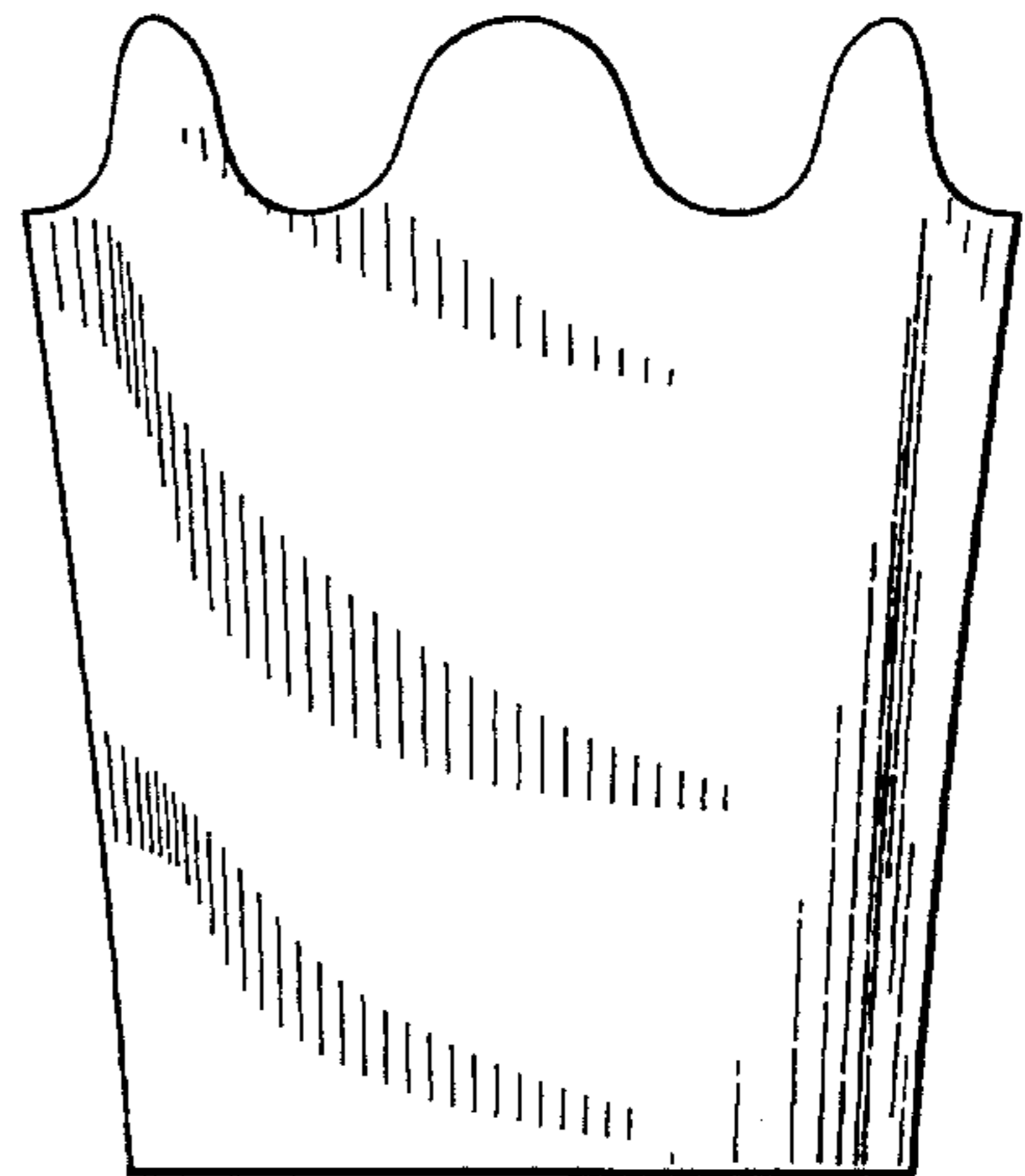

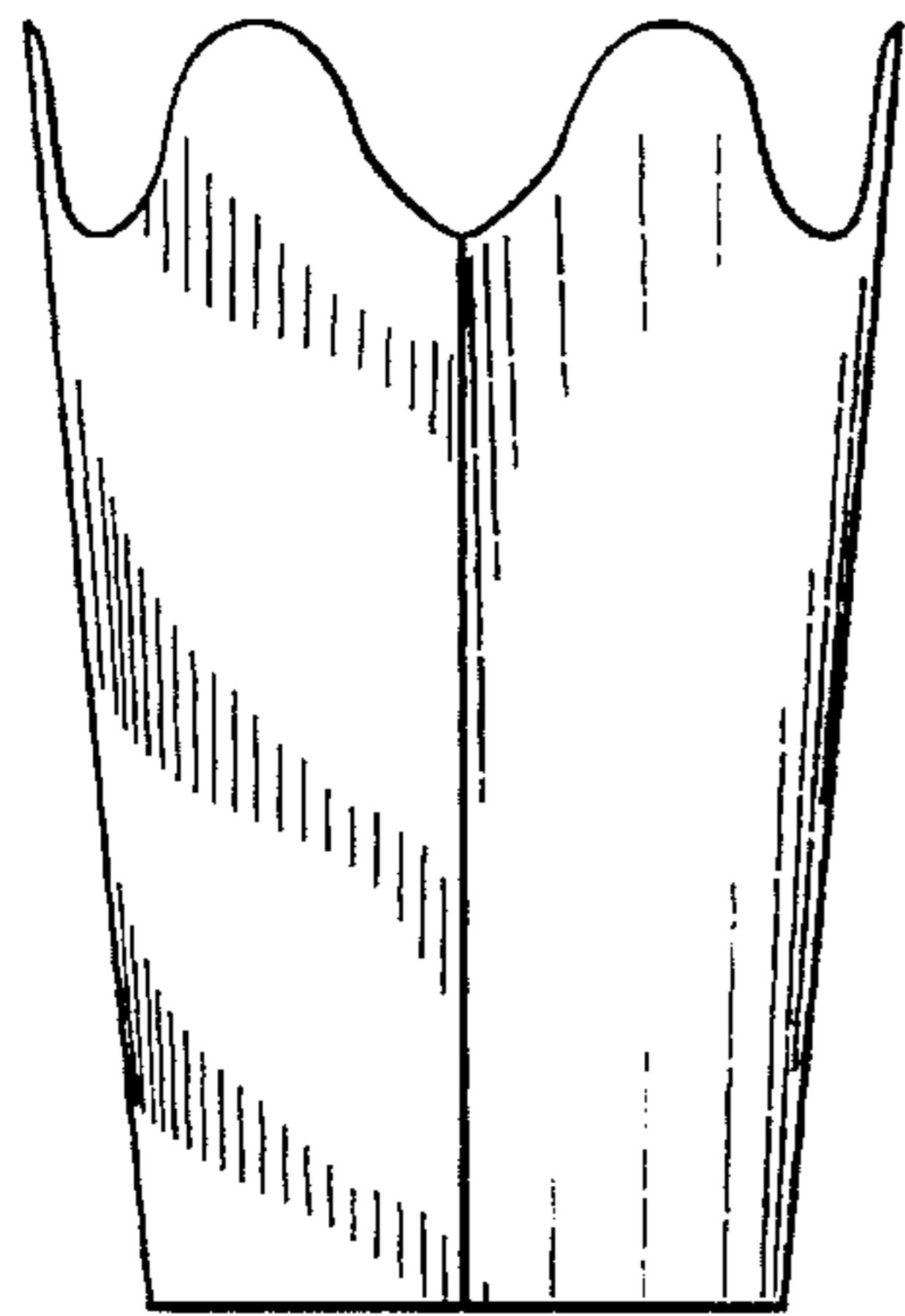

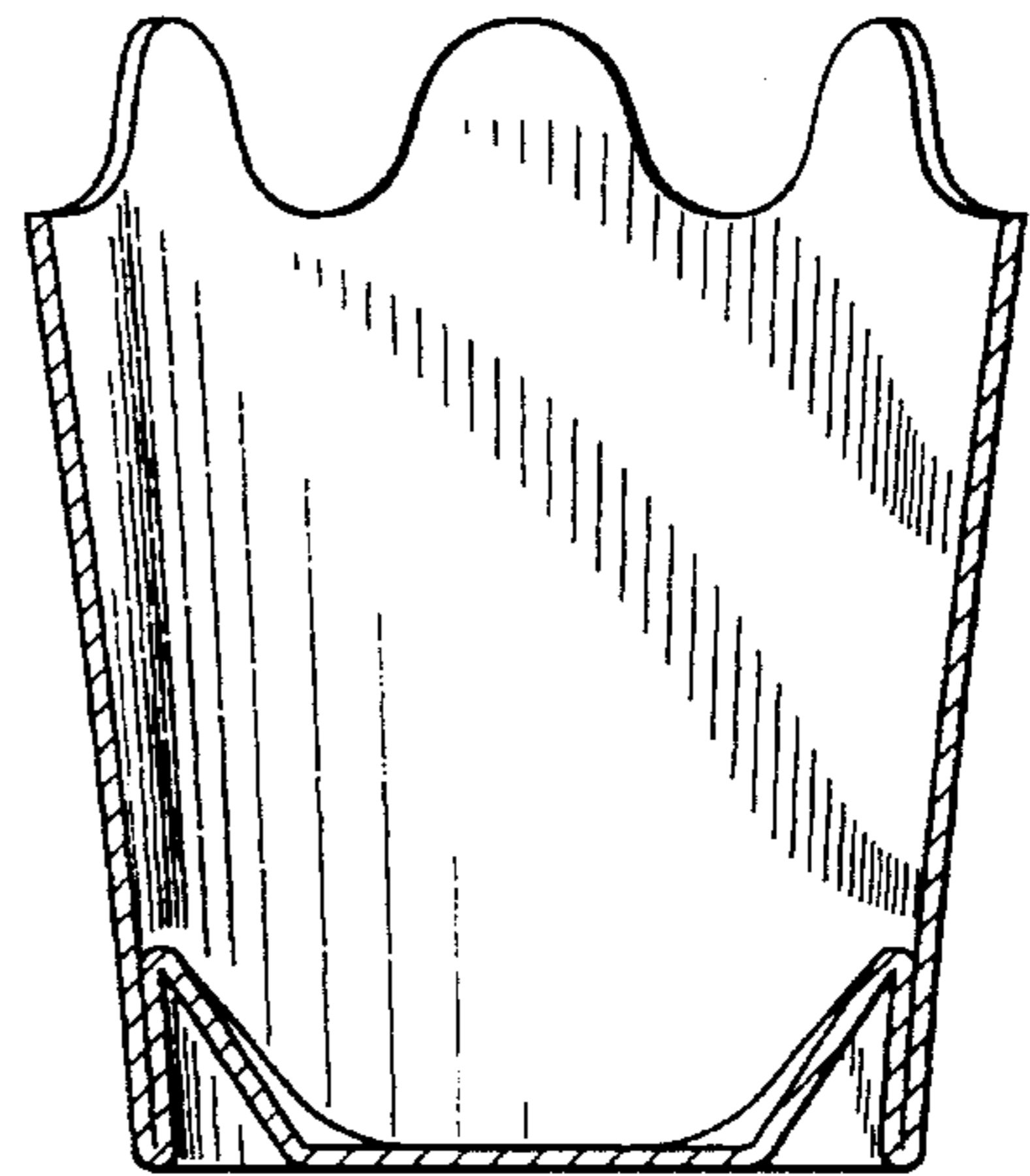

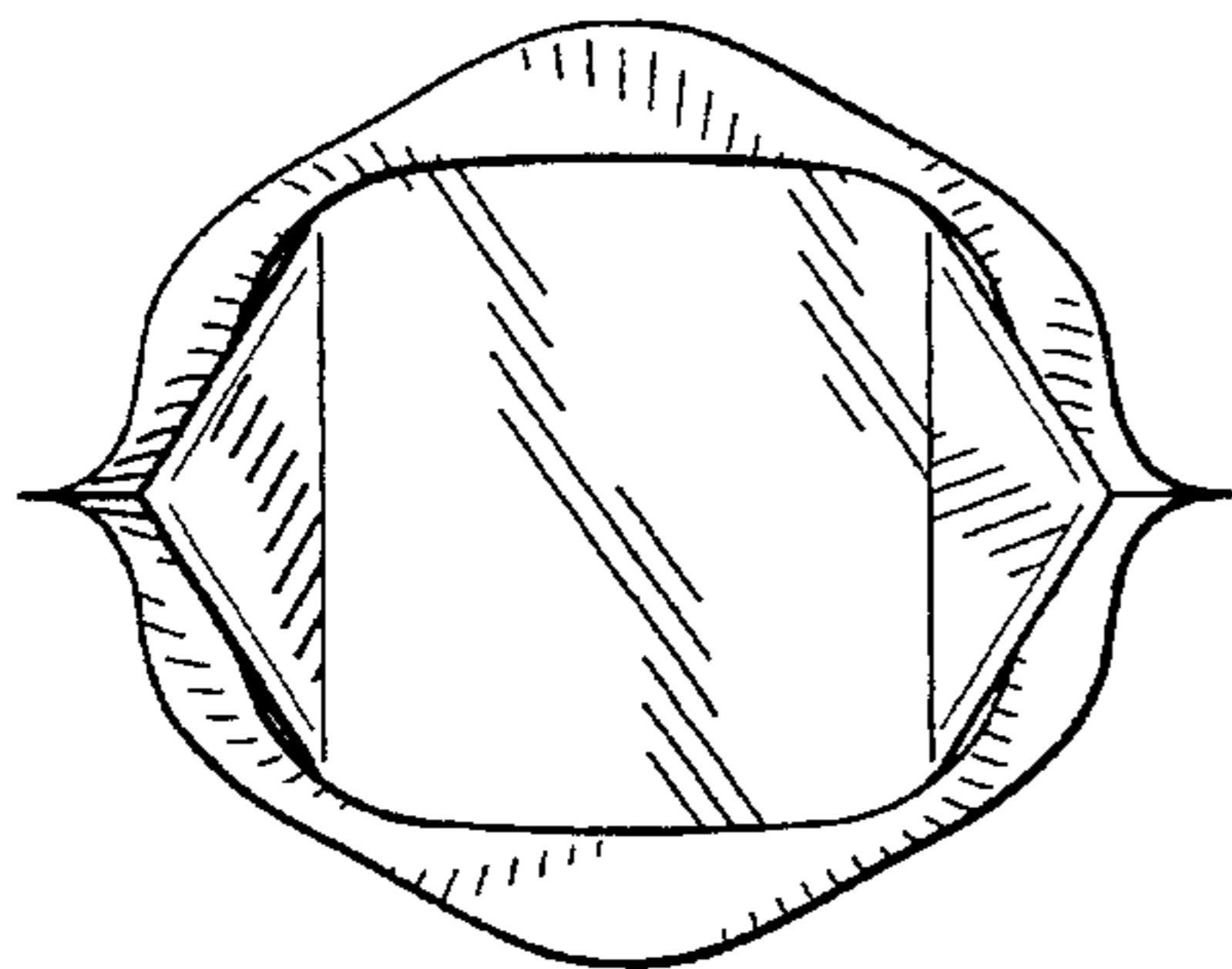

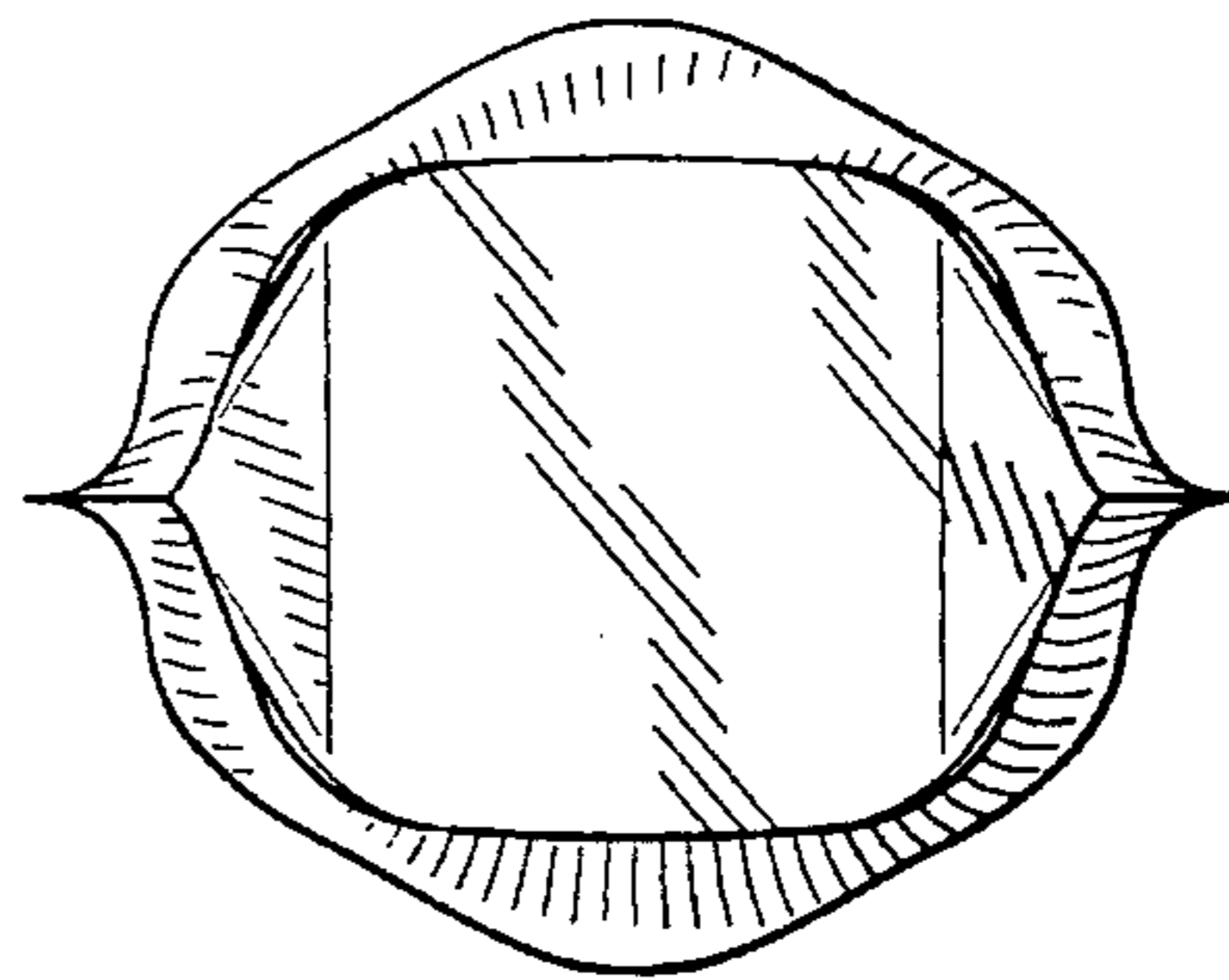

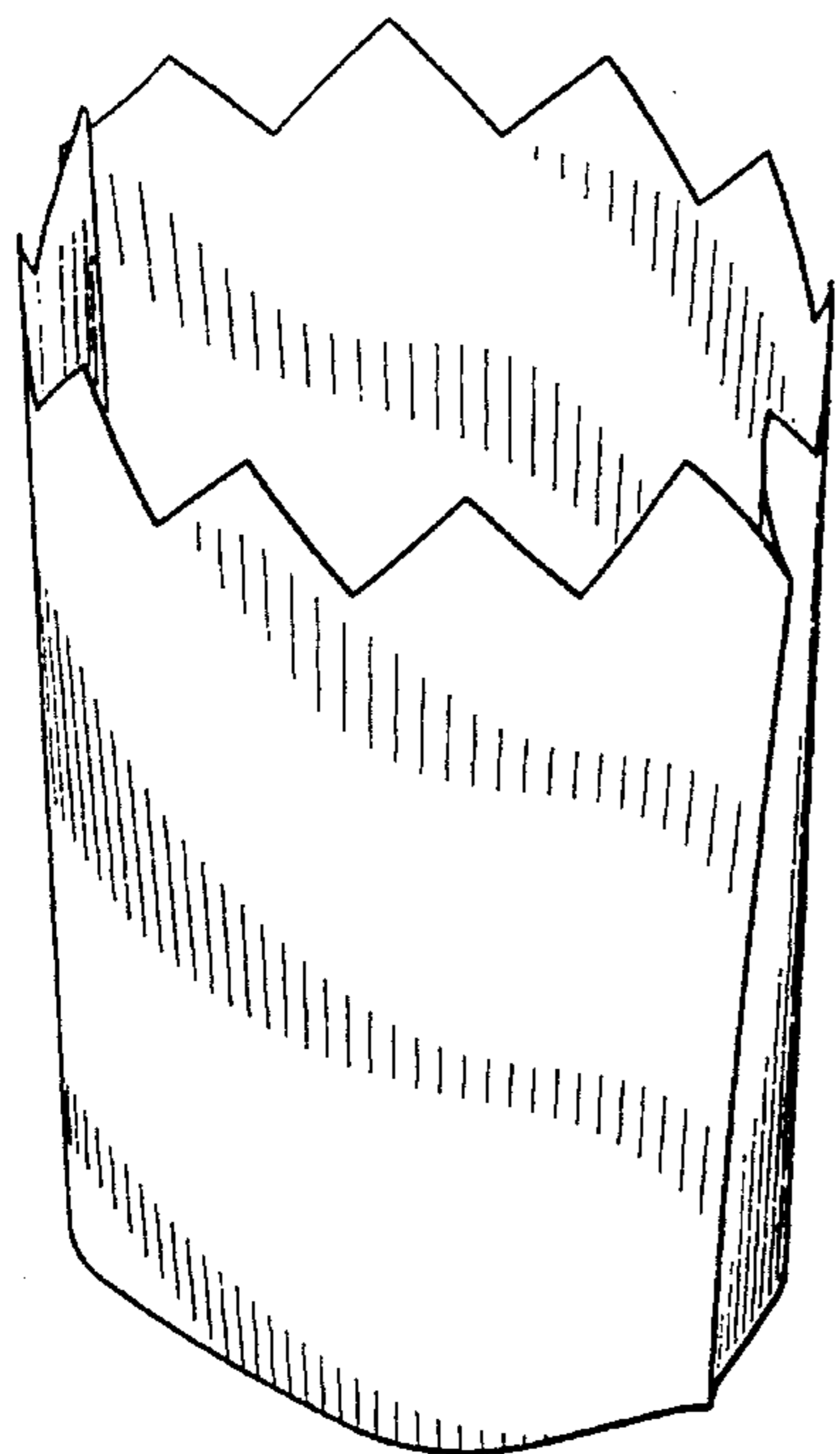

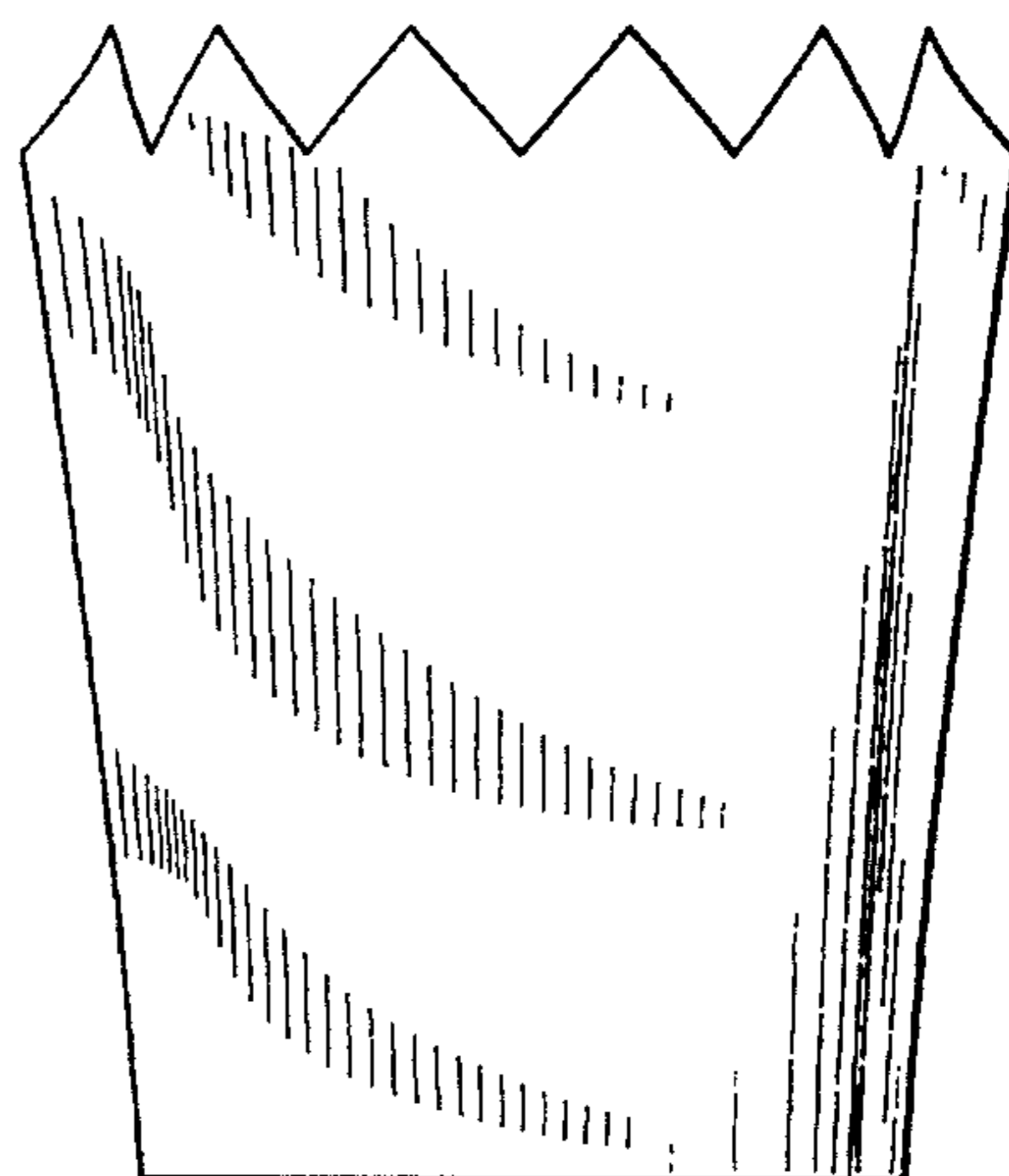

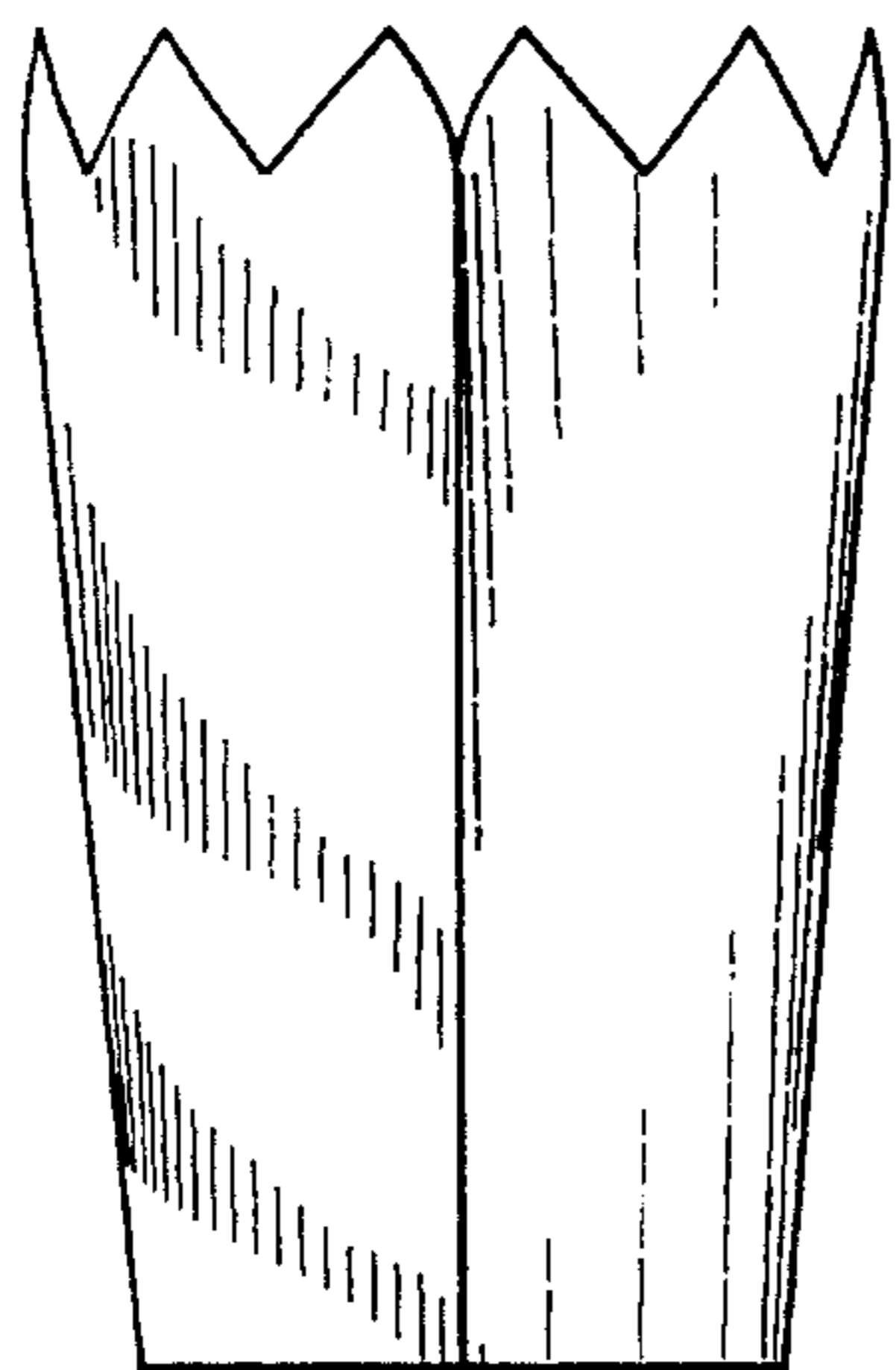

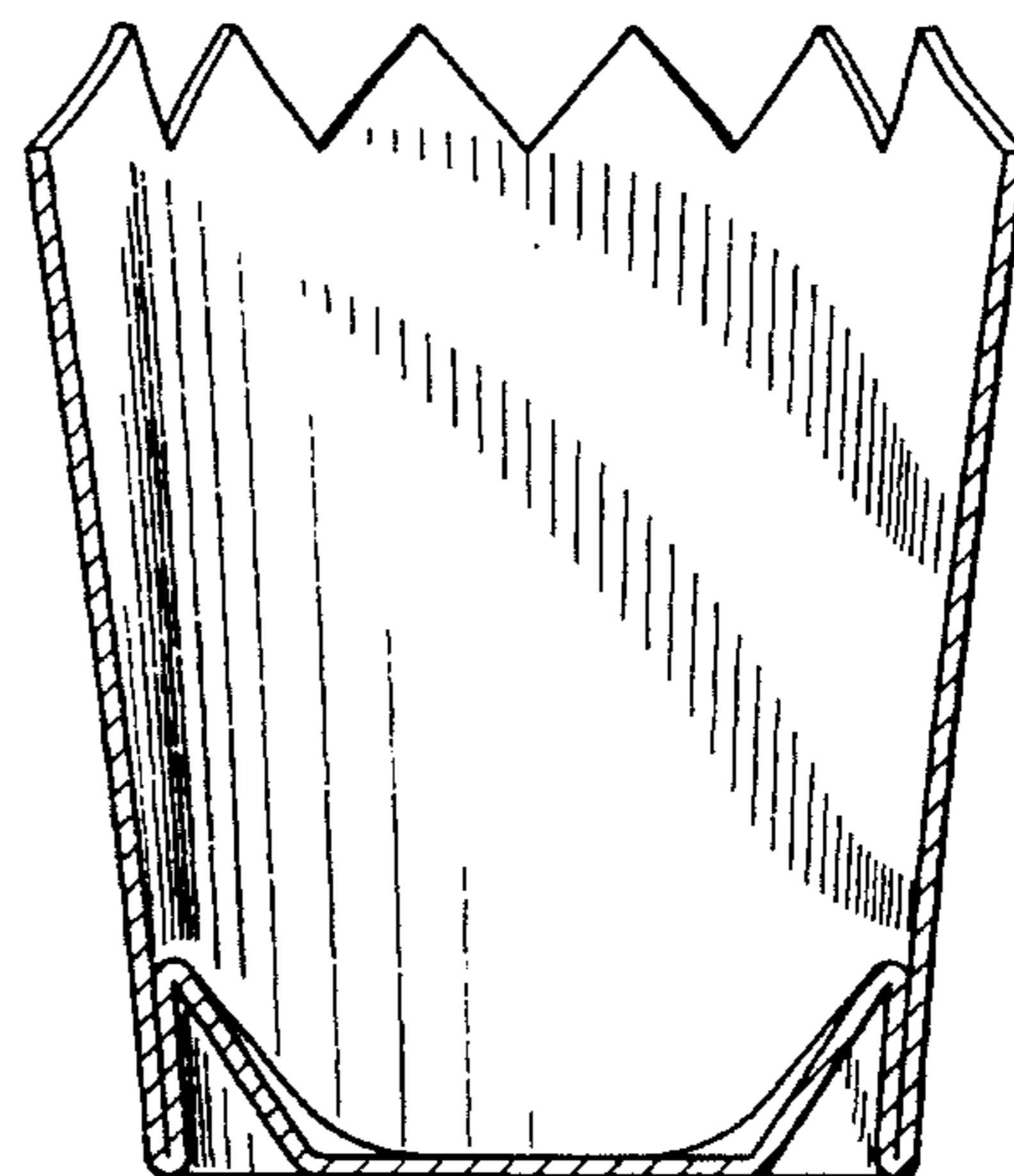

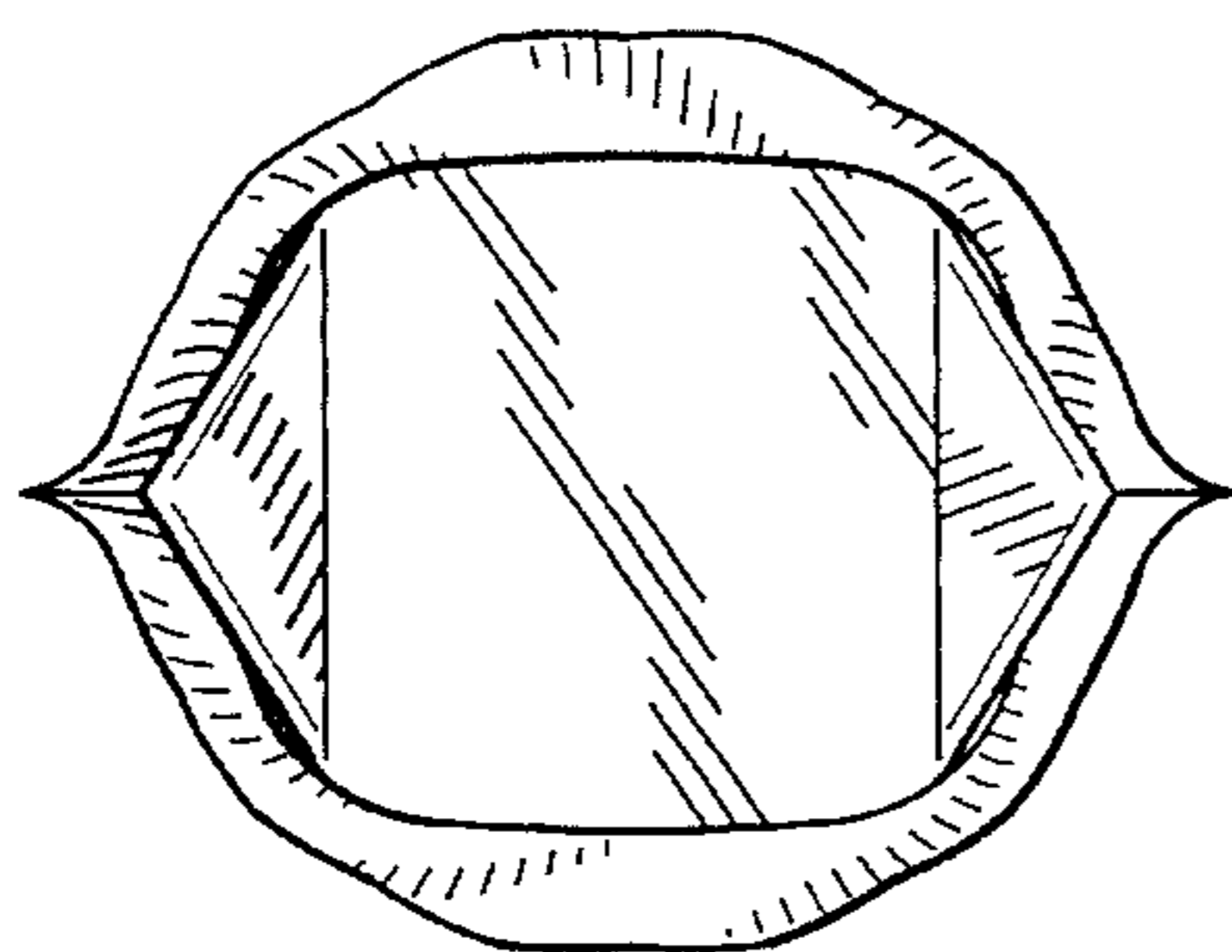

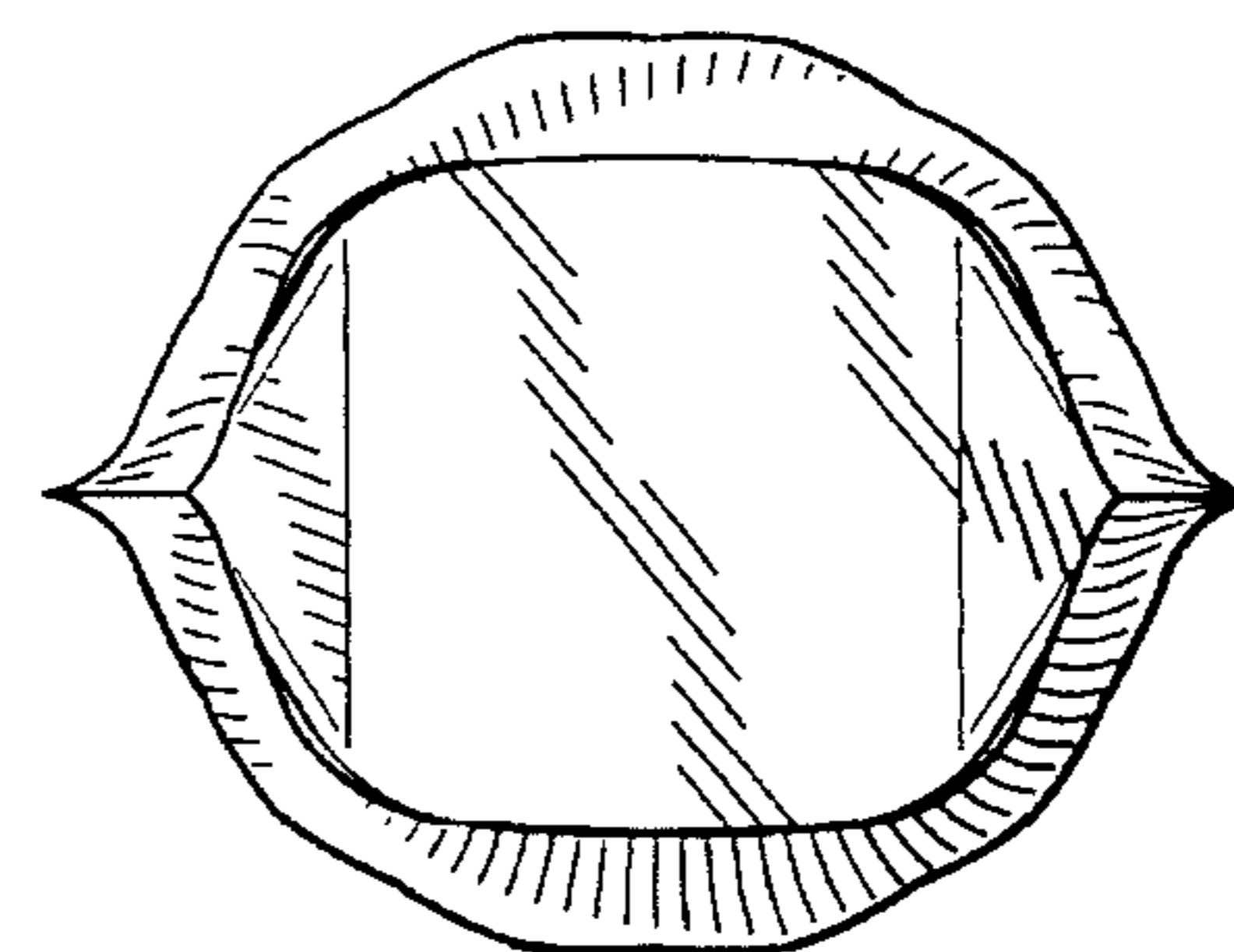
