FIG. 2 is a right side perspective view;

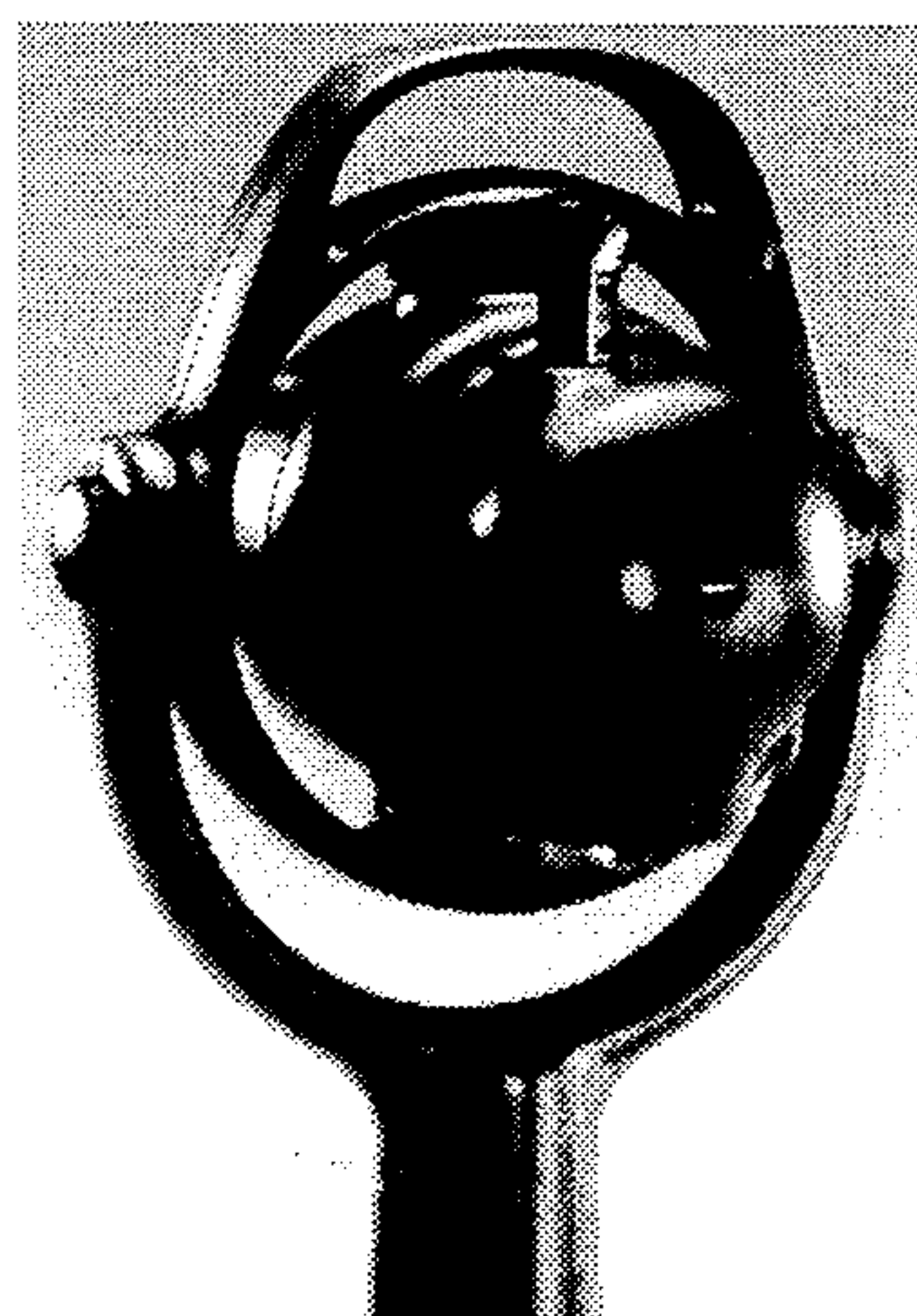
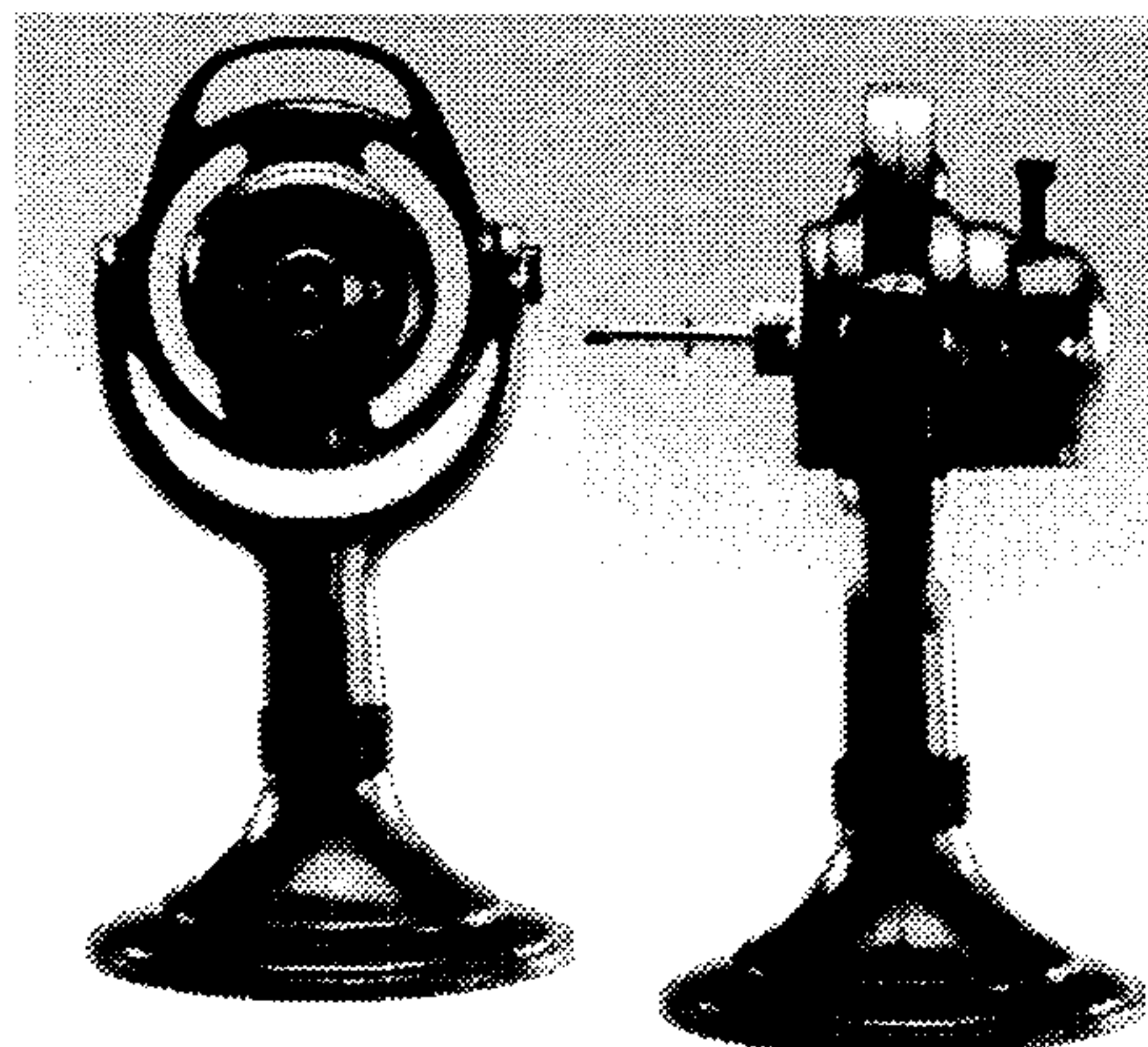
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view;

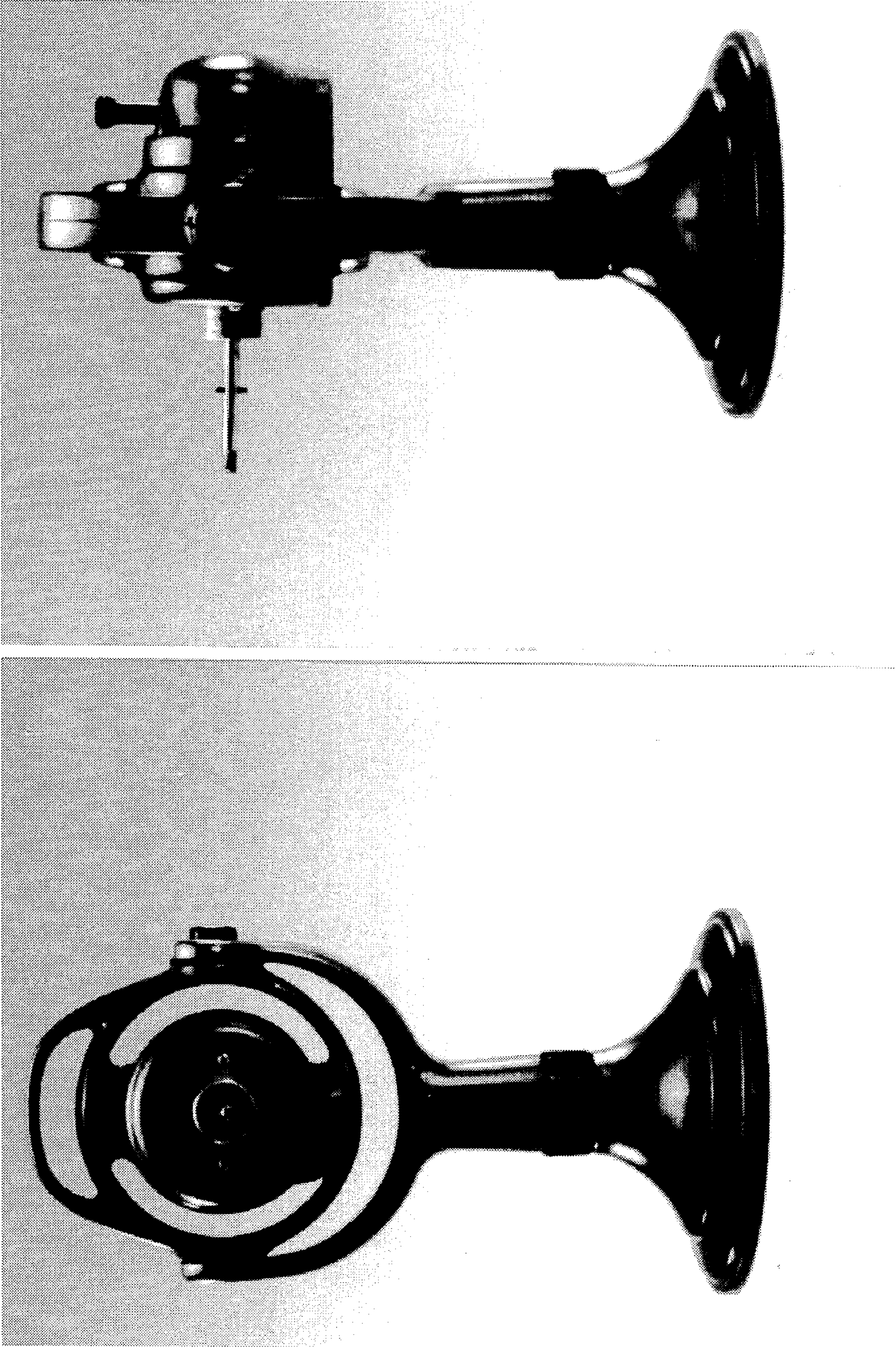

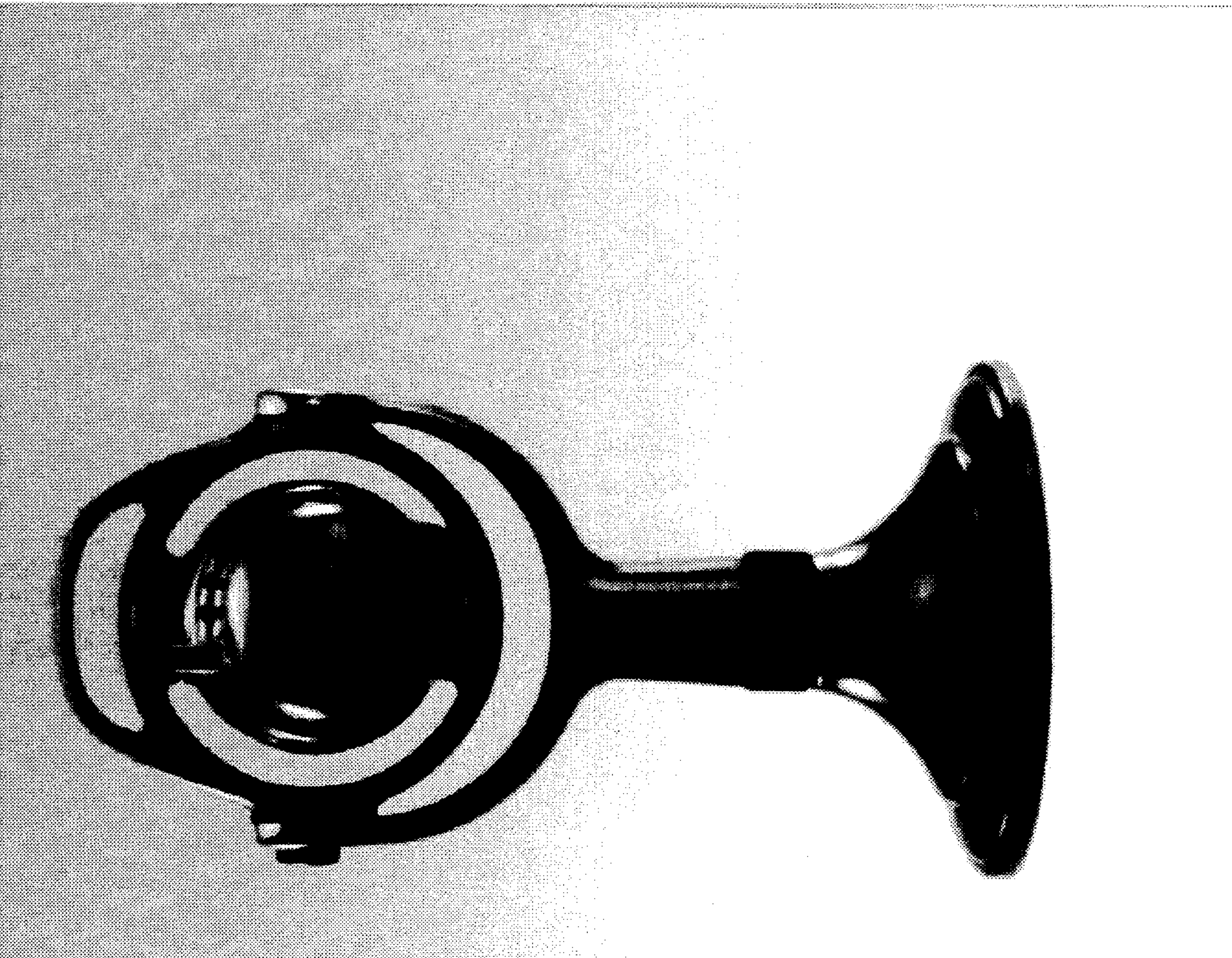

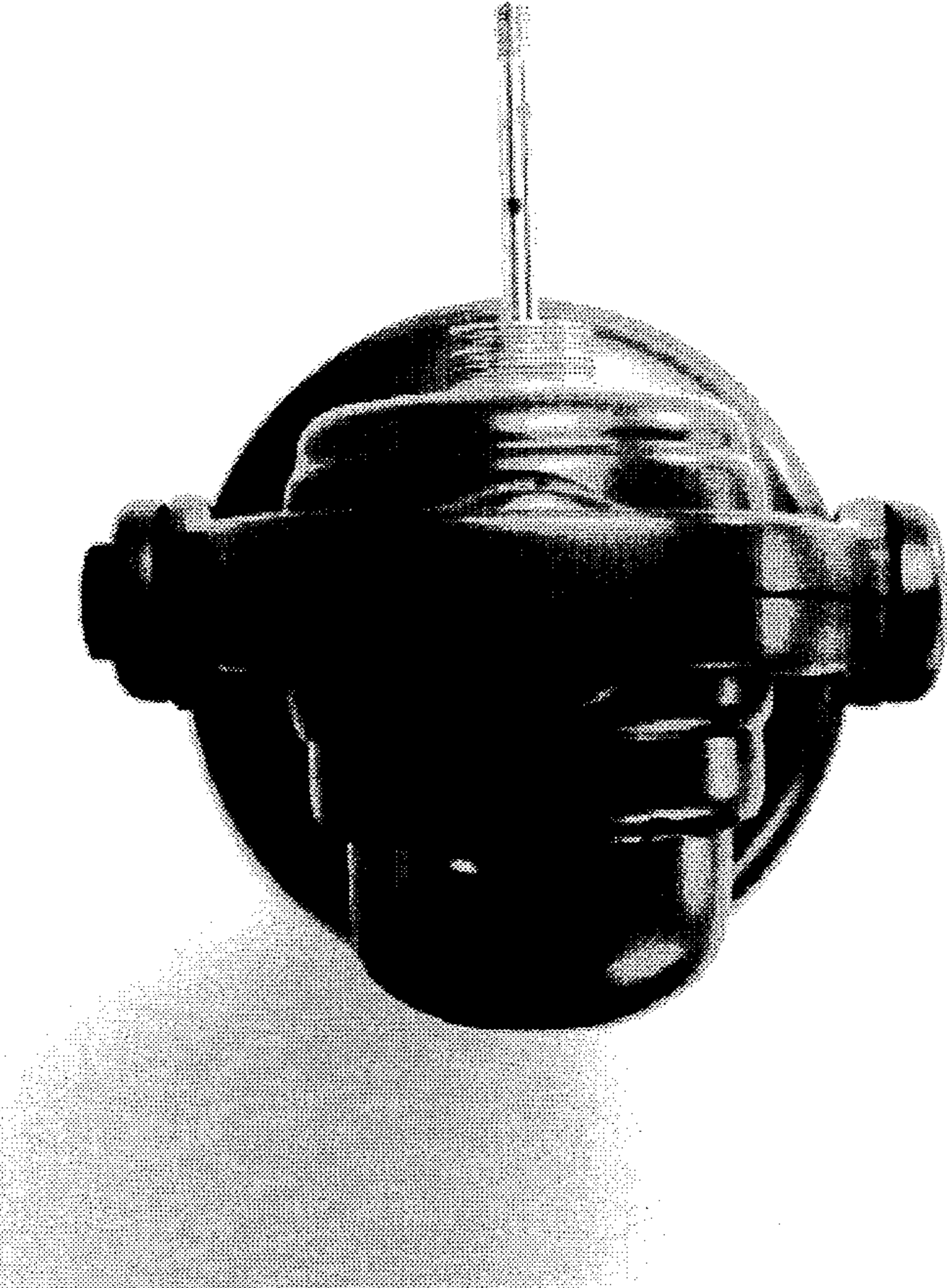

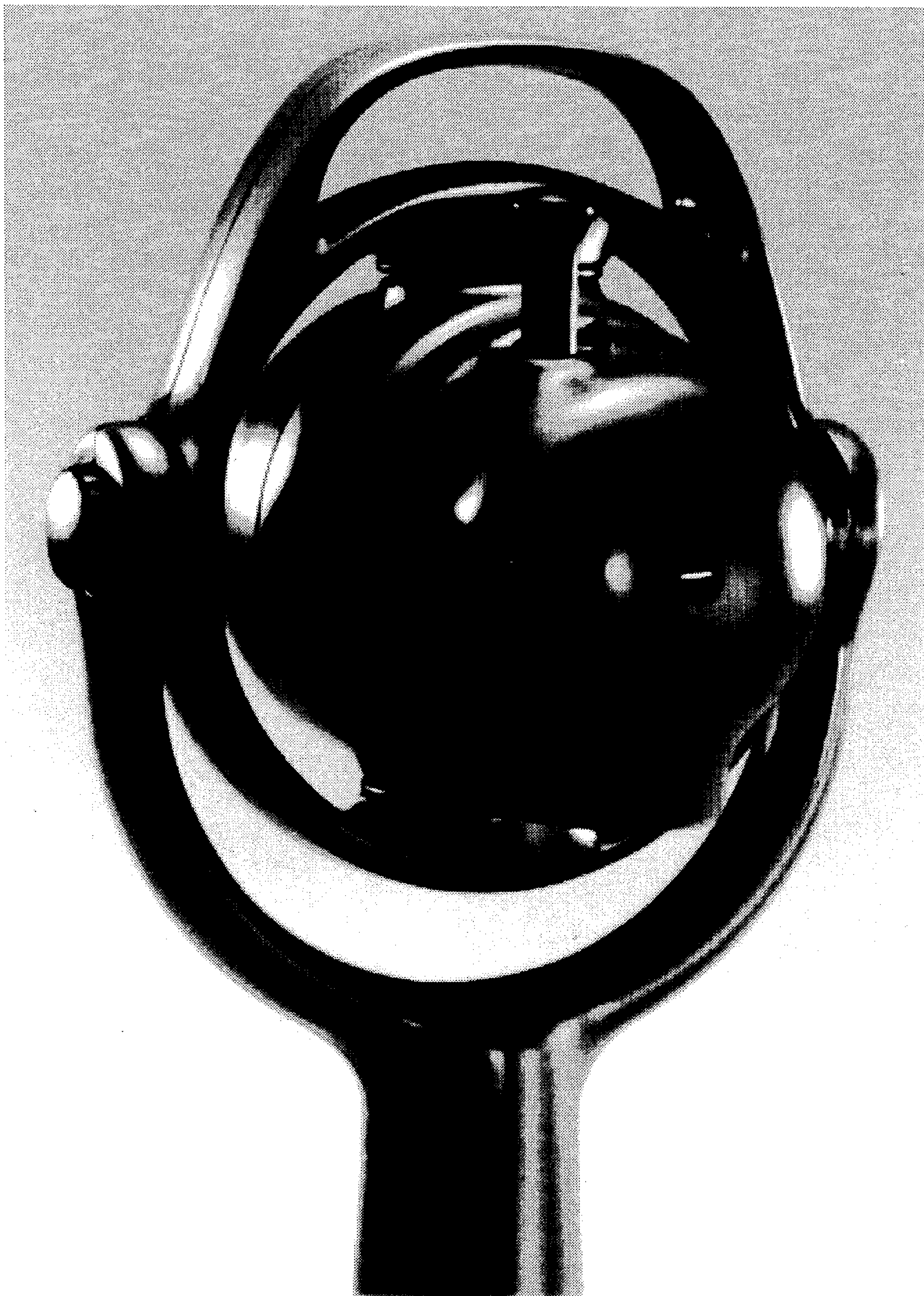
