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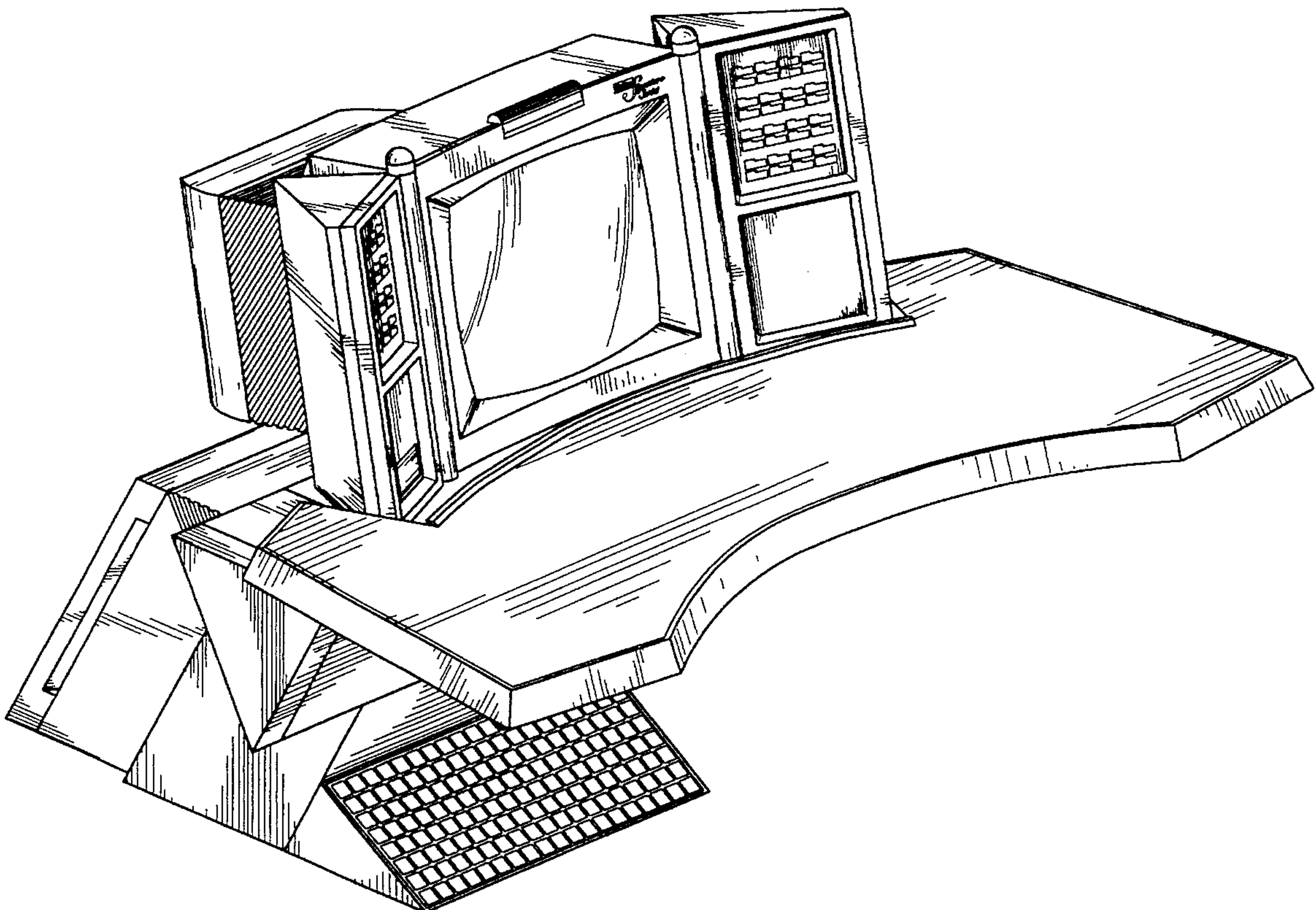

The ornamental design for an operator interface workstation, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left front top perspective view of the operator interface workstation of the present invention; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of the FIG. 1 station, the right side elevational view thereof being identical to the left side elevational view; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the FIG. 1 workstation; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the FIG. 1 workstation; FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the FIG. 1 workstation; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the FIG. 1 workstation.

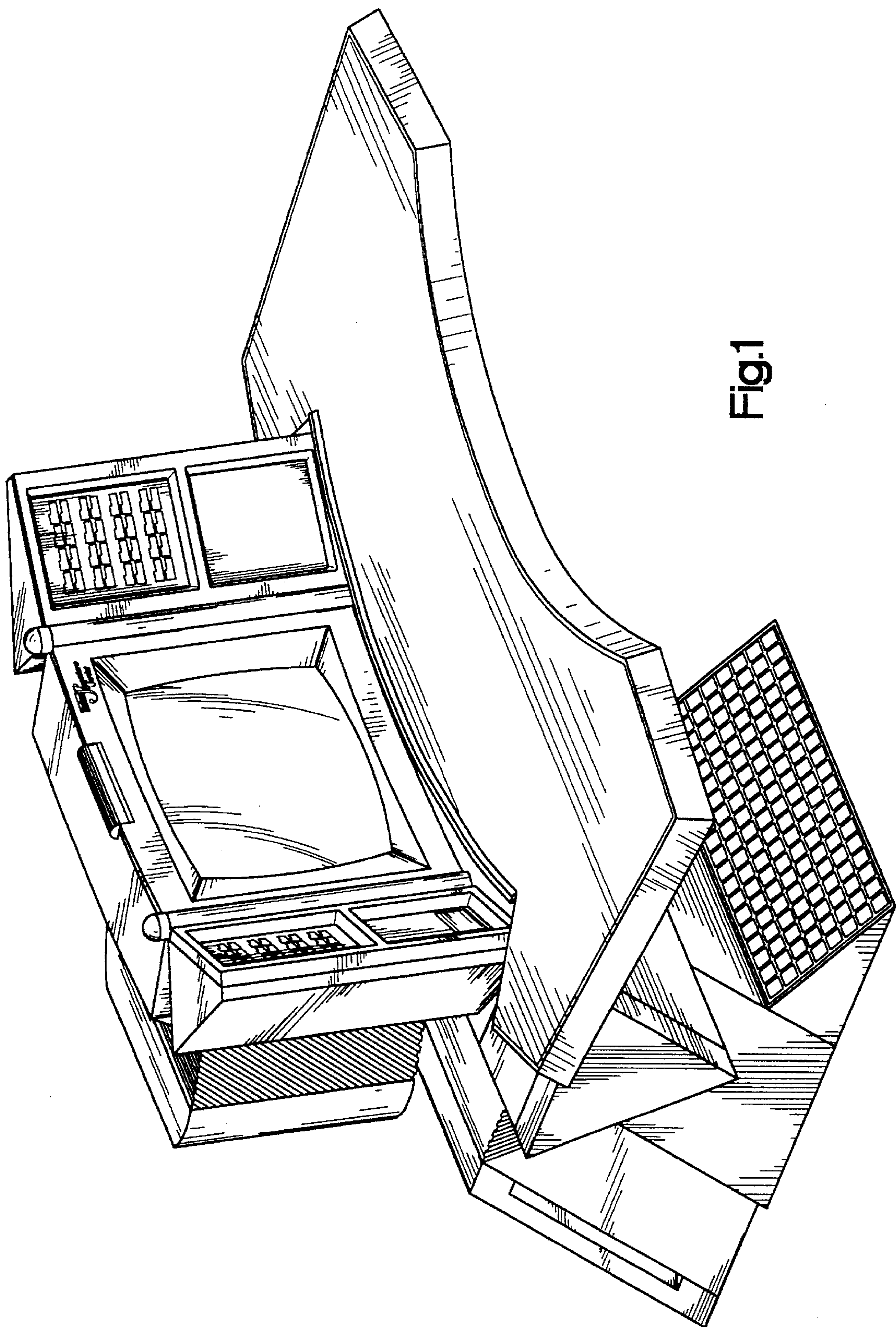

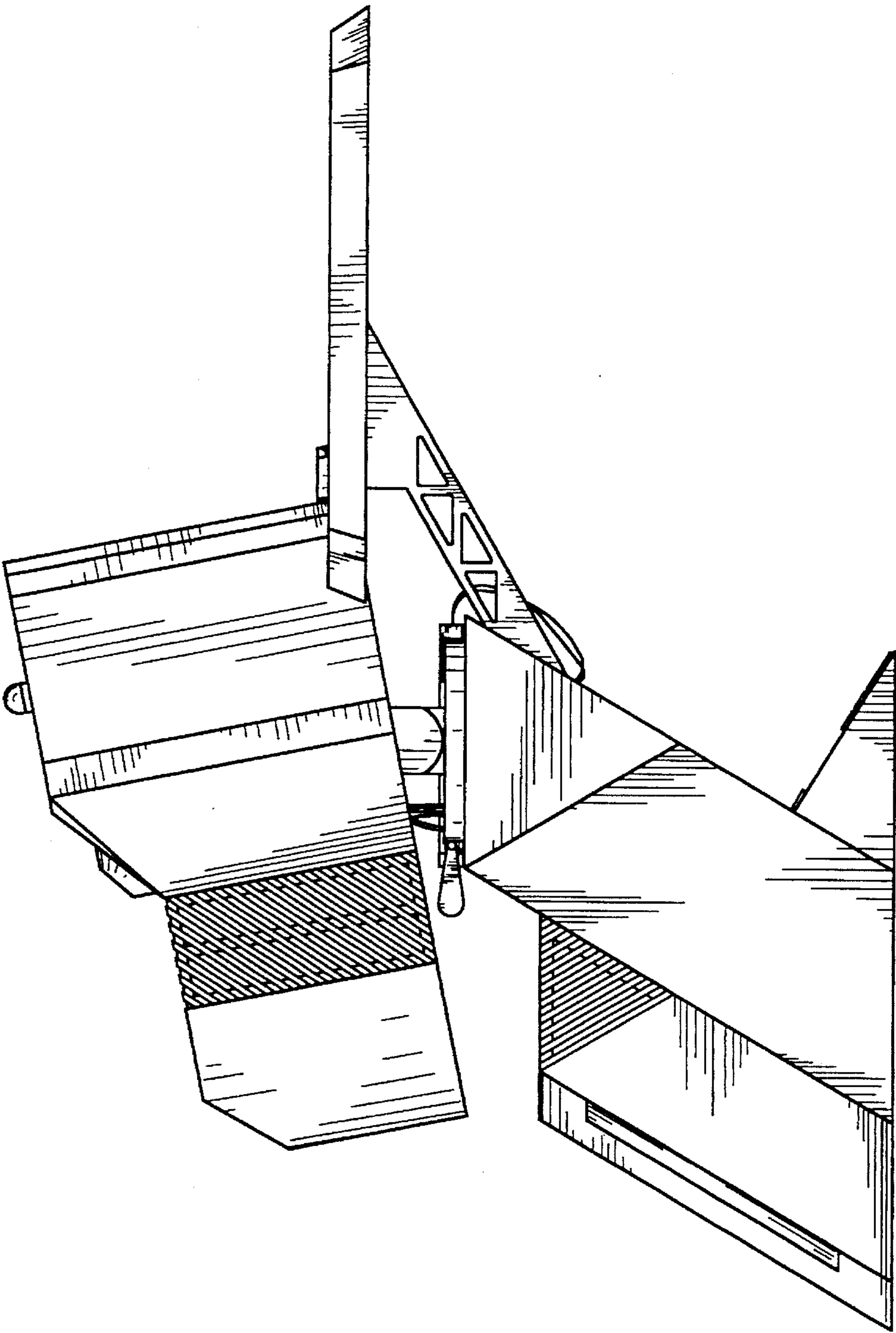

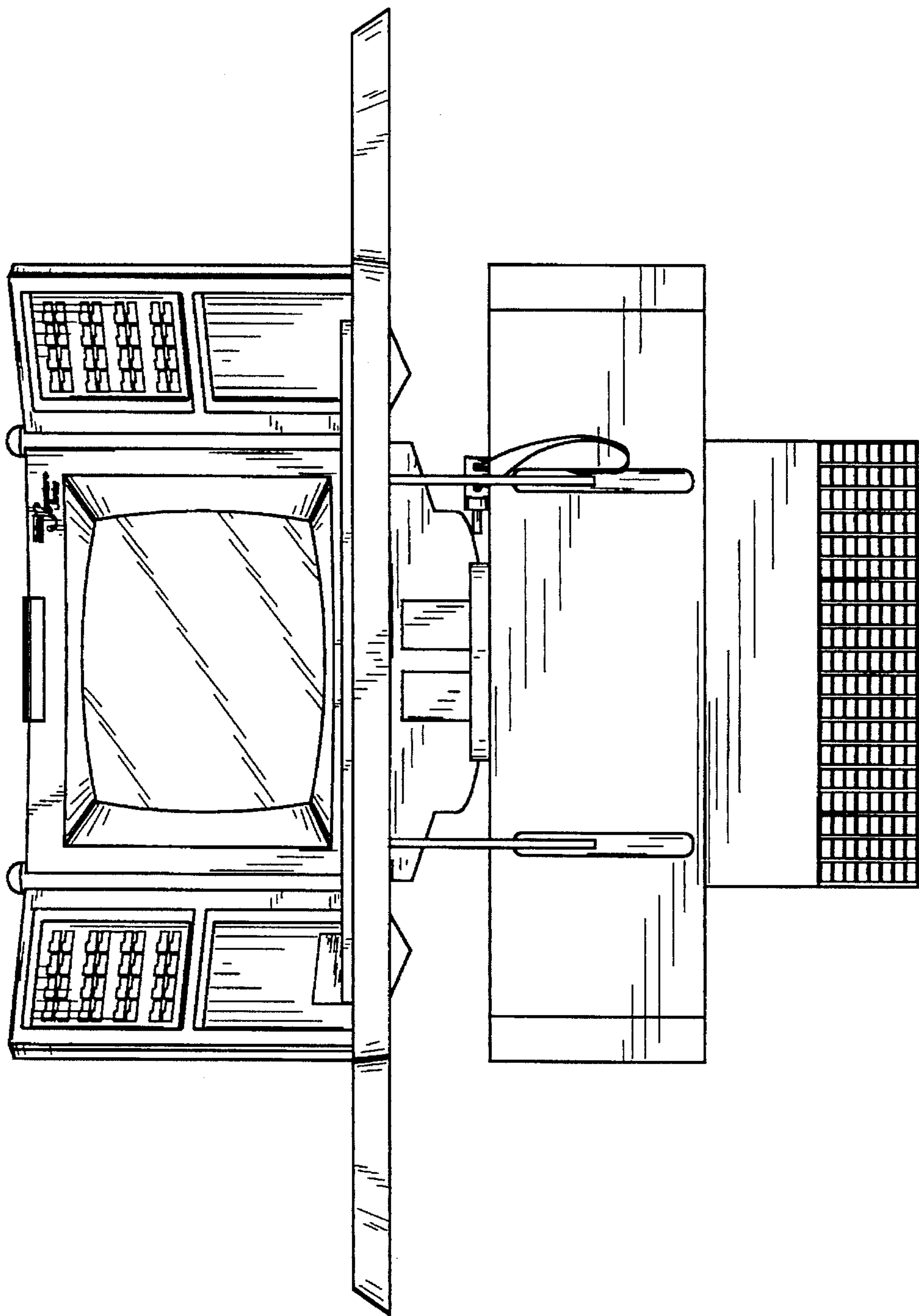

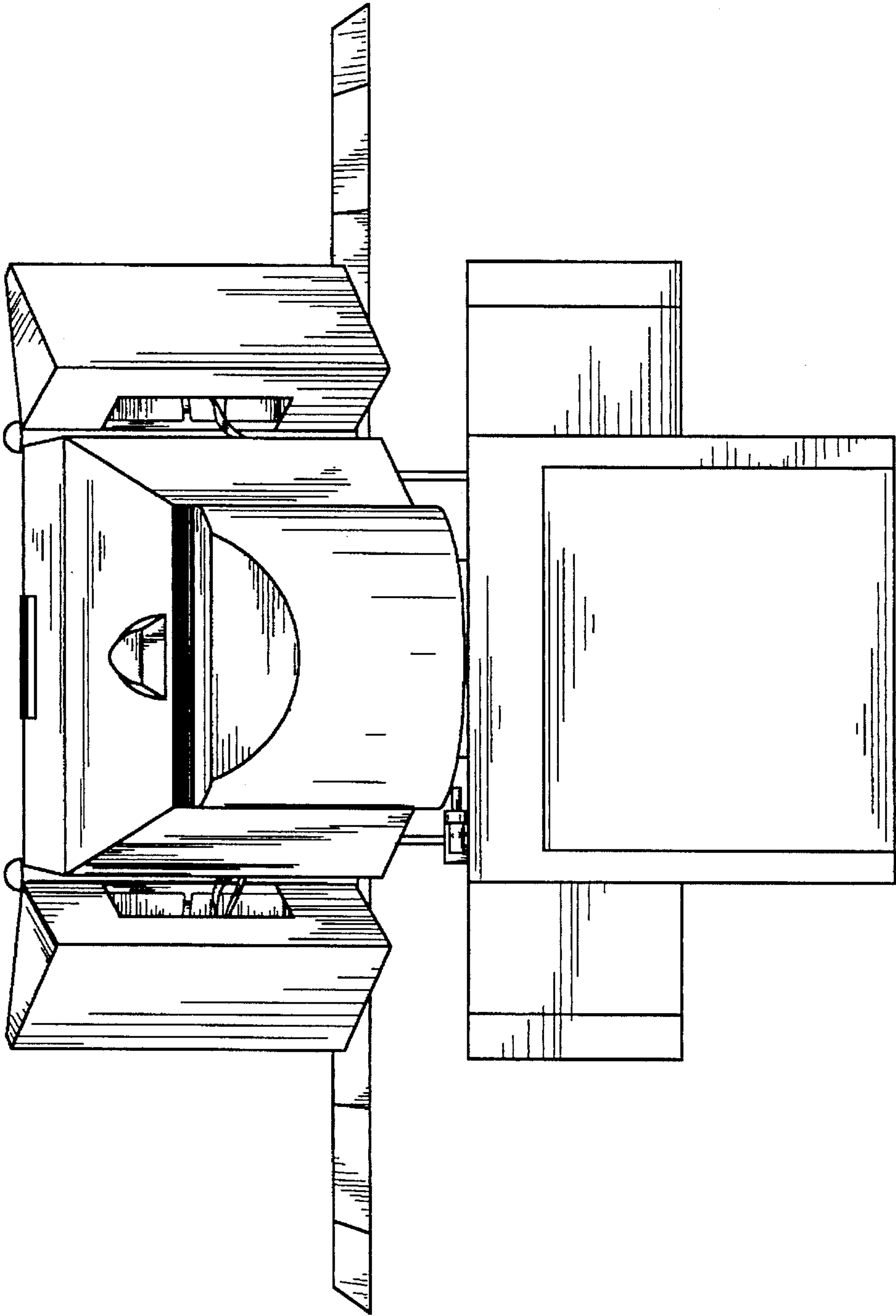

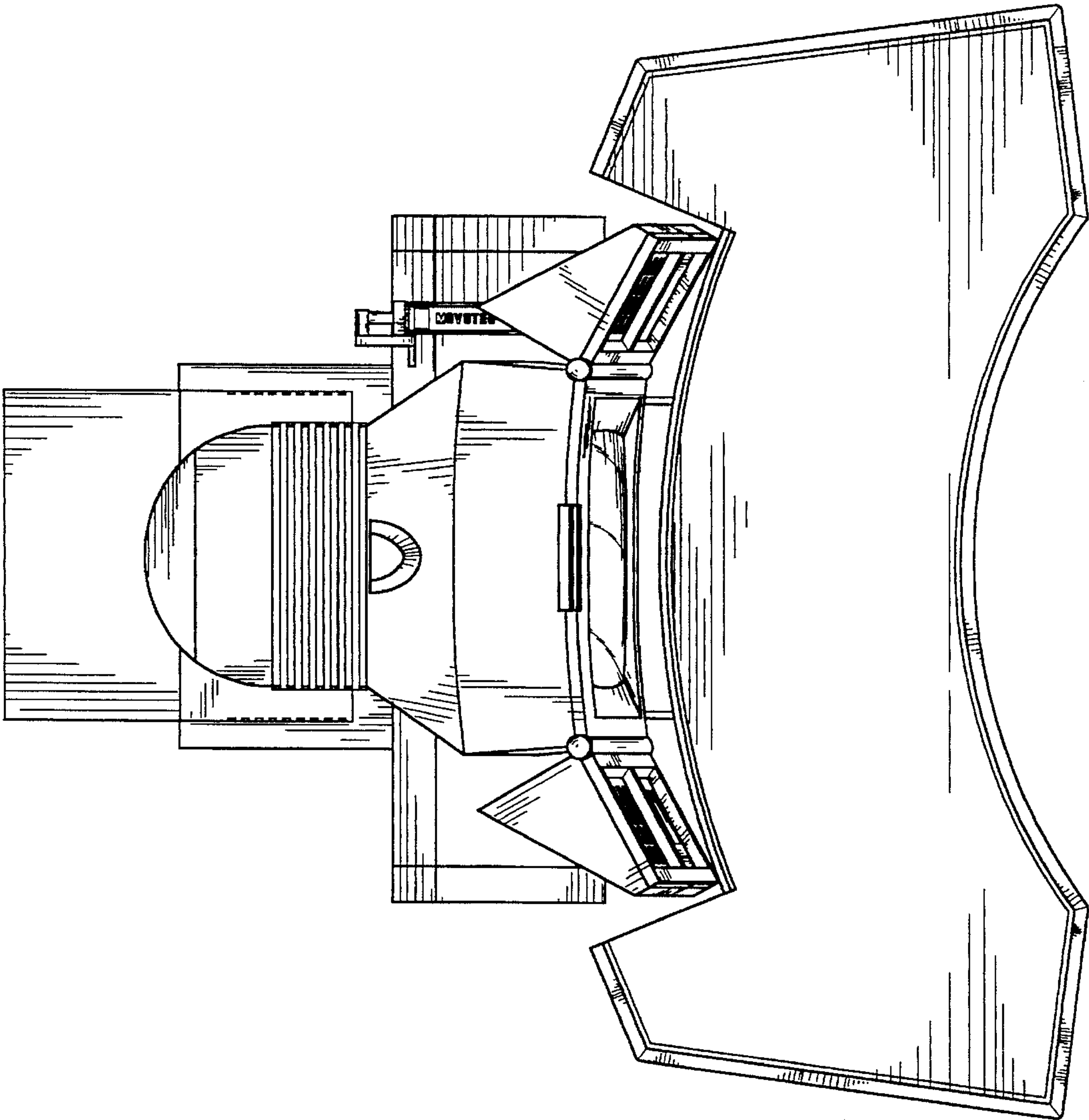

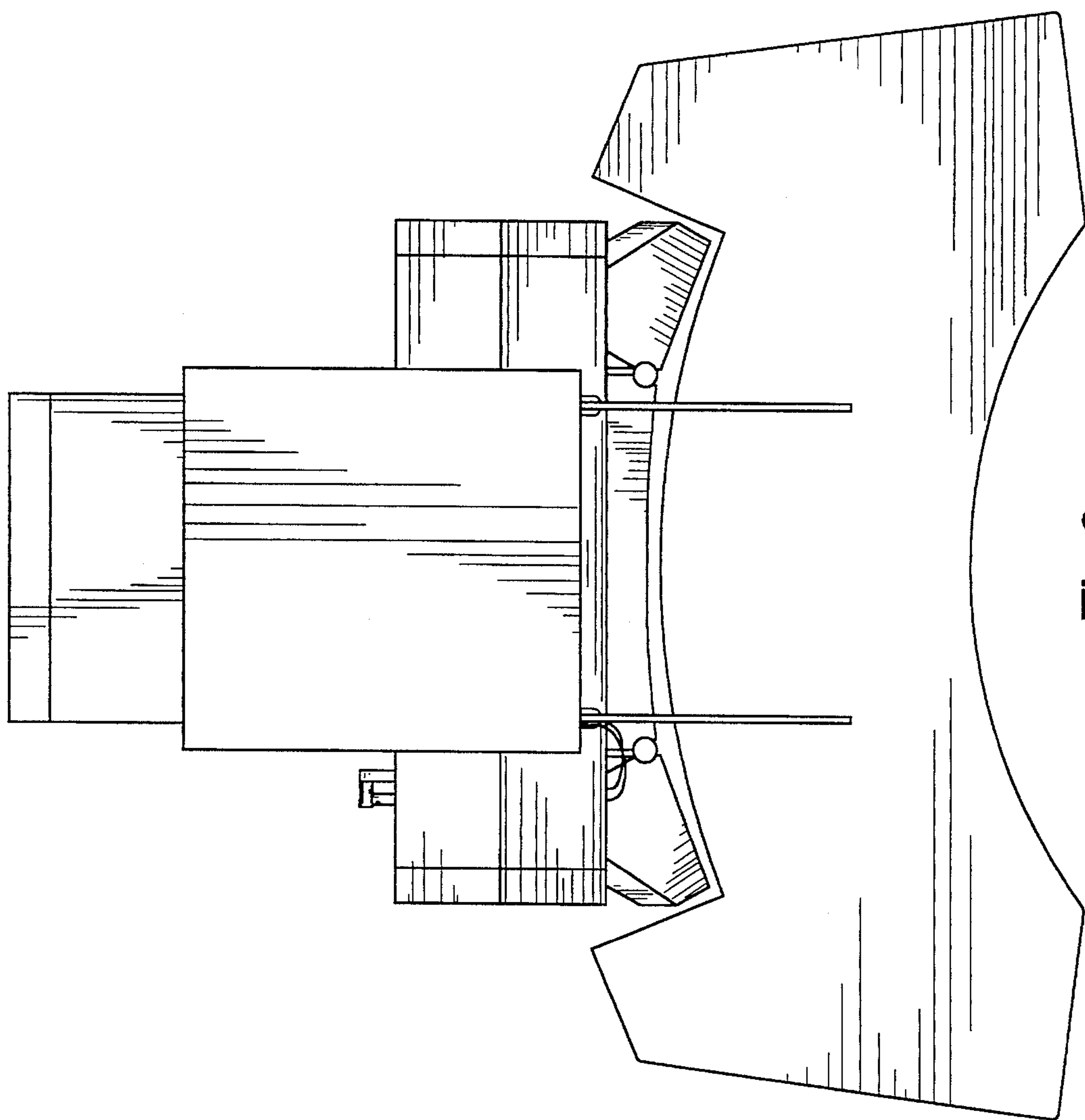
