[57] CLAIM

The new ornamental design for an armoire, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an armoire showing our new design;
- FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
- FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
- FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the second embodiment of the armoire shown in FIG. 1;
- FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
- FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a third embodiment of the armoire shown in FIG. 1;
- FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
- FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the fourth embodiment of the armoire shown in FIG. 1; and,
- FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof.

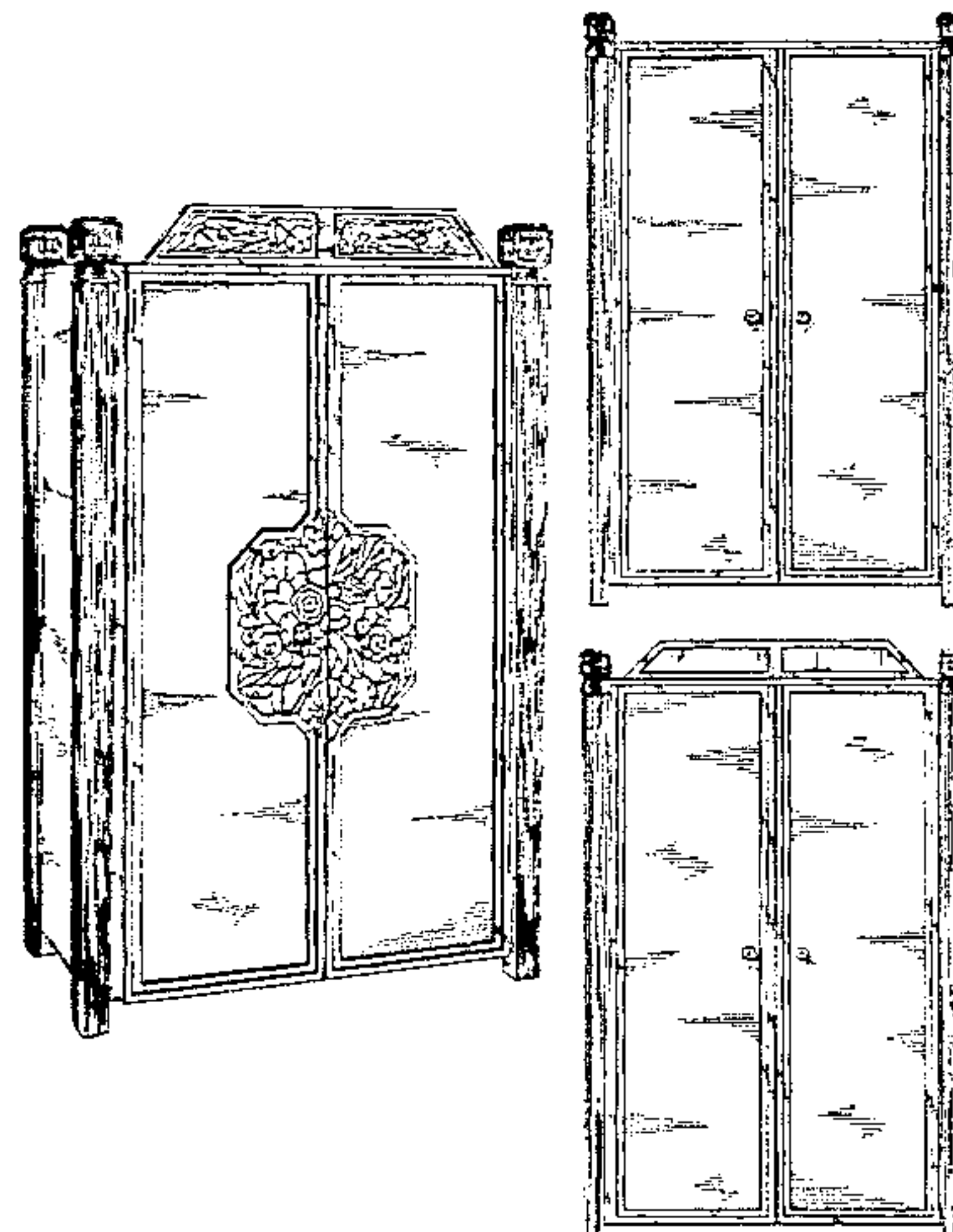
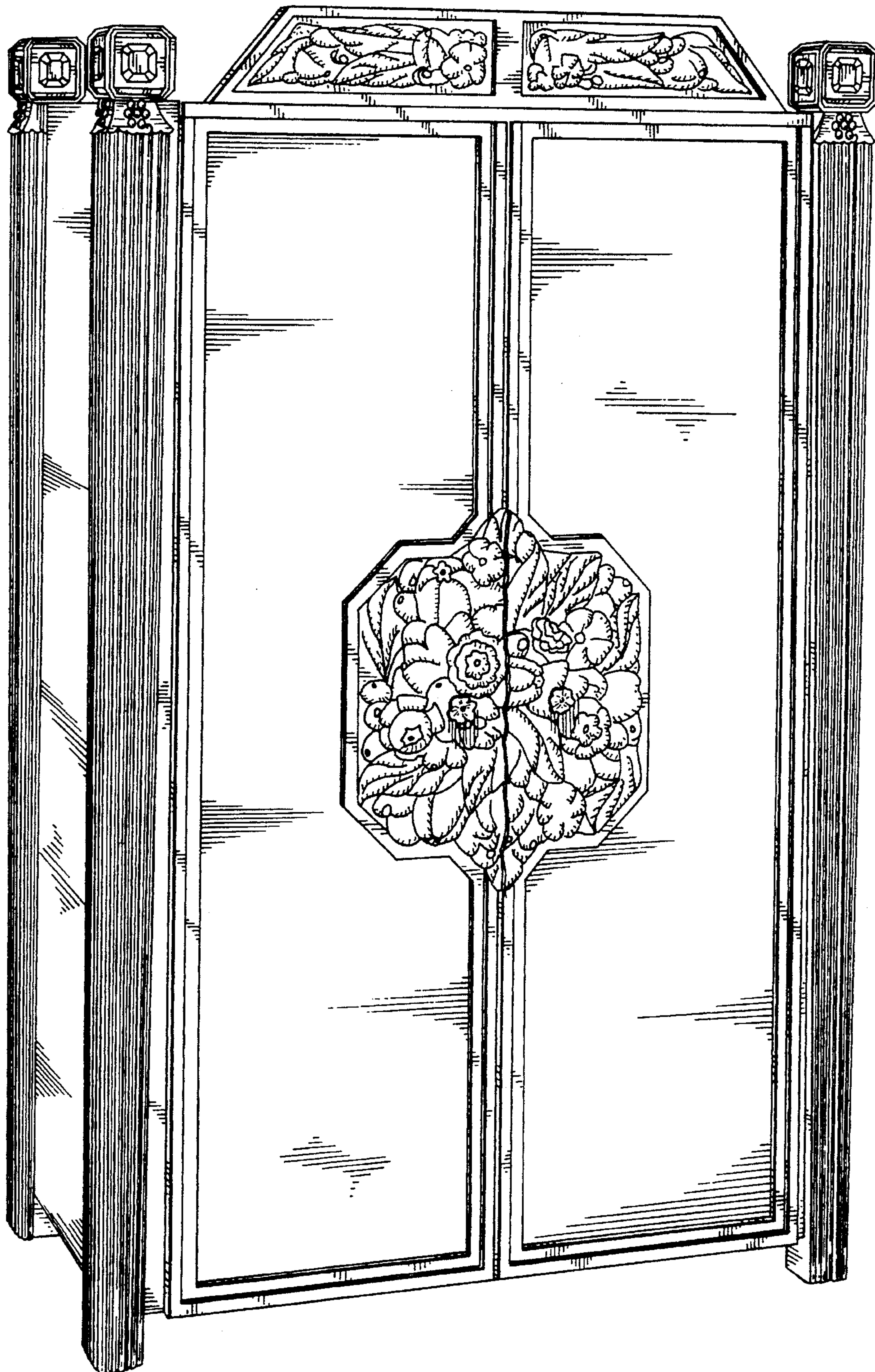

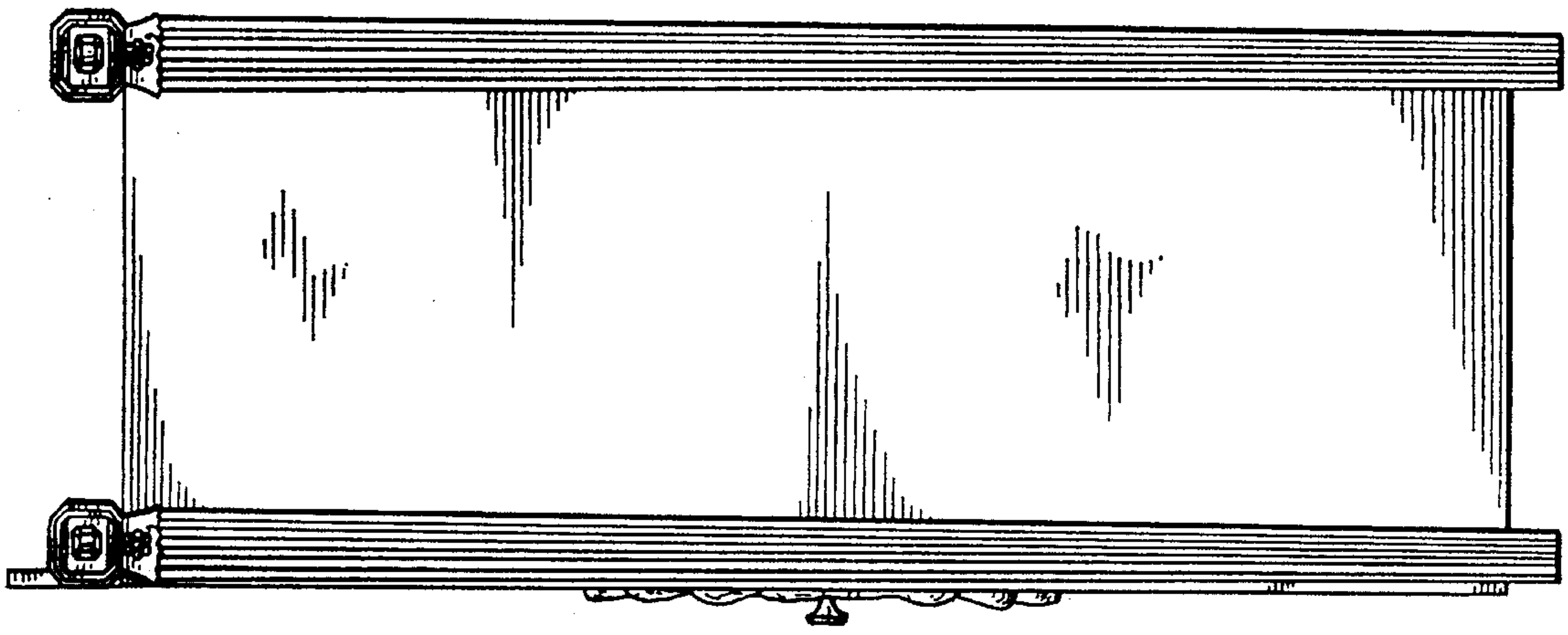

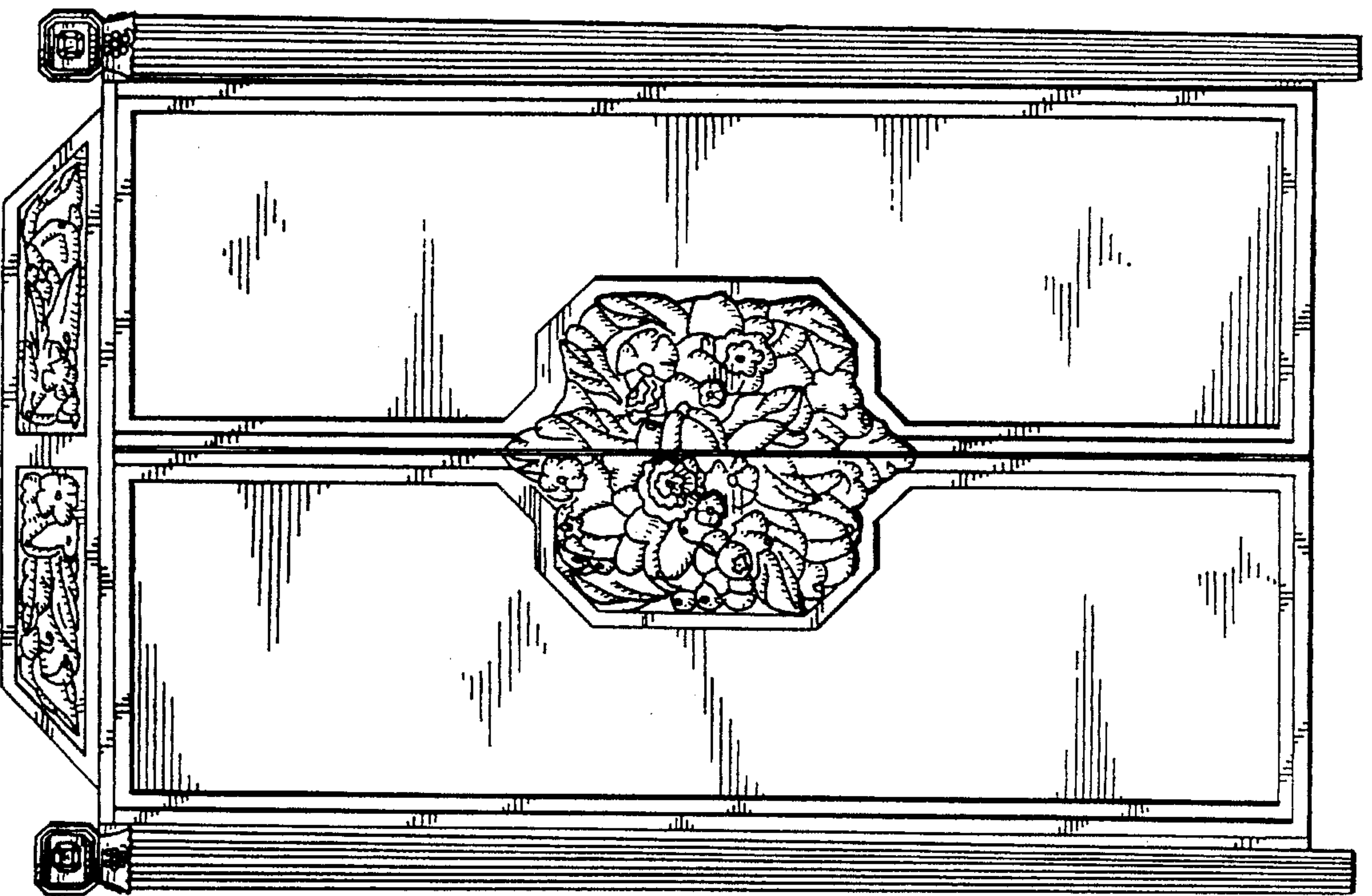

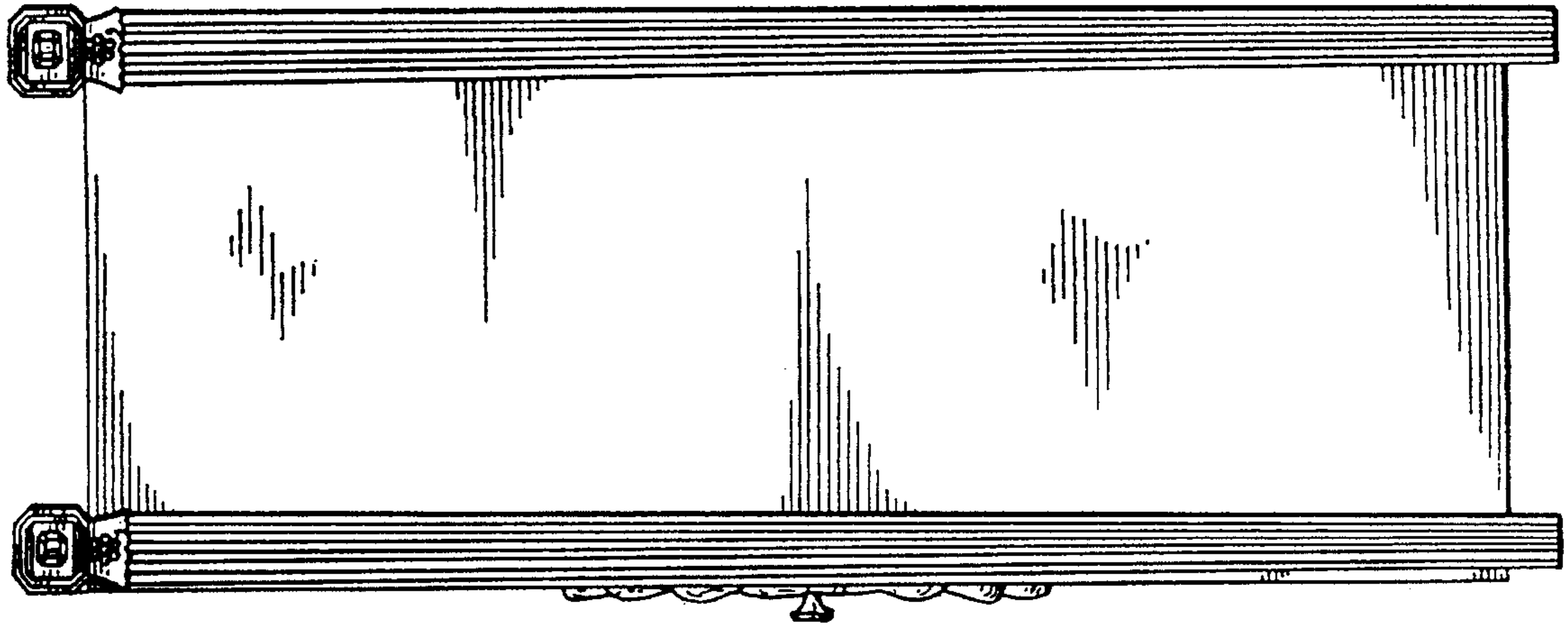

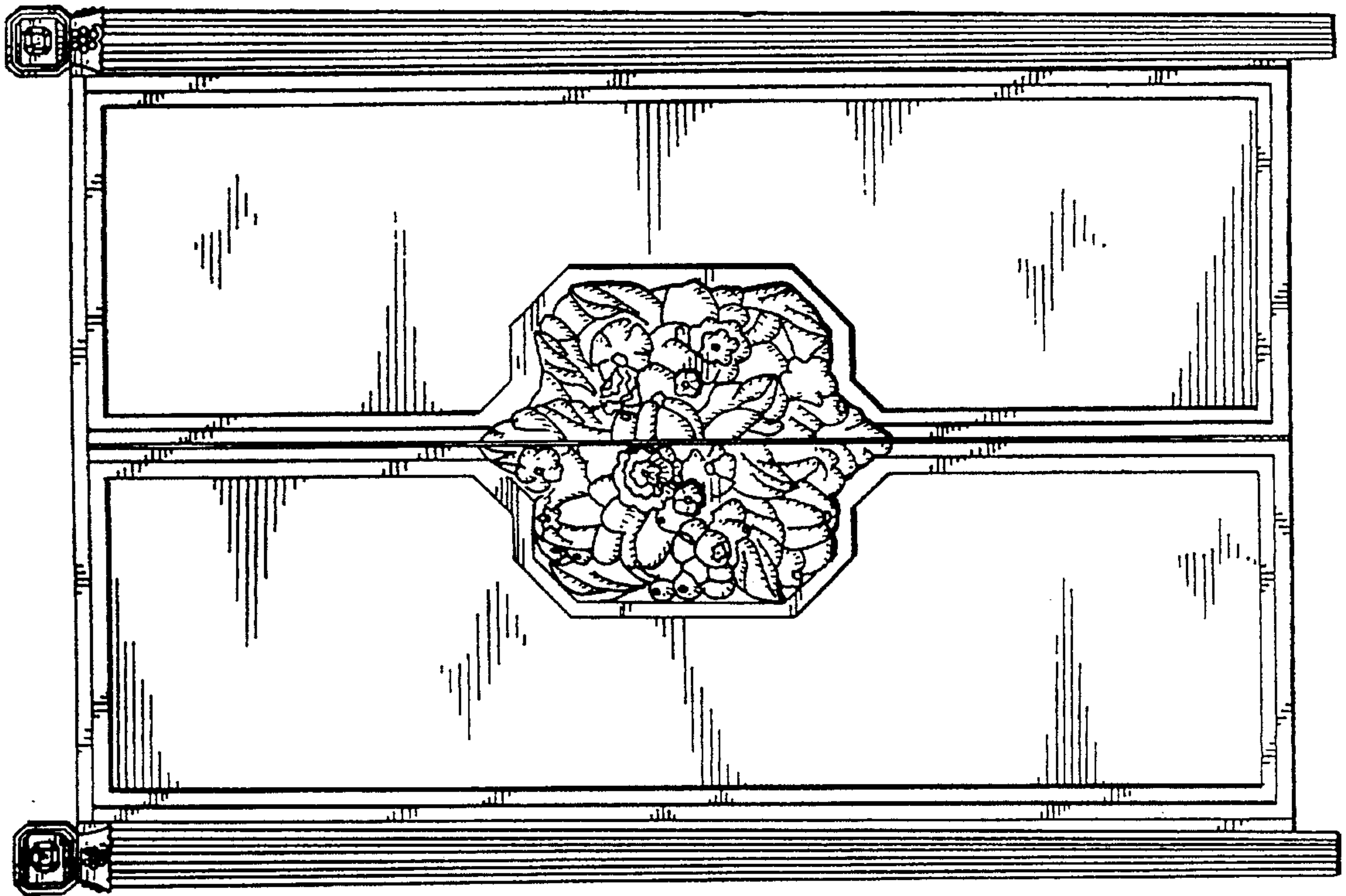

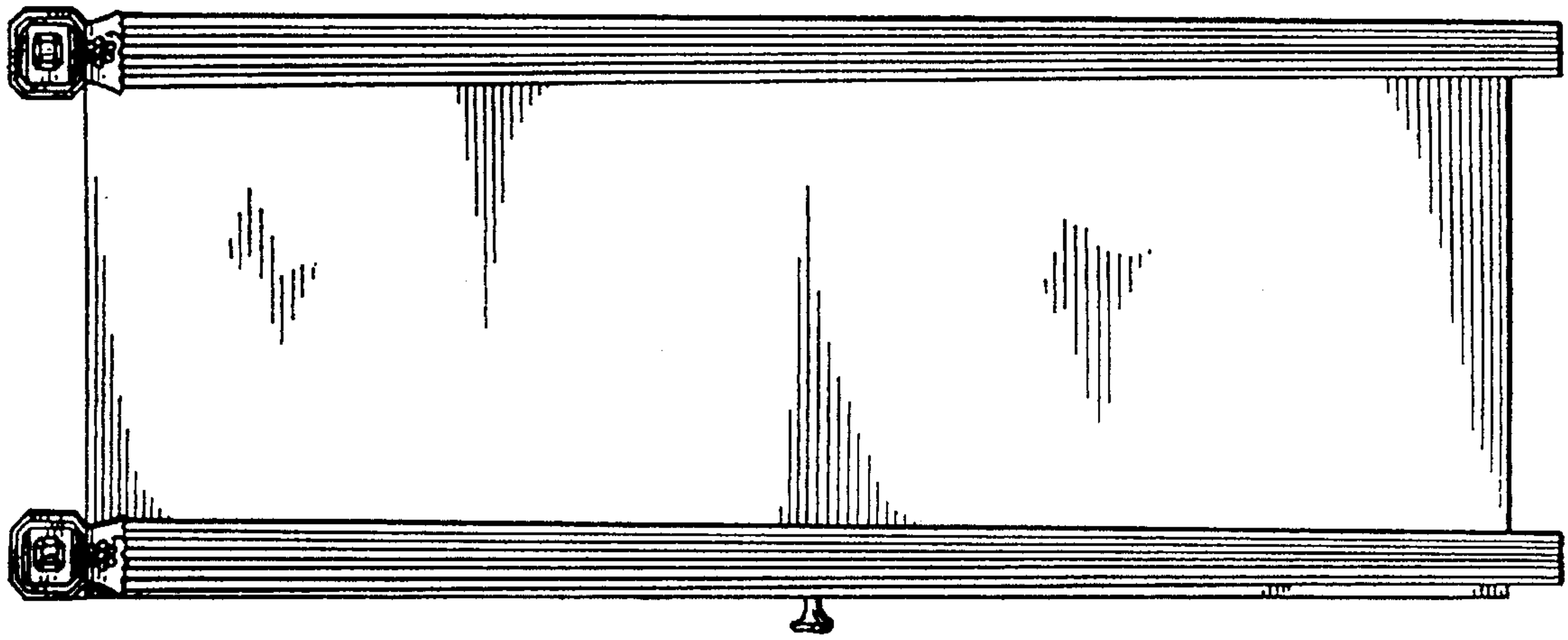
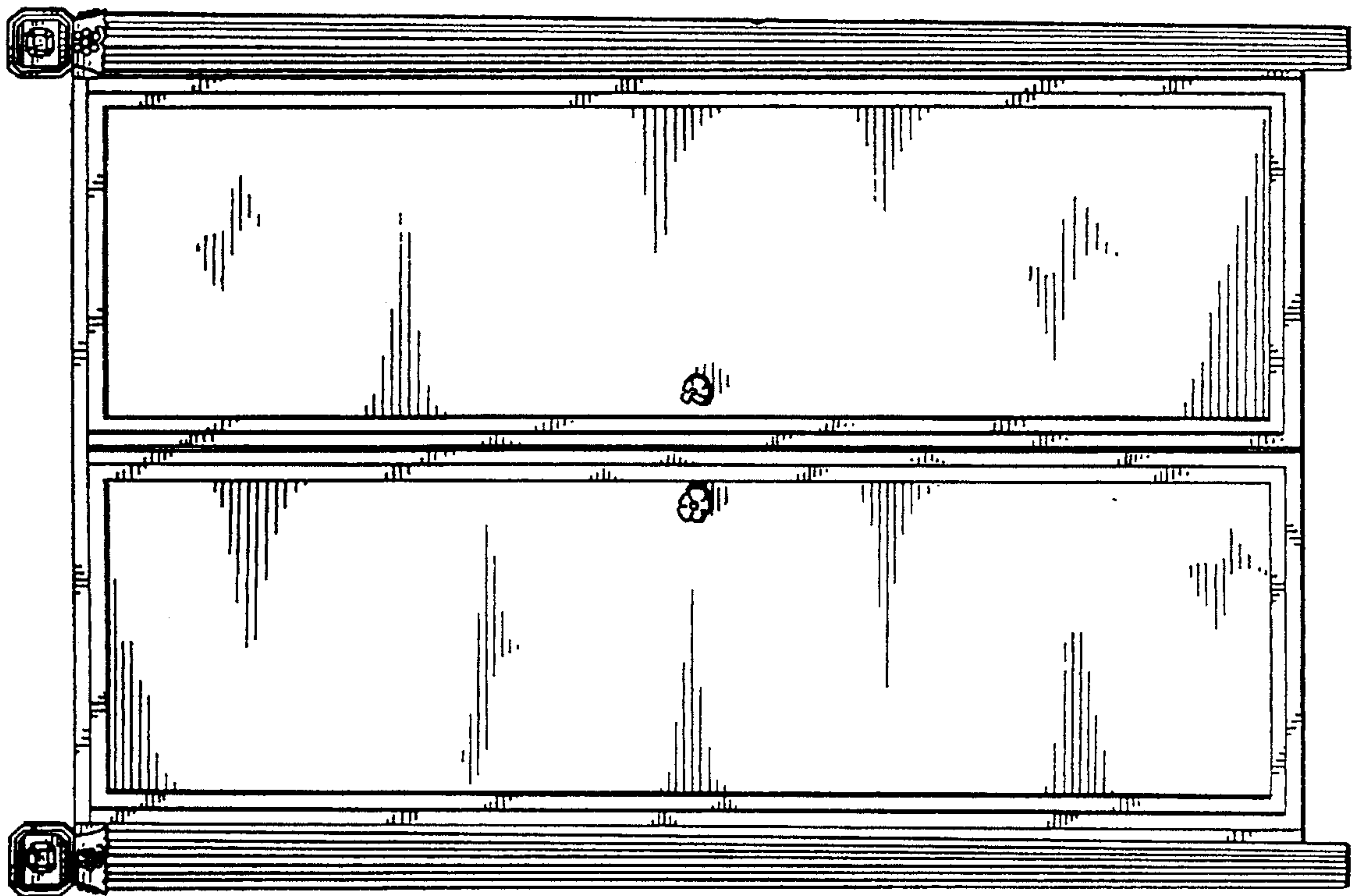

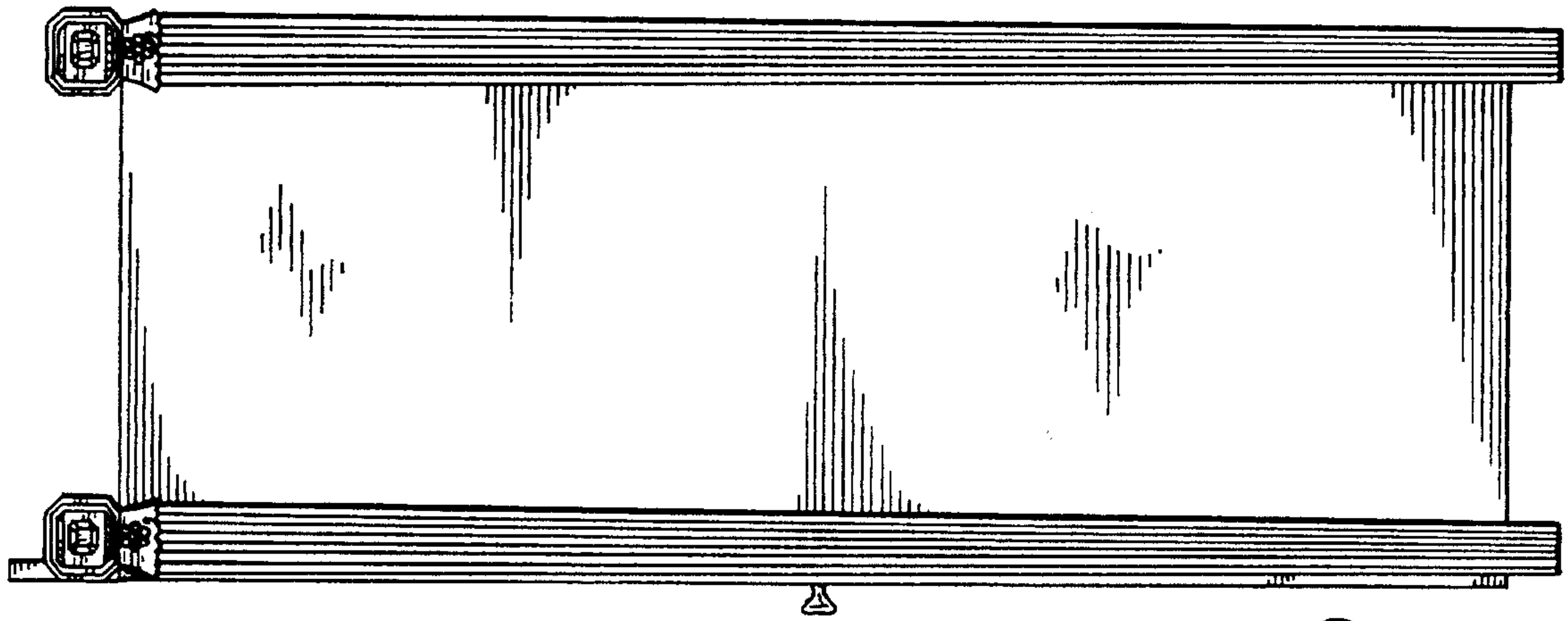

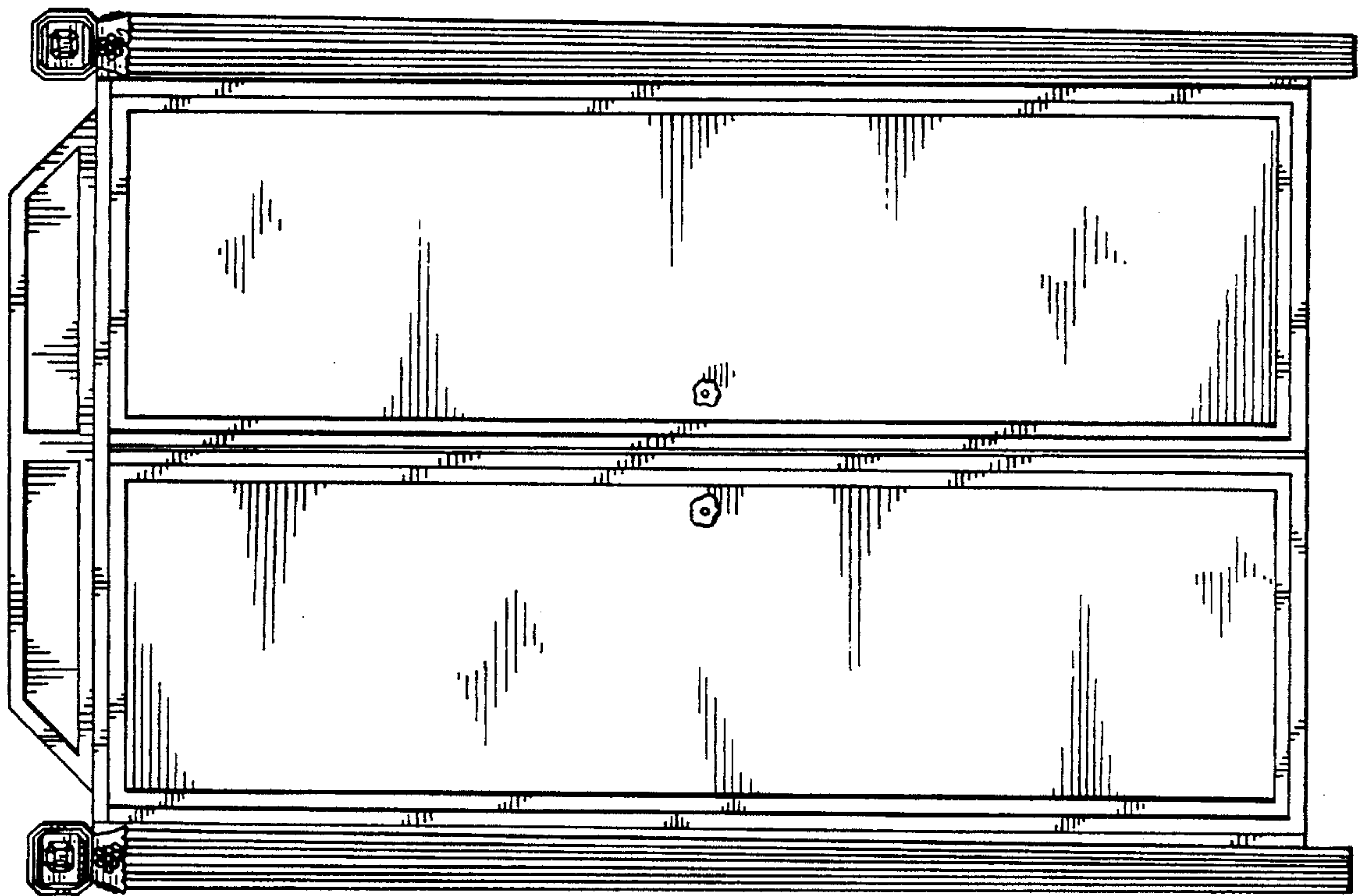
