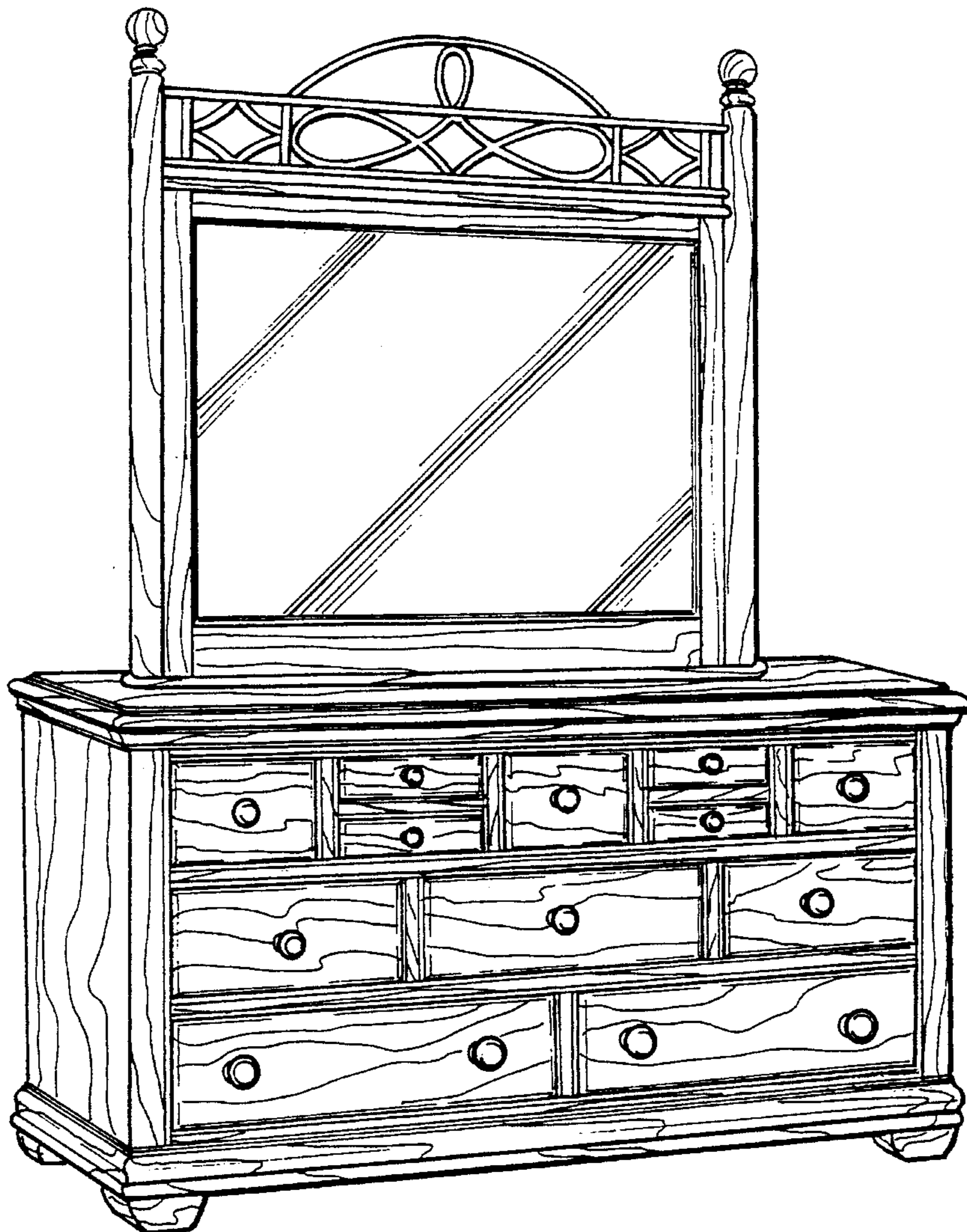
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a dresser with mirror showing my new design;

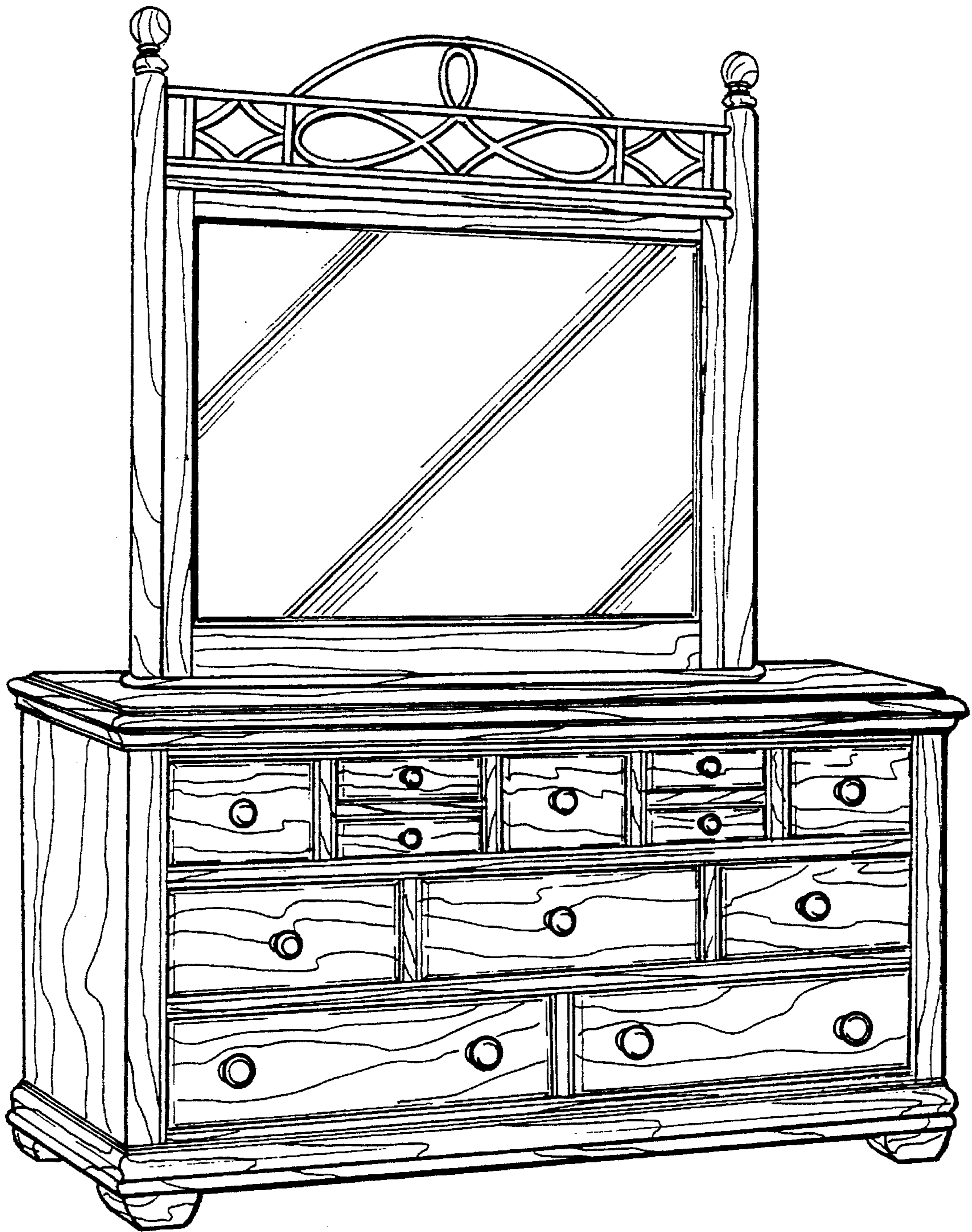

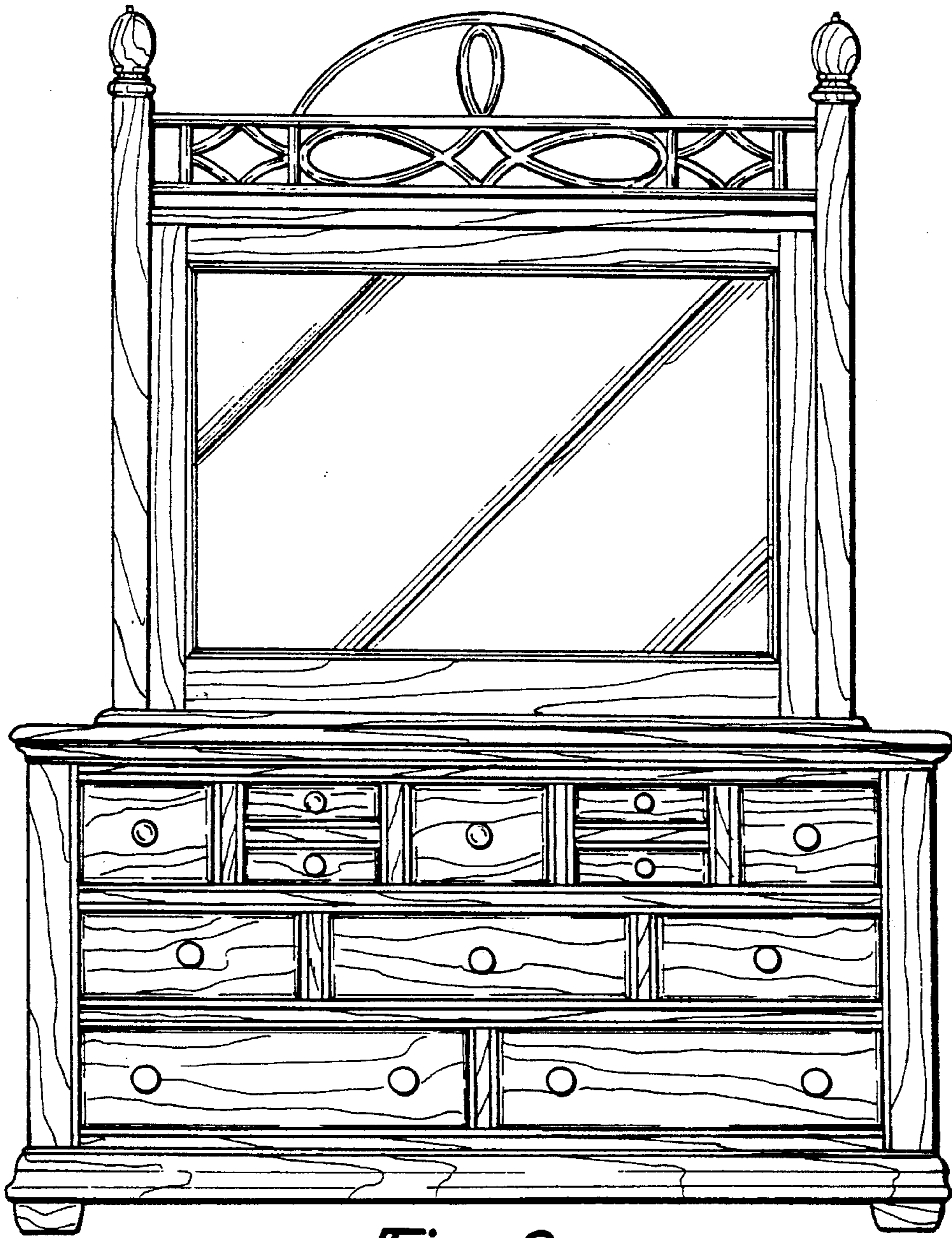

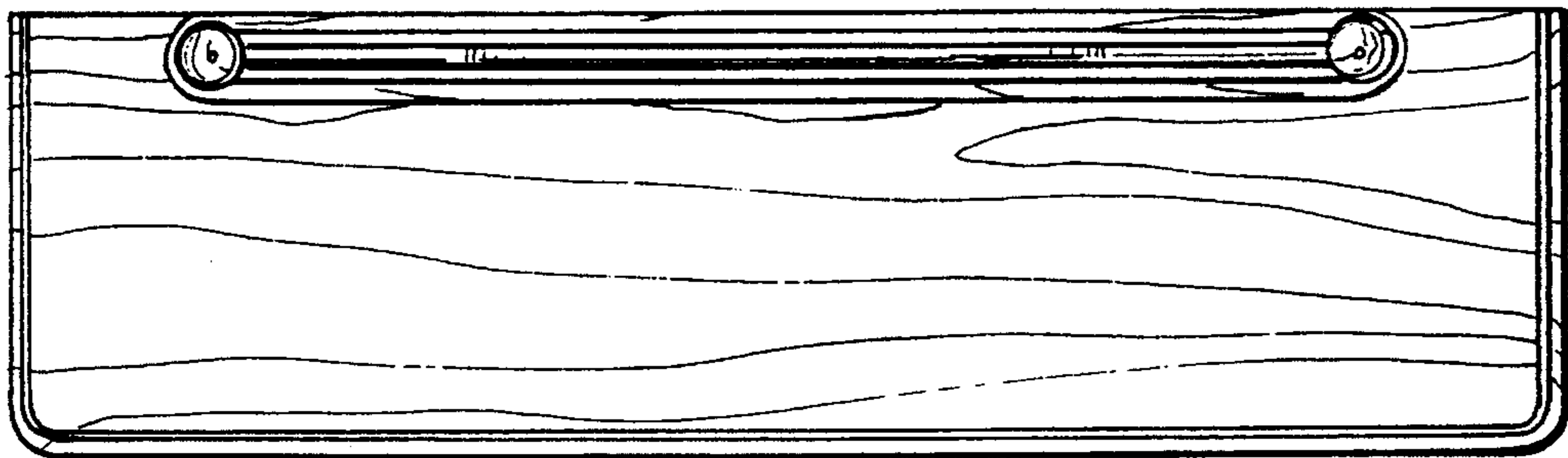

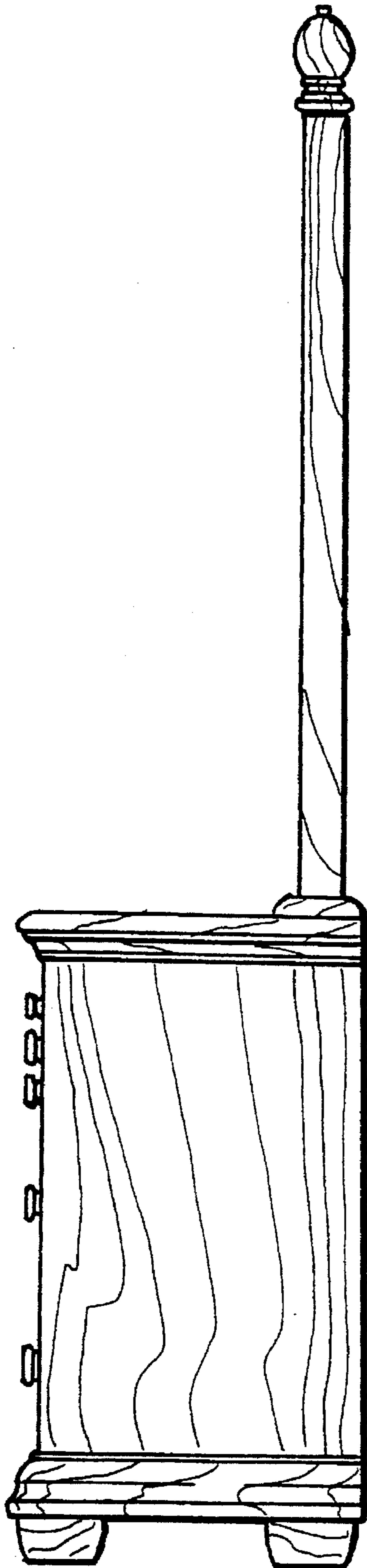
