[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a headgear accessory, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an environmental perspective view of a headgear accessory showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, with the bottom plan view being a mirror image;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, with the rear, left, and right side elevational views being mirror images;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a second embodiment thereof, with the bottom plan view being a mirror image;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 4, with the rear, left and right side elevational views being mirror images;
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a third embodiment thereof, with the bottom plan view being a mirror image;
 FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 6, with the rear, left and right side elevational views being mirror images;
 FIG. 8 is a top plan view of a fourth embodiment thereof, with the bottom plan view being a mirror image;
 FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 8, with the rear elevational view being a mirror image;
 FIG. 10 is a top plan view of a fifth embodiment thereof, with the bottom plan view being a mirror image; and,
 FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 10, with the rear, left, and right side elevational views being mirror images.
 The broken line showing of headgear and a wearer thereof in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

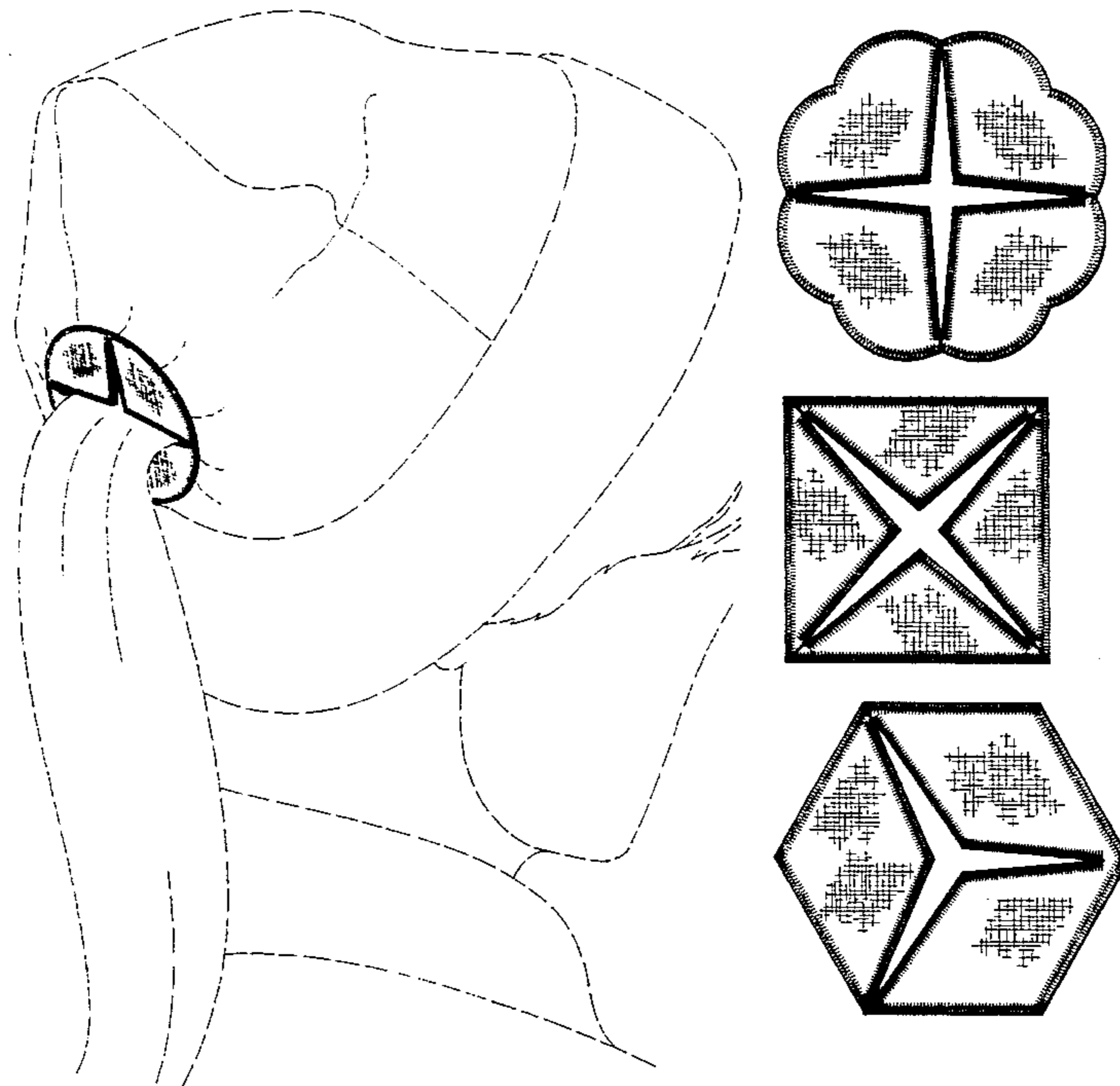

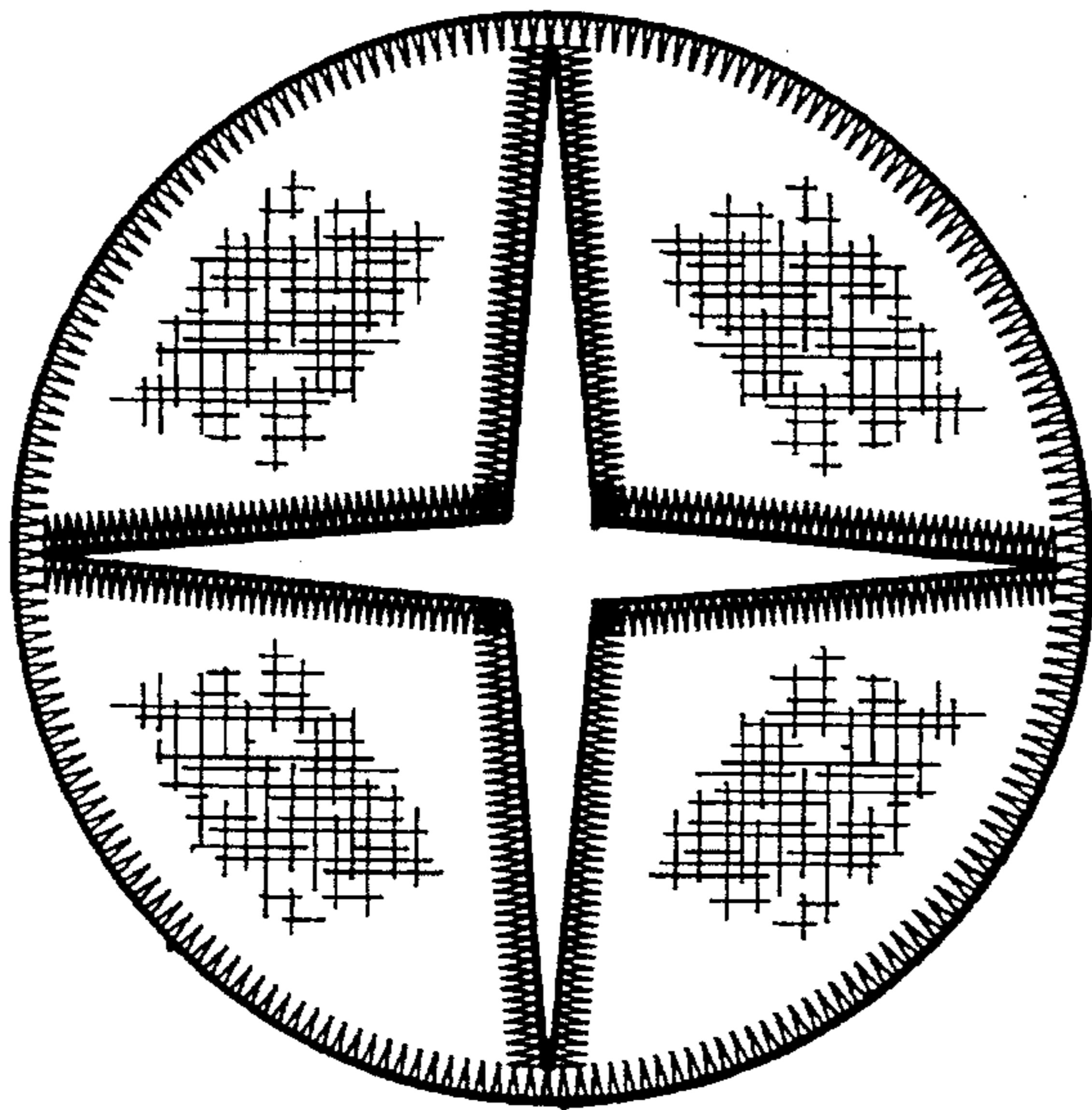

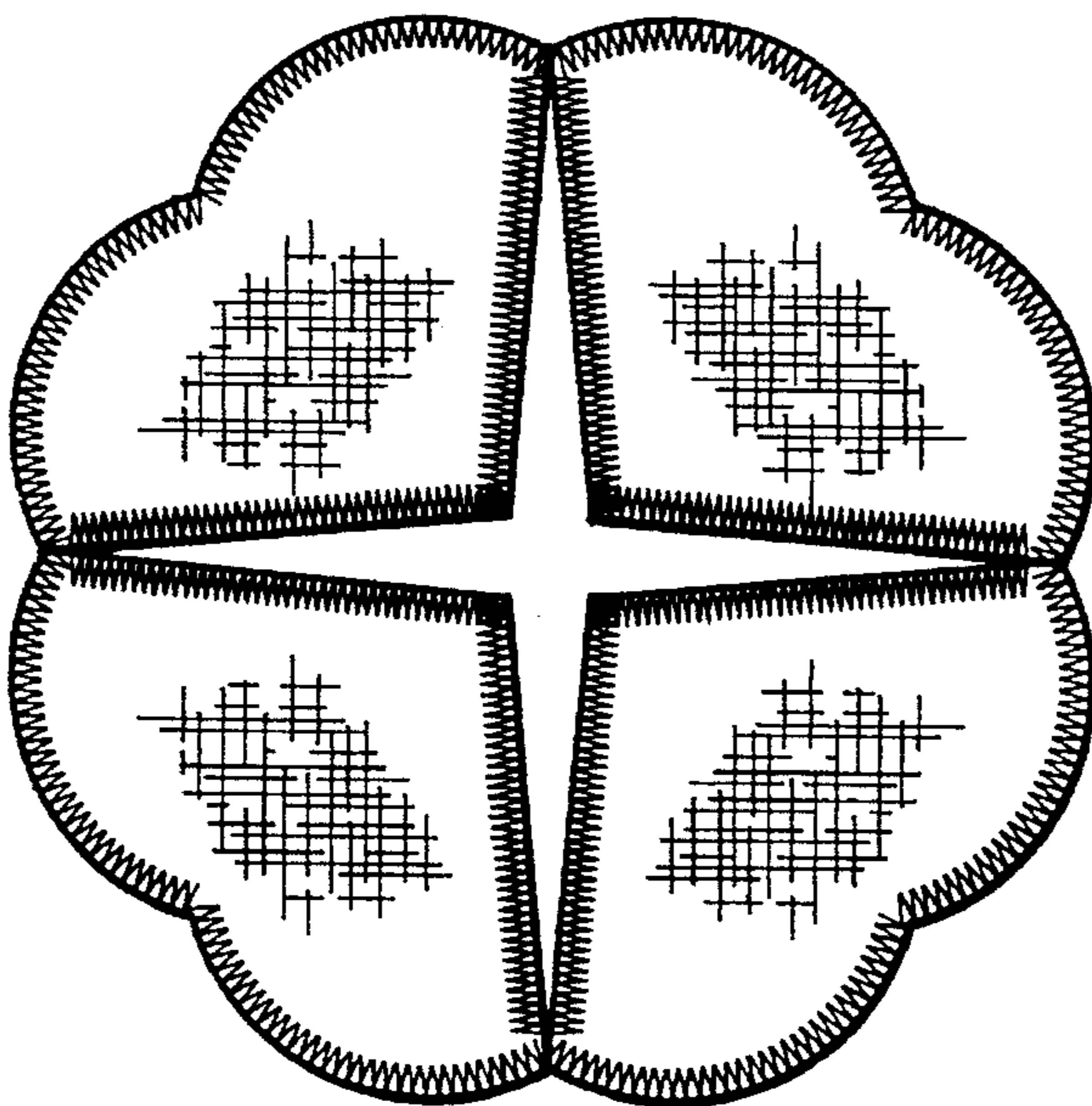

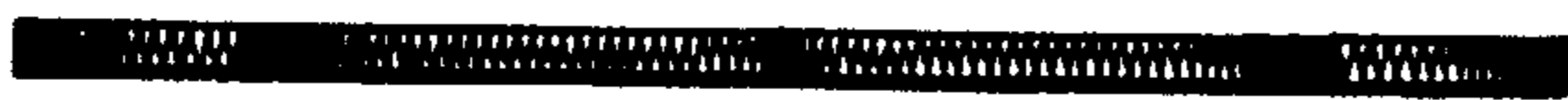

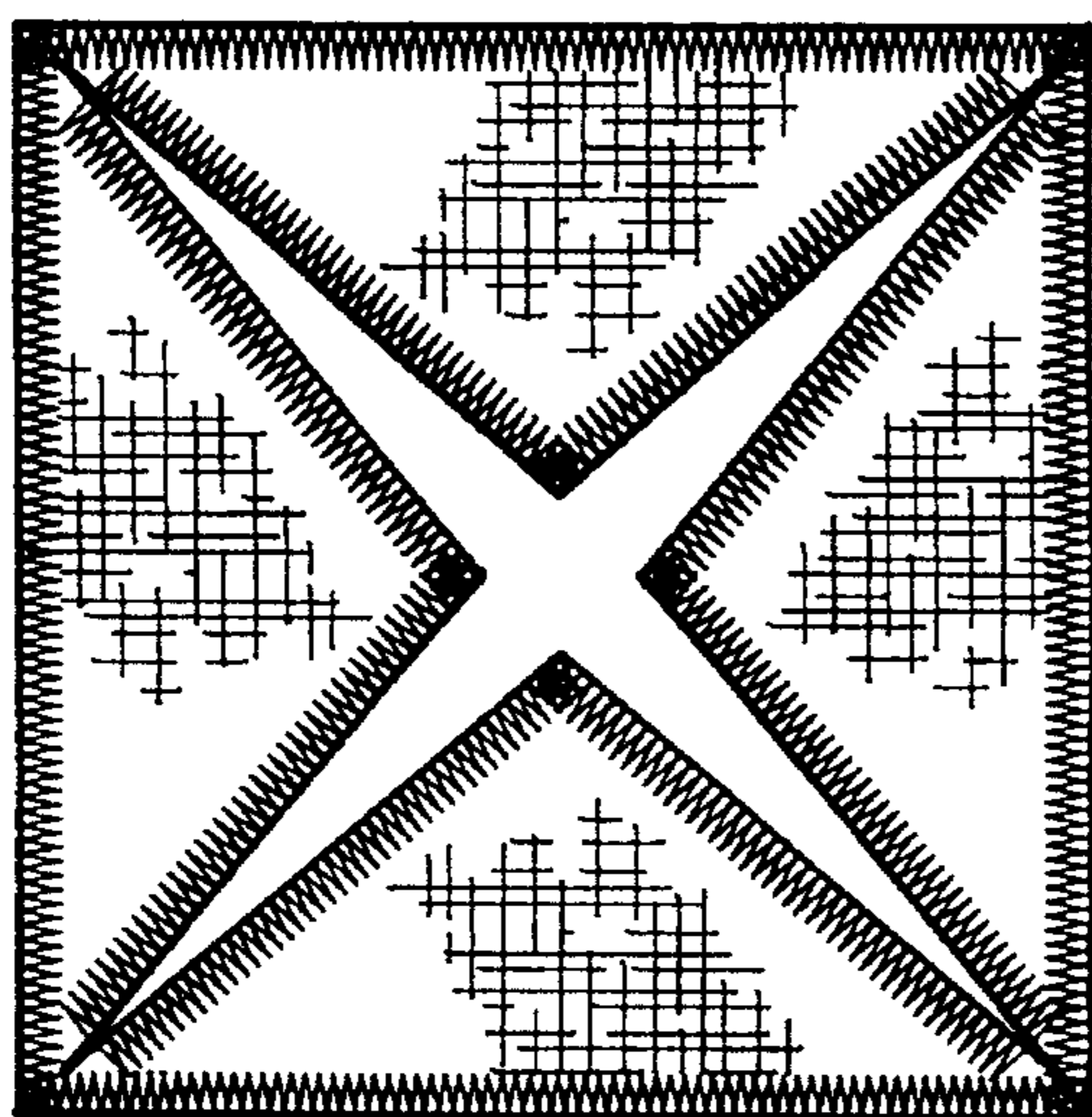

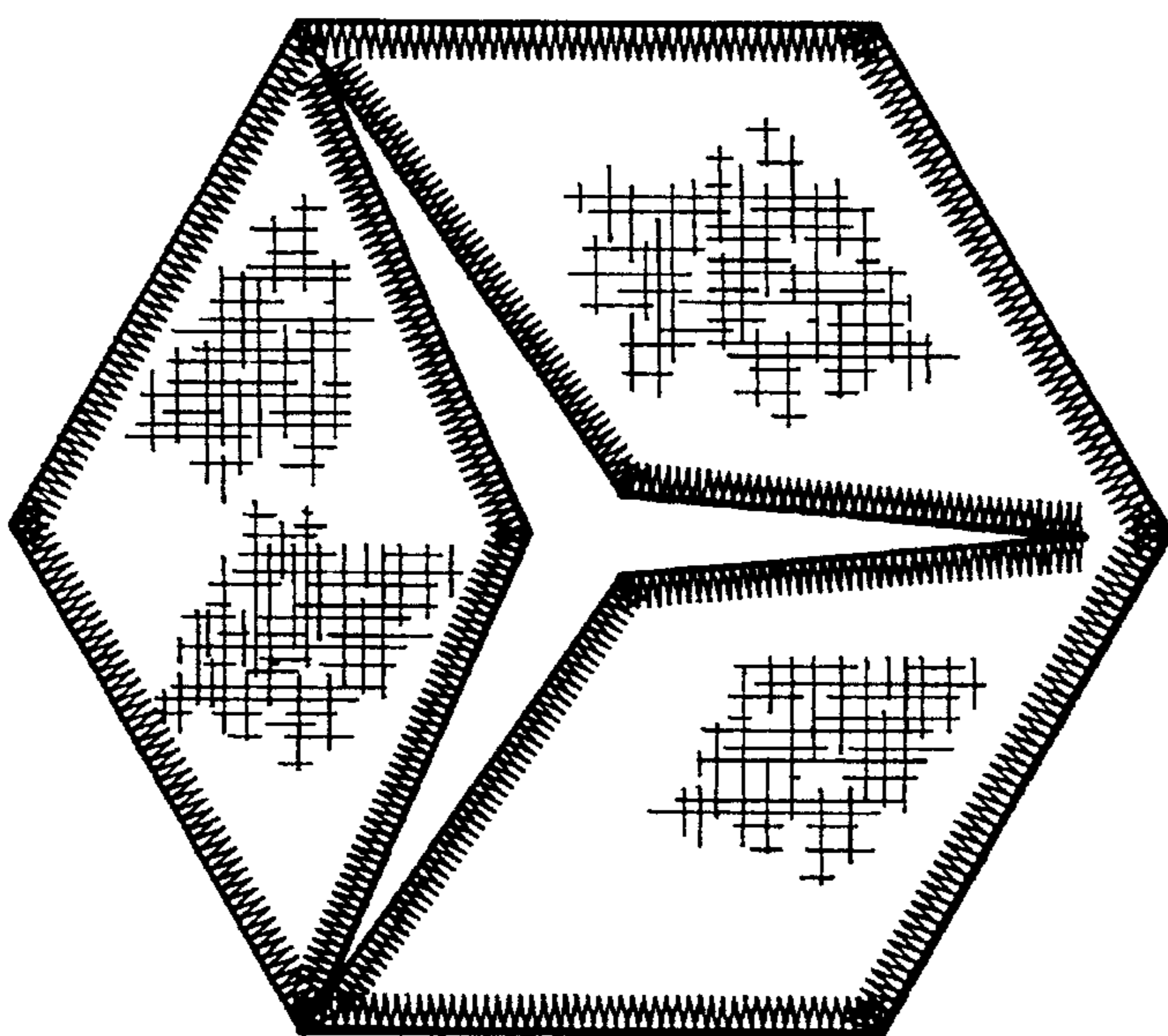

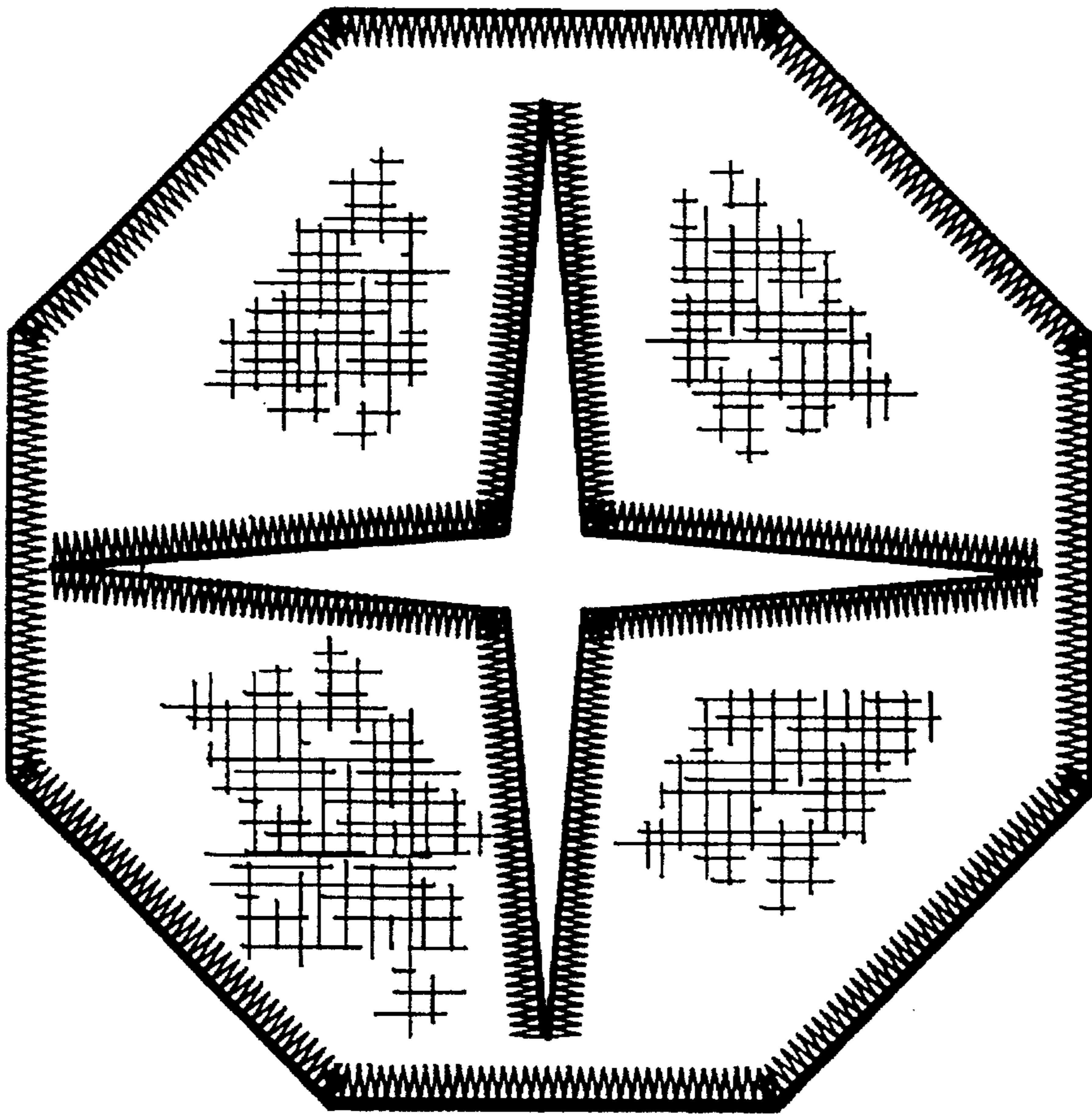
