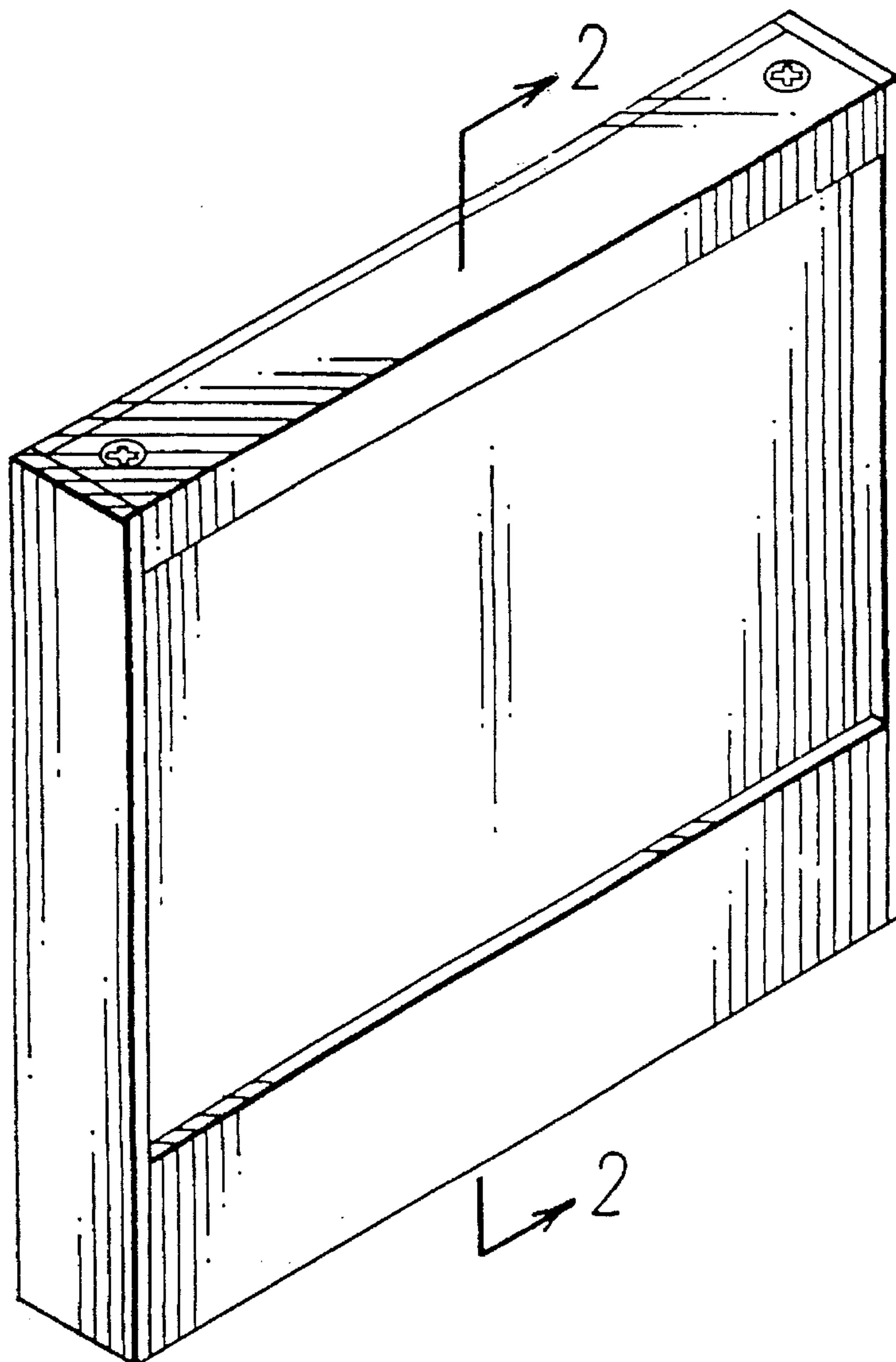
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an urn for cremated remains, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side, top front perspective view of our new urn for cremated remains;
FIG. 2 is a sectional view taken on the line 2—2 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation;
FIG. 4 is a front elevation;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view.

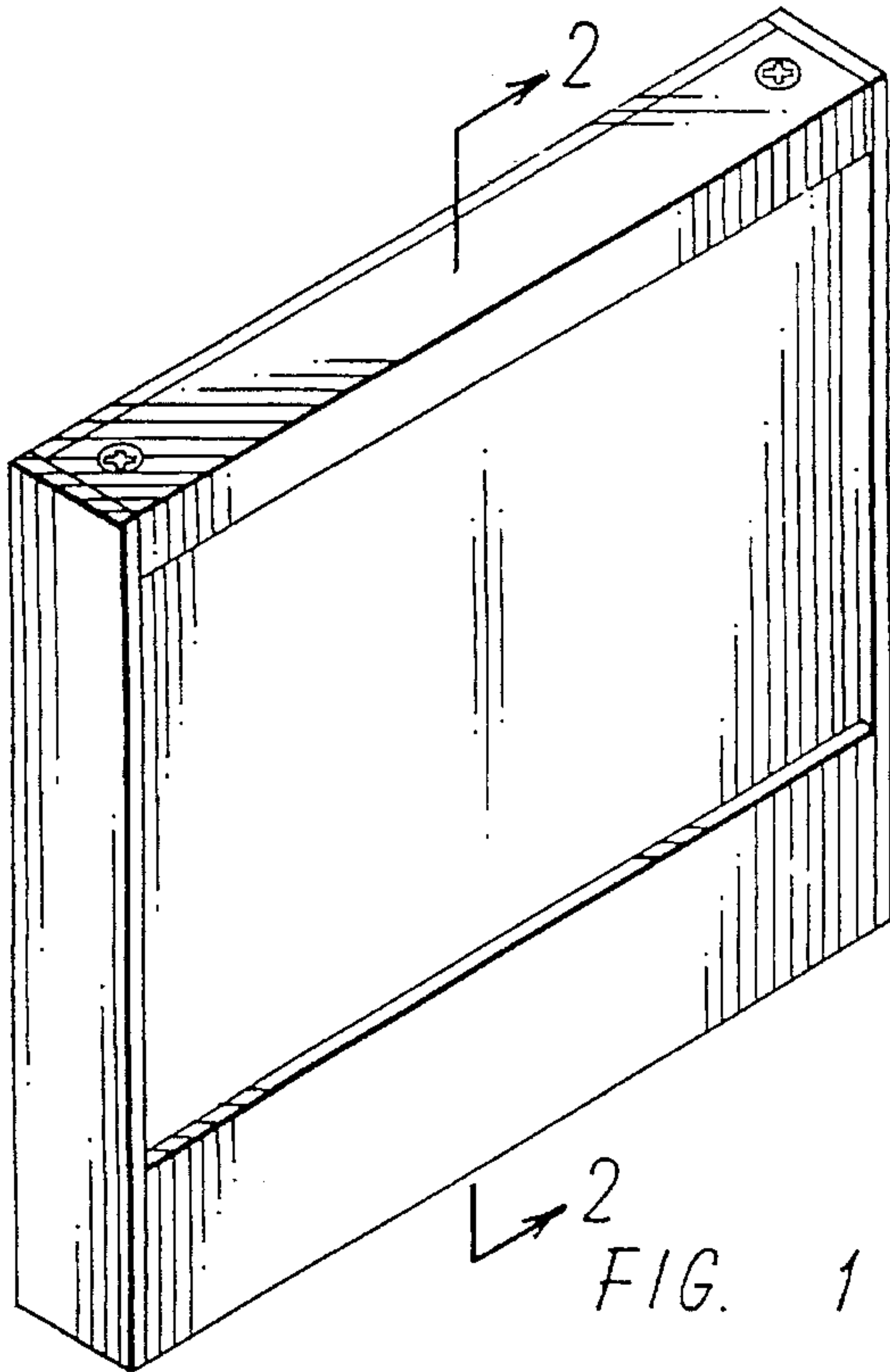

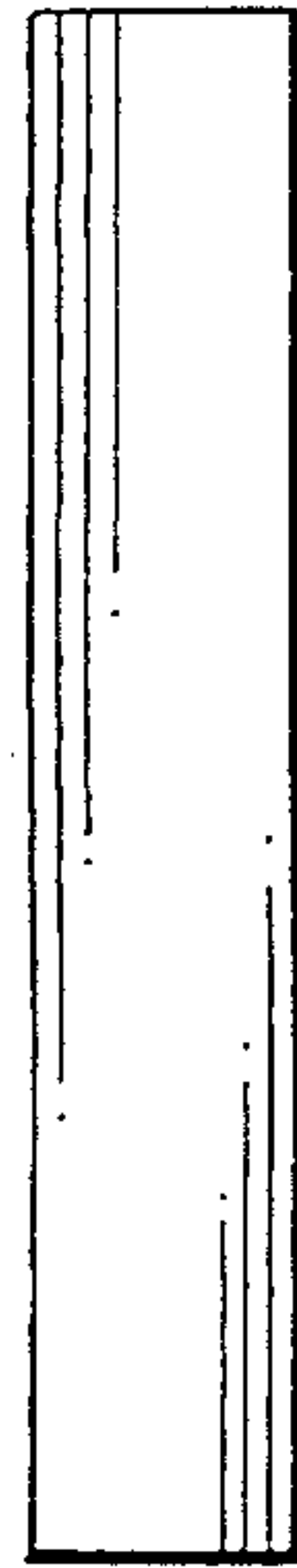

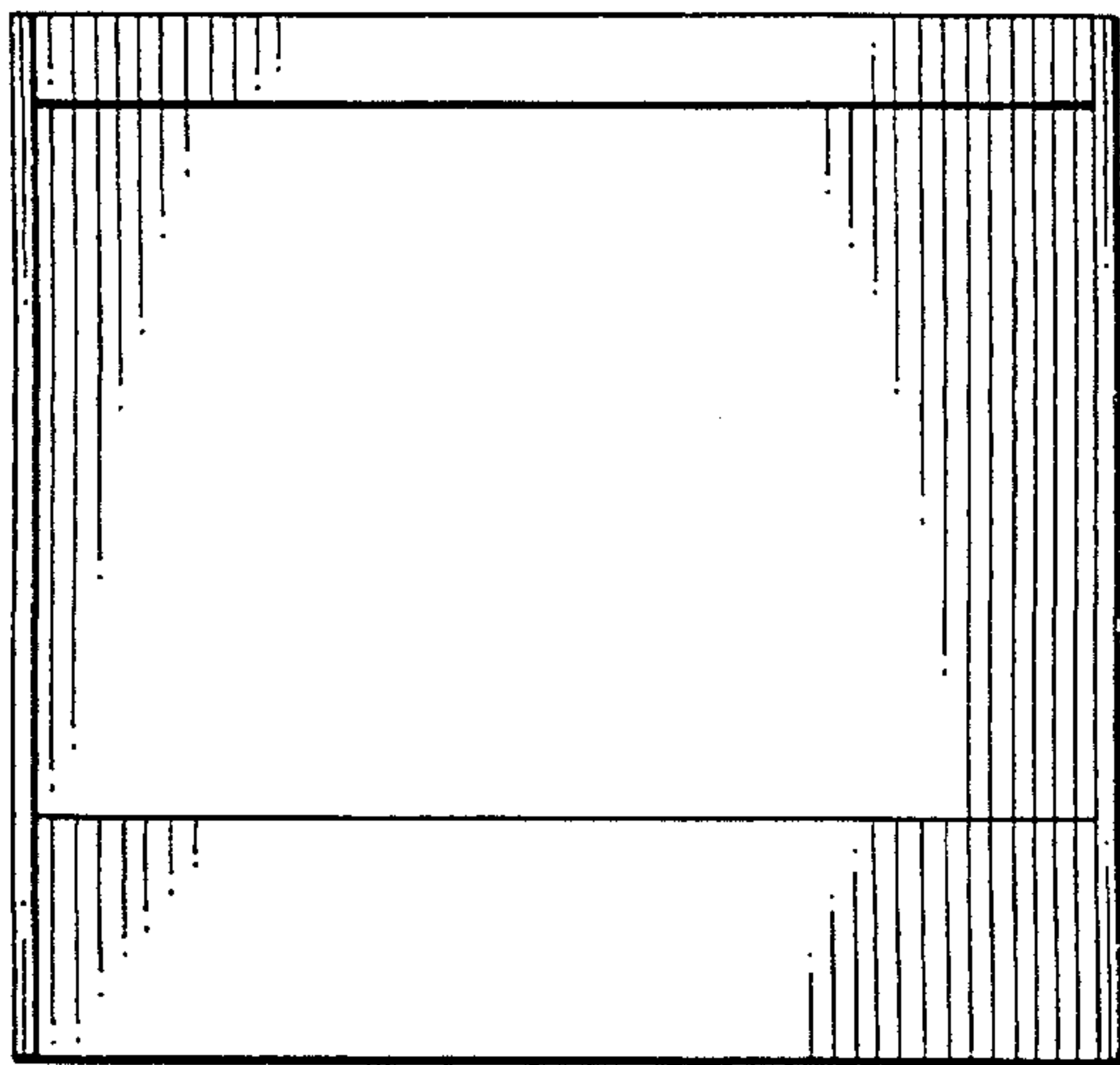

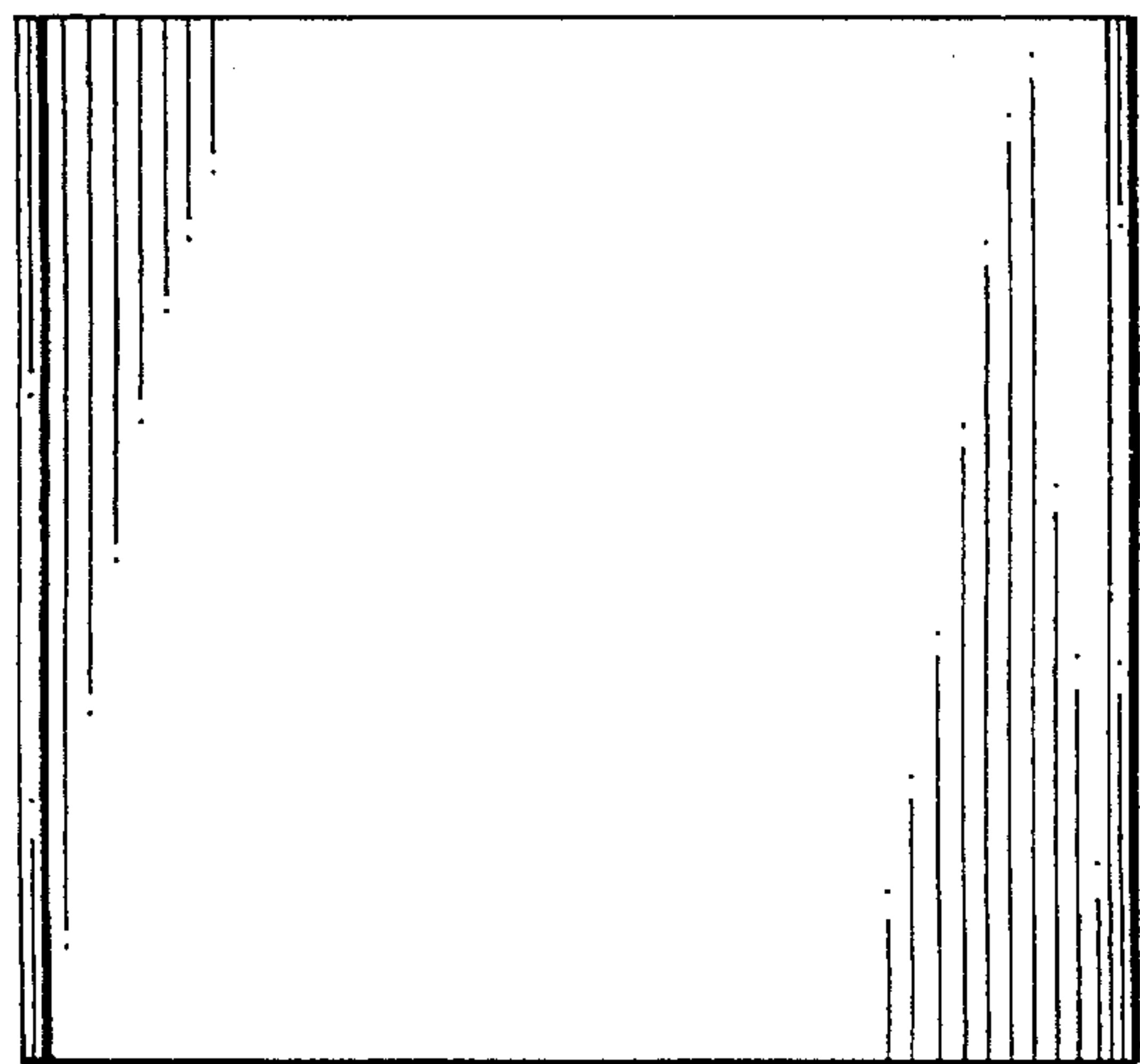

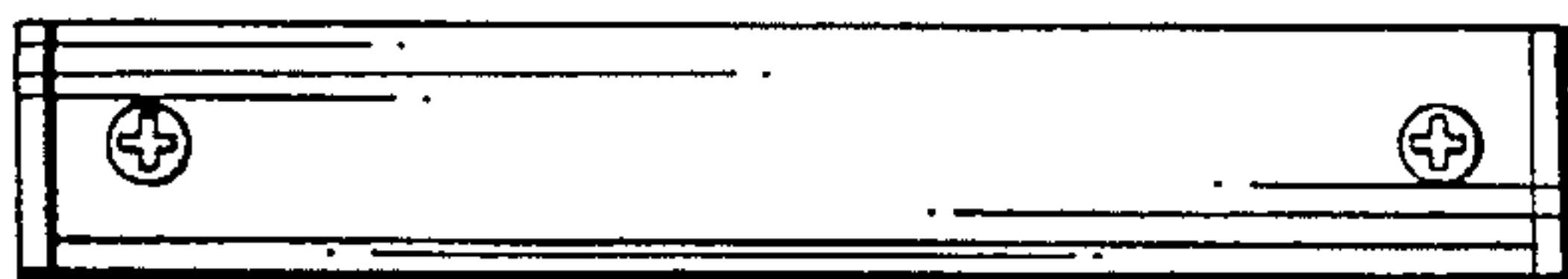

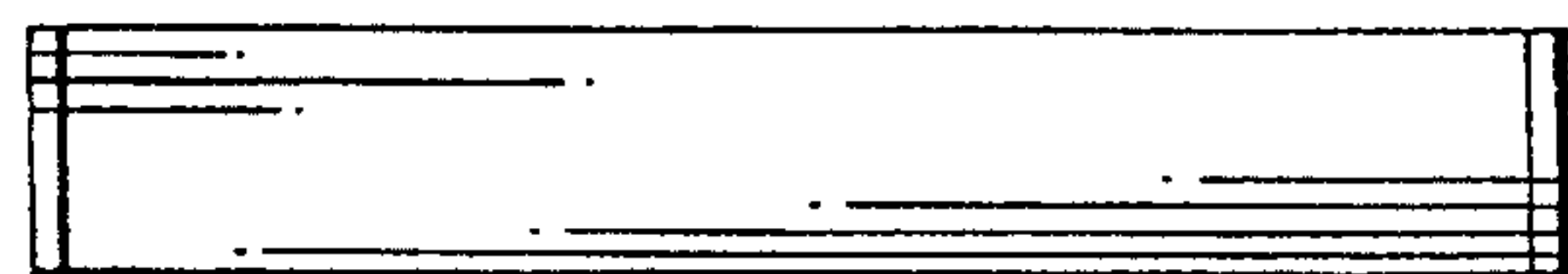
