[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a unified footpiece clamp for computer paper margin stripper, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a unified footpiece clamp for computer paper margin stripping showing a first form of my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevation thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;  
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevation;  
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view;  
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view;  
 FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view;  
 FIG. 8 is a left front perspective view of a unified footpiece clamp for computer paper margin stripping showing another form of my new design;  
 FIG. 9 is a right side elevation thereof;  
 FIG. 10 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 11 is a right side elevation thereof;  
 FIG. 12 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,  
 FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view thereof.
