The ornamental design for a sports card display holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the sports card display holder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is an enlarged partial isometric view taken from FIG. 1, the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

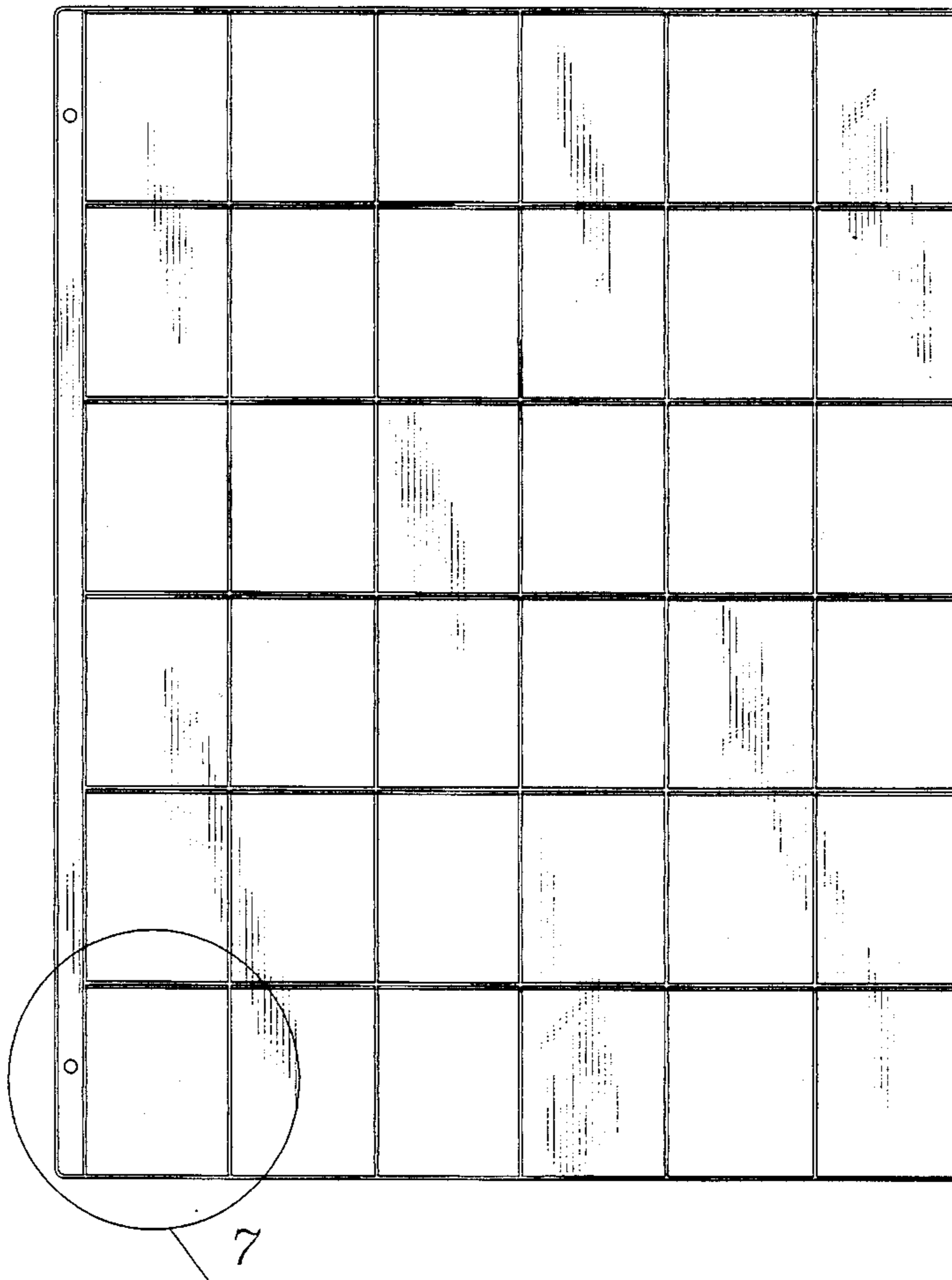

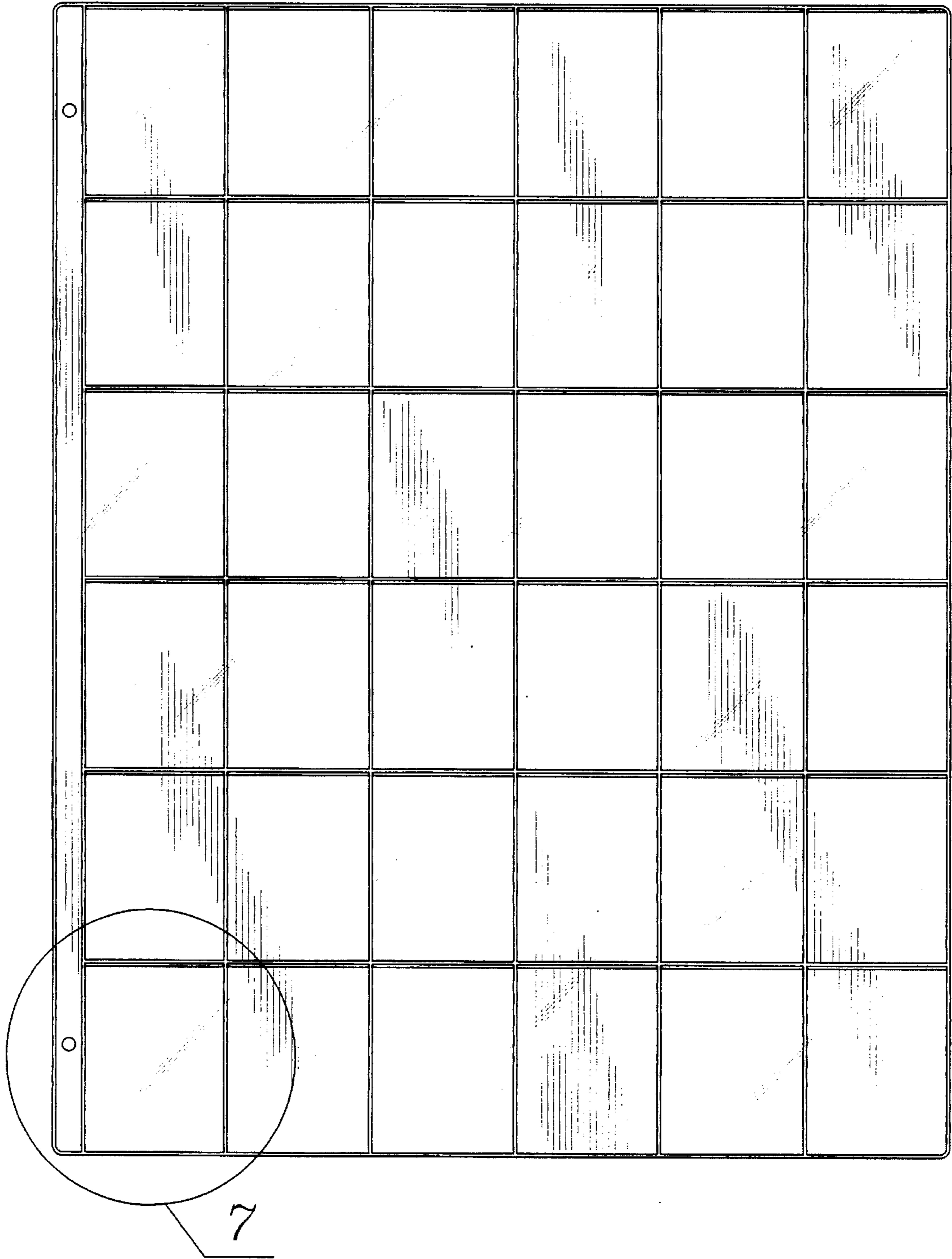

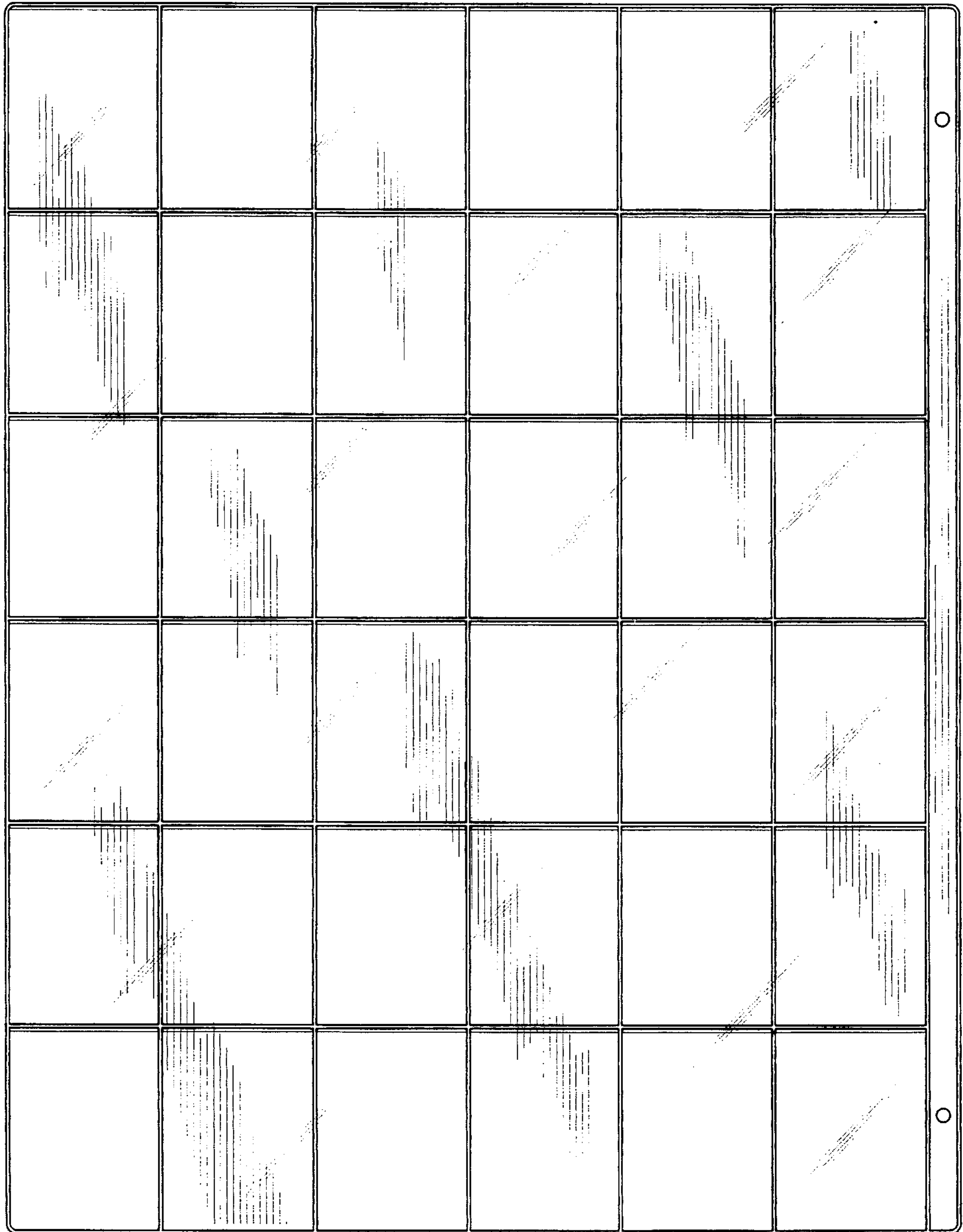
