[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a backpack cooler, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the backpack cooler showing the design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

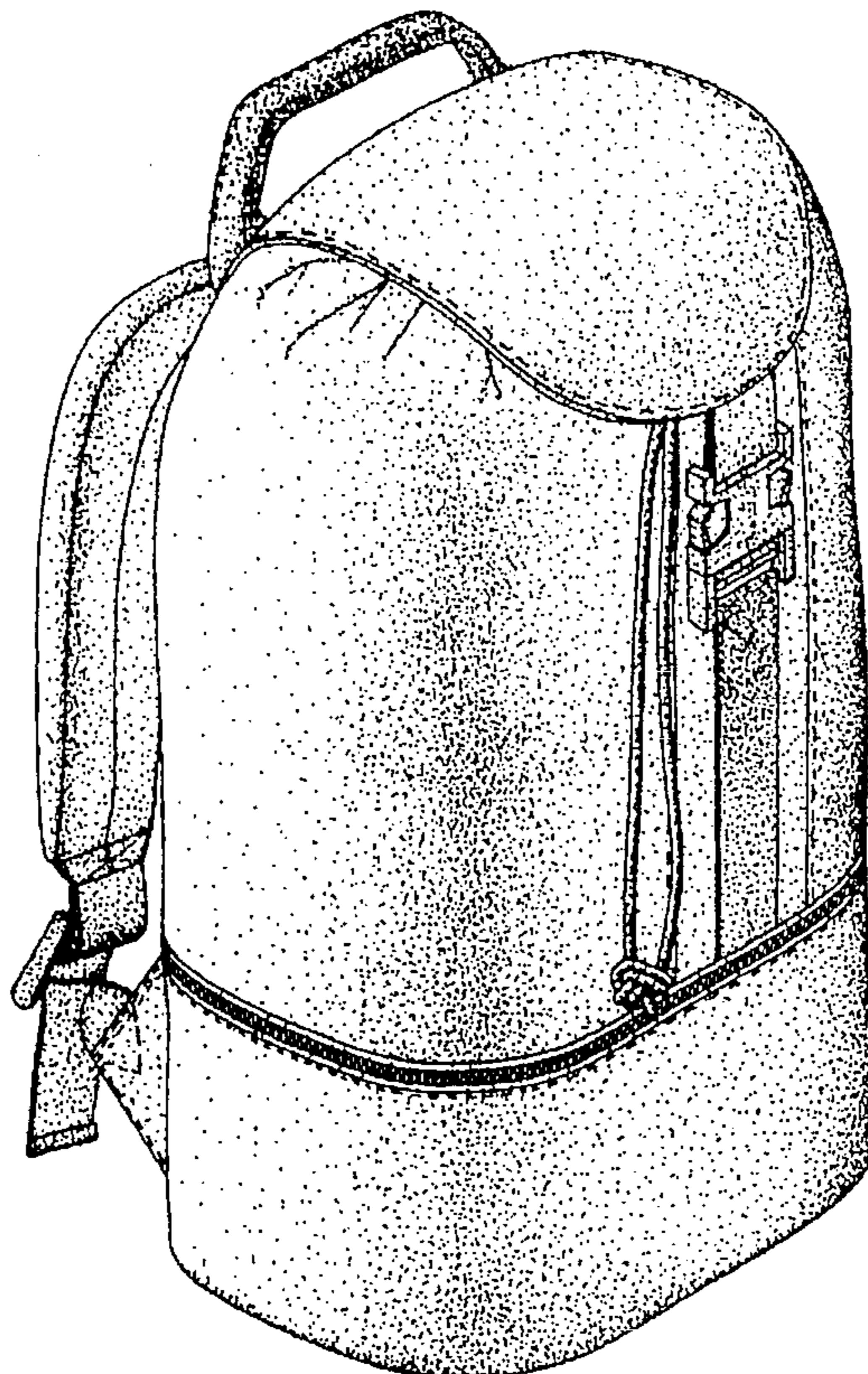
FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof;

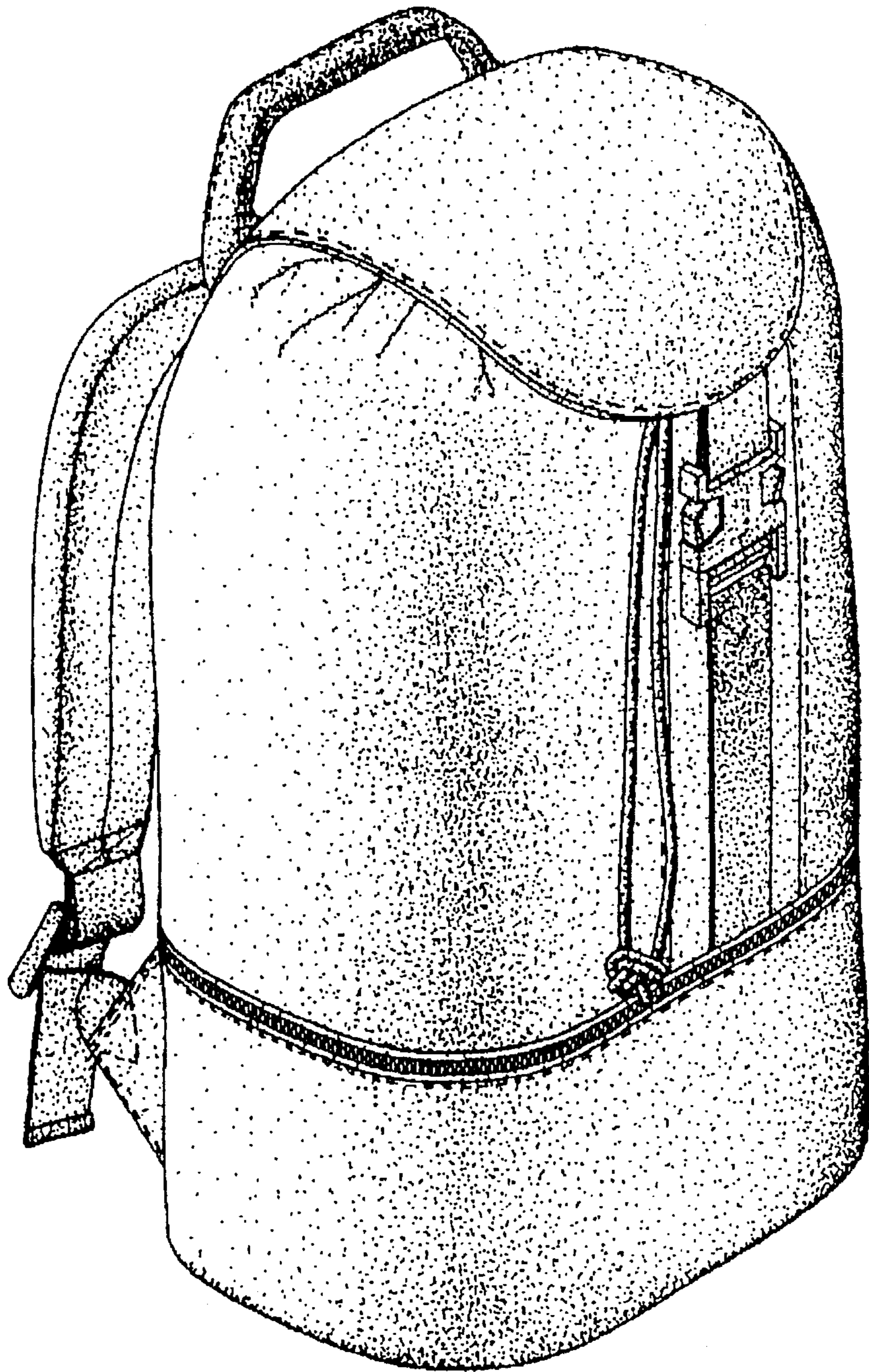

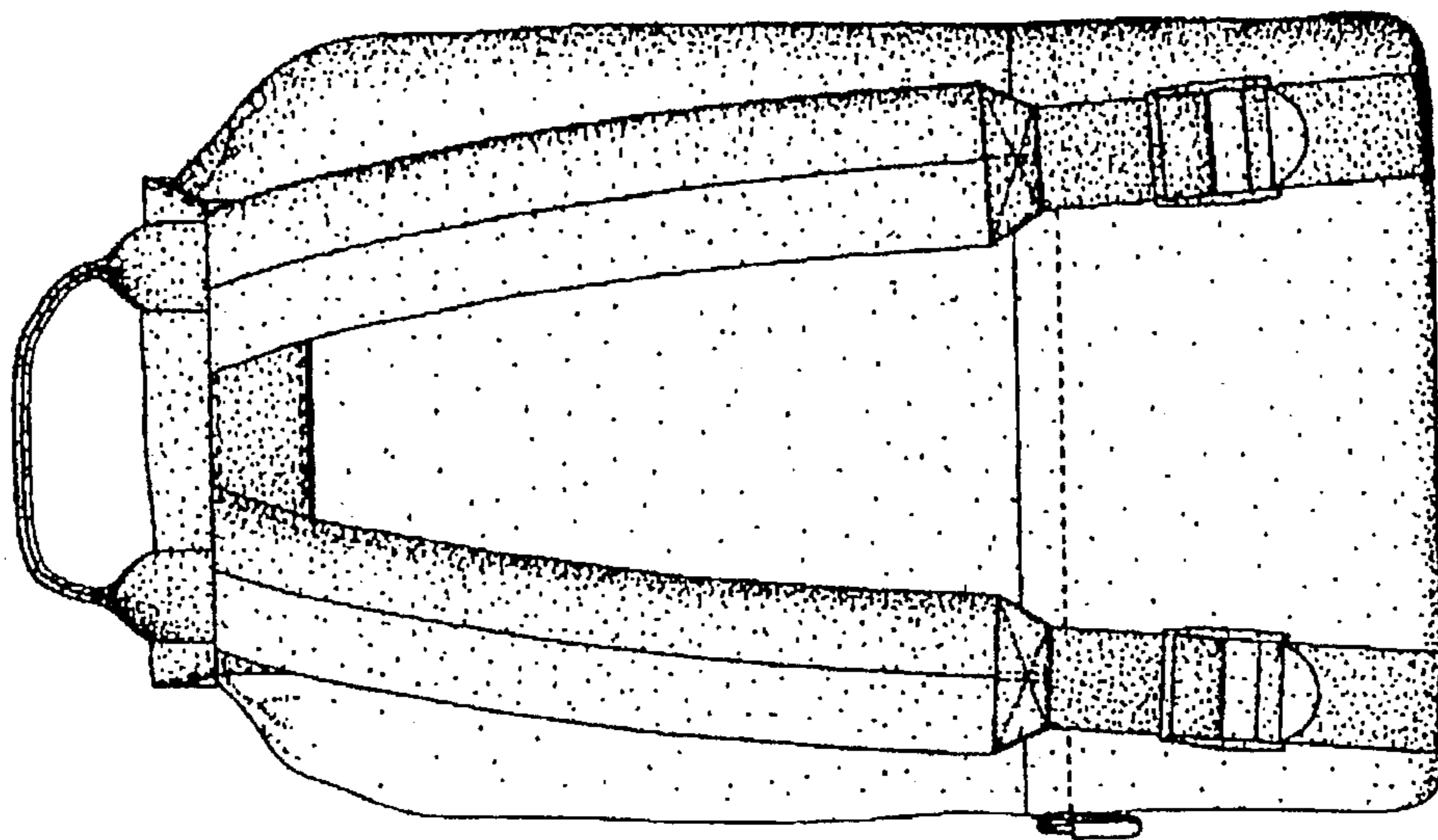

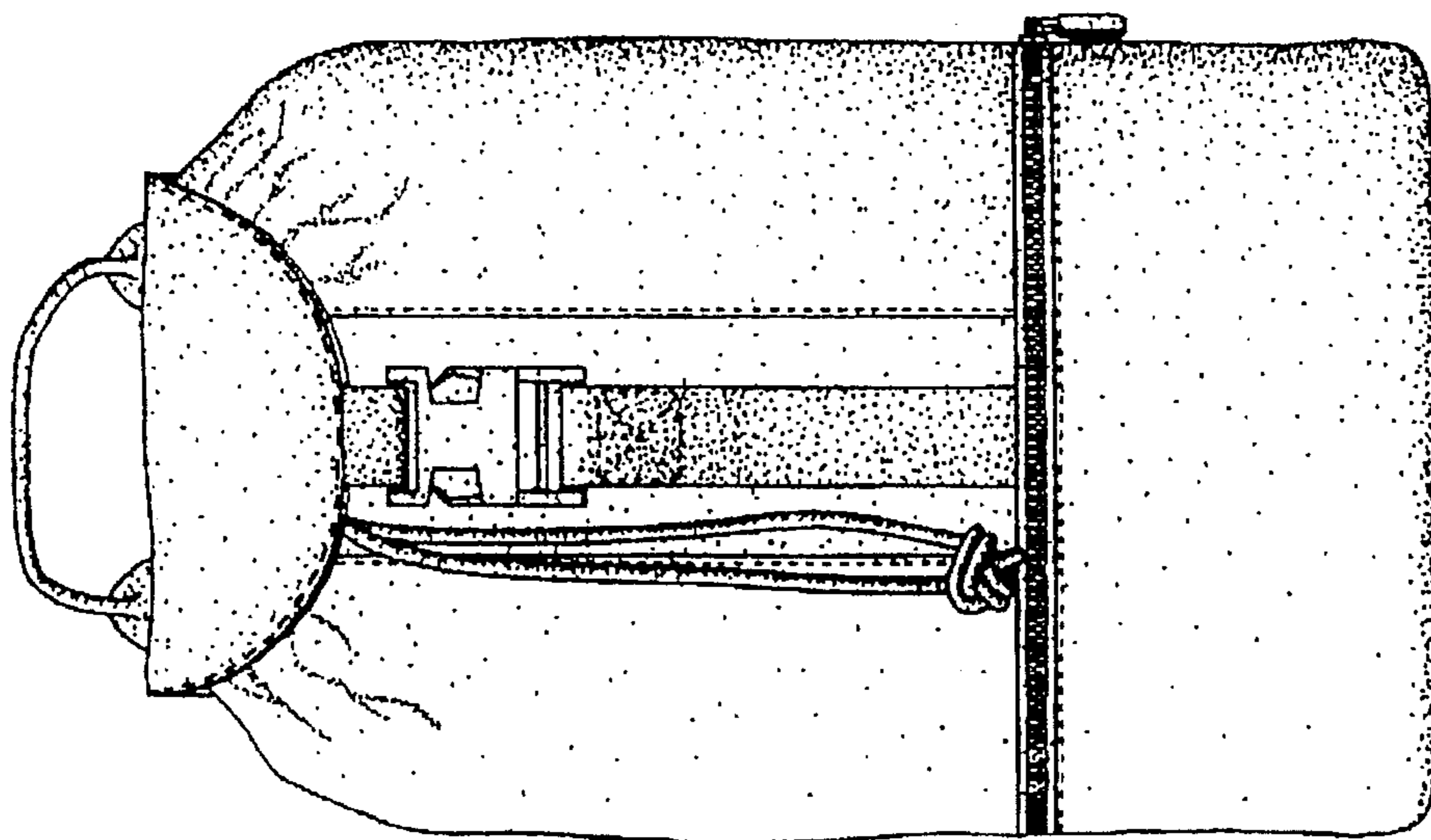

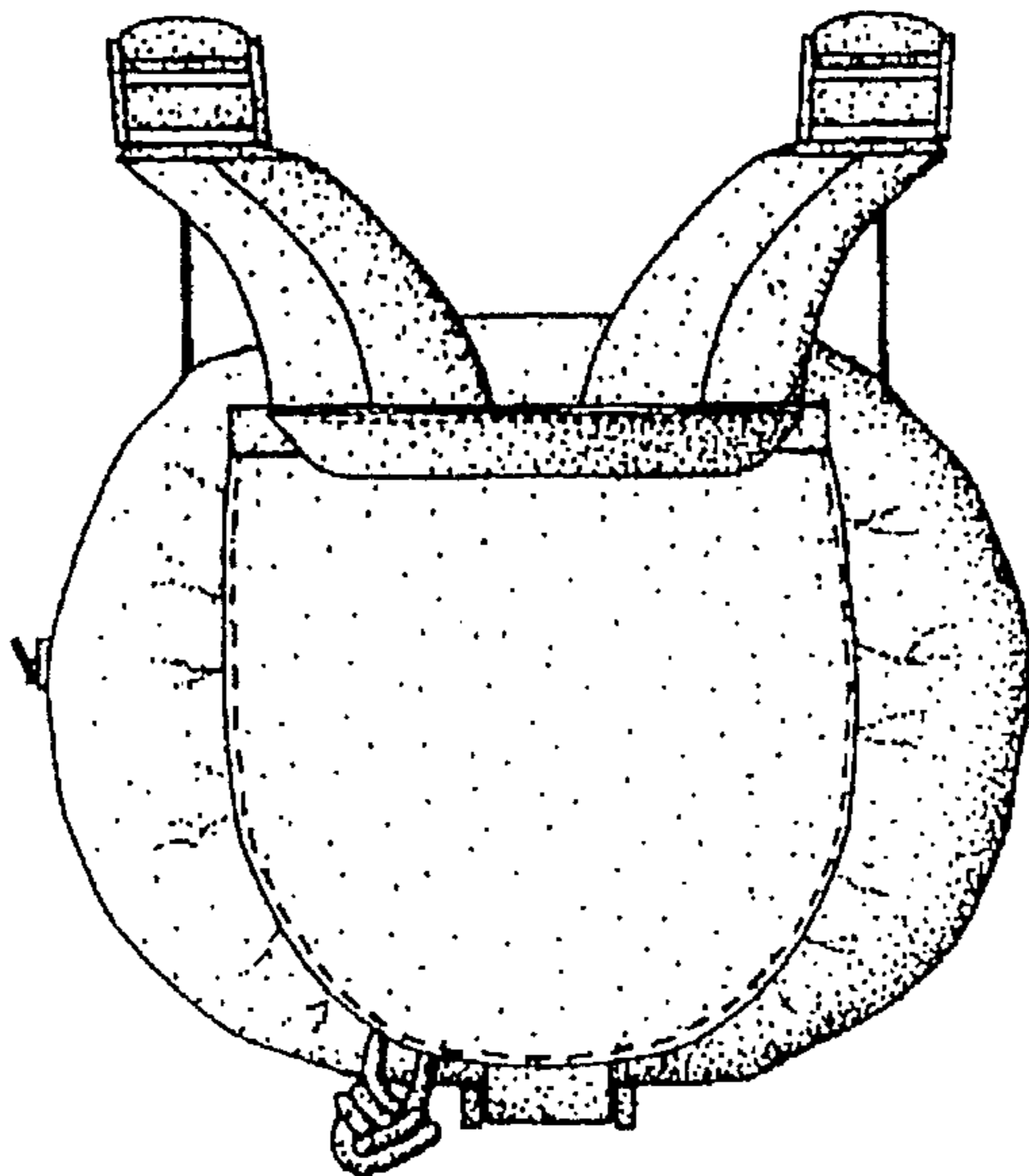

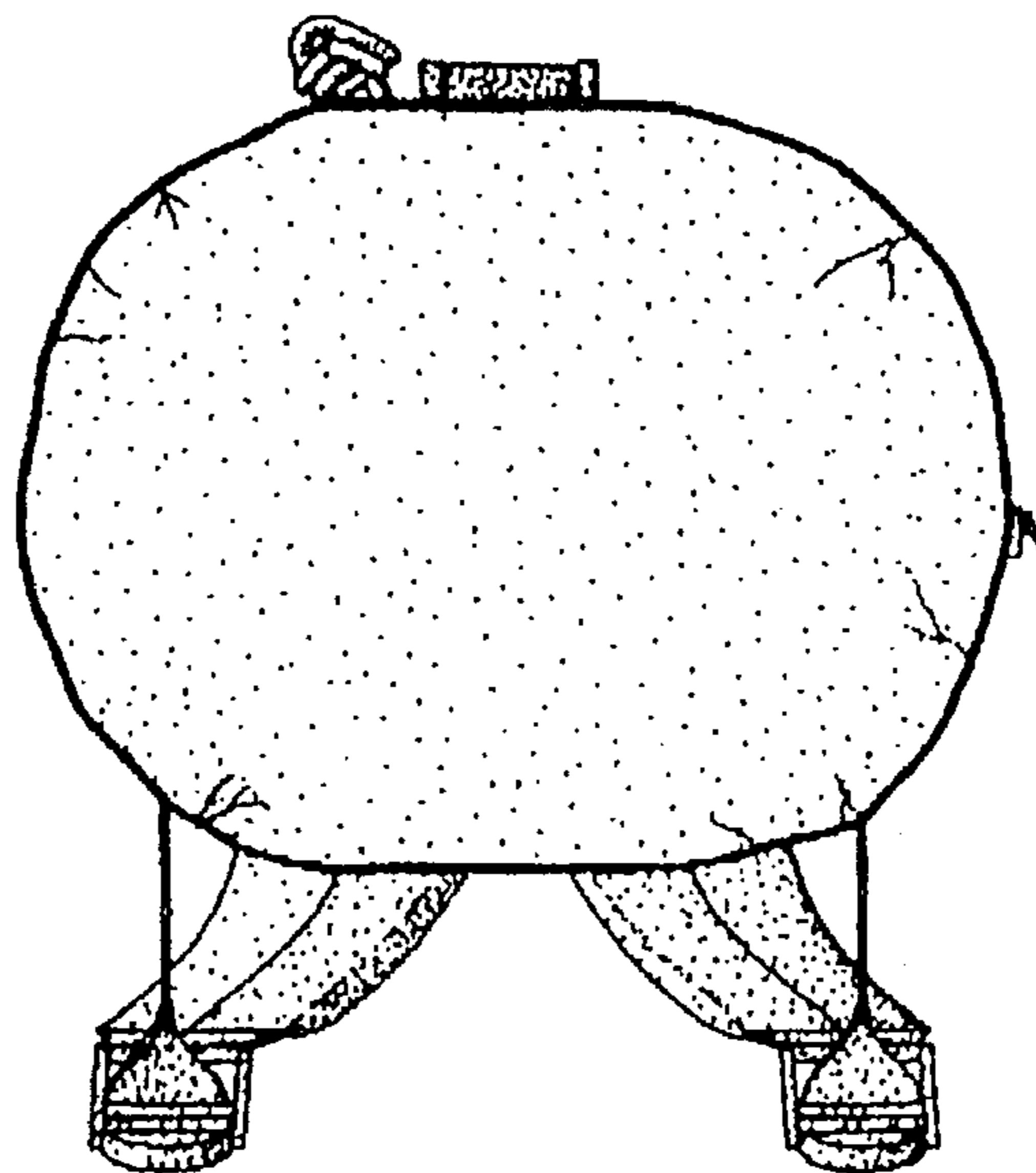

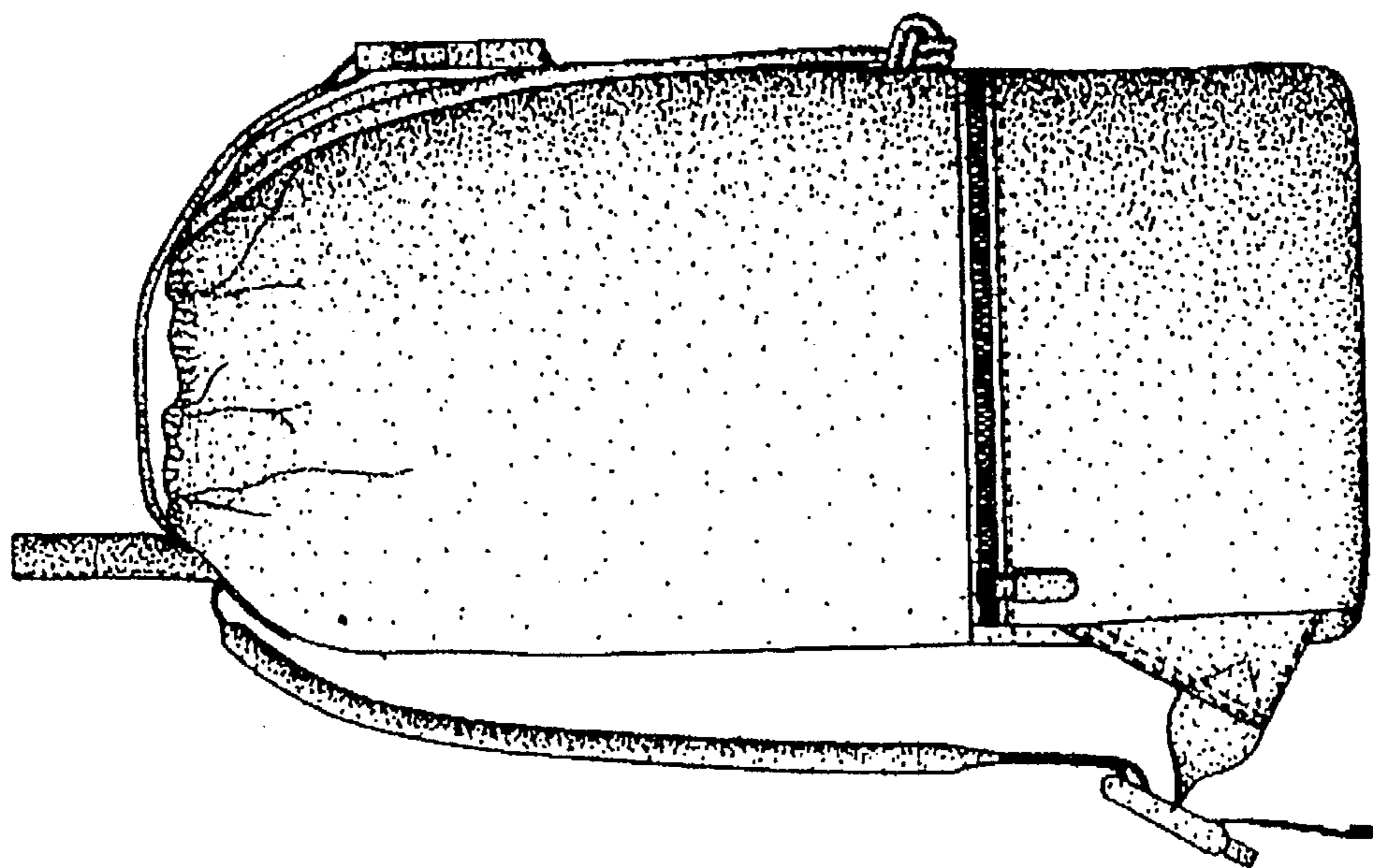

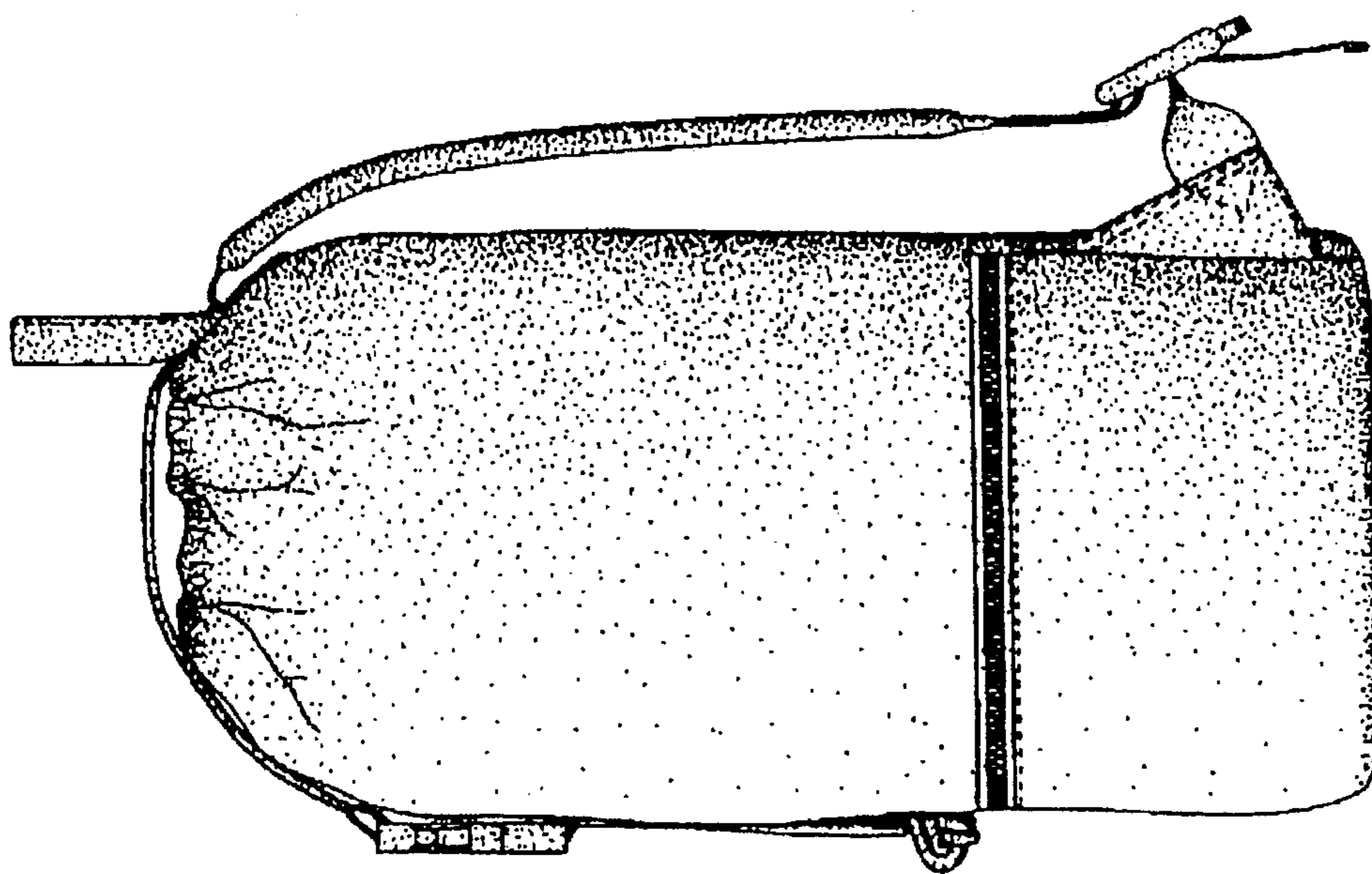

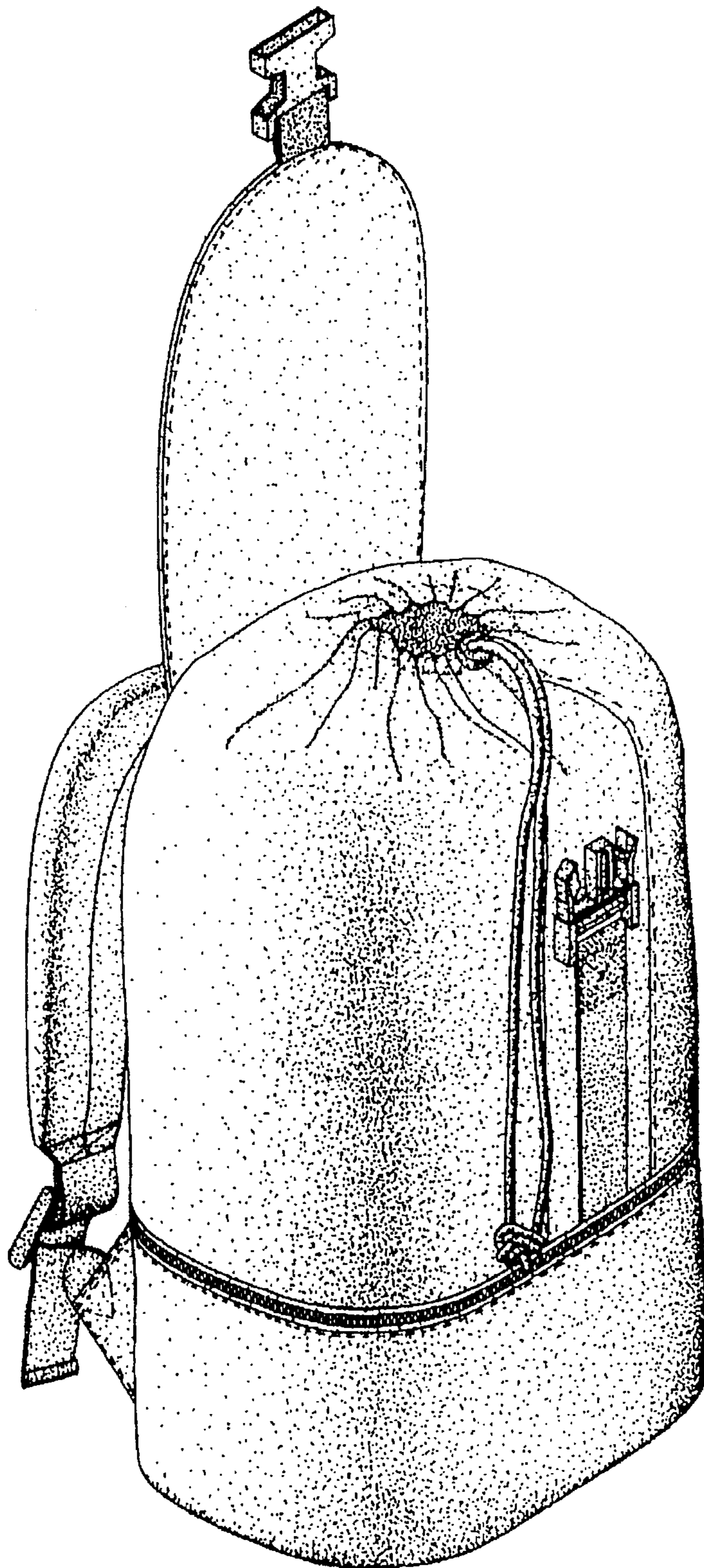

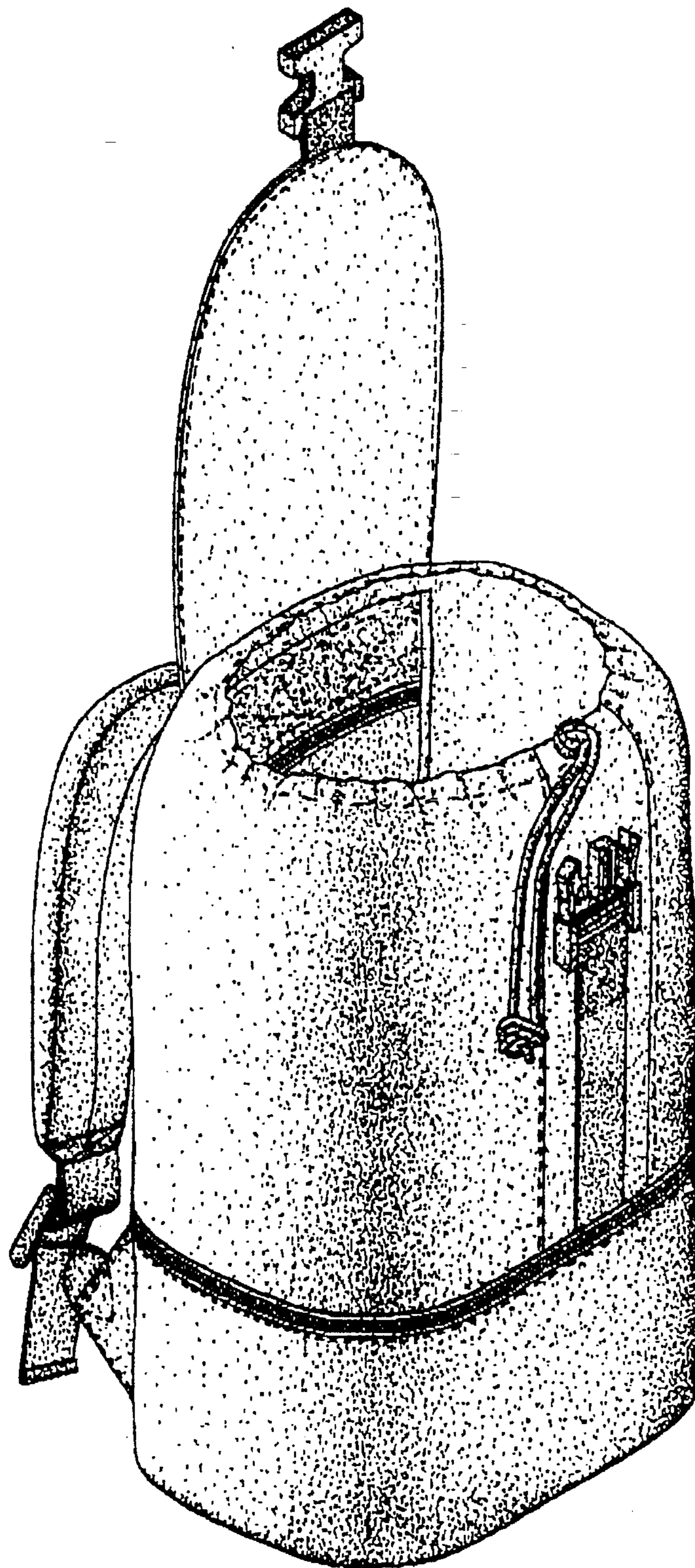
