FIG. 23 is a front elevational view of an eleventh embodiment of a shingle showing our new design;


FIG. 24 is a bottom view thereof;


FIG. 25 is a front elevational view of a twelfth embodiment of a shingle showing our new design; and,


FIG. 26 is a bottom view thereof.
























