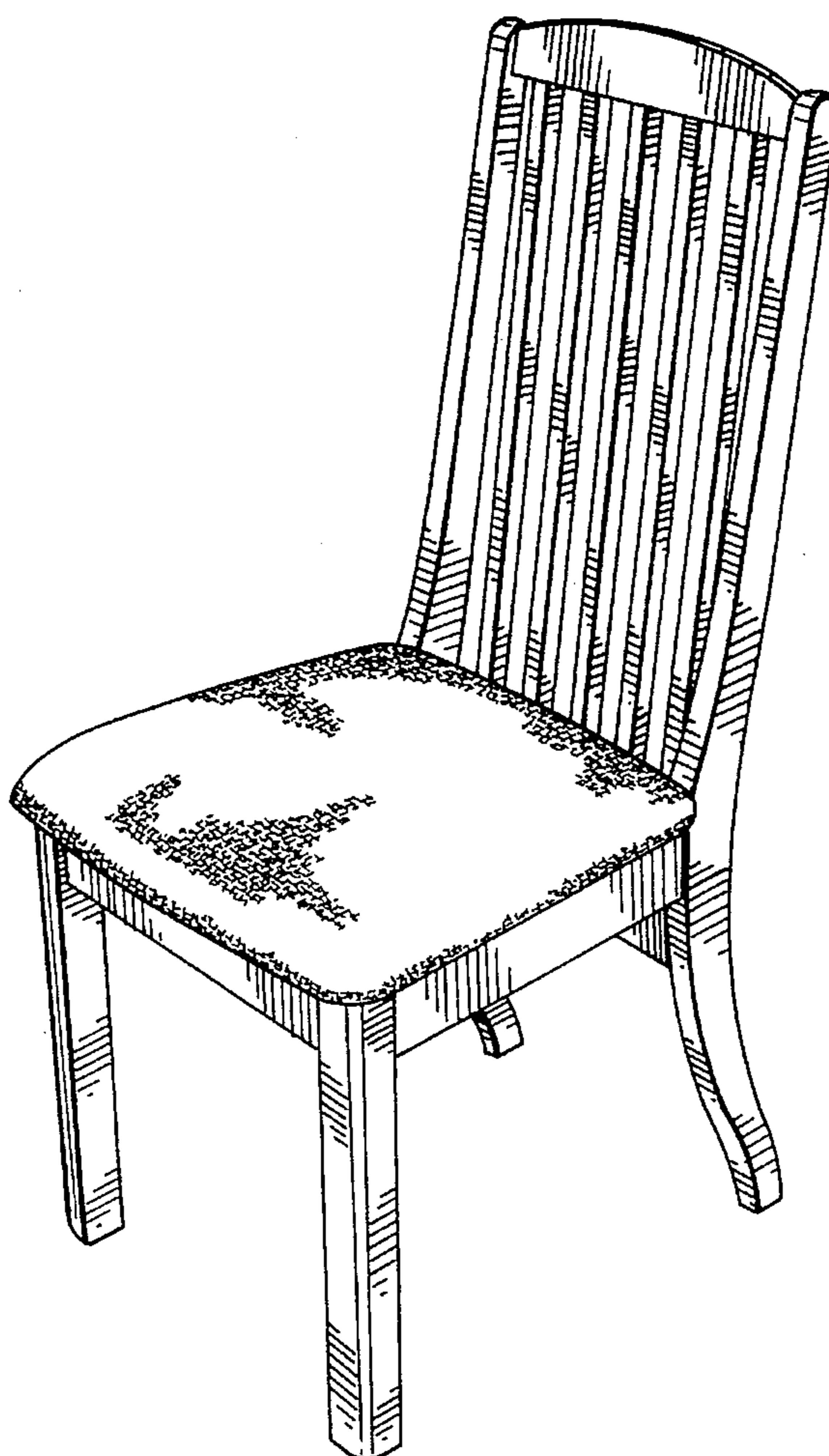
The ornamental design for a chair, as shown.

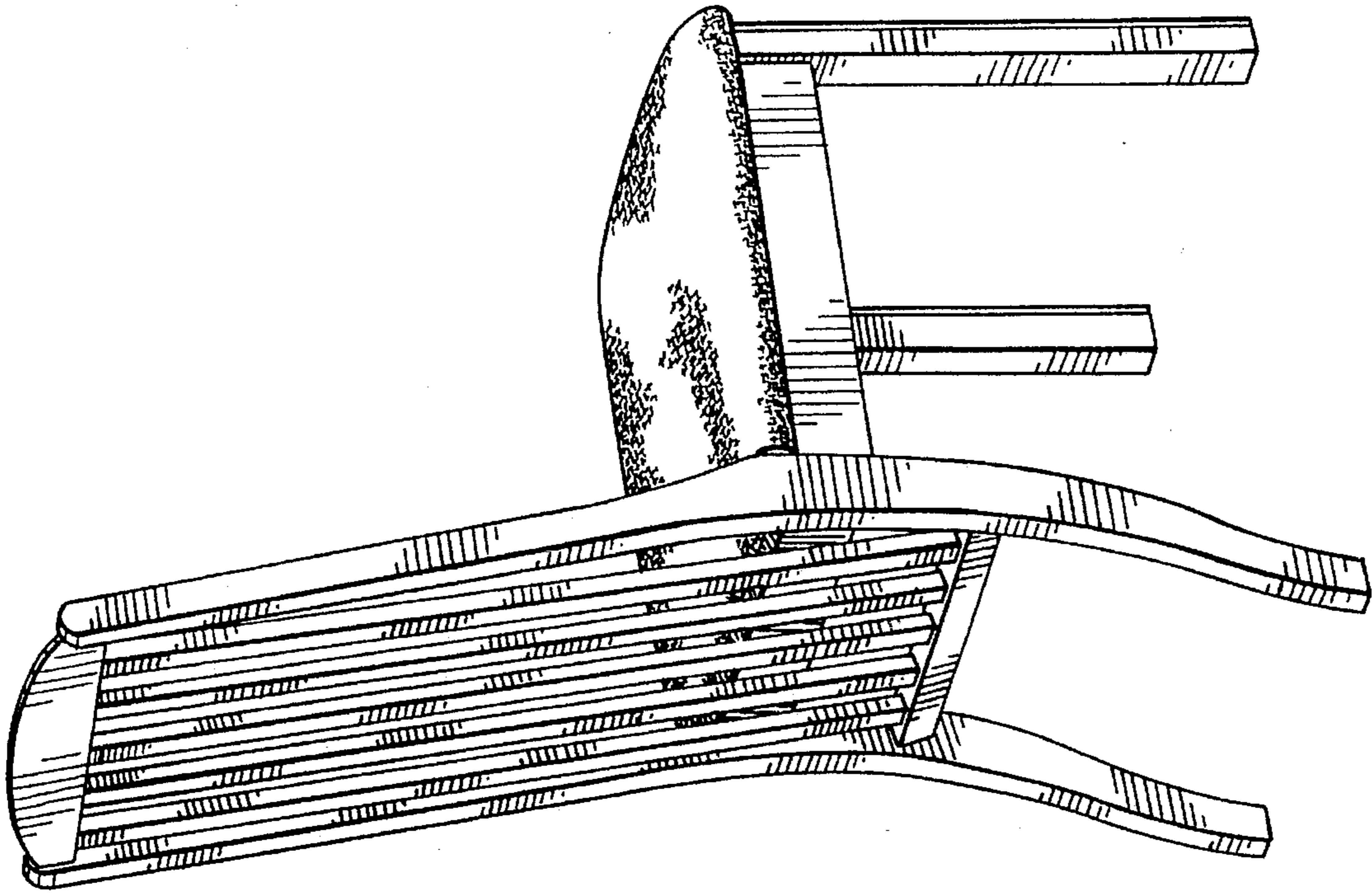

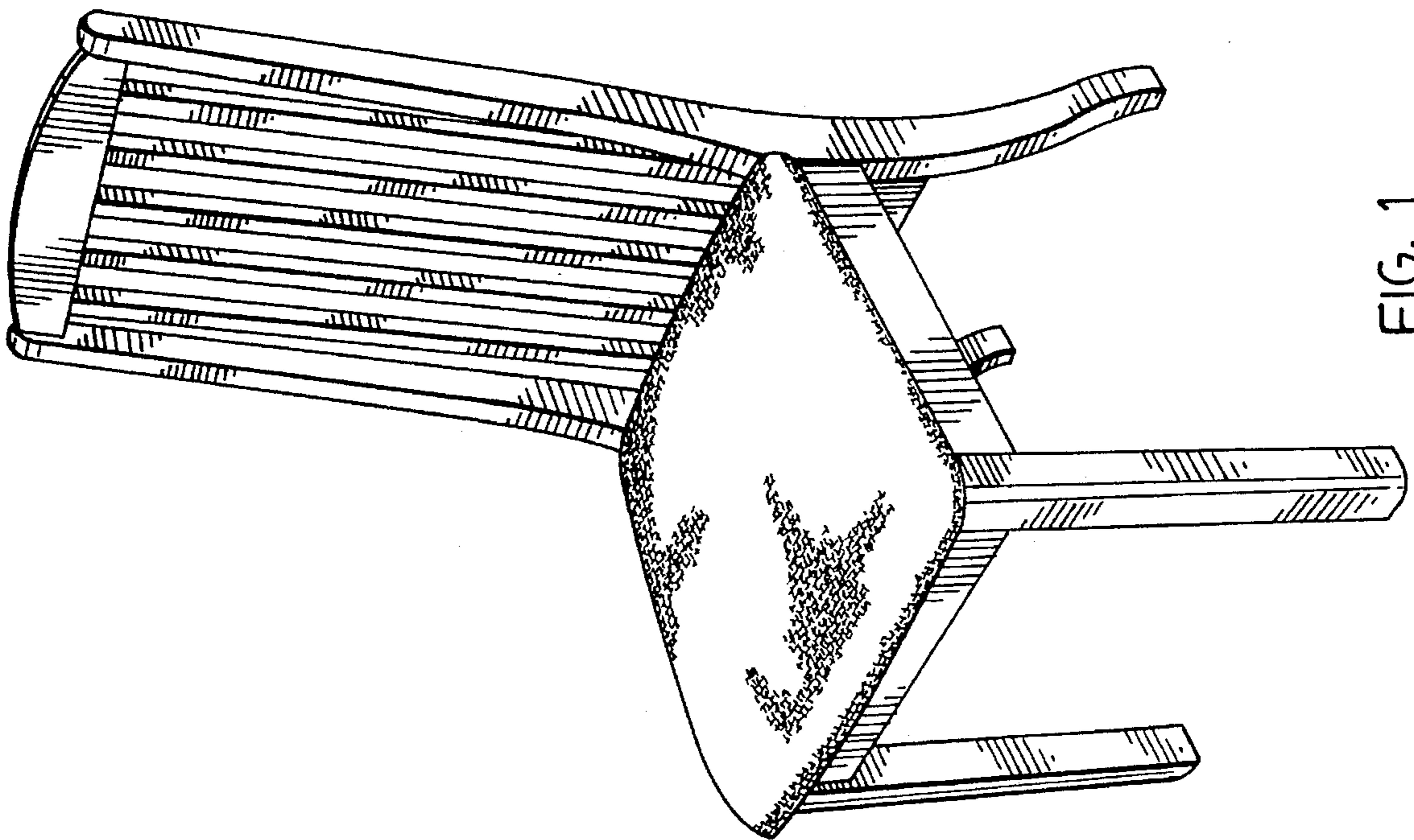
