FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;

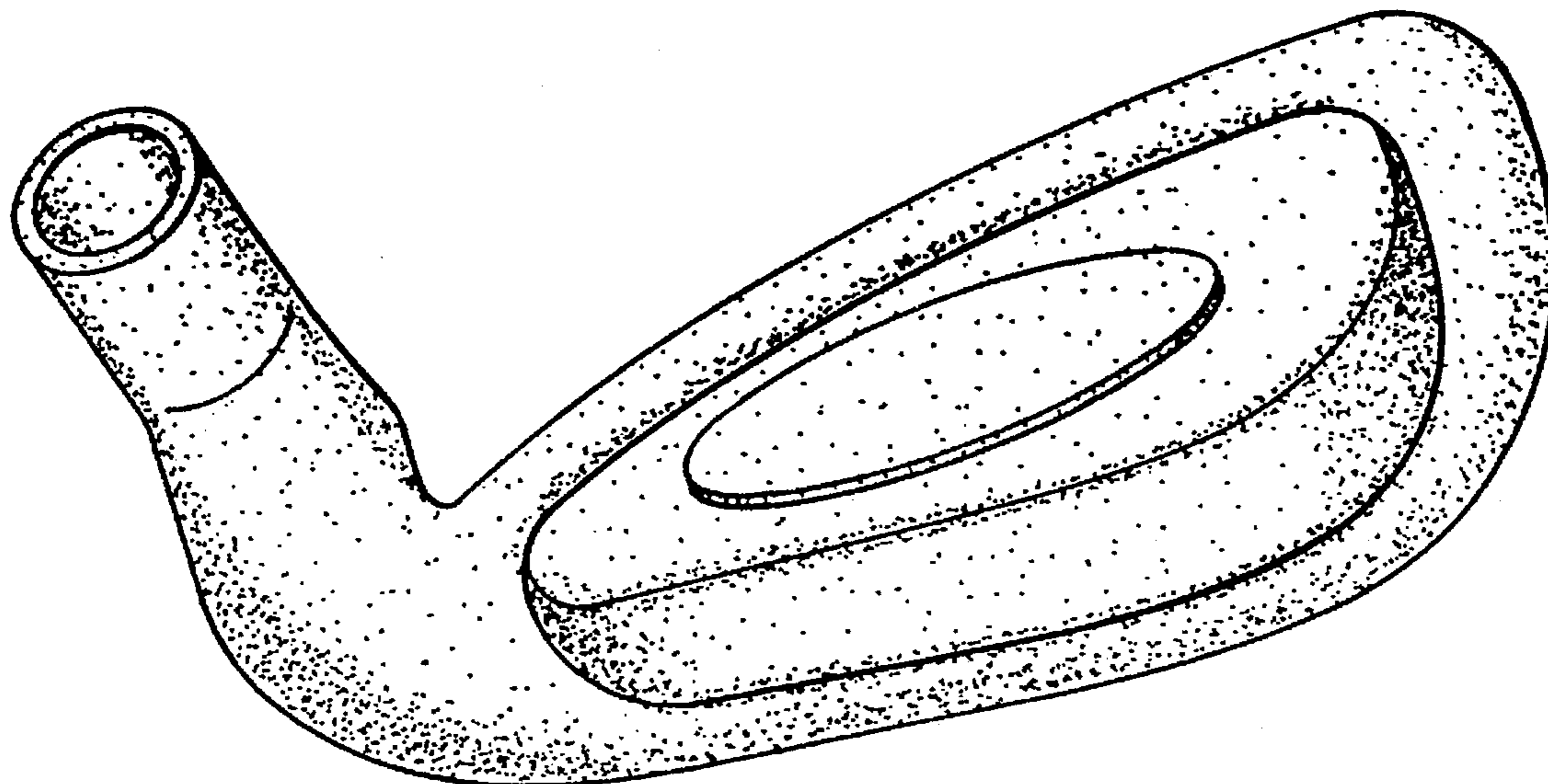
FIG. 6 is an inverted left view thereof from the toe end;

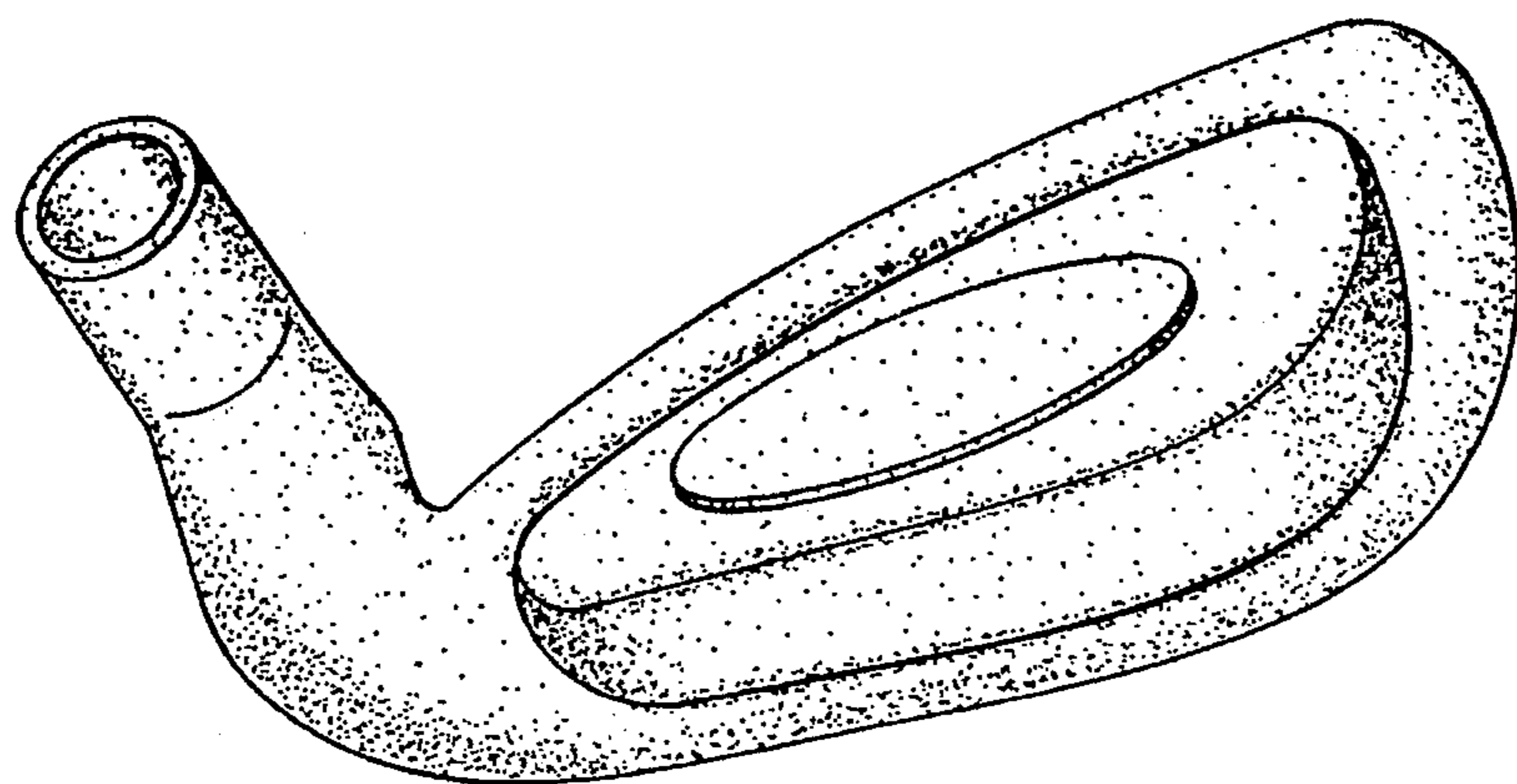
FIG. 7 is an inverted right view thereof from the heel end;

and,

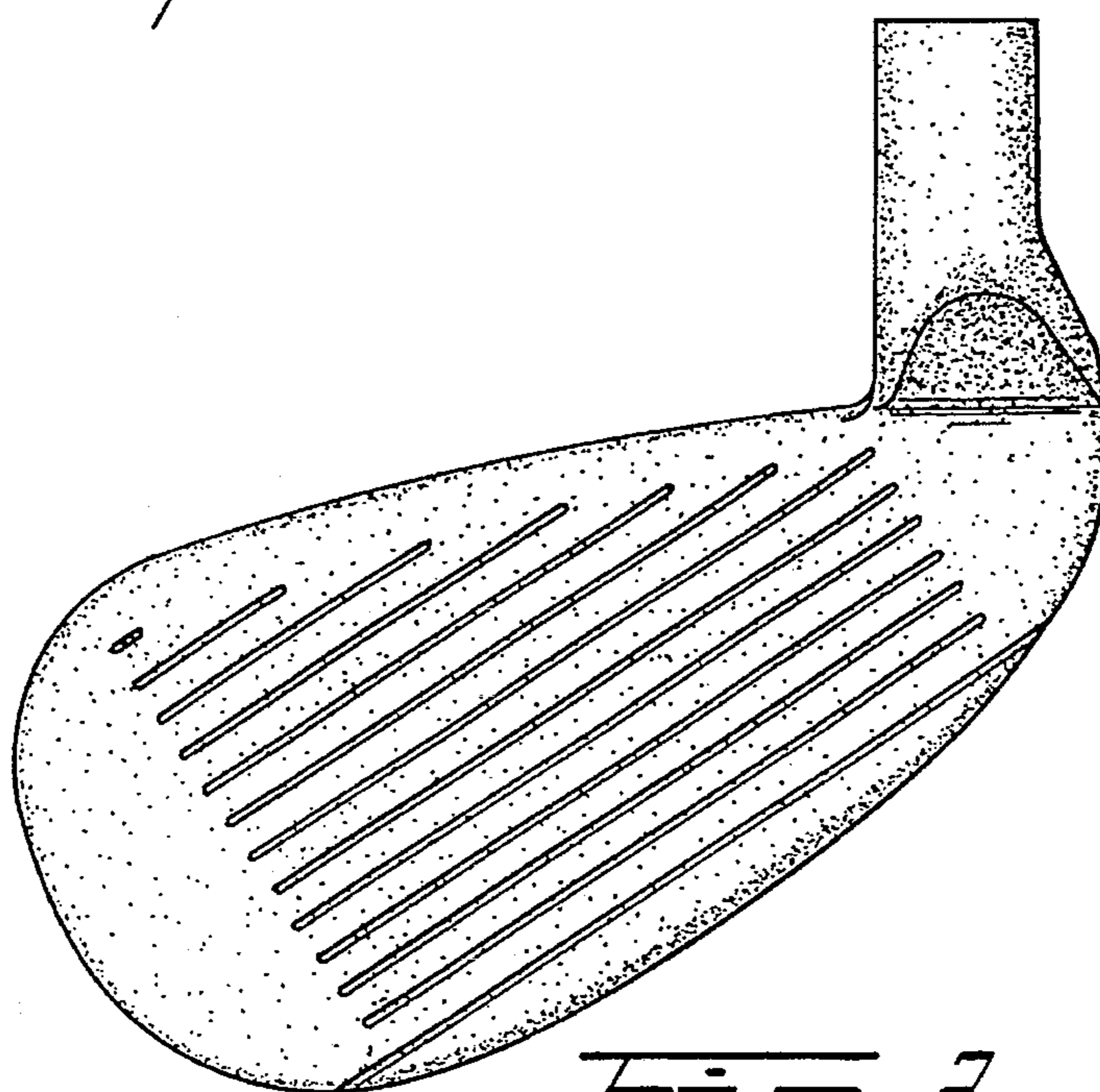

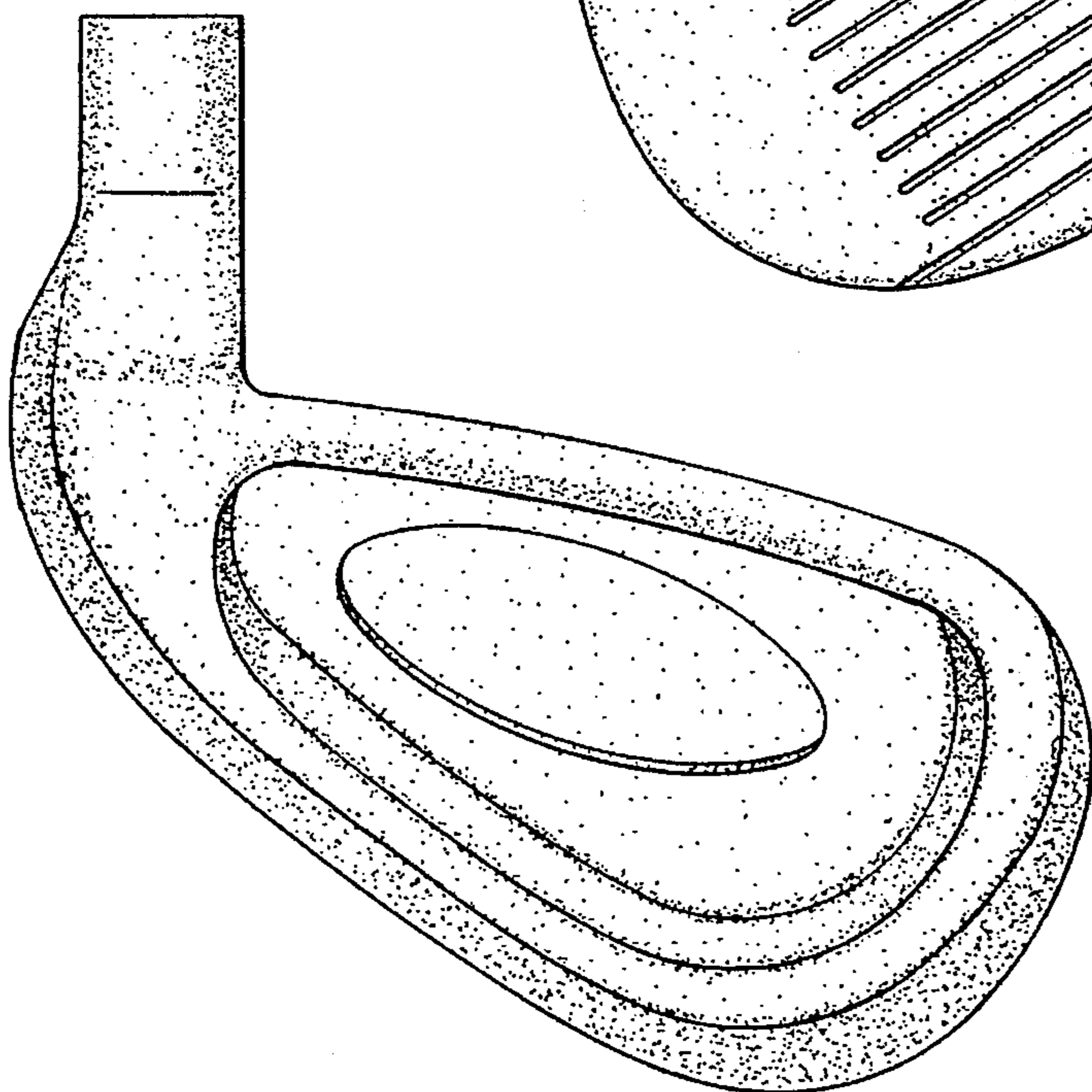

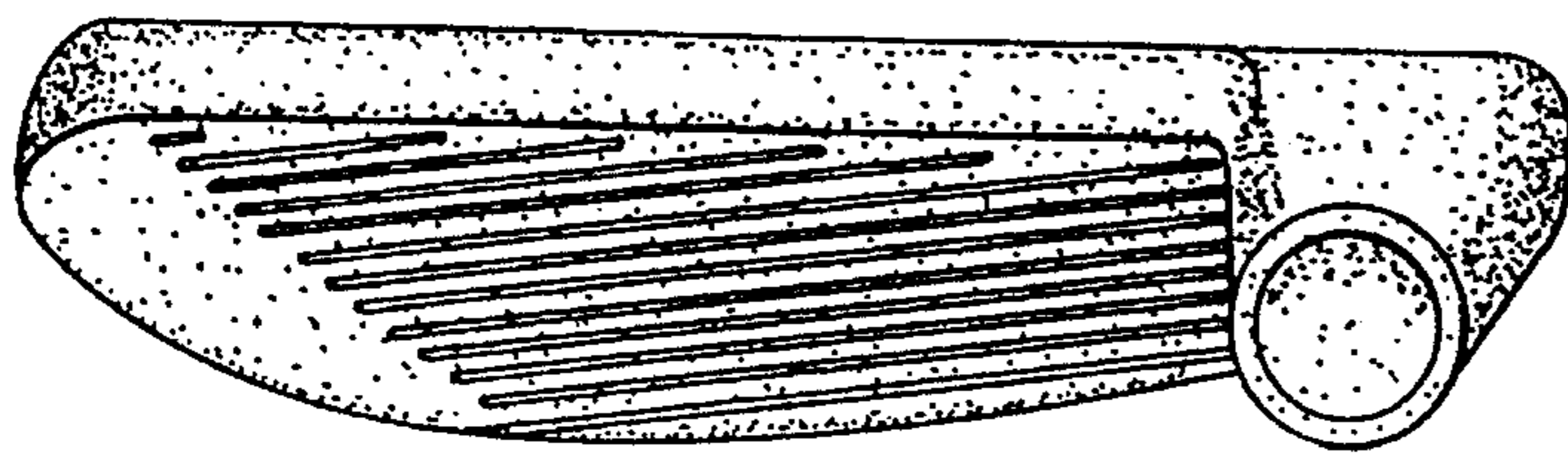

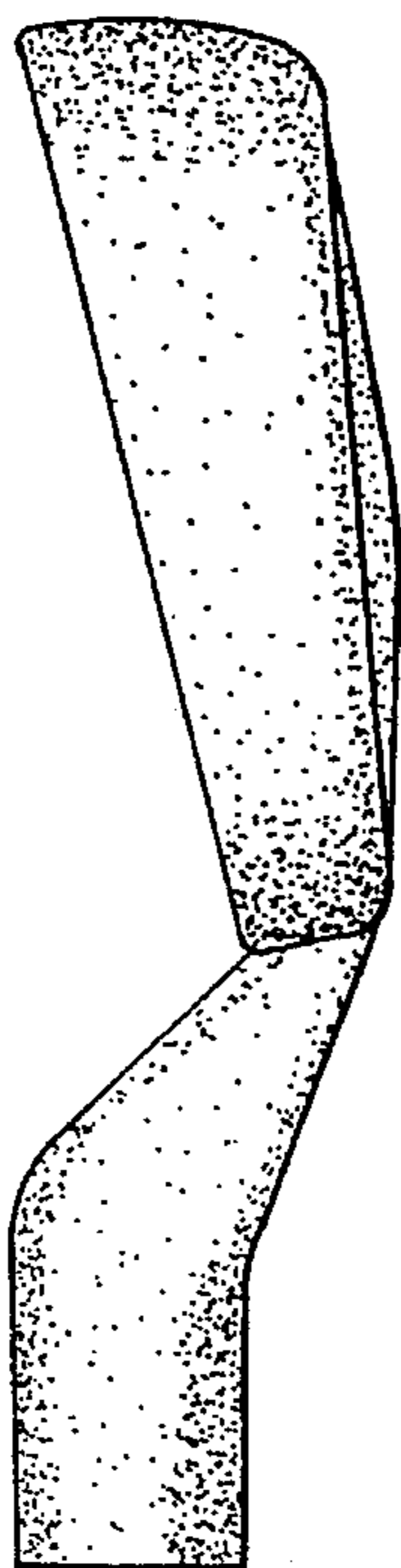
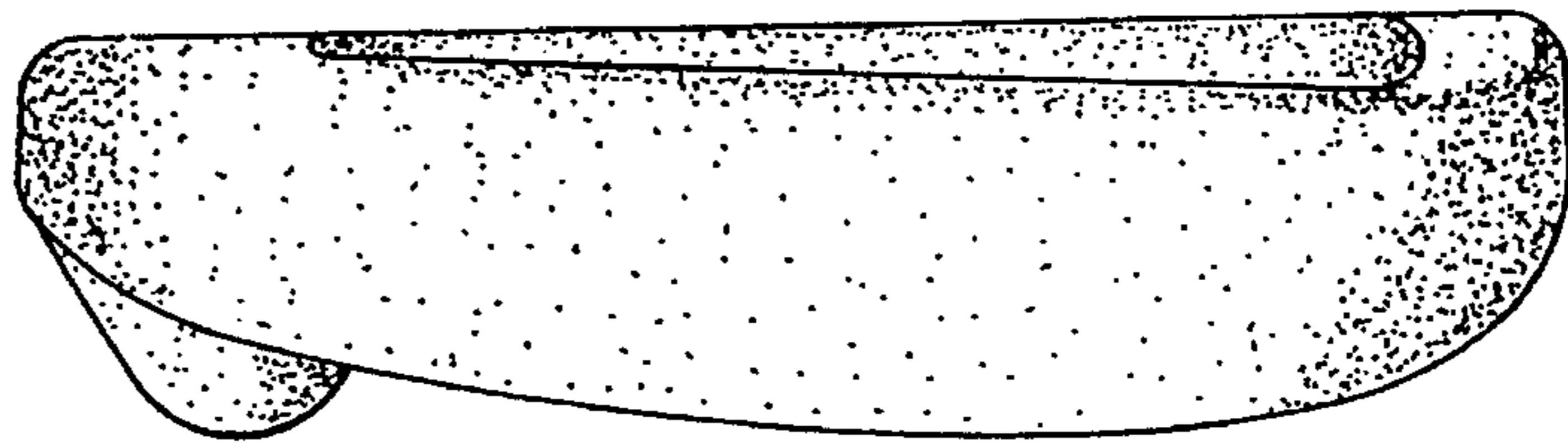

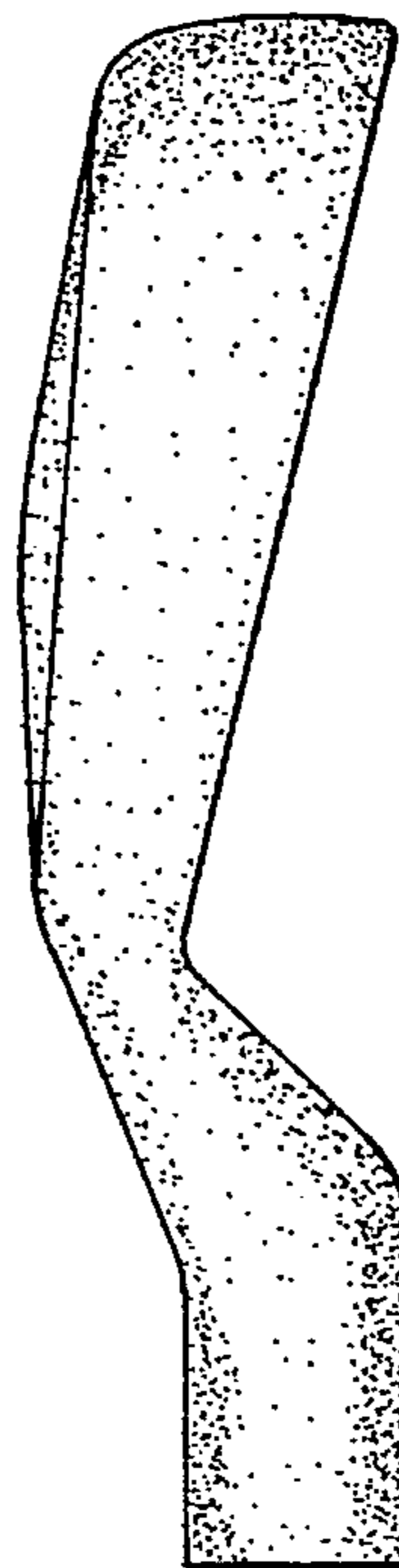

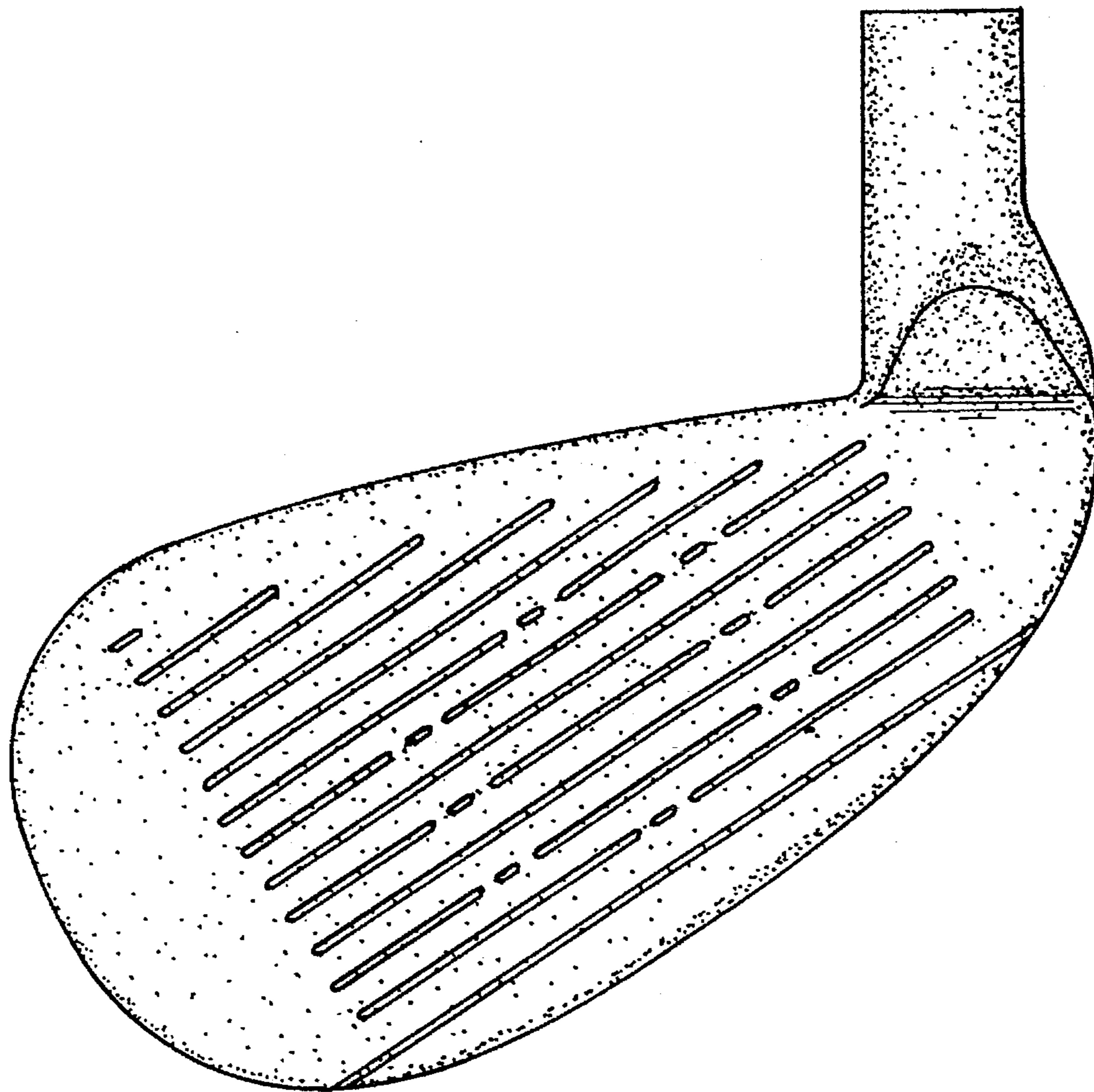
