The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, taken from the left of FIG. 2, the elevational view opposite that shown in FIG. 3 being the mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

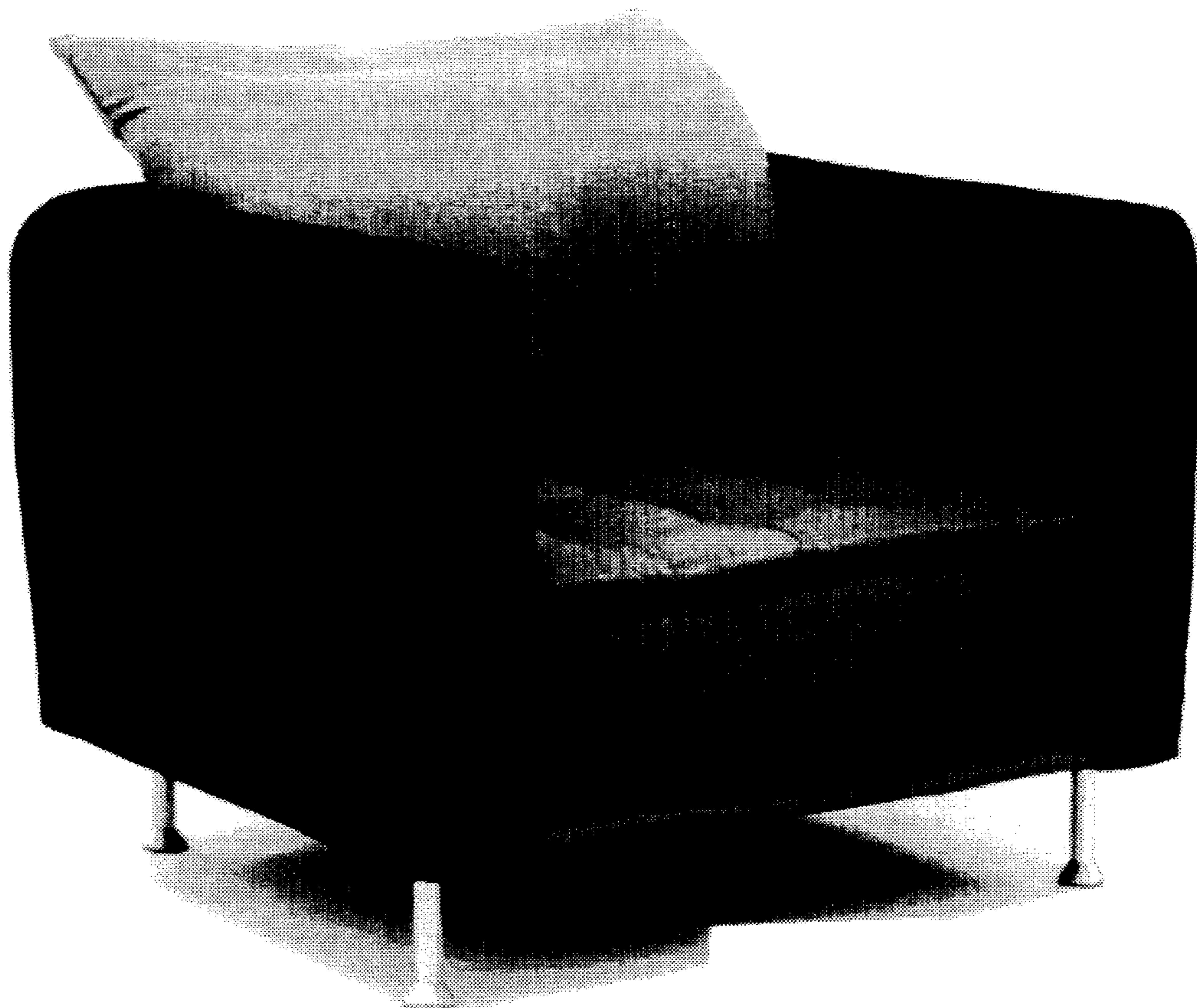

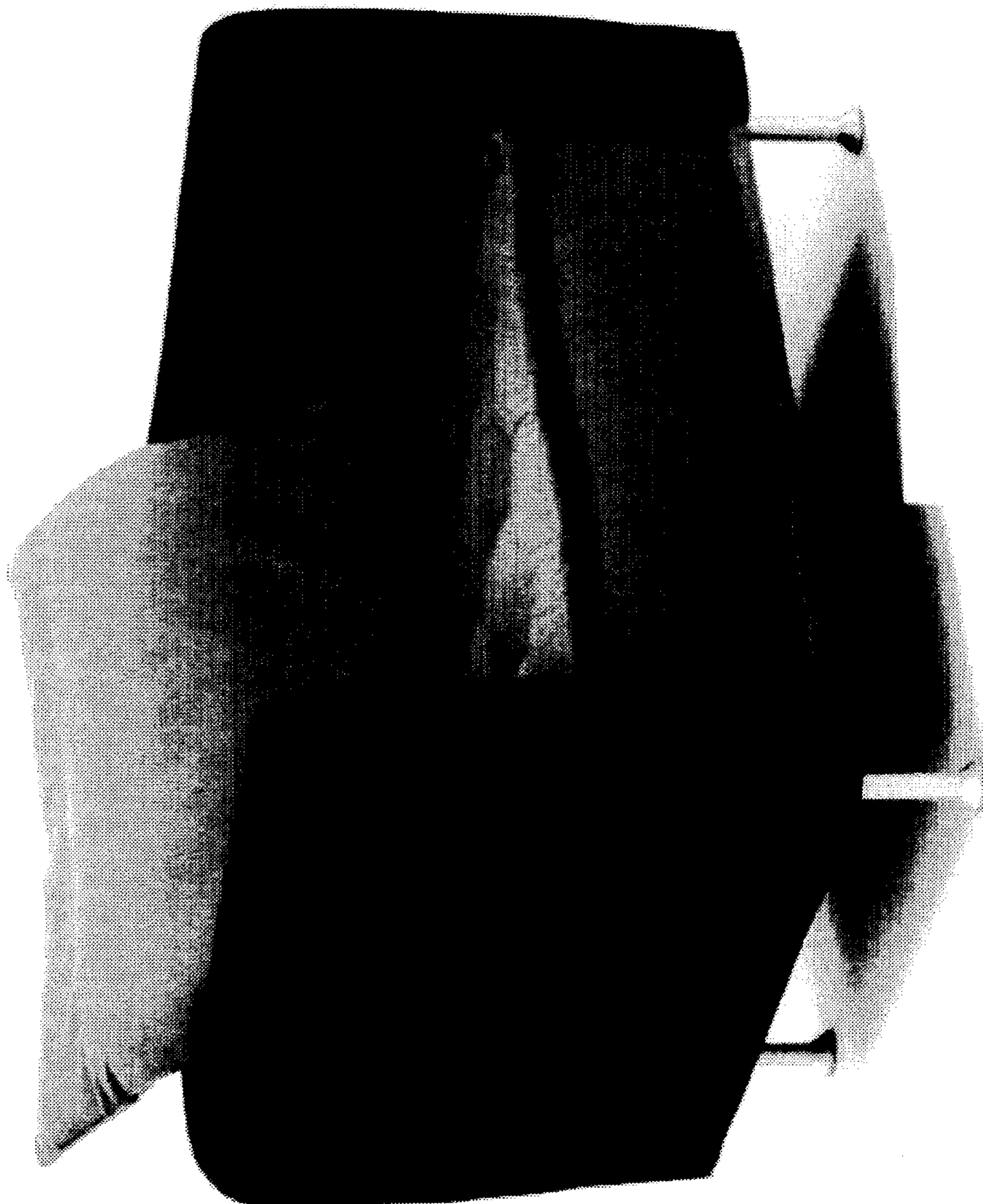

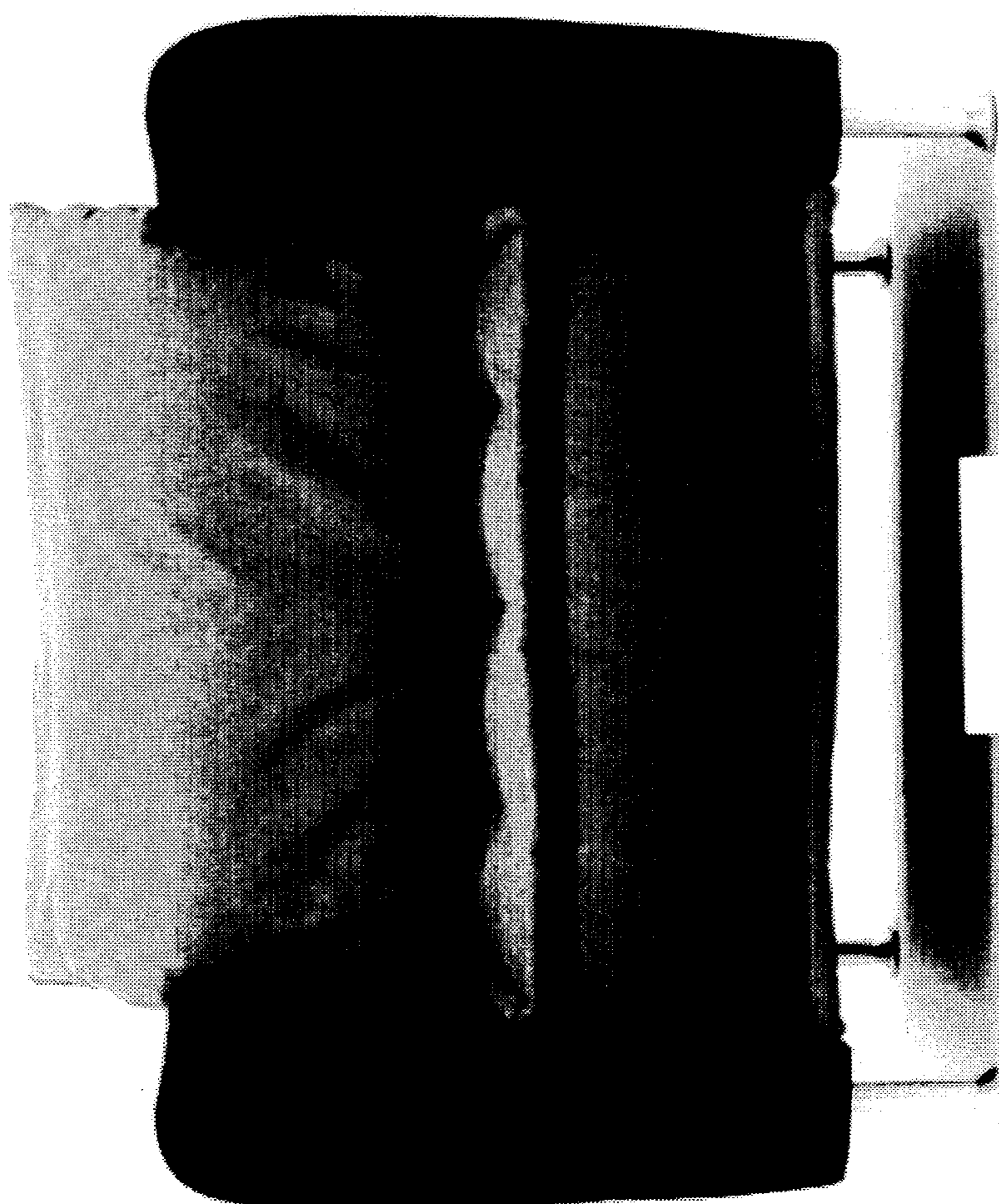

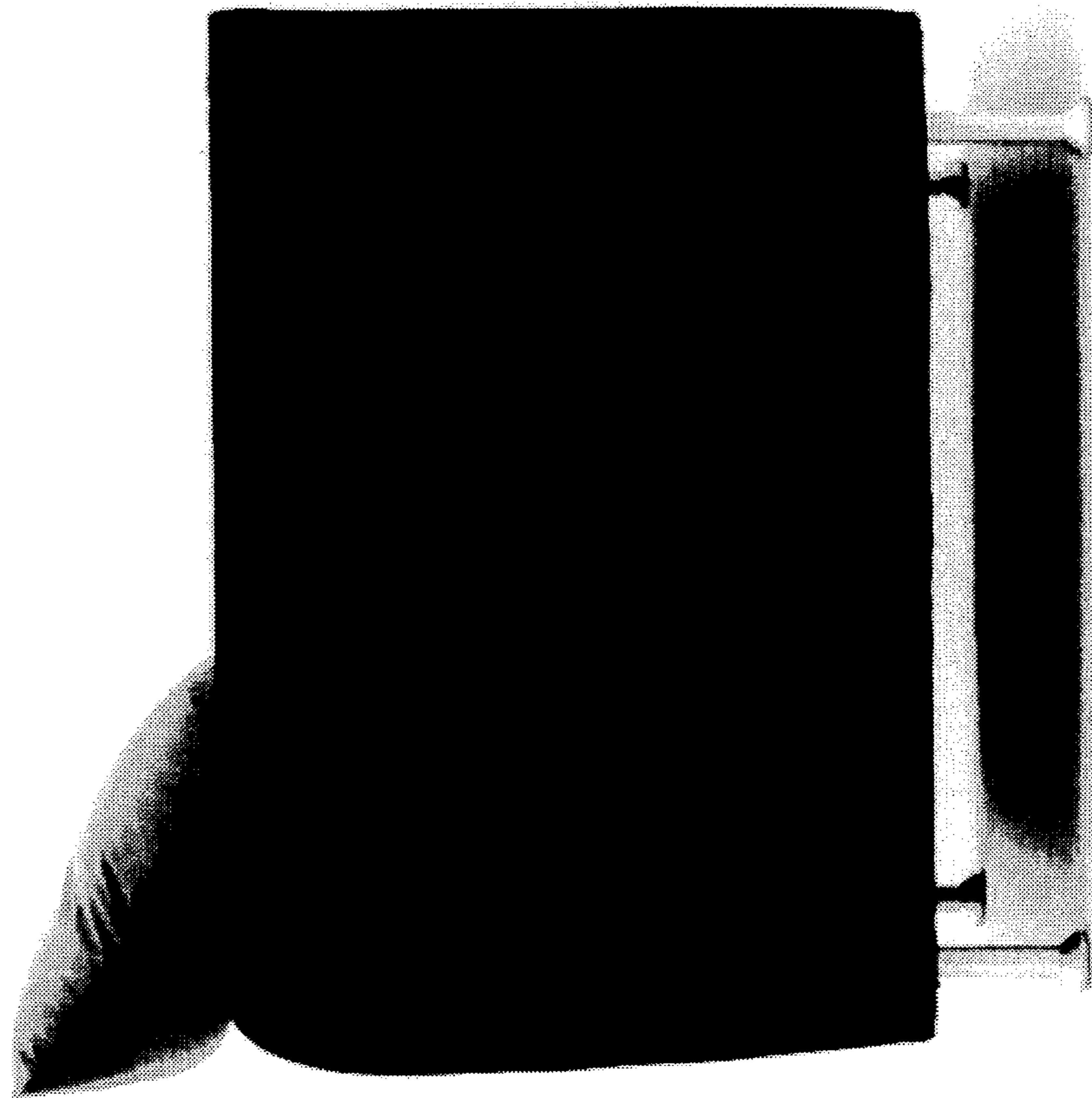

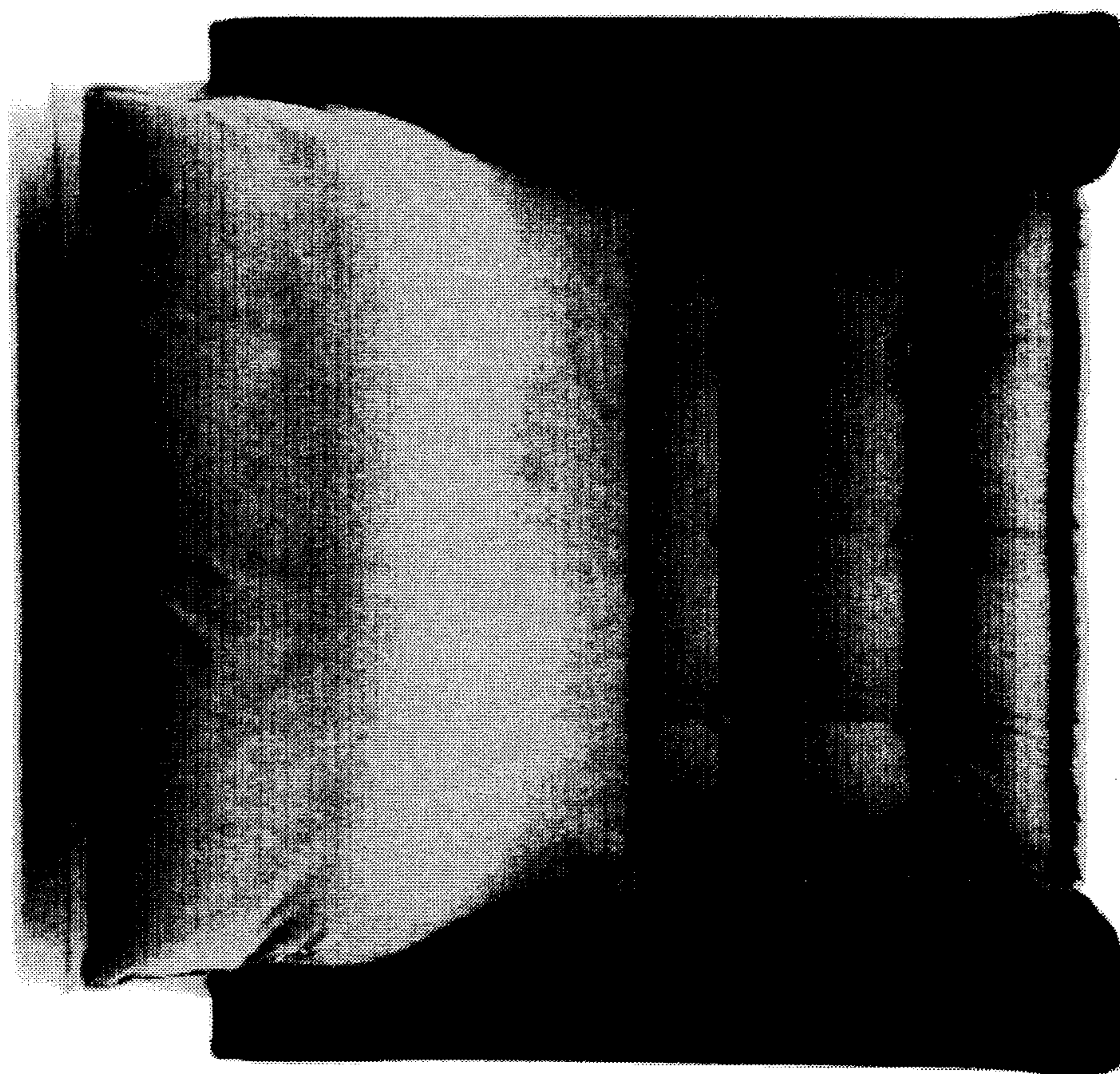
