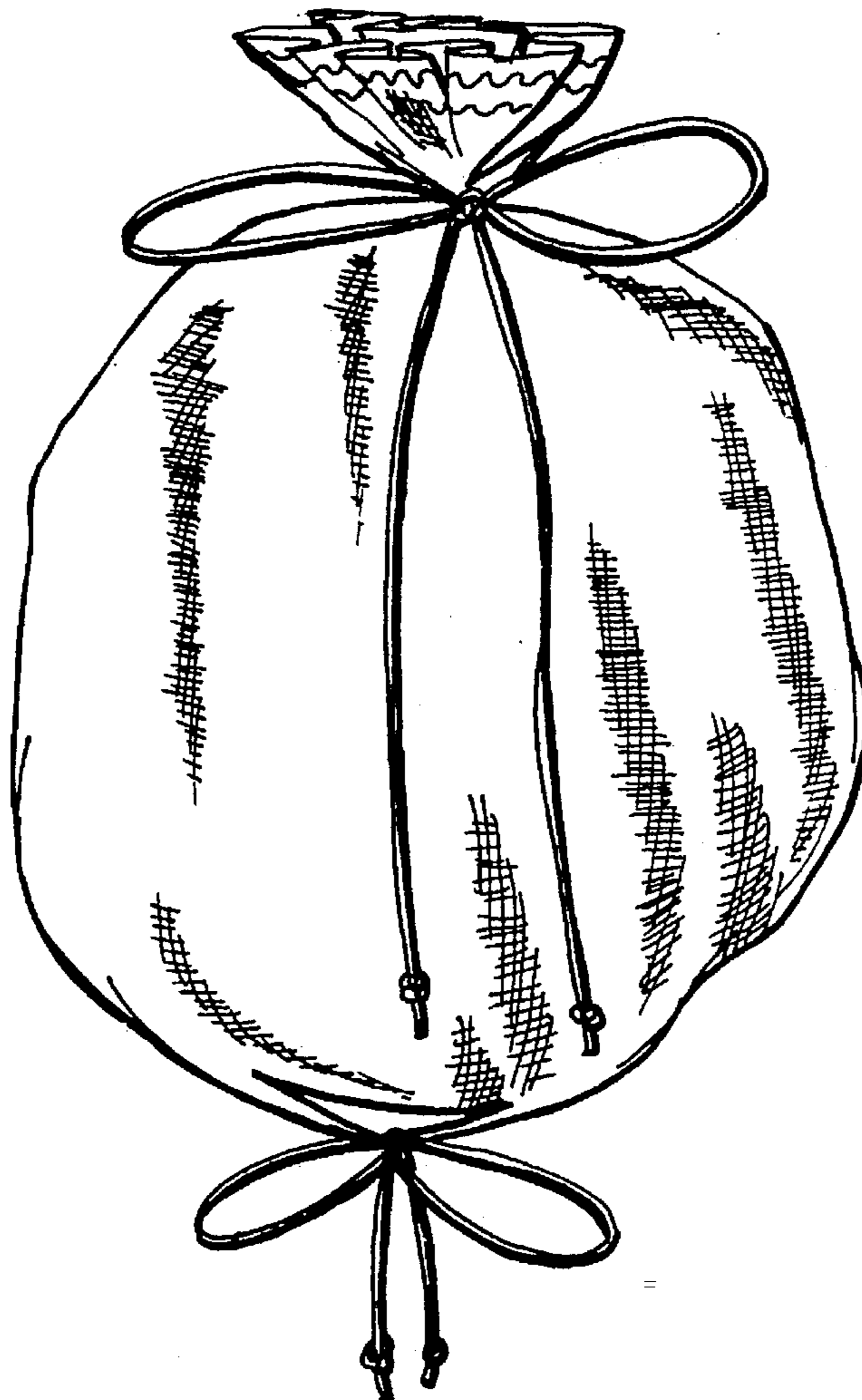
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a see through veil-type bow bag for holding bows and/or ribbons, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the see through veil-type bow bag for holding bows and/or ribbons;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of the see through veil-type bow bag for holding bows and/or ribbons shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 7;
 FIG. 9 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 7;
 FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 7;
 FIG. 11 is a top plan view of FIG. 7; and
 FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7.

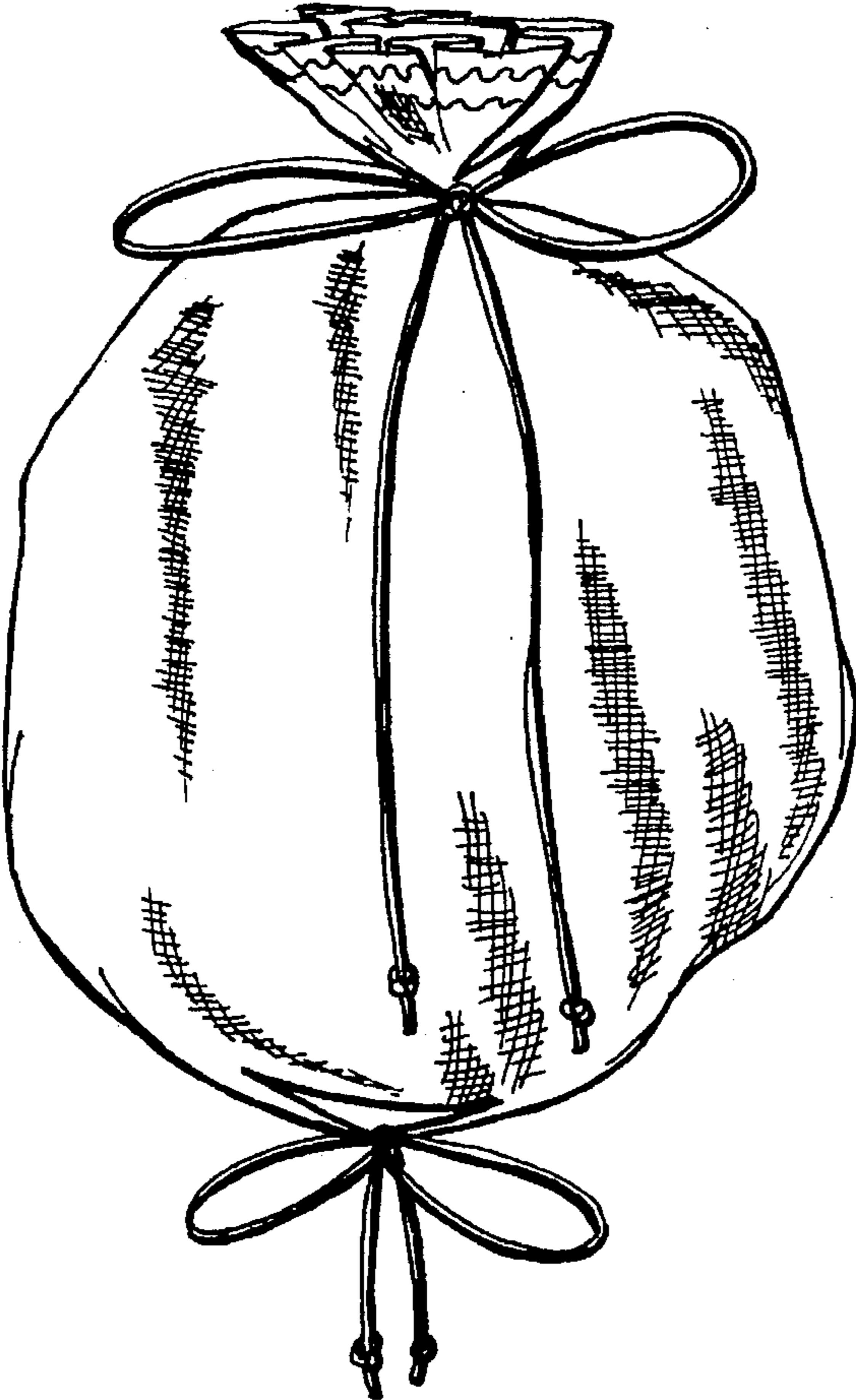

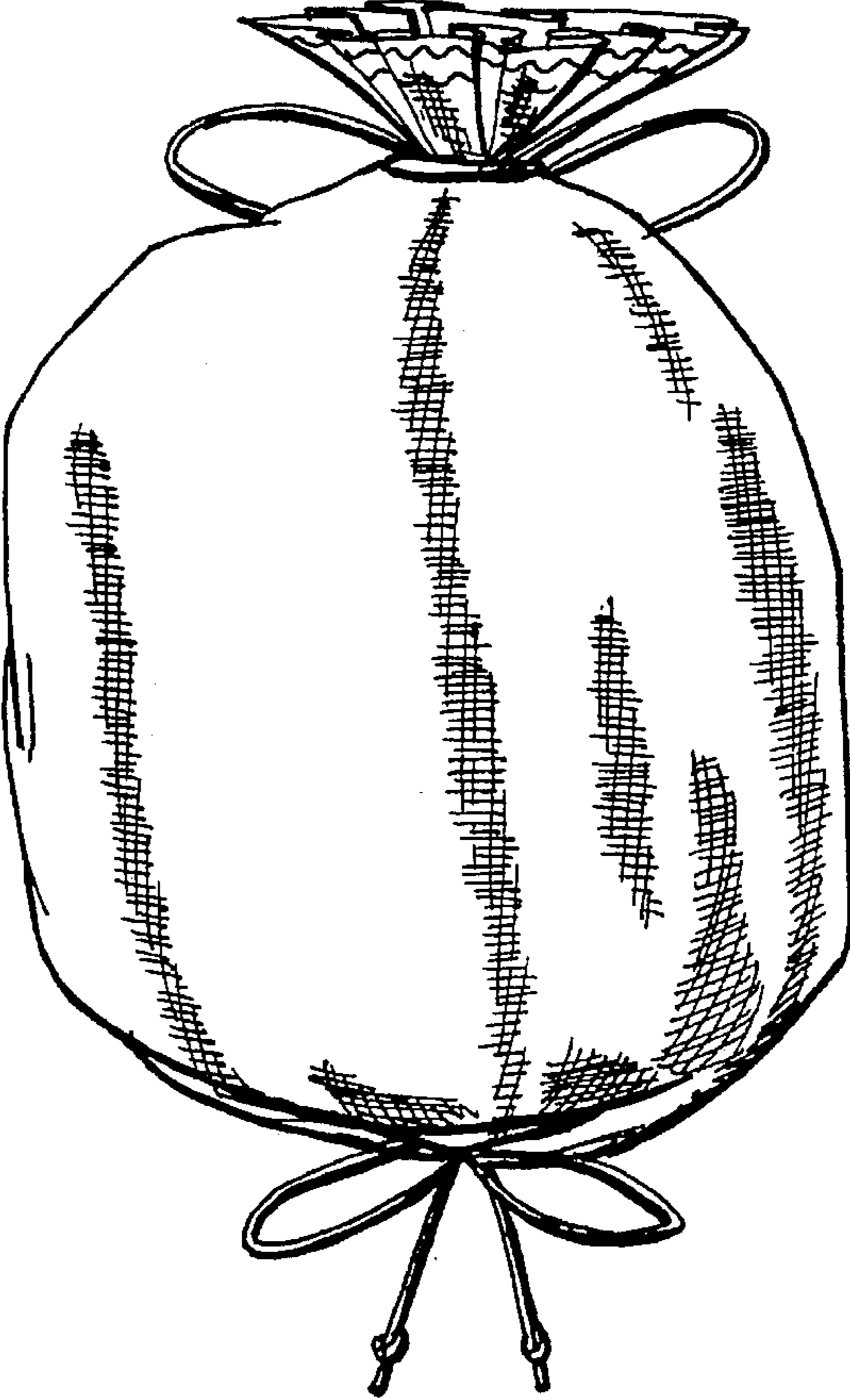

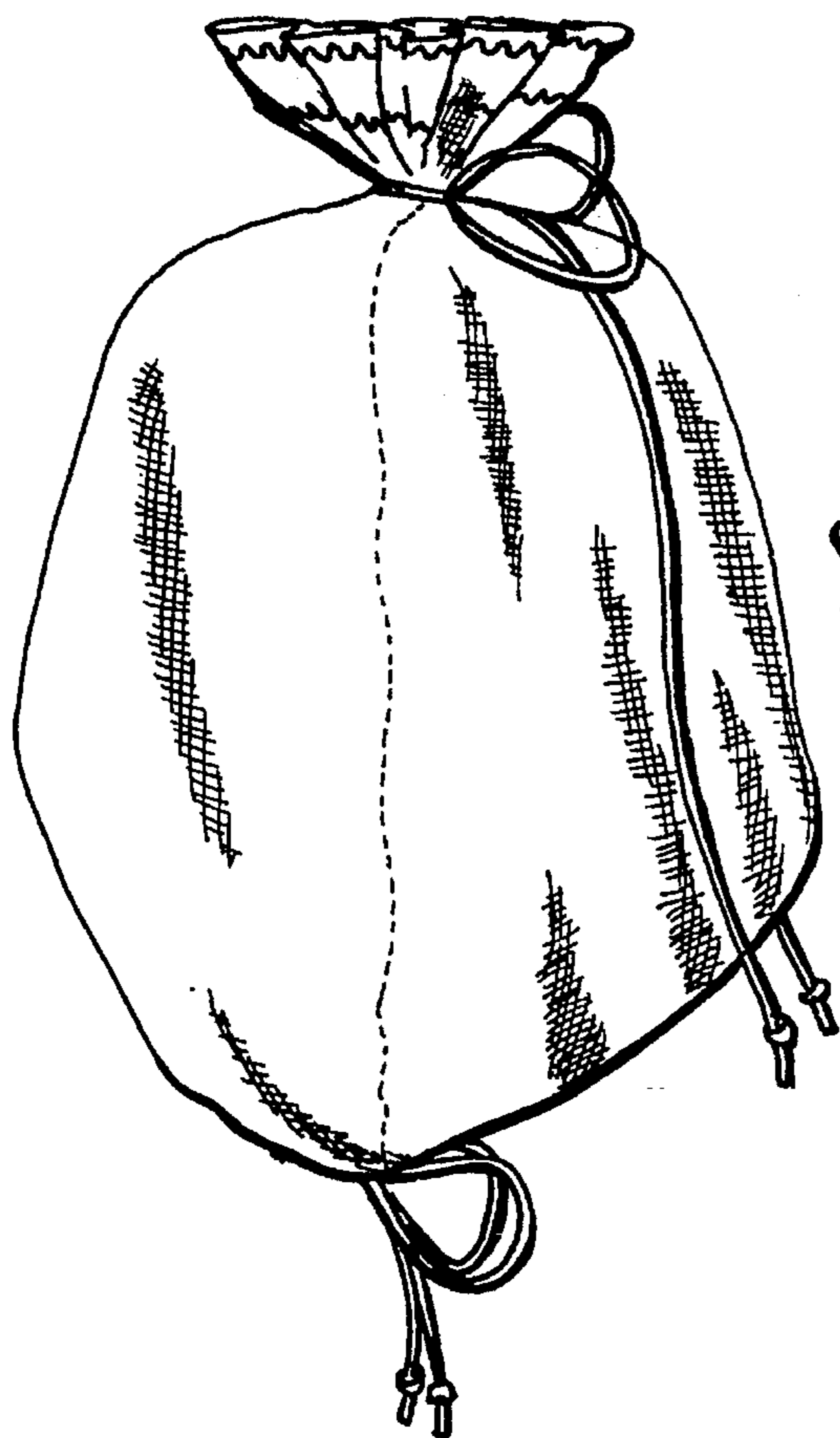

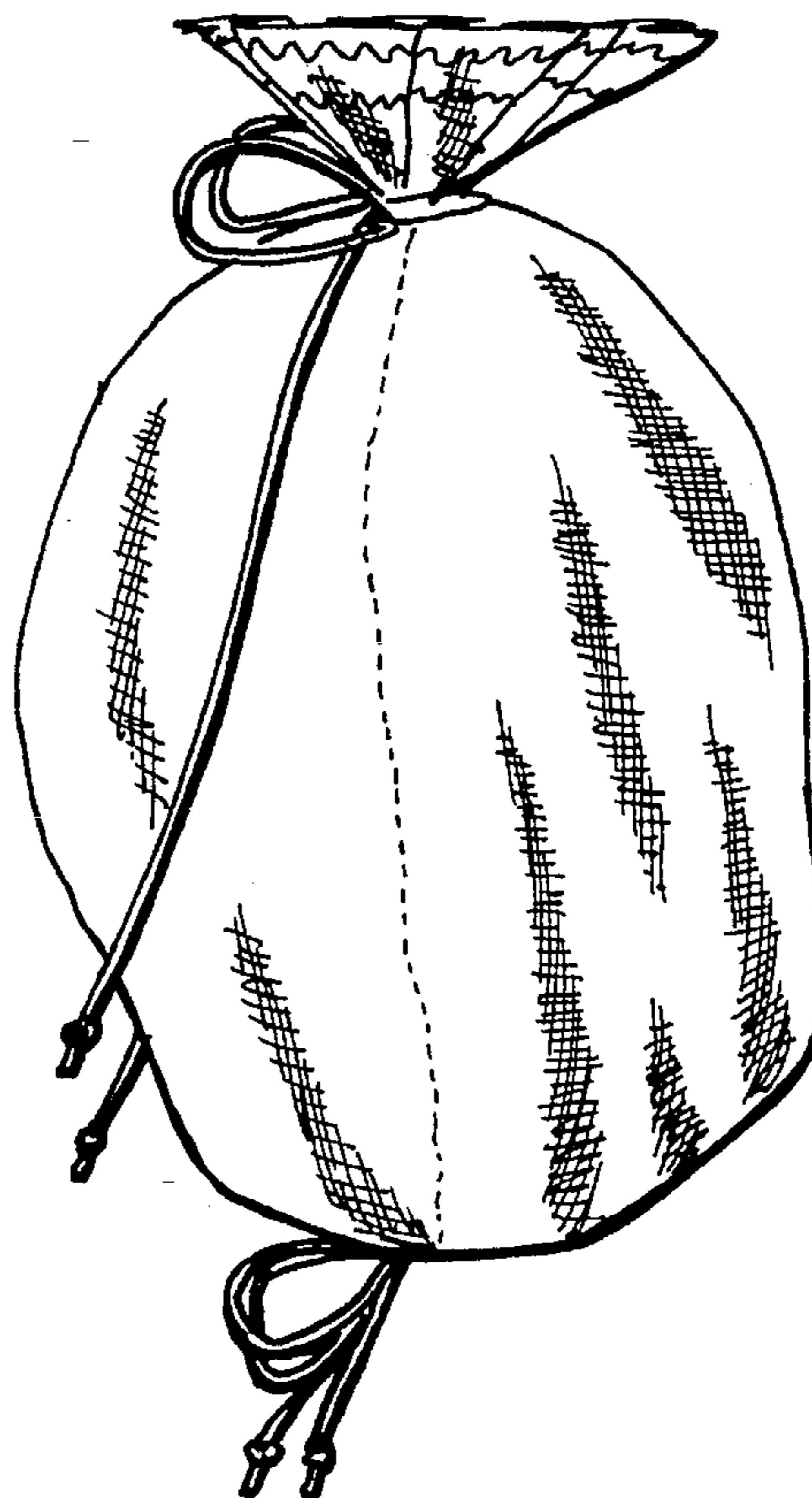

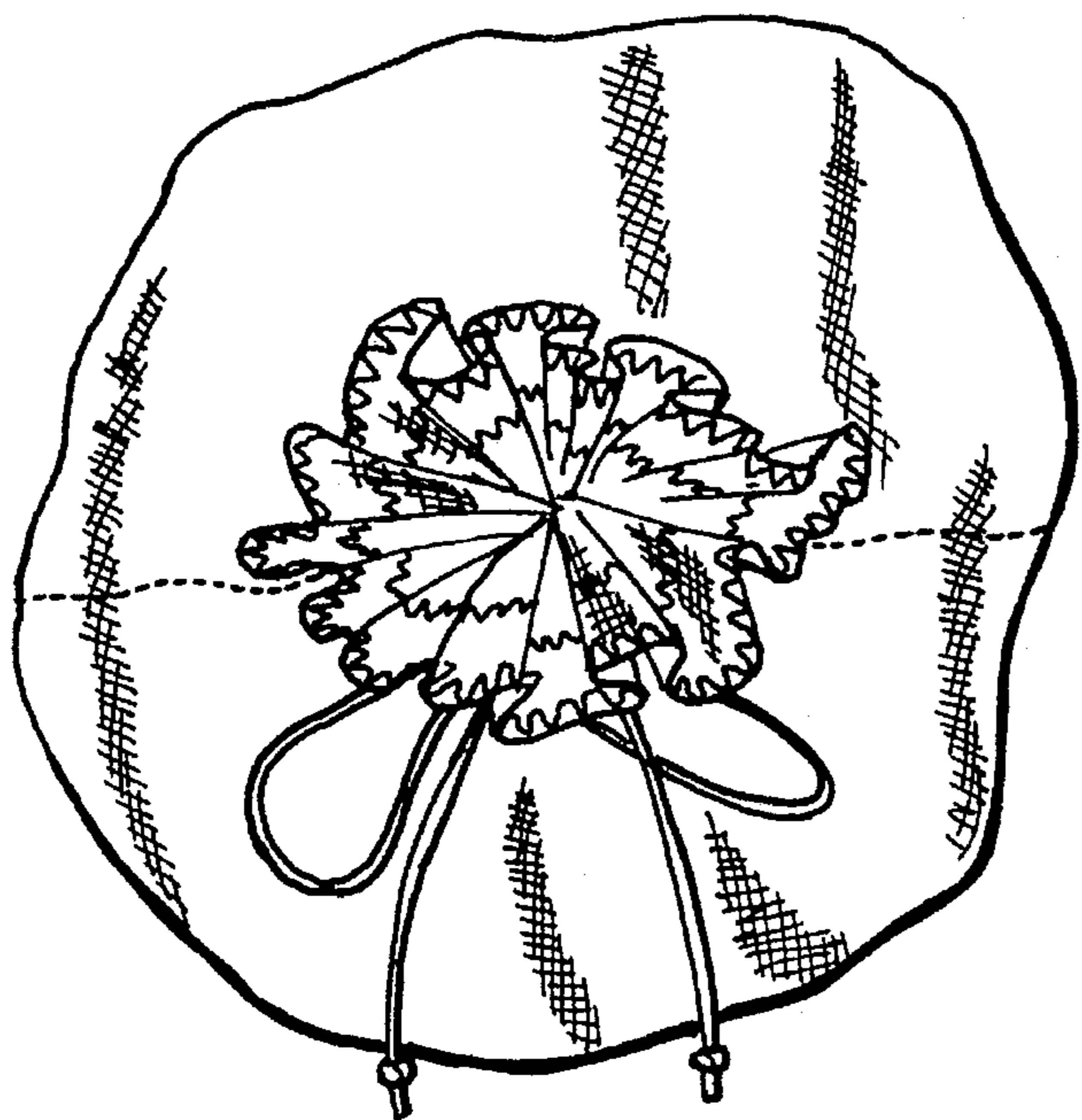

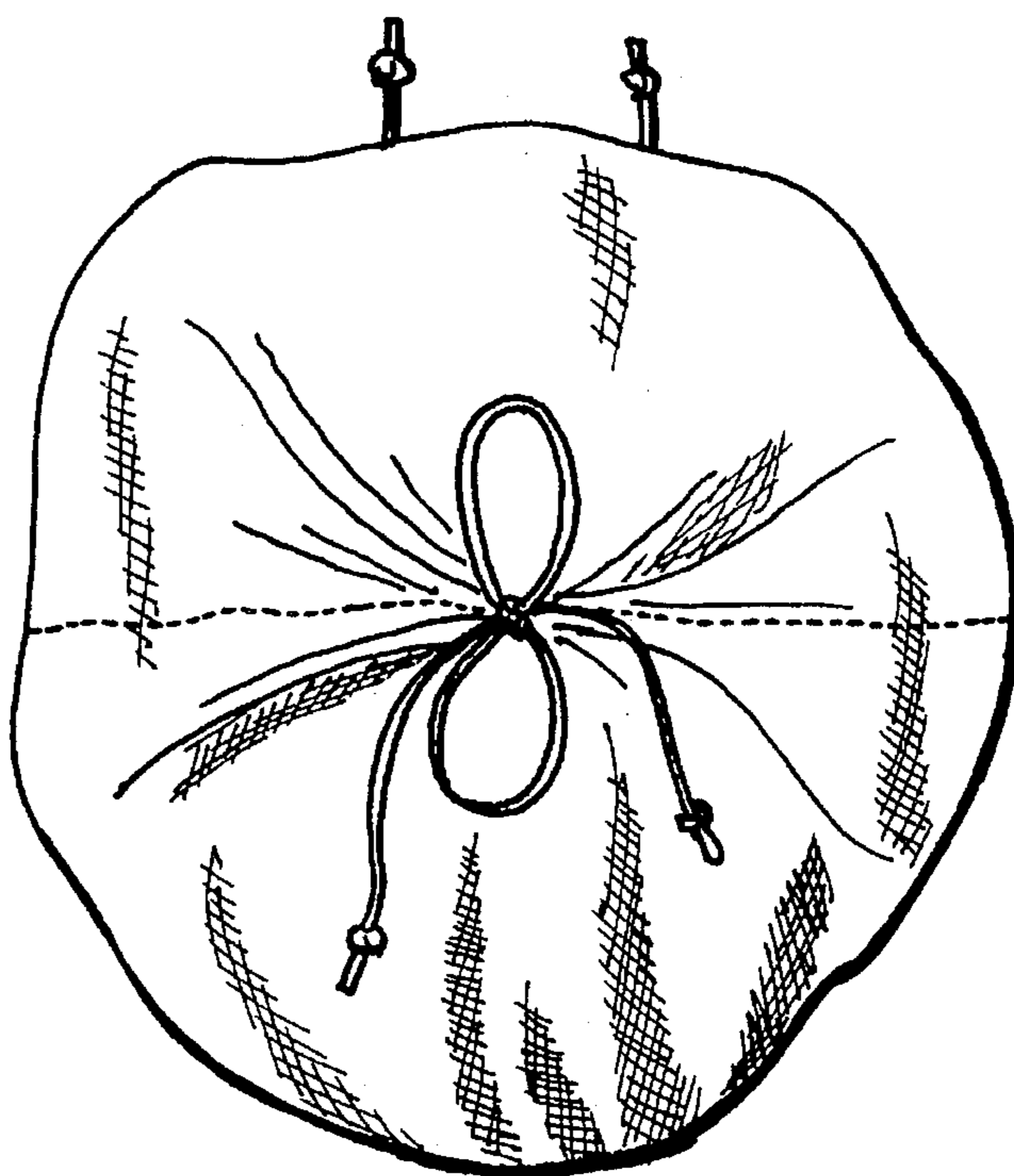

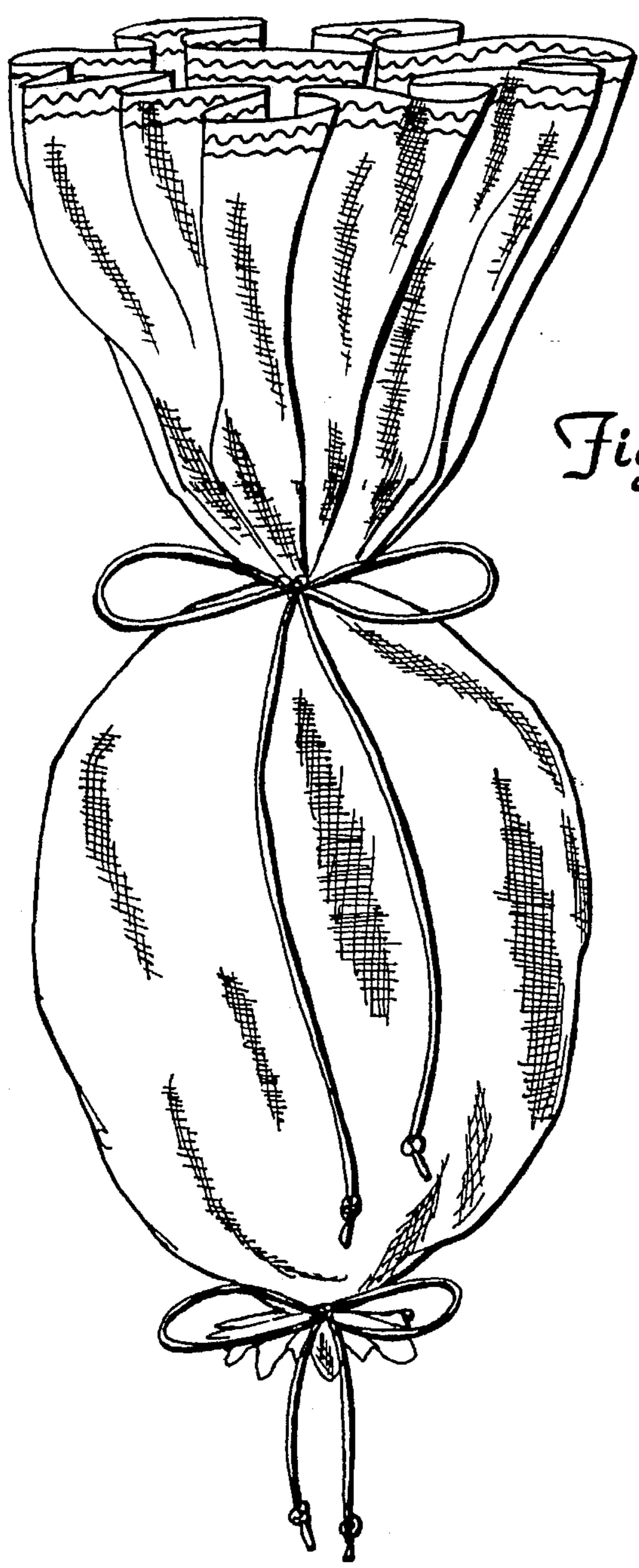

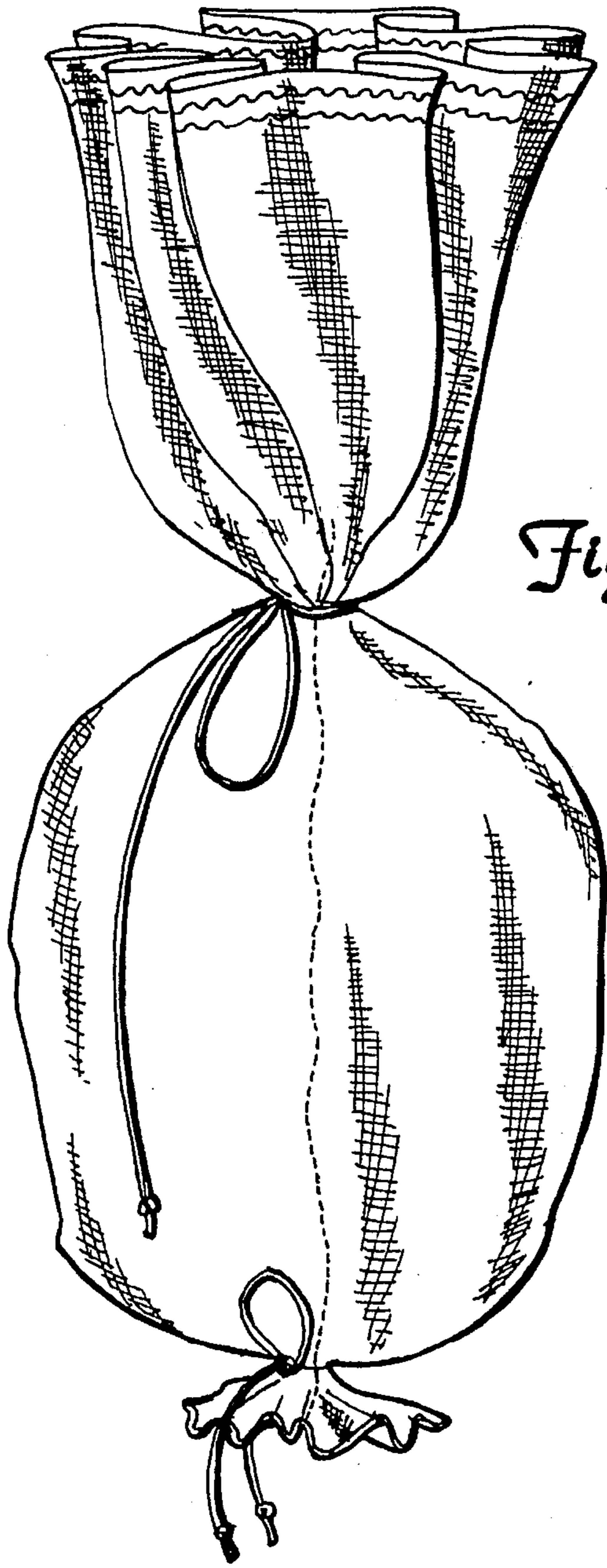

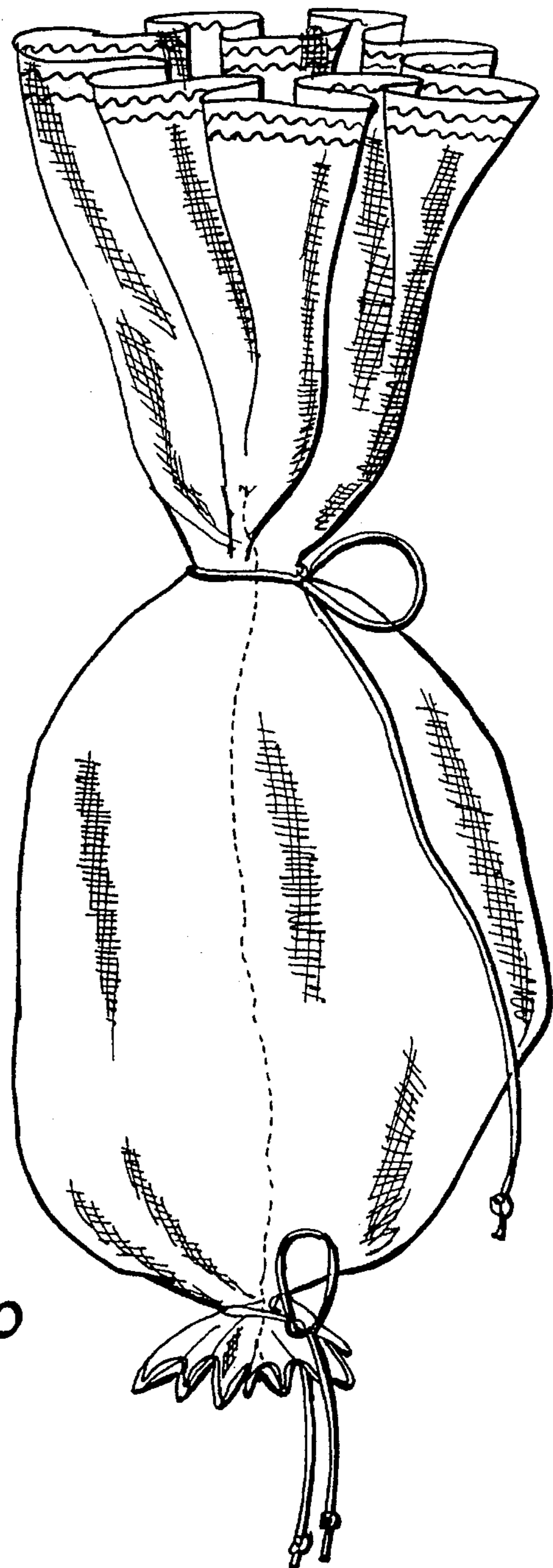

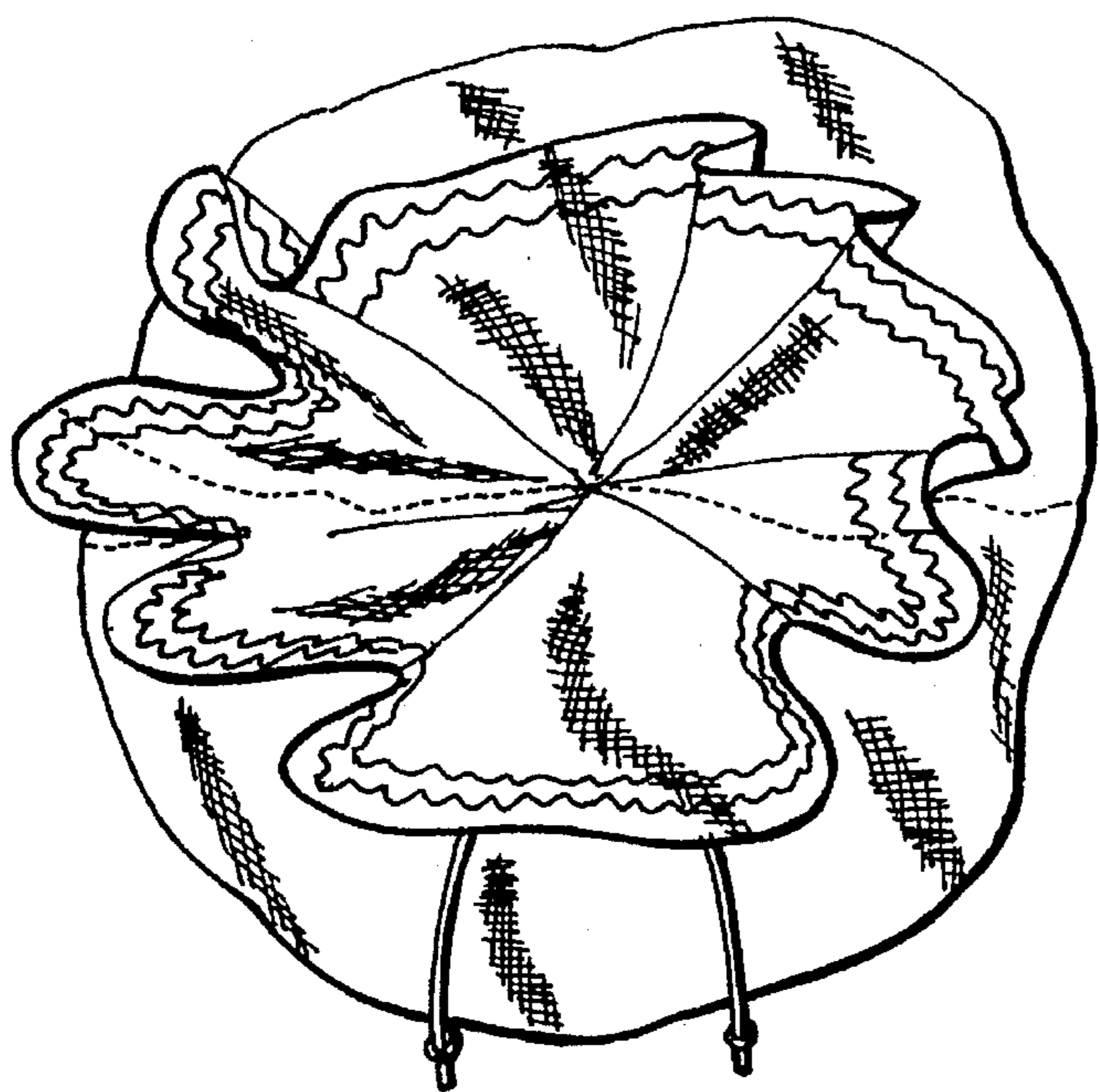

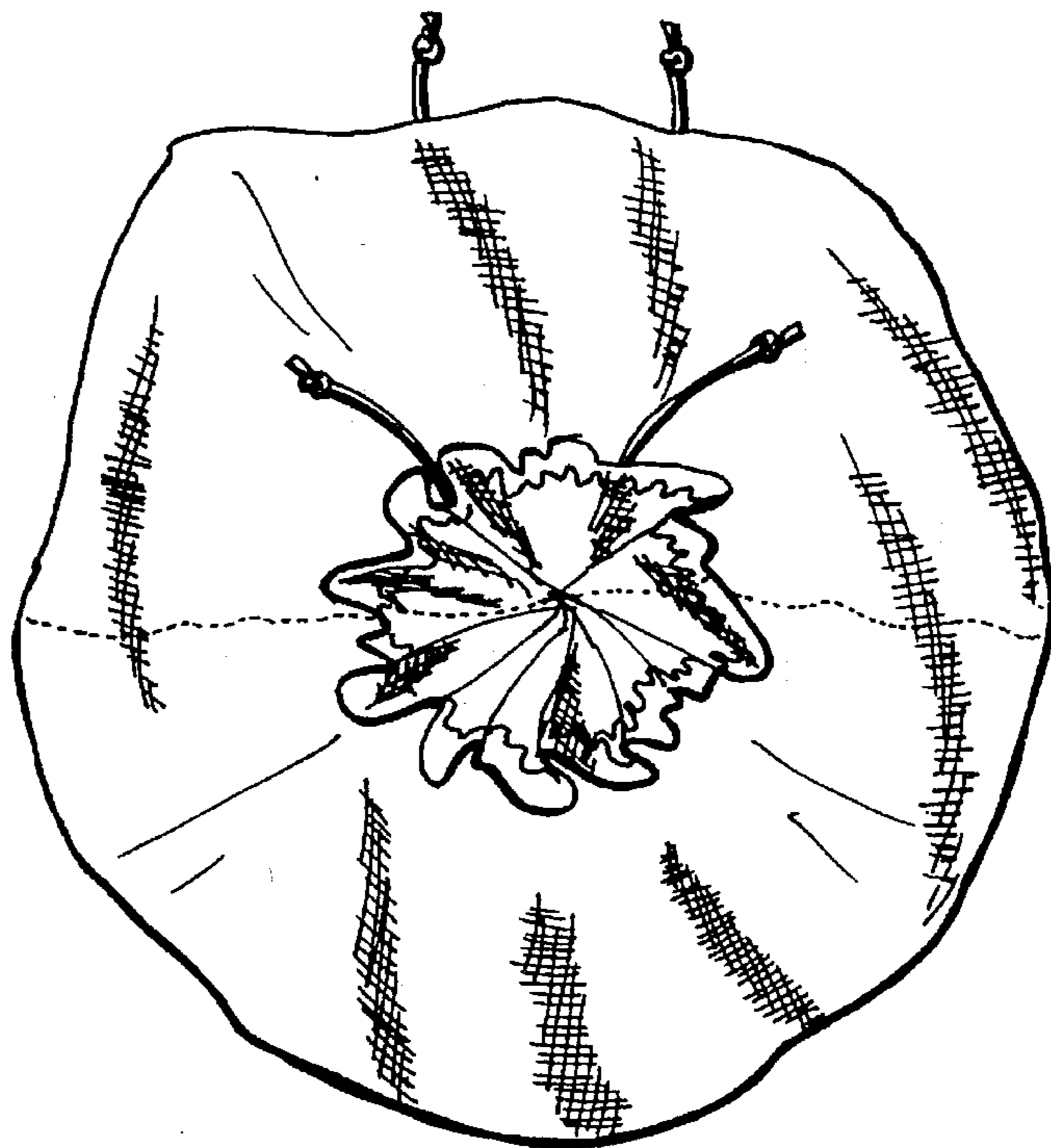
