[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a vehicular sun shield with single side sun shield extension, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the vehicular sun shield with single side sun shield extension of the invention;

FIG. 2 is a left side view of the vehicular sun shield with single side sun shield extension of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a right side view of the vehicular sun shield with single side sun shield extension of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top view of the vehicular sun shield with single side sun shield extension of FIG. 1;

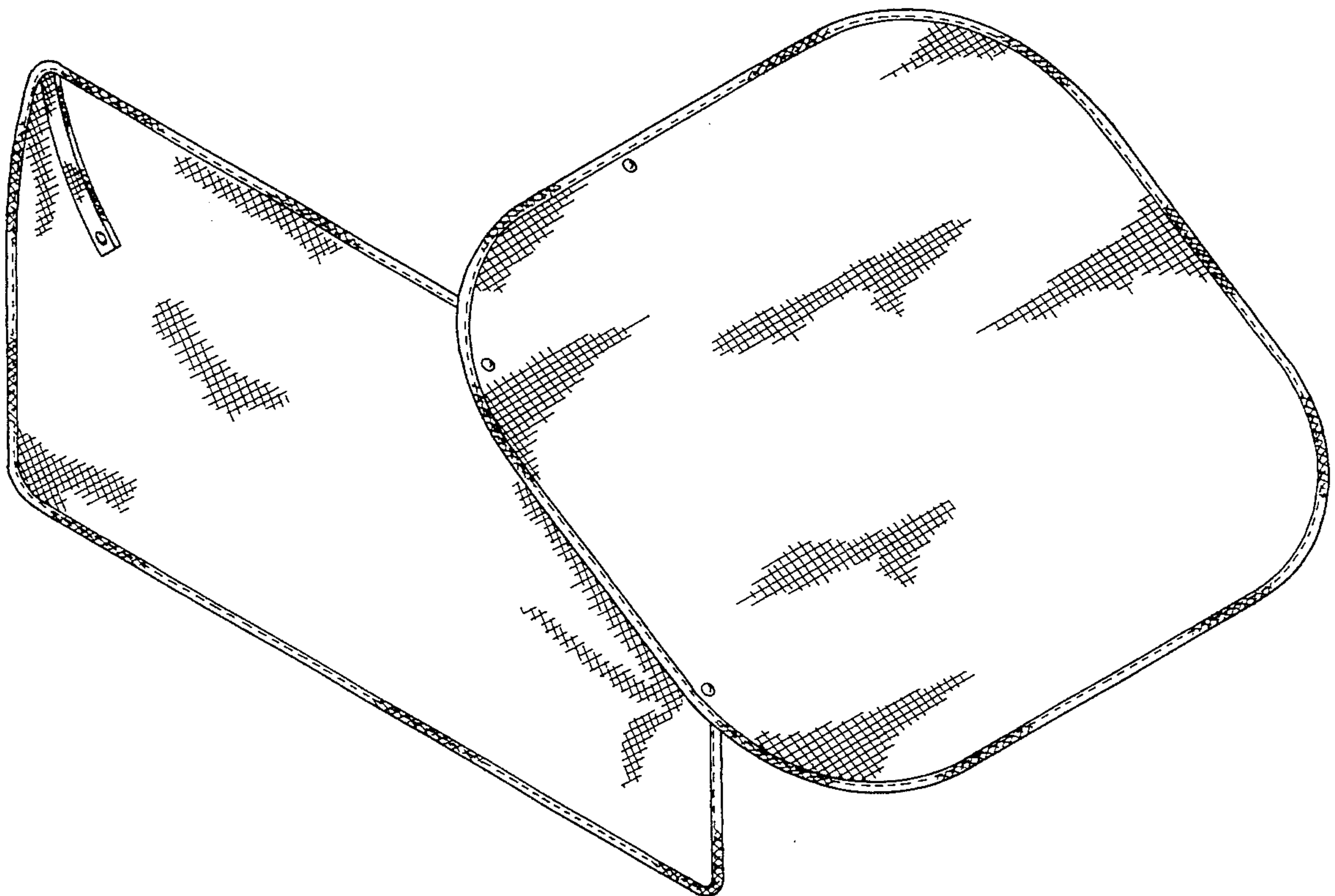
FIG. 5 is an end view of the vehicular sun shield with single side sun shield extension of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is an end view opposite that shown in FIG. 5; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the vehicular sun shield with single side sun shield extension of FIG. 1.

The shading indicates a flexible material sheet which extends completely within the borders which are shown.

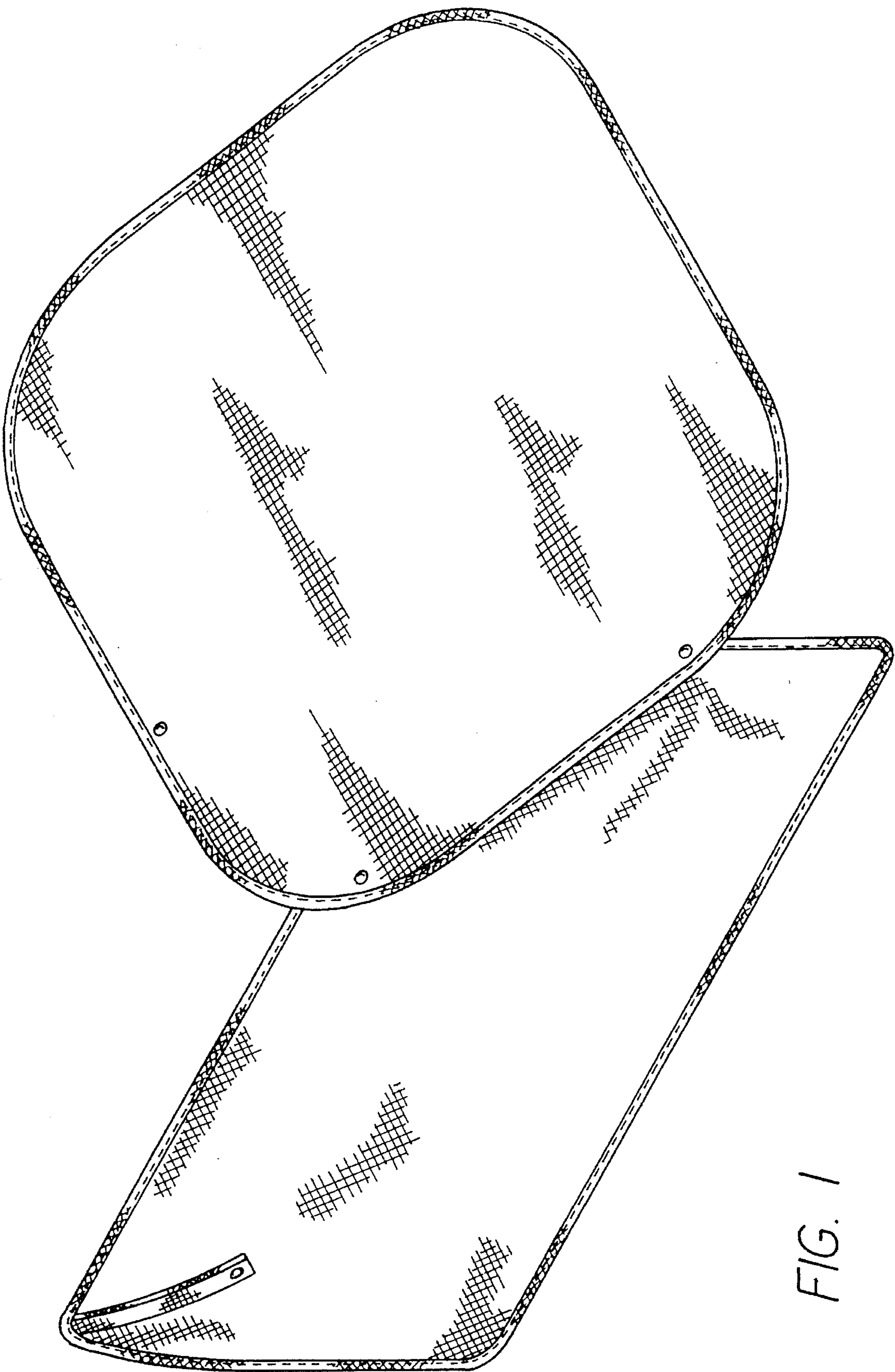

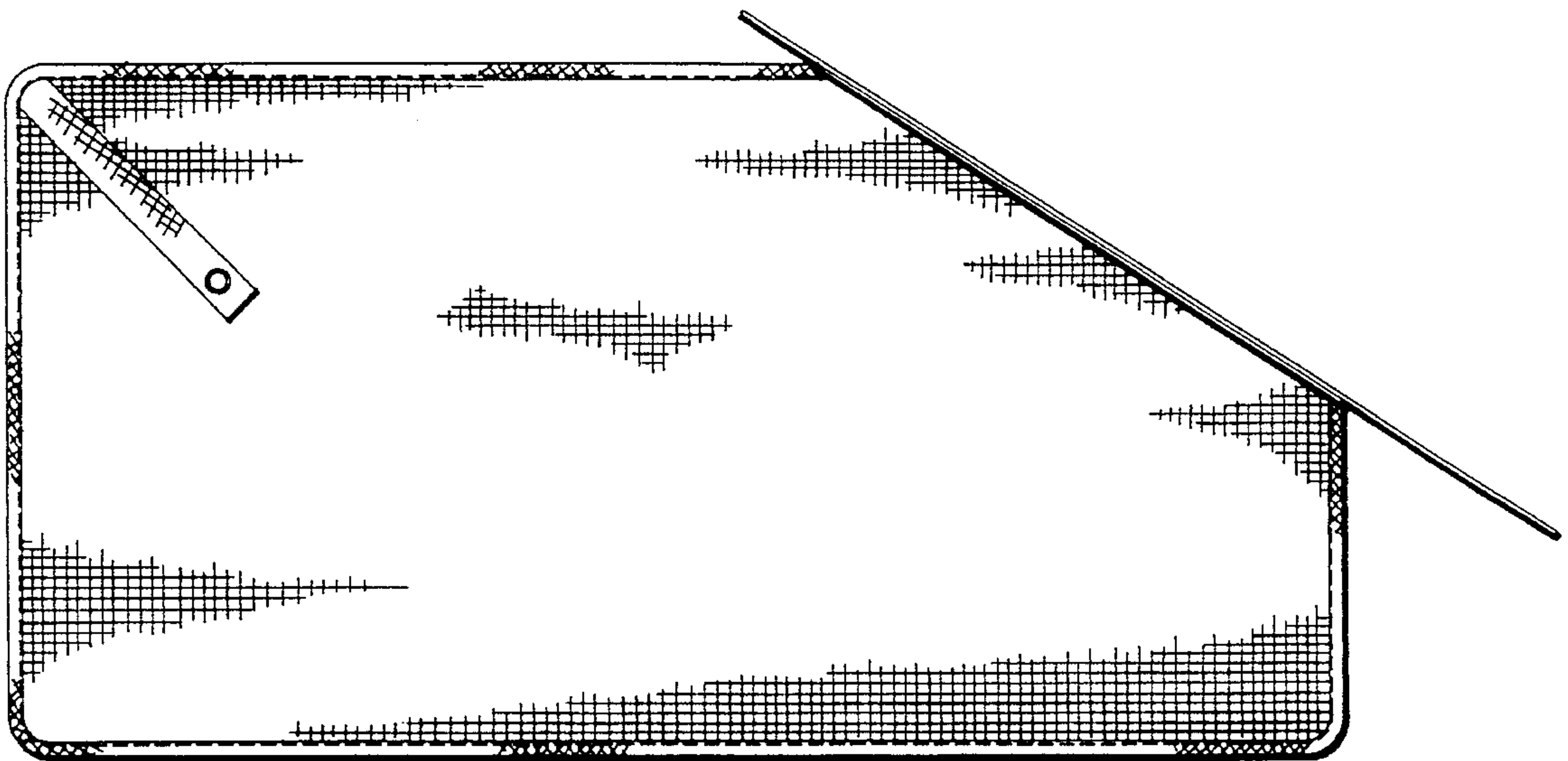

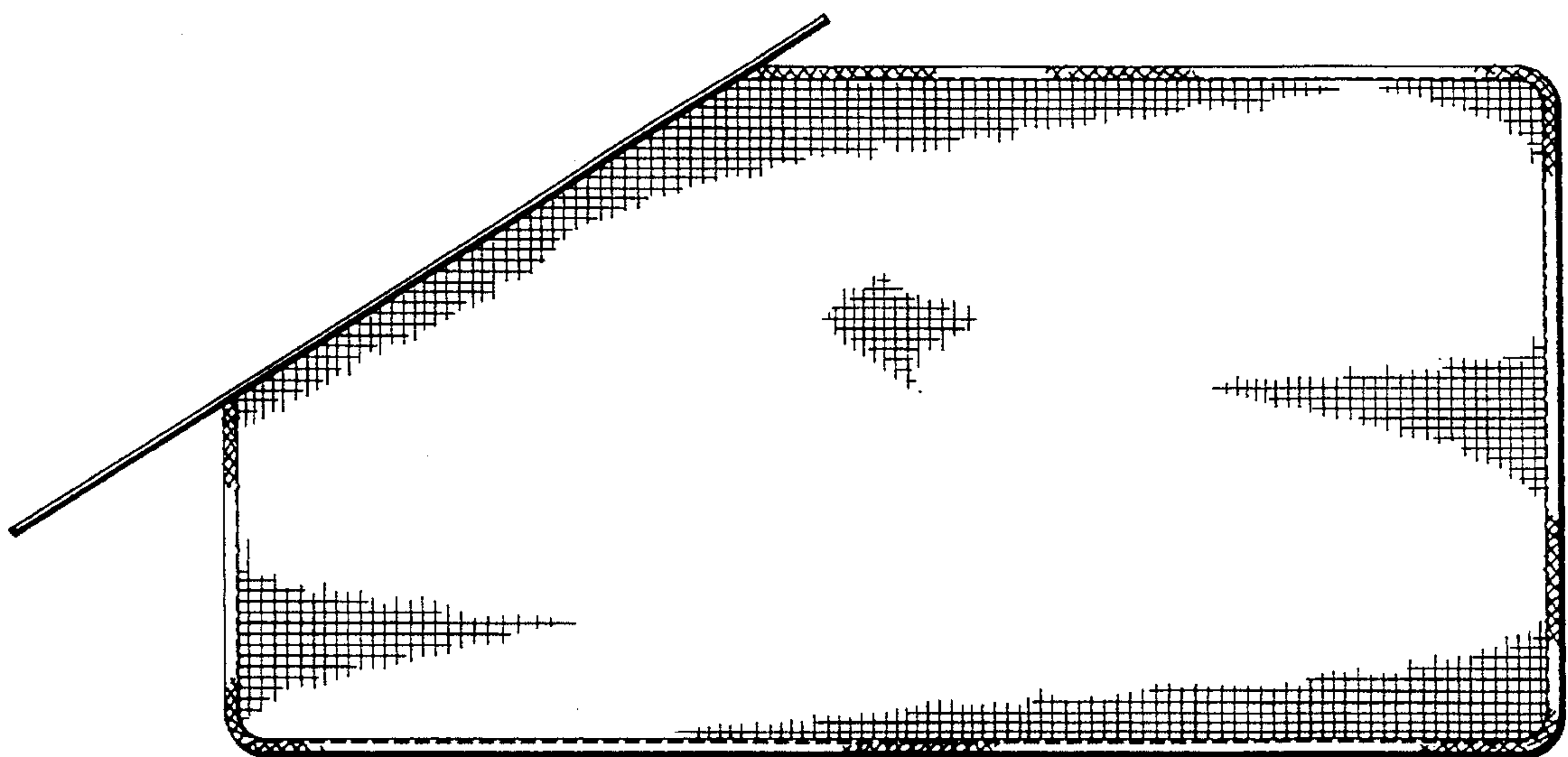

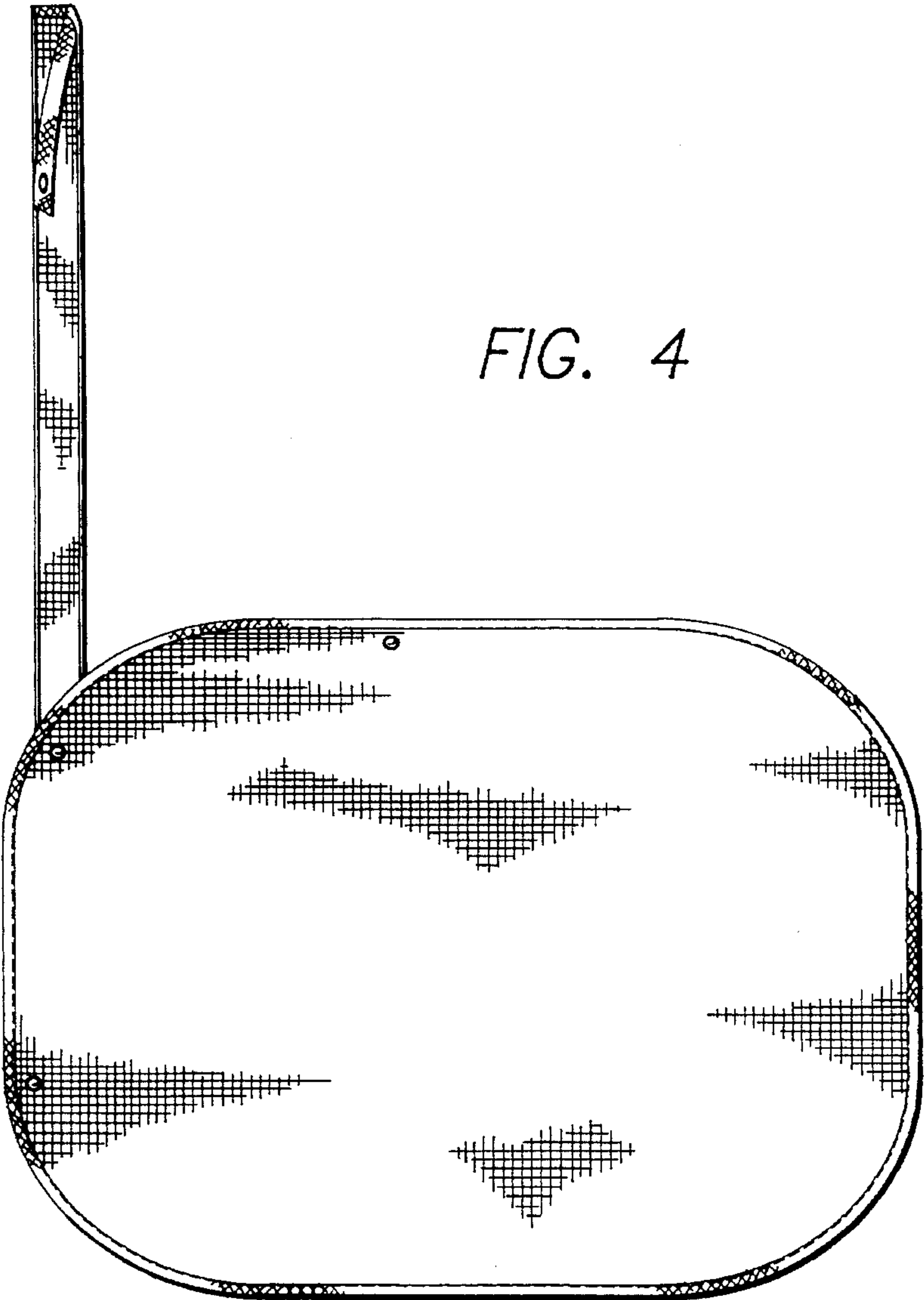

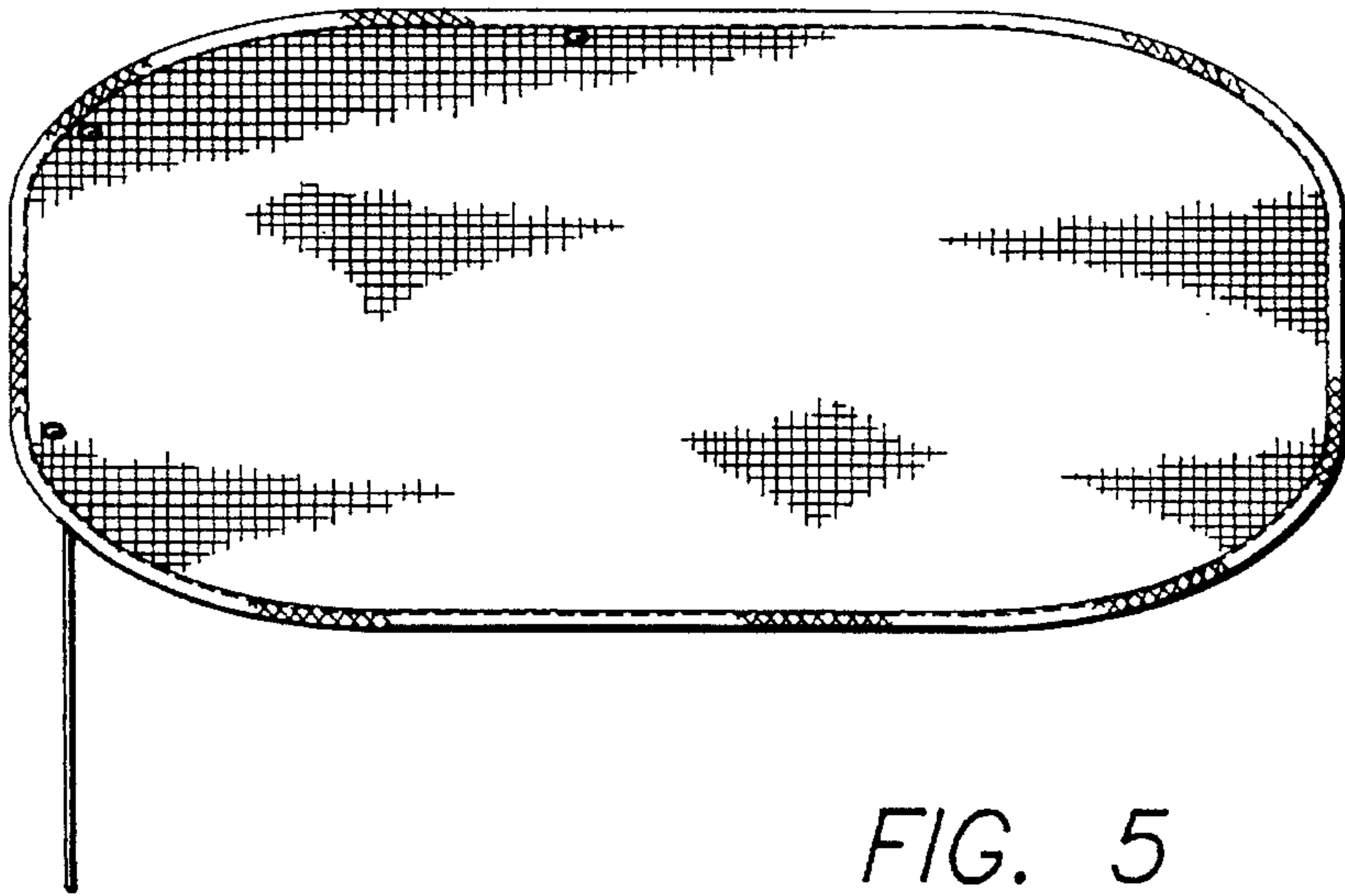

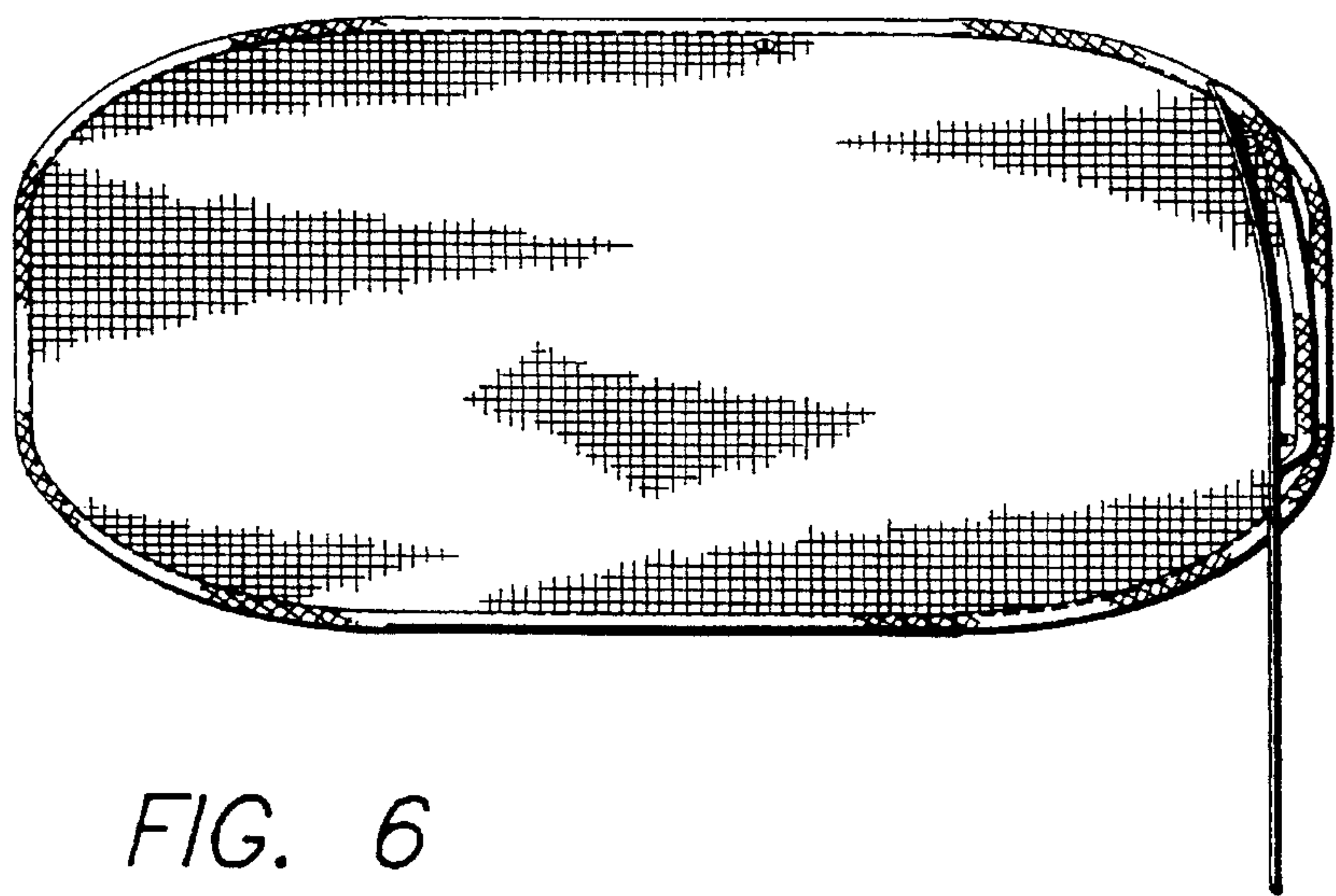

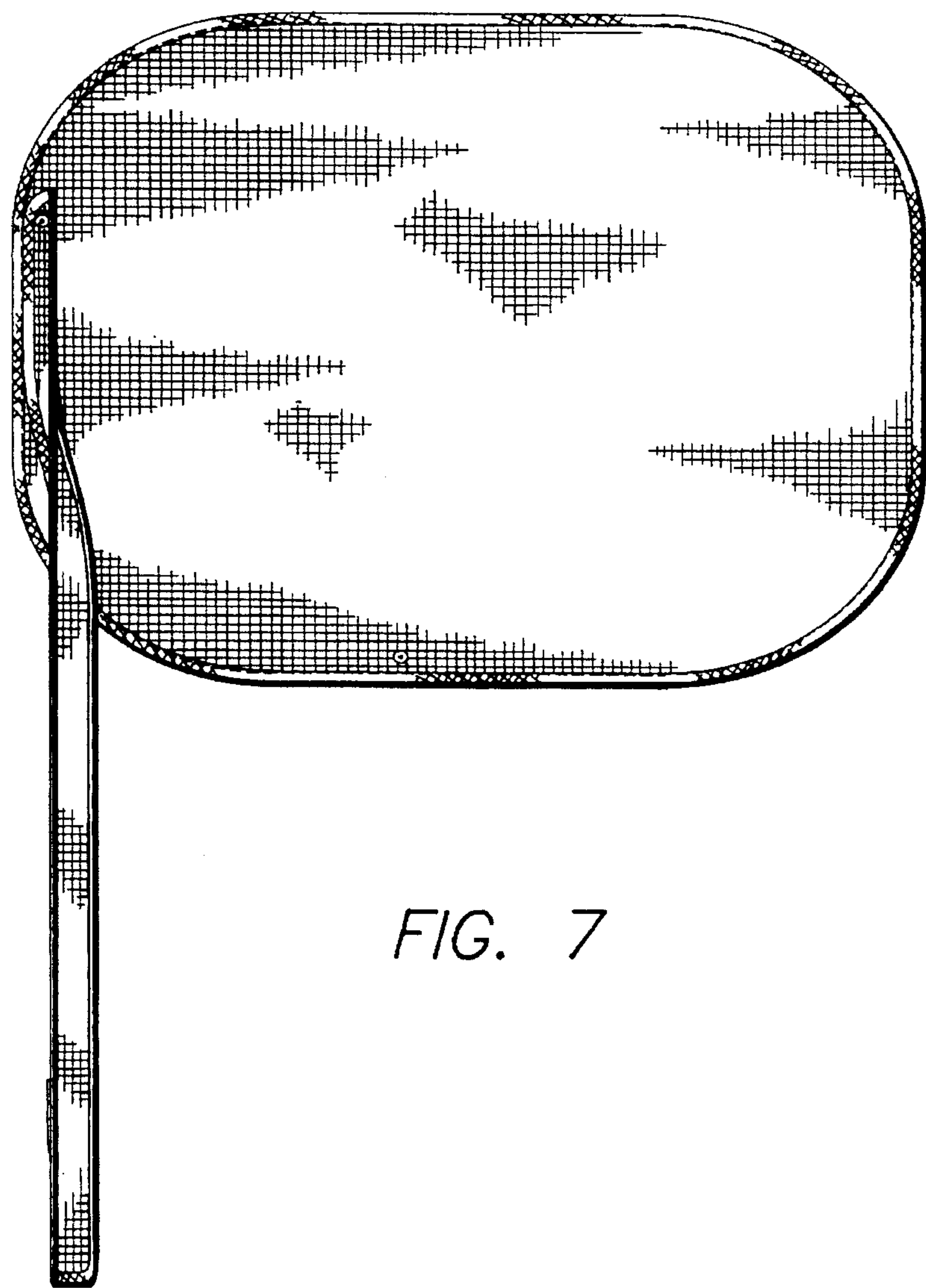
