FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof;

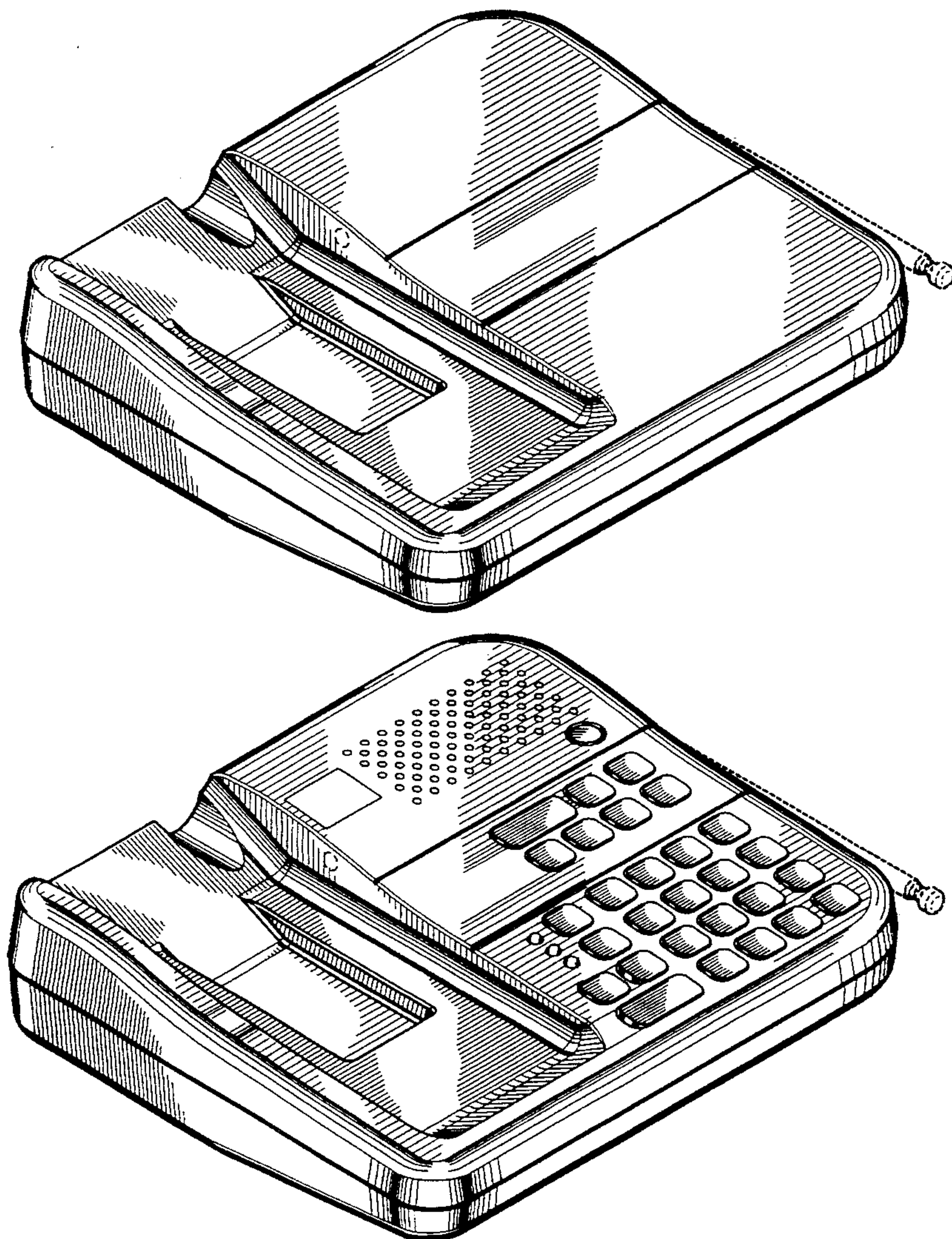
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

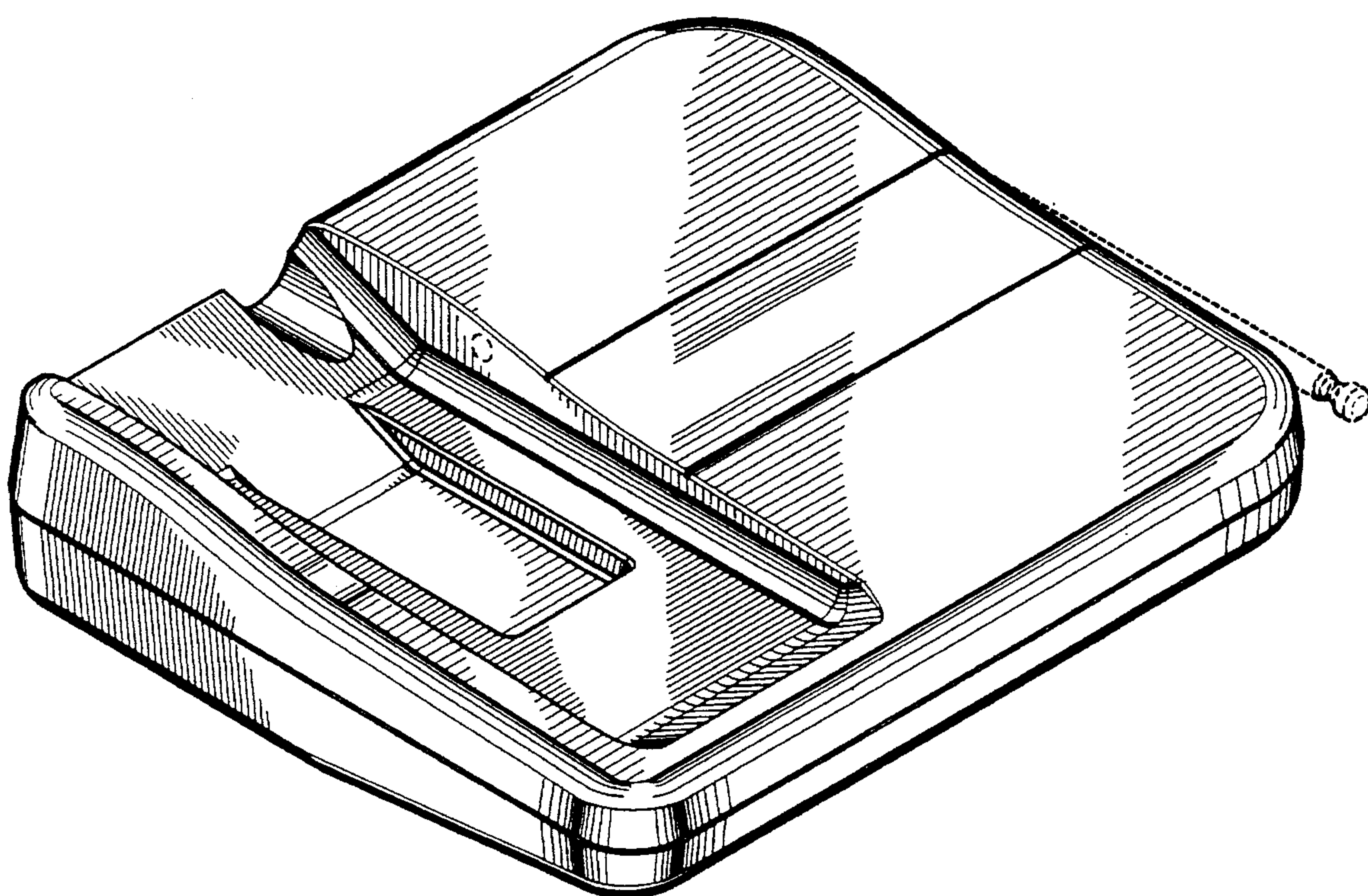

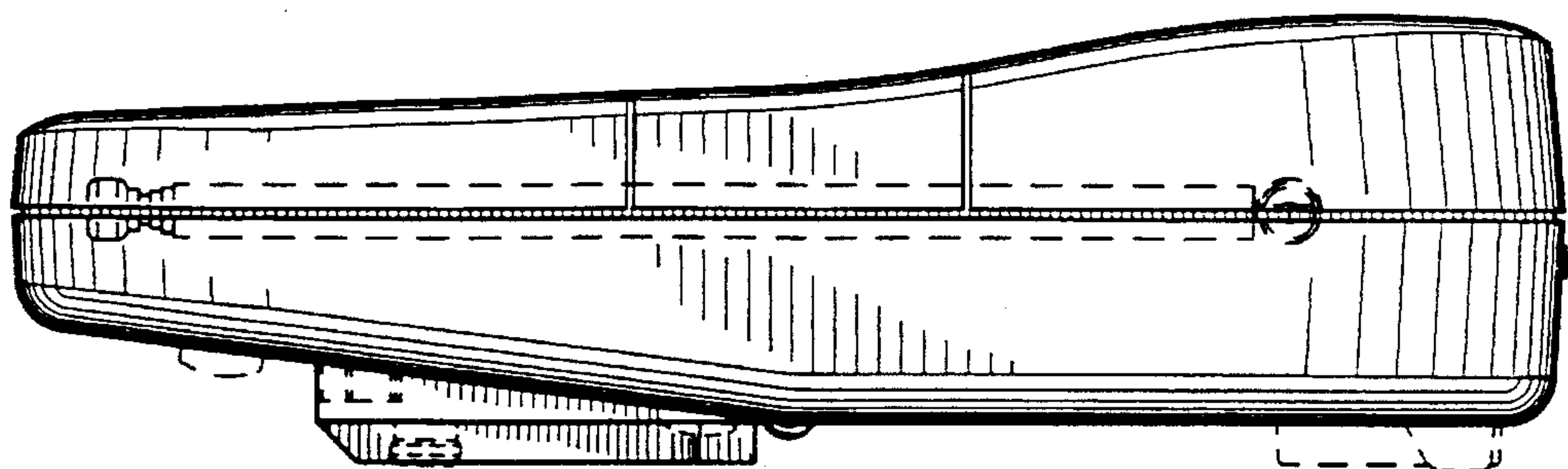

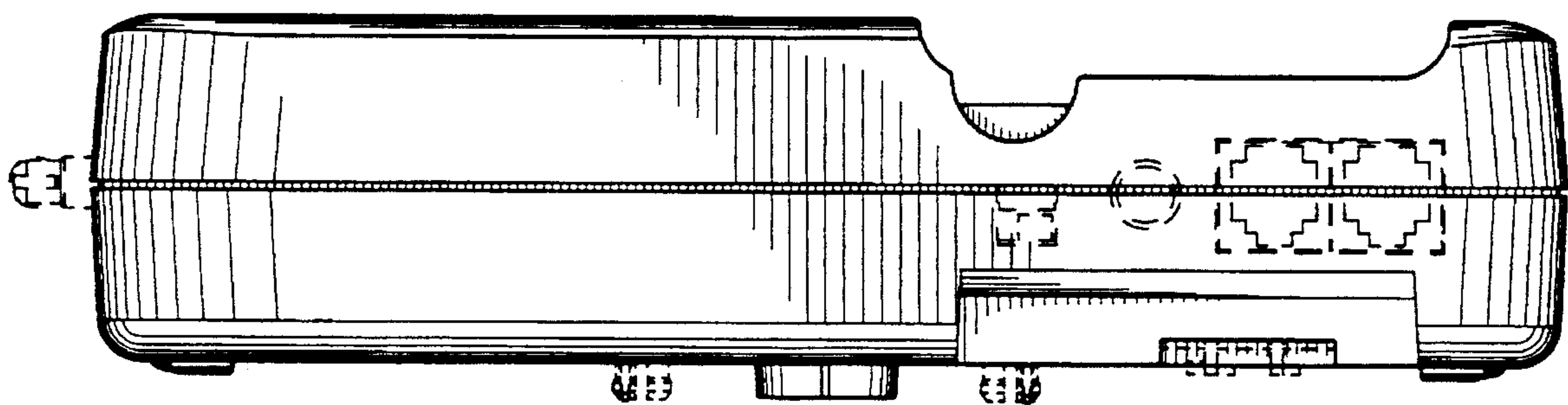

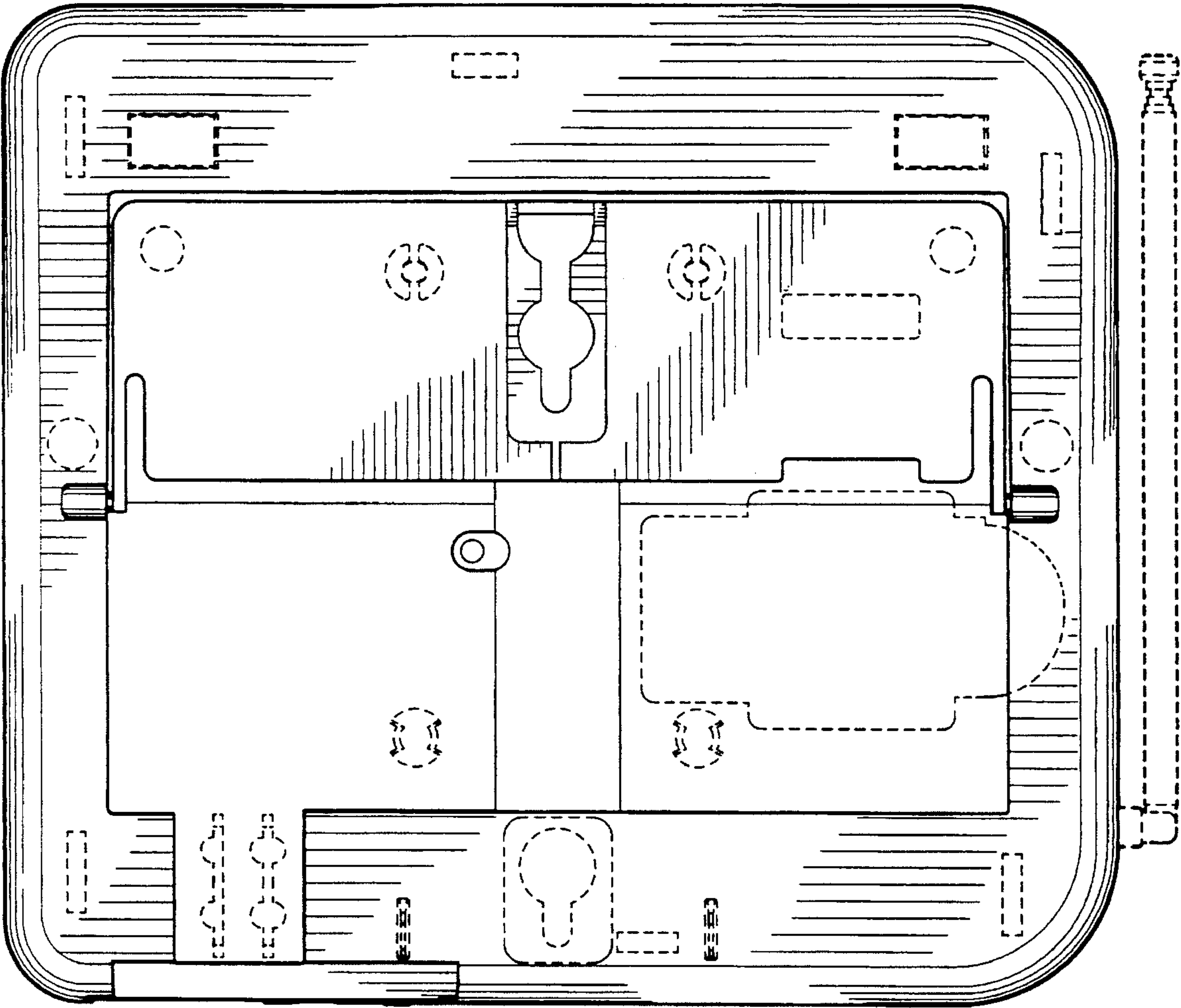

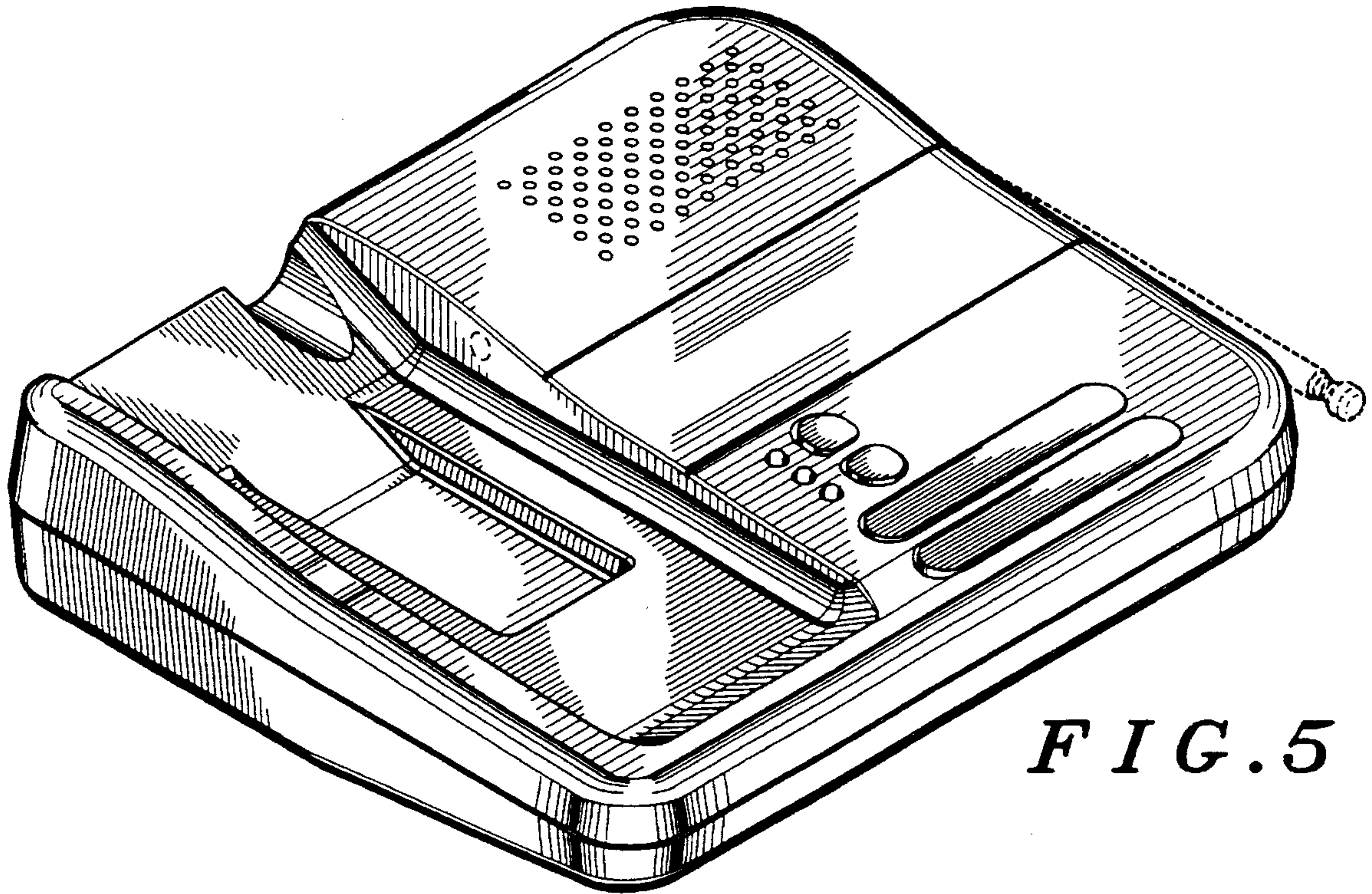

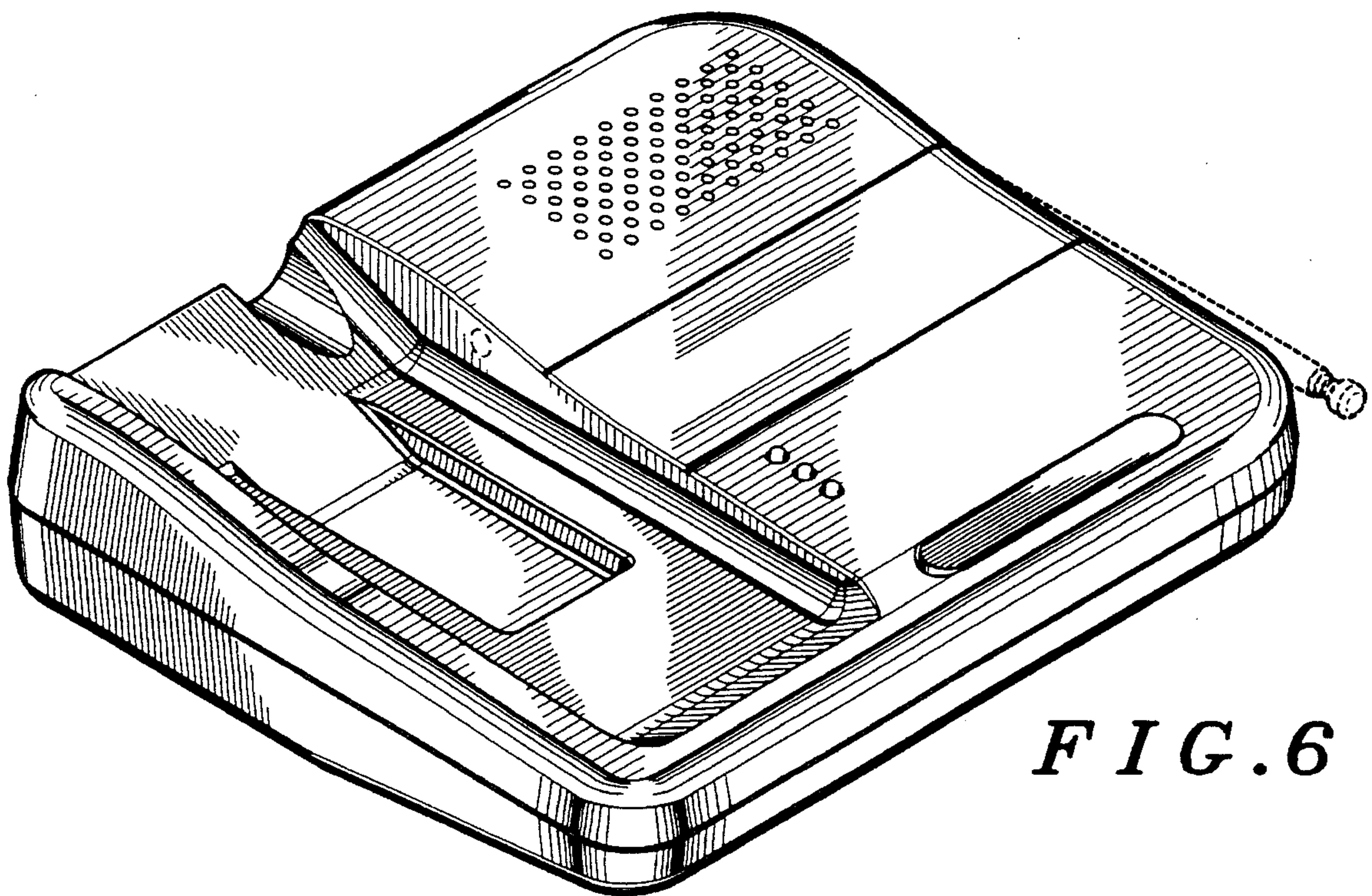

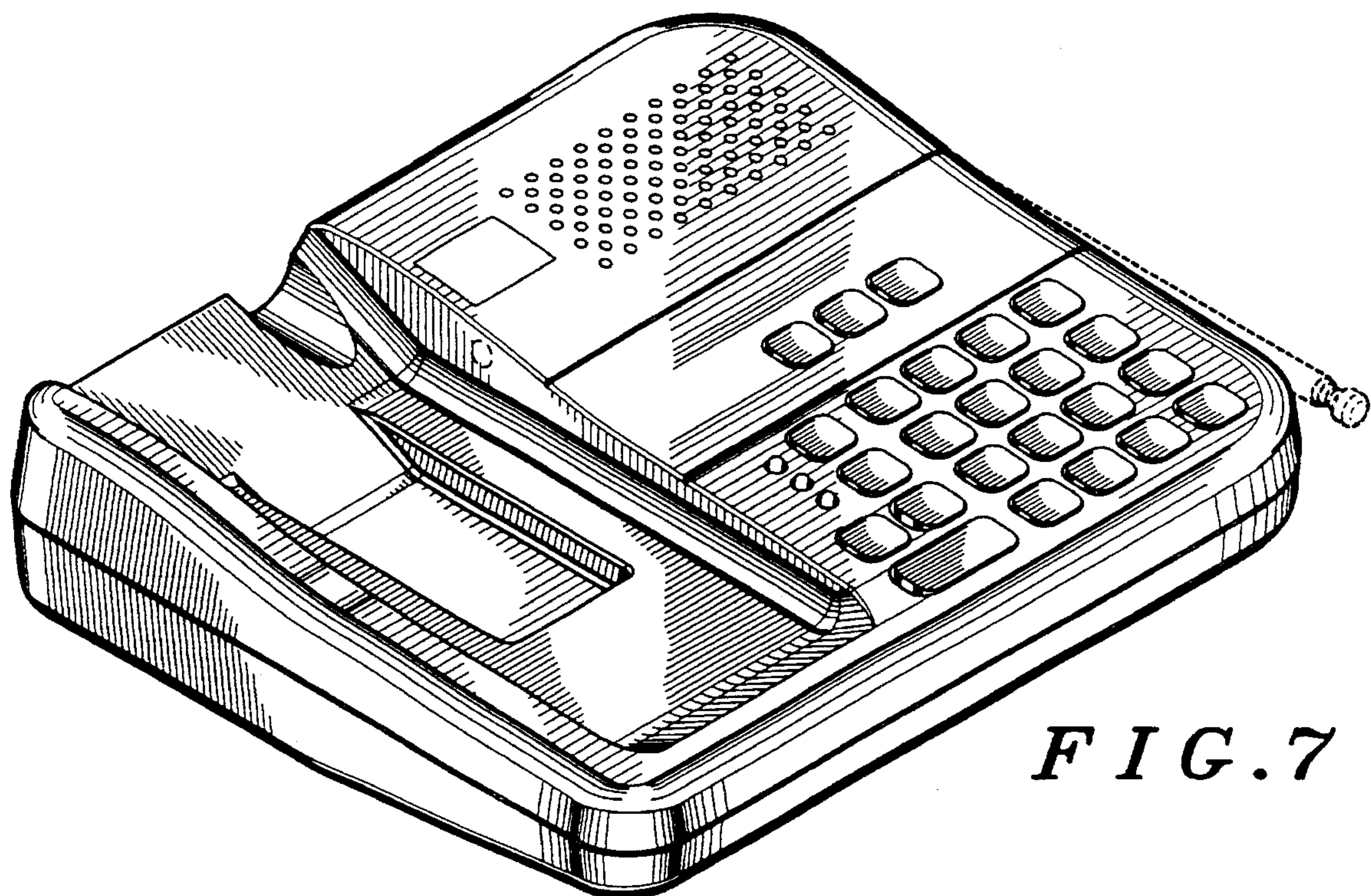

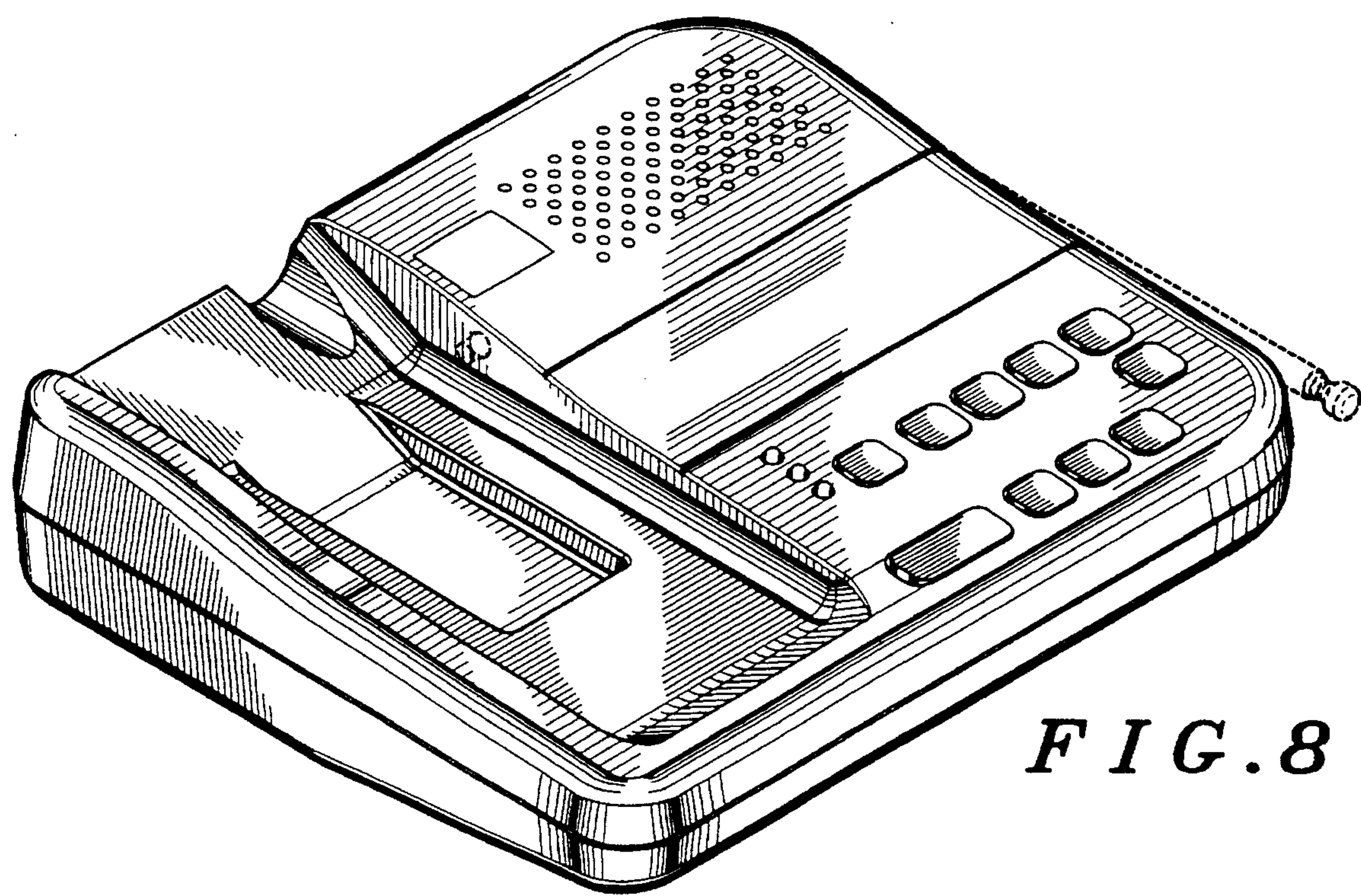

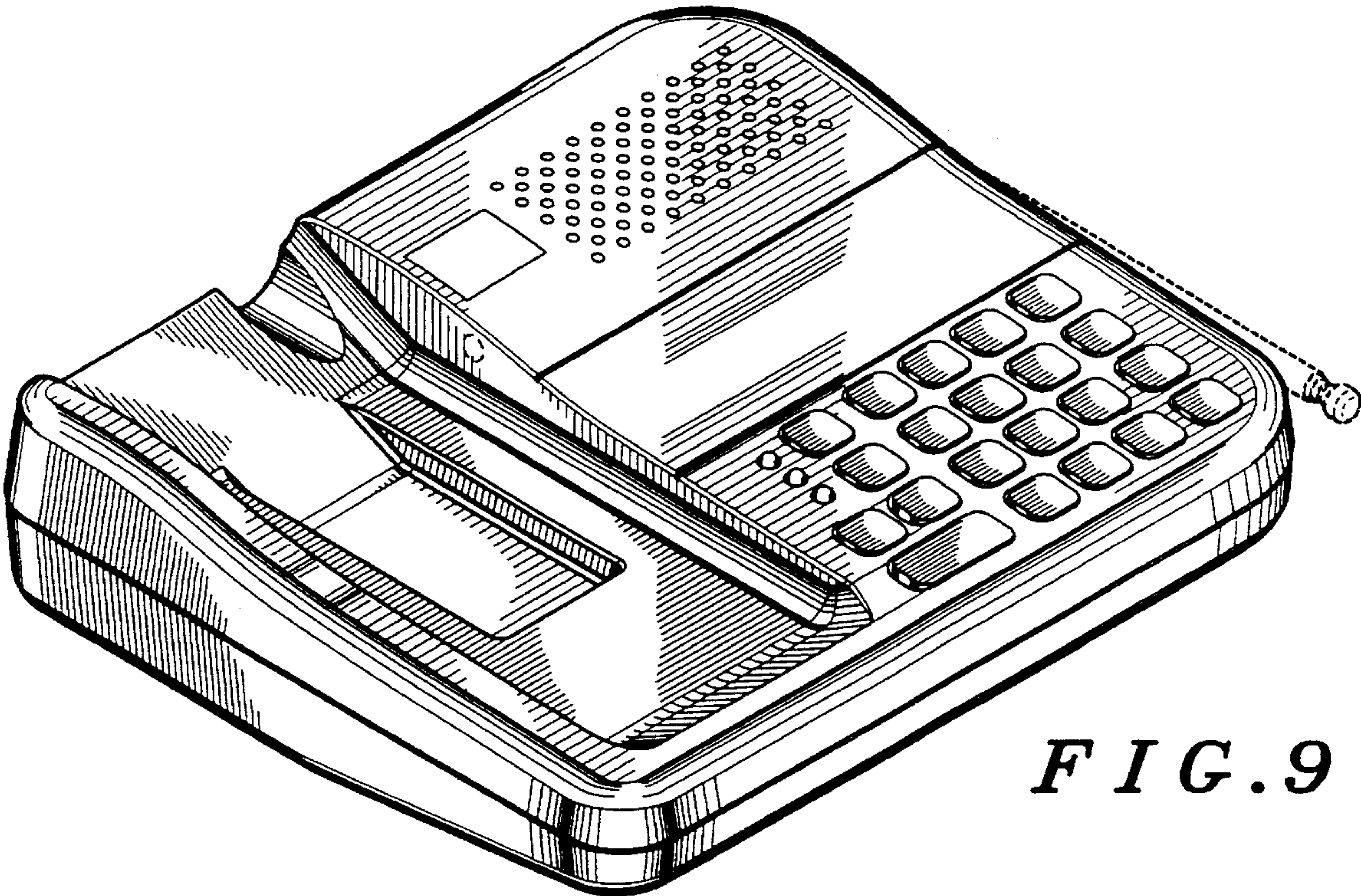

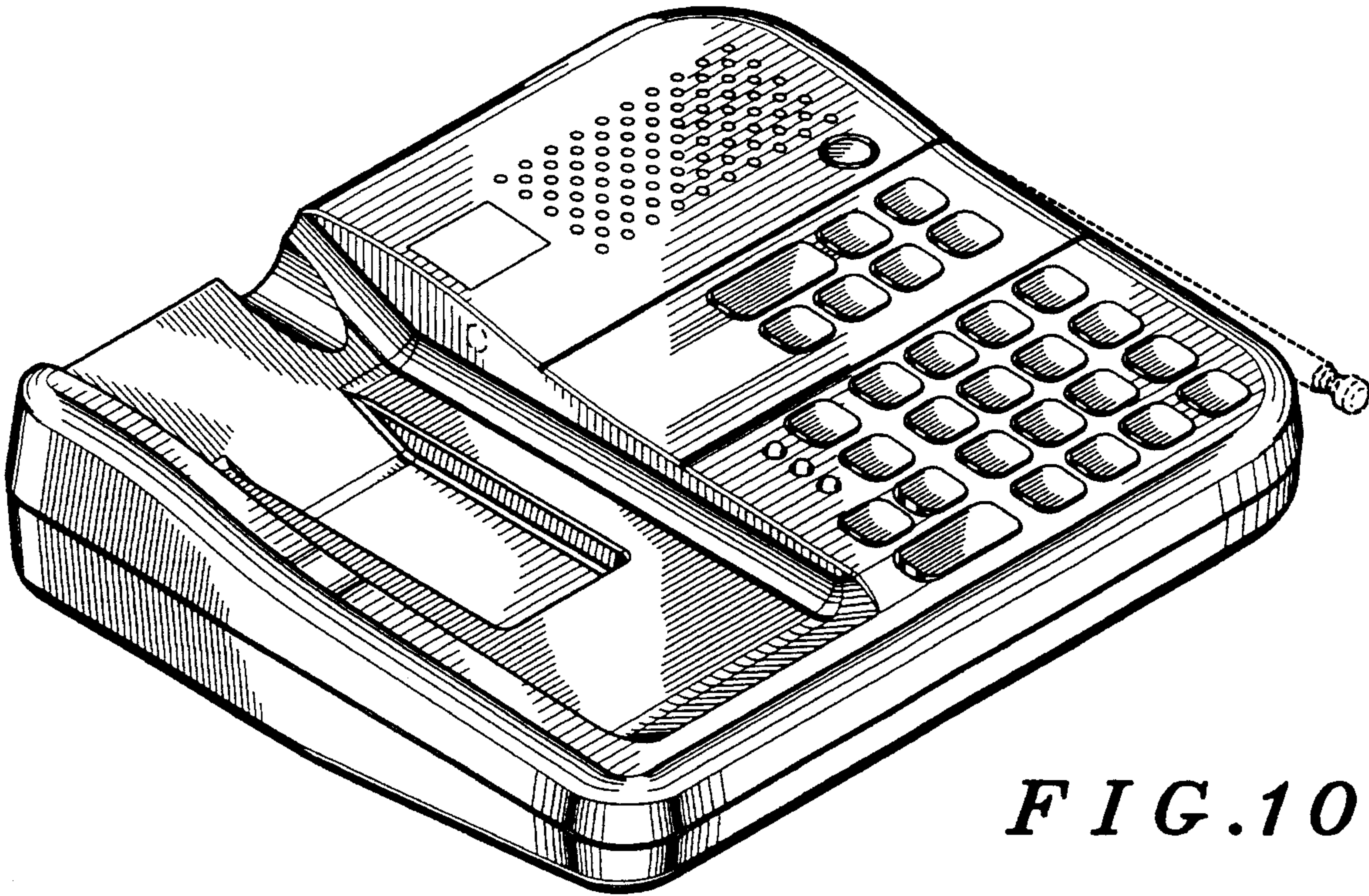
