FIG. 7 is another perspective view.

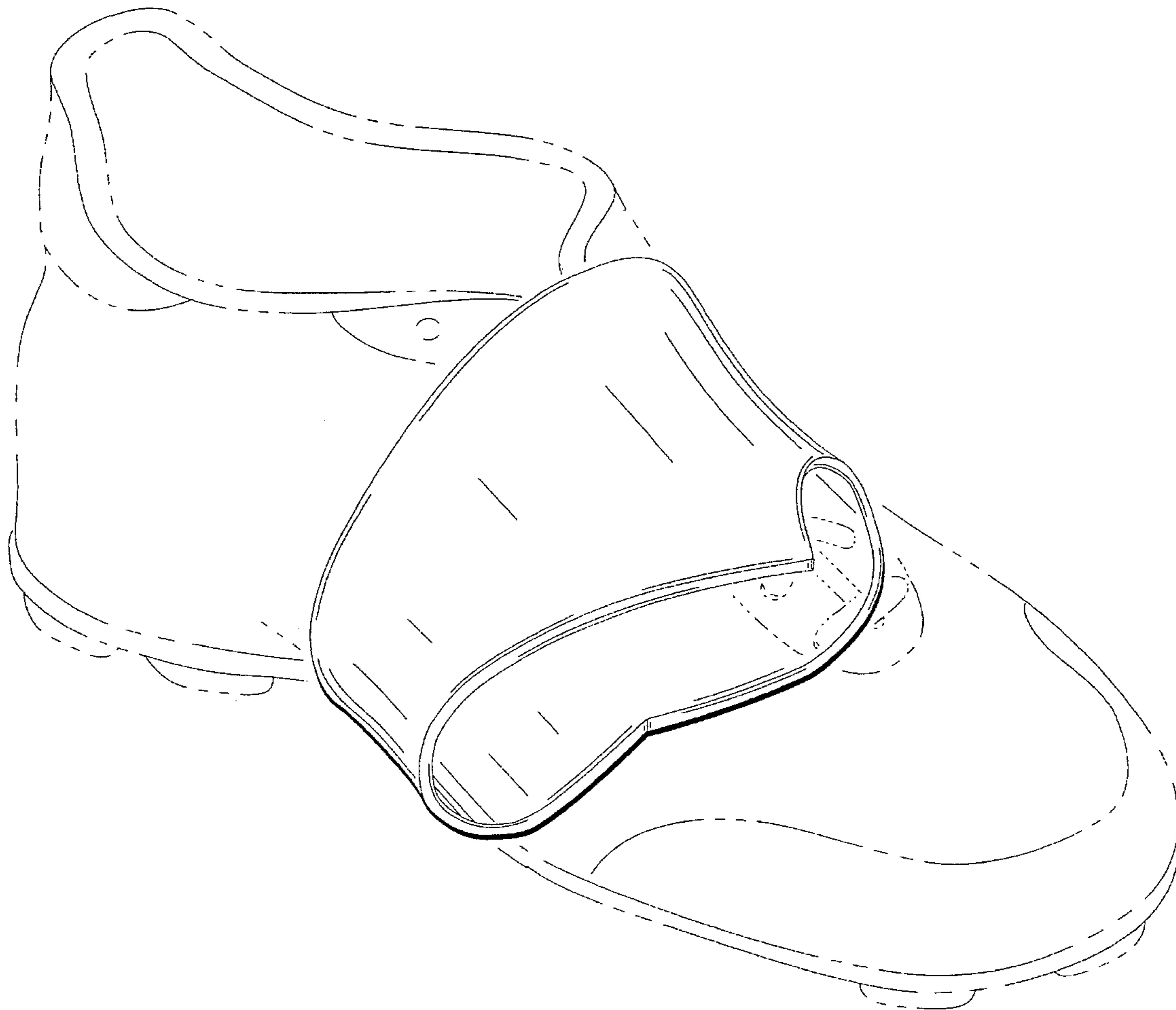

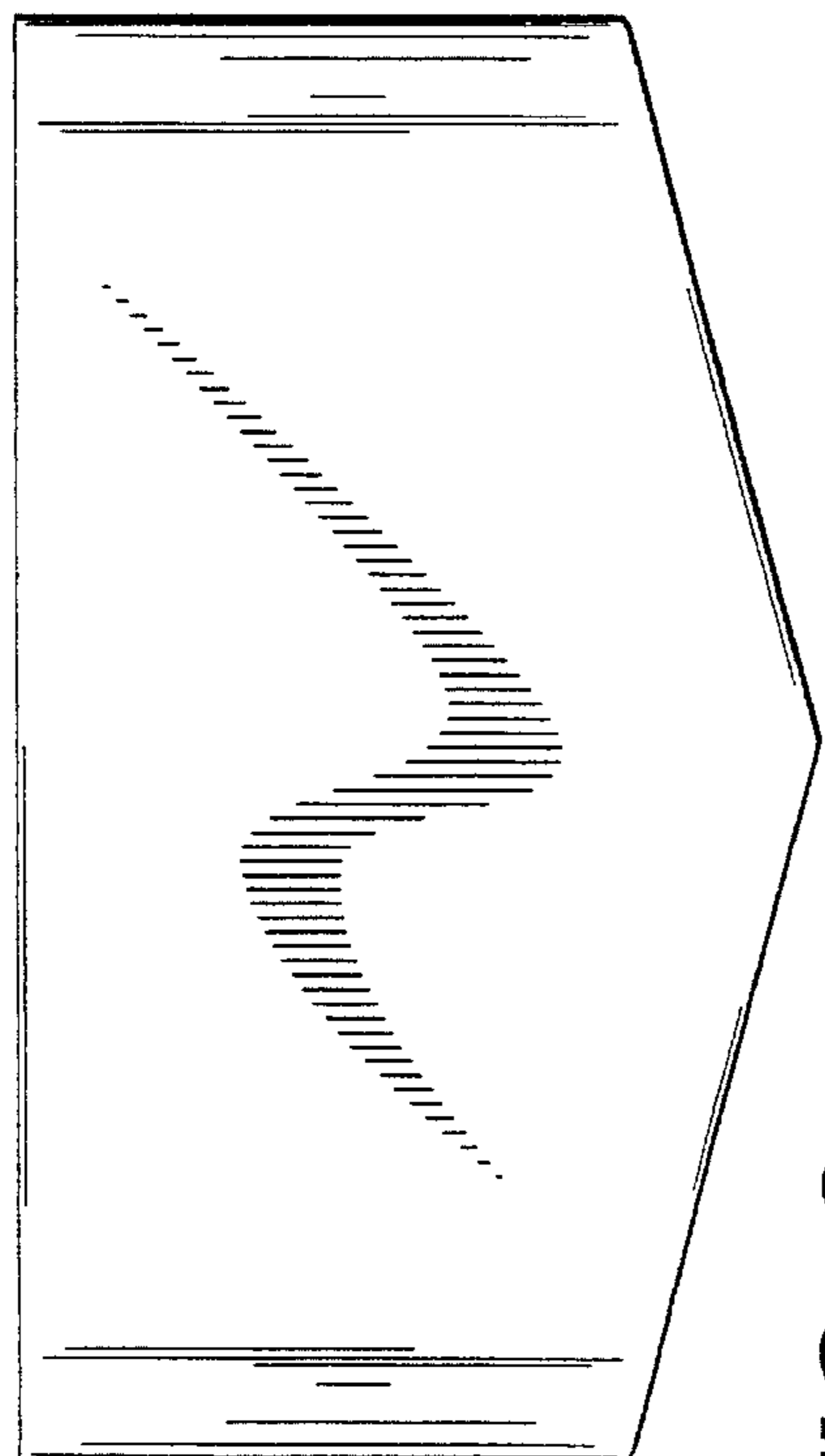

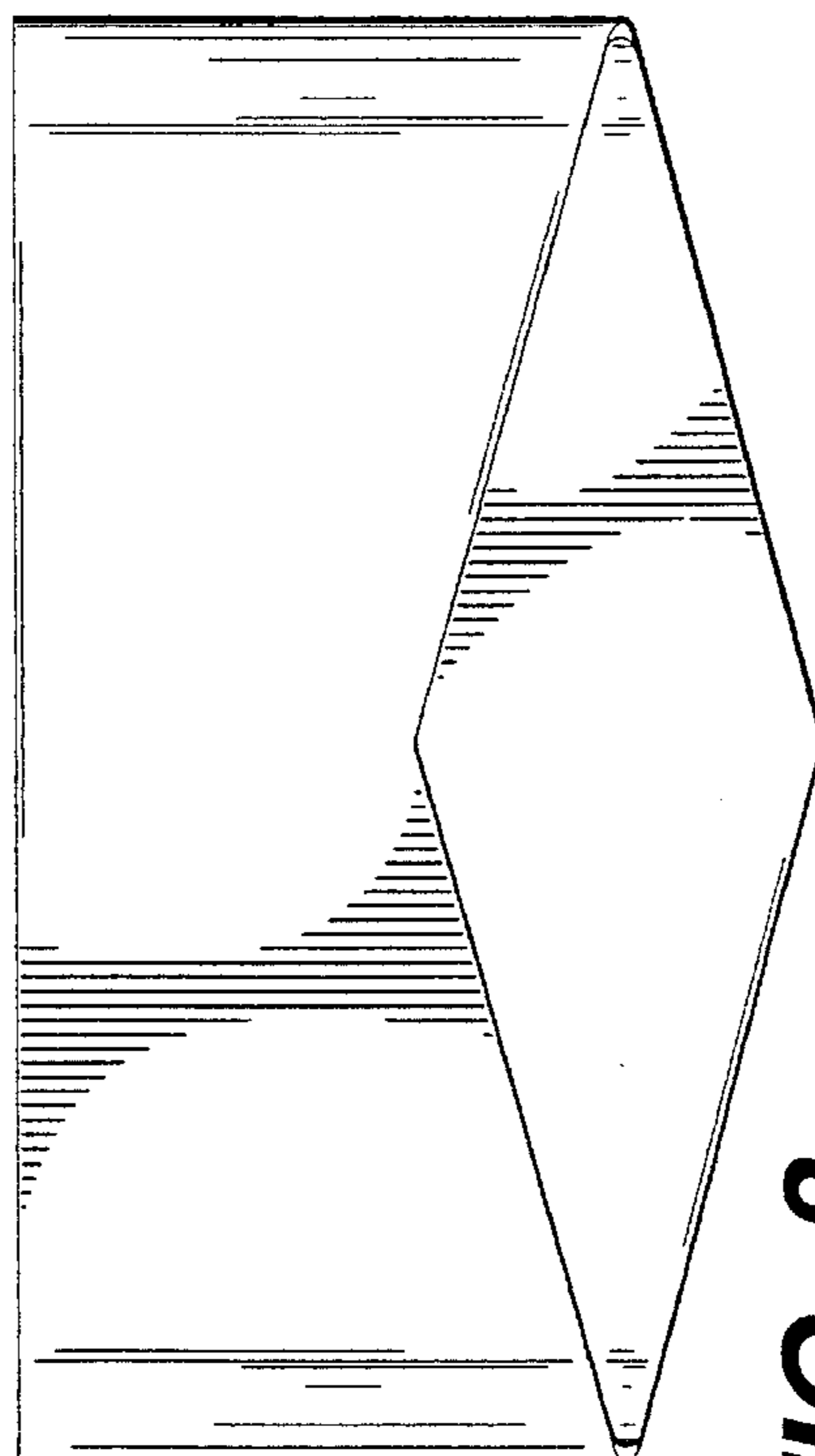

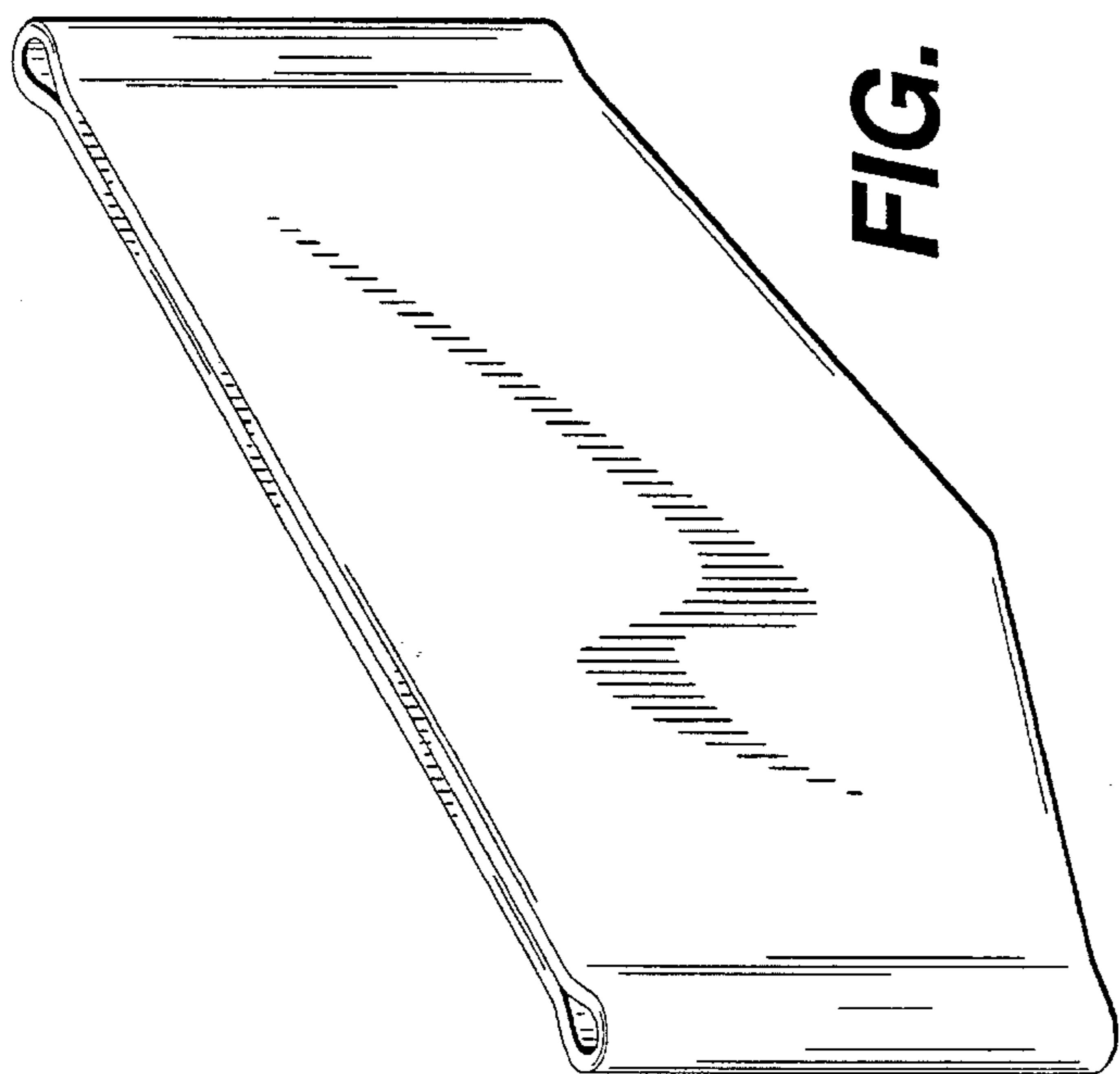

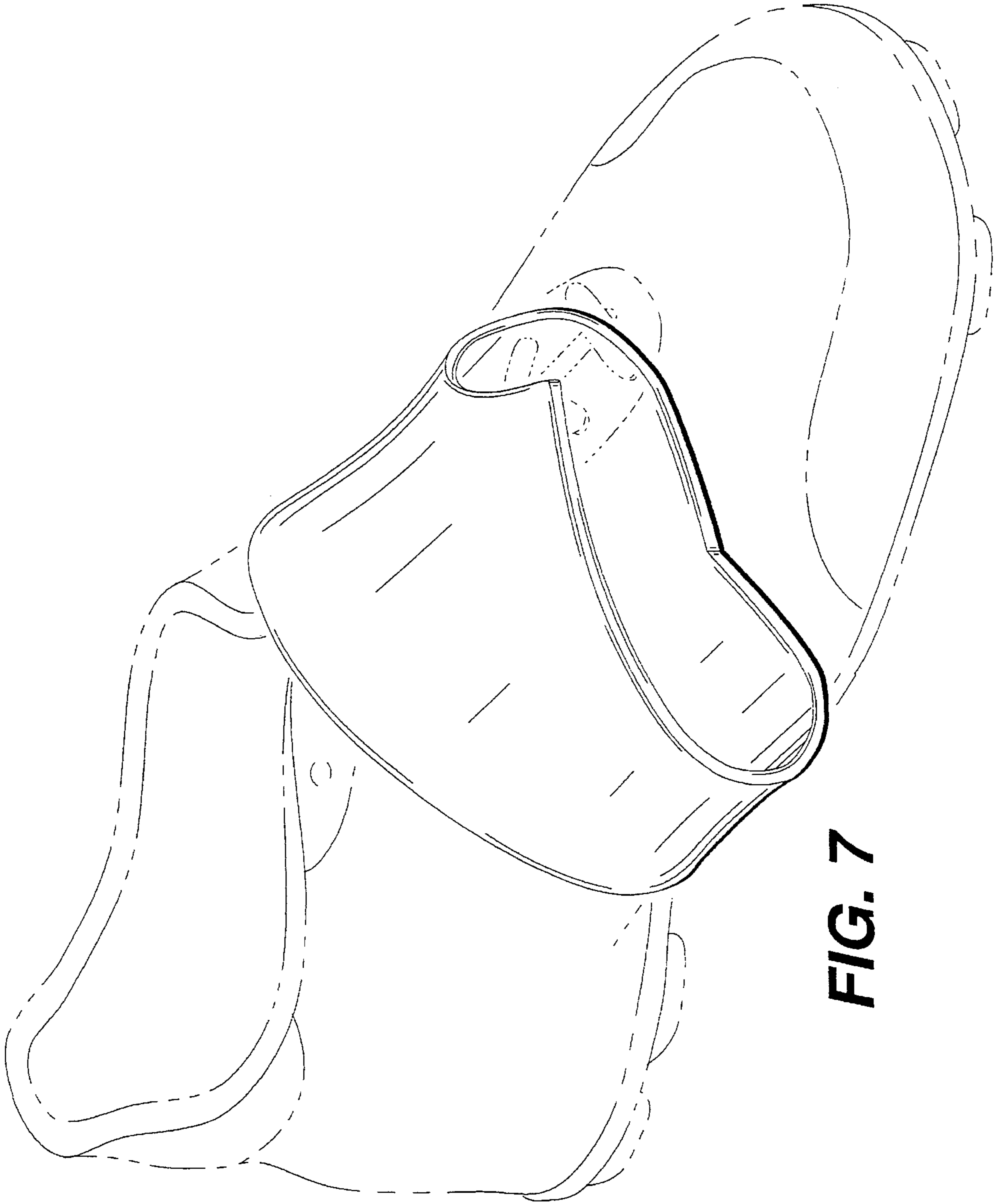

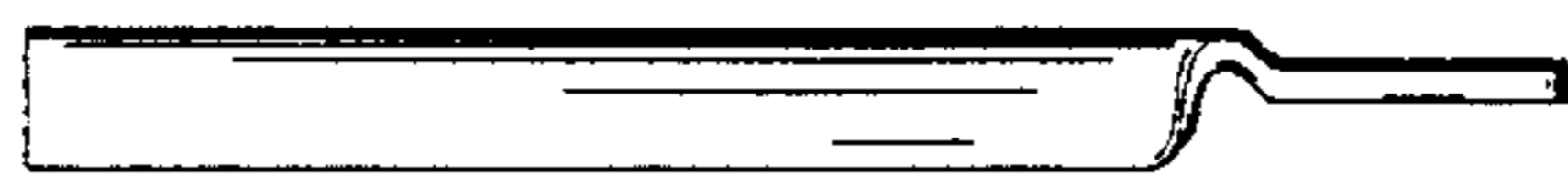
