FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a slipper chair showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof; and,

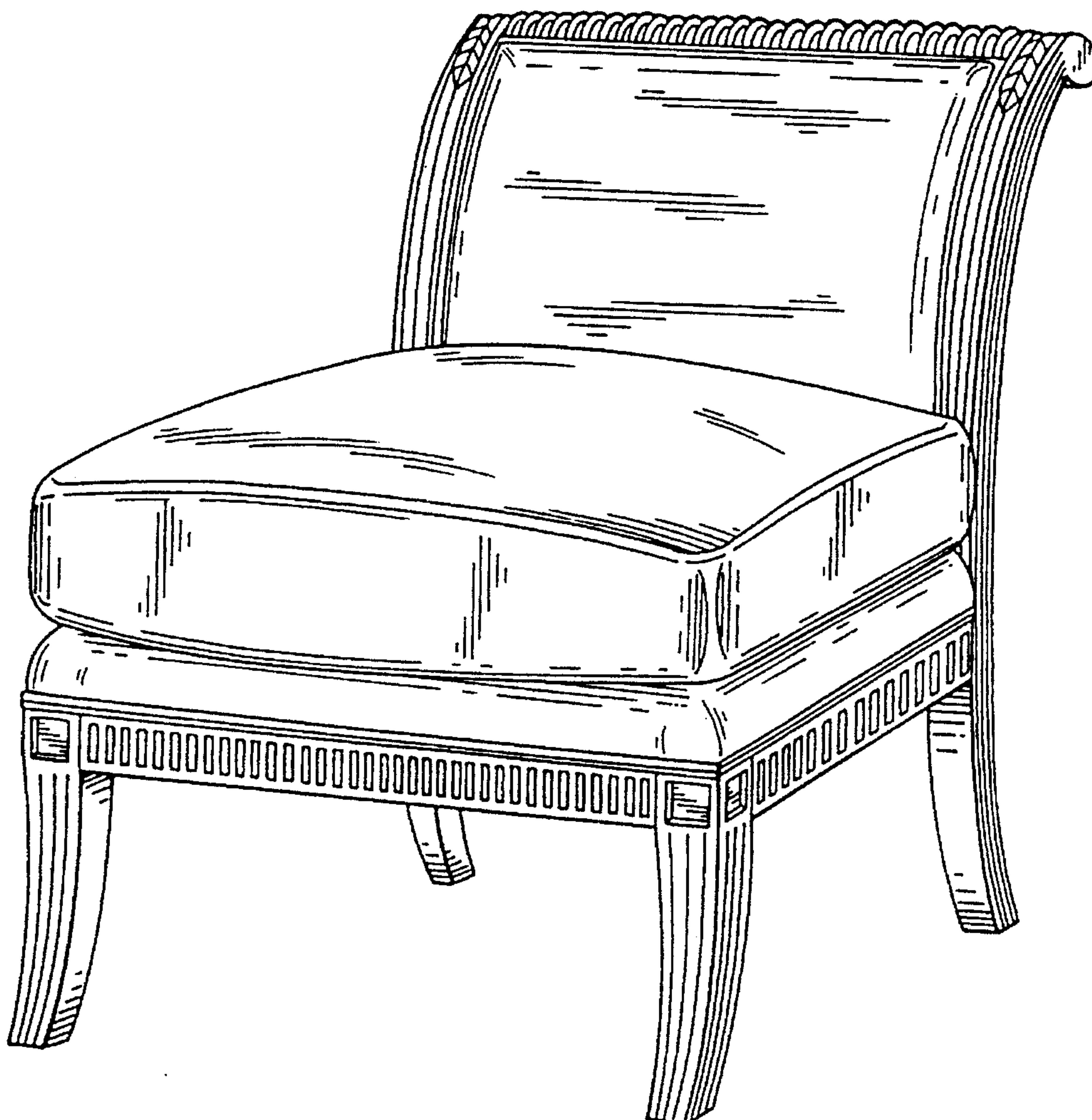

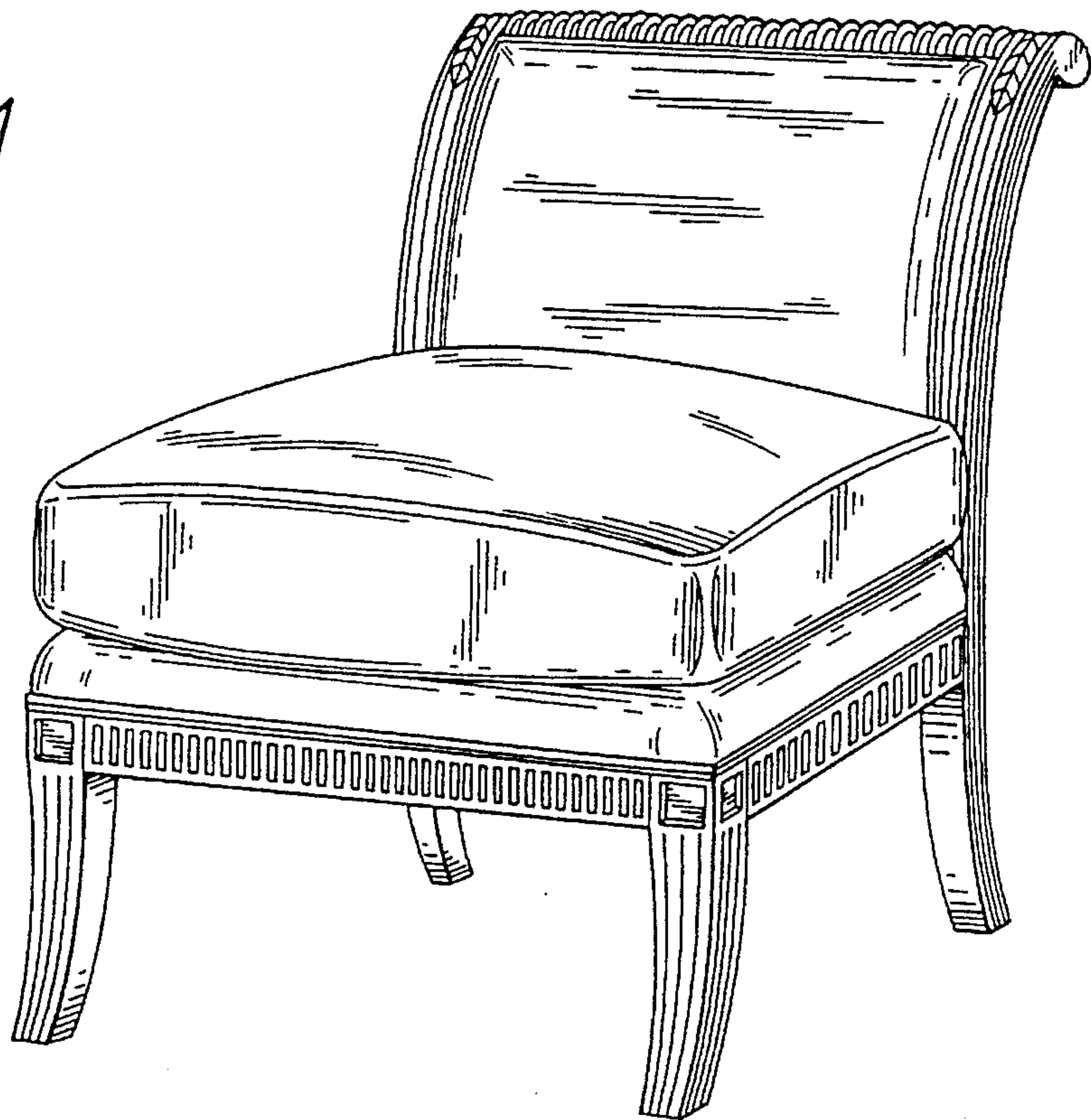
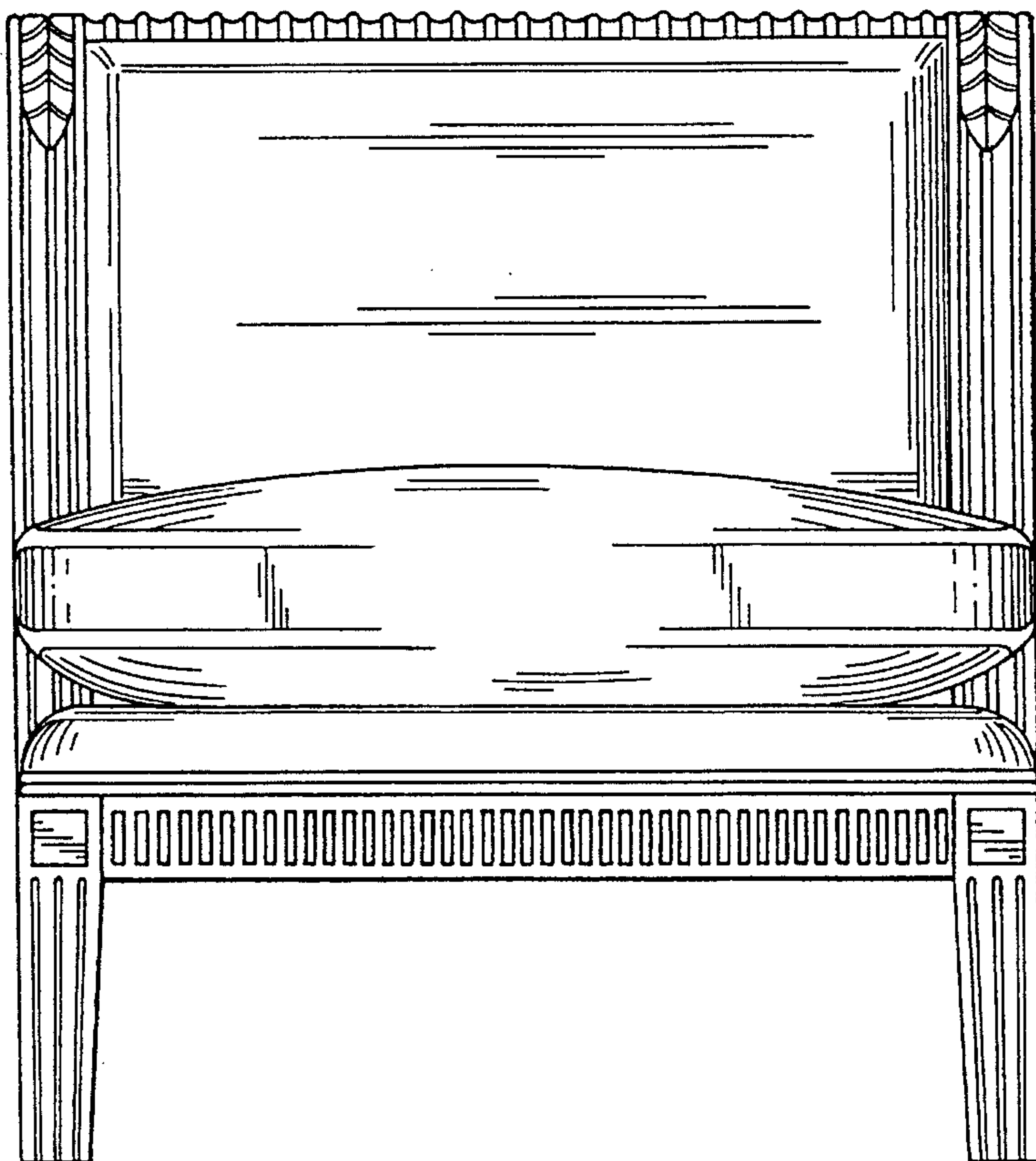

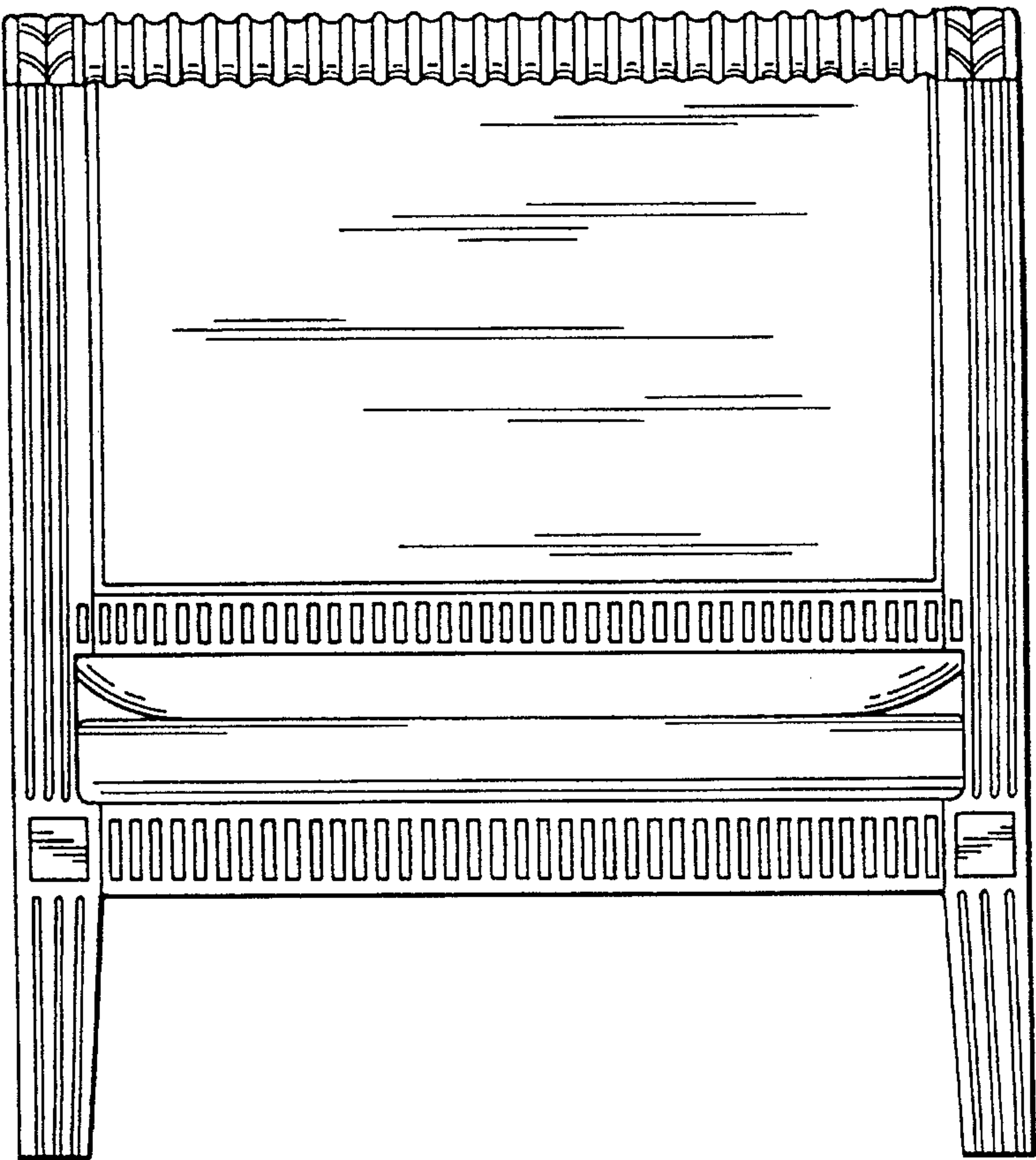

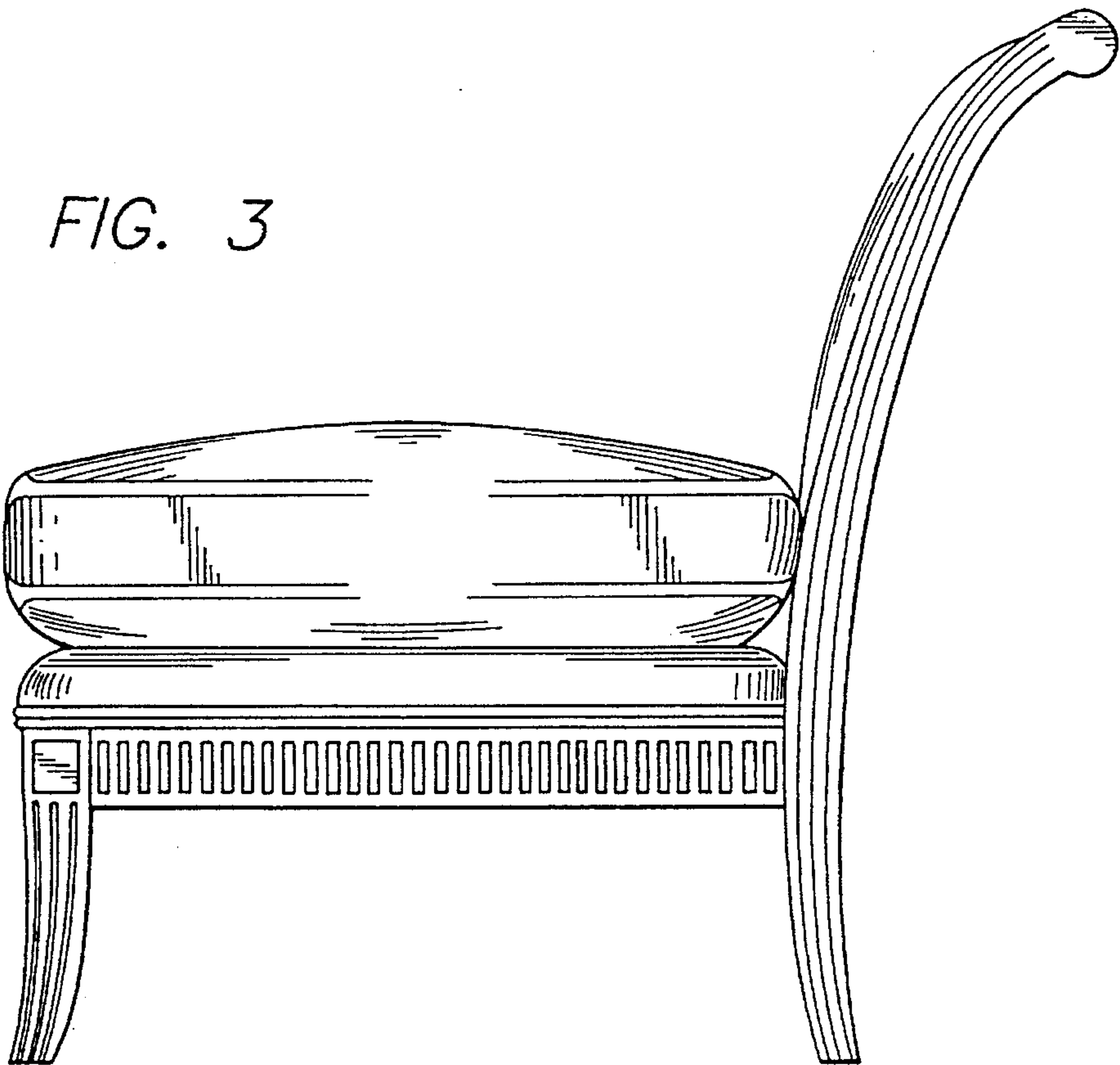
