The ornamental design for a computer mouse case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the novel computer mouse case; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side view being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
