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[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a urine collection funnel, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a urine collection funnel having a lid in place thereof in accordance with a first embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the urine collection funnel shown in FIG. 1, without the lid;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the urine collection funnel shown in FIG. 1, without the lid;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the urine collection funnel shown in FIG. 1, without the lid, with the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the urine collection funnel shown in FIG. 1, without the lid, with the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a urine collection funnel in accordance with a second embodiment of the invention, with the rear view elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view of the urine collection funnel shown in FIG. 6, with the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view of the urine collection funnel shown in FIG. 6;

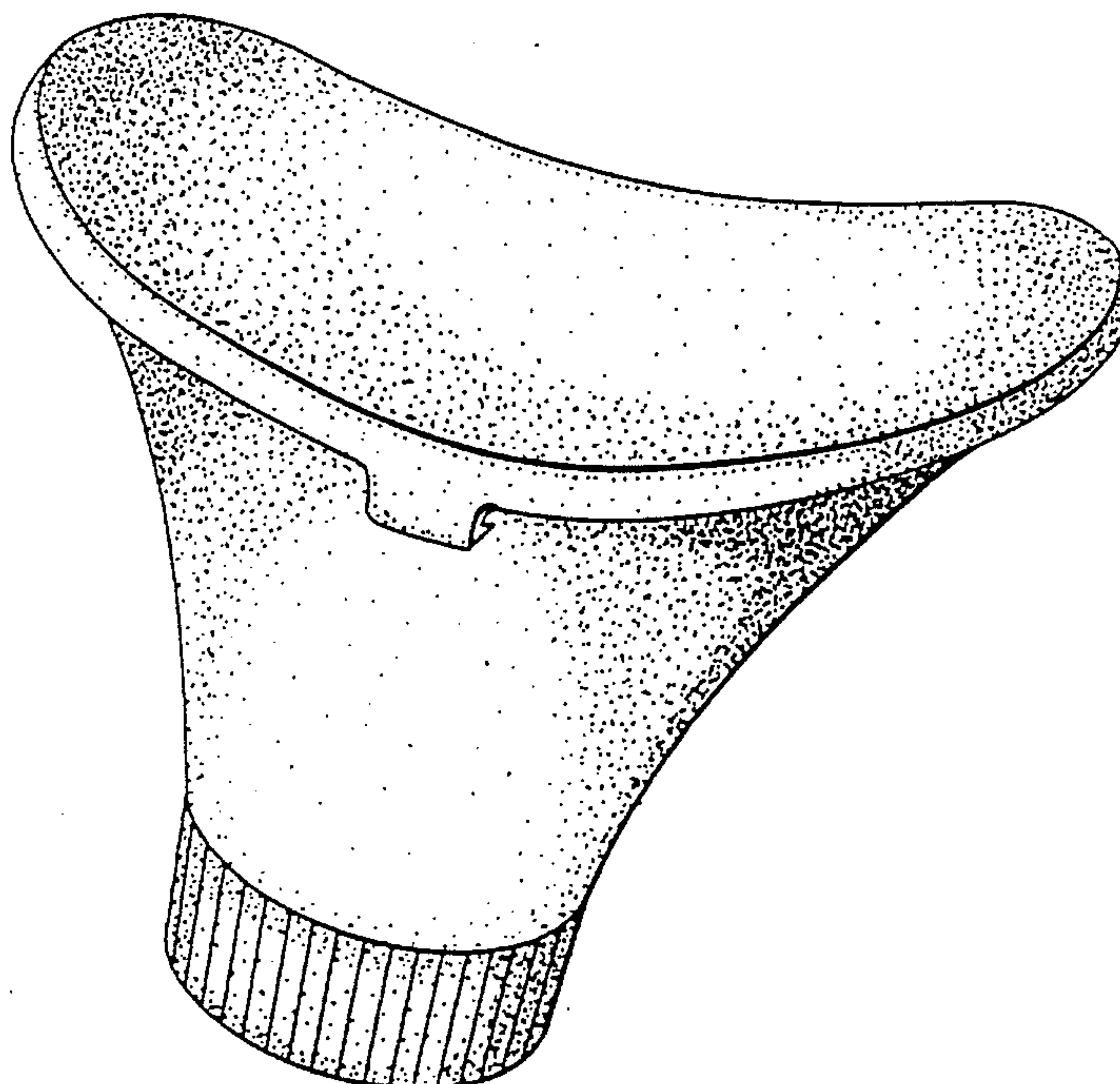
FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the urine collection funnel shown in FIG. 6;

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the urine collection funnel shown in FIG. 6, with an optional handle, with the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 11 is a left side elevational view of the urine collection funnel shown in FIG. 10; and,

FIG. 12 is a right side elevational view of the urine collection funnel shown in FIG. 10.

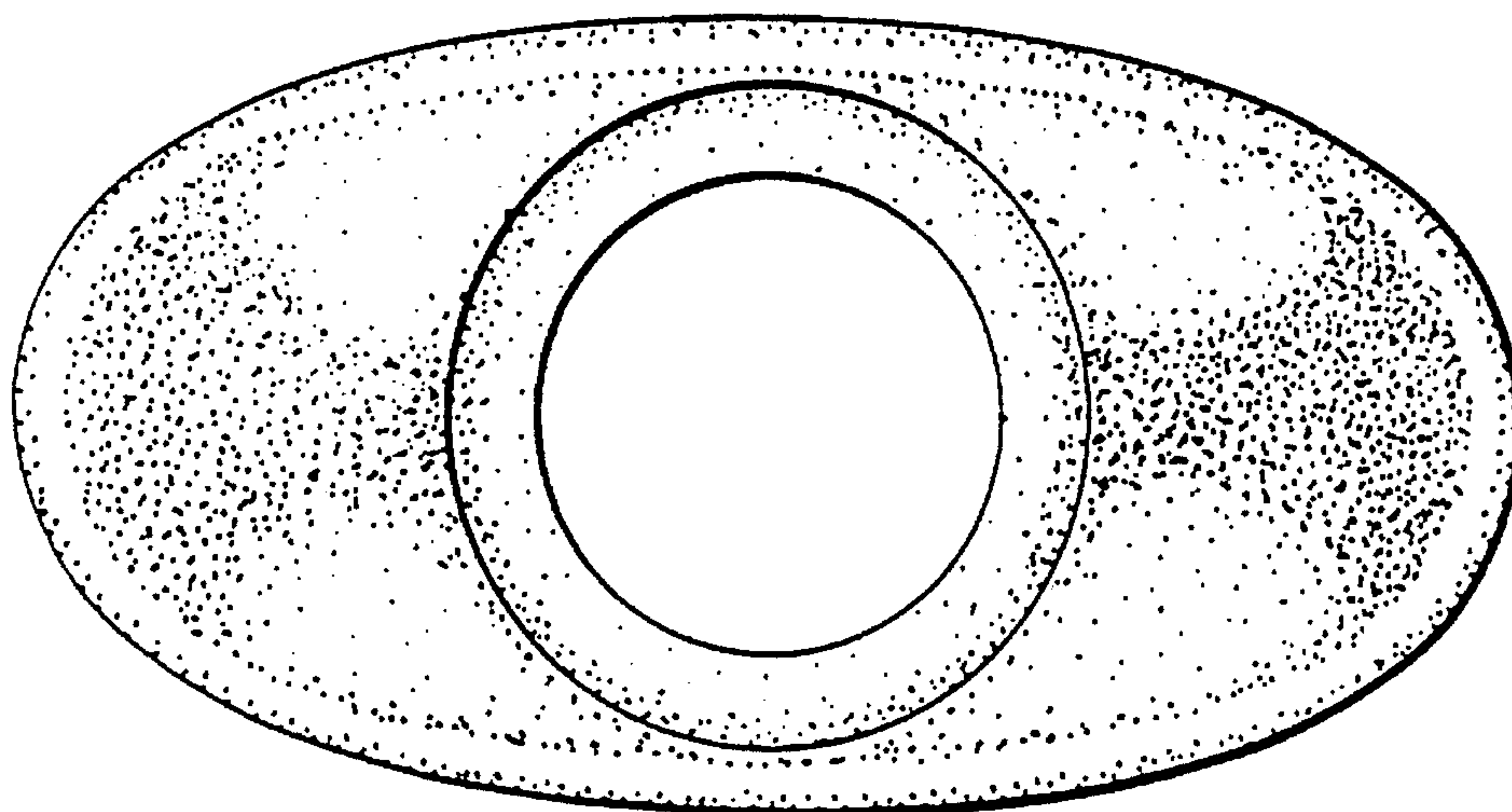
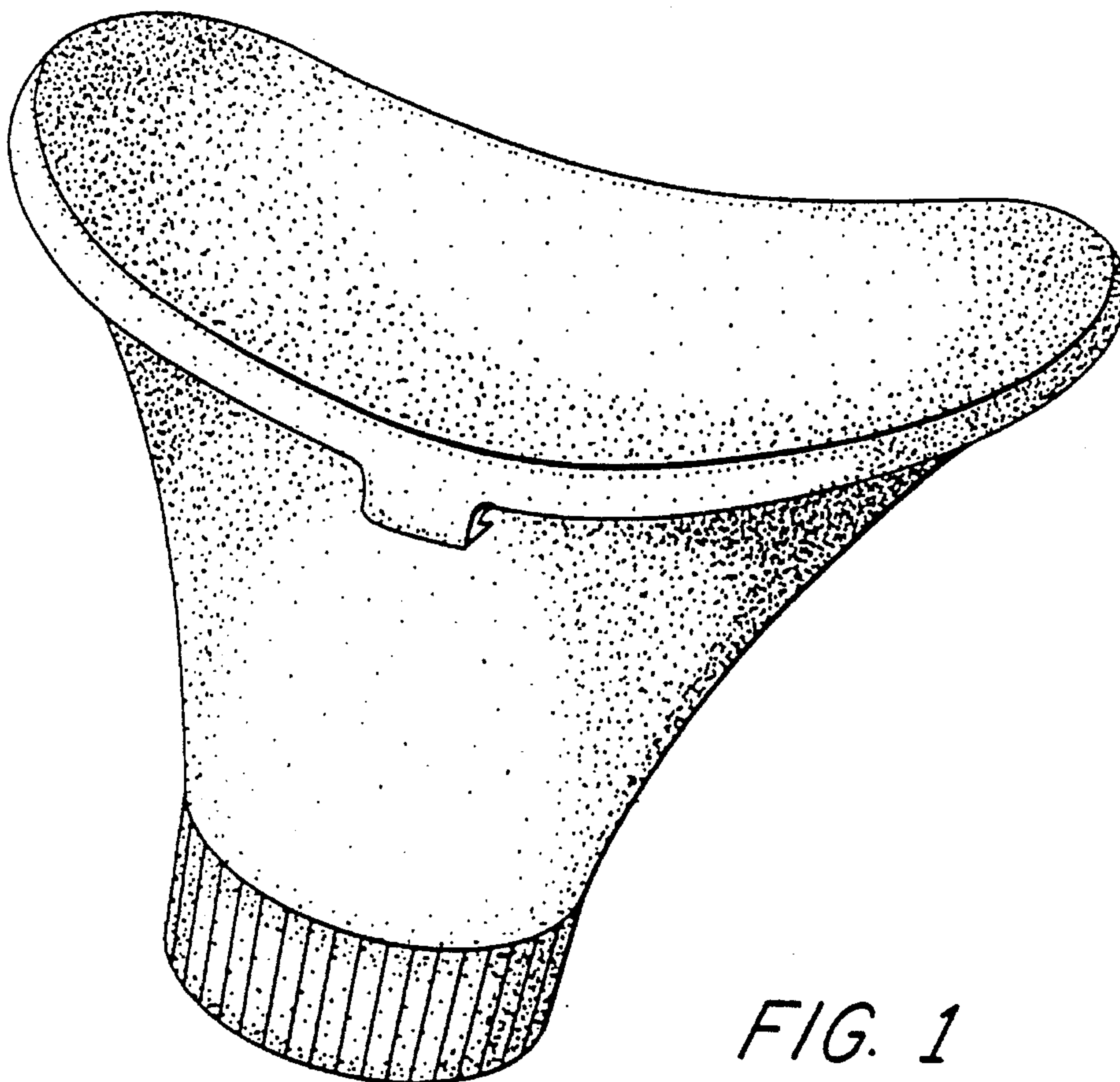

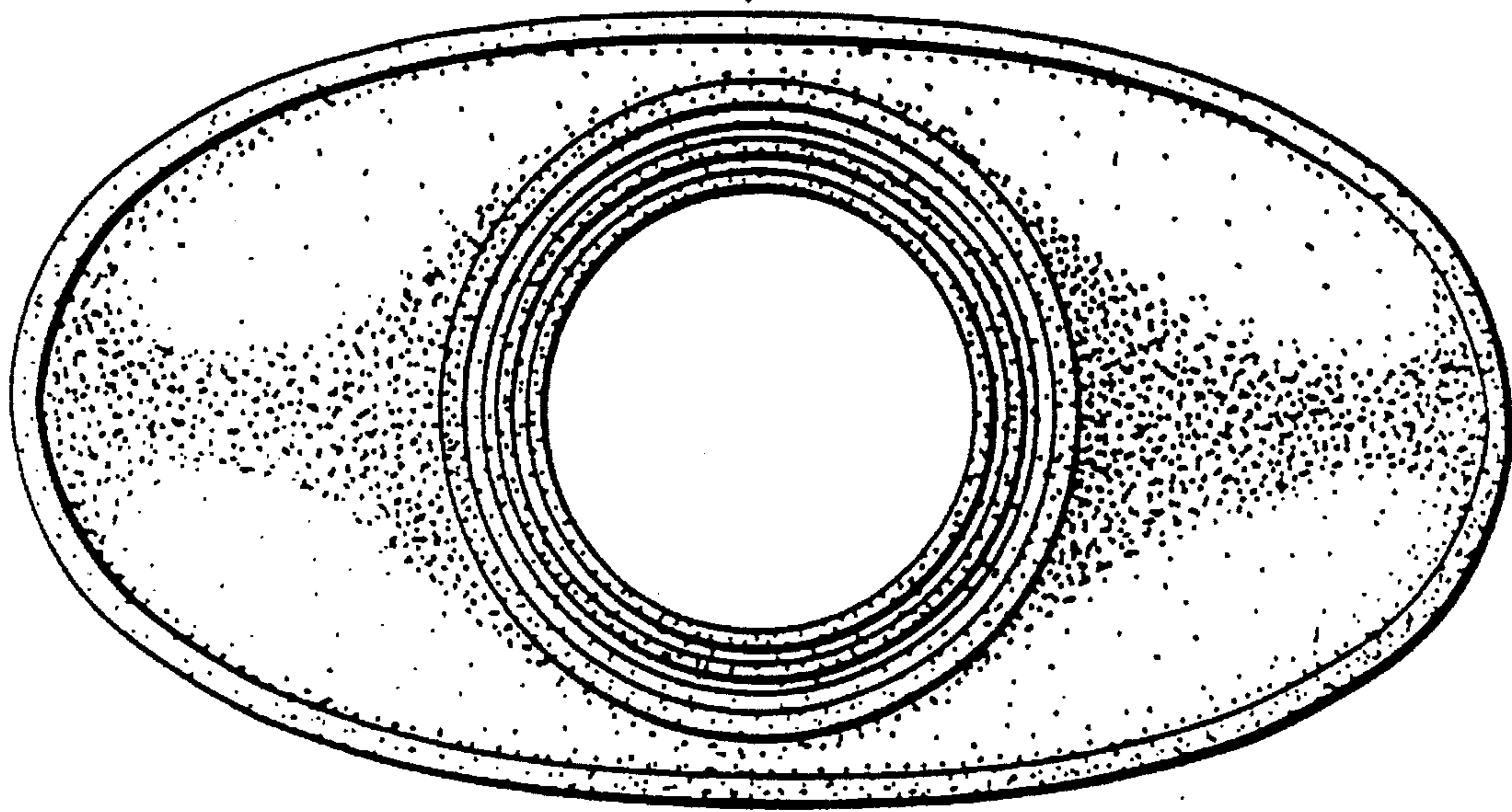

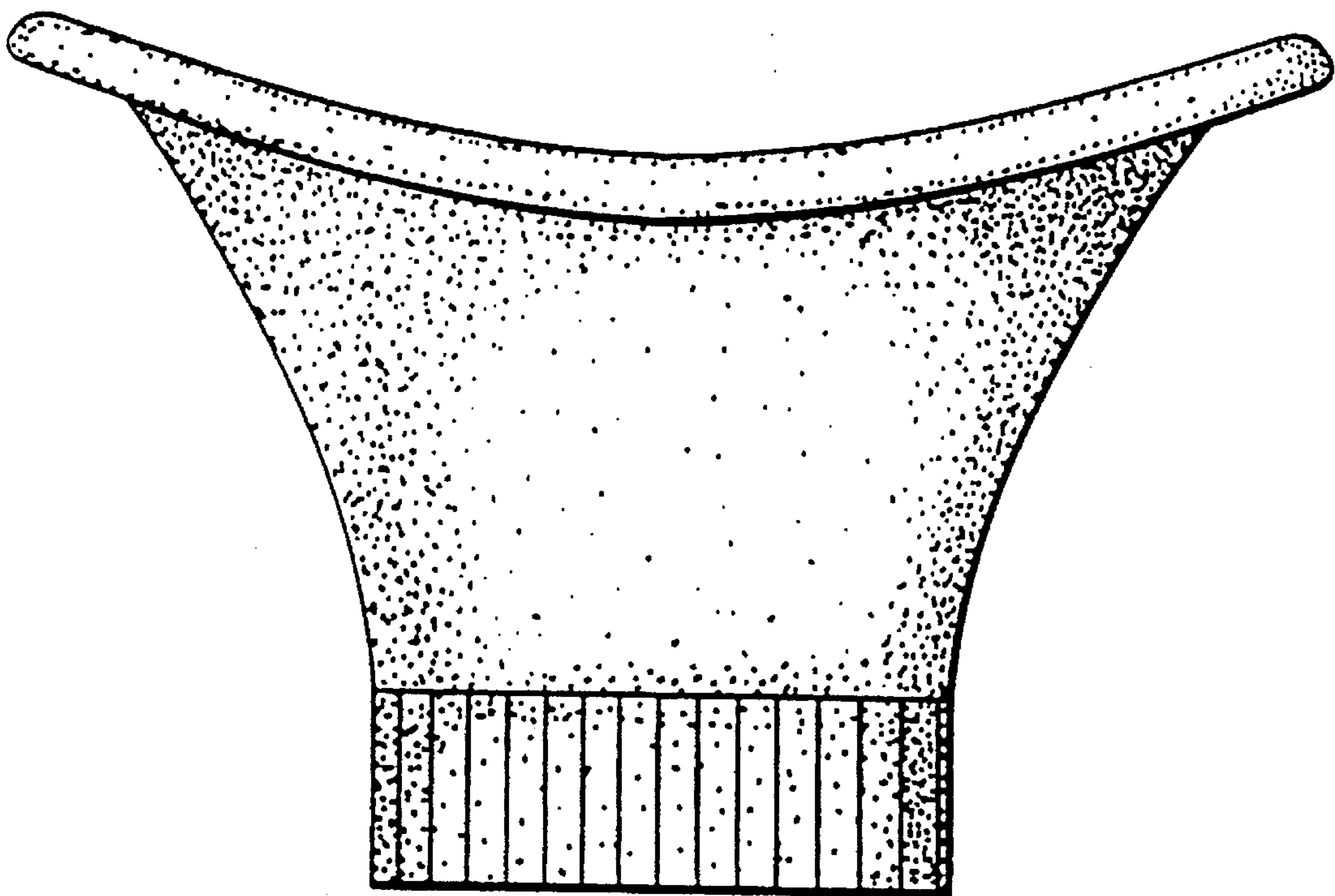
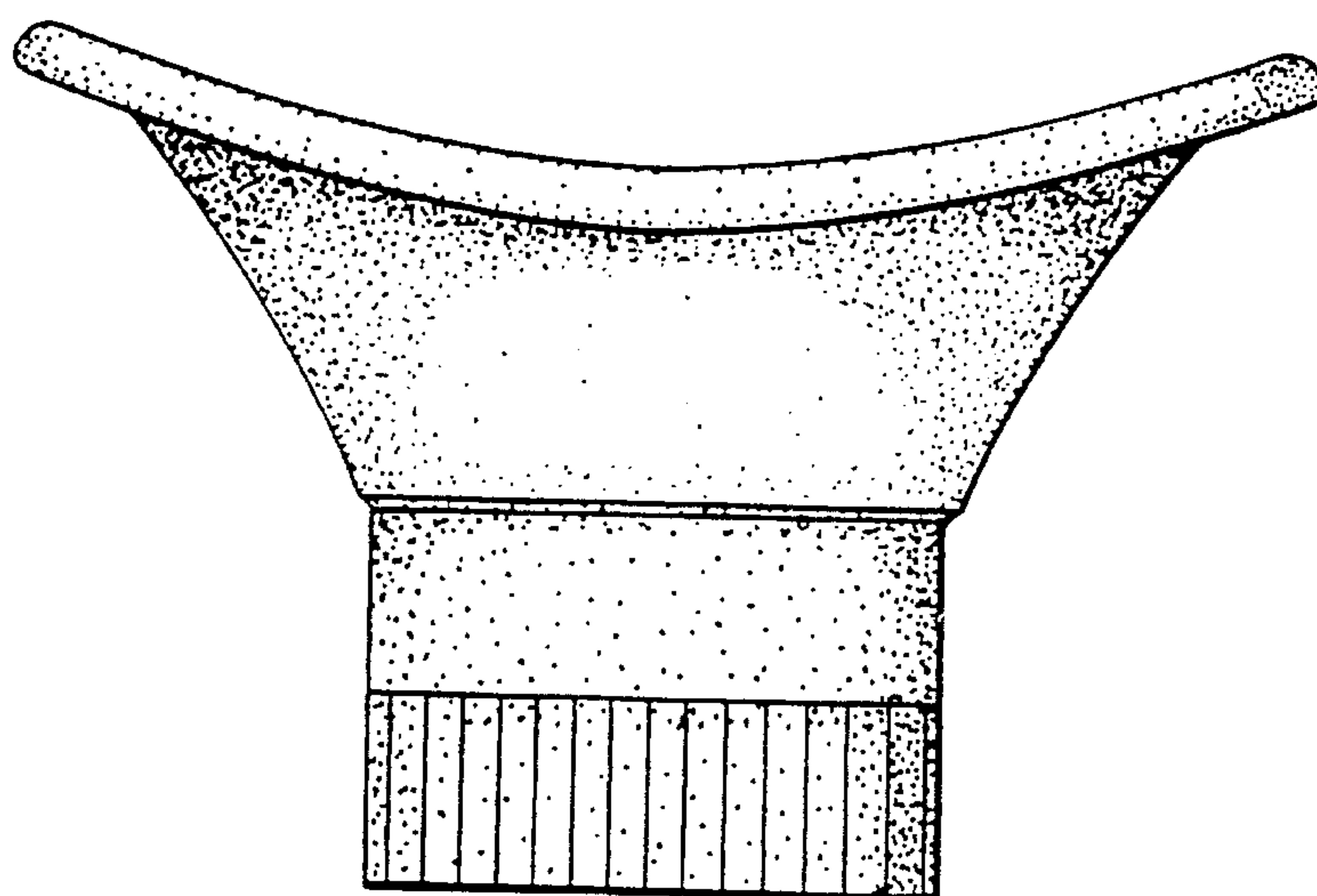
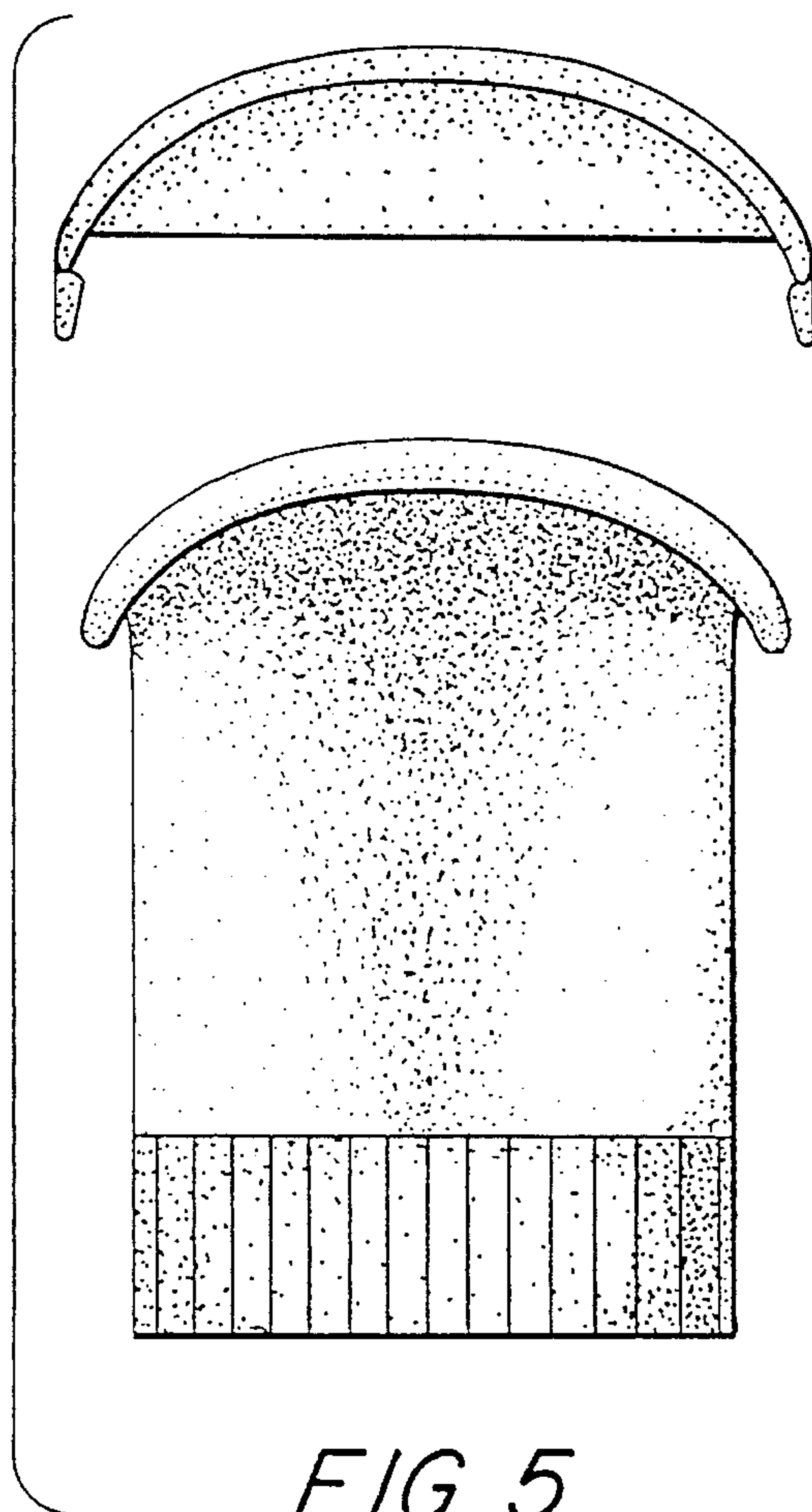

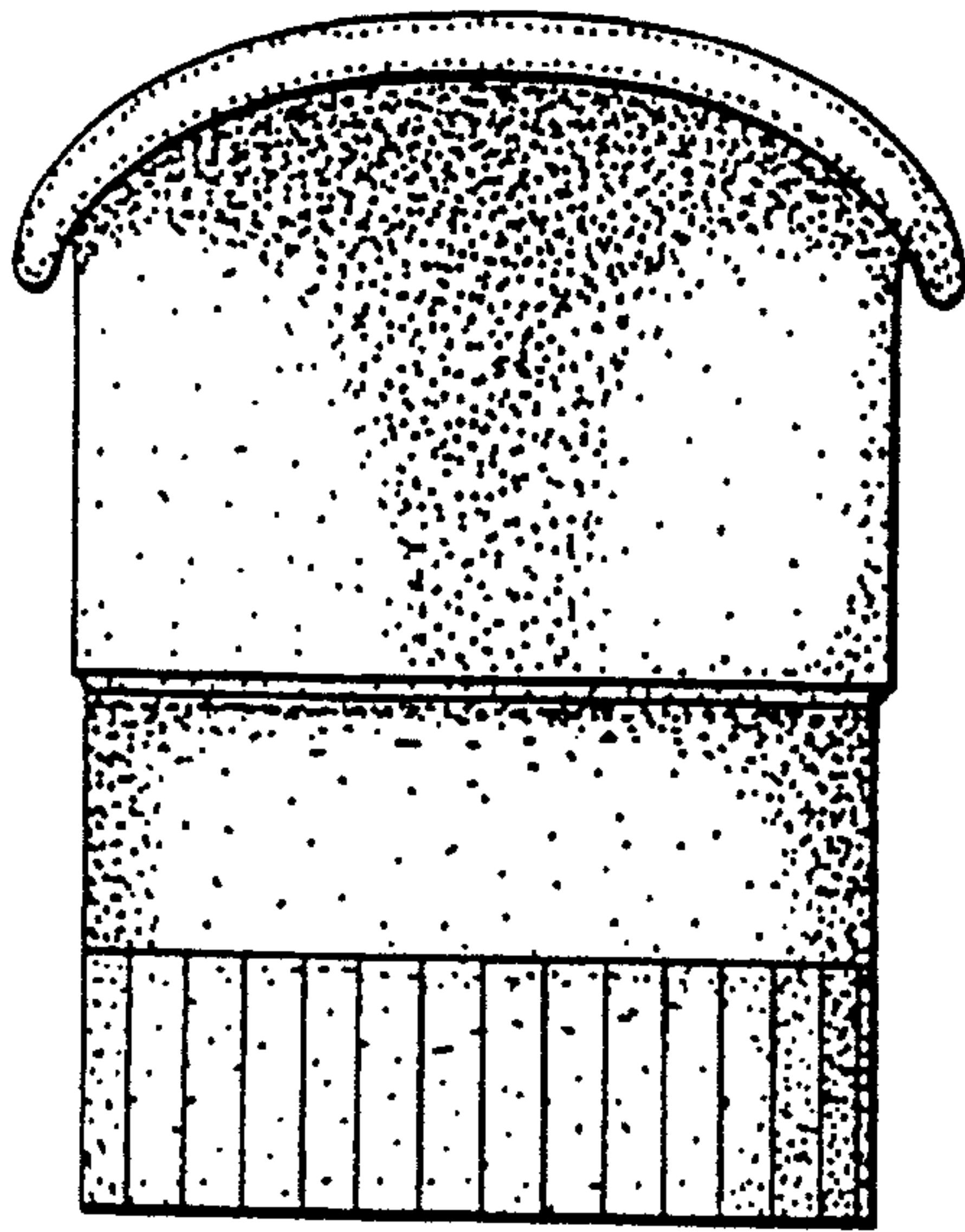

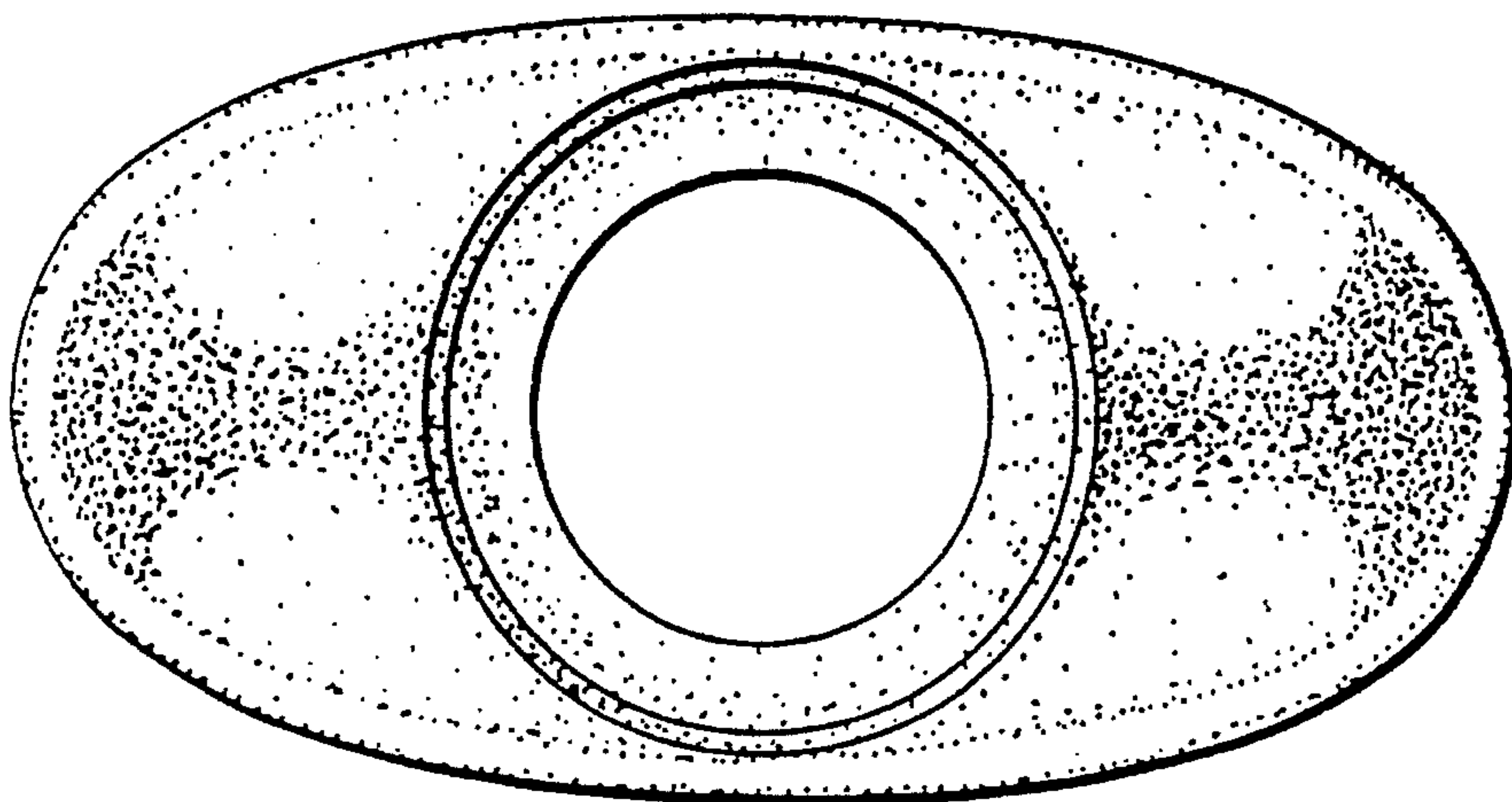

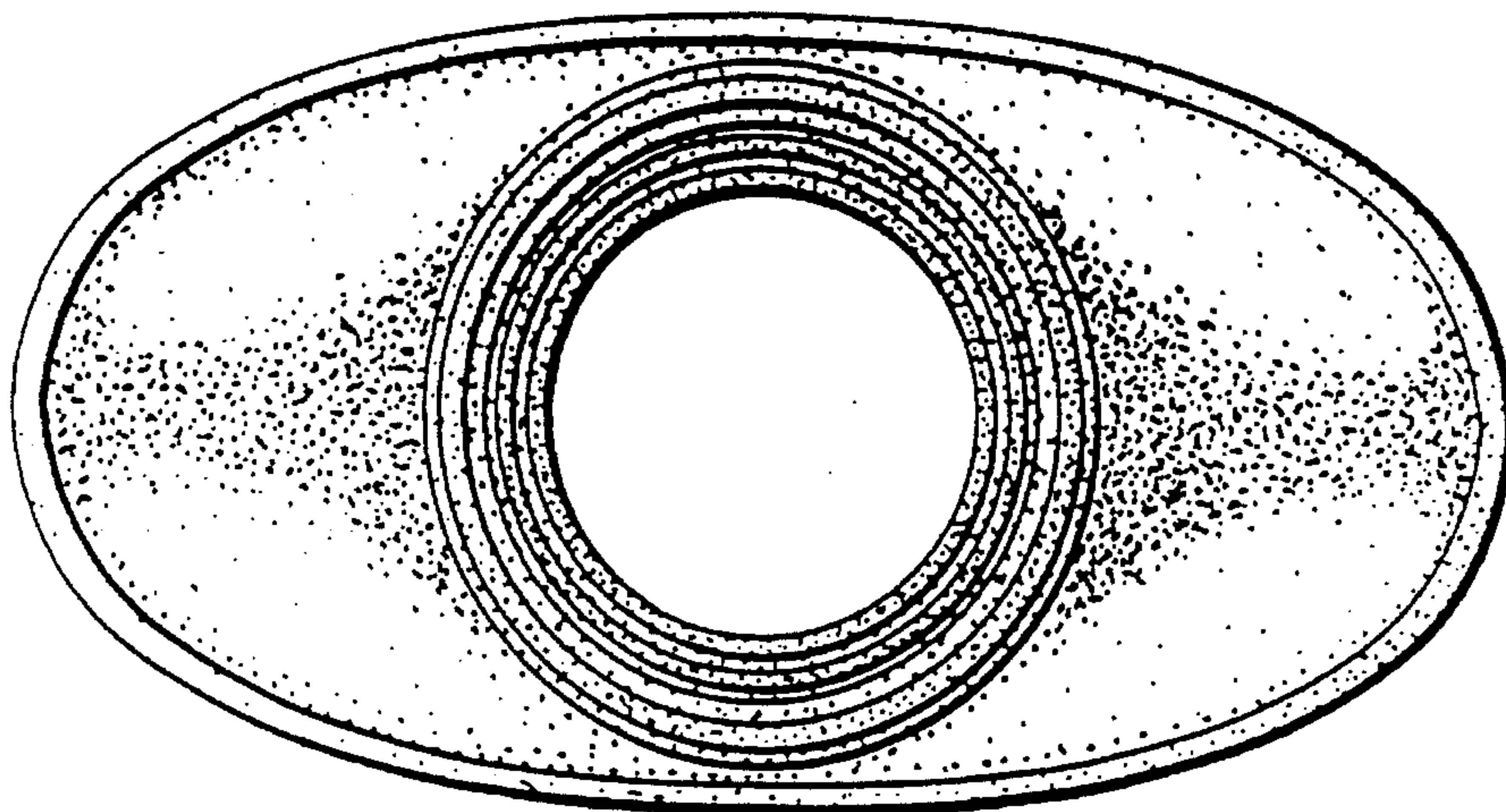

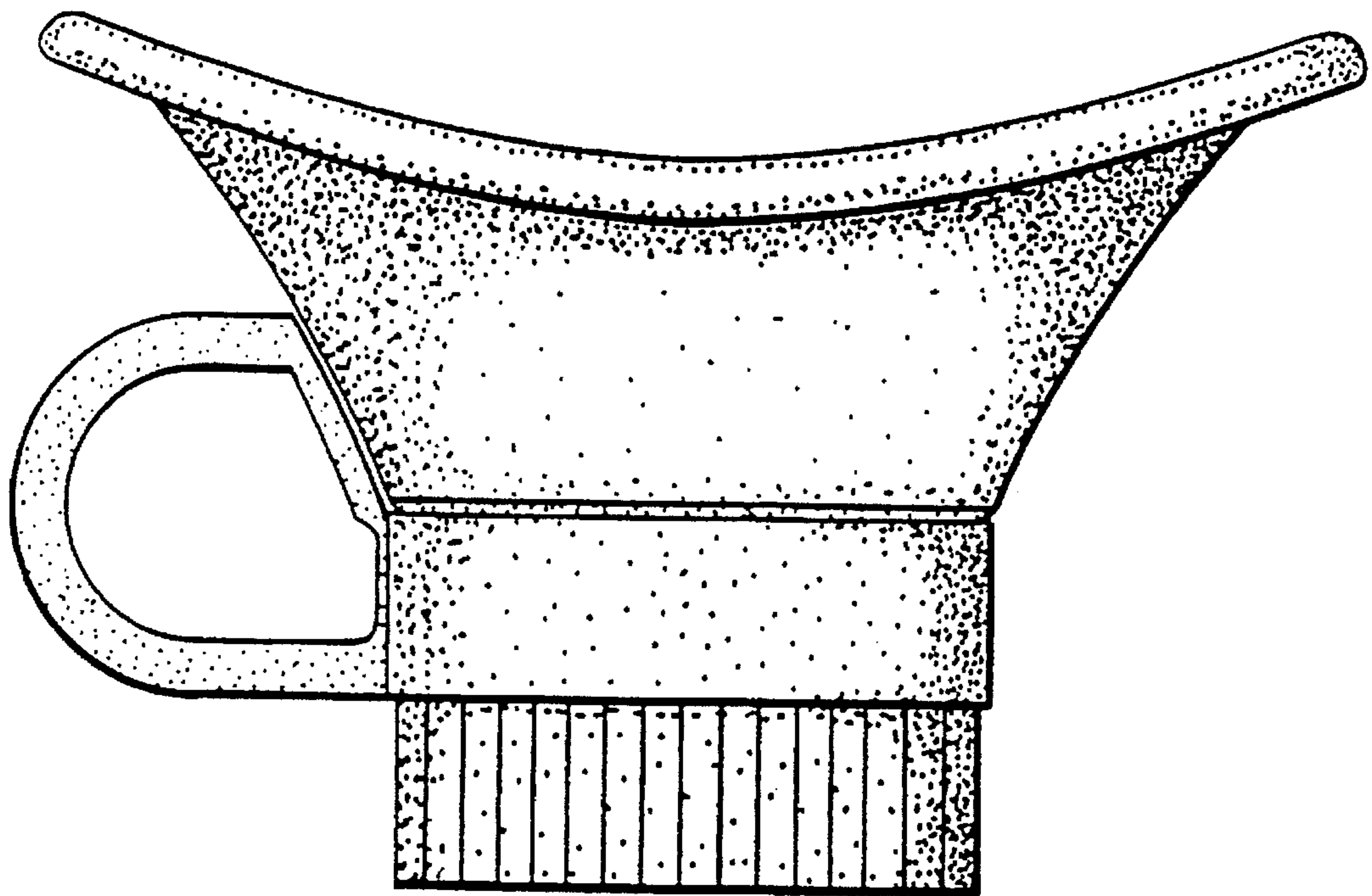

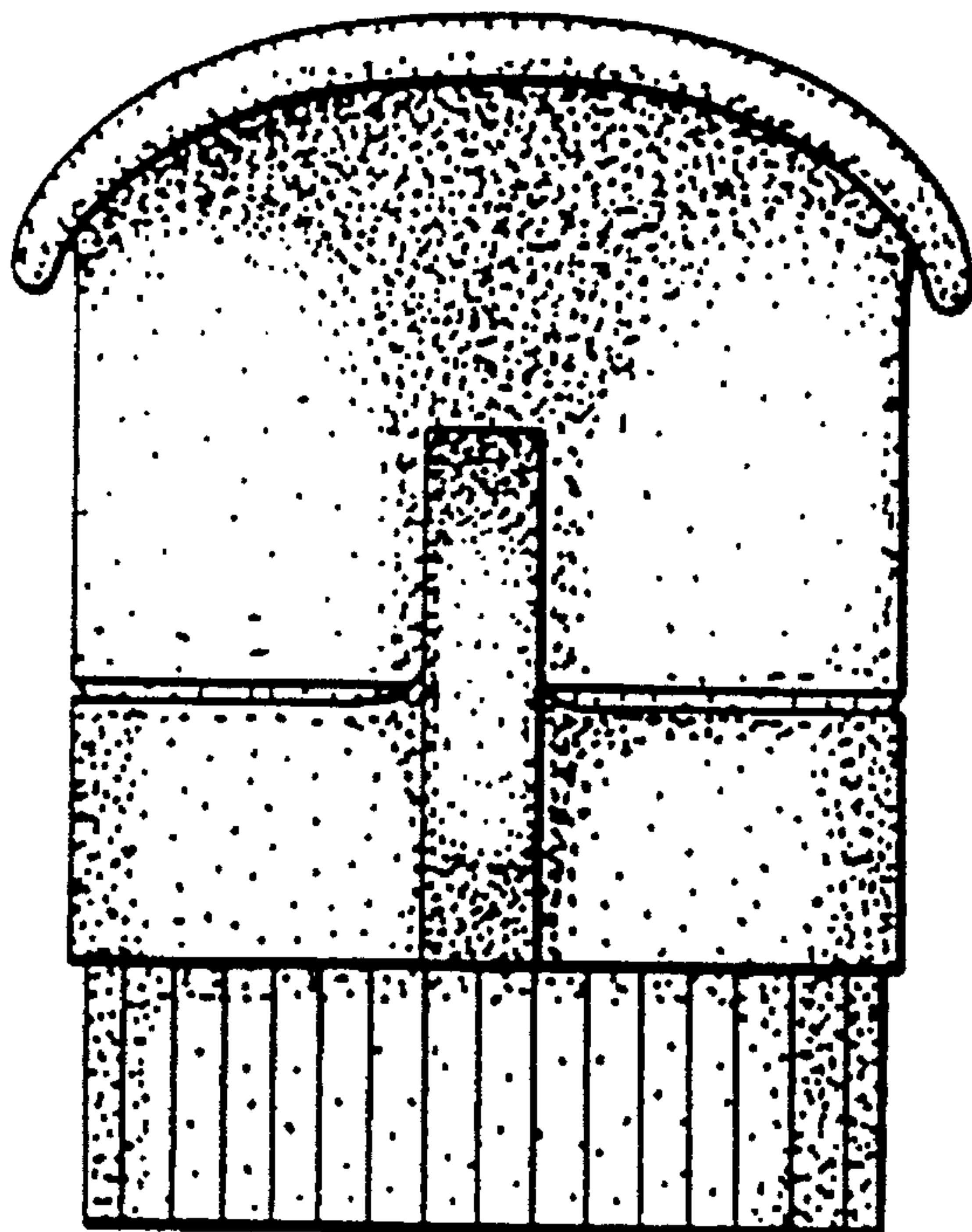

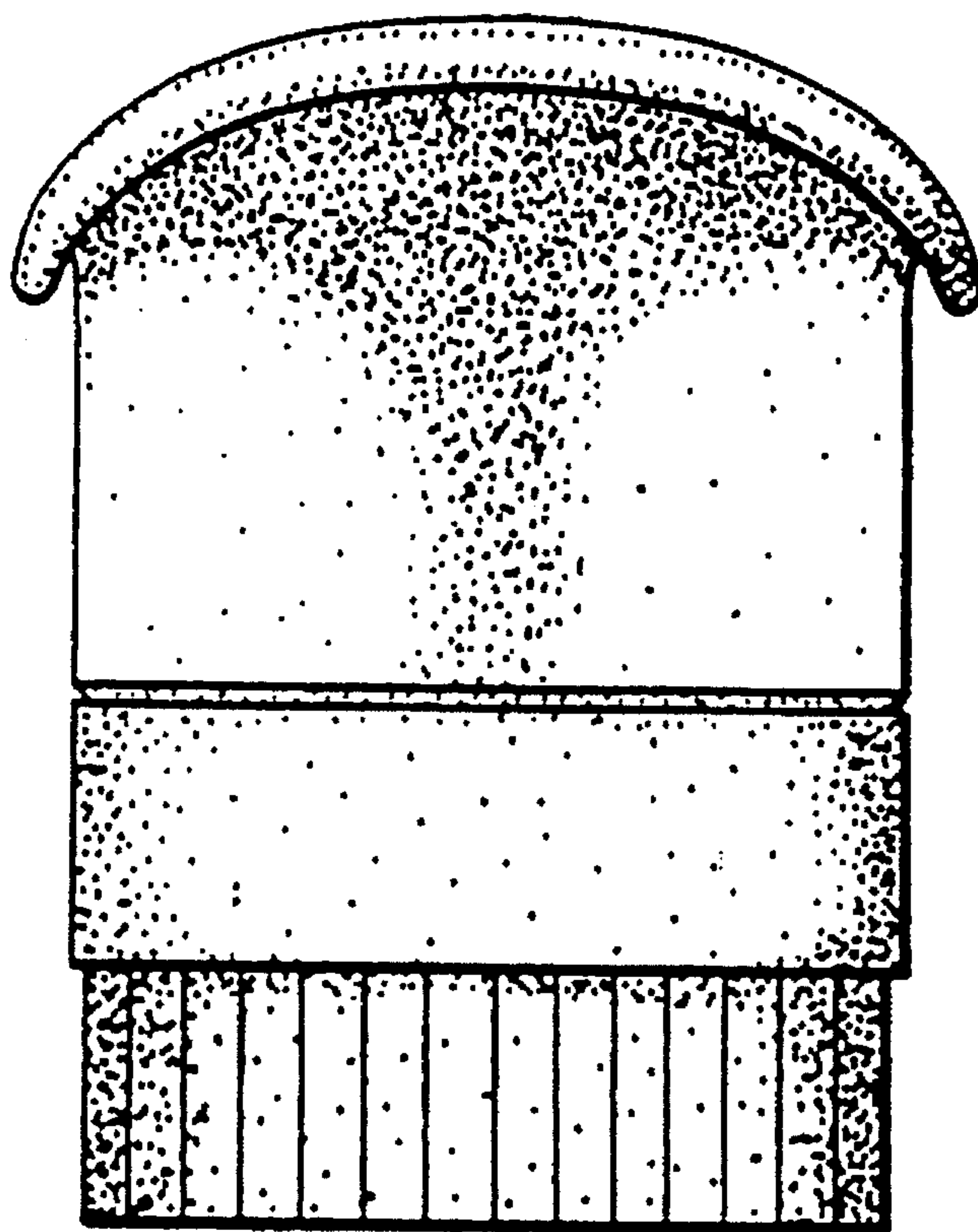
