CLAIM

The ornamental design for a set of letter-shaped pasta, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a set of letter-shaped pasta showing a first embodiment of our new design;

- FIG. 28 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image;






FIG. 29 is a right-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 95 is a top plan view of a letter-shaped pasta showing a twenty-fourth embodiment of our new design;


FIG. 96 is a left-side elevational view thereof, the right-side elevational view being identical;


FIG. 97 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being identical; and,


FIG. 98 is a bottom plan view thereof.

It is understood that the figures are shown separately for clarity of illustration only and the separate embodiment comprise a set.









