FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

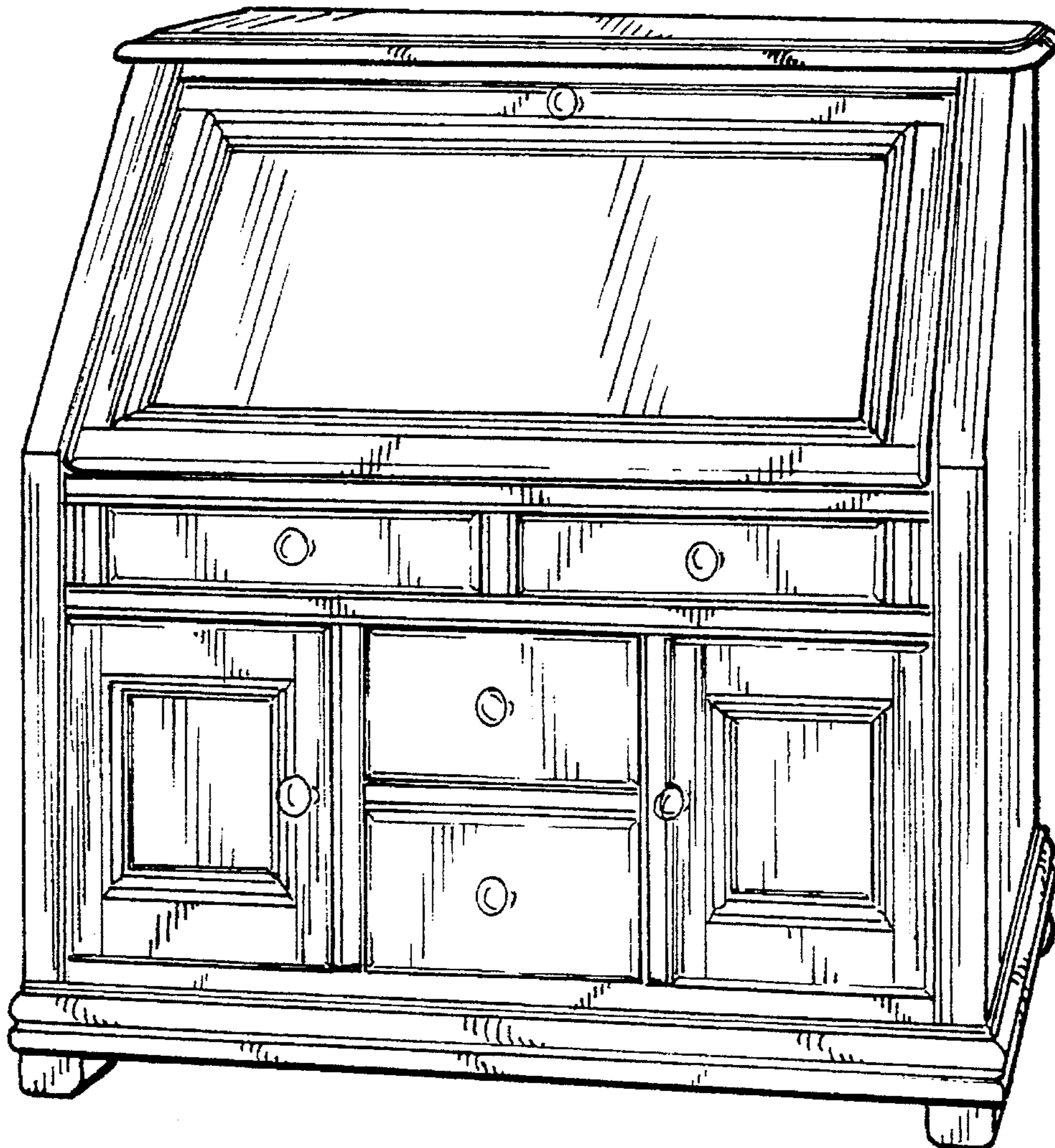
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and,

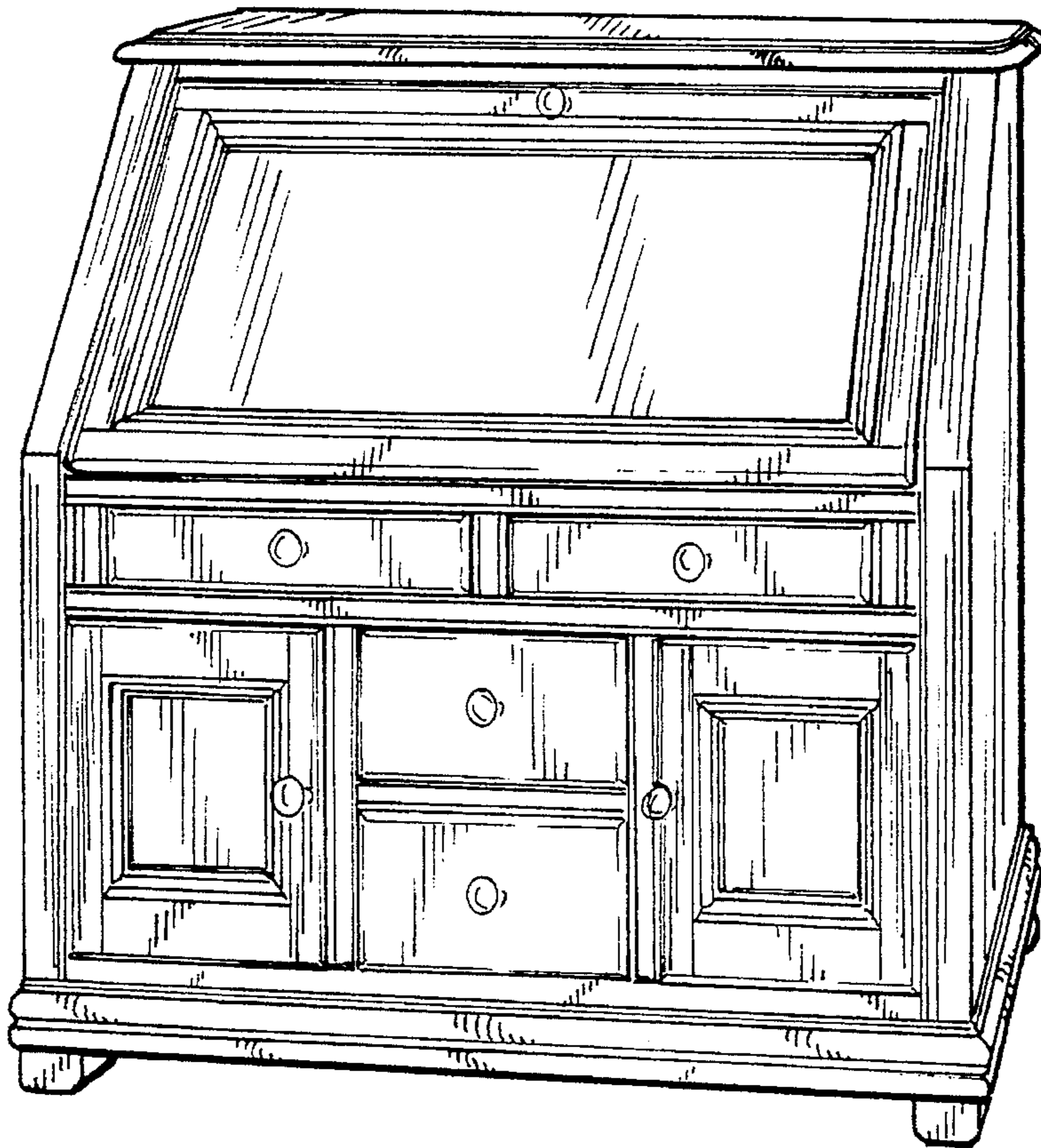

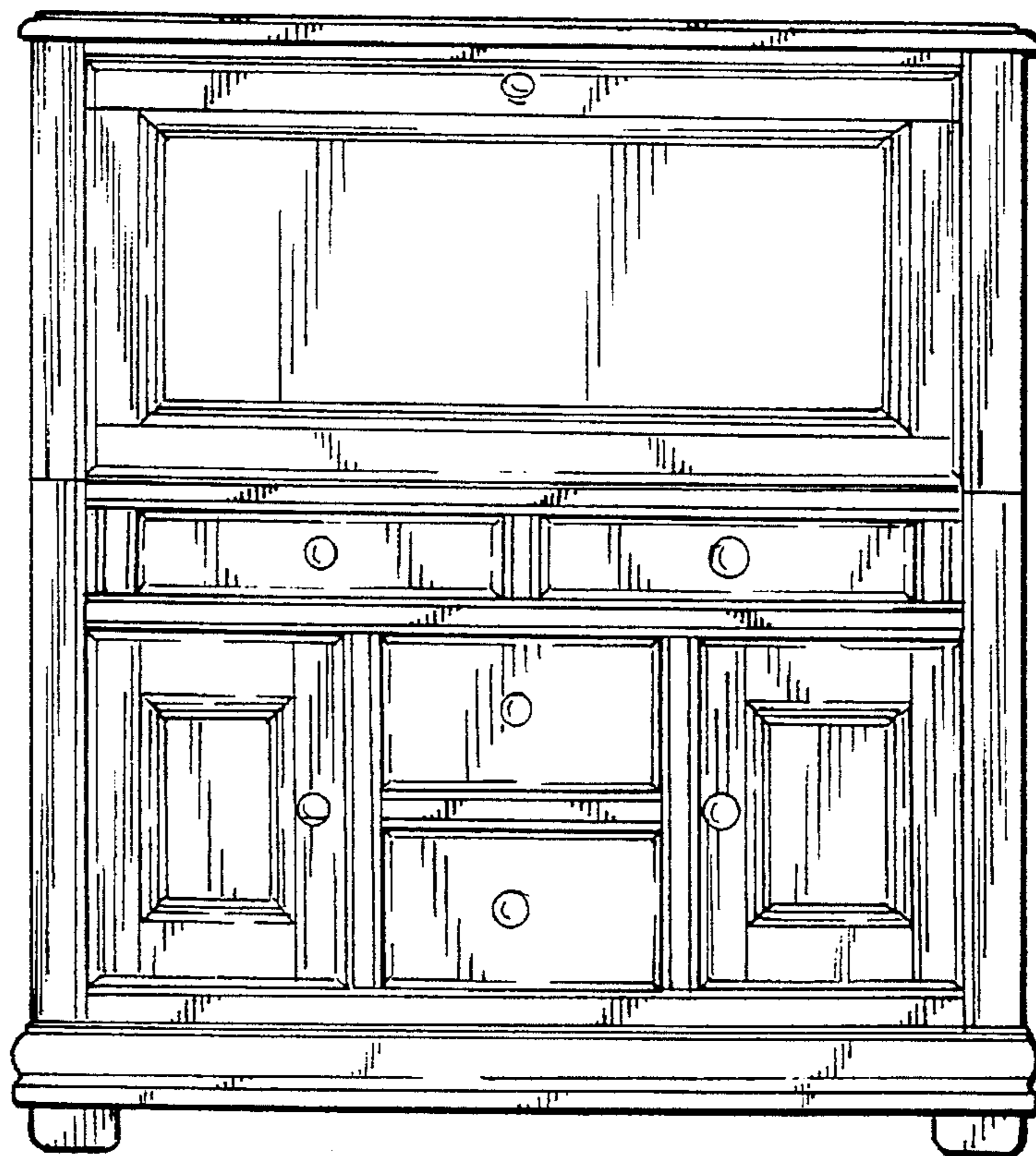

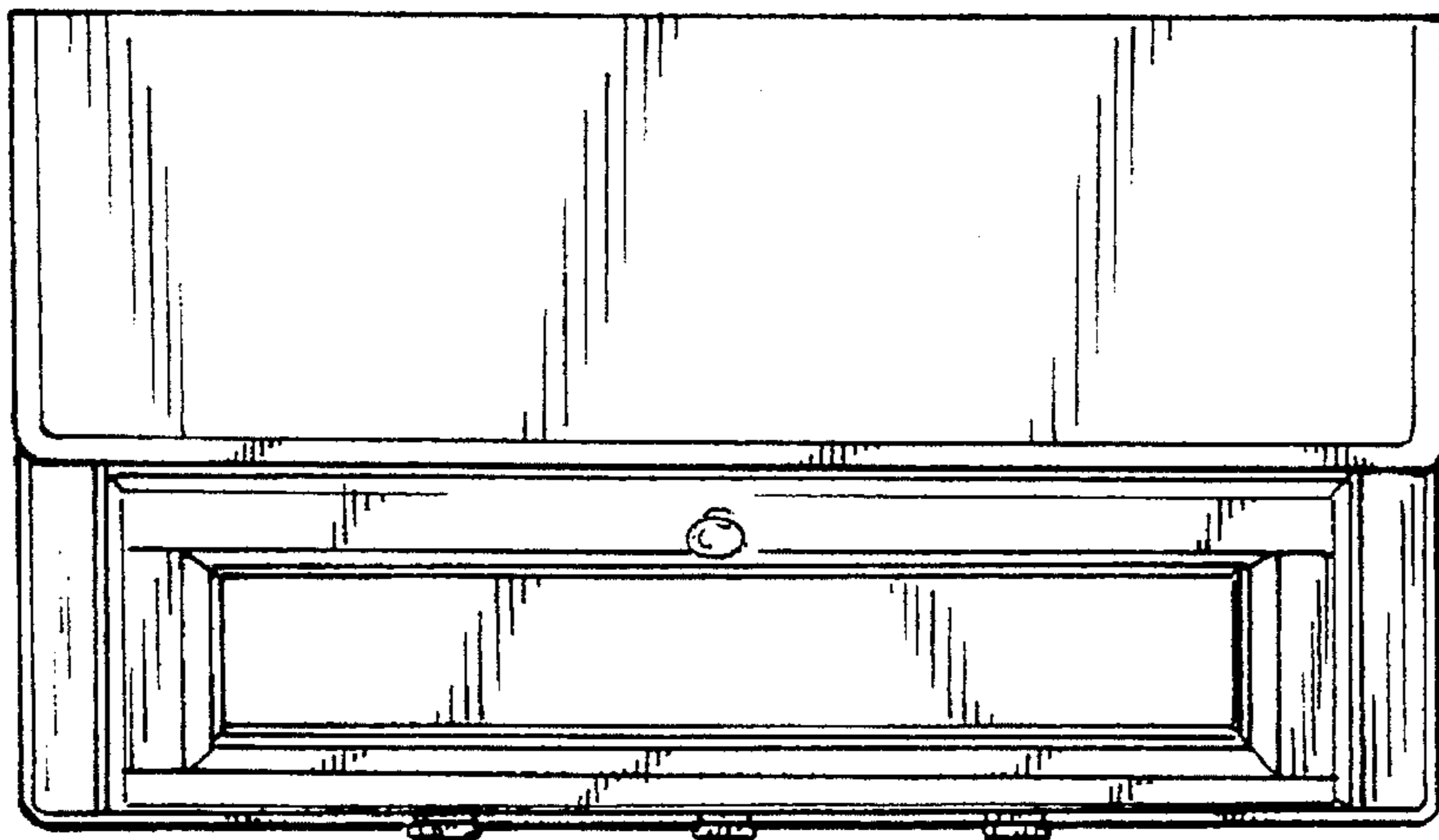

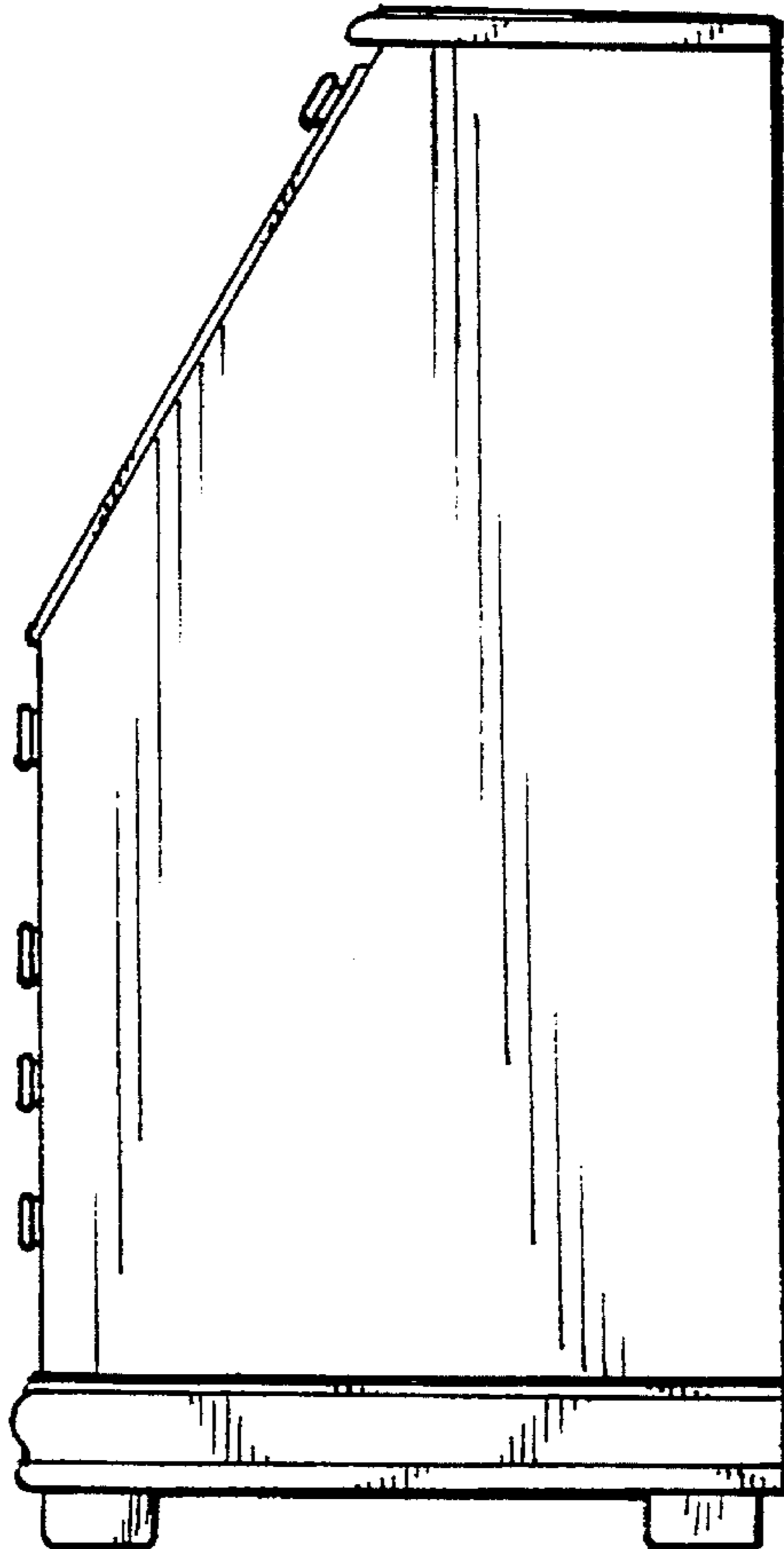
