FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 7 is a top, front and right-side perspective view thereof;


FIG. 8 is a top, front and right-side perspective view thereof in open position; and,

FIG. 9 is a top, front and right-side perspective view thereof in operation.

















