[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a headwrap with a detachable visor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a headwrap with detachable visor showing my new design, the broken line showing of the human form is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is an exploded rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the visor portion shown separately for ease of illustration;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side is a mirror image;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view of the headwrap portion in an open position;

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the headwrap portion in an open position;

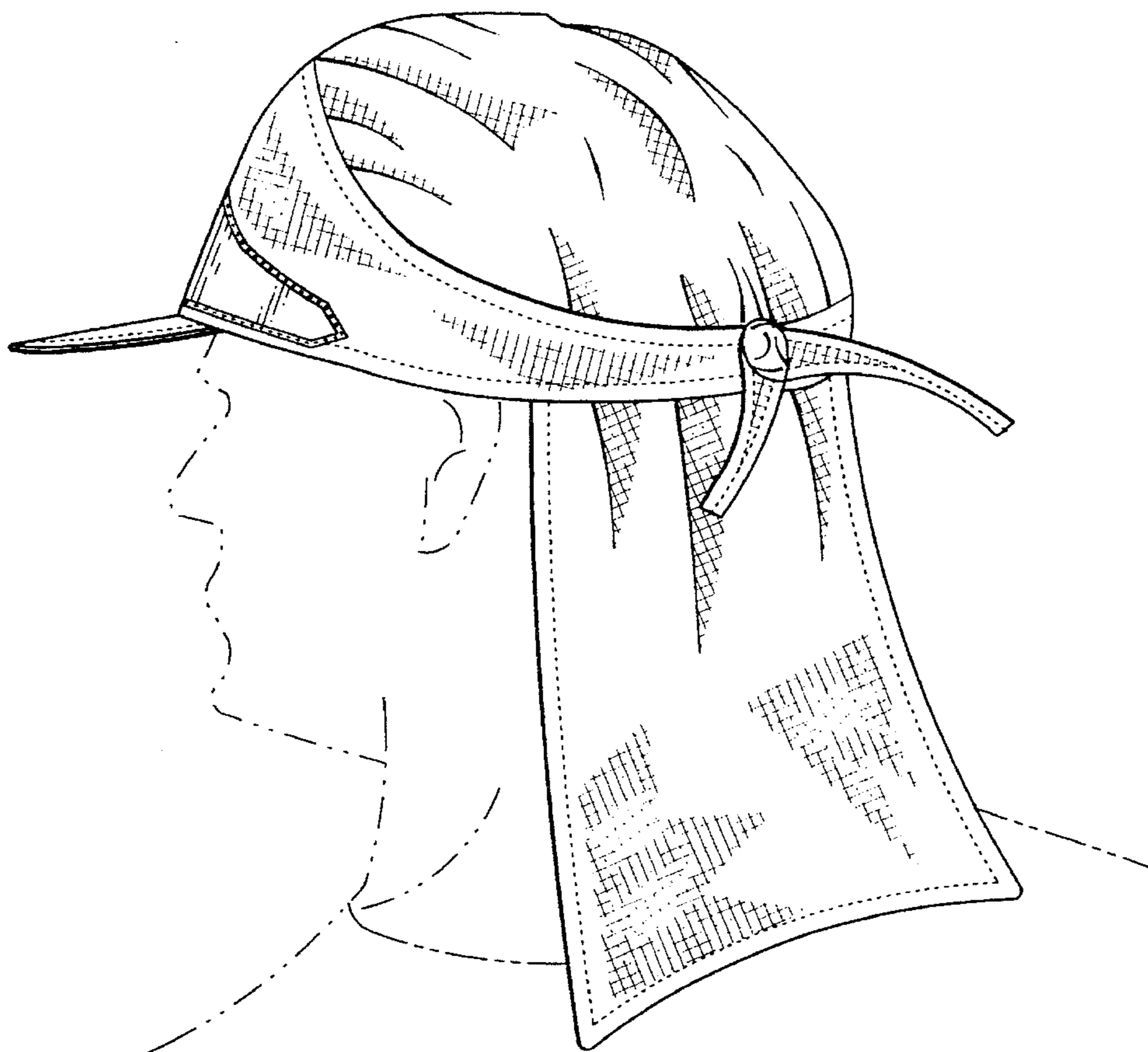
FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the headband portion shown separately for ease of illustration;

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 12 is a top plan view thereof.

The dashed lines around the periphery of the headwrap, visor, and sweatband in all views represent conventional stitching.

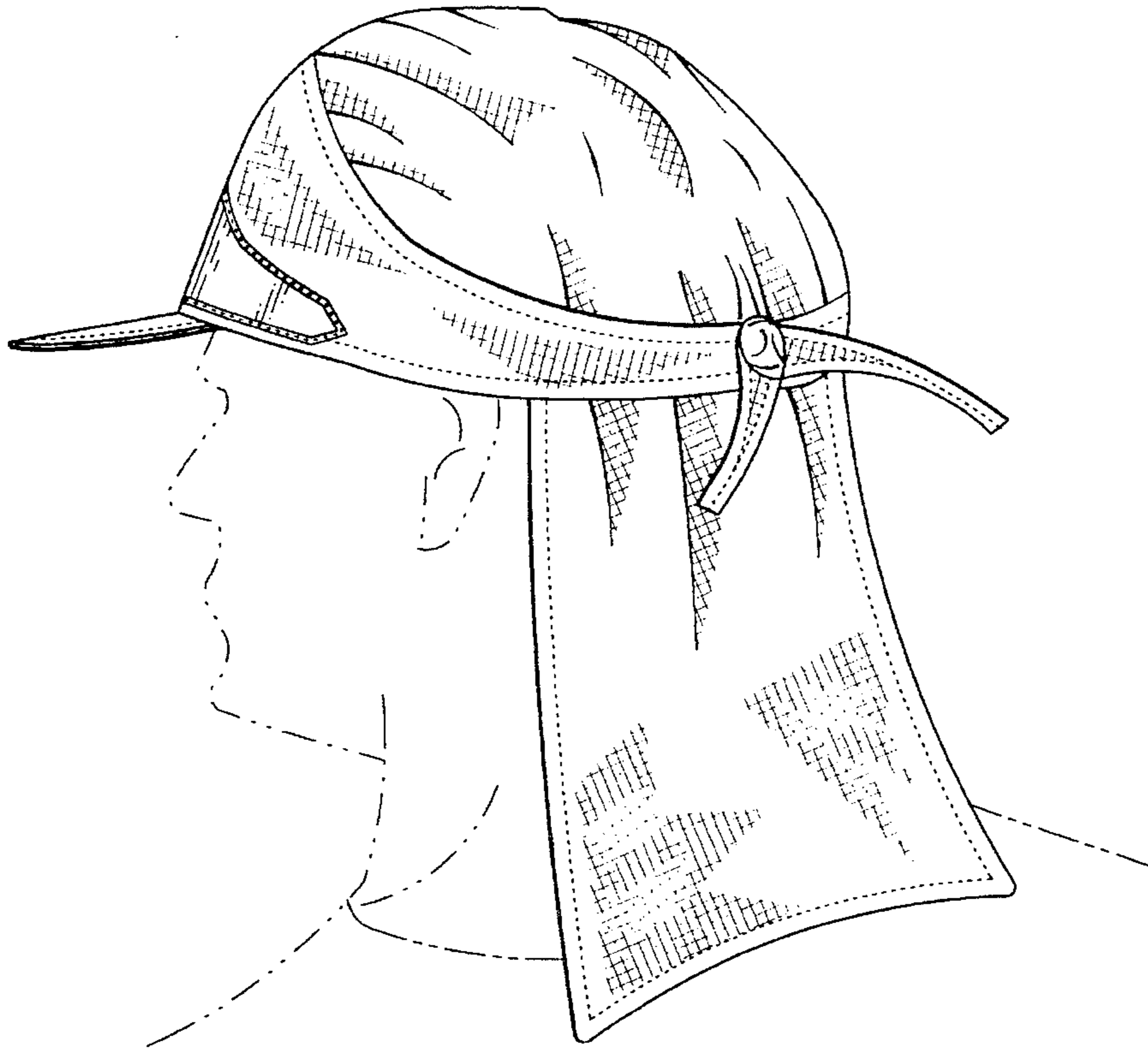

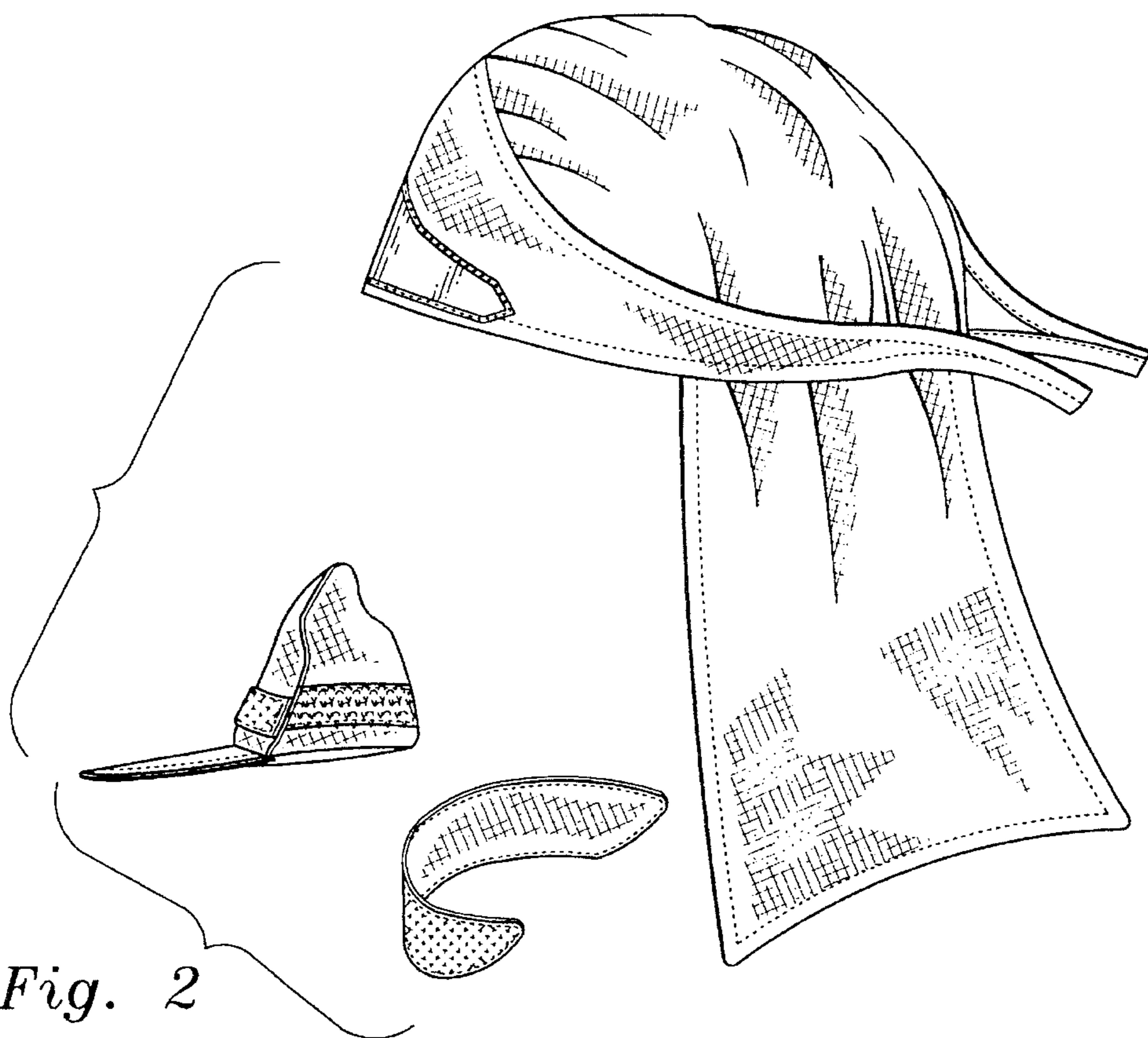

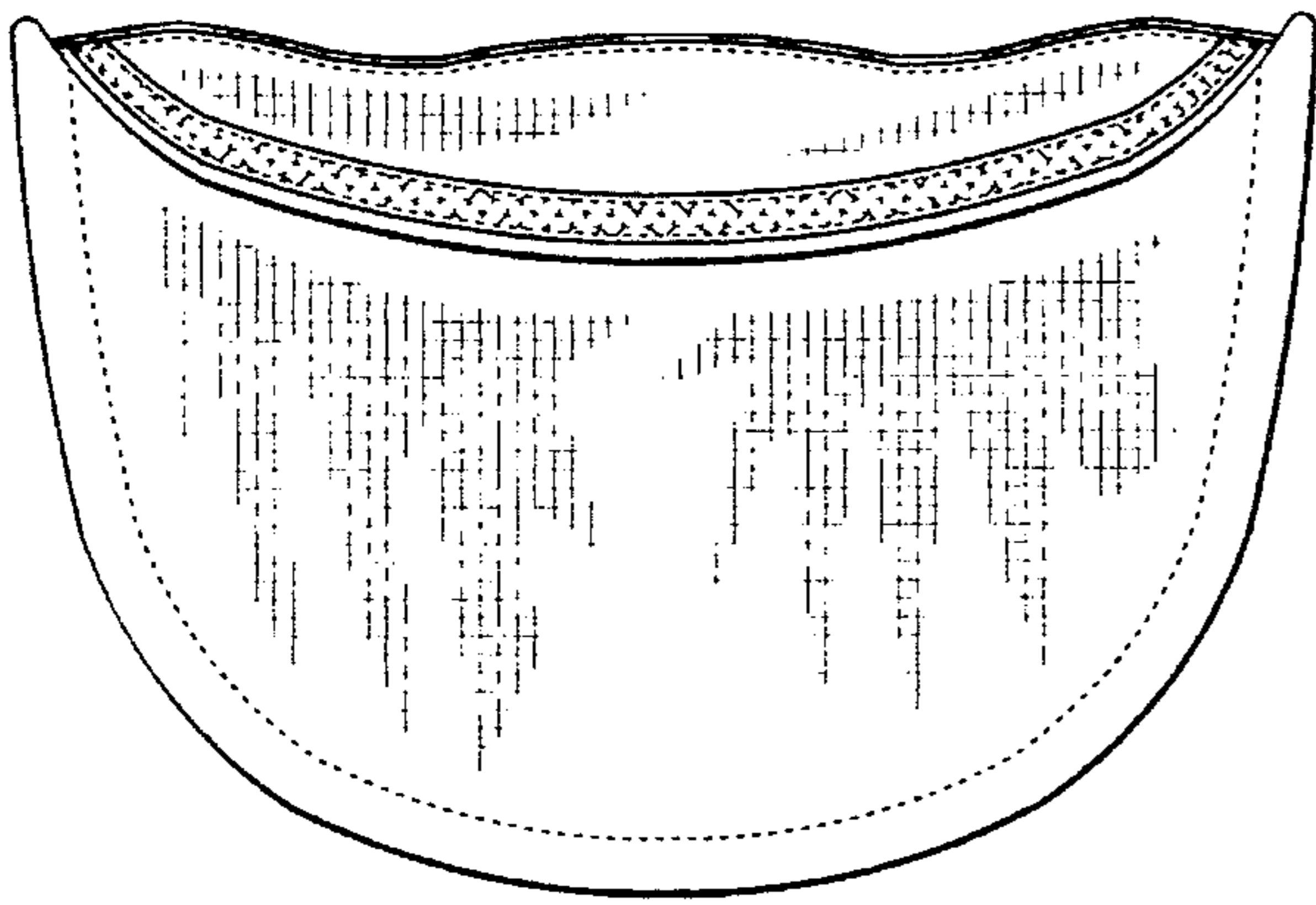

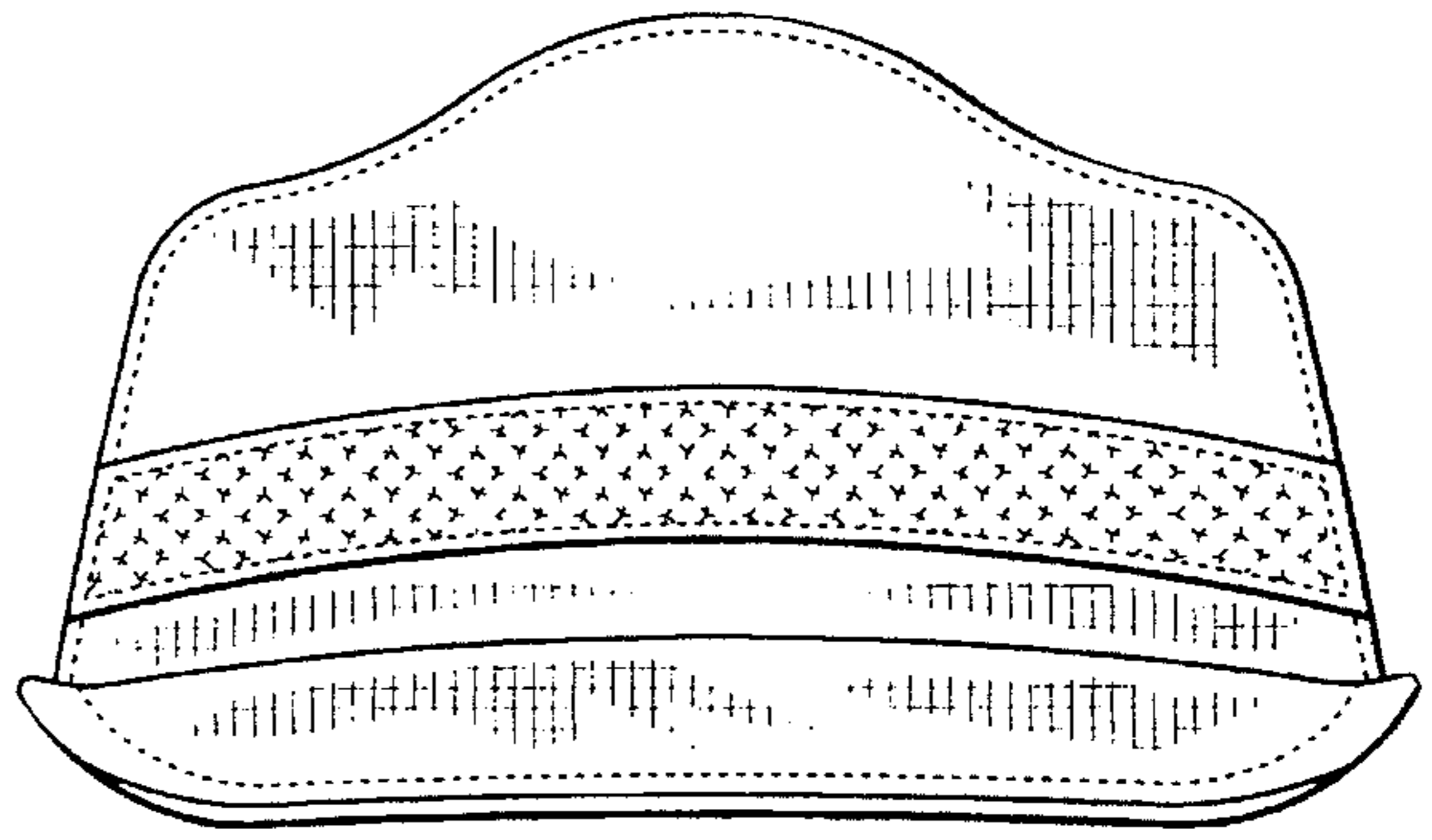

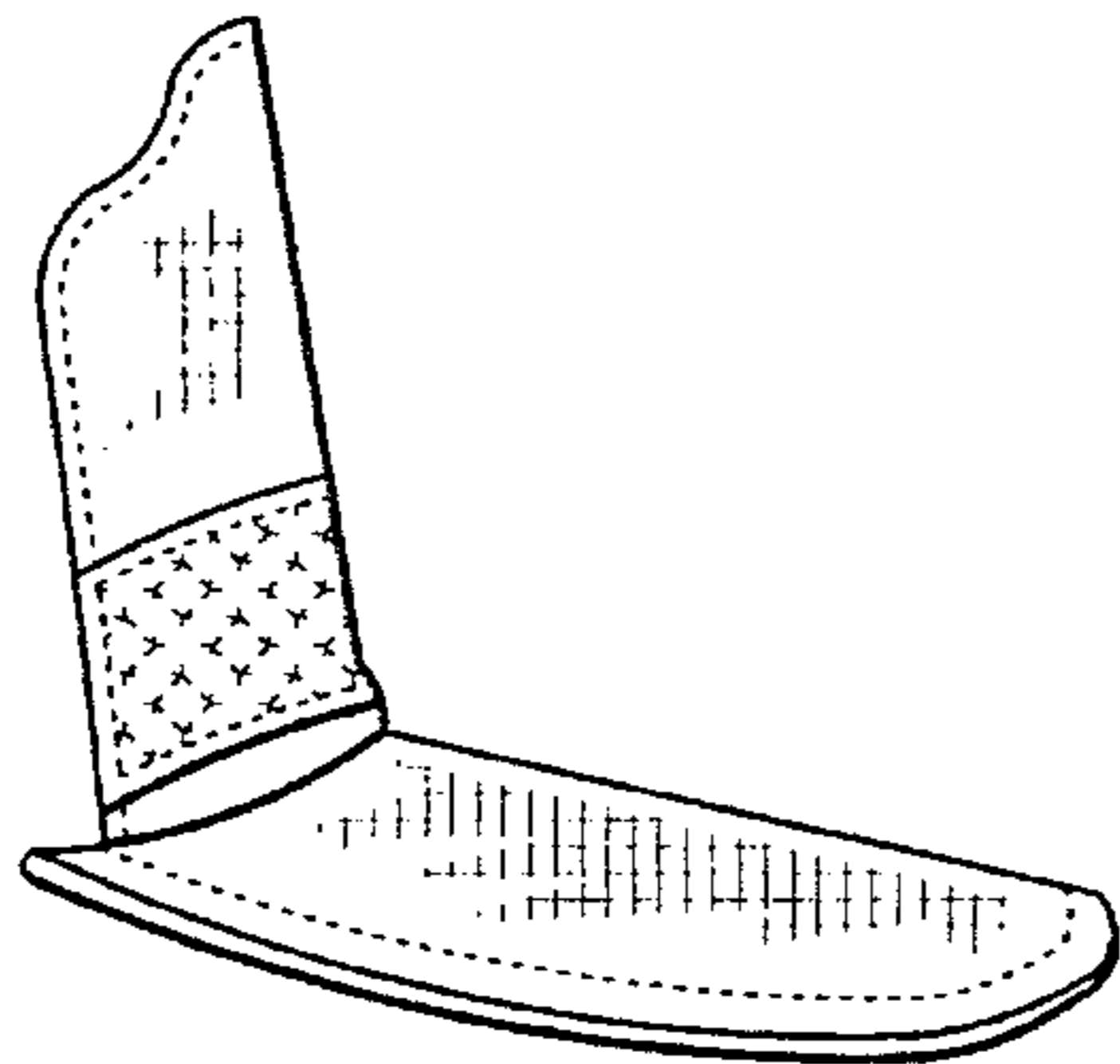

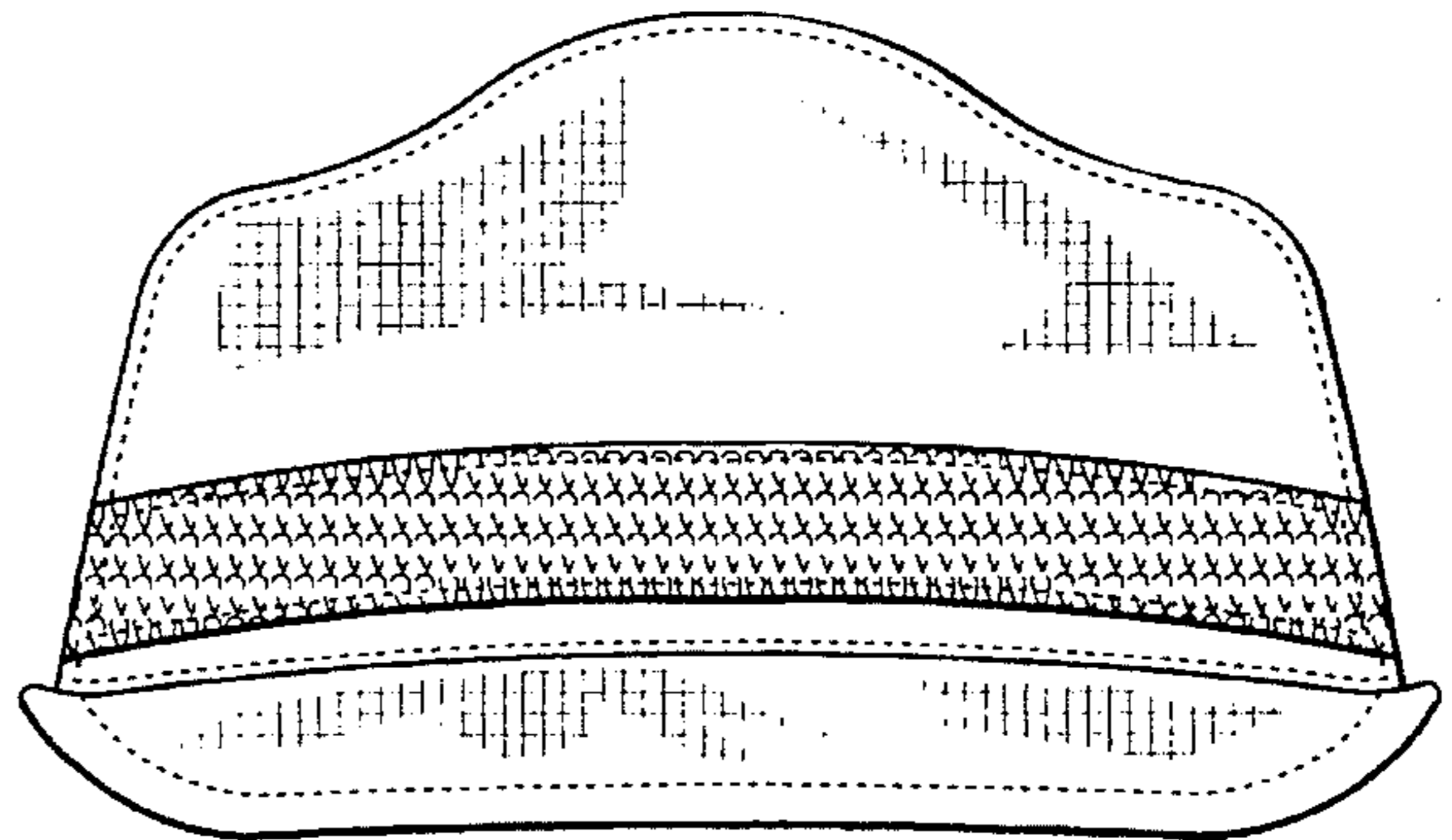

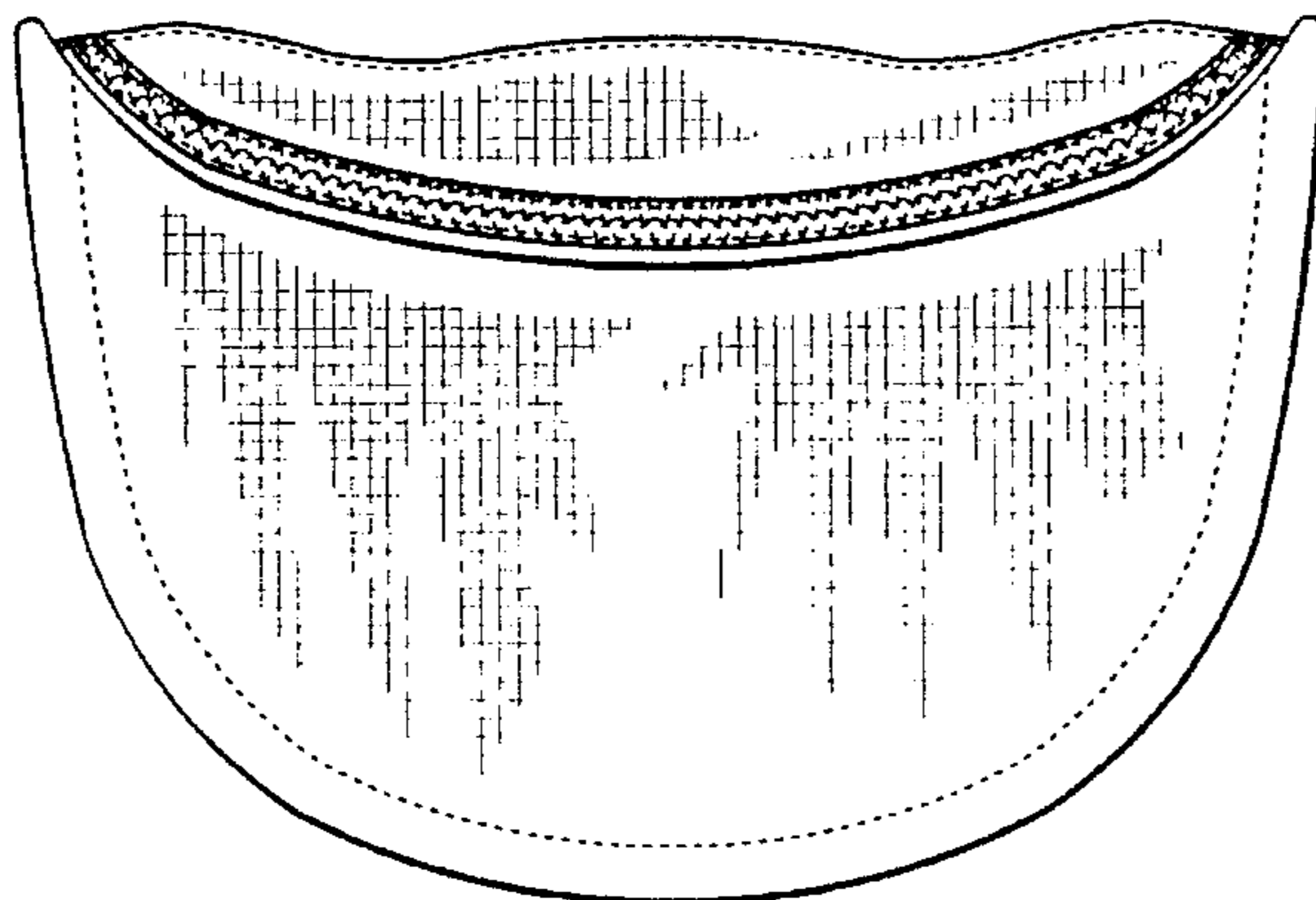

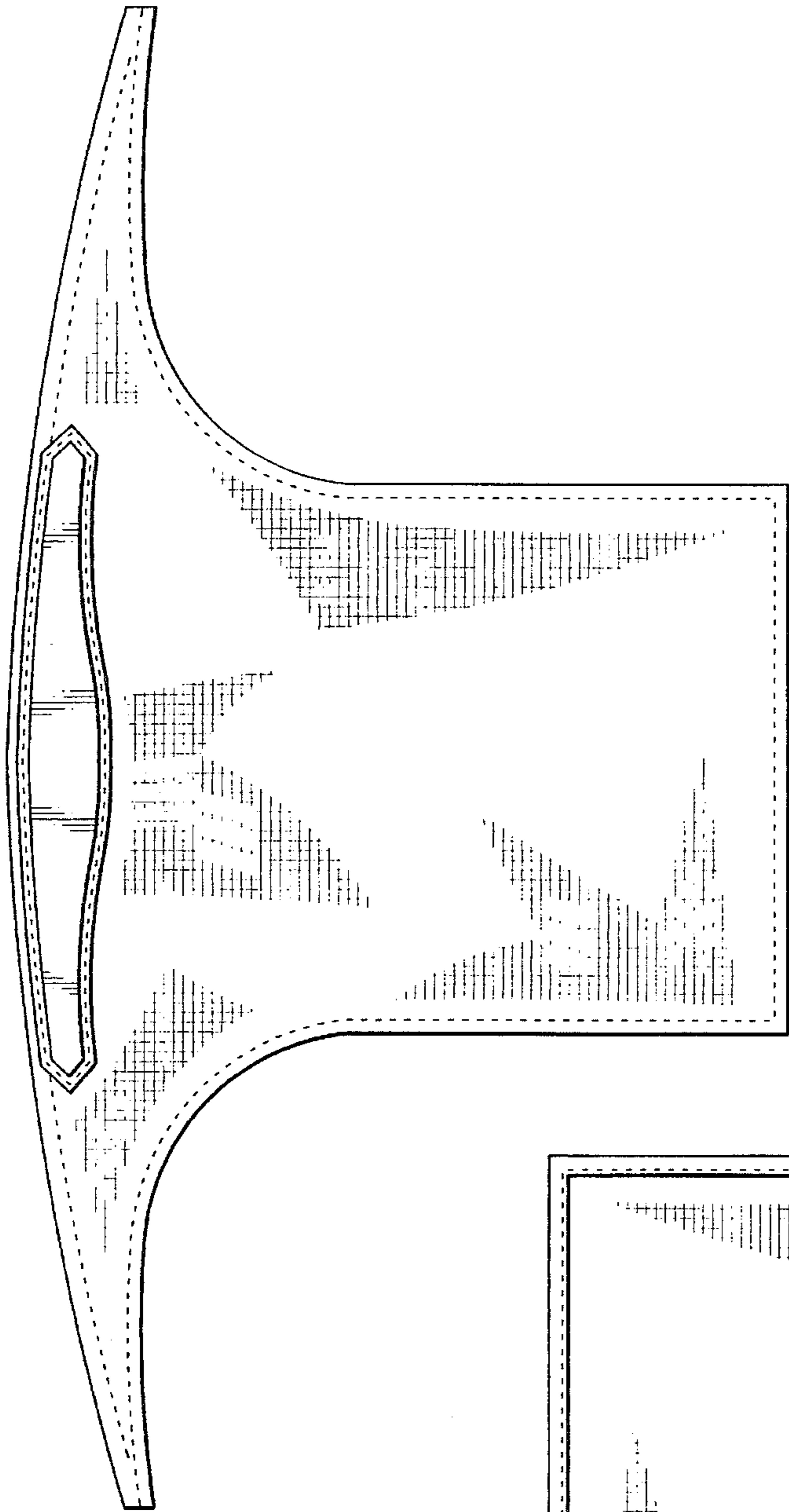

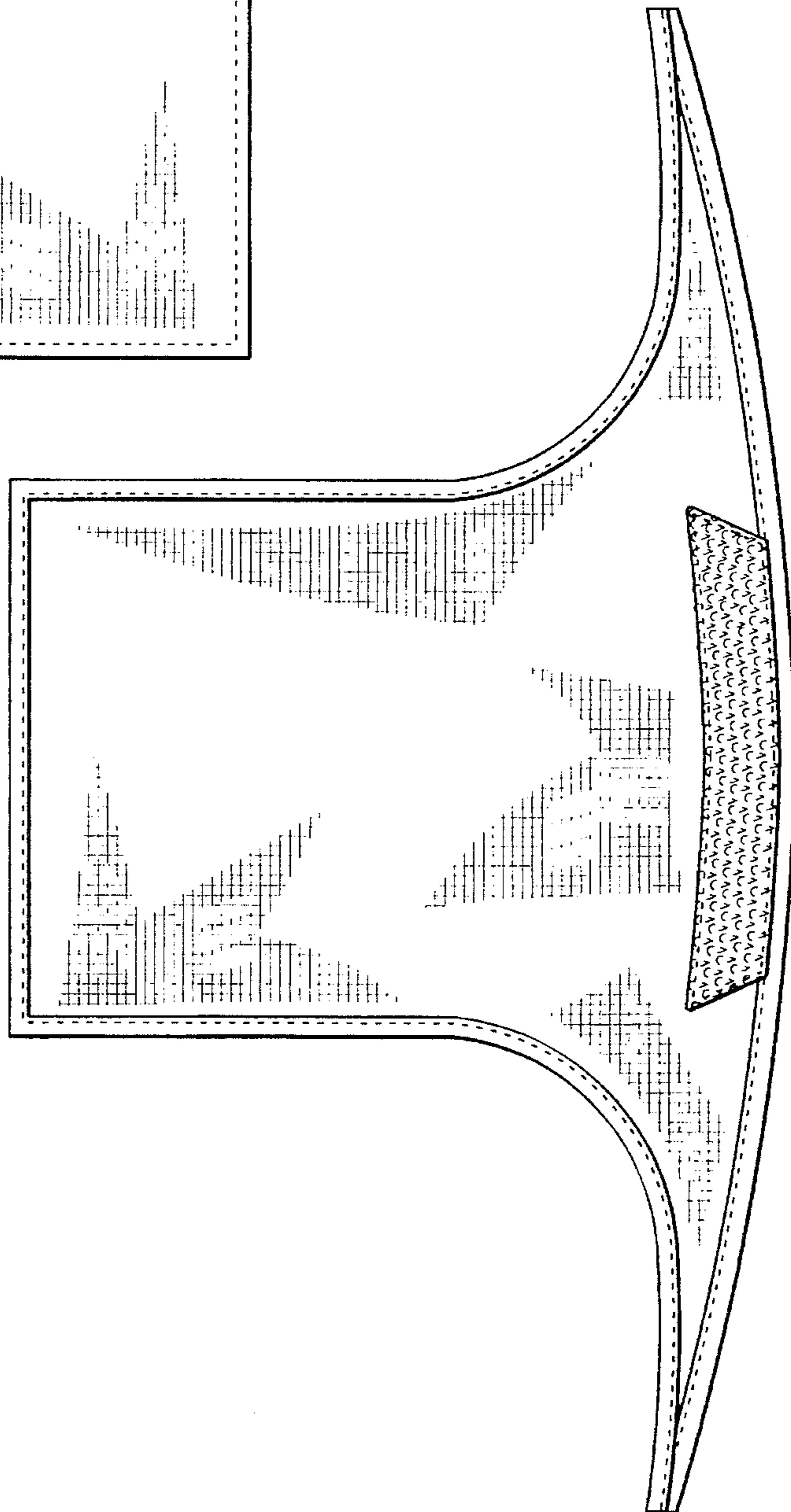

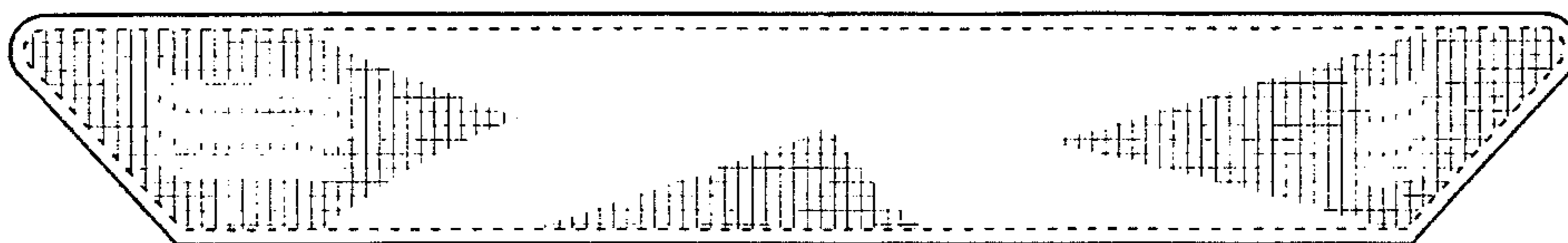

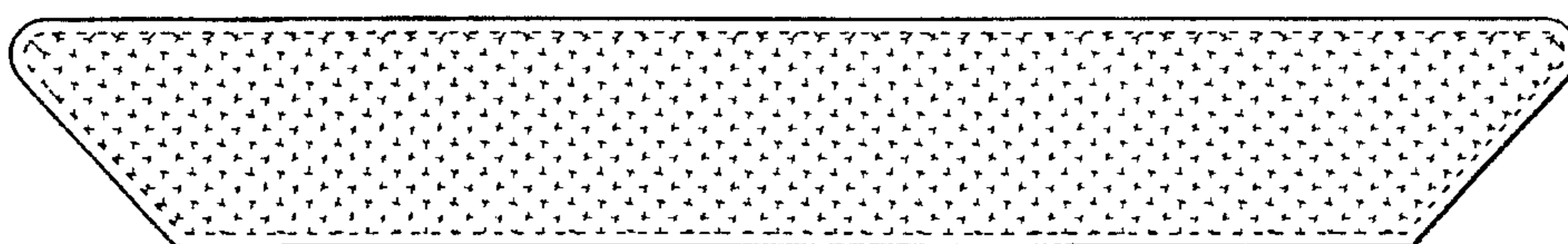

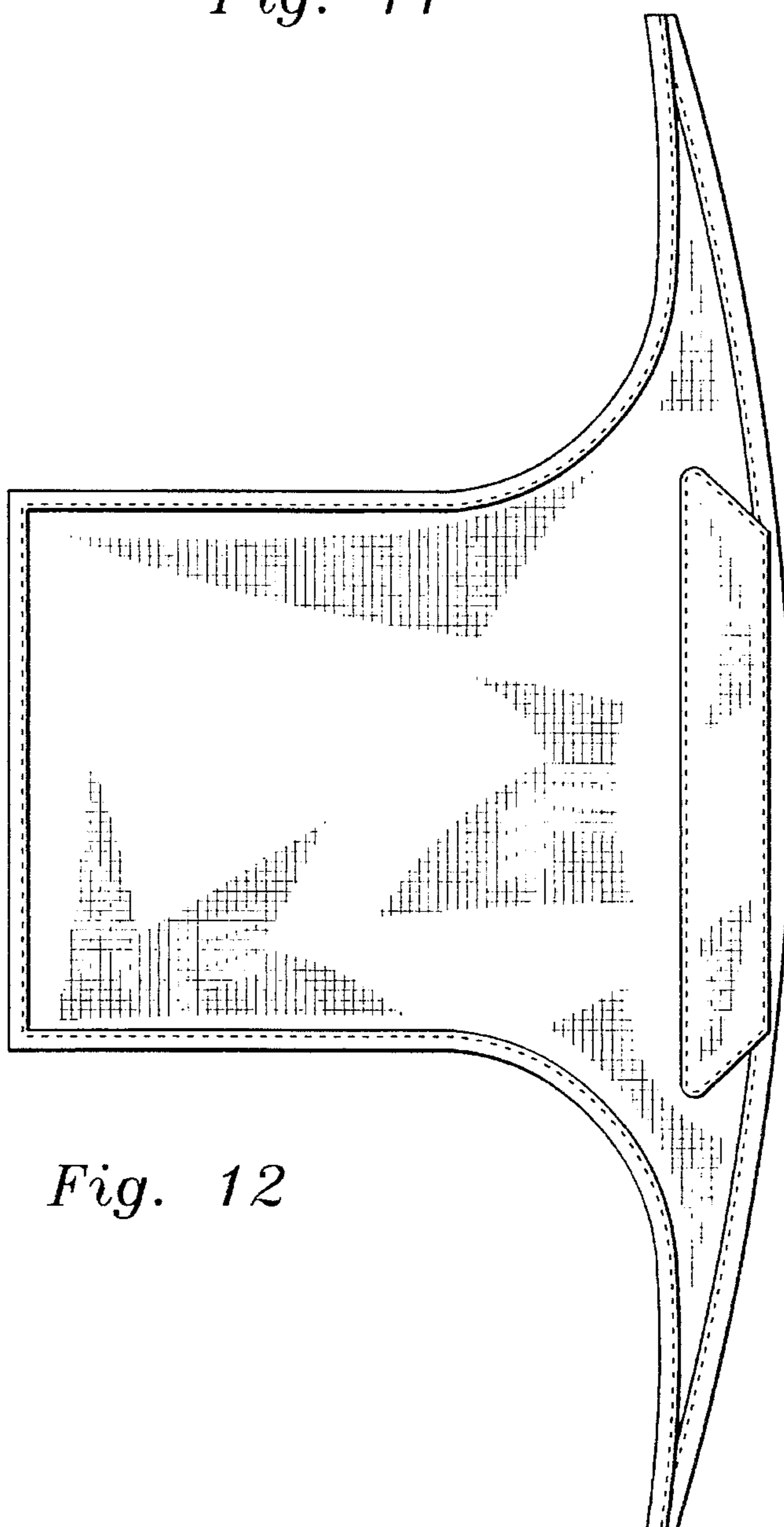
