The ornamental design for a hedge trimmer, as shown and described.

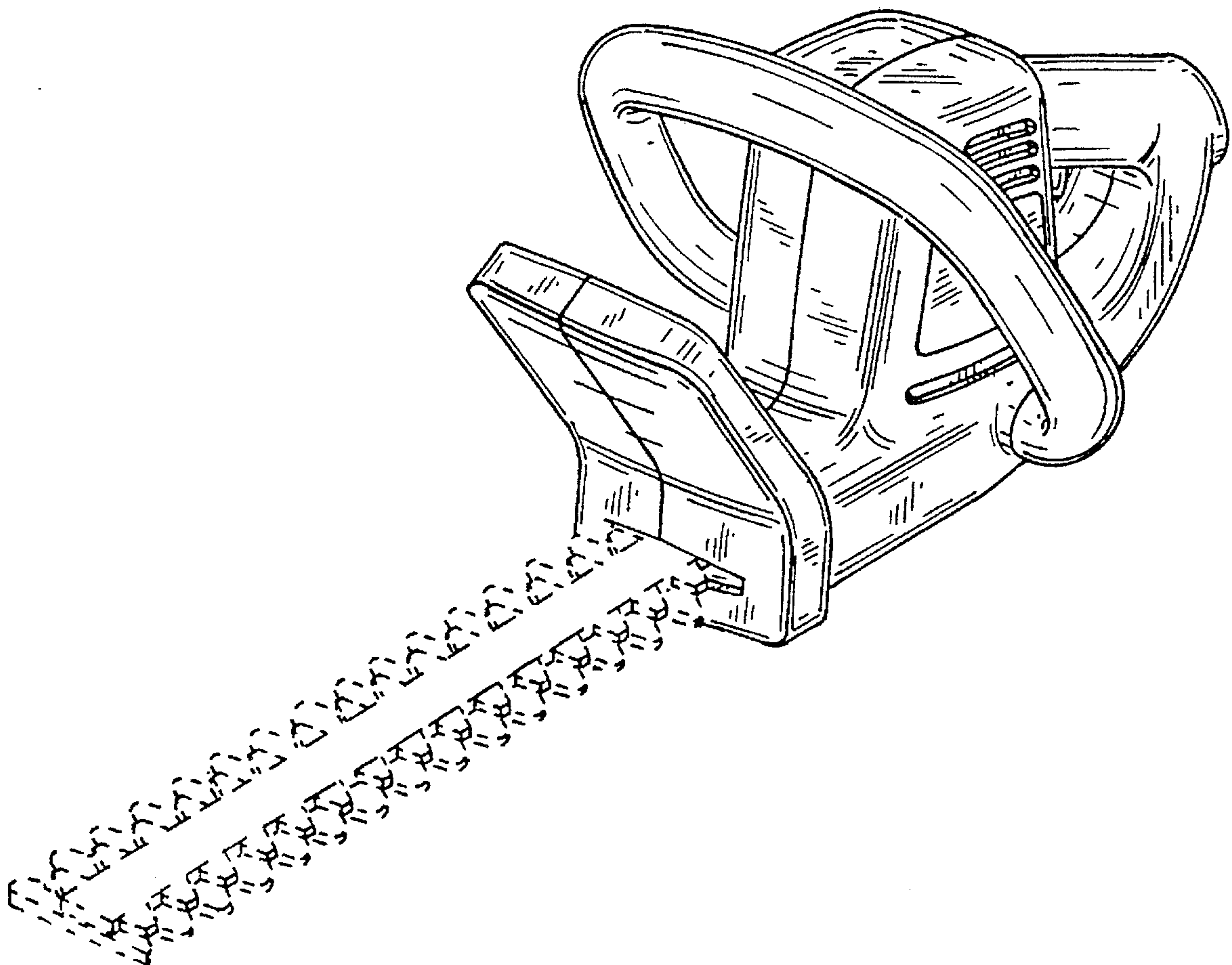
DESCRIPTION

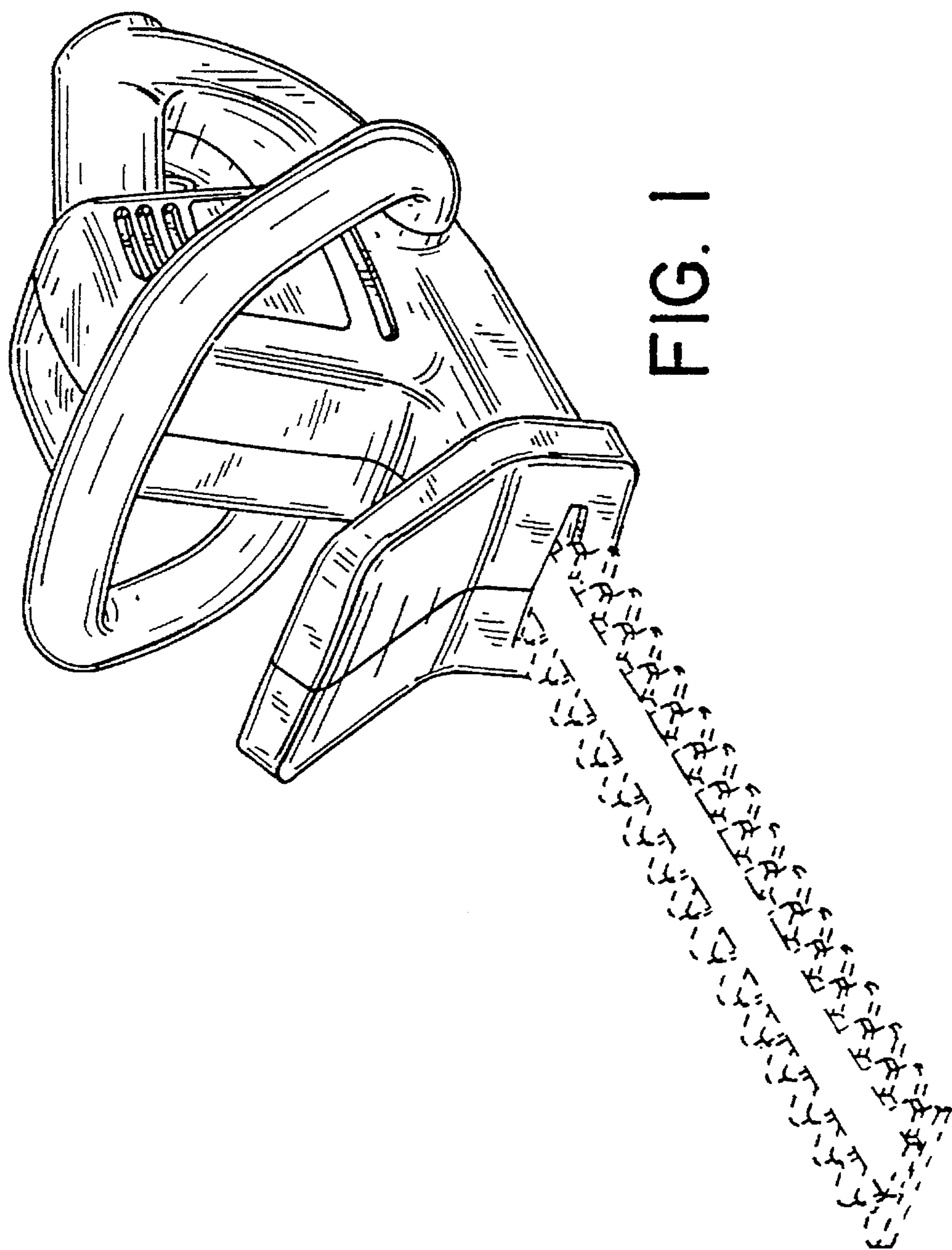

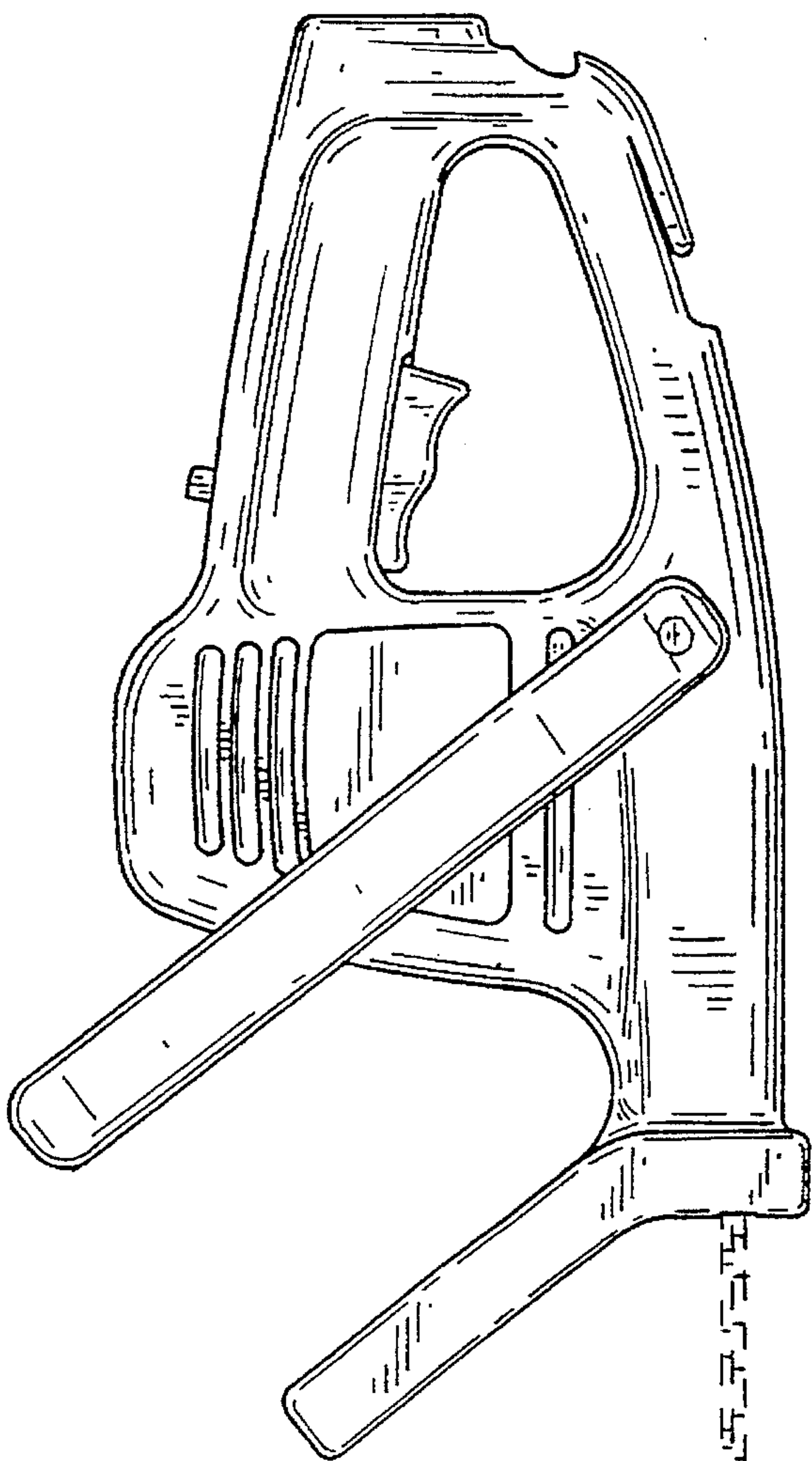

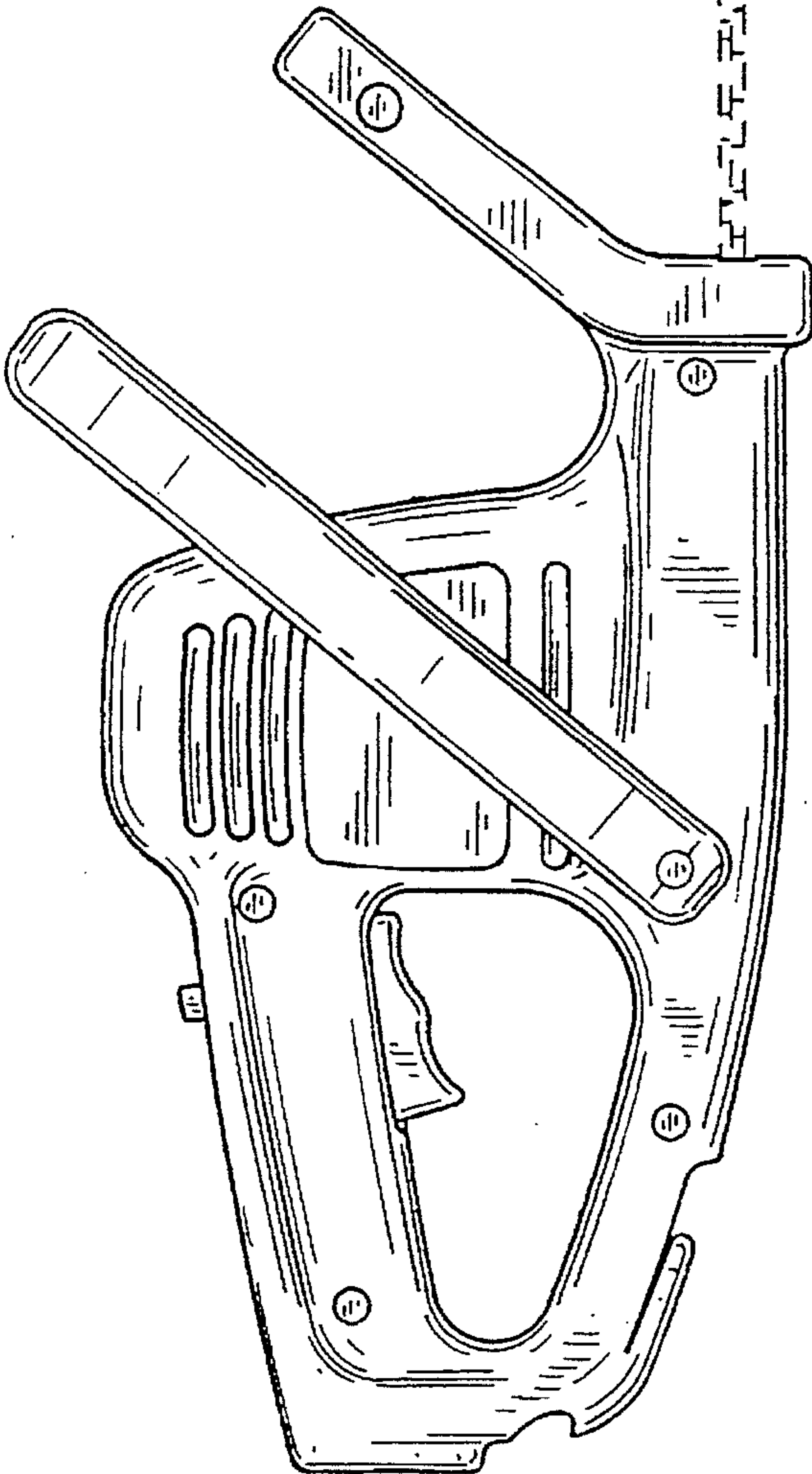

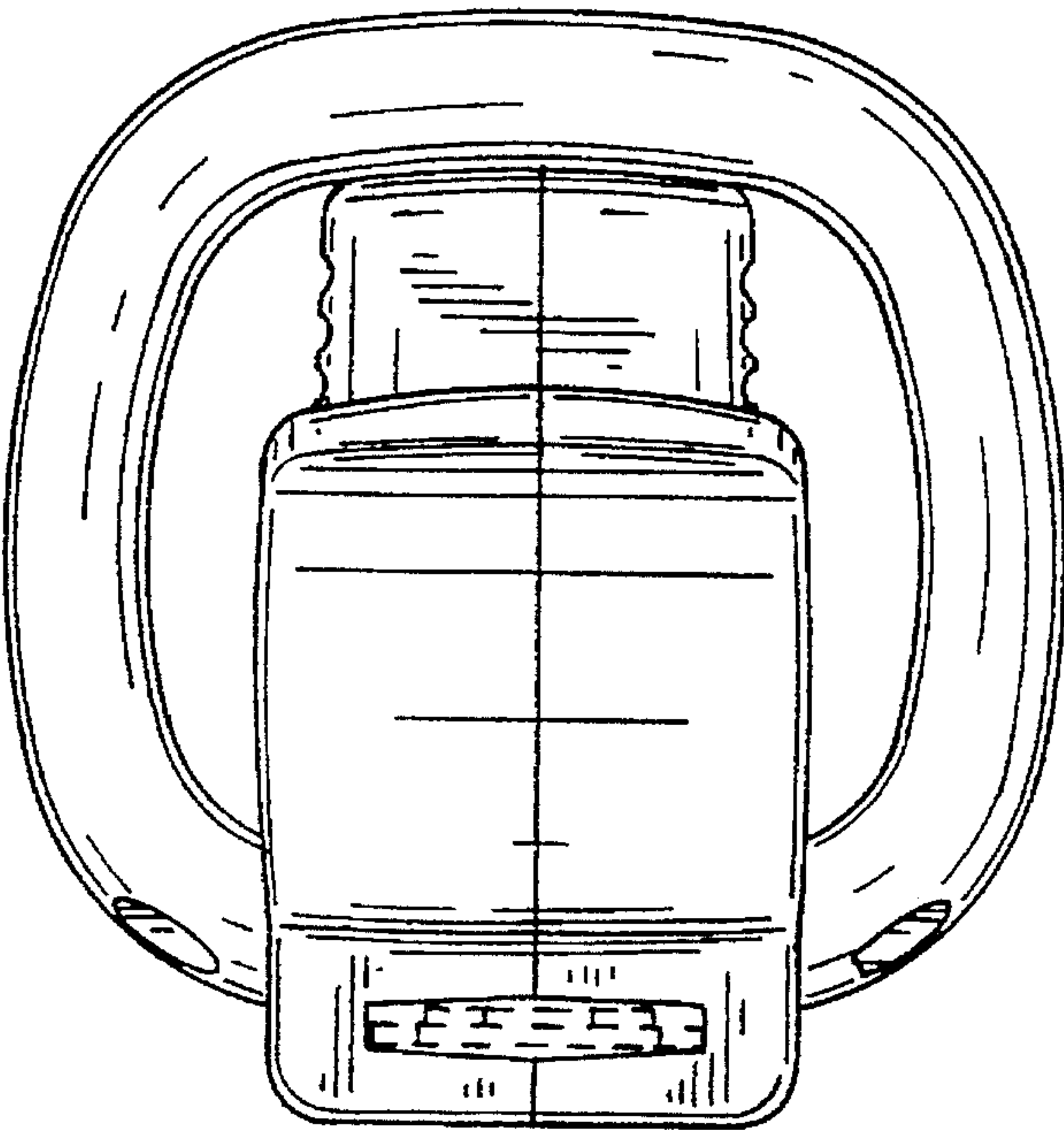

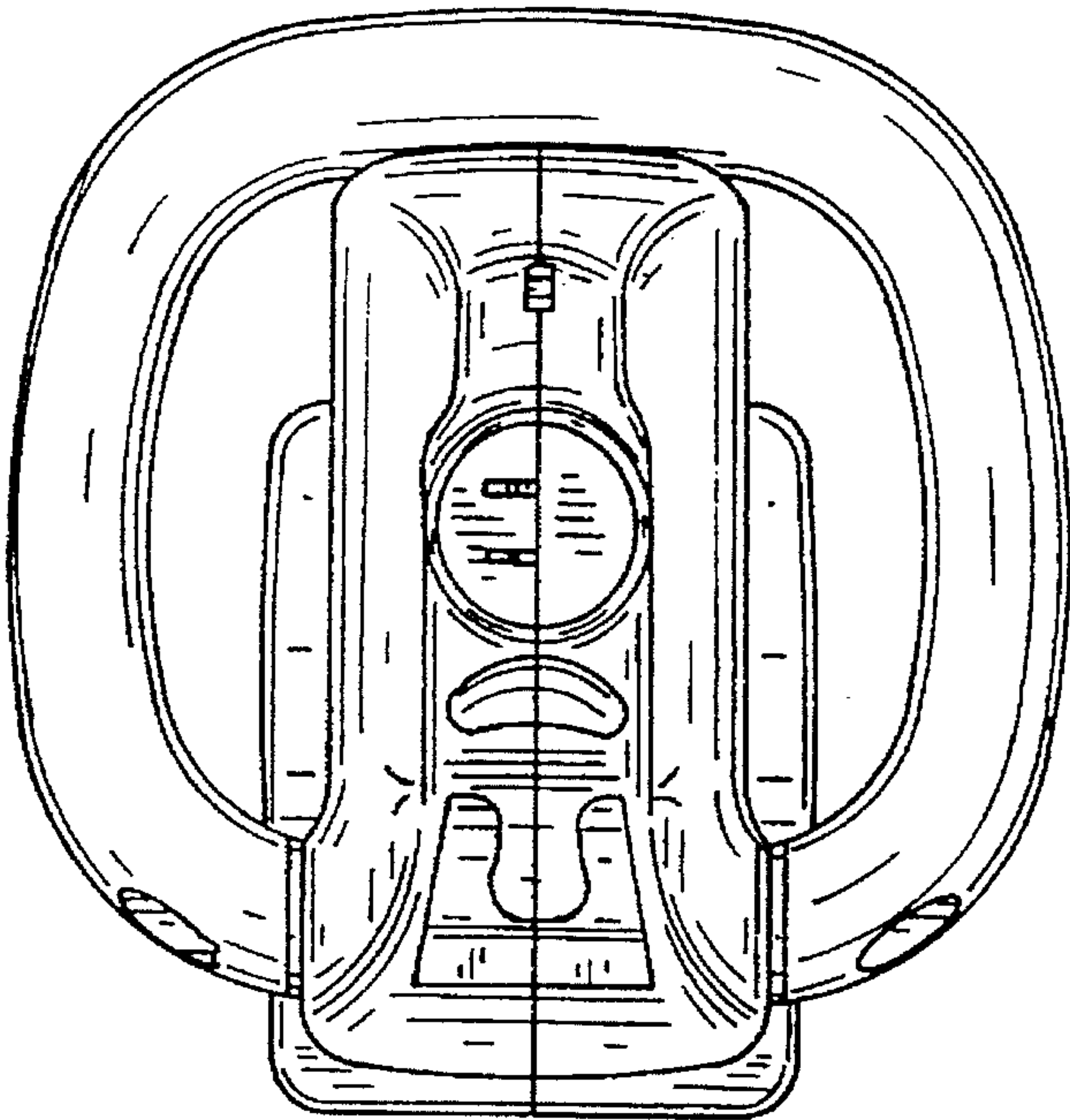

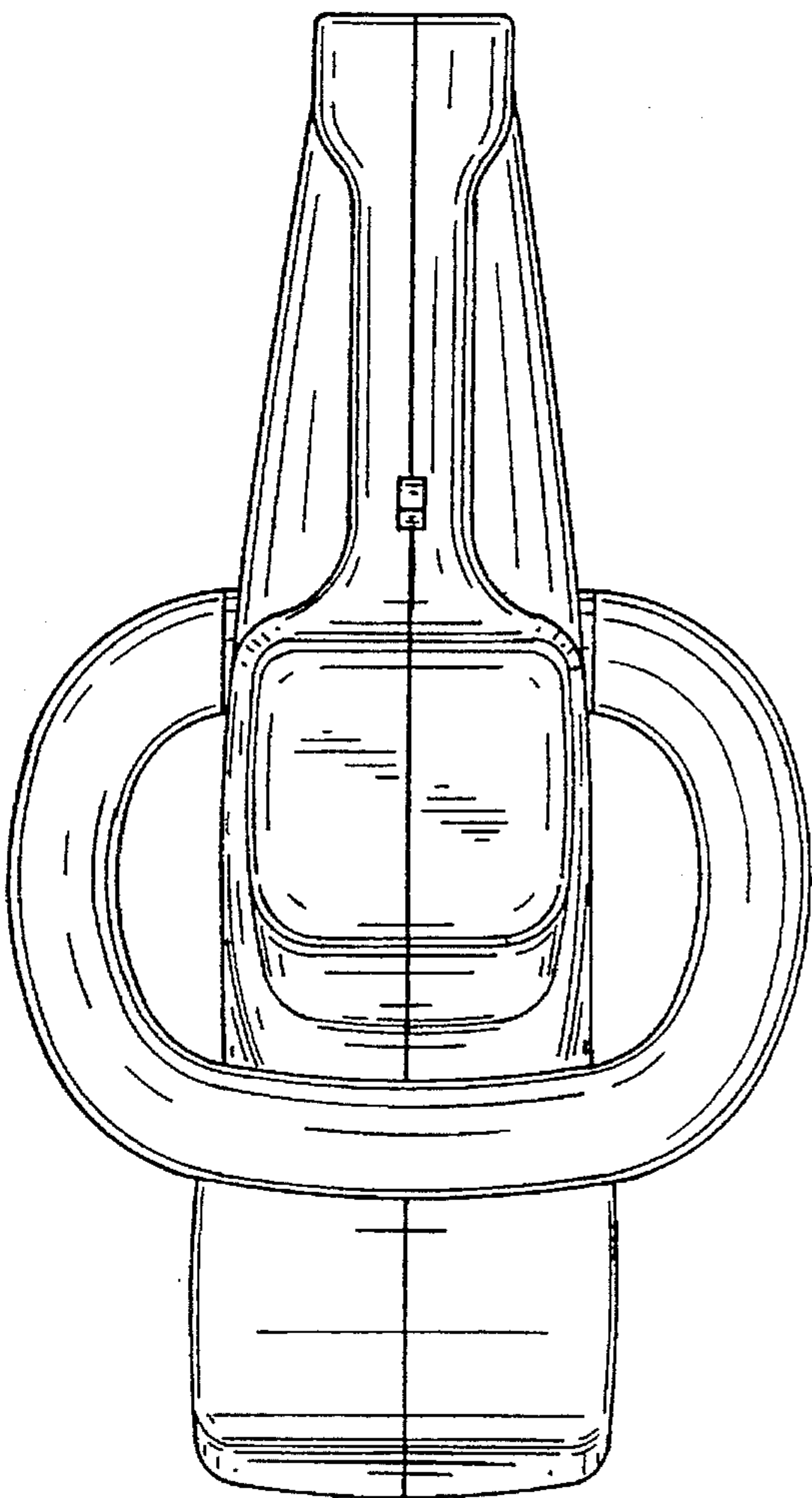

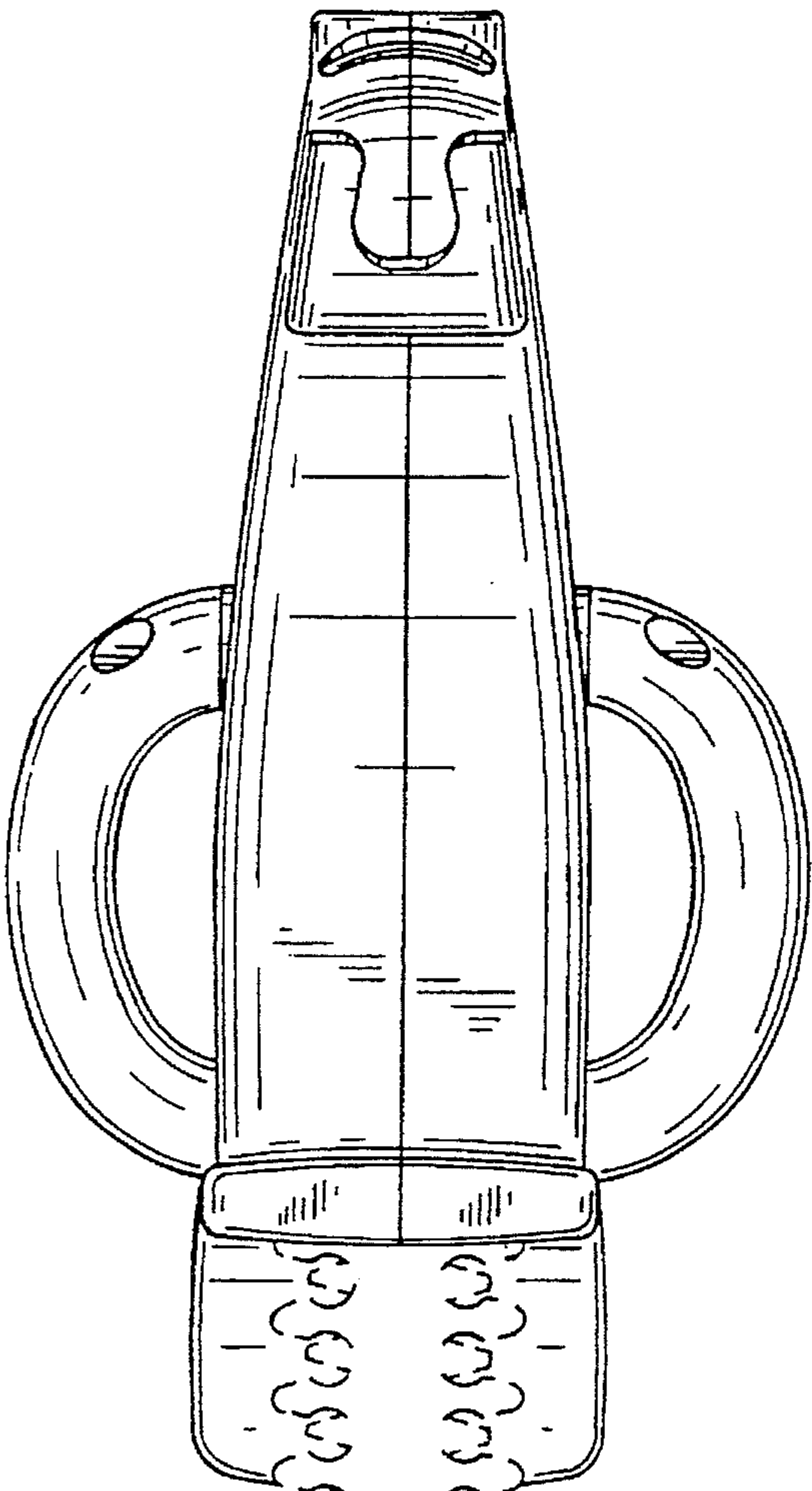
