DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of swimming goggles showing the design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom view thereof being a mirror image of FIG. 3;
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image of FIG. 4;
FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof showing a state where the belt portion is vertically split; and,
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof showing a state where the belt portion is detached from the body.

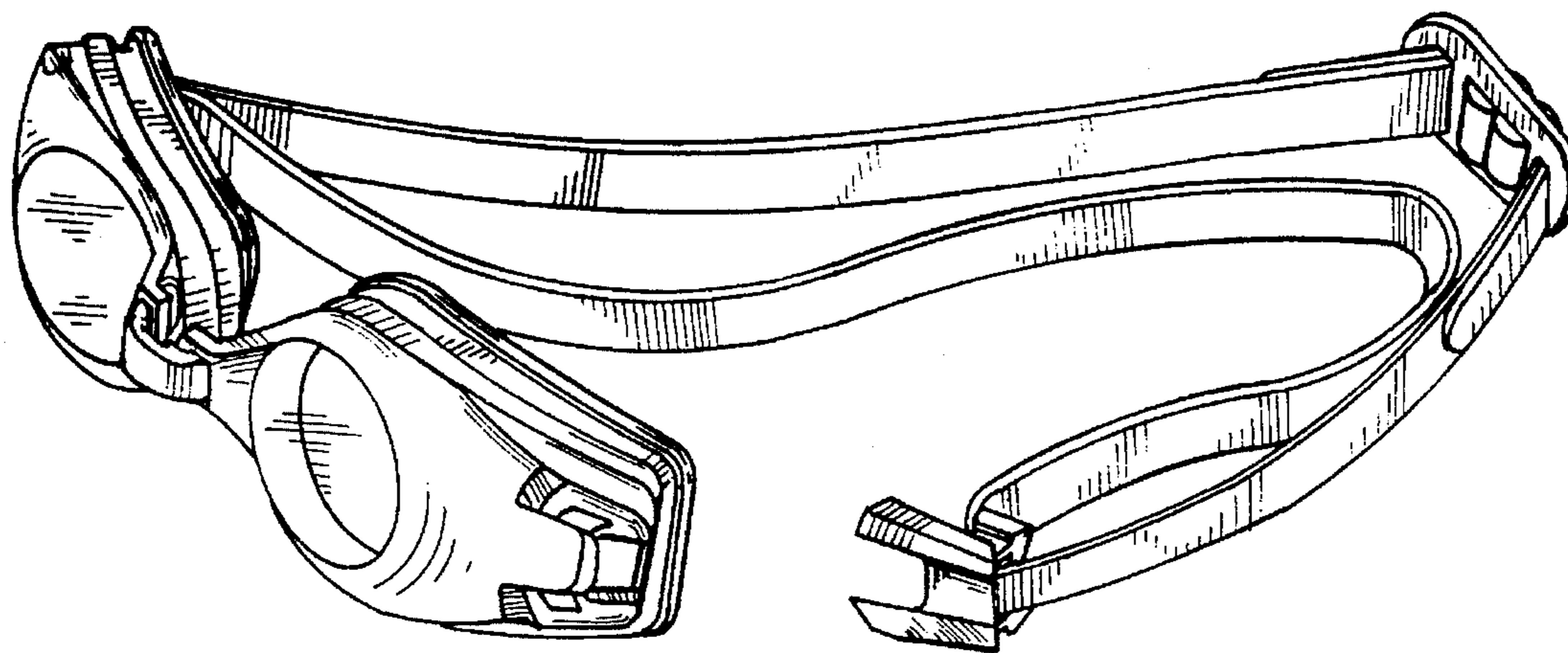

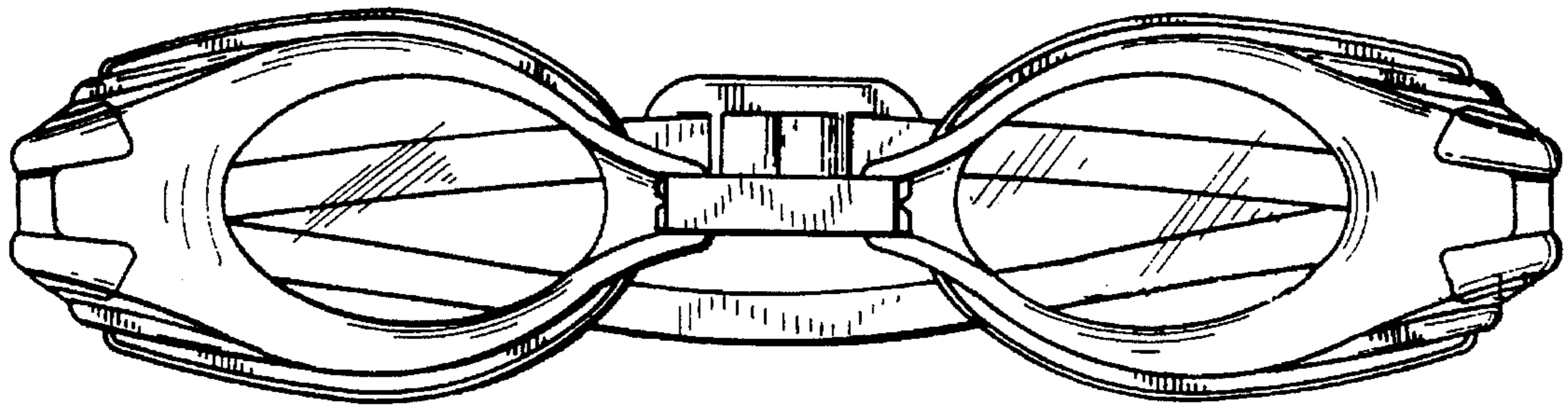

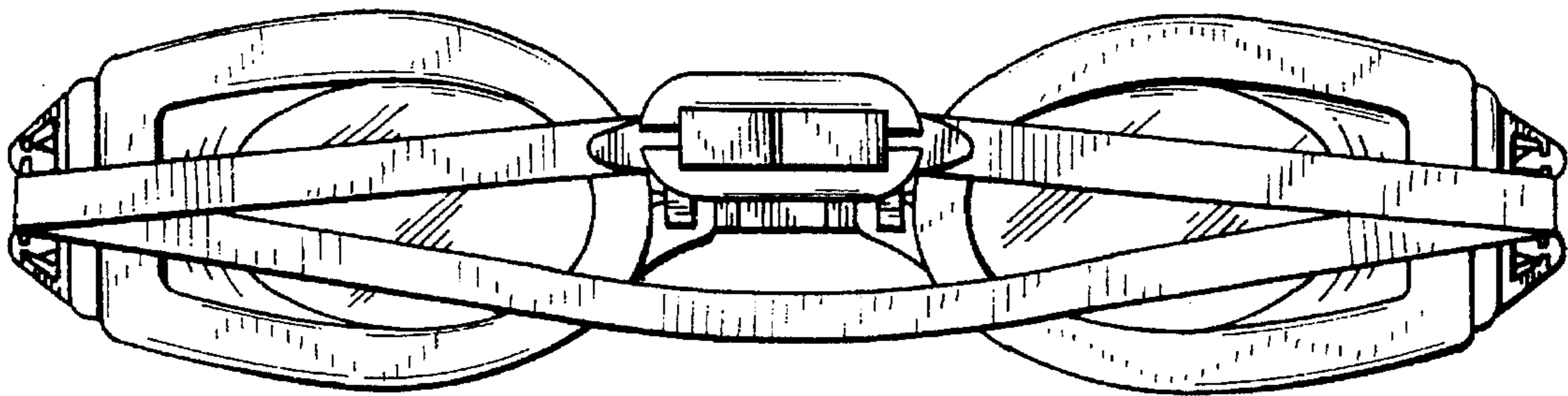

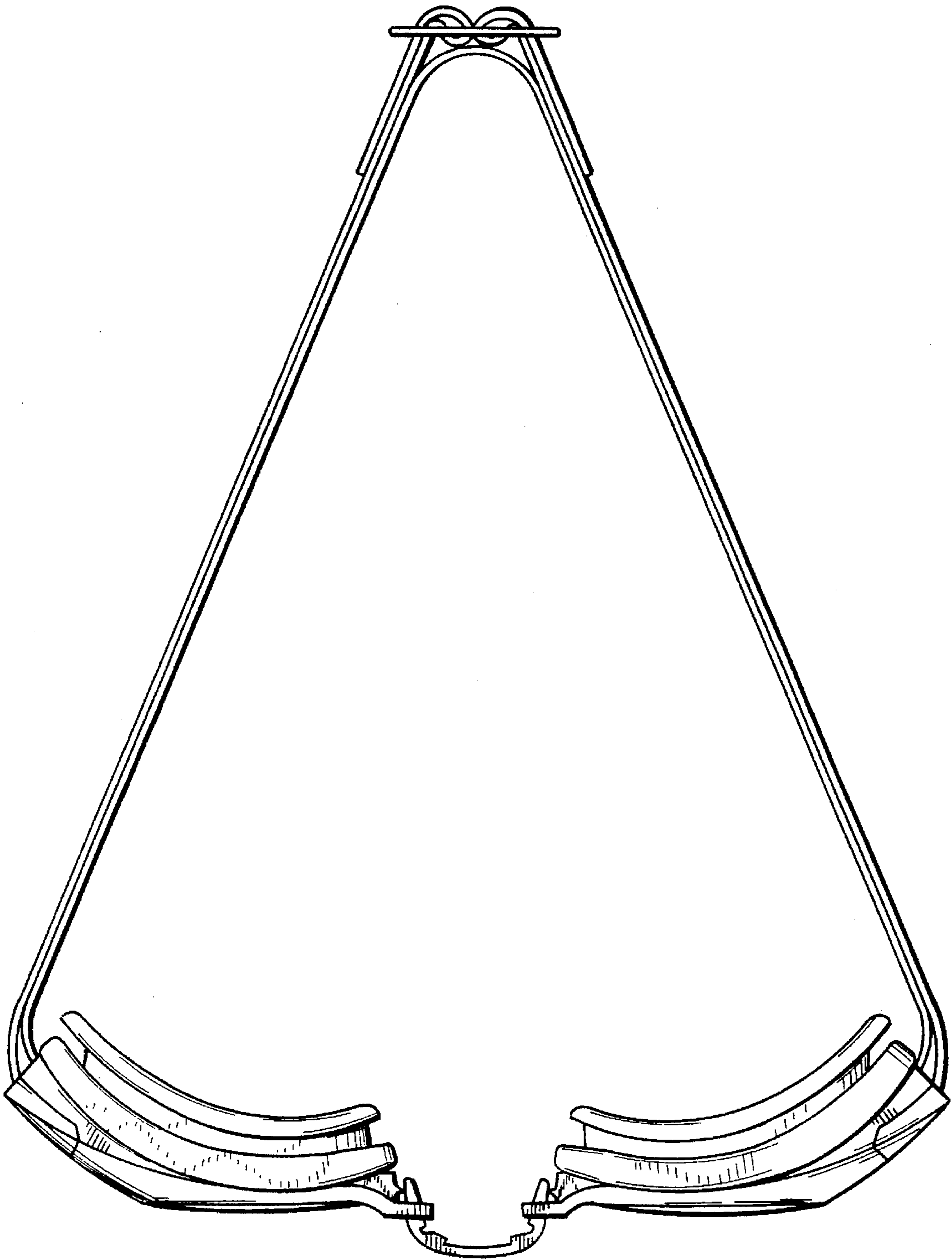

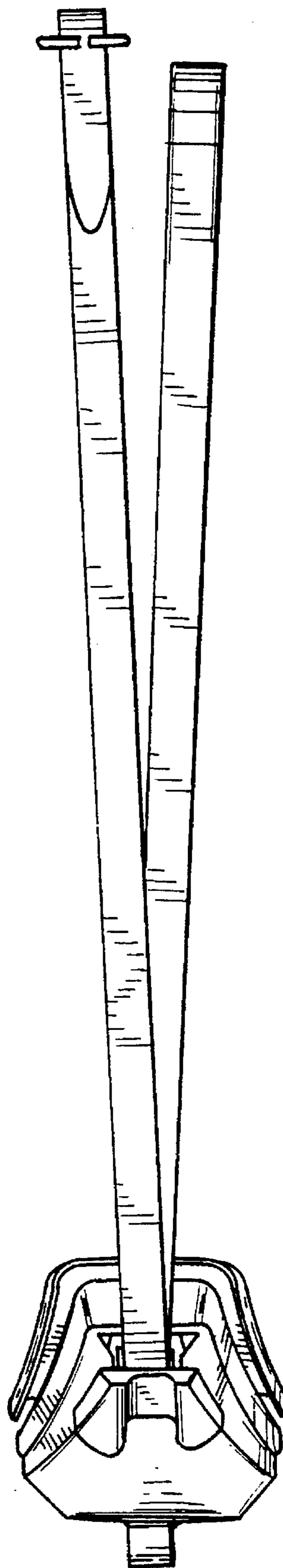

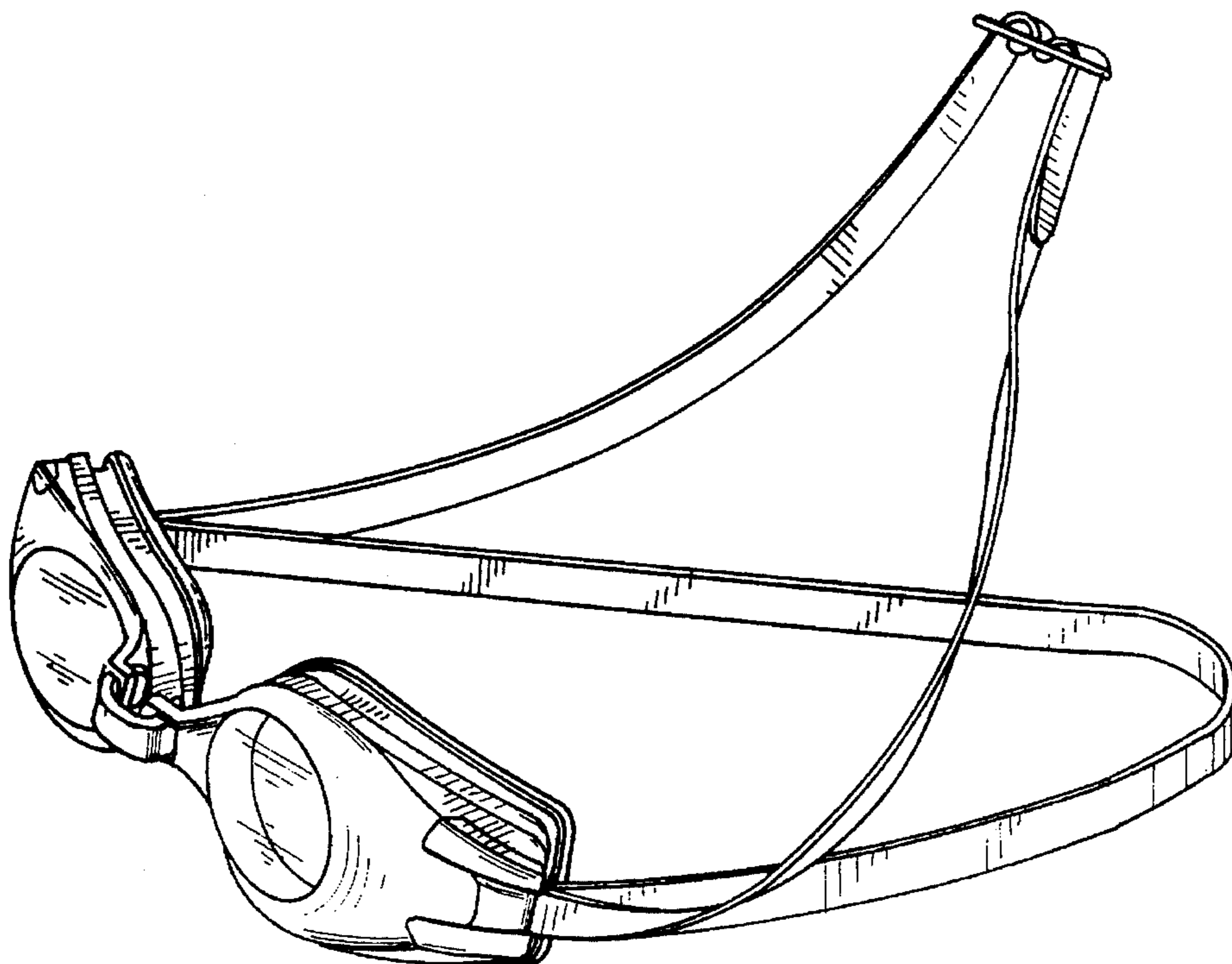
