[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pen, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of the penbody in an exploded condition, with the cap member removed for convenience of illustration, all side being identical thereof;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, left side being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of a writing instrument showing my new design thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 3 thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 3 thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 7, the left side being a mirror image thereof; and,
 FIG. 7 is a front elevational view the pen cap thereof.

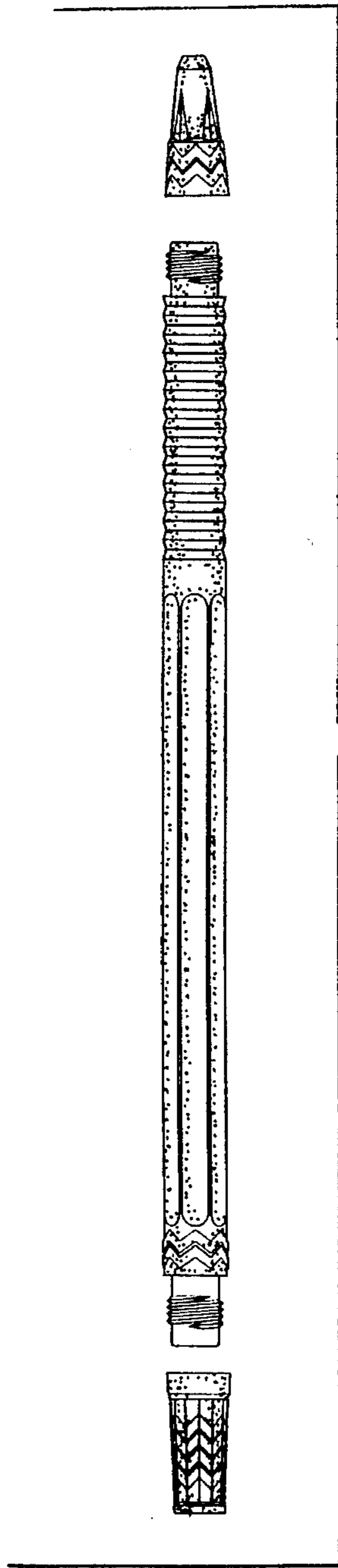

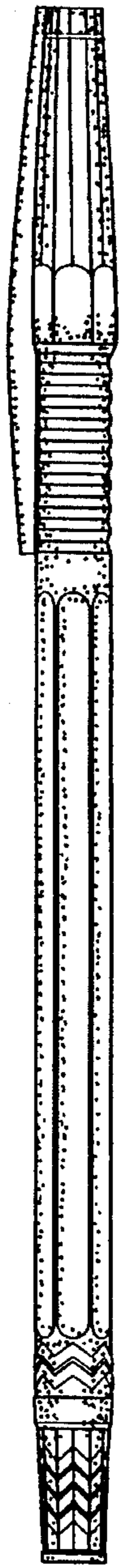

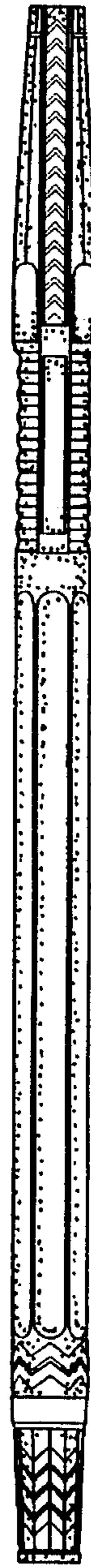
