FIG. 2 is a left side view of FIG. 1, the right side being a mirror image of FIG. 2;

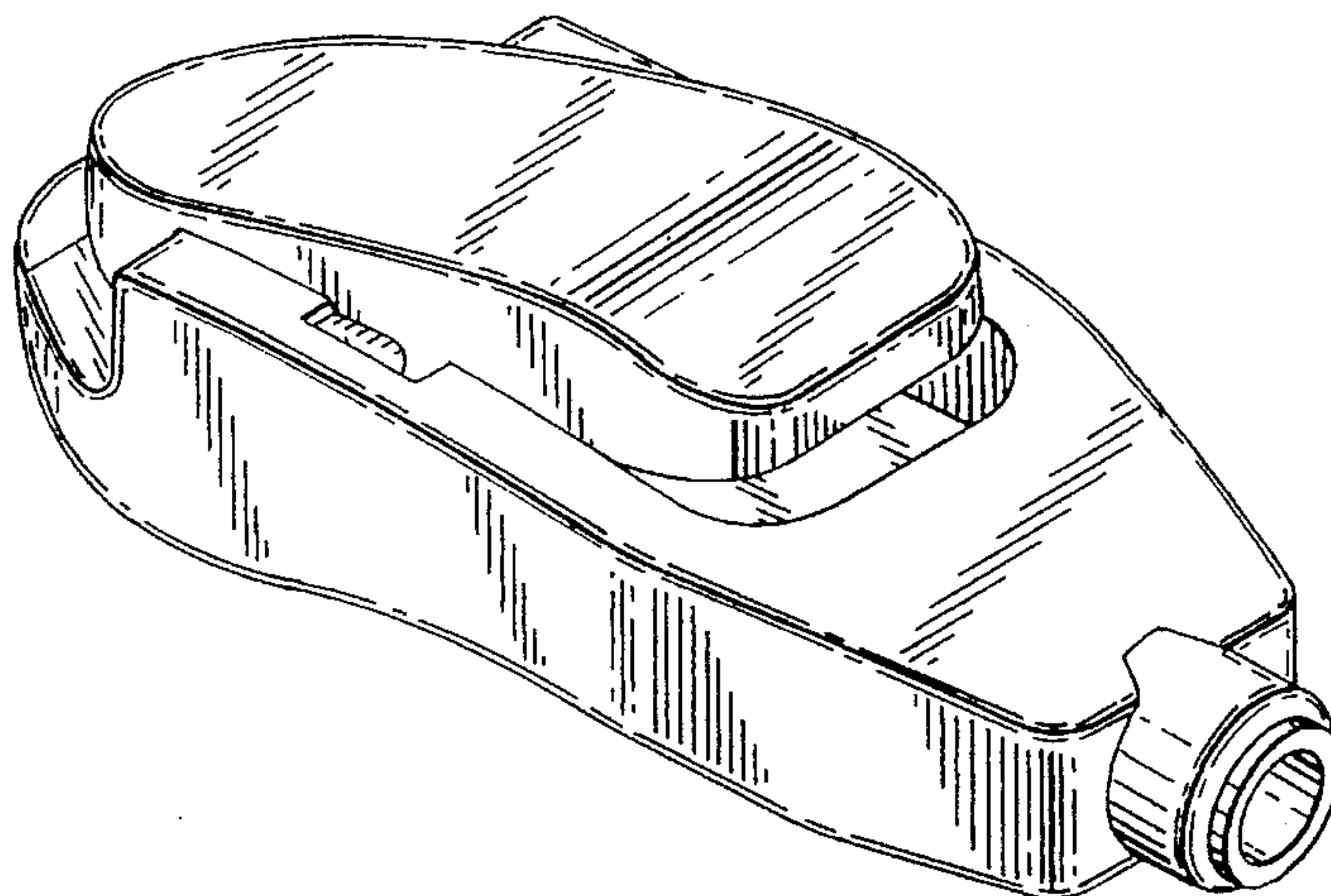
FIG. 3 is a top view of FIG. 1;

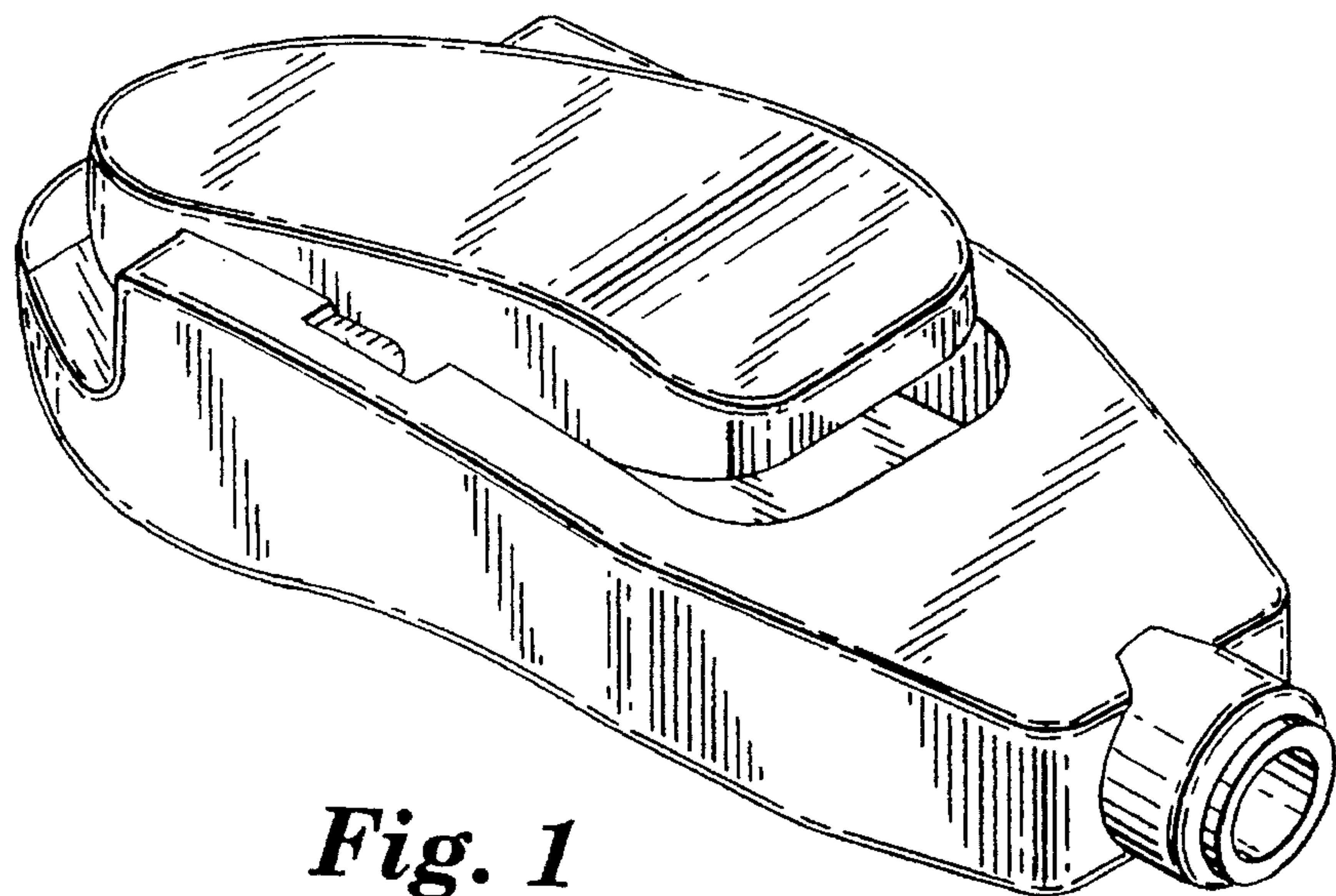

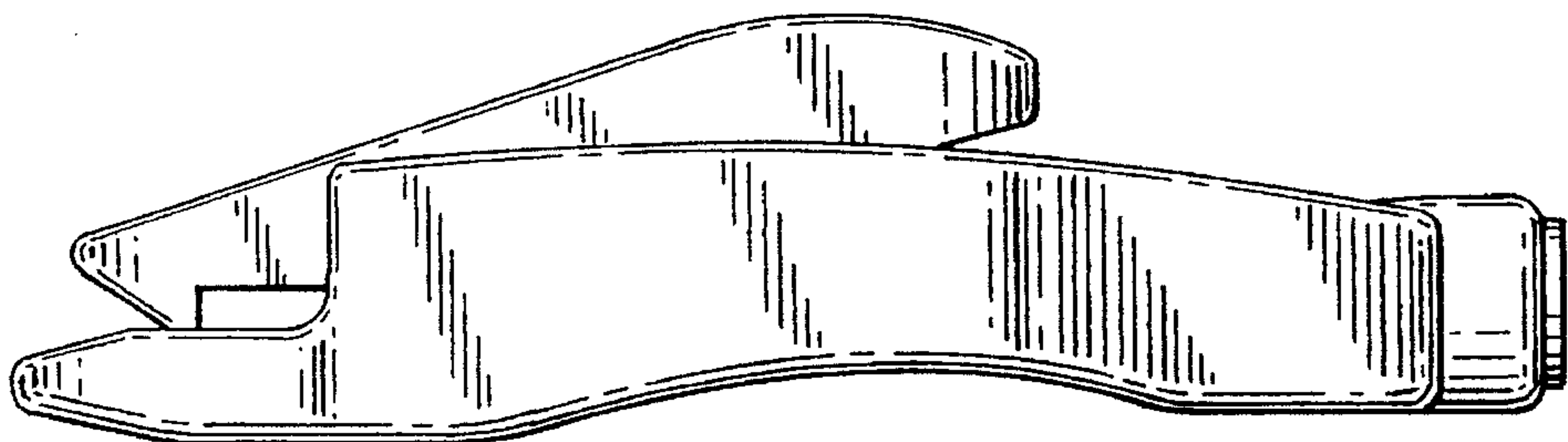

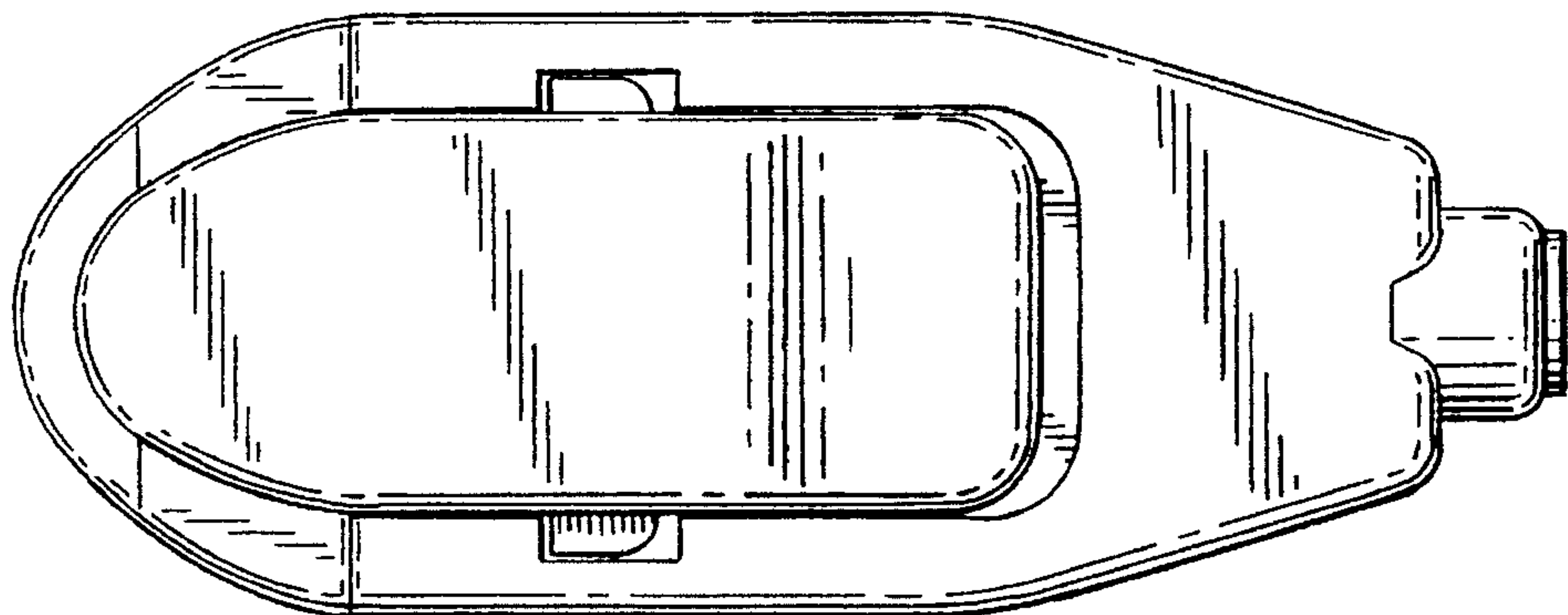

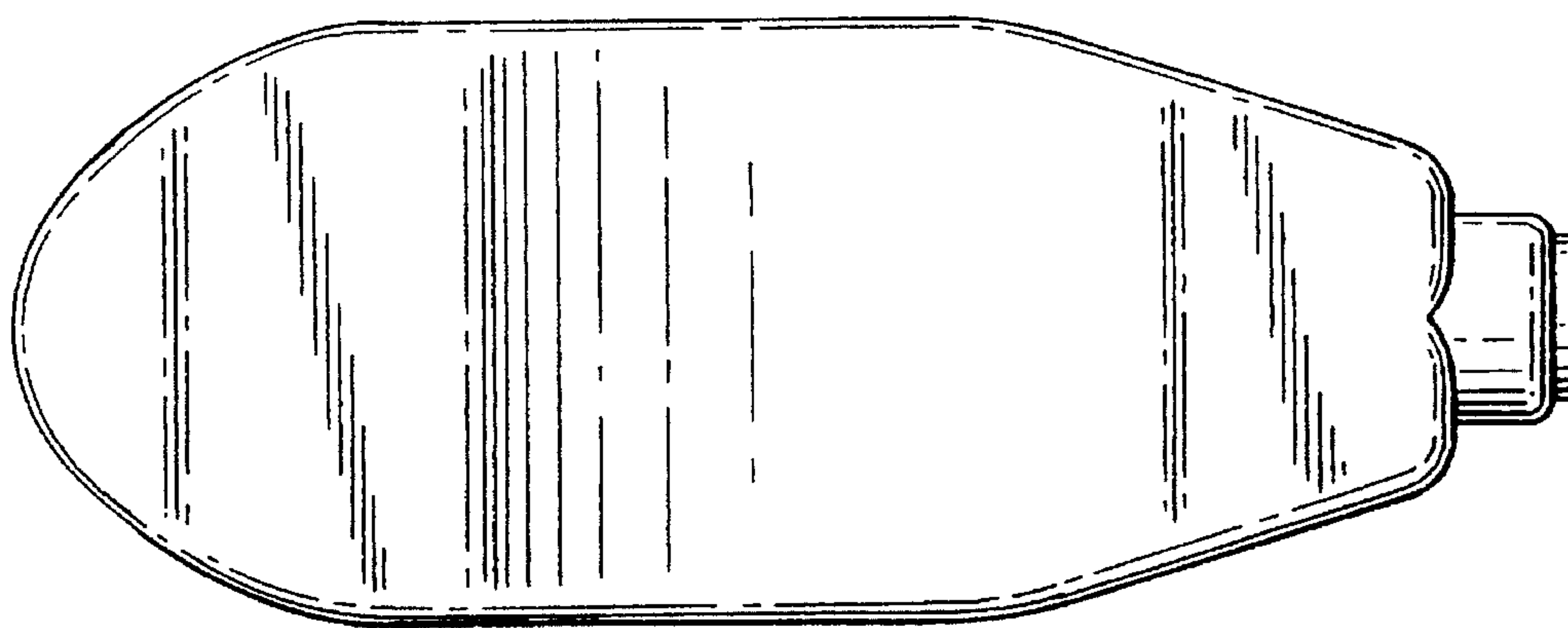

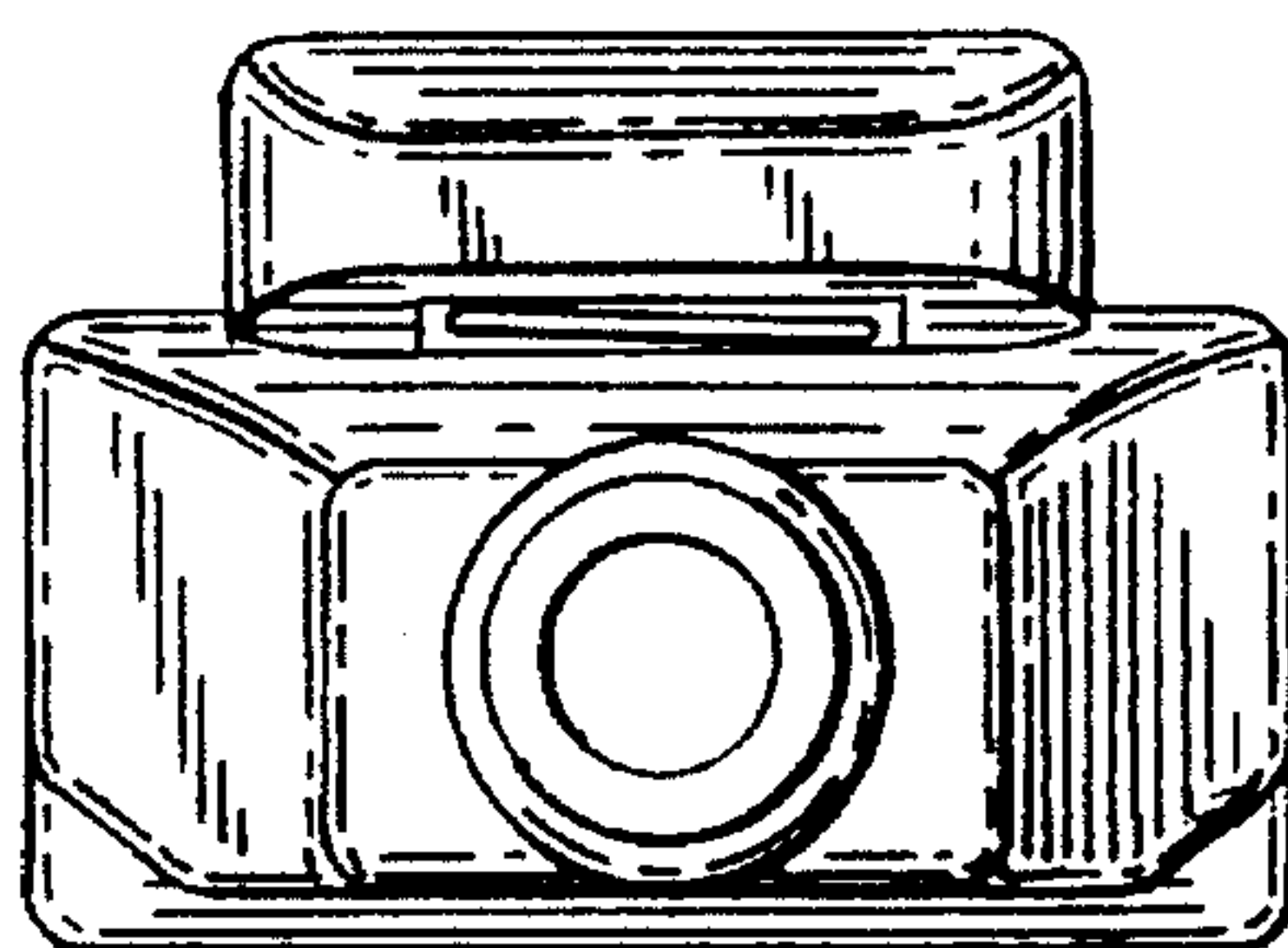

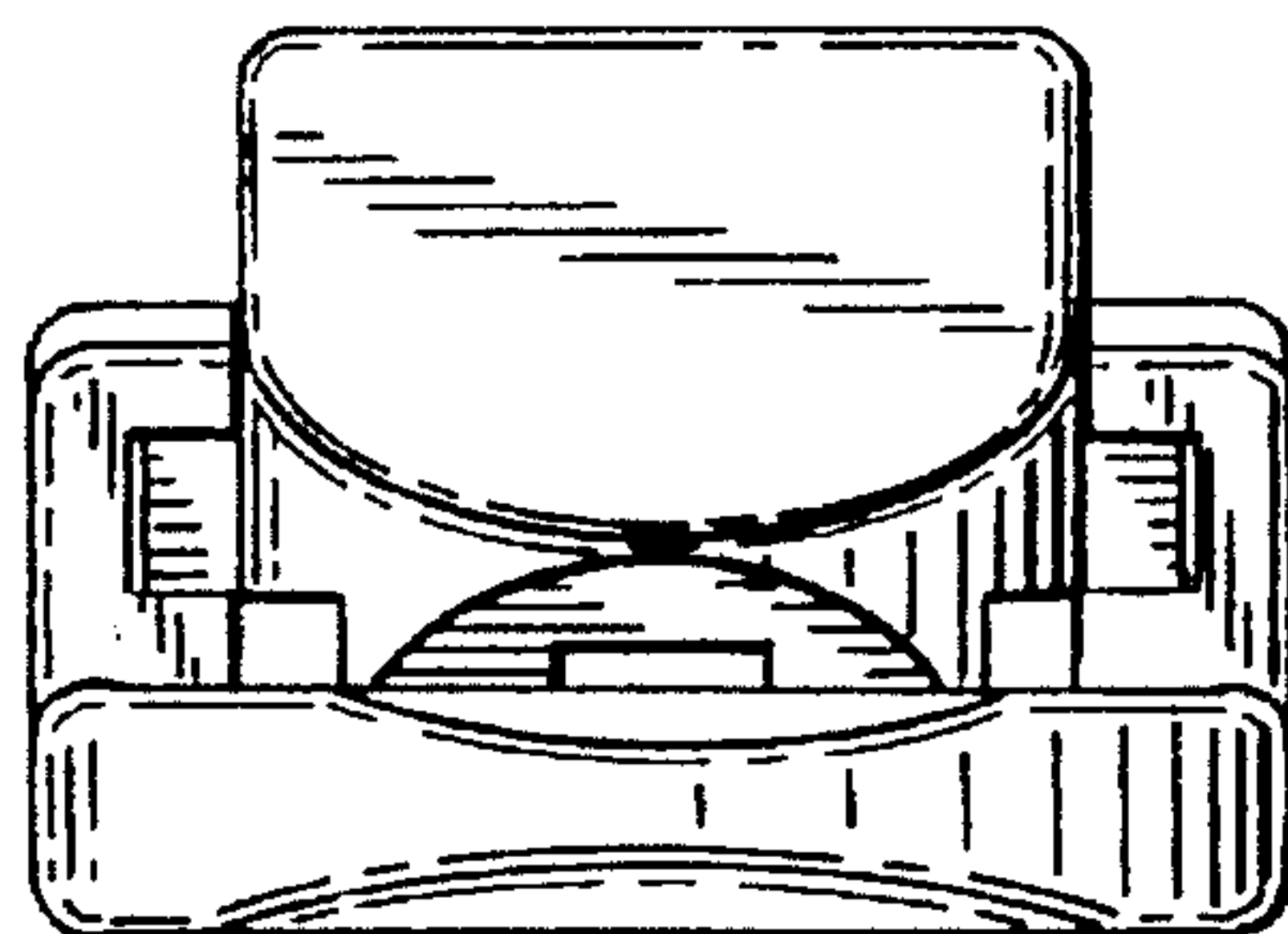
