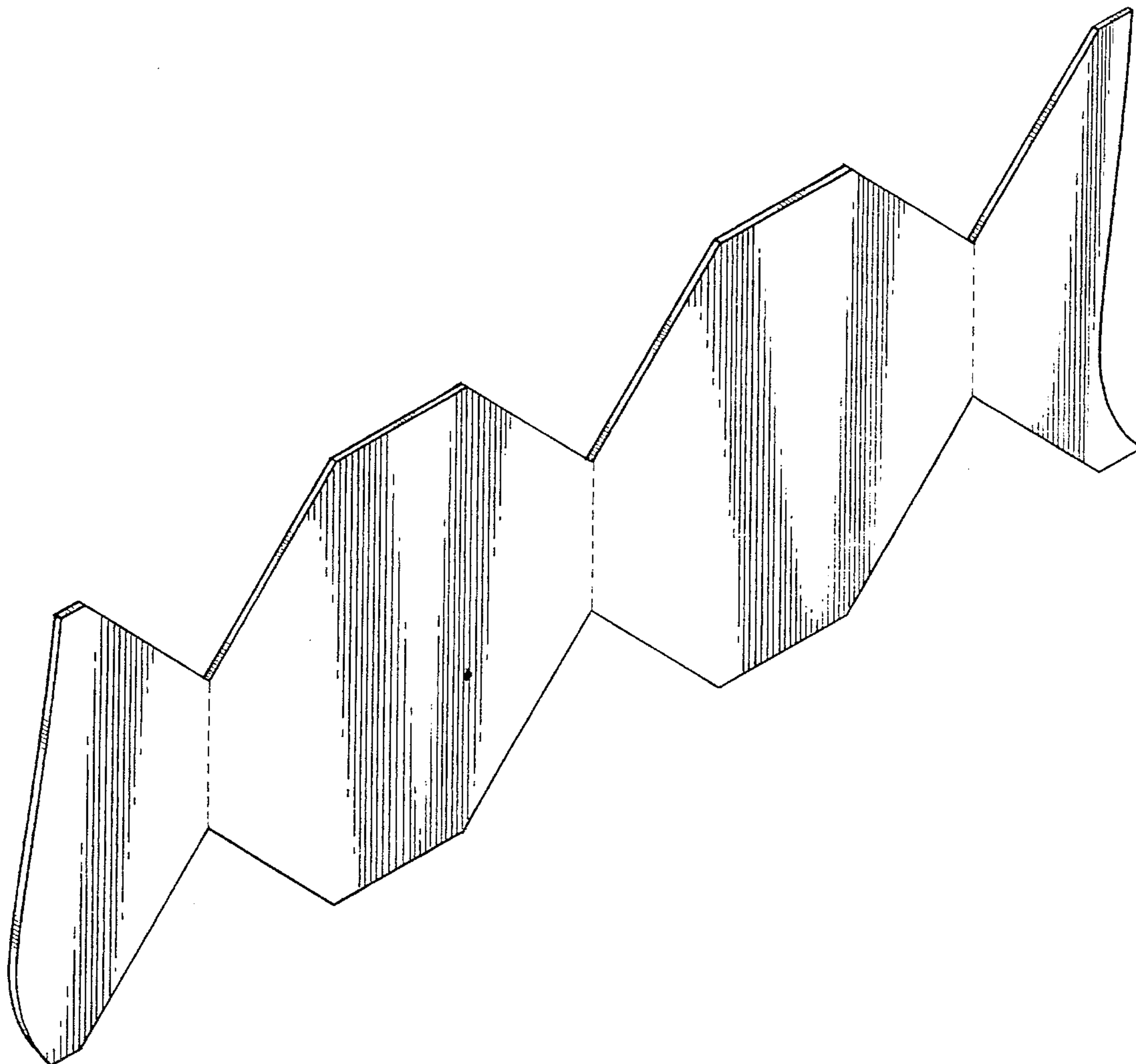
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a paper towel, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a paper towel showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a sectional view taken along lines 2—2 of FIG. 3;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image of the view shown in this Figure; and,
FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along lines 4—4 of FIG. 3. The broken lines indicate perforations and are part of the claimed design.

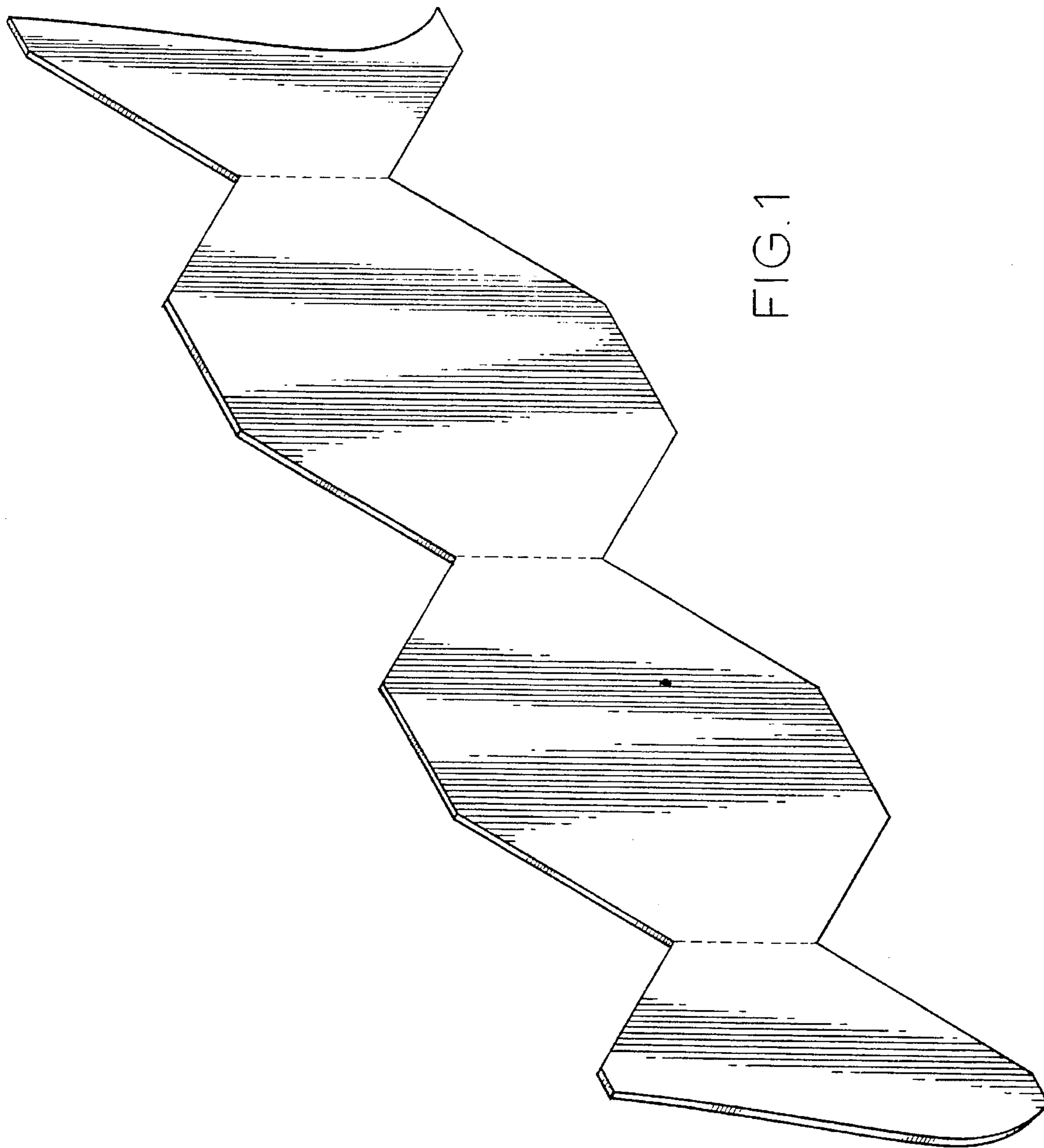

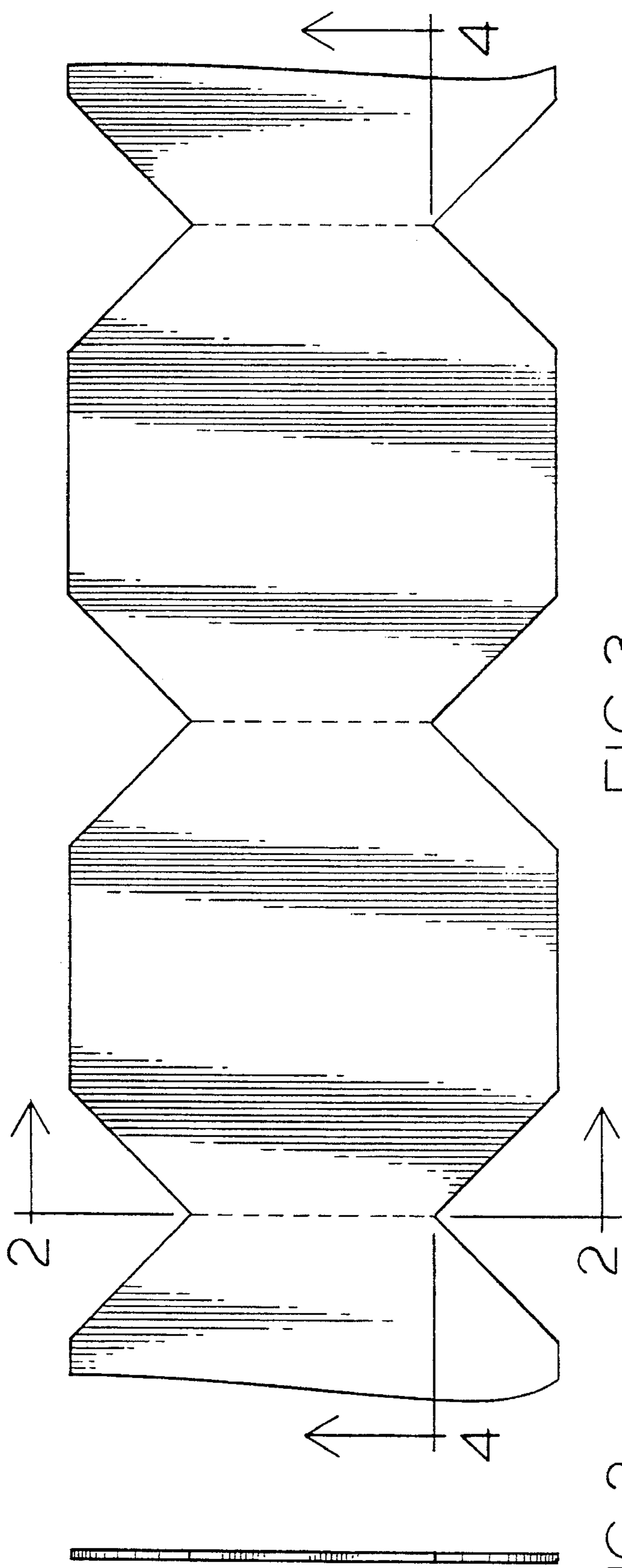
