The ornamental design for a window blind pull, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a window blind pull of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front view in elevation of the window blind pull of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side view in elevation of the window blind pull as seen from the right hand side of FIG. 1;

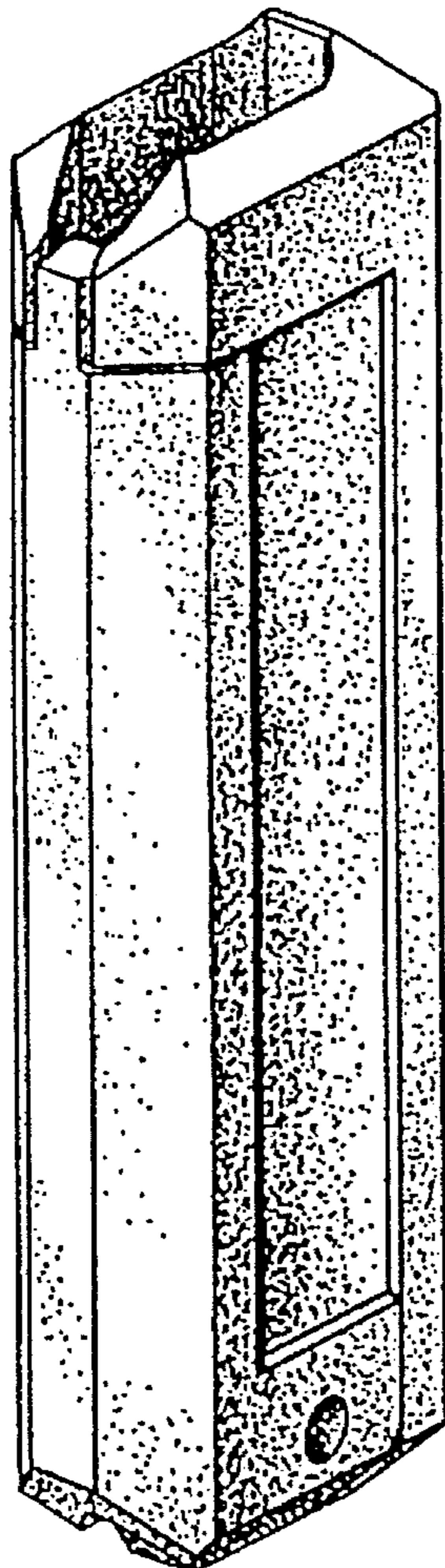
FIG. 4 is a rear view in elevation of the window blind pull of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a side view in elevation of the window blind pull as seen from the left hand side of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the window blind pull of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the window blind pull of FIG. 1.

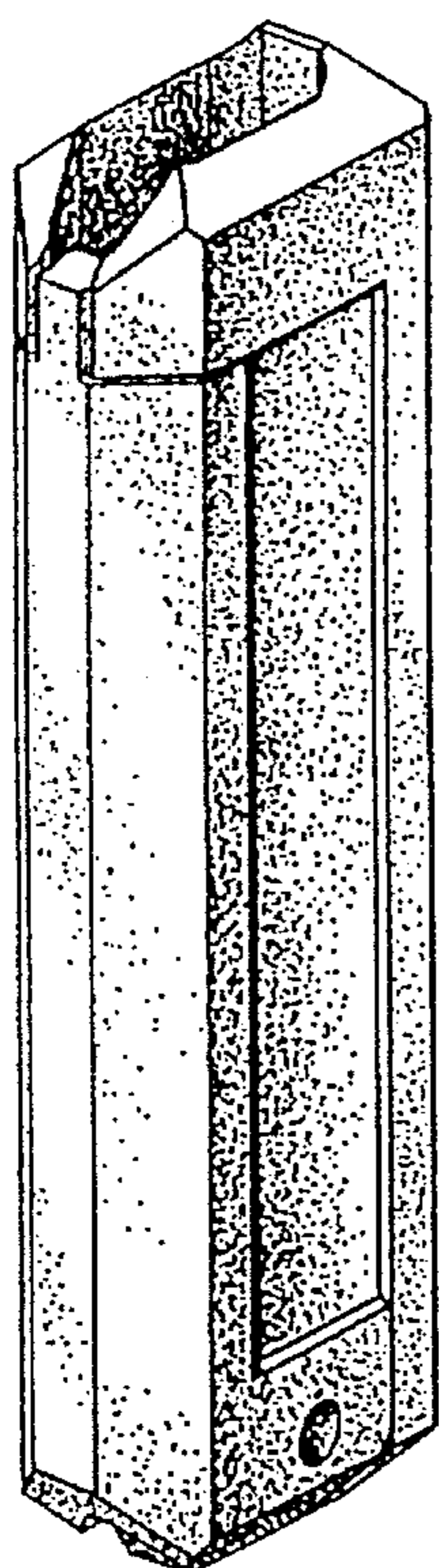

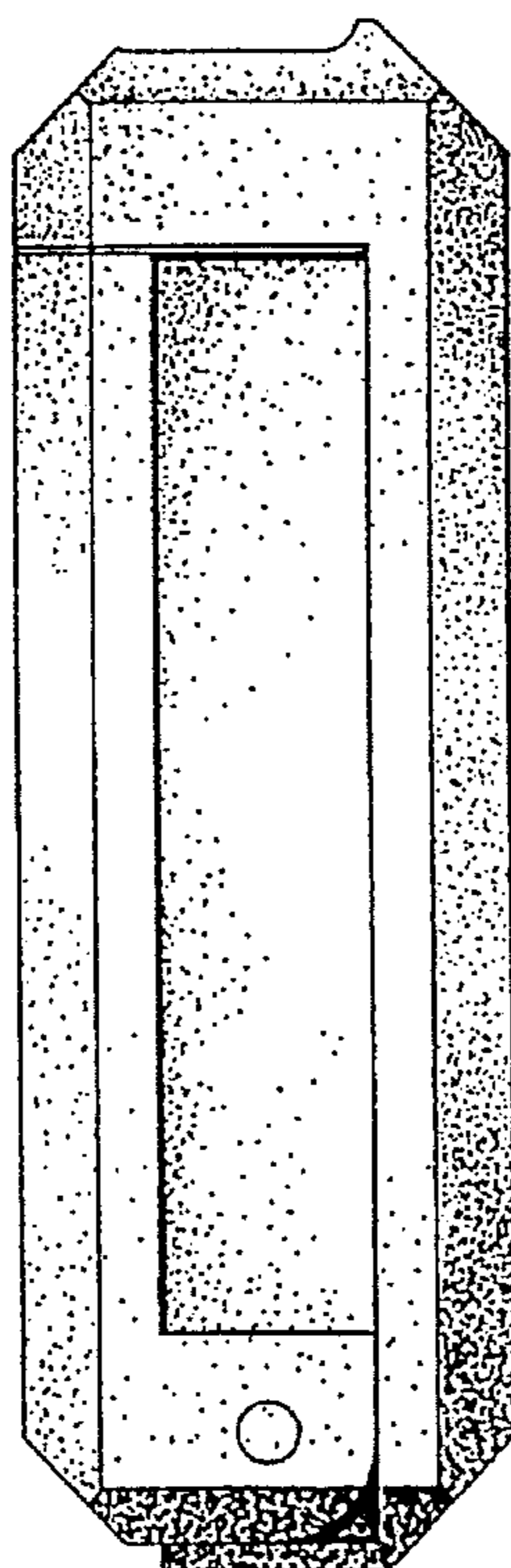

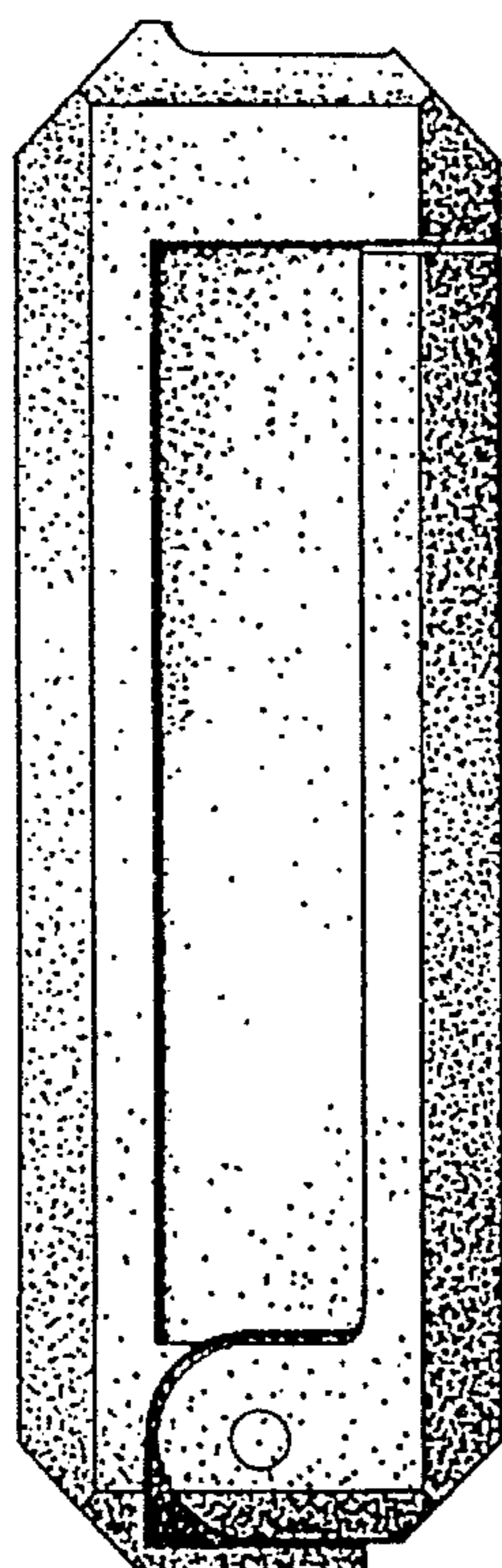

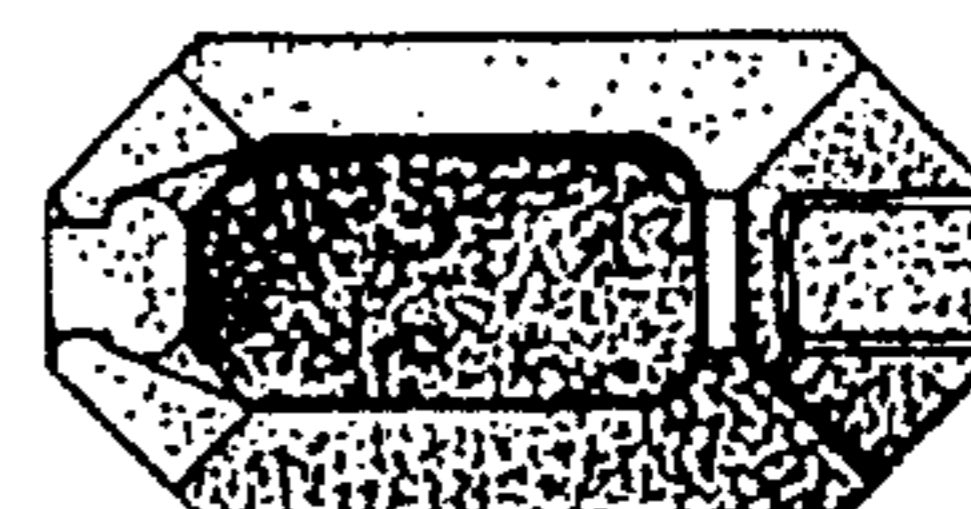

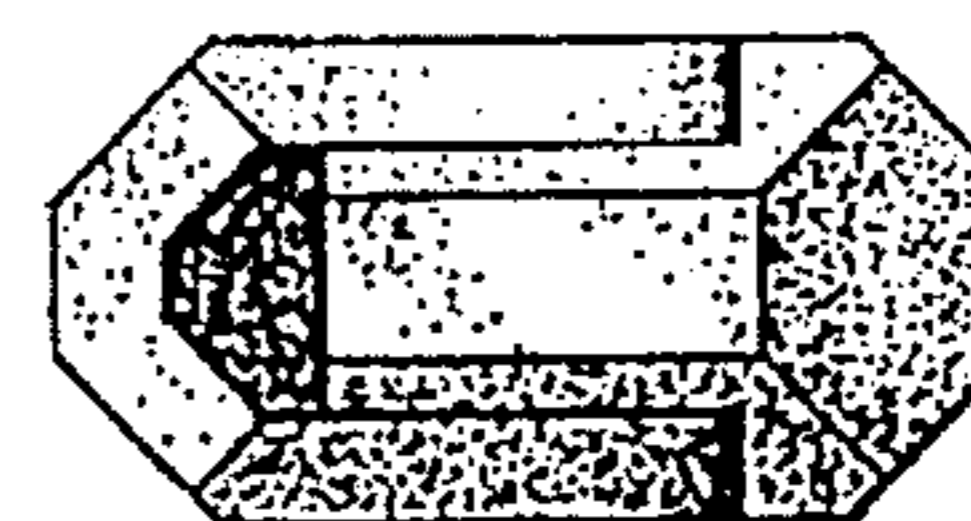
