FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

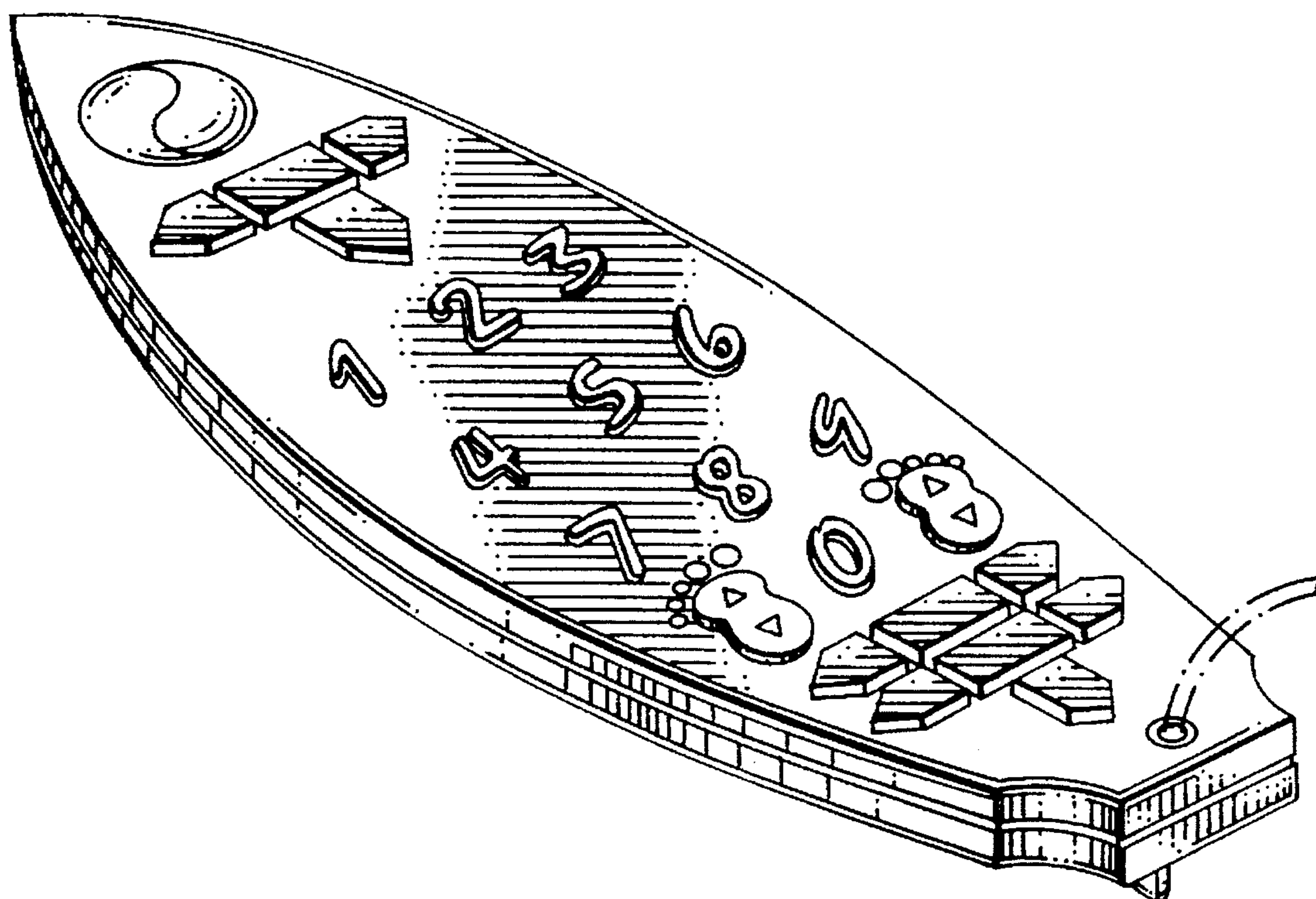
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, with the push buttons shown removed for ease of illustration;

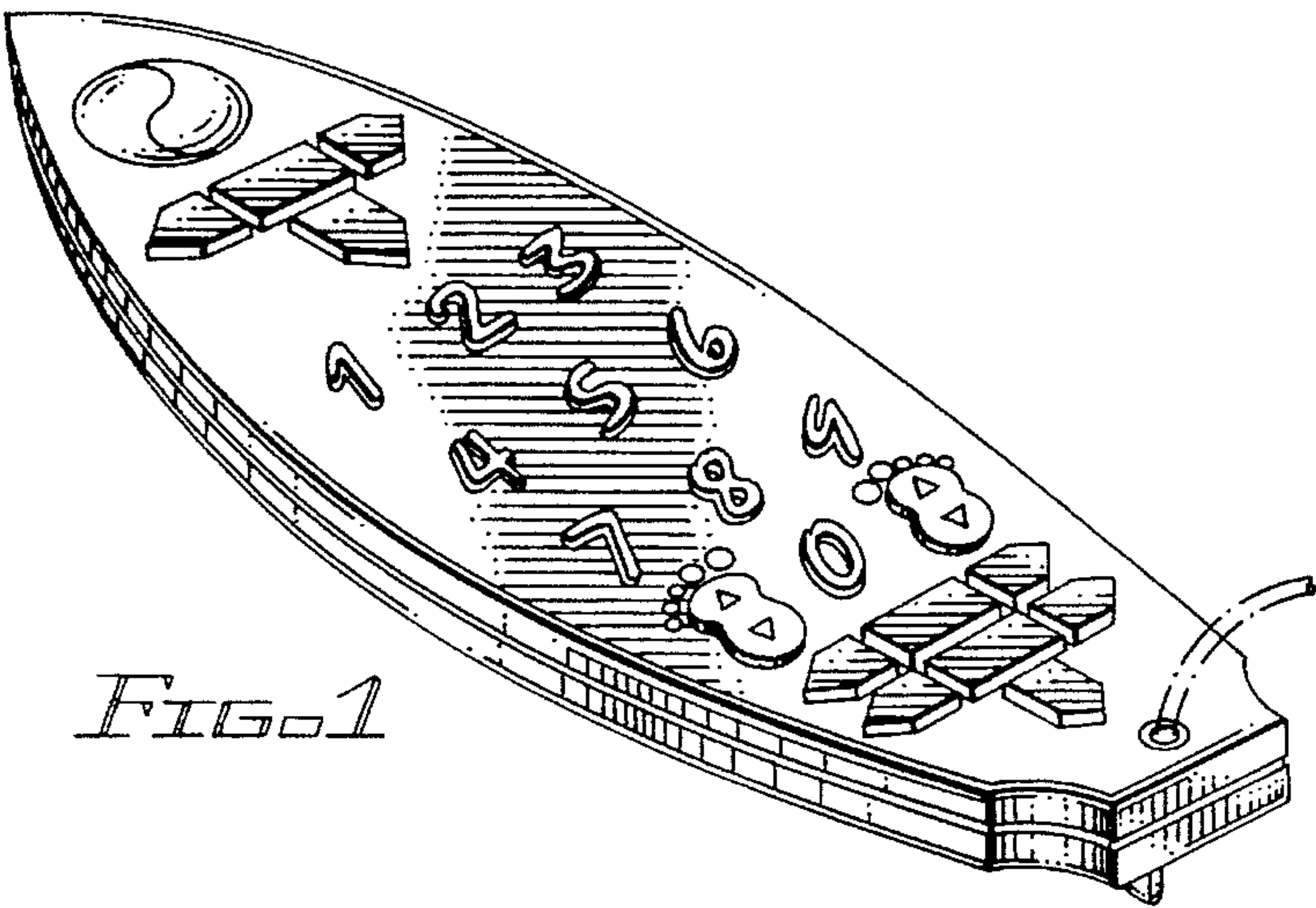

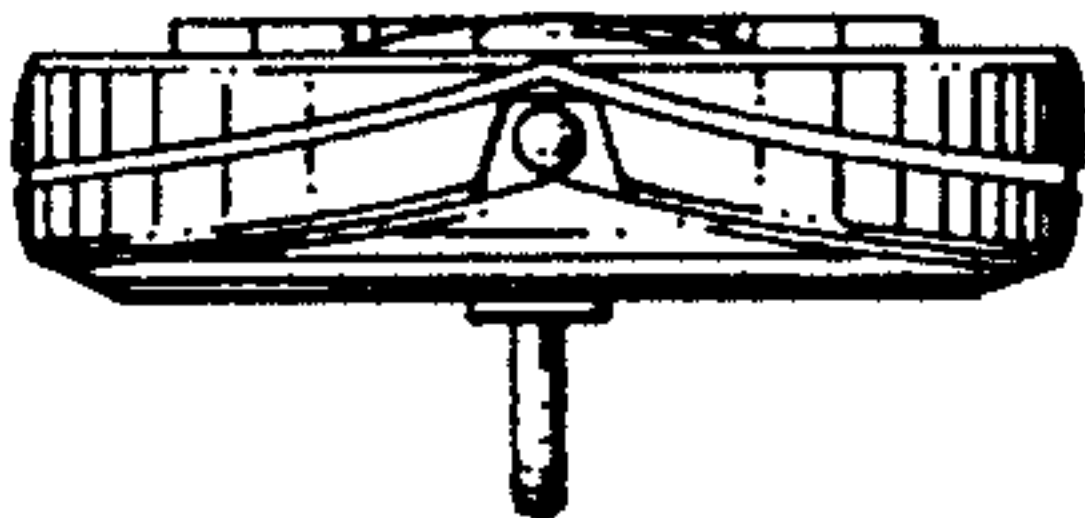

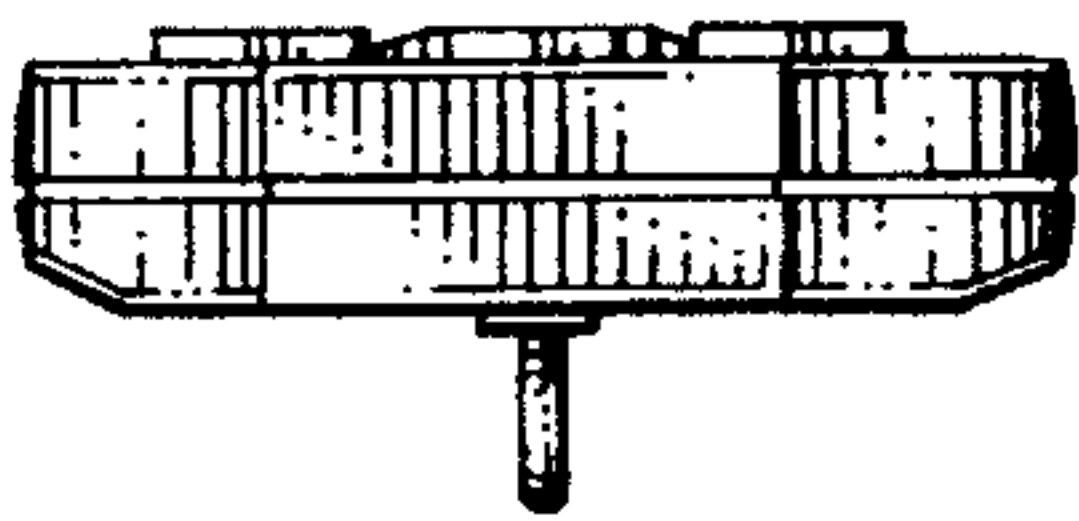

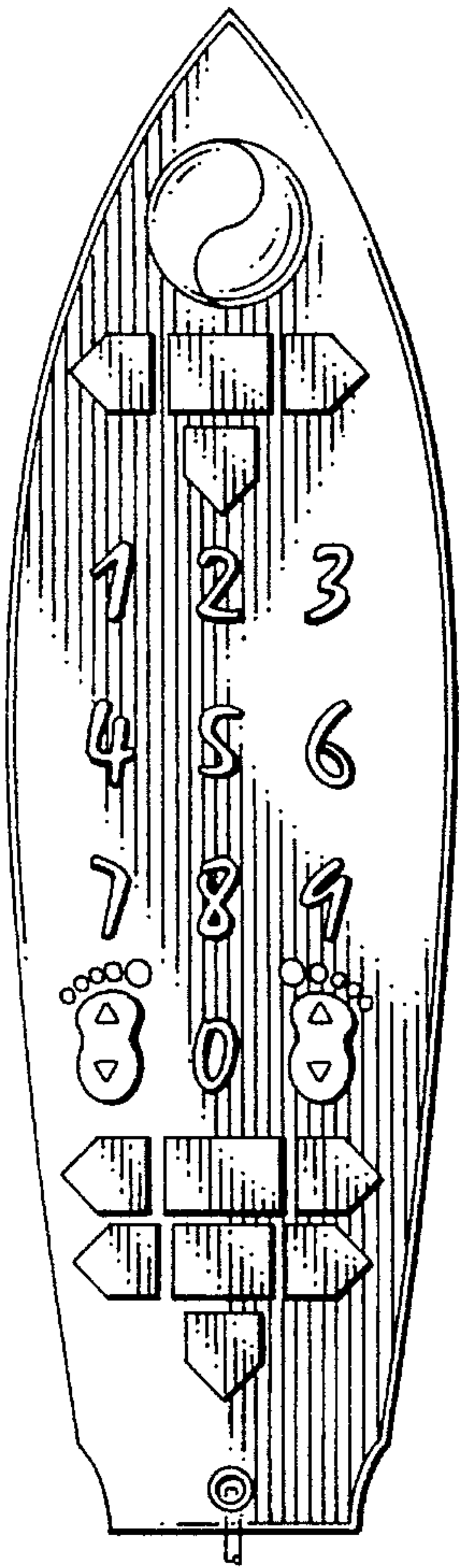

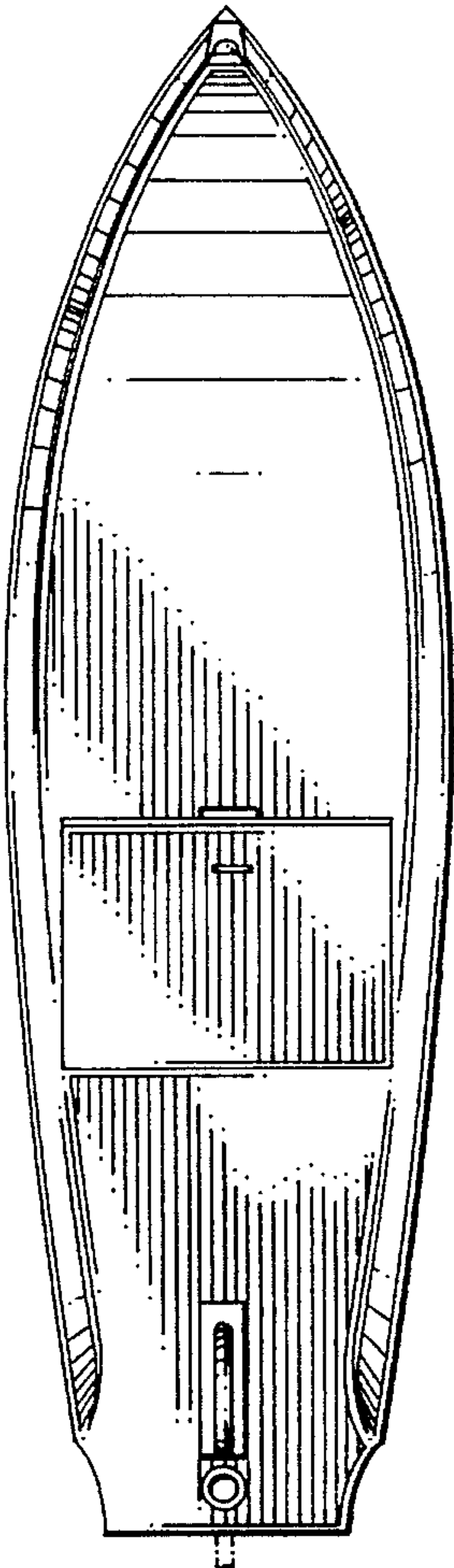

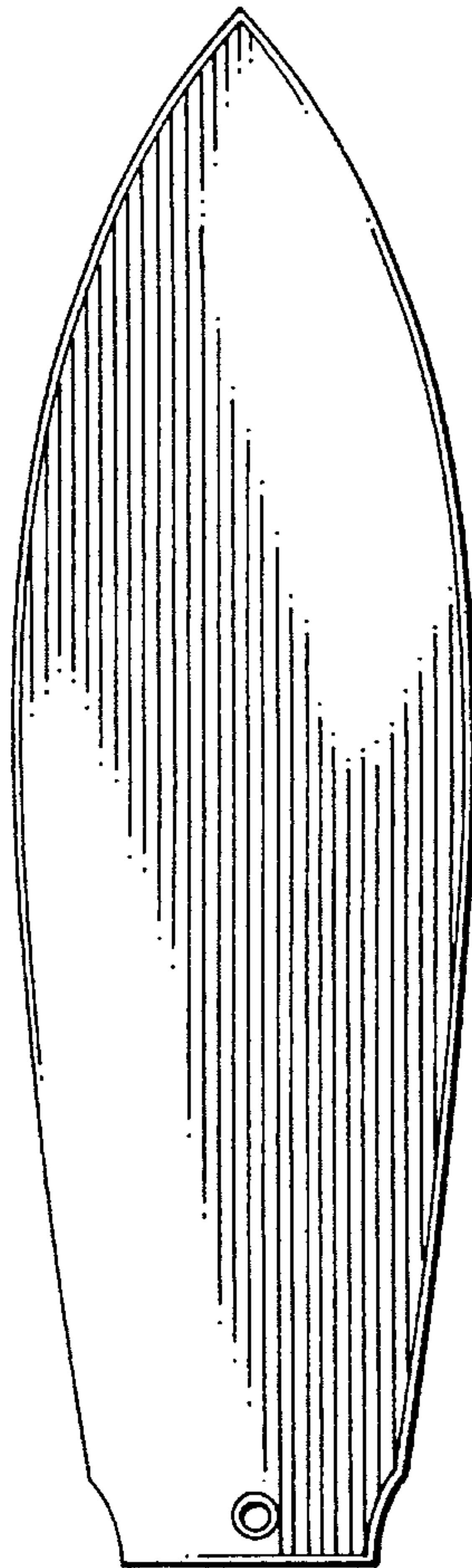

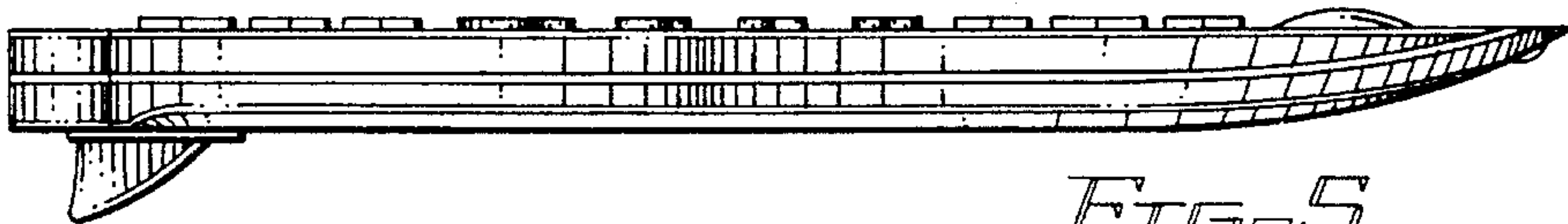
