The ornamental design of a flared personal mirror, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a flared personal mirror showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view;

FIG. 3 is a left side view;

FIG. 4 is a rear view;

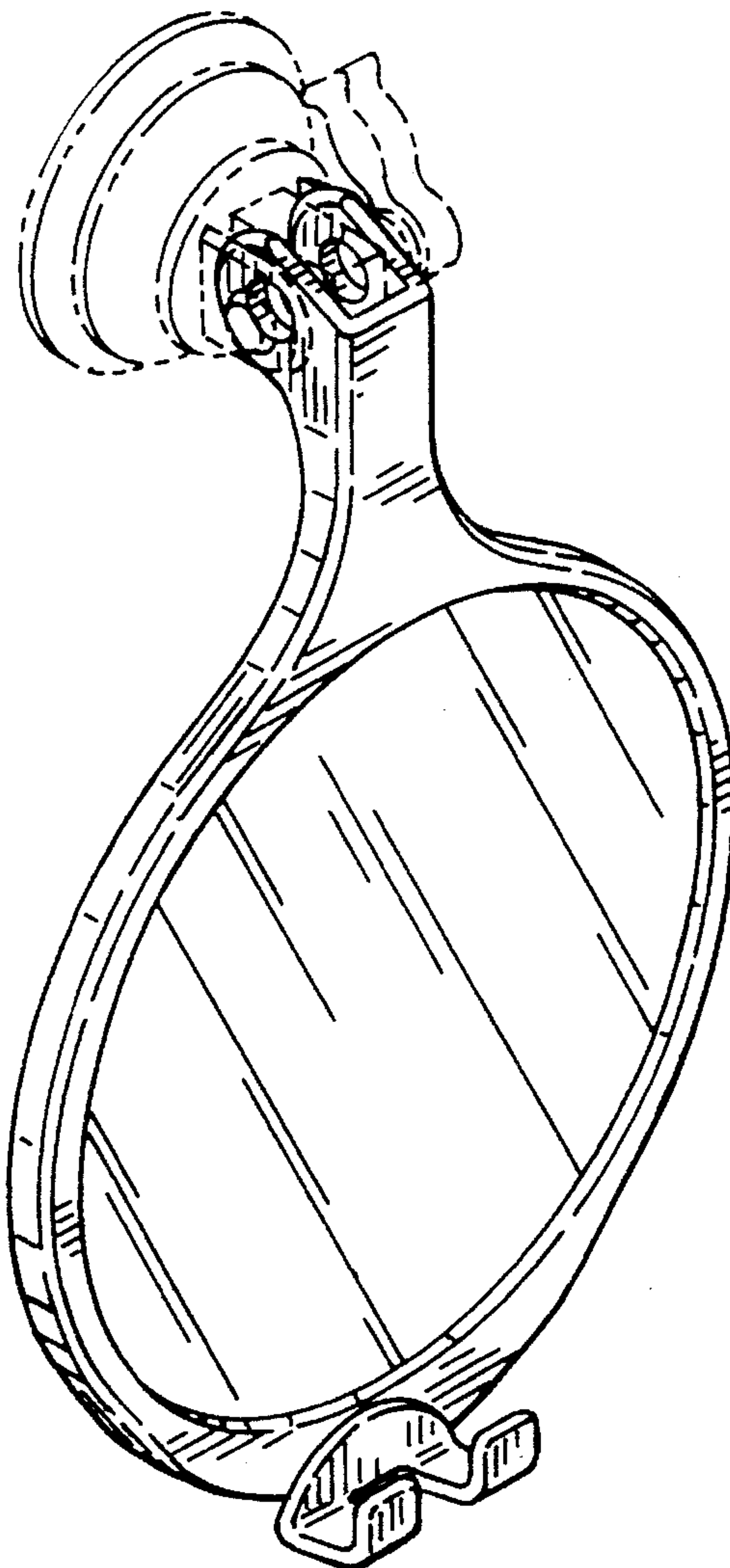
FIG. 5 is a top view; and,

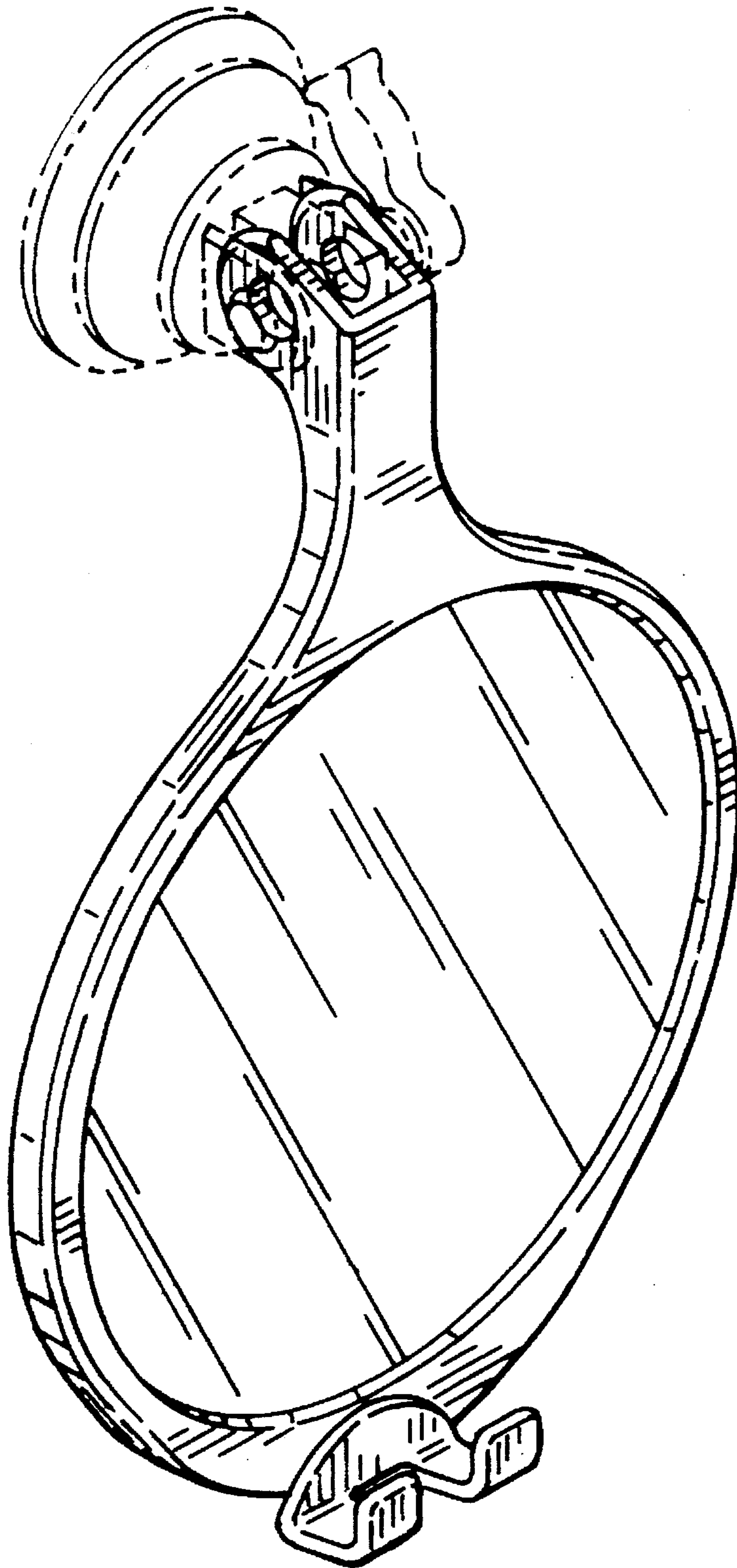

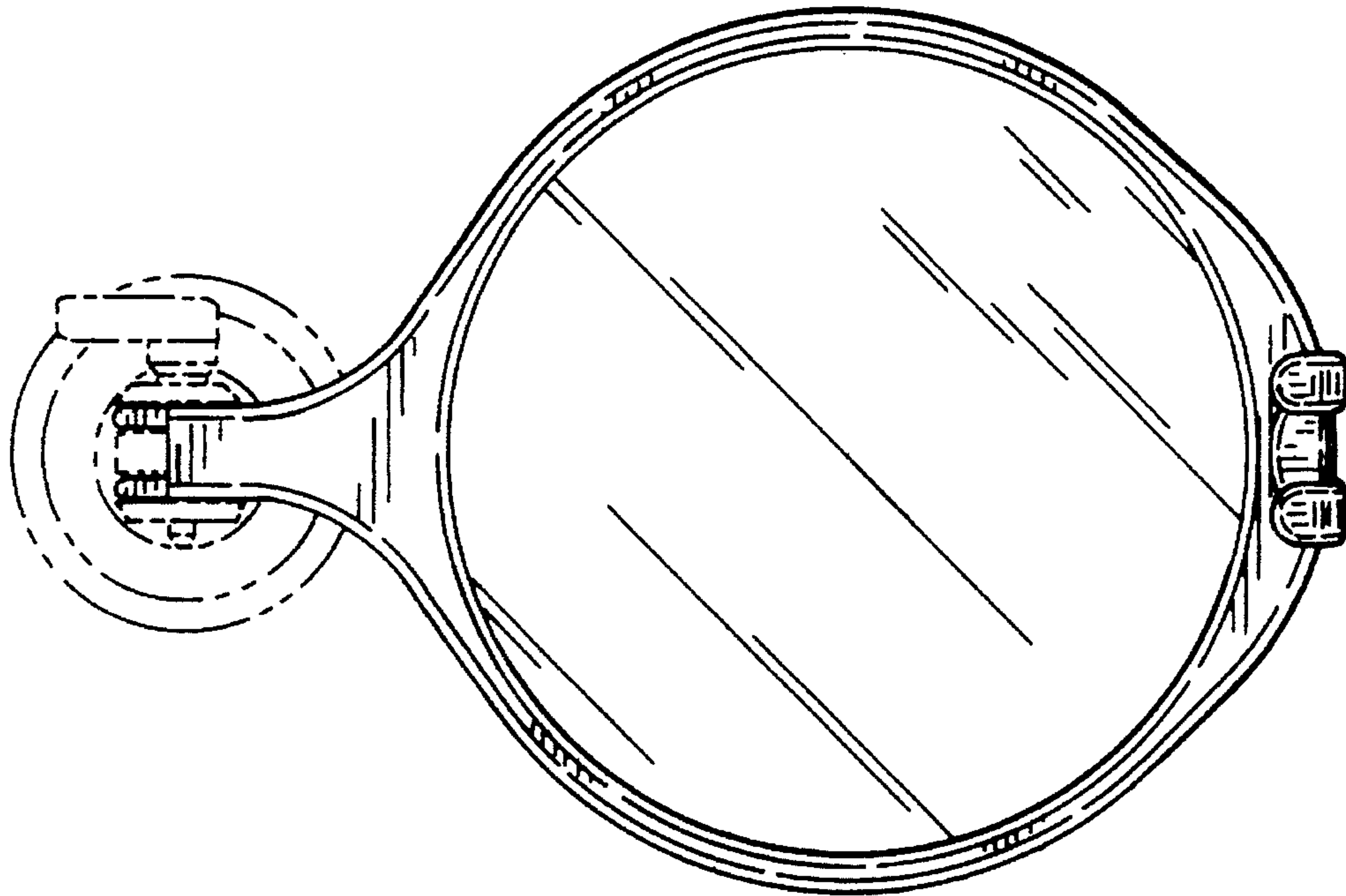

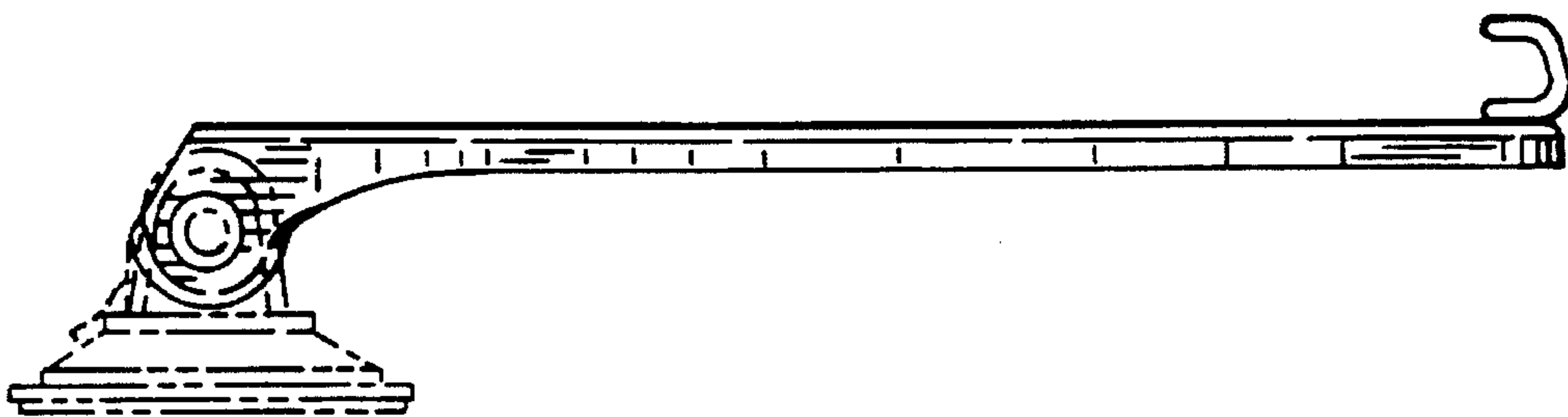

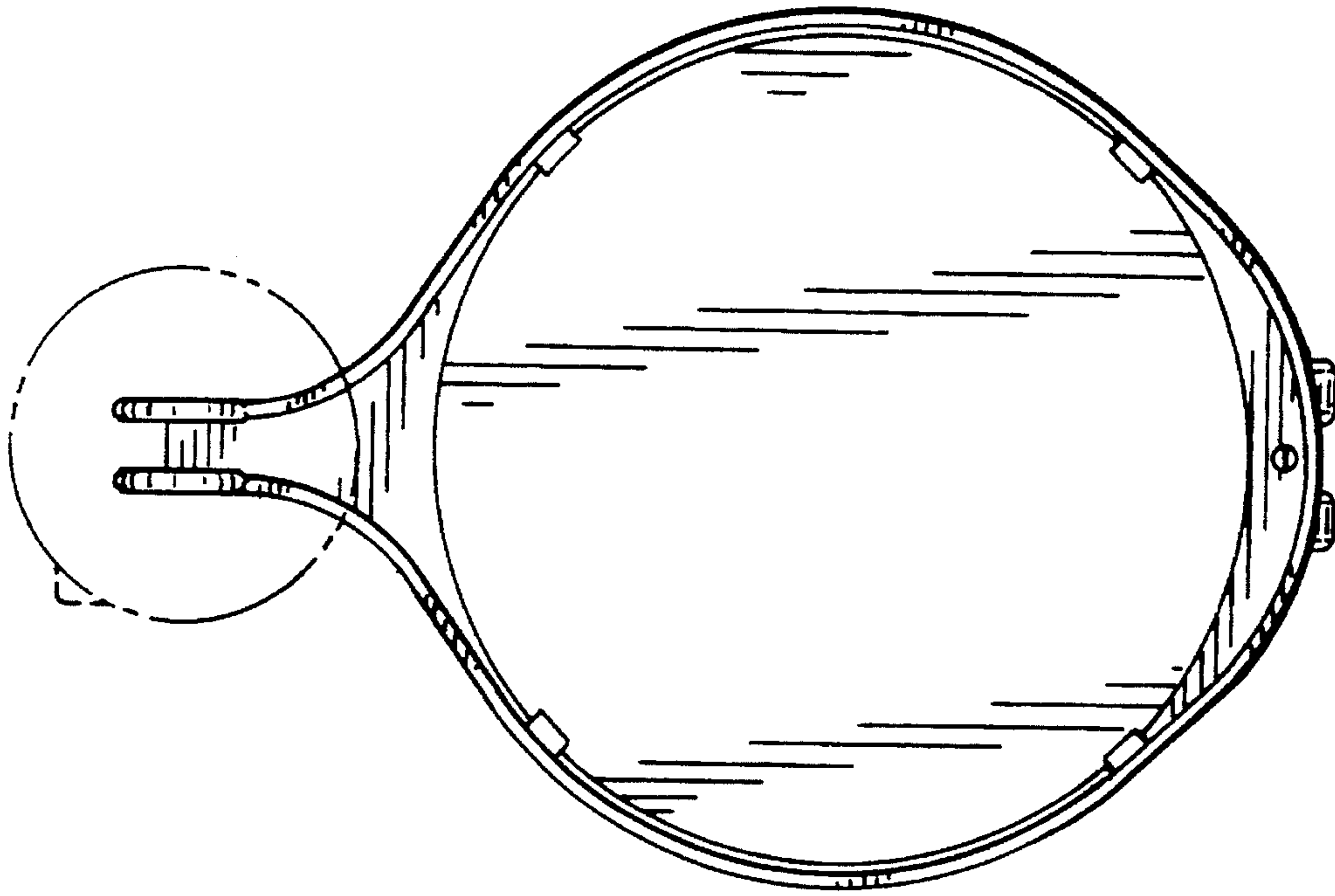

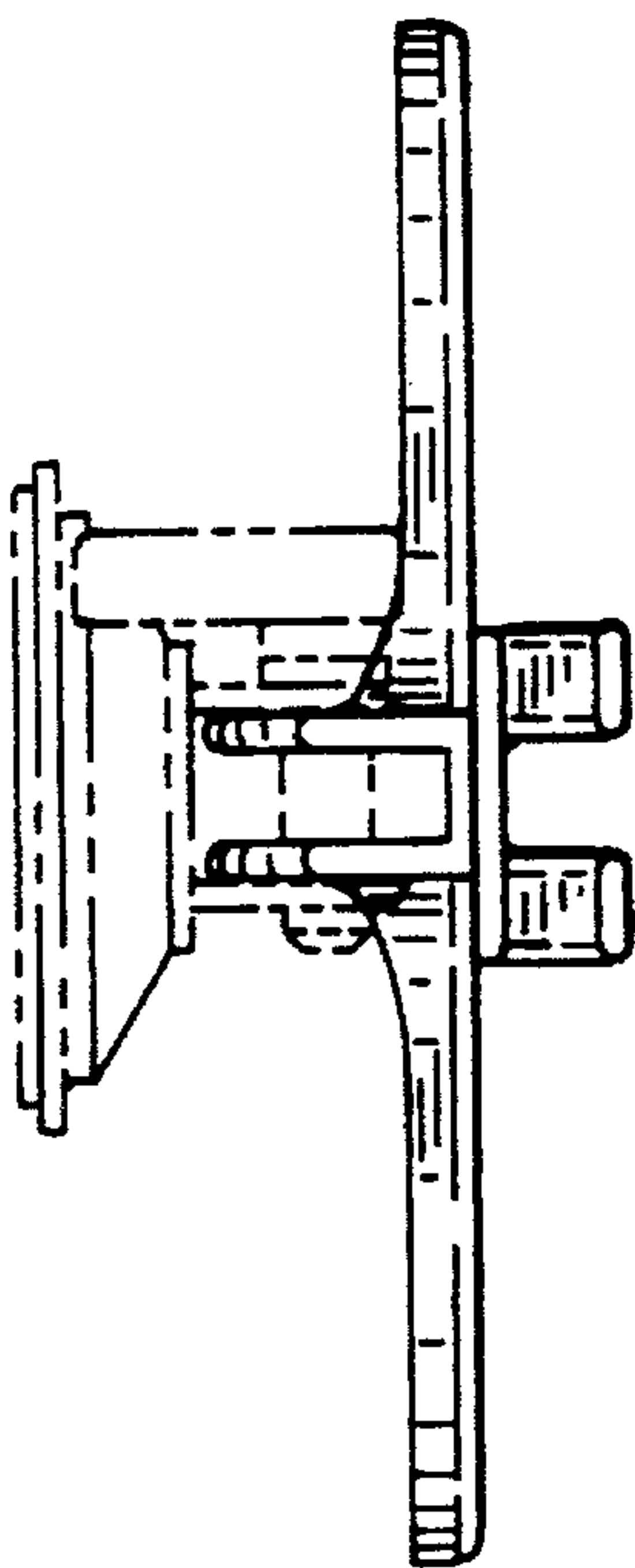

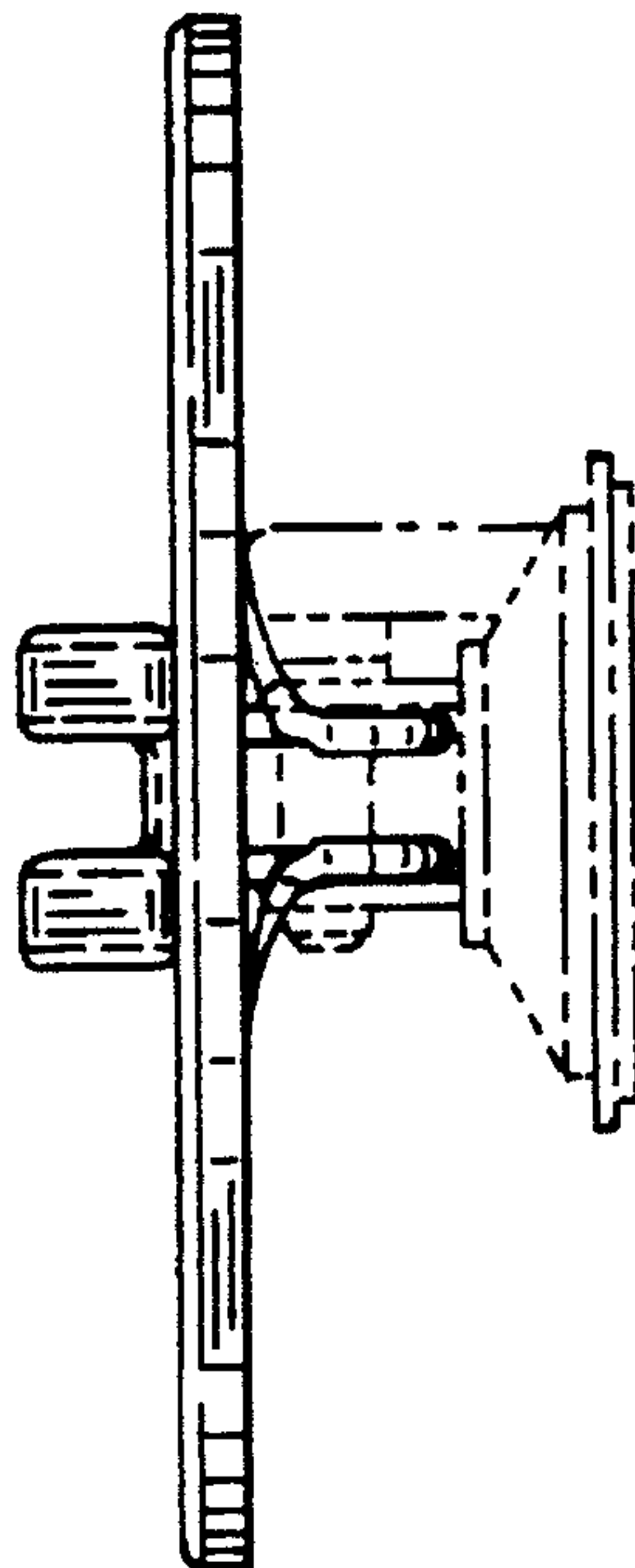
