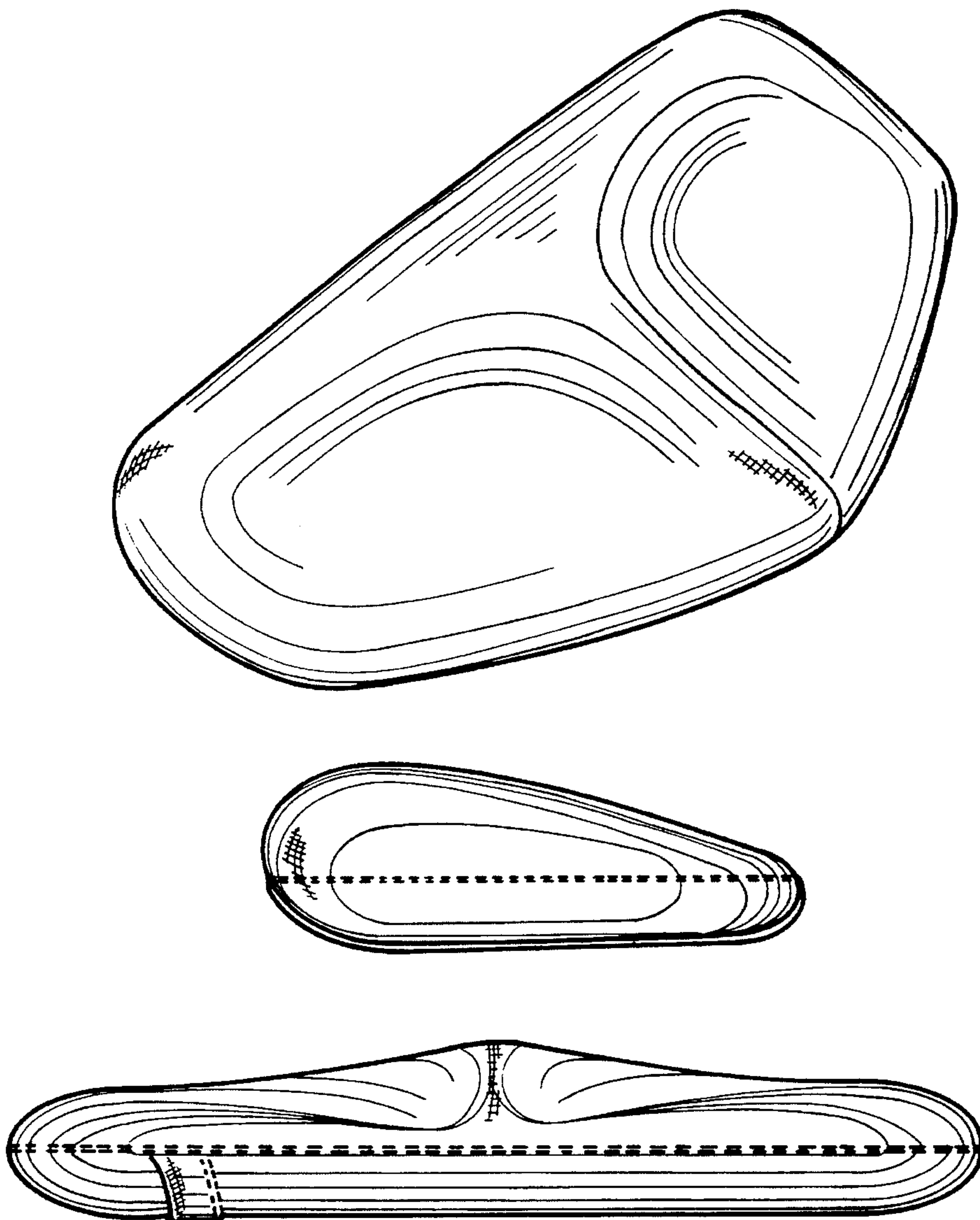
The ornamental design for a molded foam pillow, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a molded foam pillow;
FIG. 2 is a left side view;
FIG. 3 is a right side view;
FIG. 4 is a front view;

FIG. 6 is a top view; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom view.

The broken lines in FIGS. 3-5 represent stitching. The cross hatching represents conventional fabric and is understood to extend uniformly throughout the area represented.

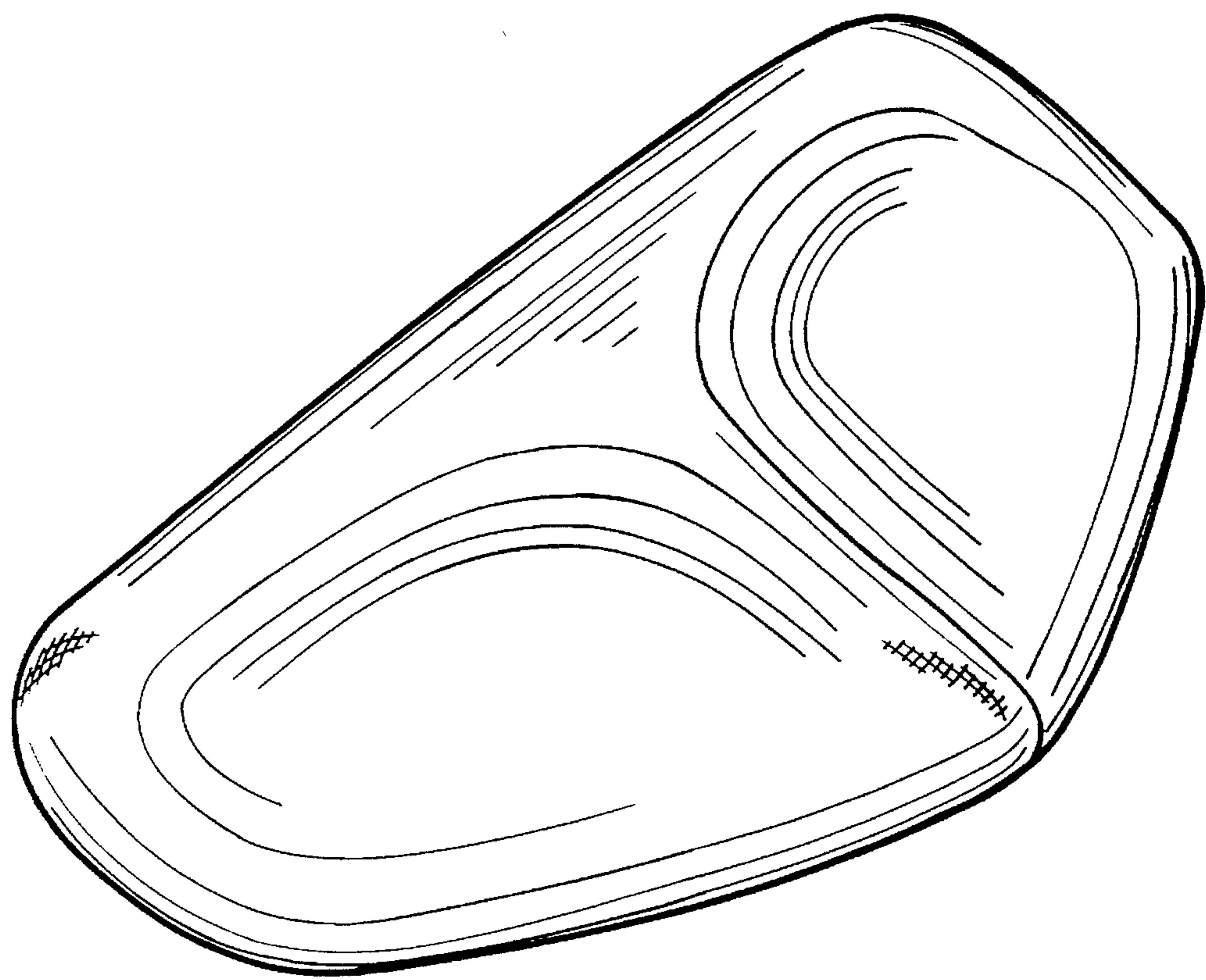

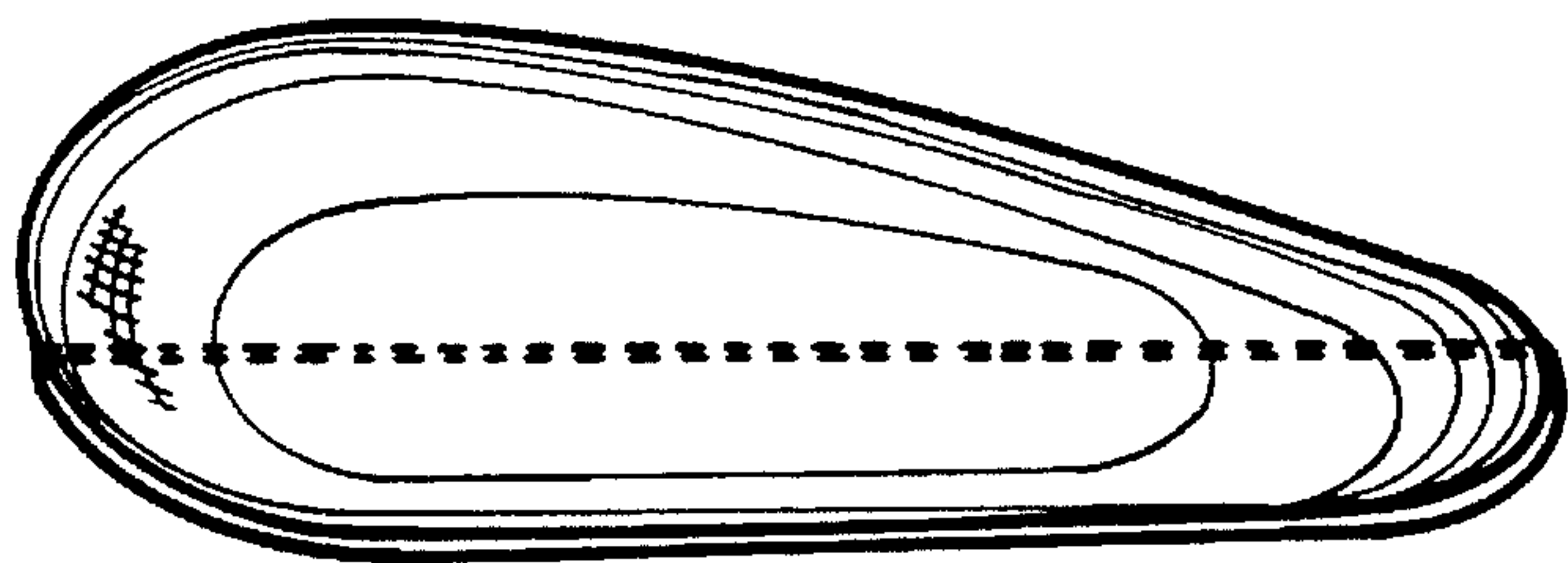

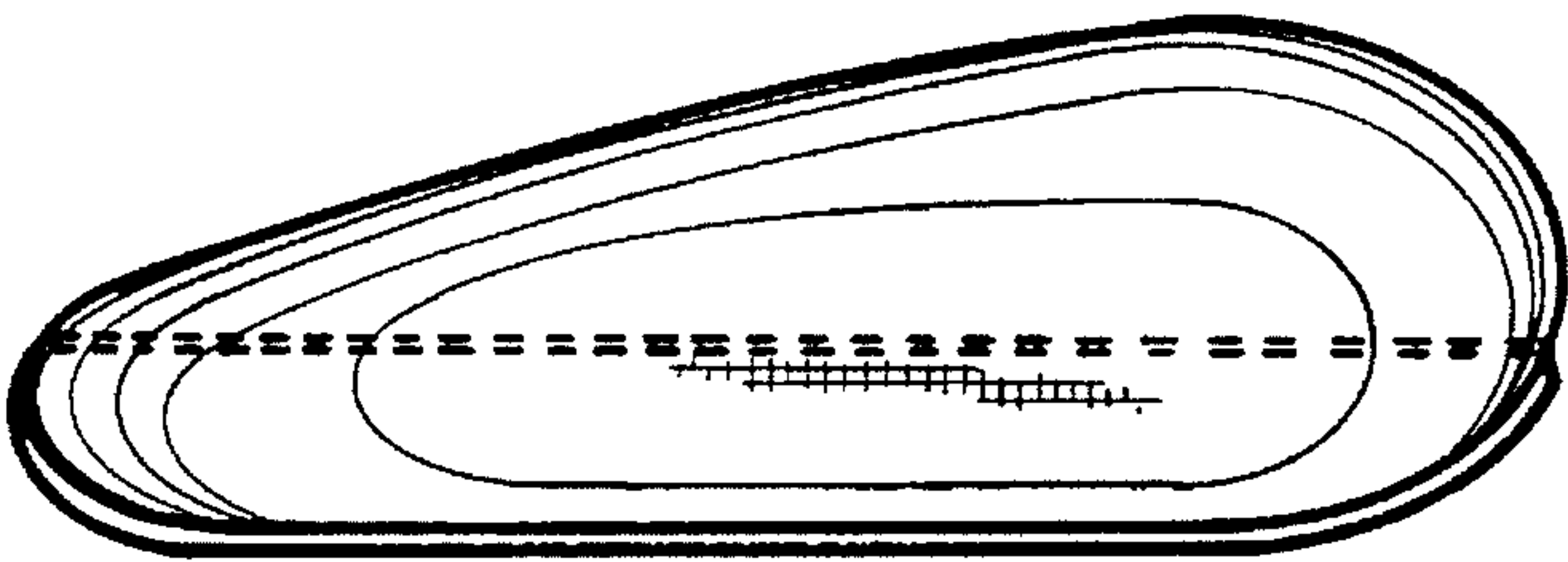

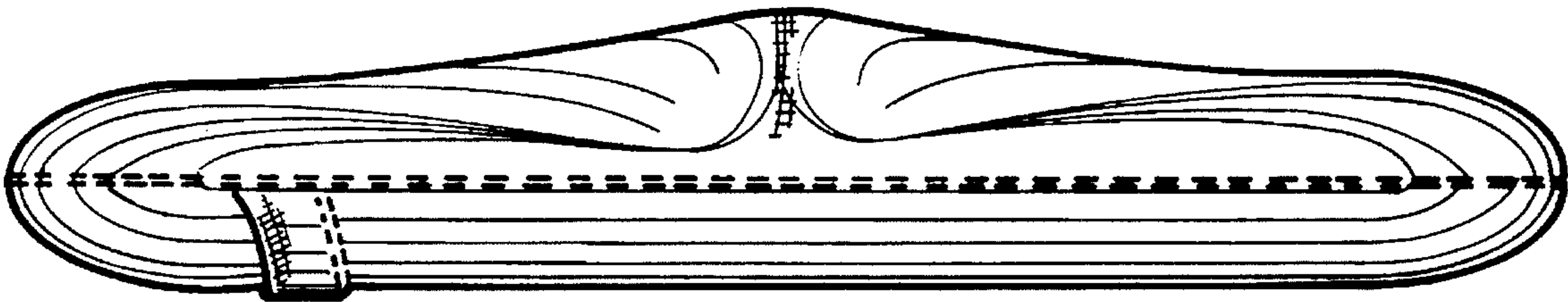

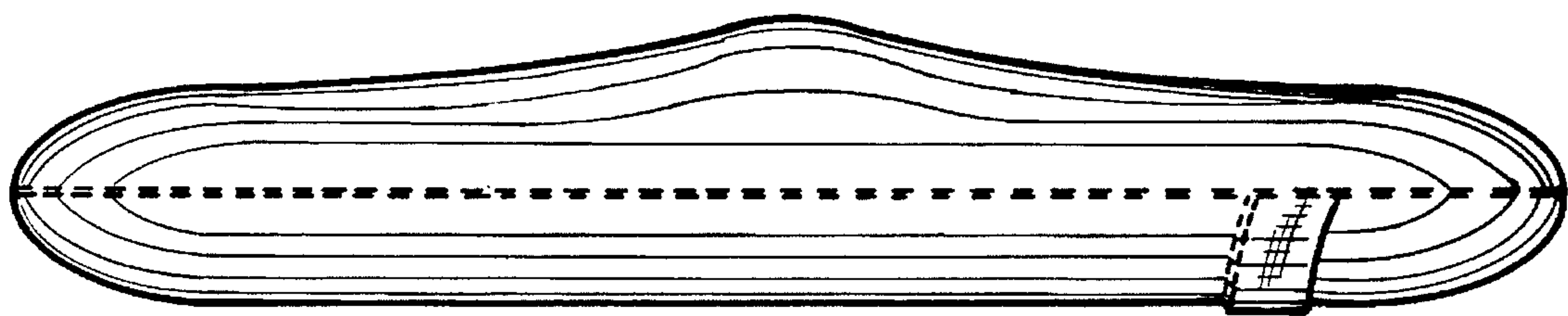

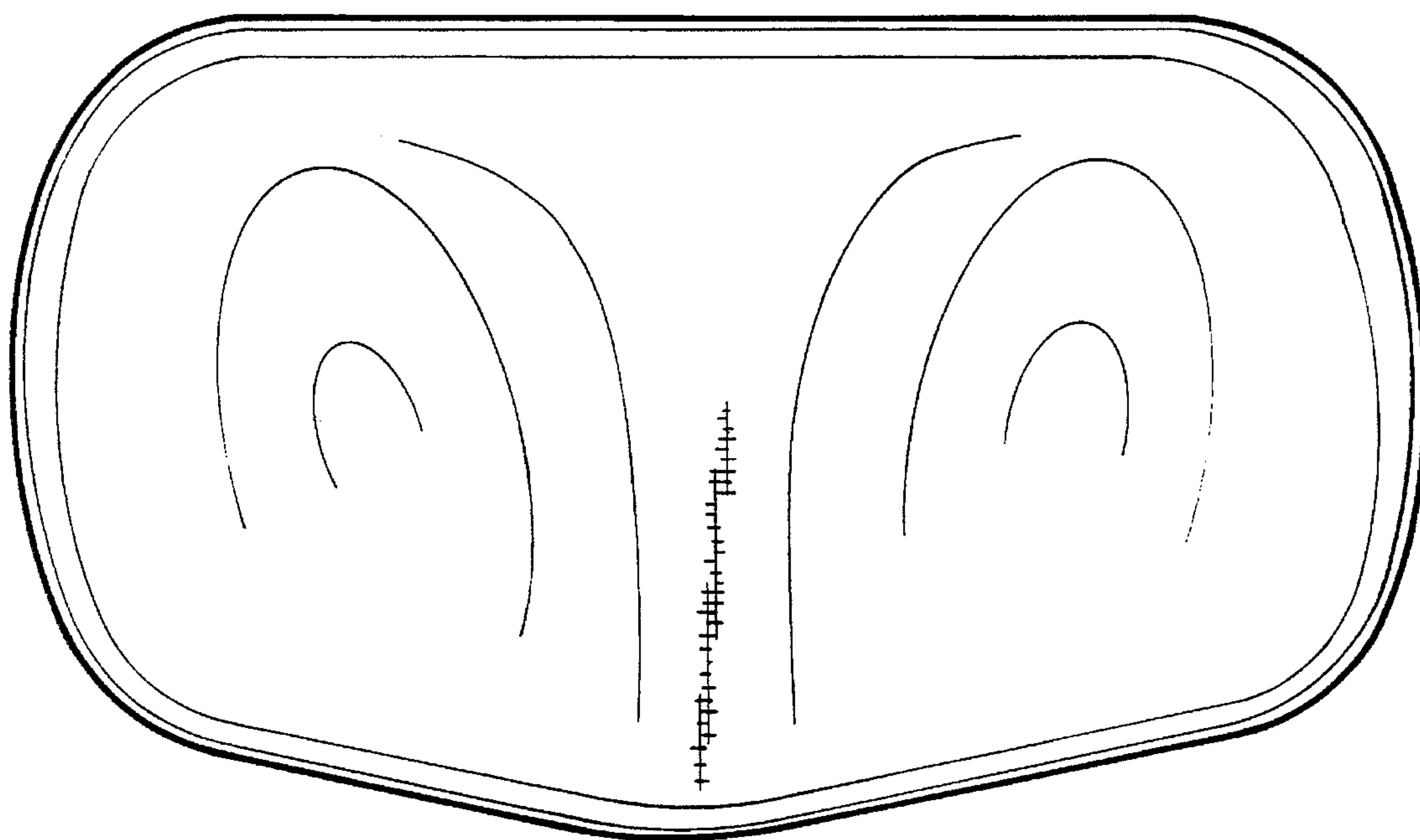

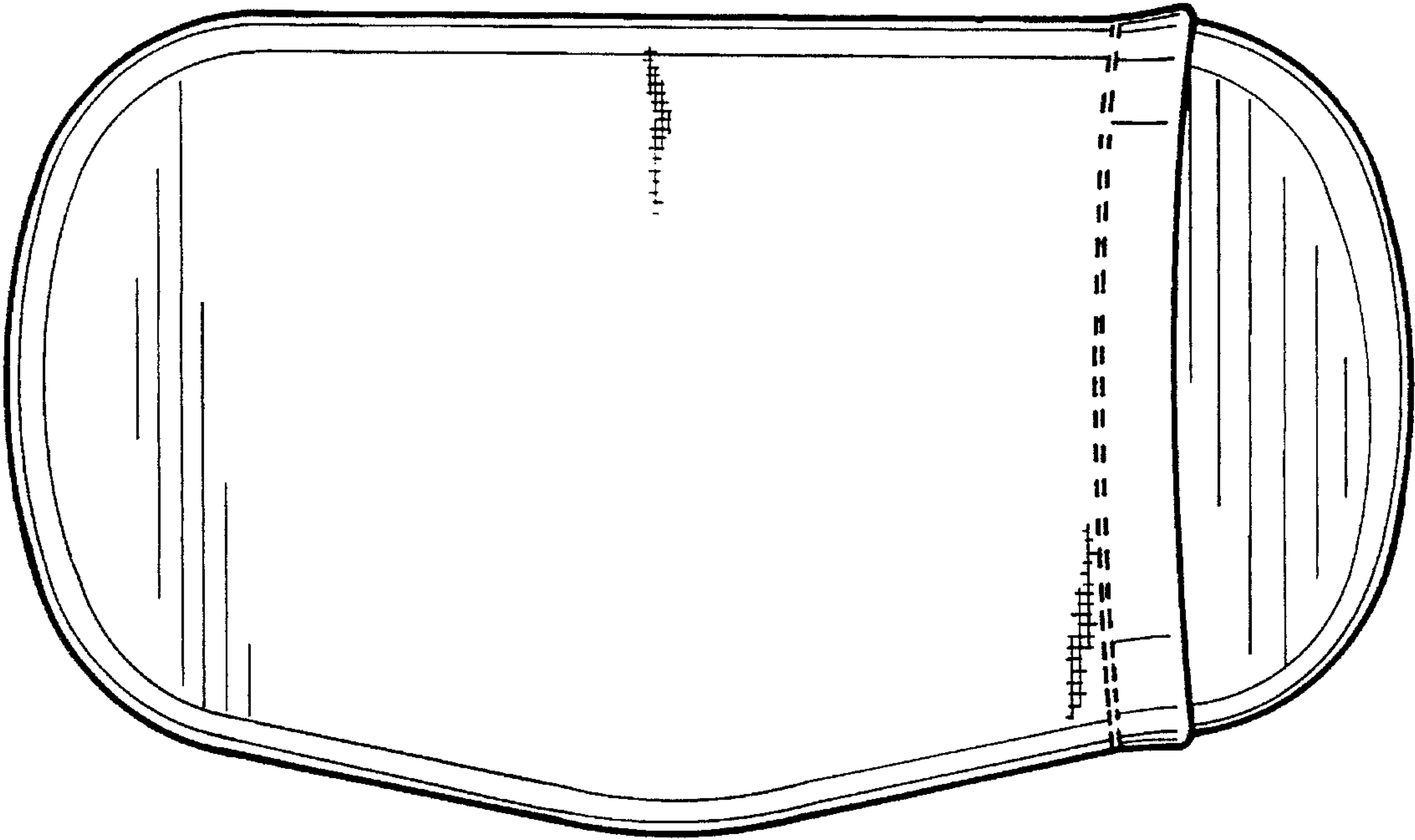
