The ornamental design for an antenna structure for detecting antitheft tags in a retail establishment, as shown and described.


### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of a first embodiment of the an antenna

structure for detecting antitheft tags in a retail establishment, the rear view being a mirror image thereof;

- FIG. 6 is a front view of a second embodiment of the an antenna structure for detecting antitheft tags in a retail establishment, the rear view being a mirror image thereof;
- FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the second embodiment of the an antenna structure for detecting antitheft tags in a retail establishment;
- FIG. 8 is a top view of the second embodiment of the an antenna structure for detecting antitheft tags in a retail establishment;
- FIG. 9 is a right side view of the second embodiment of the an antenna structure for detecting antitheft tags in a retail establishment, the left side view being a mirror image thereof; and,
- FIG. 10 is a bottom view of the second embodiment of the an antenna structure for detecting antitheft tags in a retail establishment.























