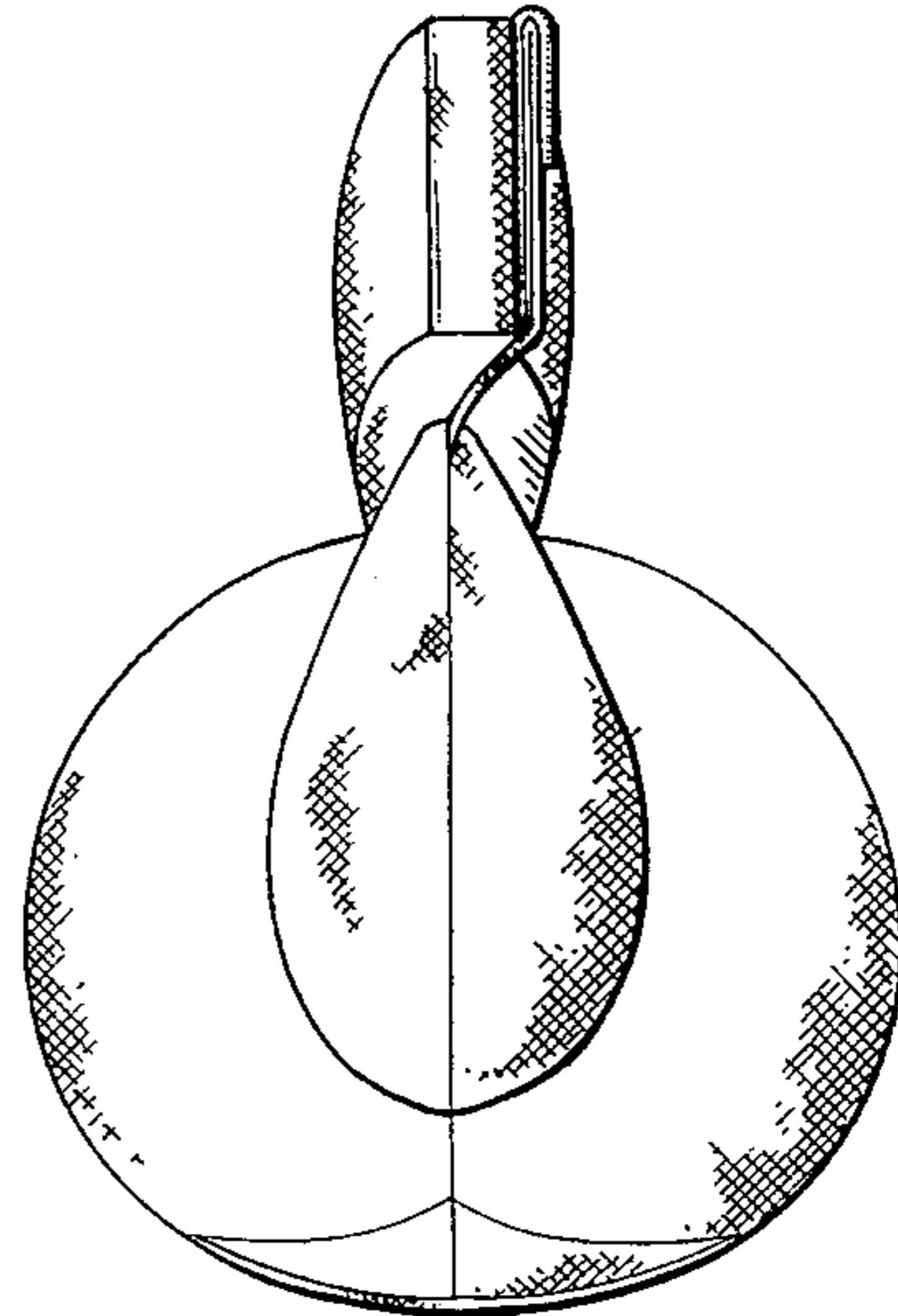
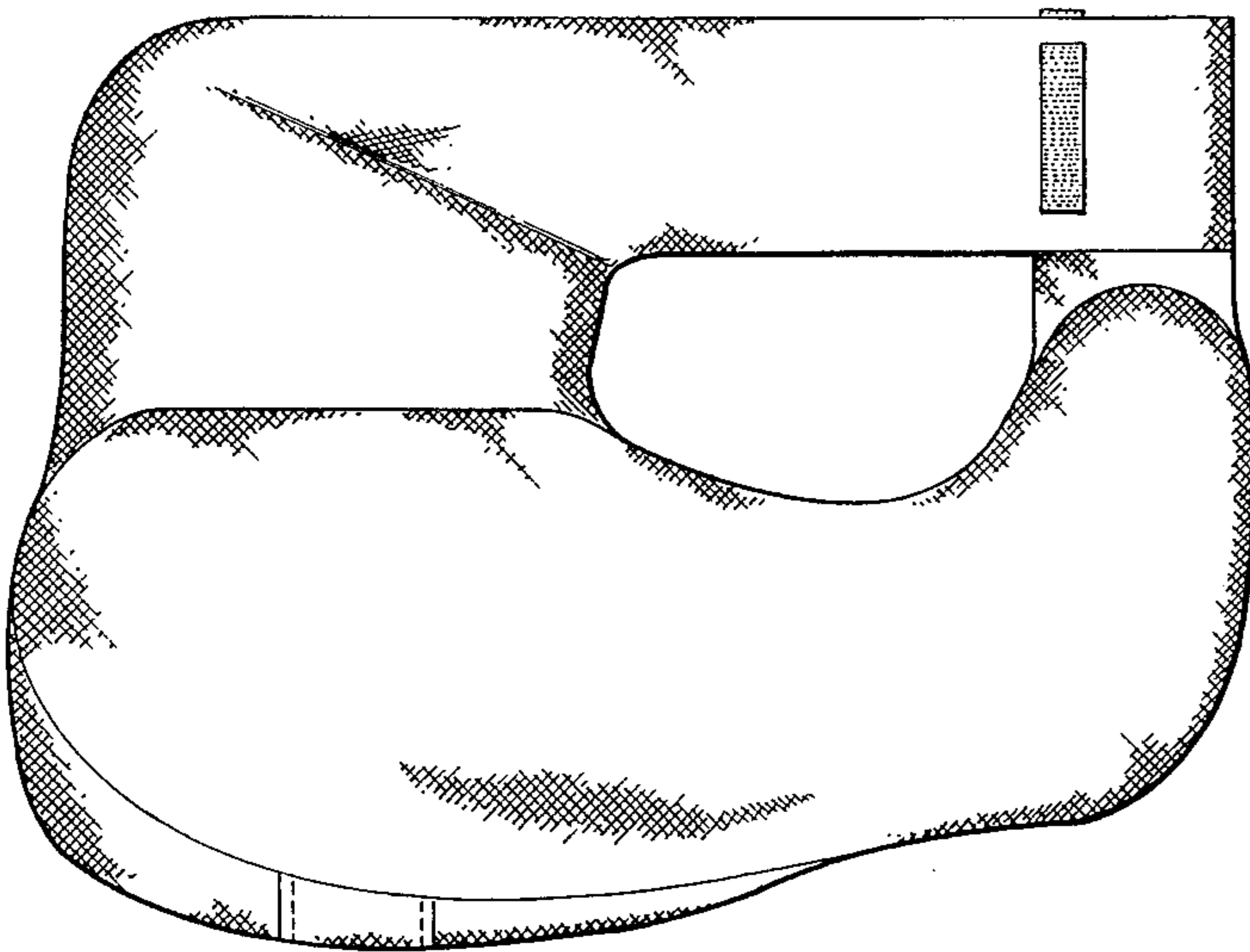
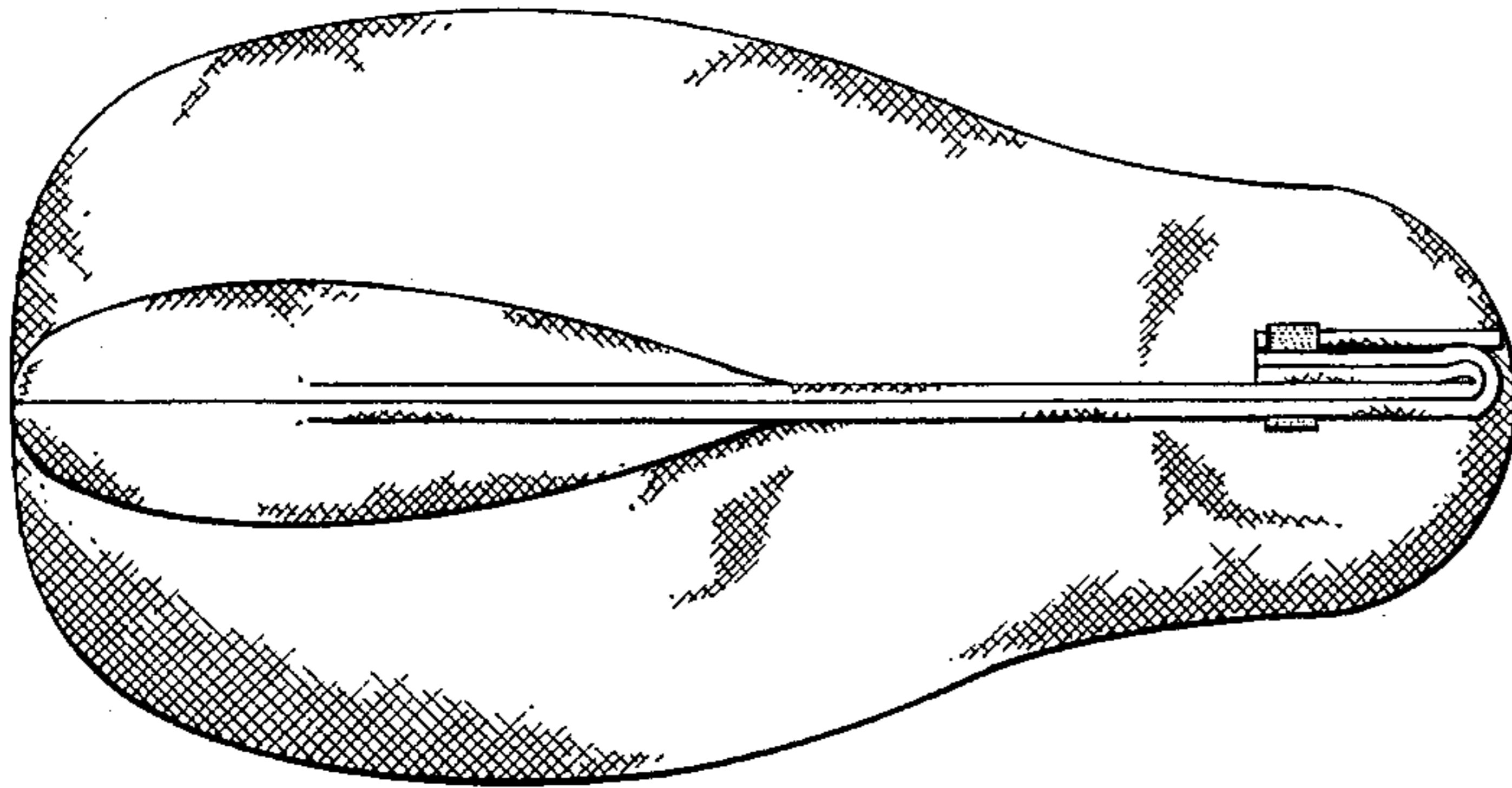
The ornamental design for a child's pillow, as shown and described.

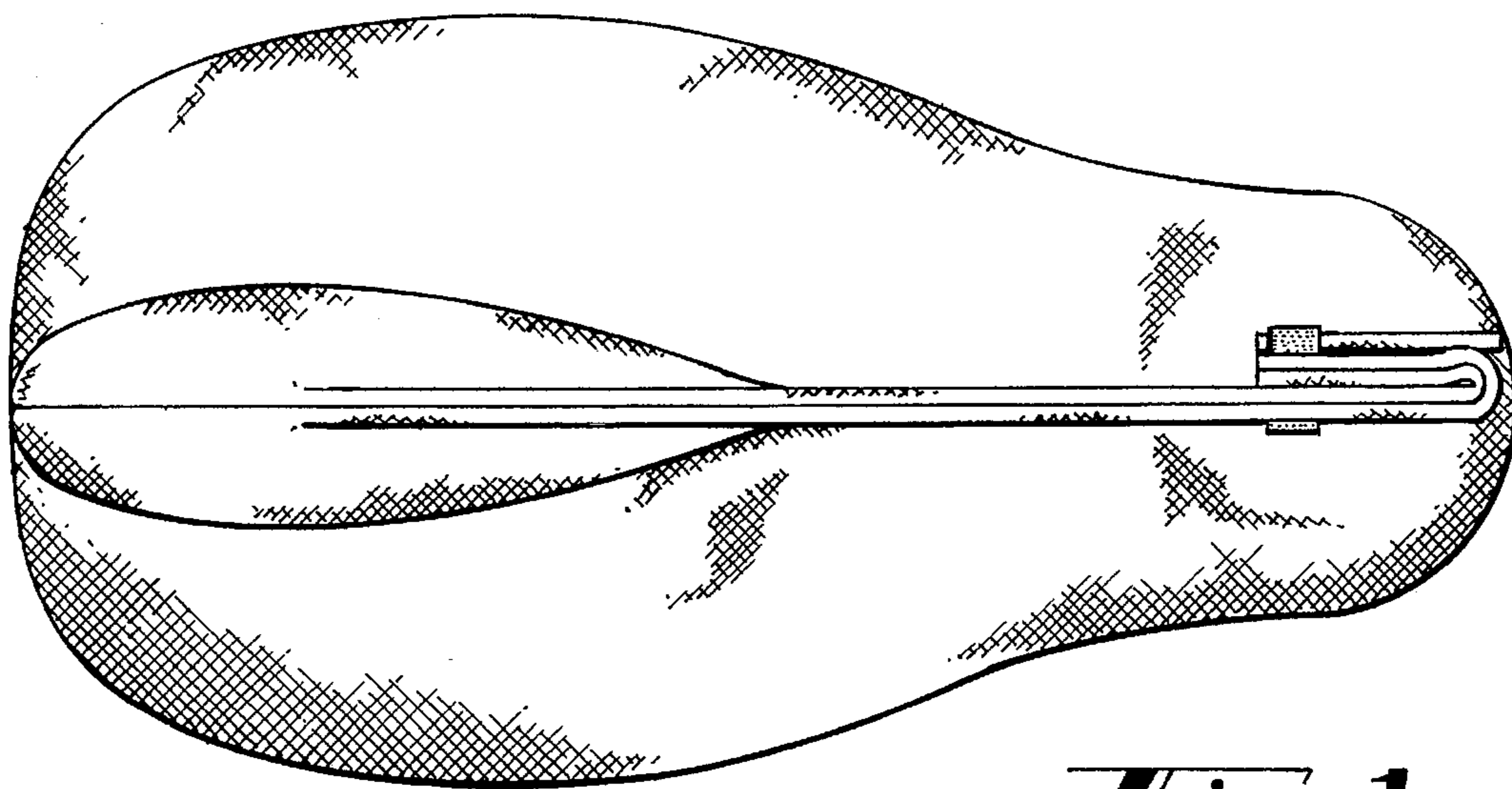

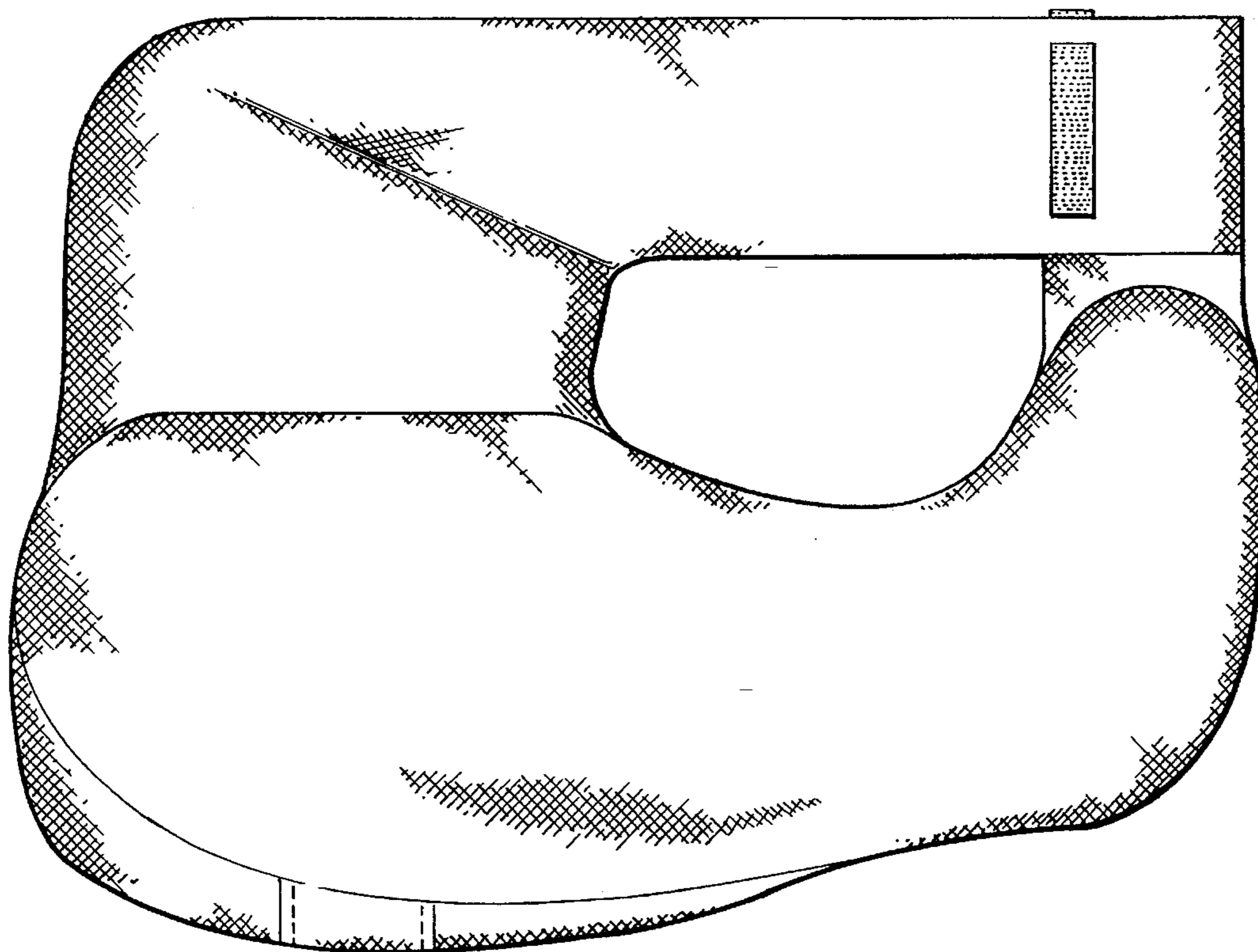

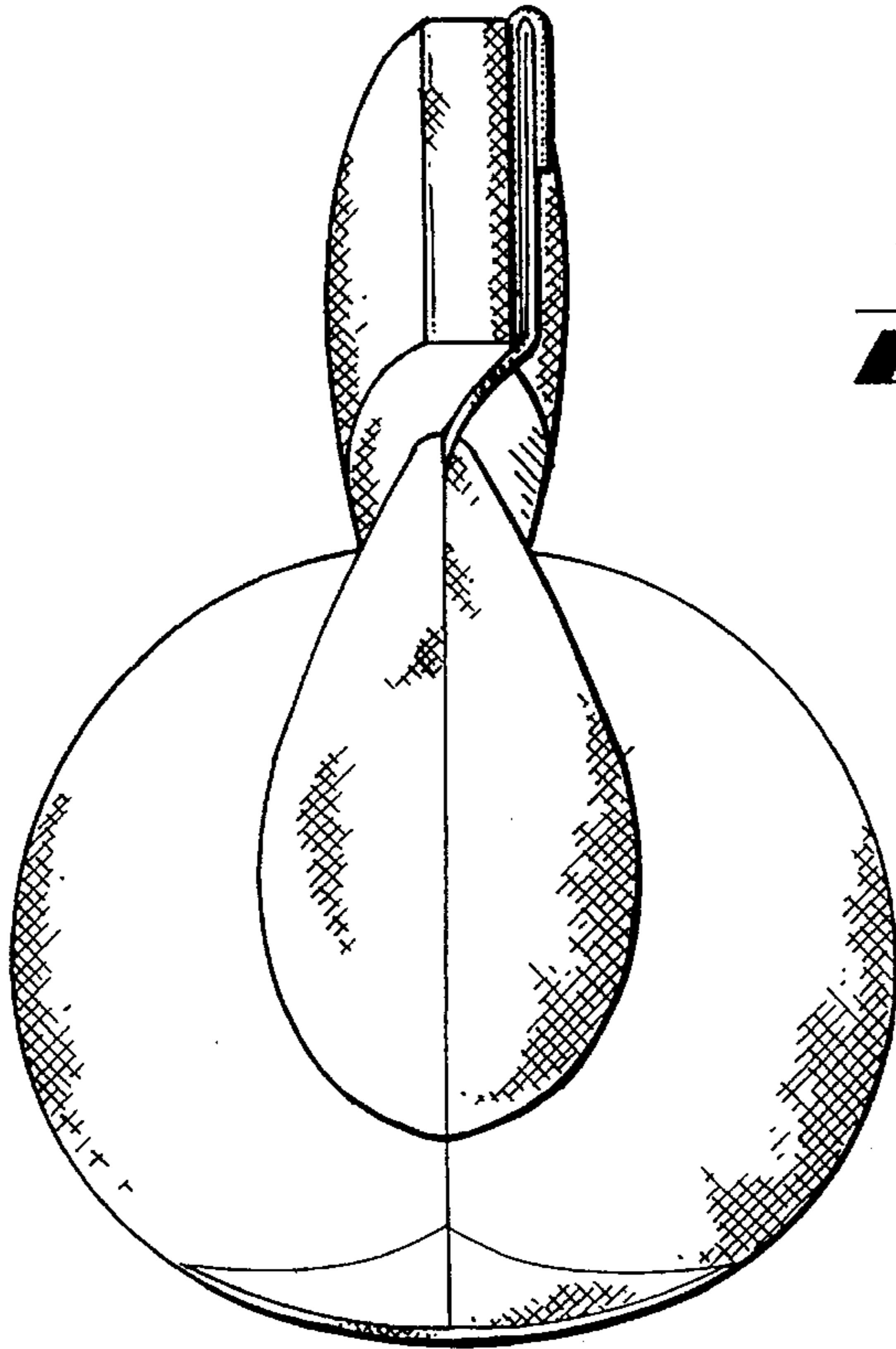
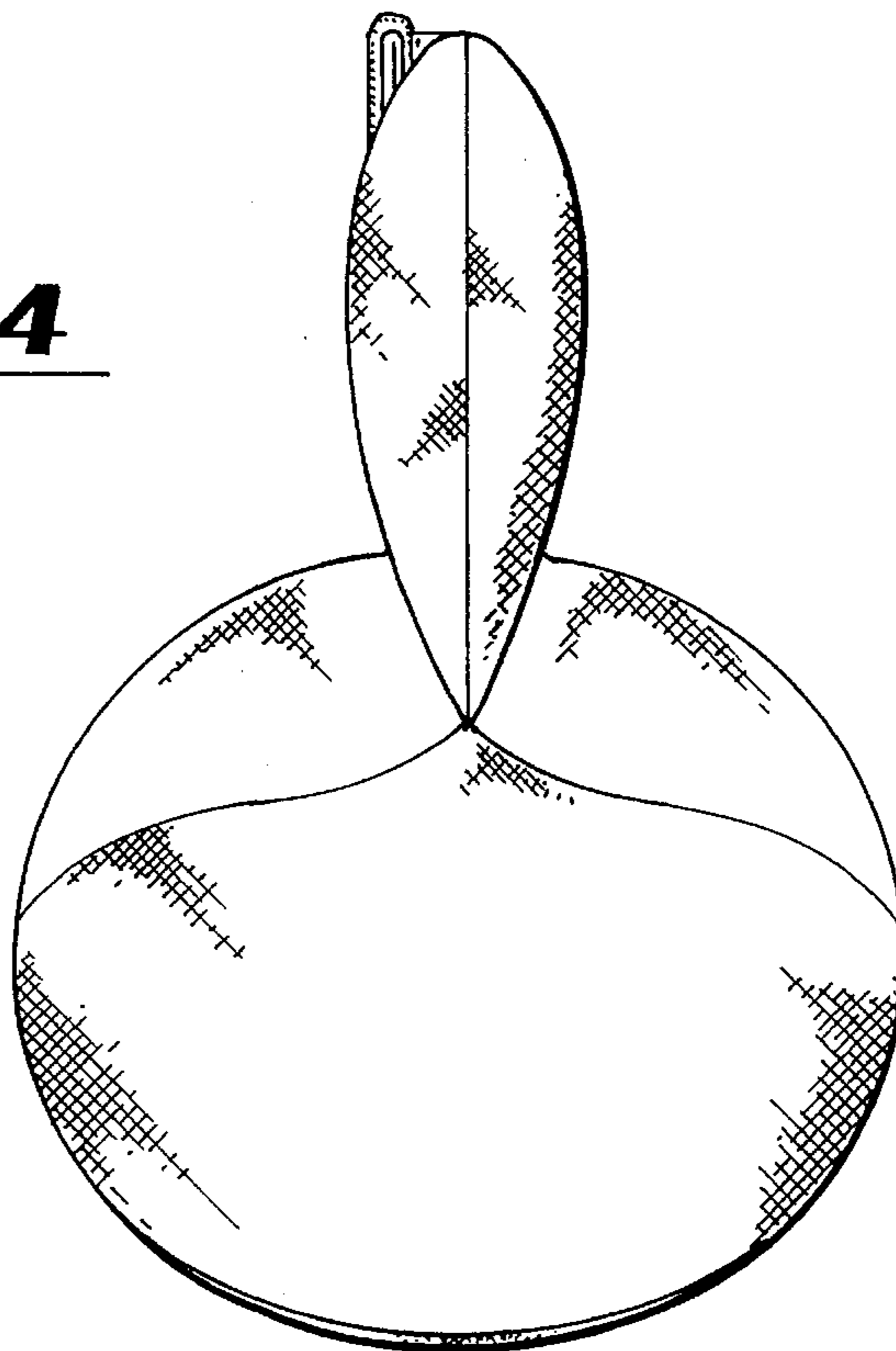

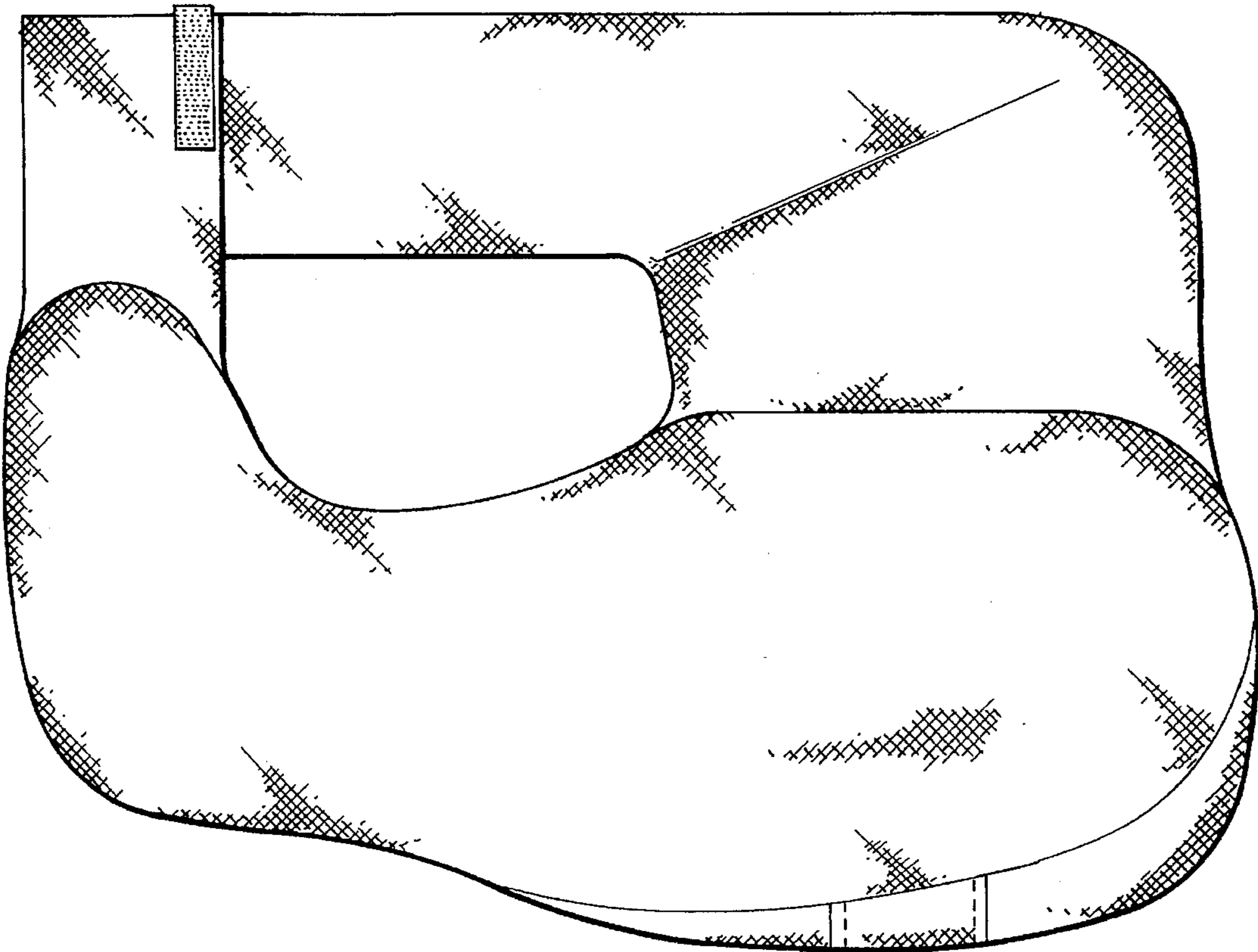

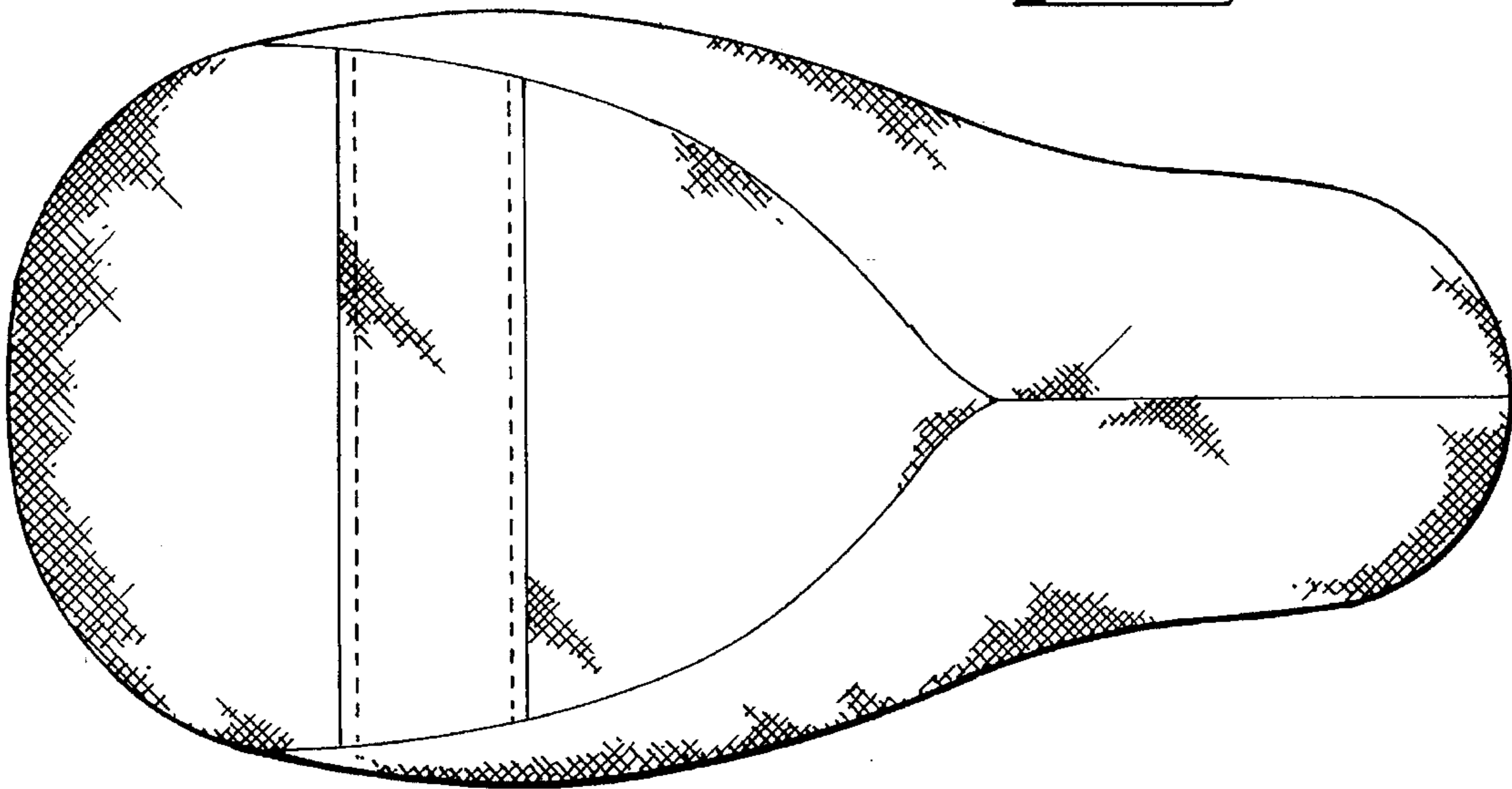
