FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1.

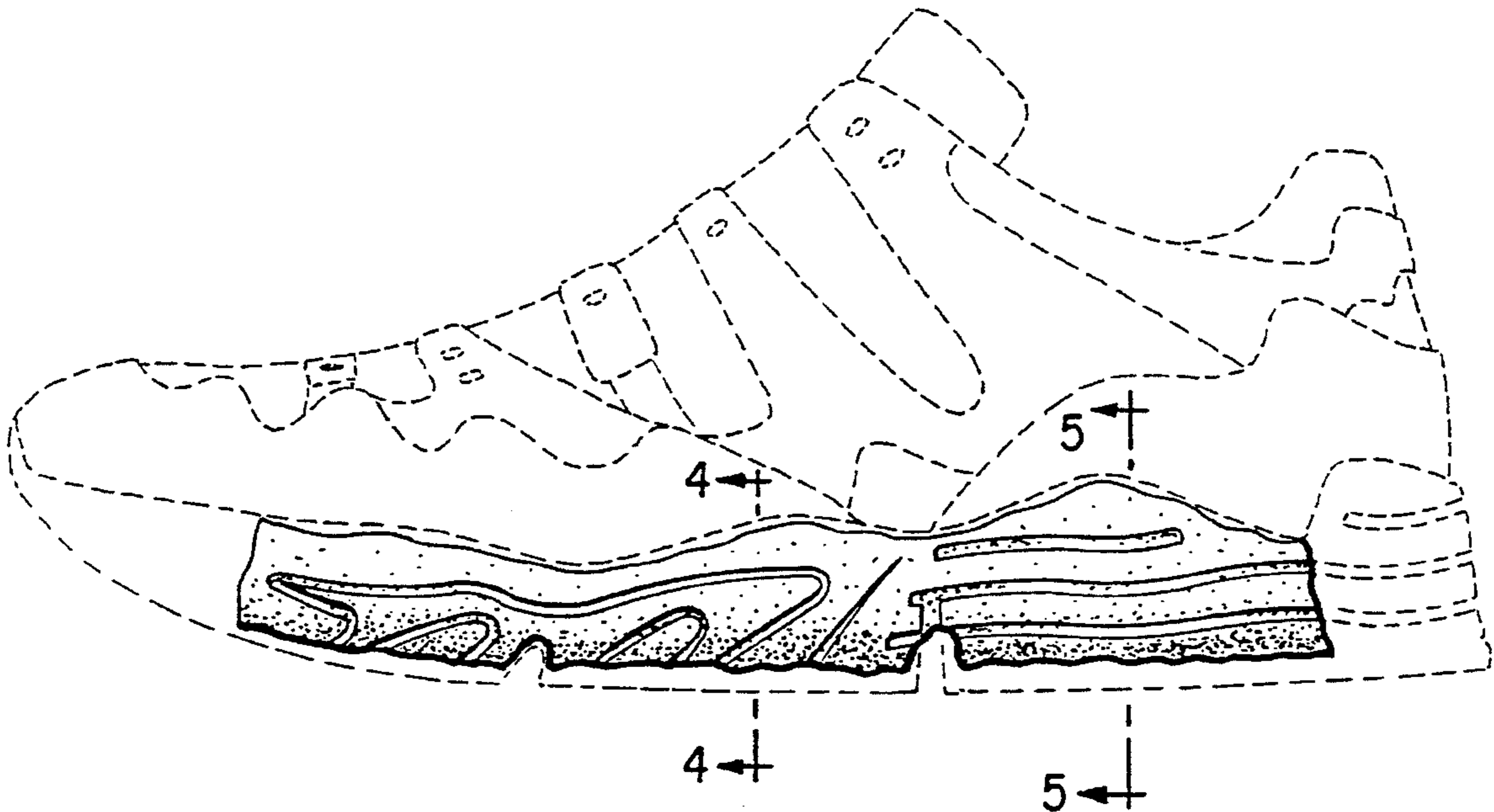

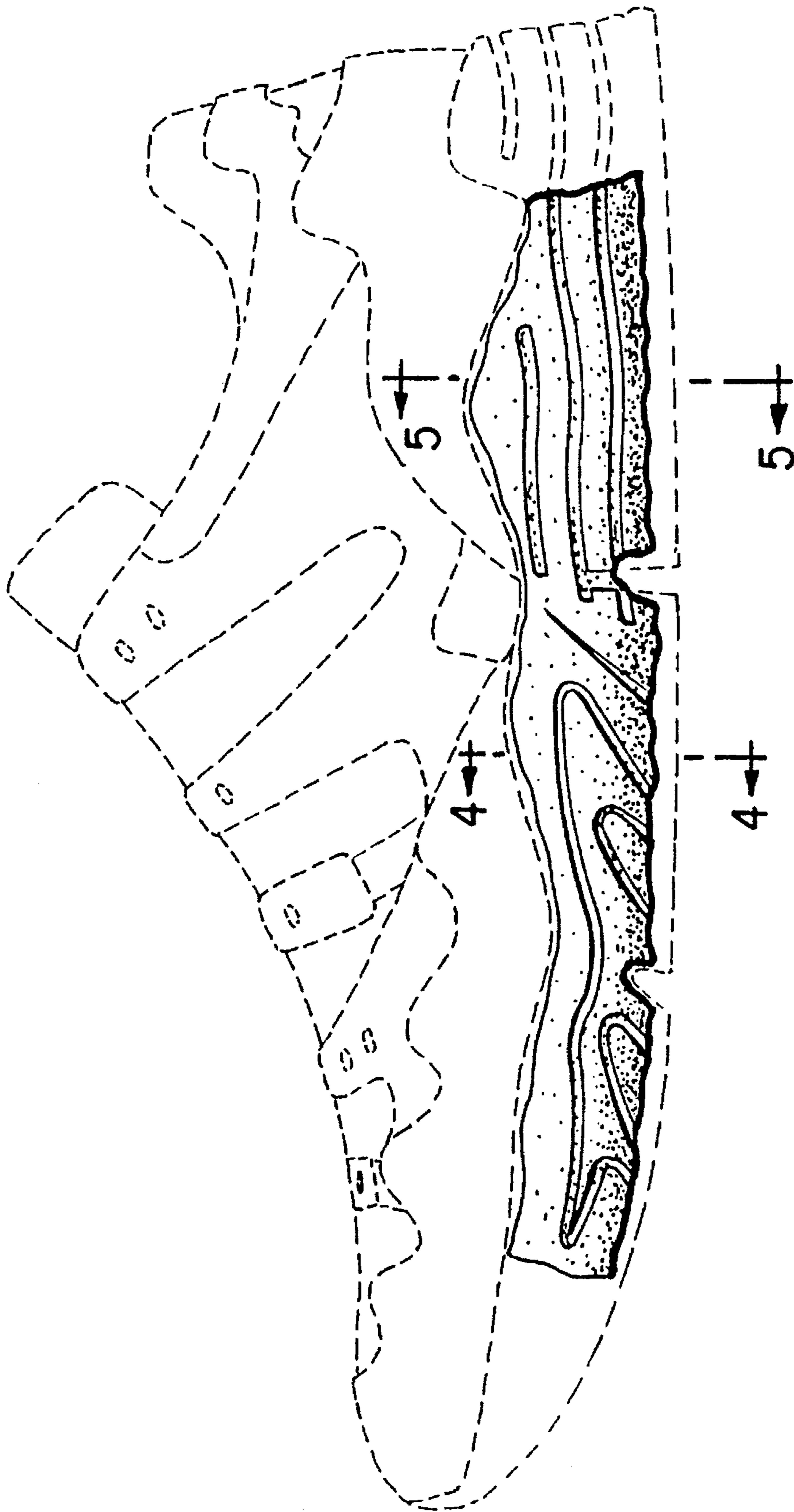

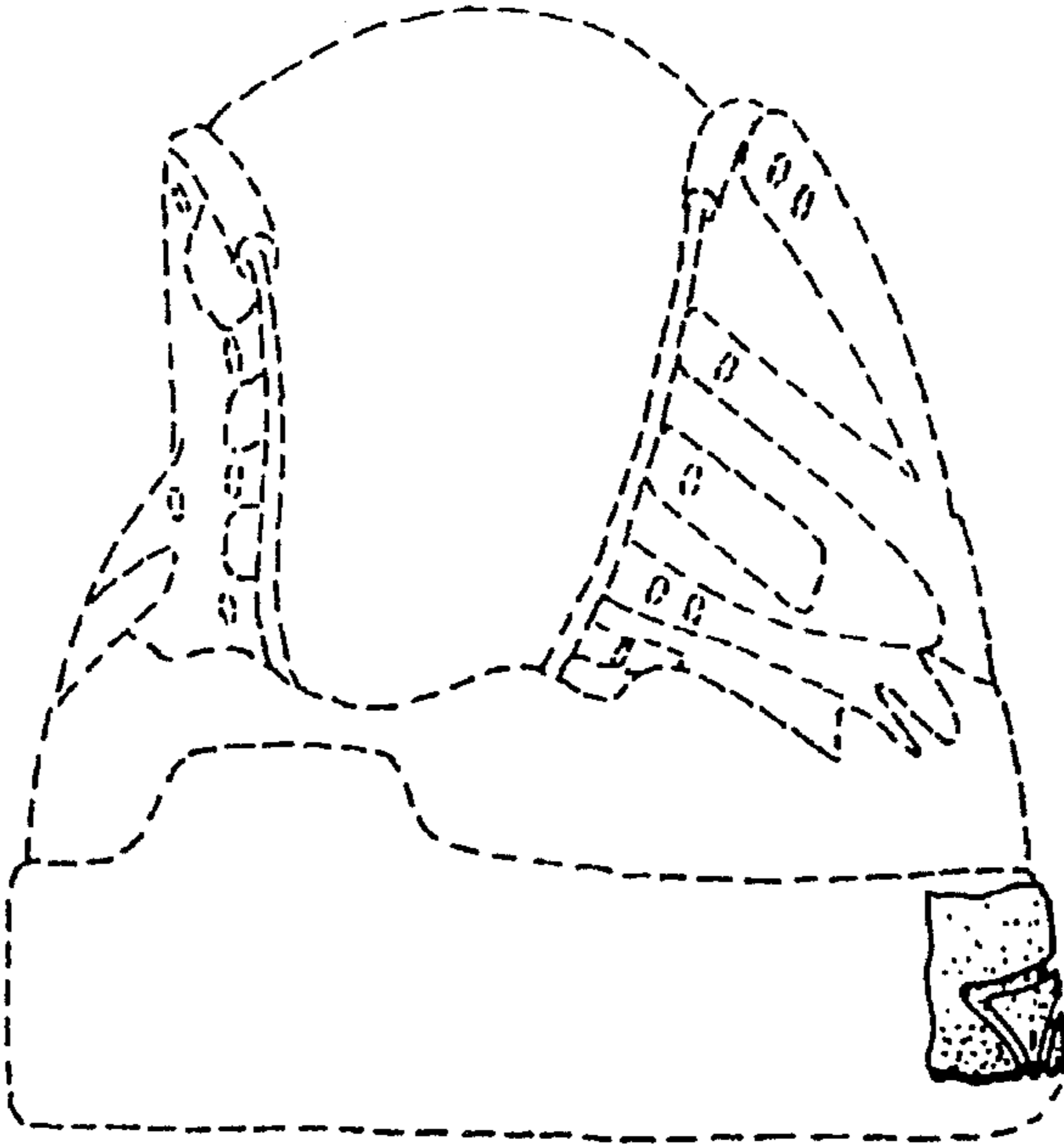

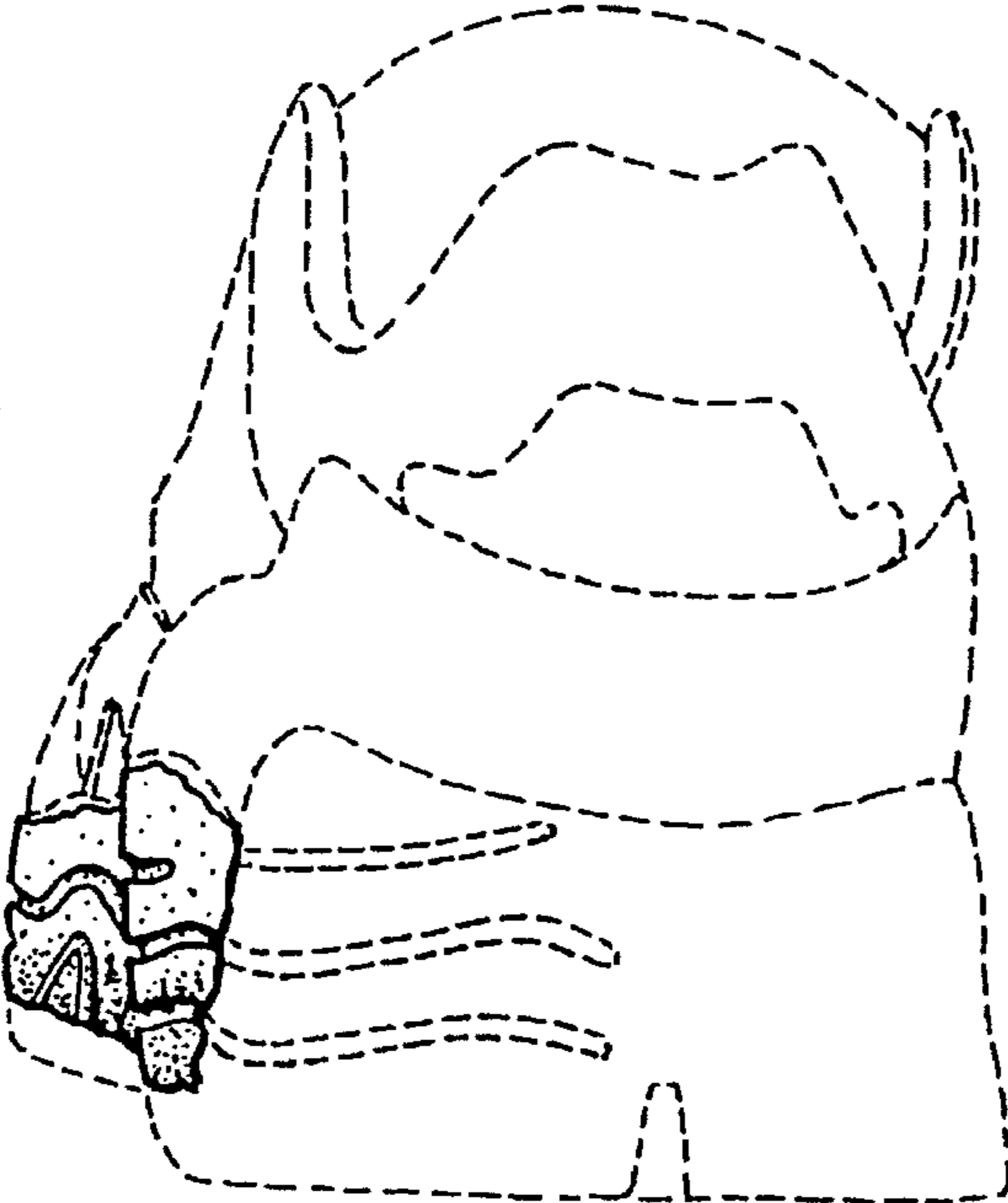
