DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a shoe upper showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof;

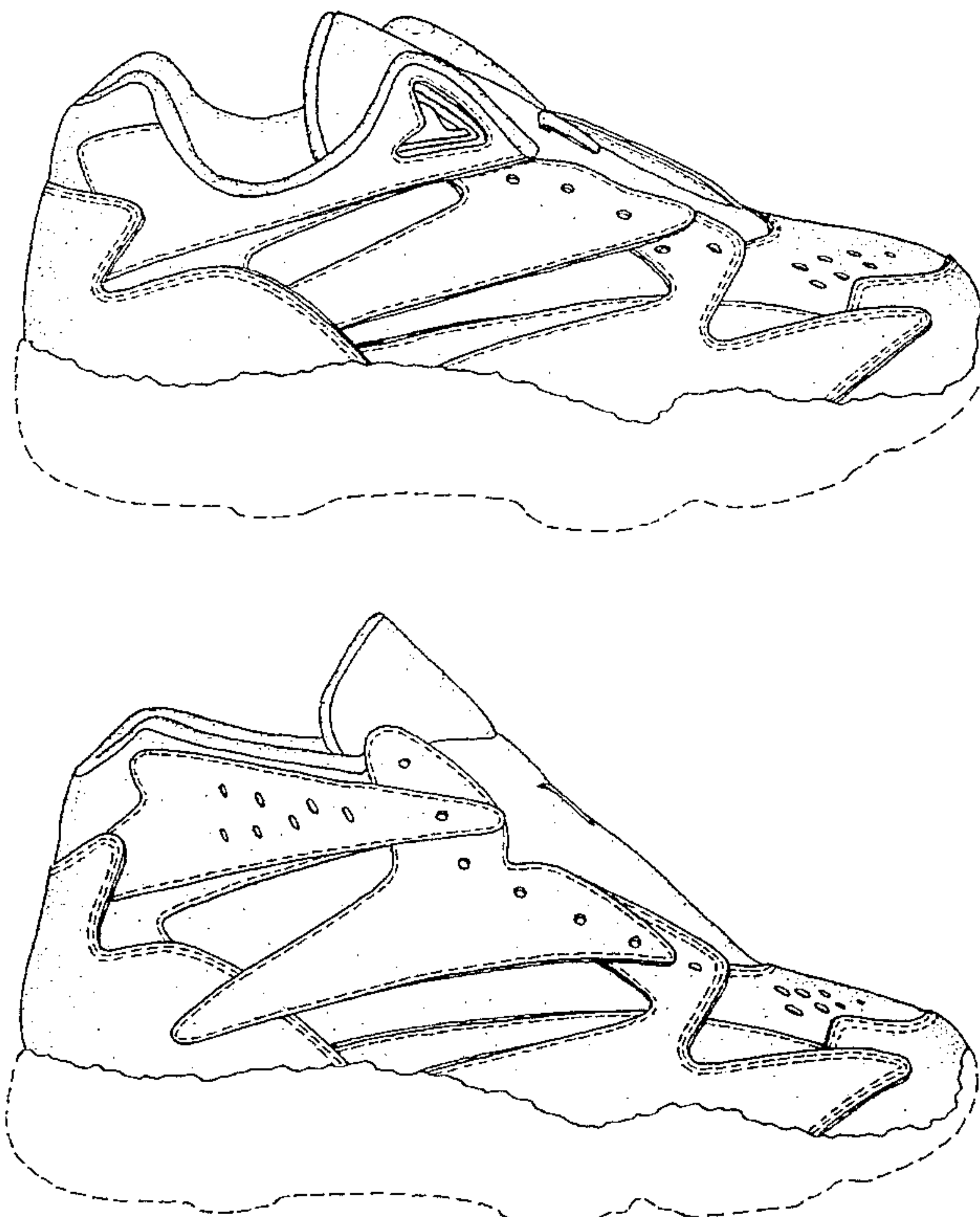
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof;

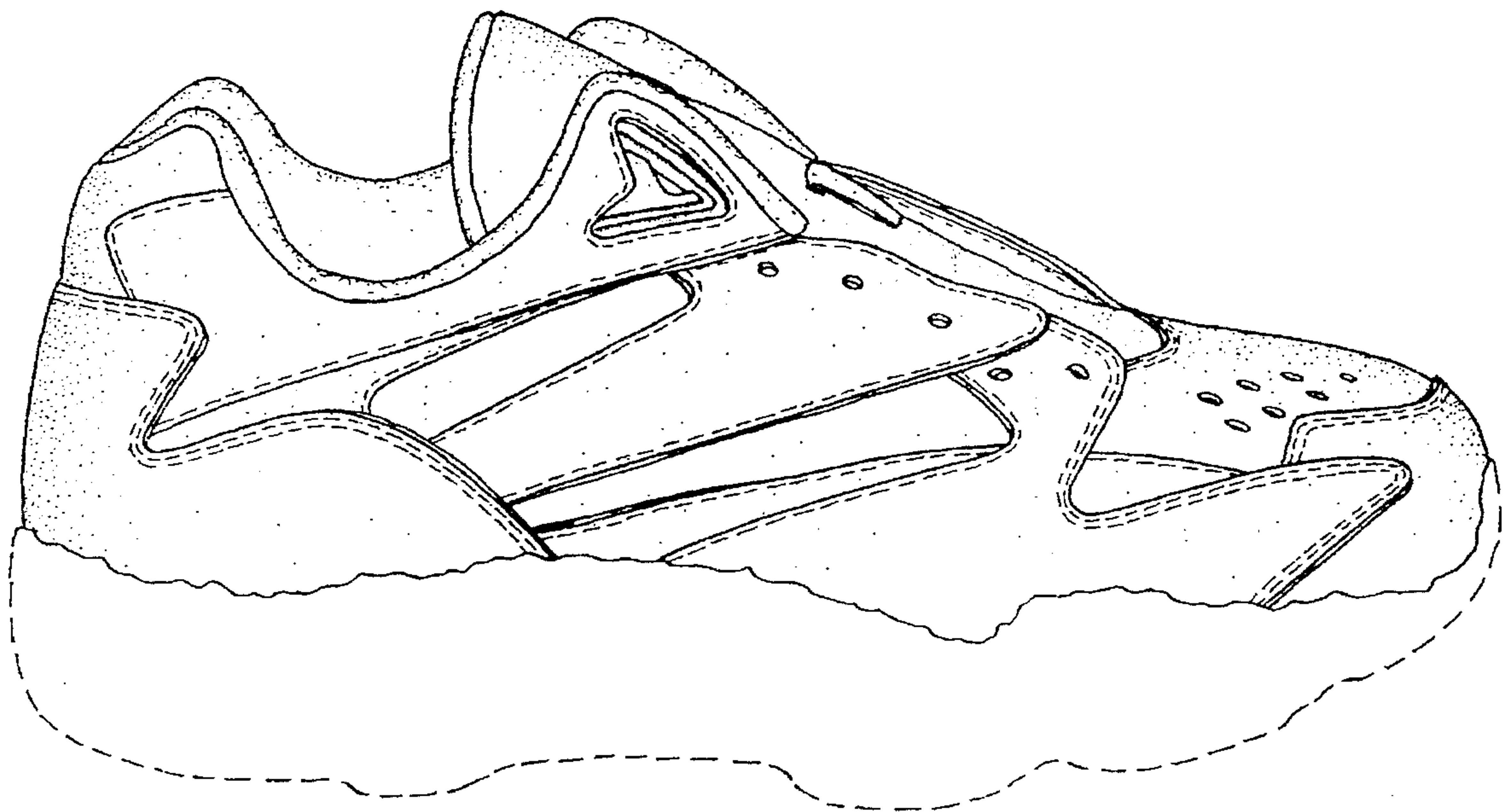

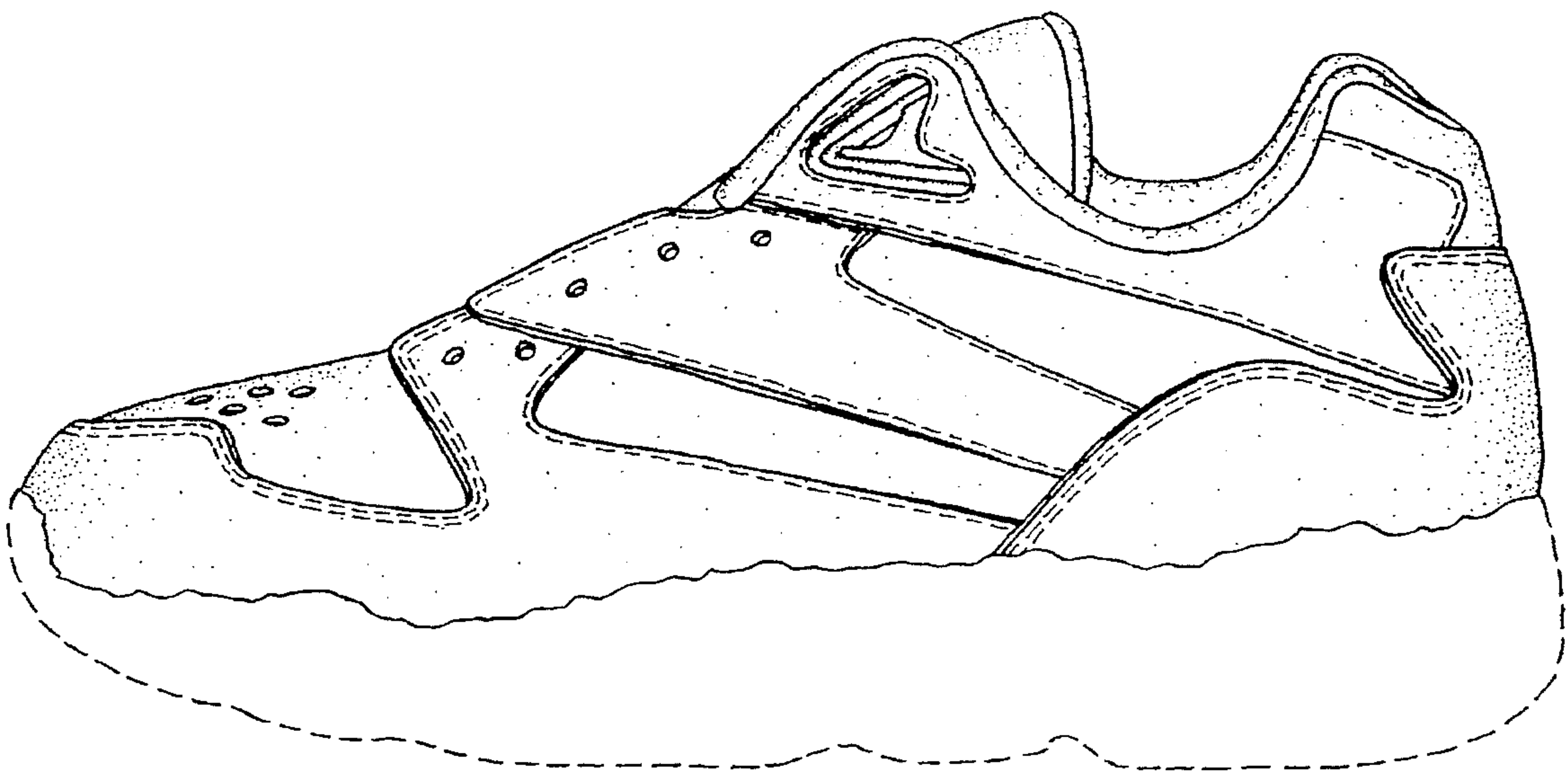

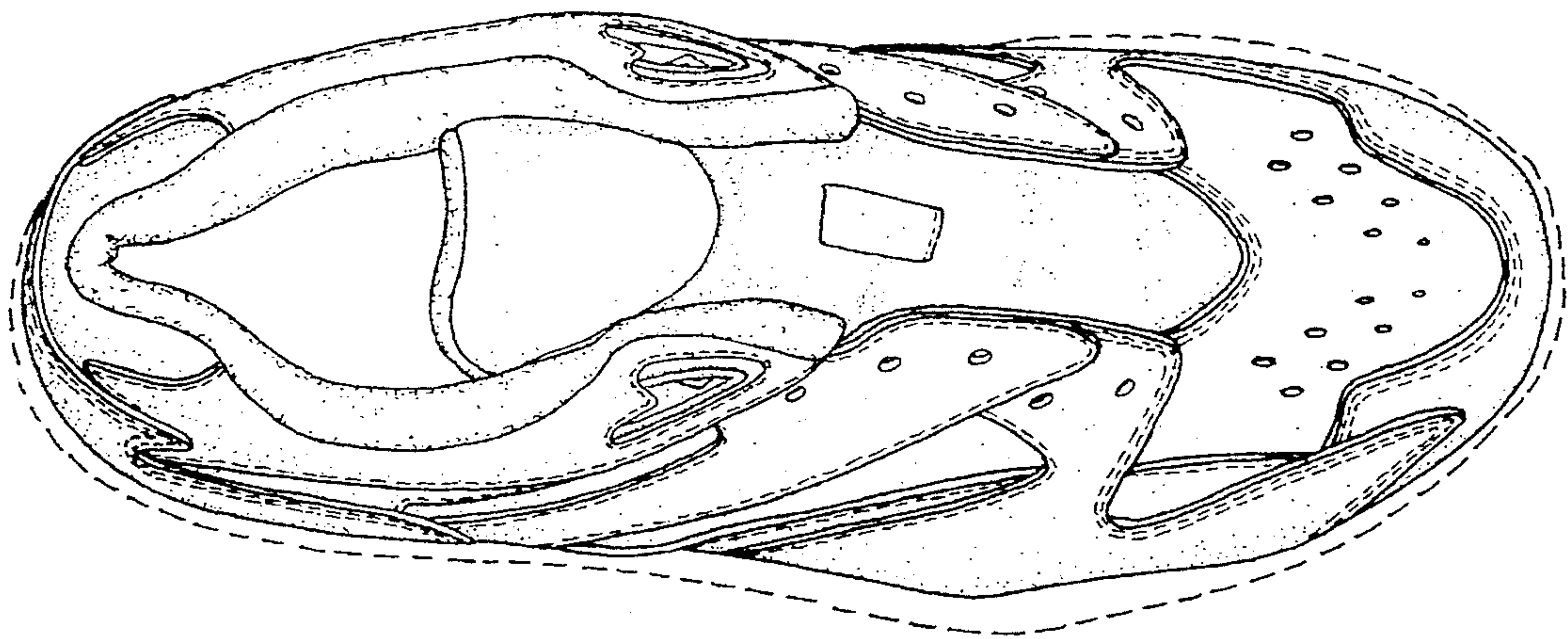

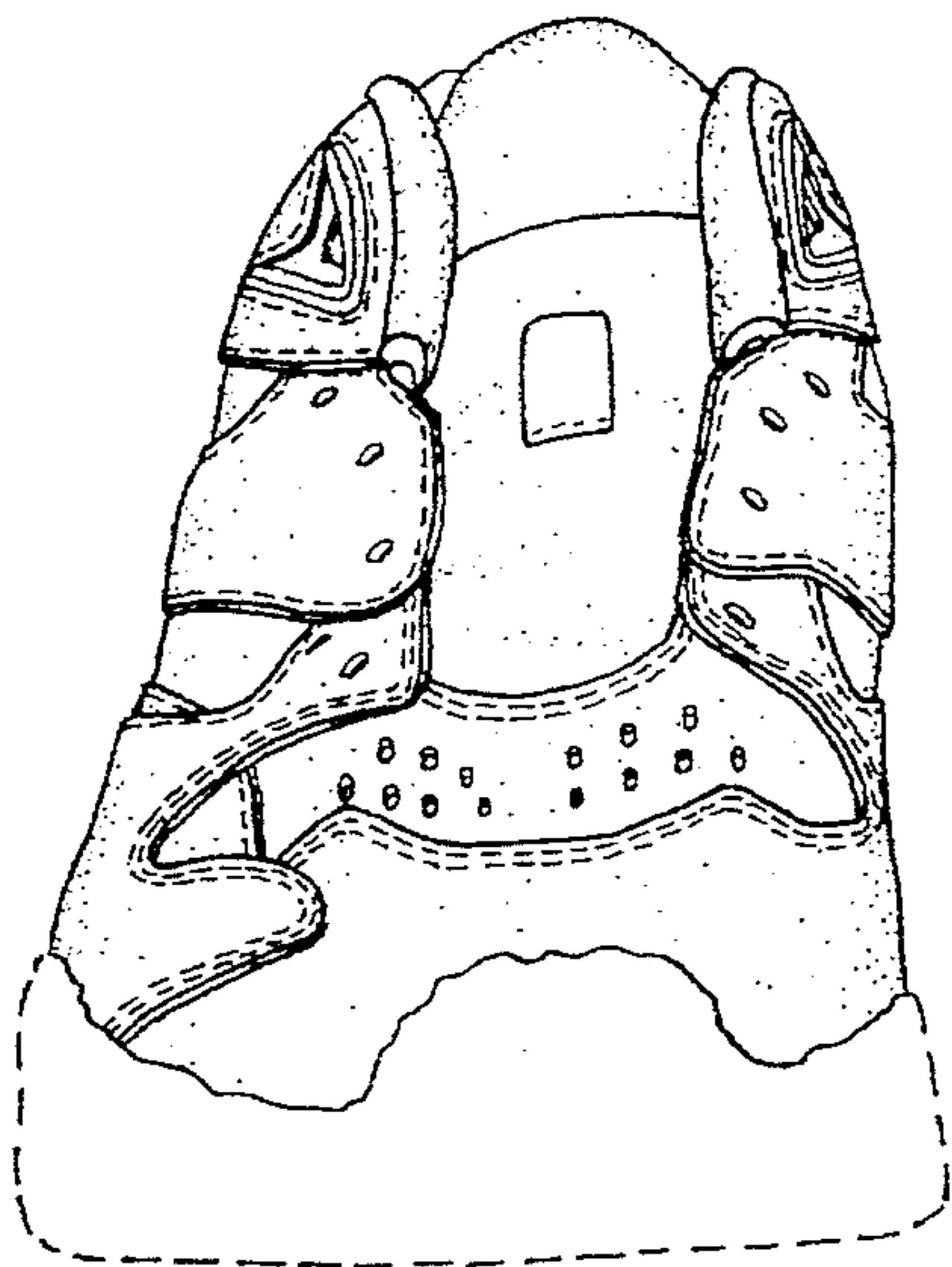

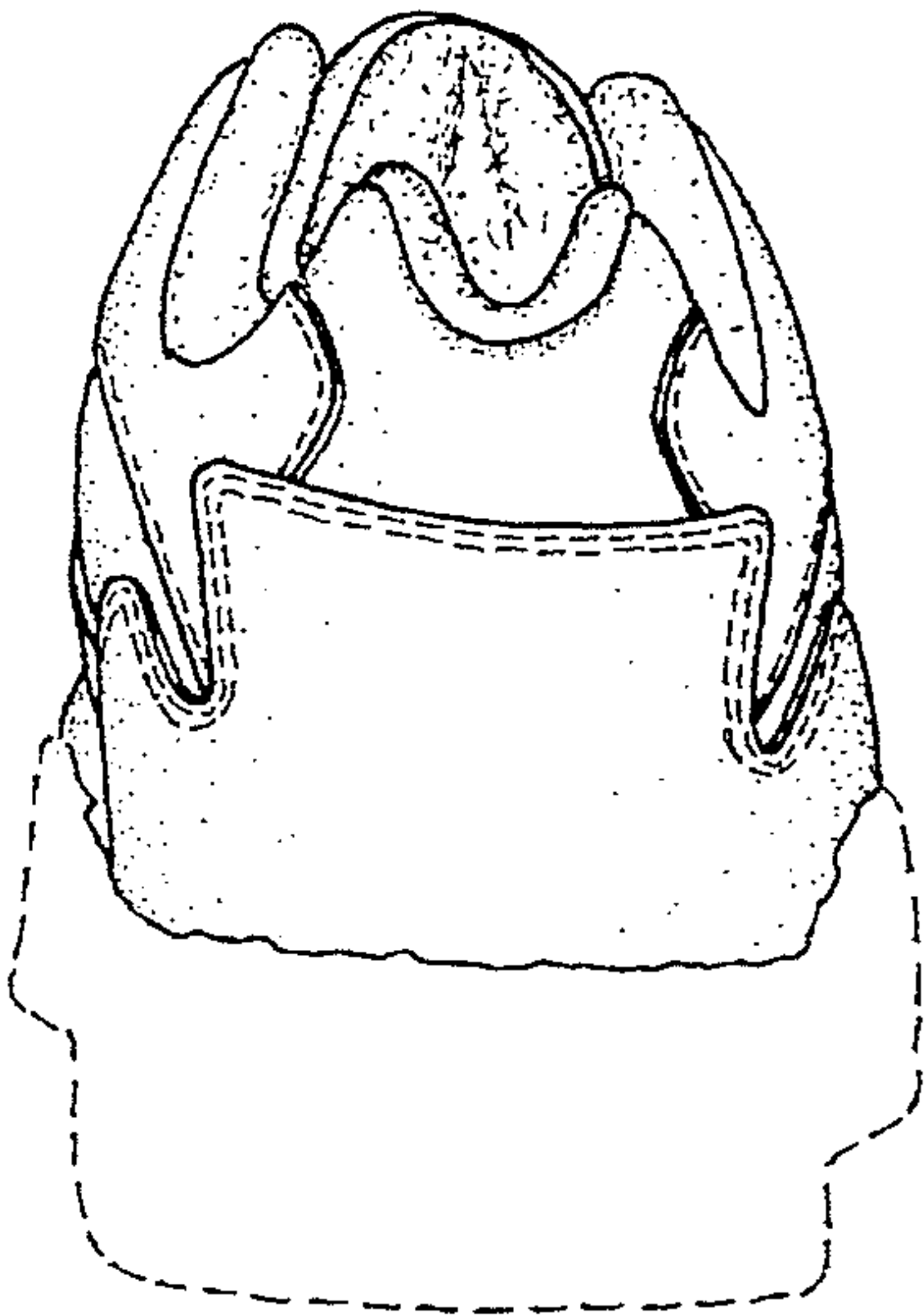

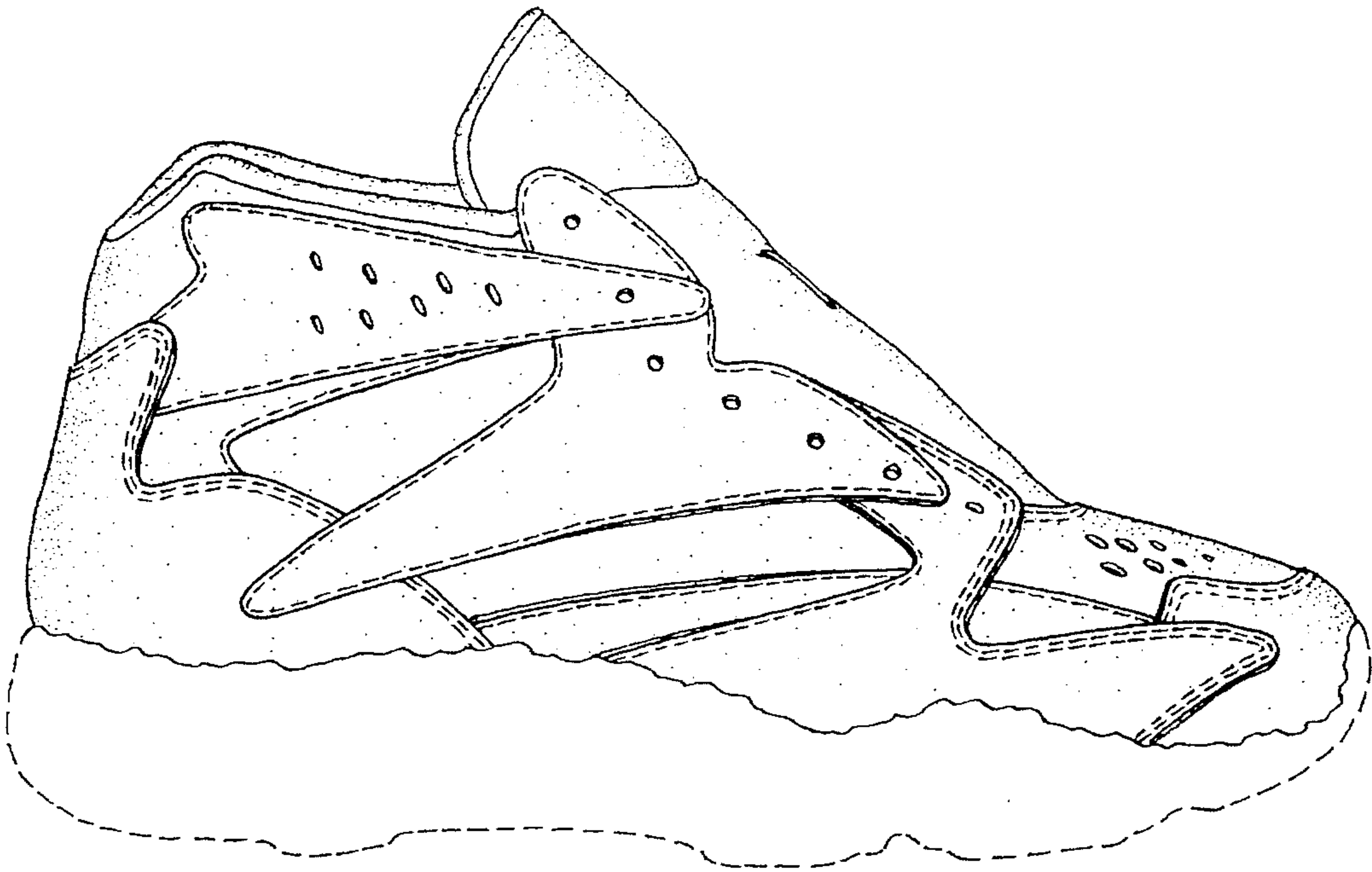

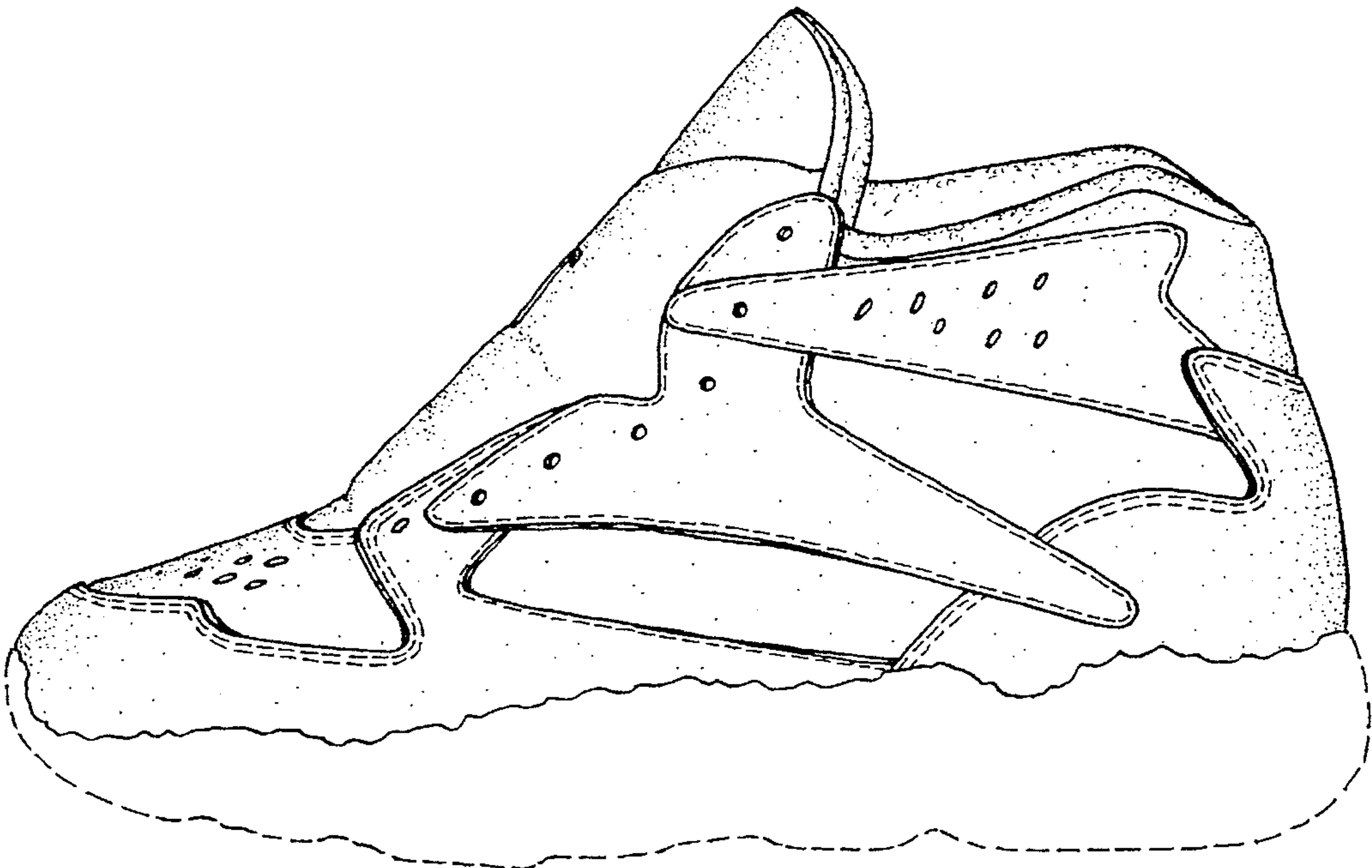

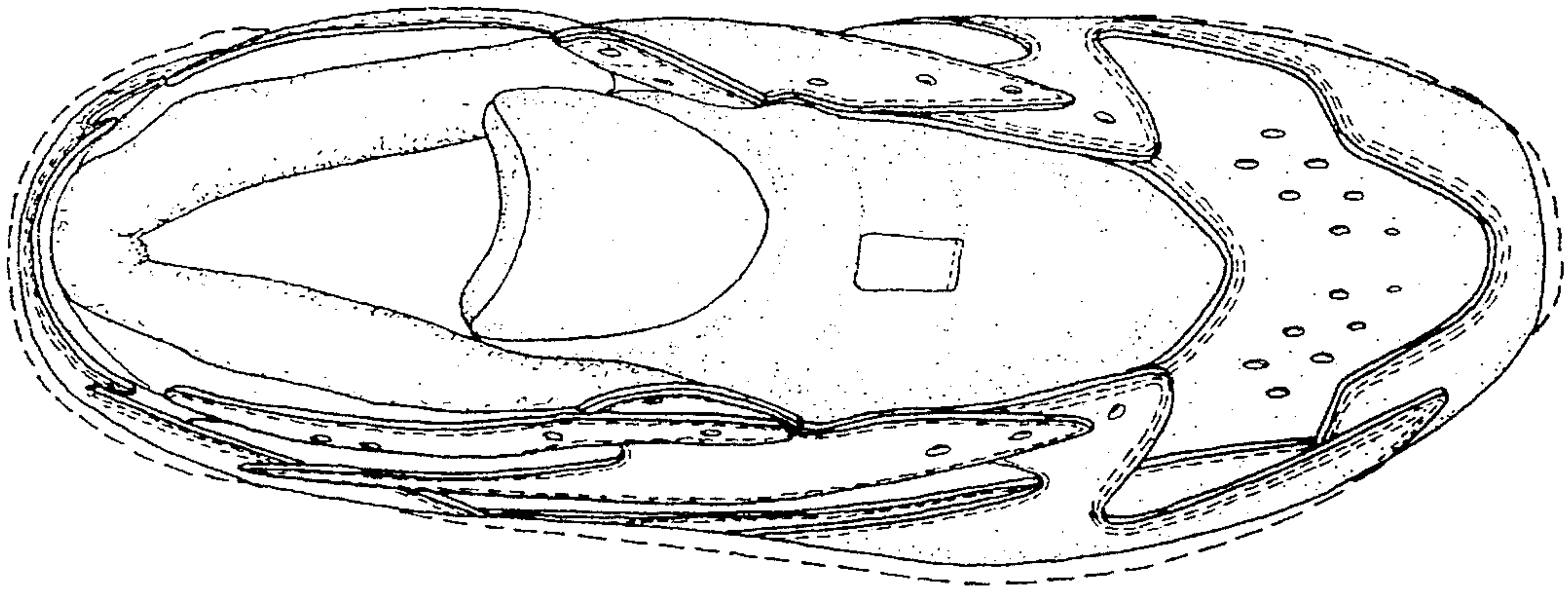

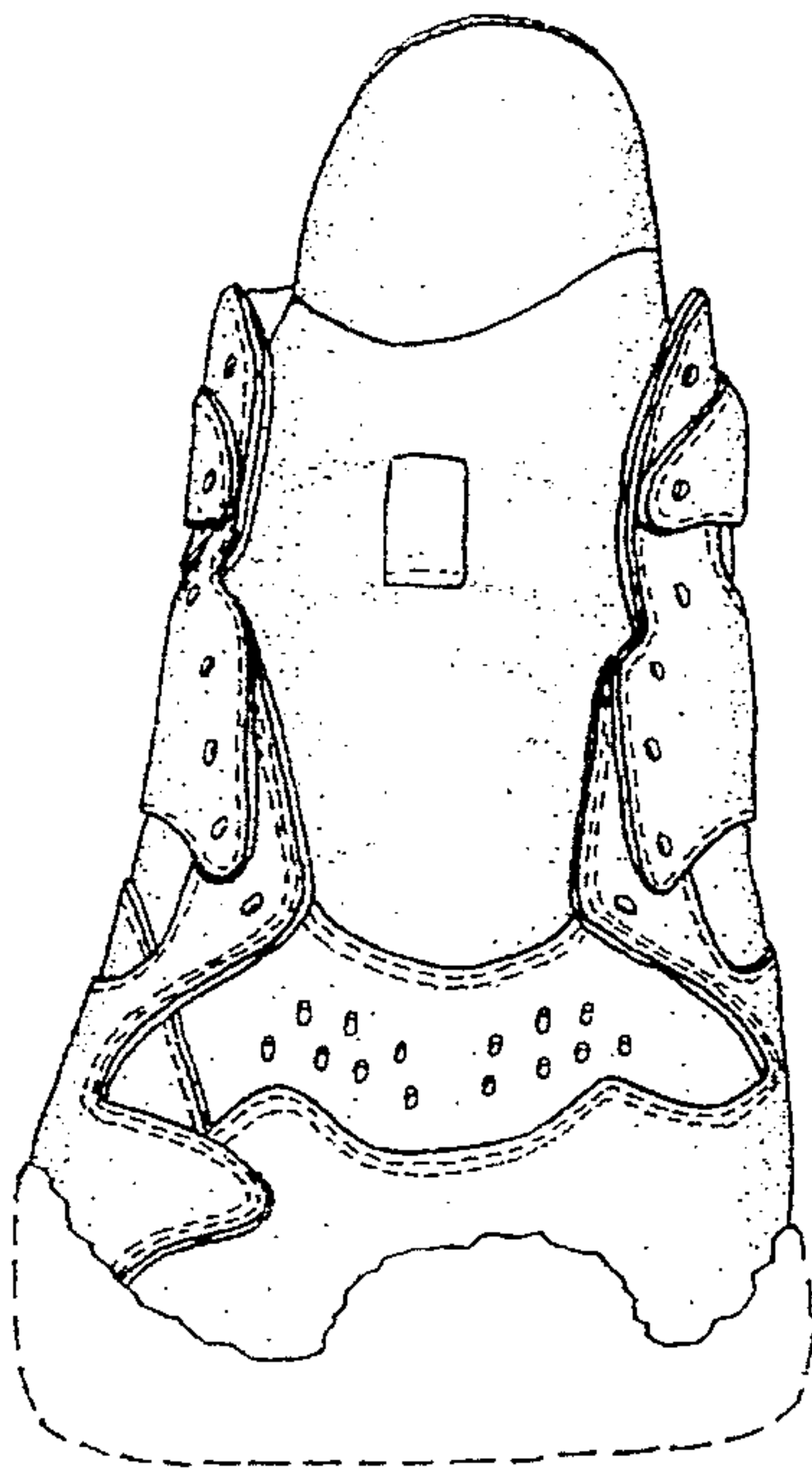

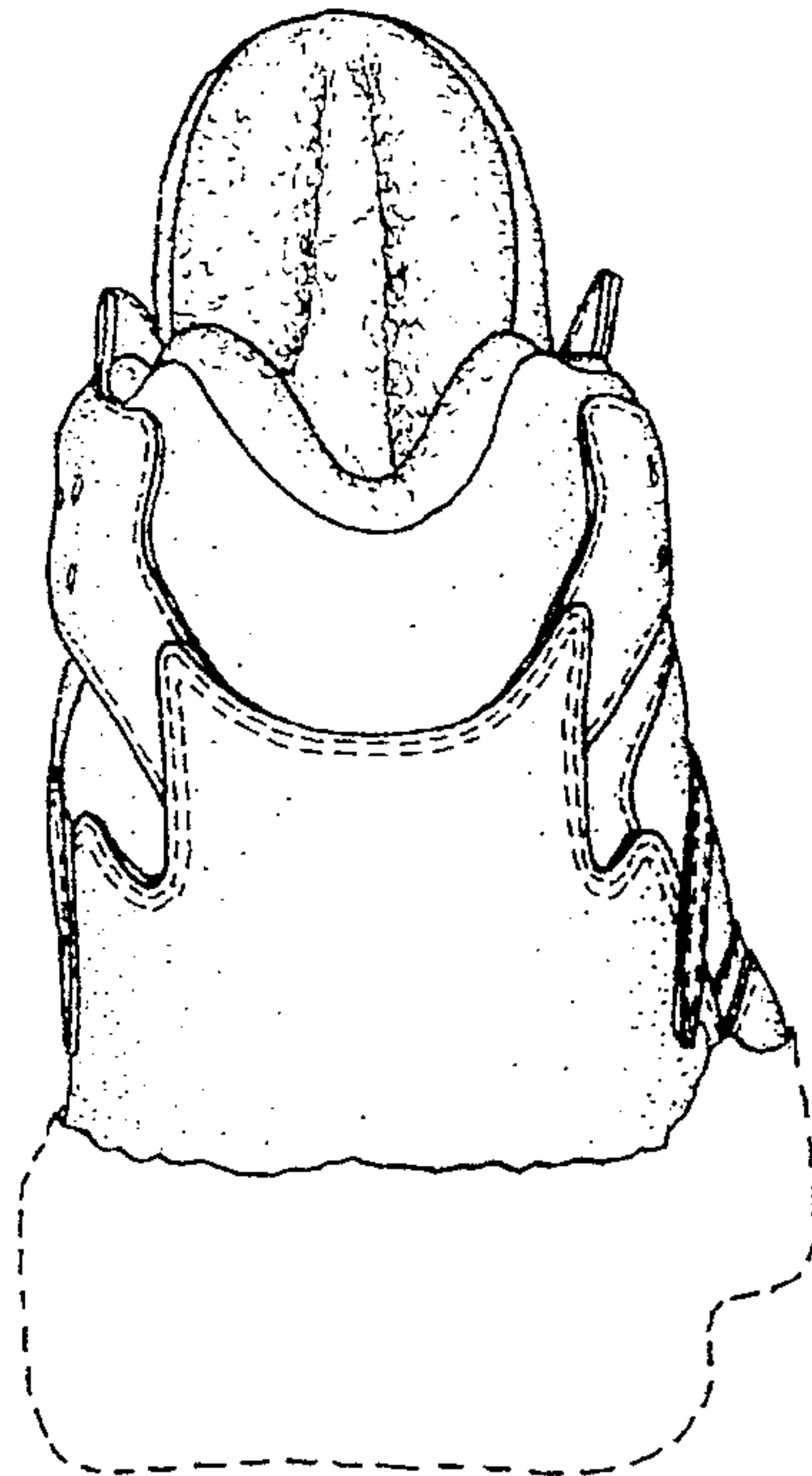
