[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a canister for shaving items, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the canister for shaving items showing the new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an exploded perspective view of a removable top component and base component thereof with the broken line showing of shaving items for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of a removable top component thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a base component thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

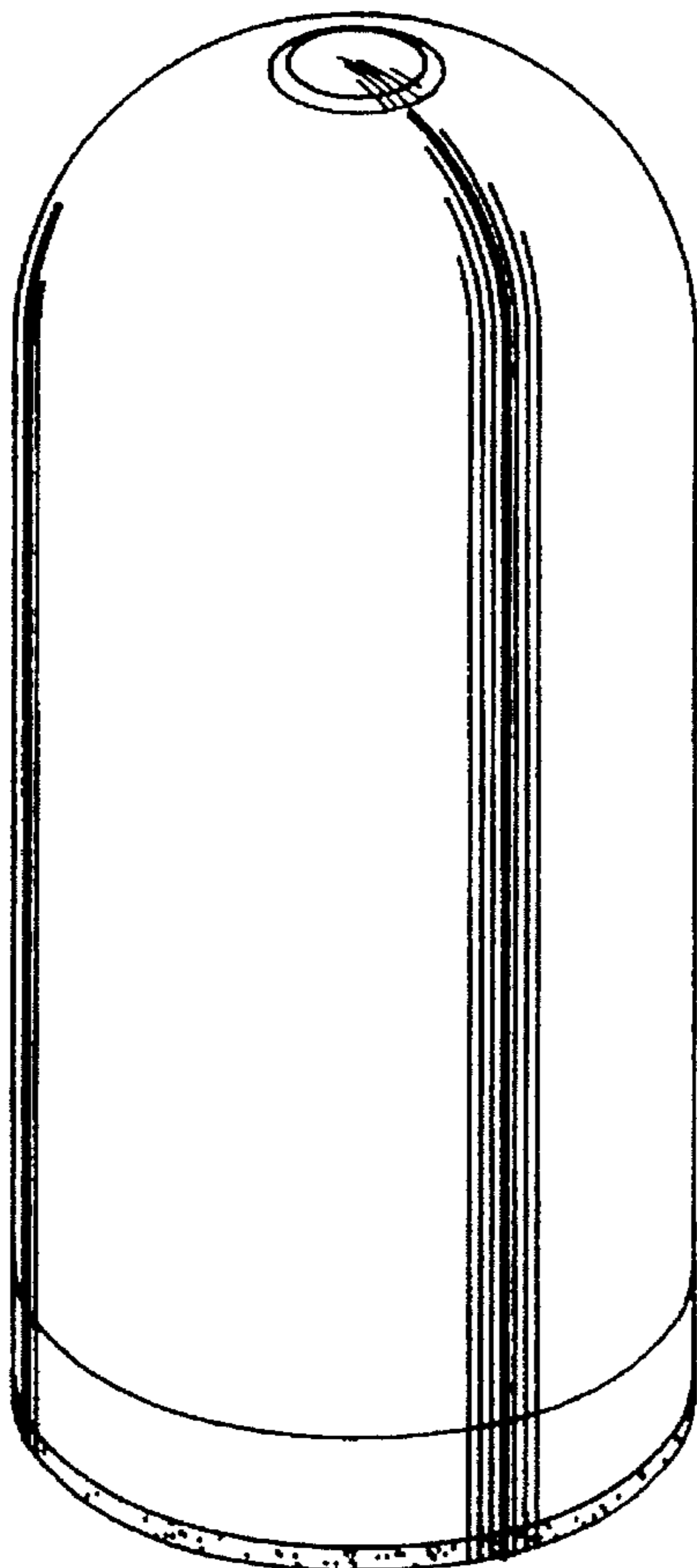

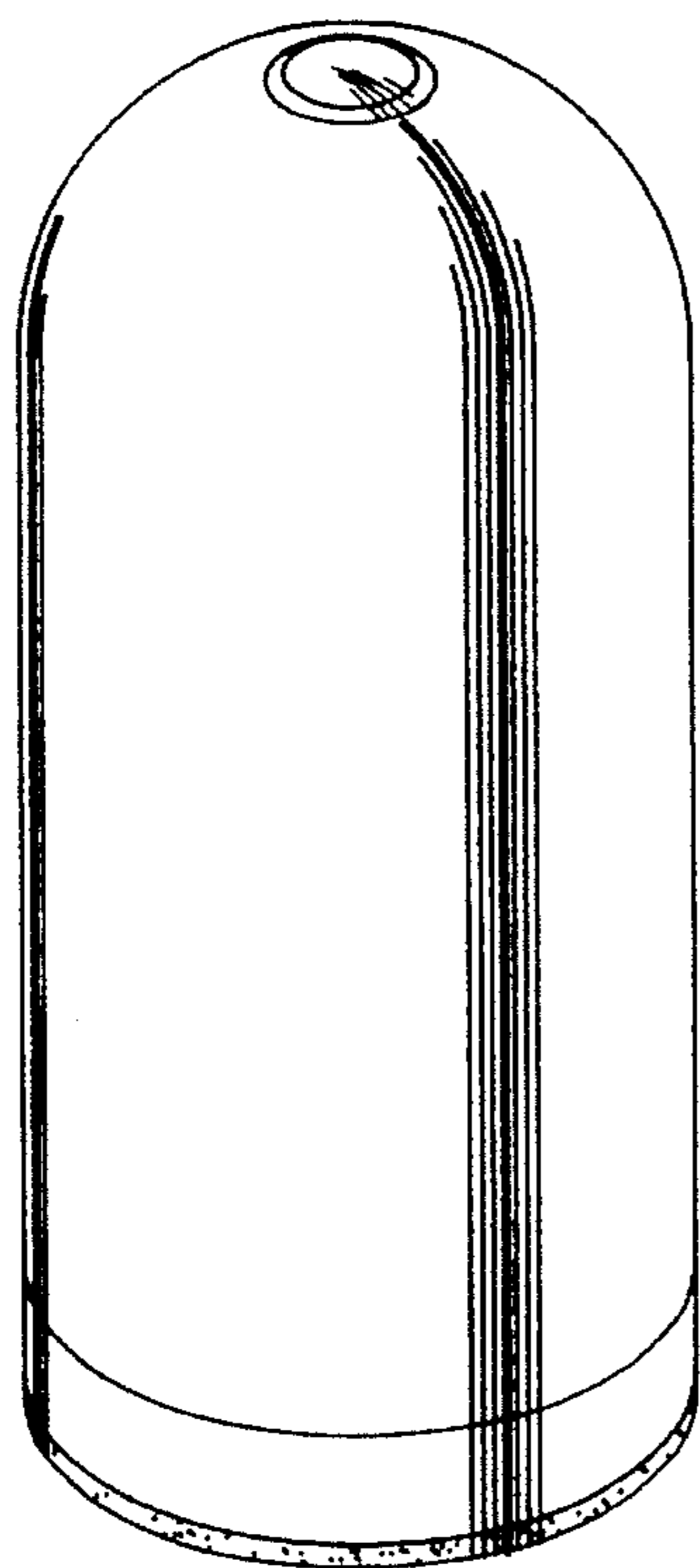

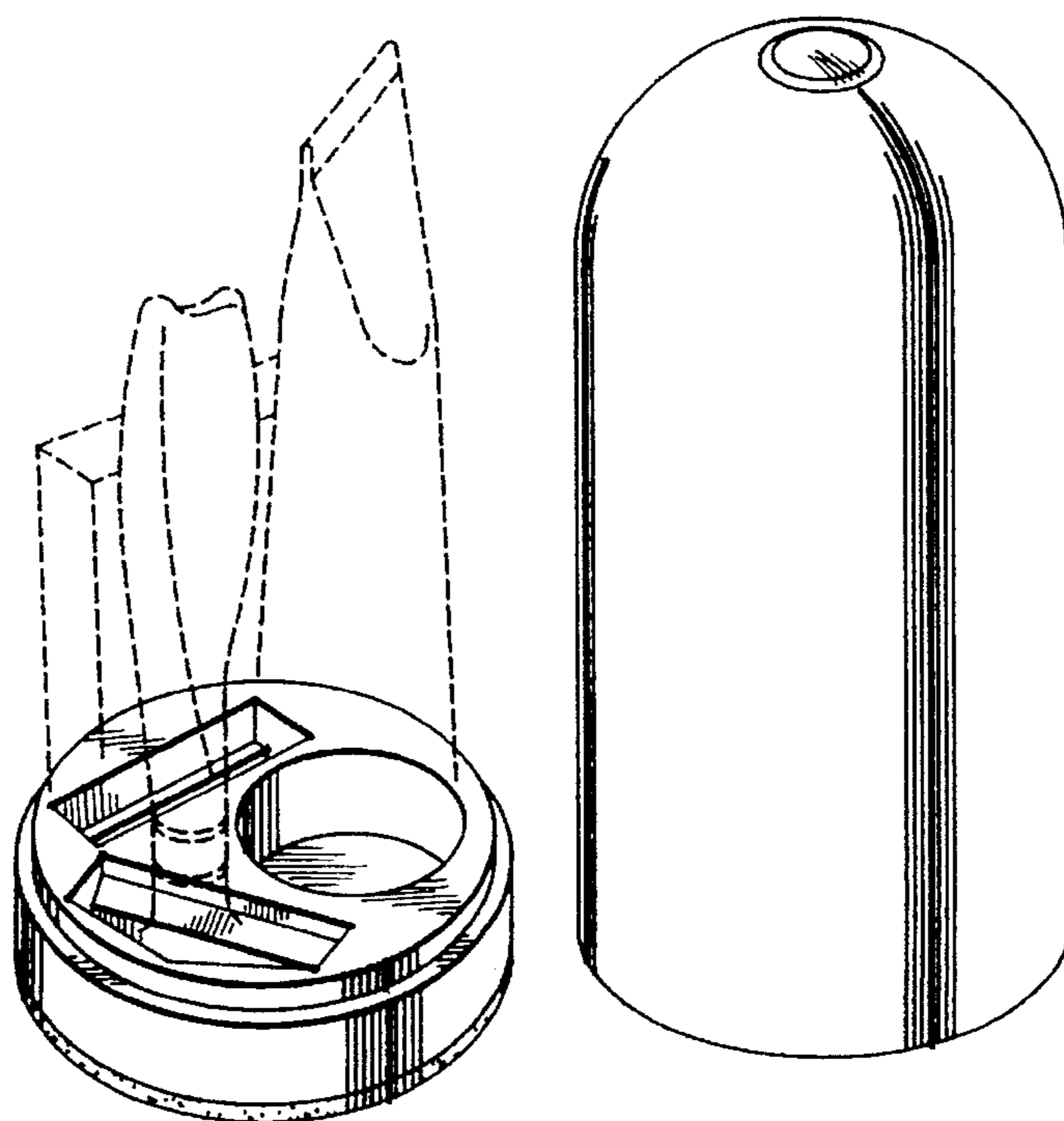
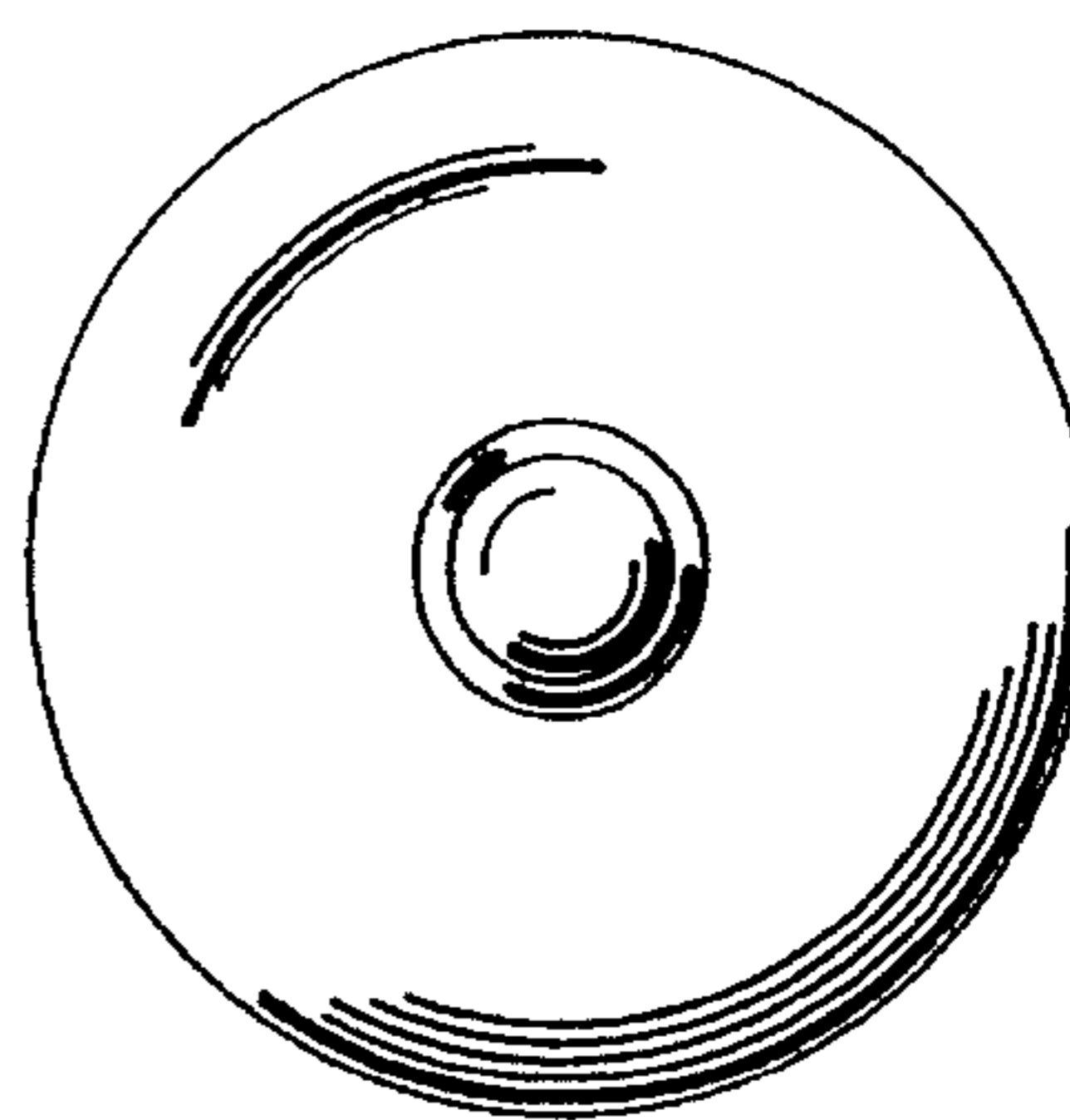

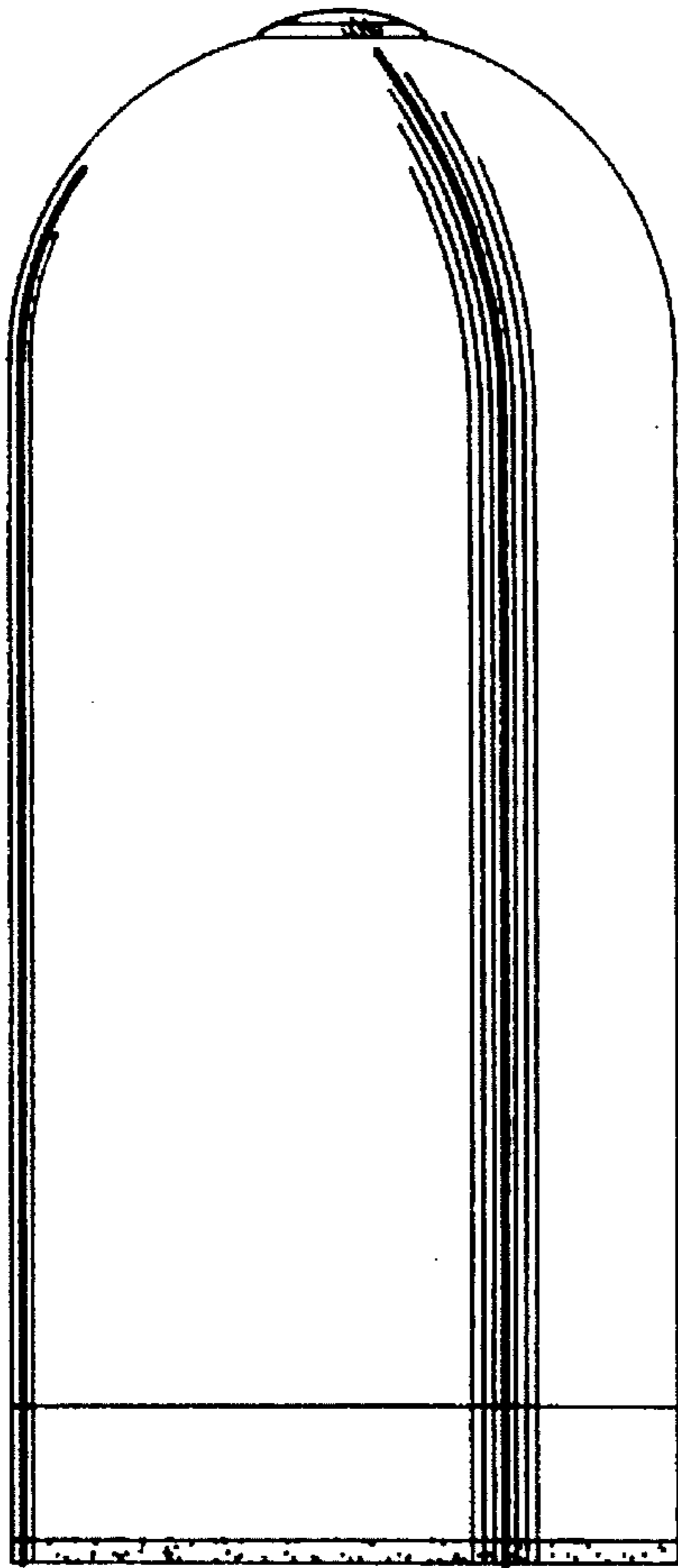

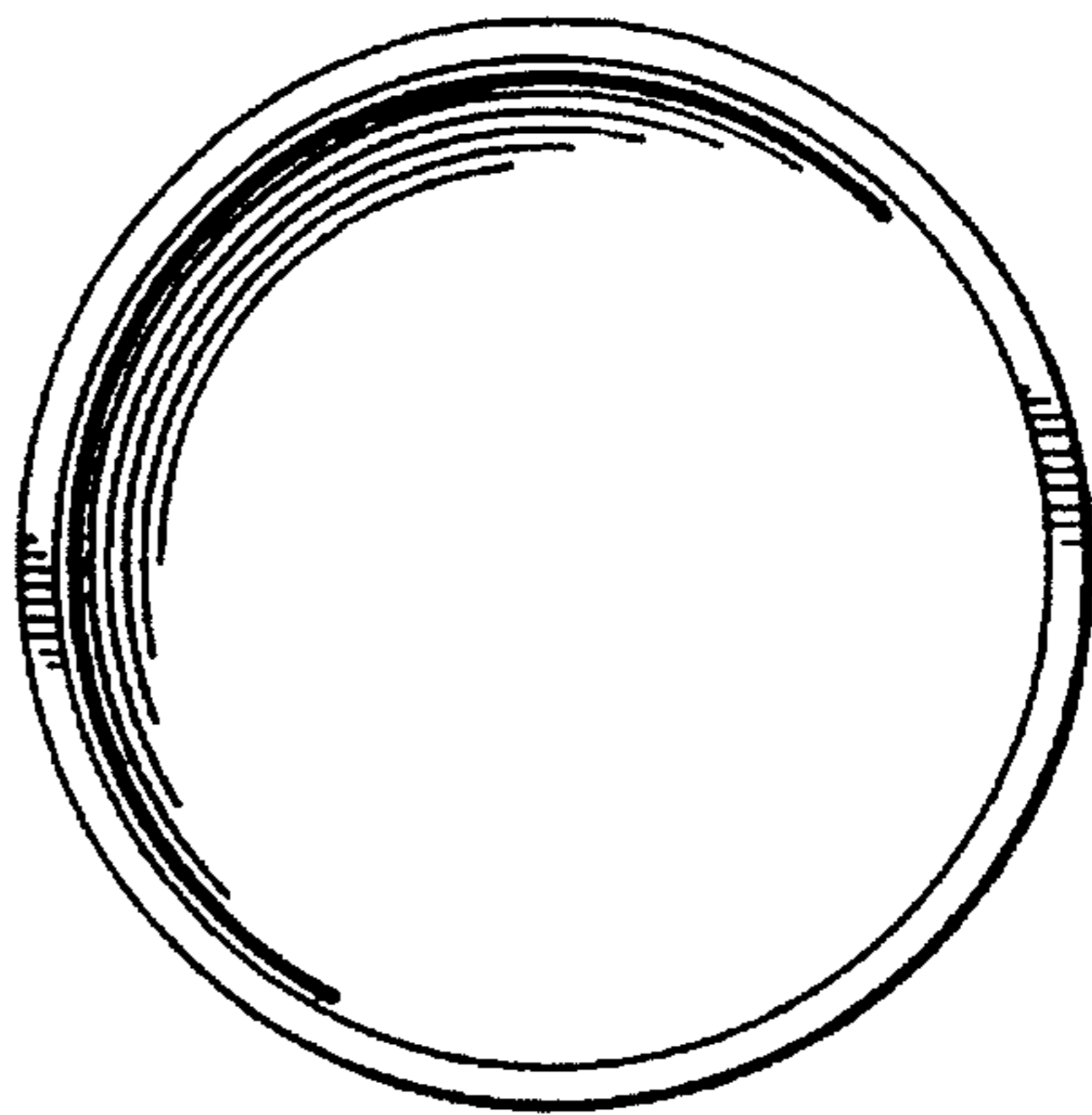

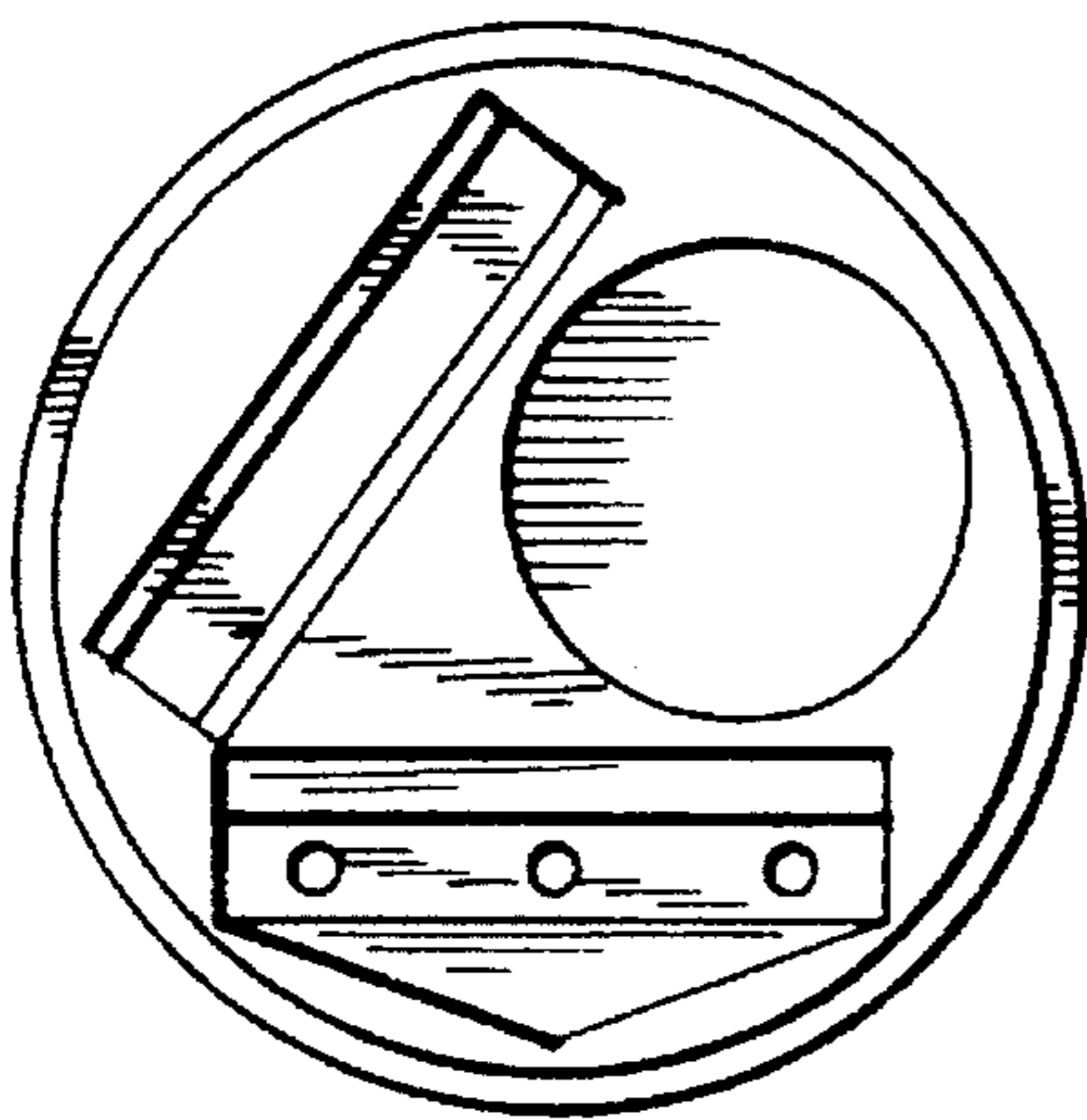
