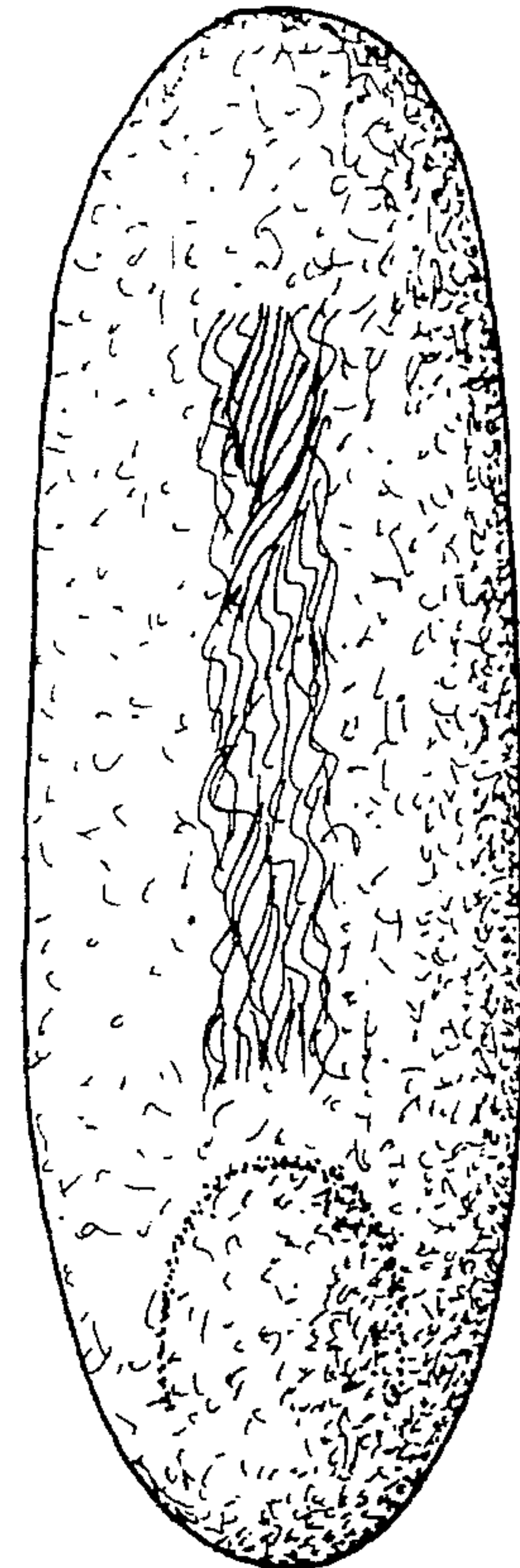
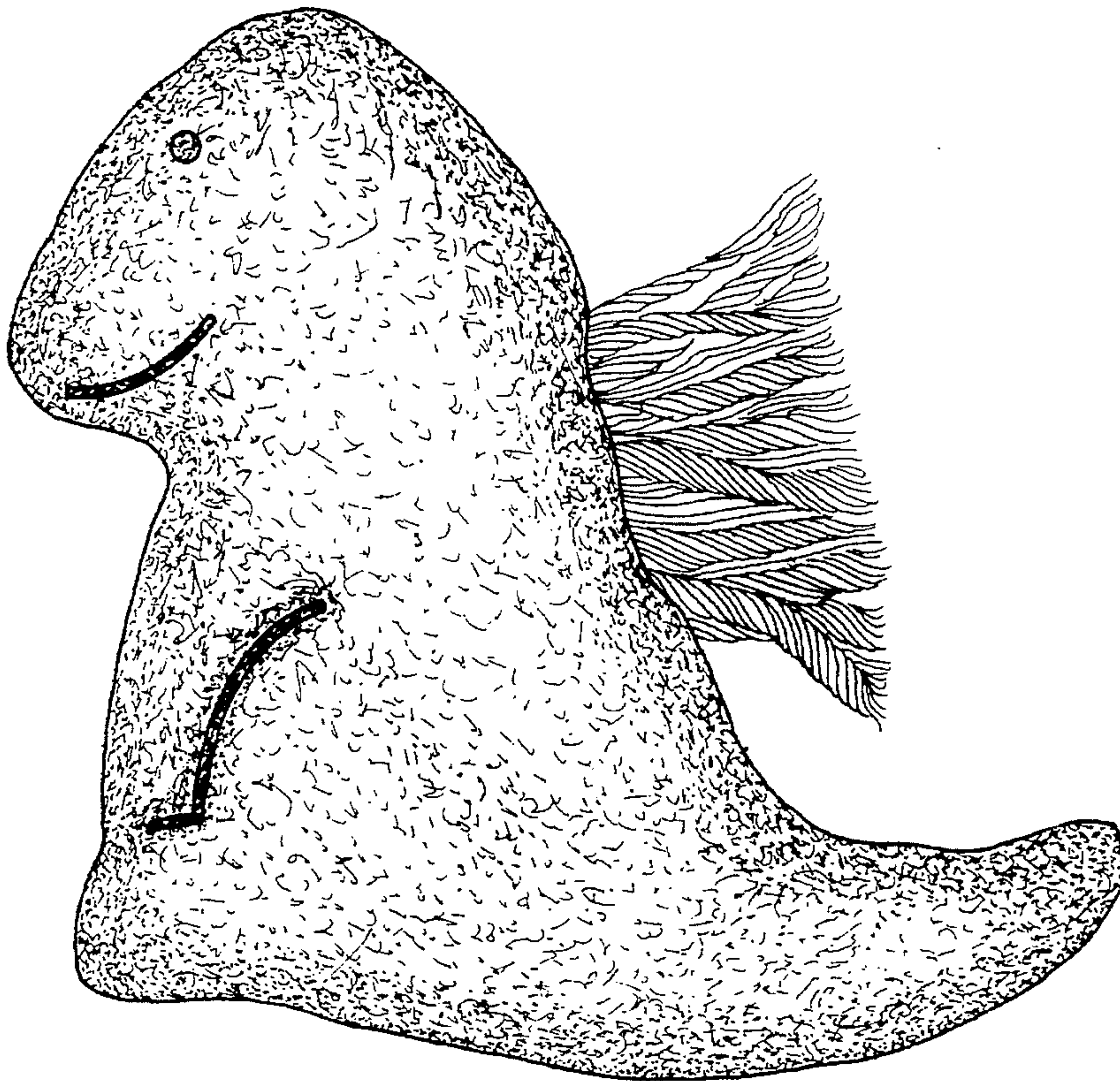
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fleece-type chew toy for dogs, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of a fleece-type chew toy for dogs; FIG. 2 is a side view thereof taken from the opposite side of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a front view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is bottom plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof.

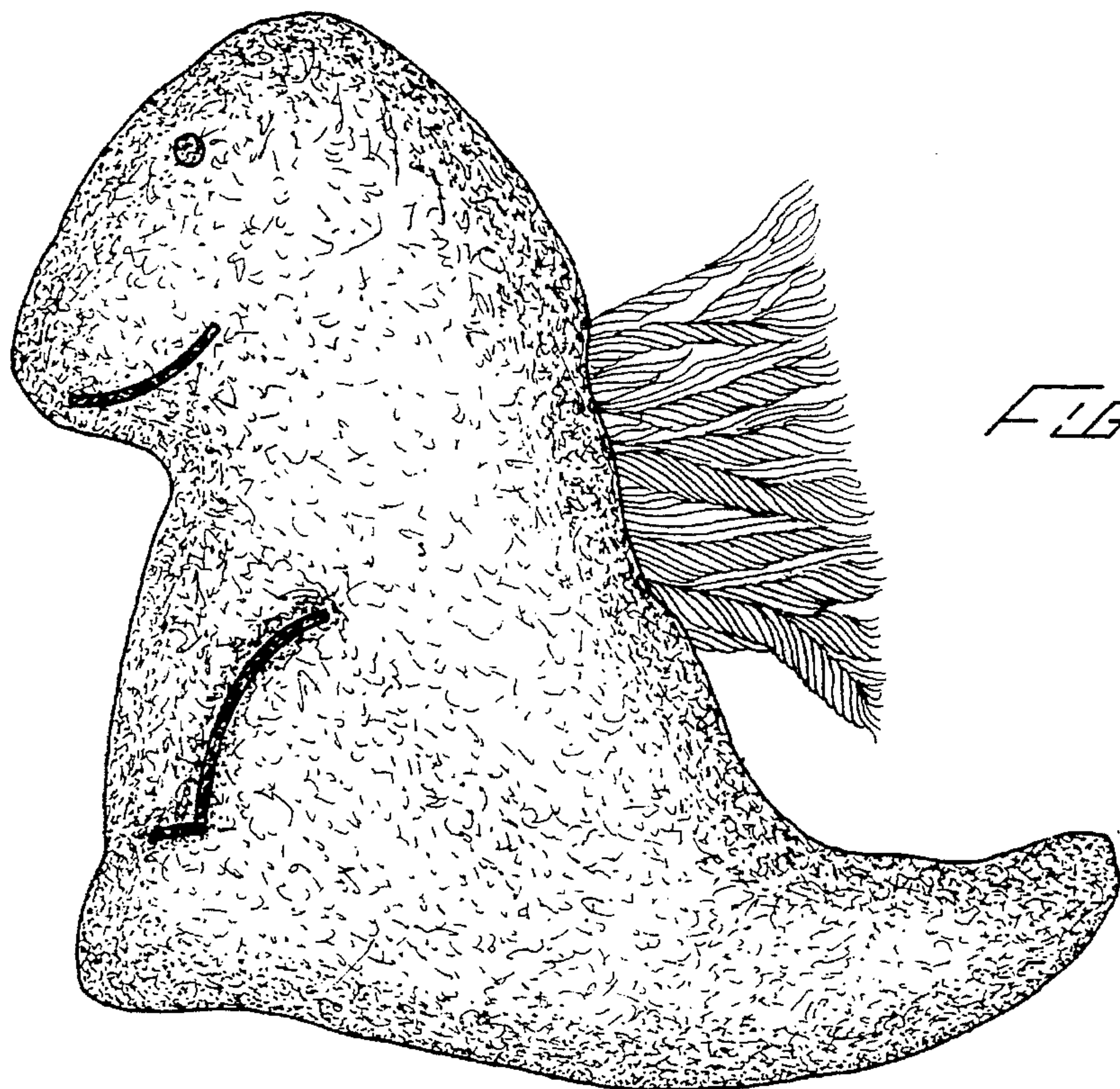

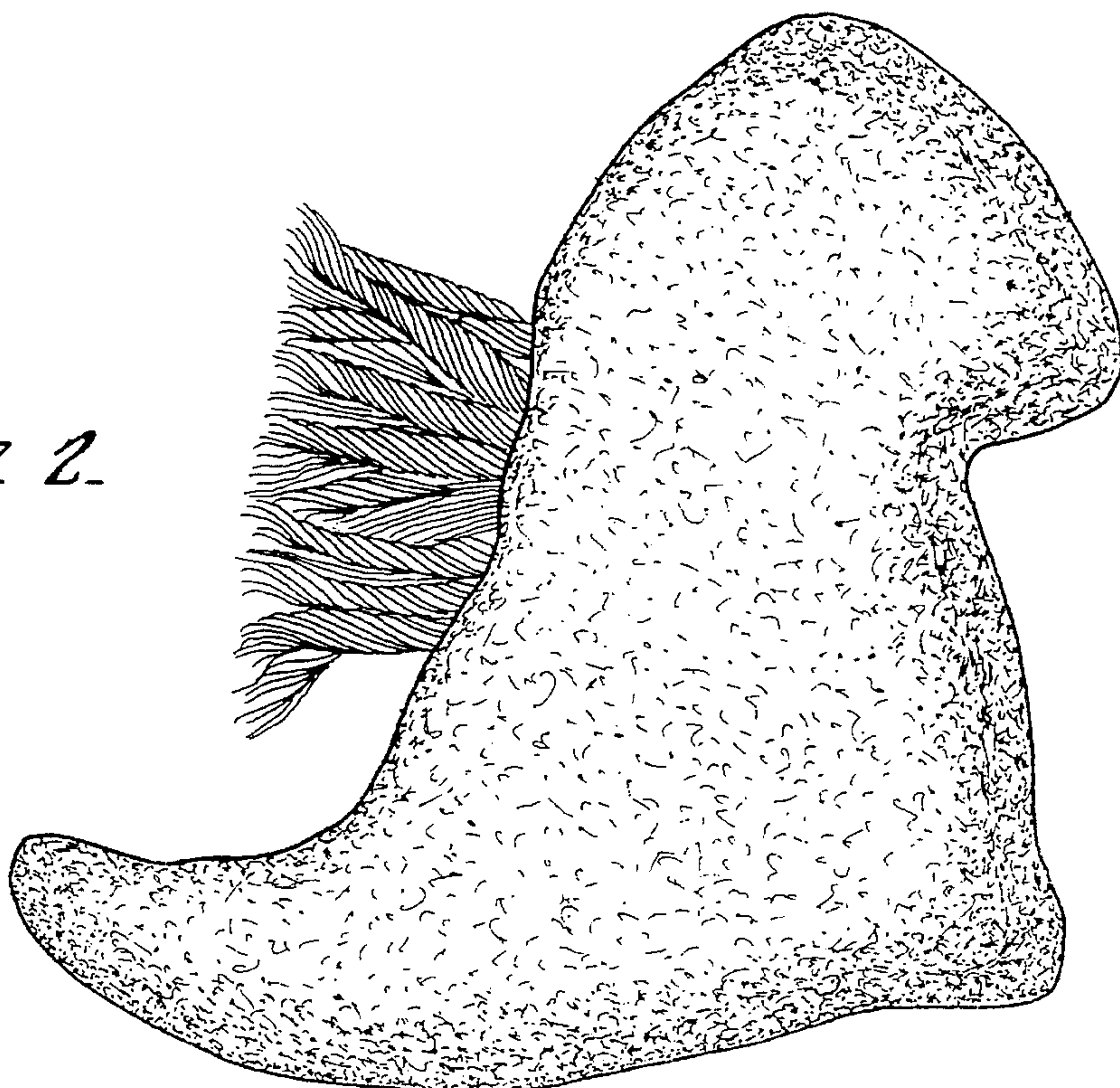

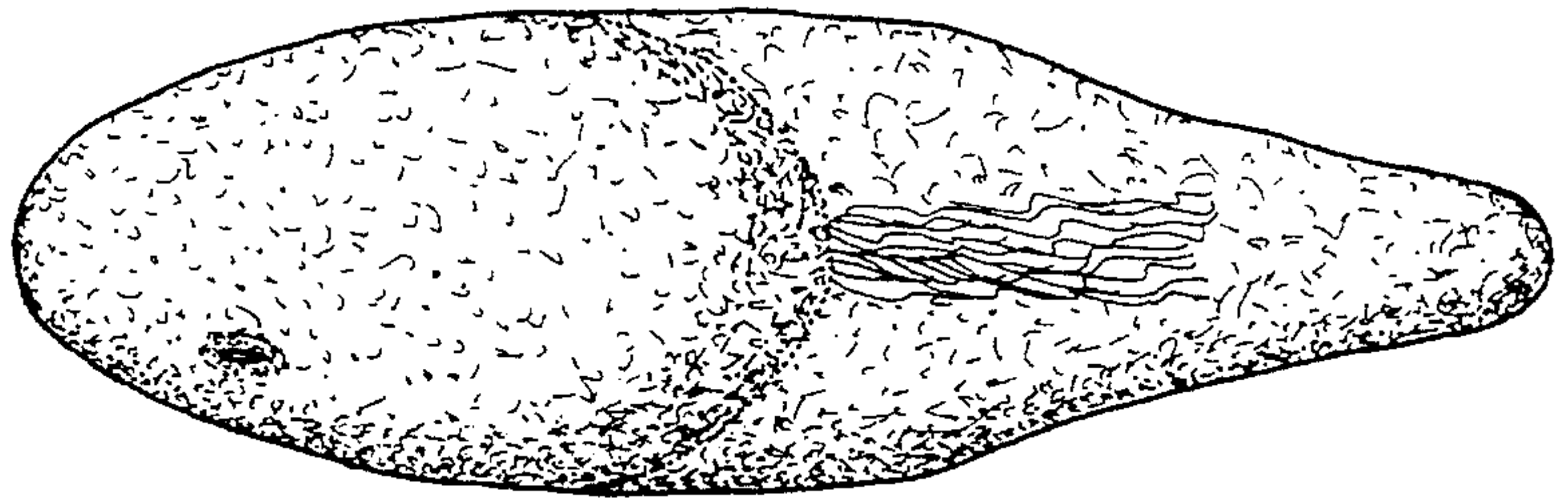

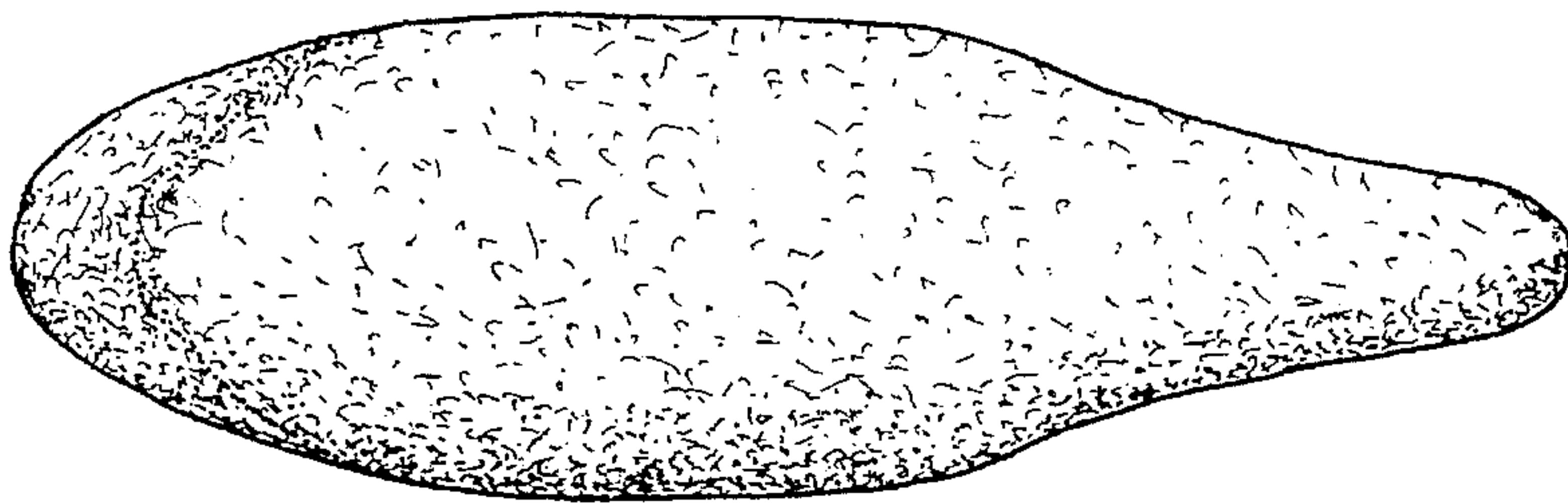

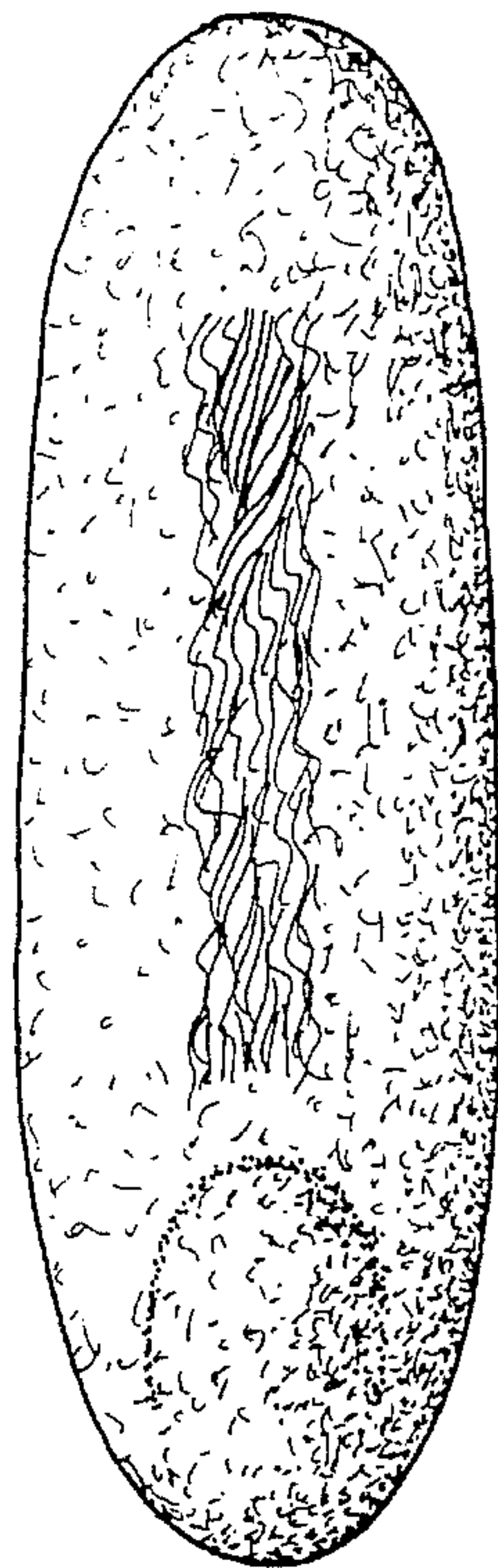
