DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe sole showing the new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the broken line disclosure of a shoe being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

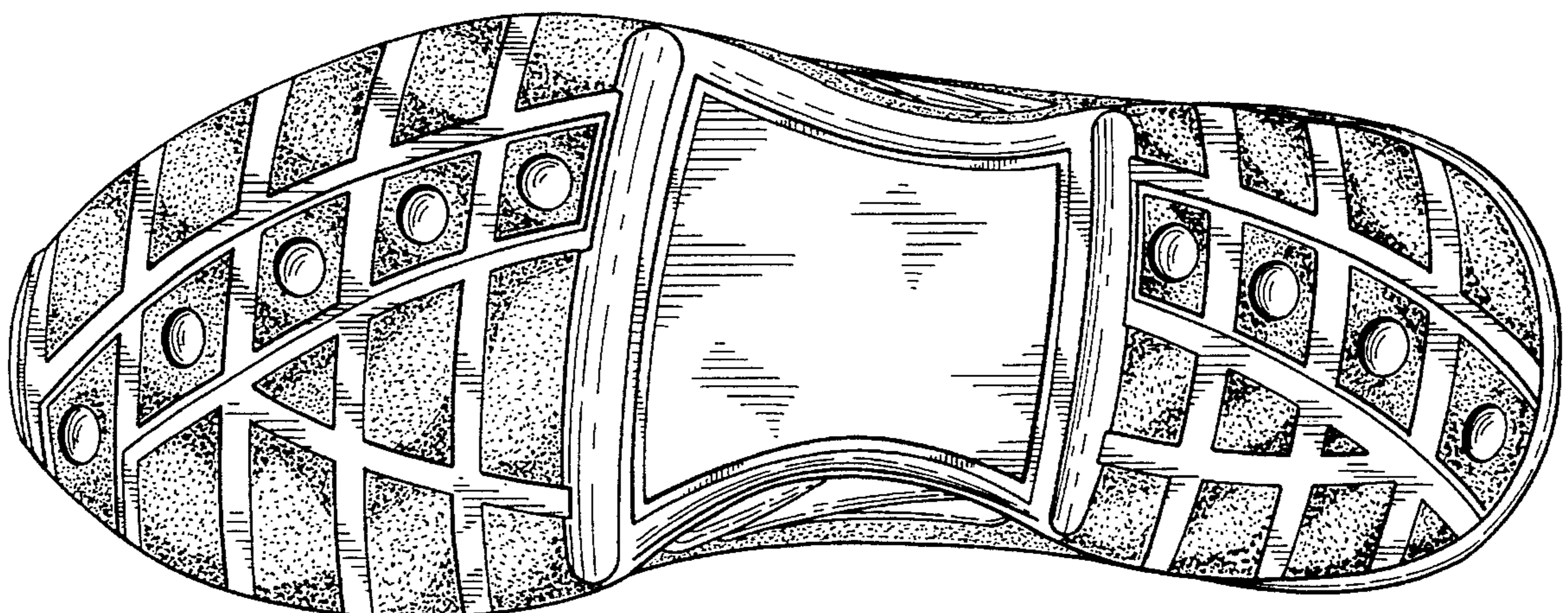
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

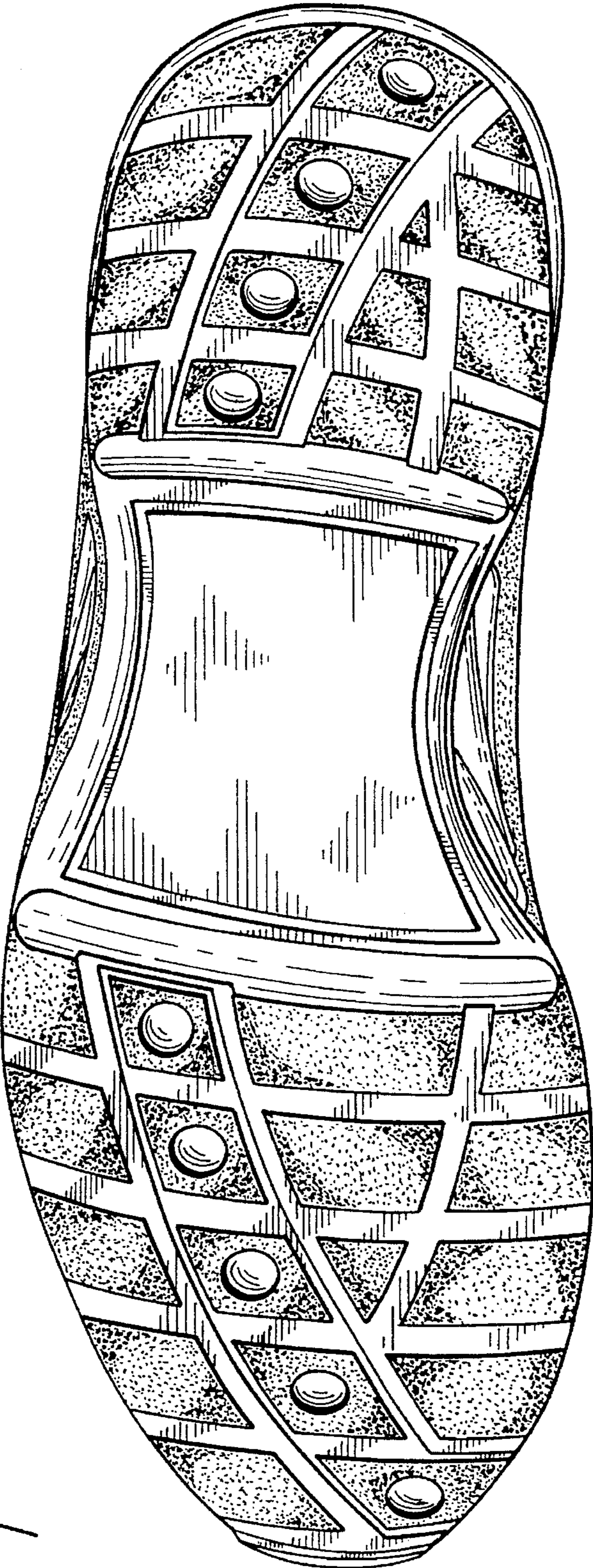

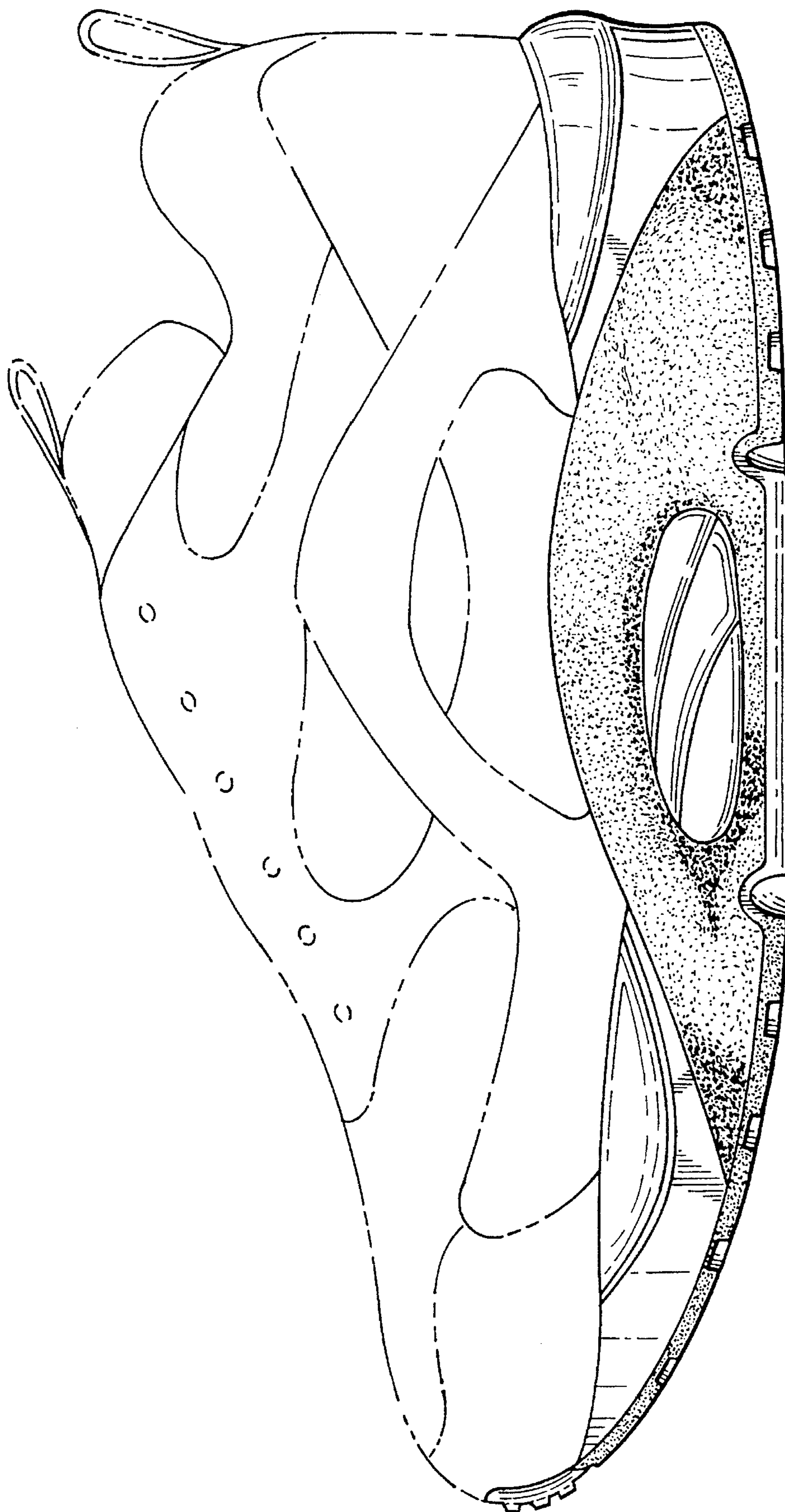

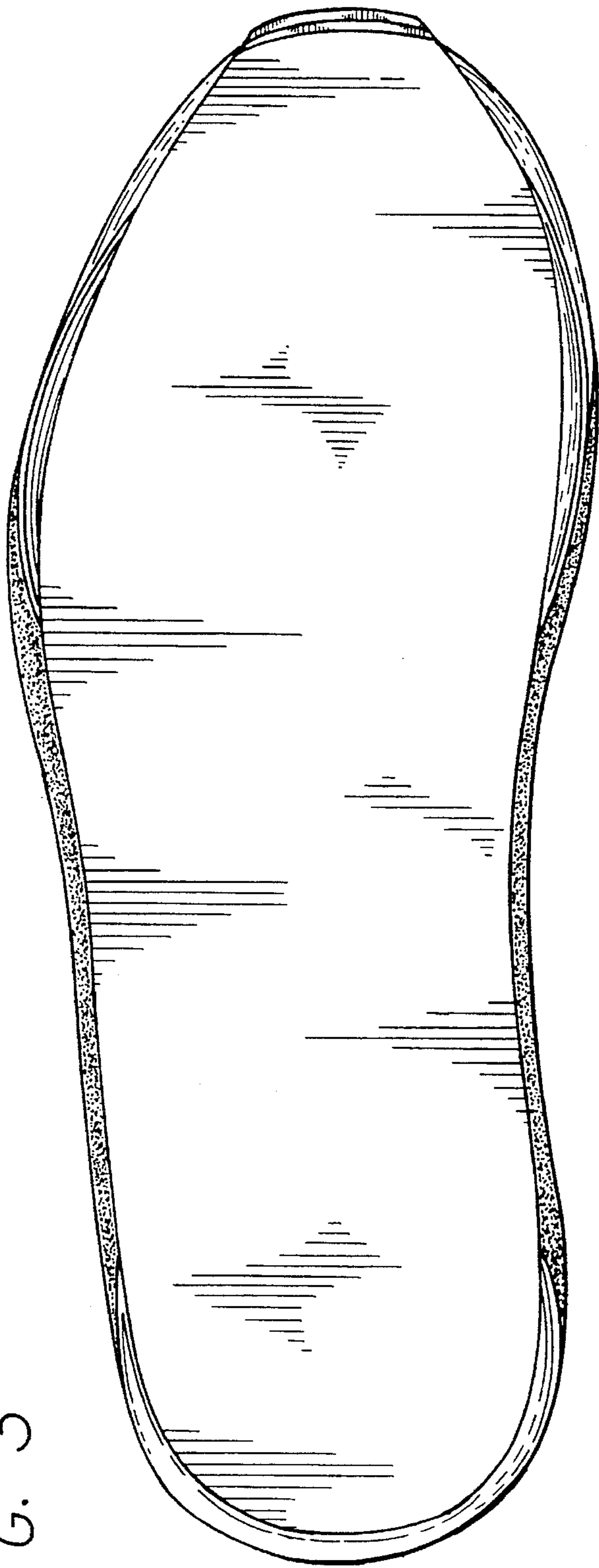

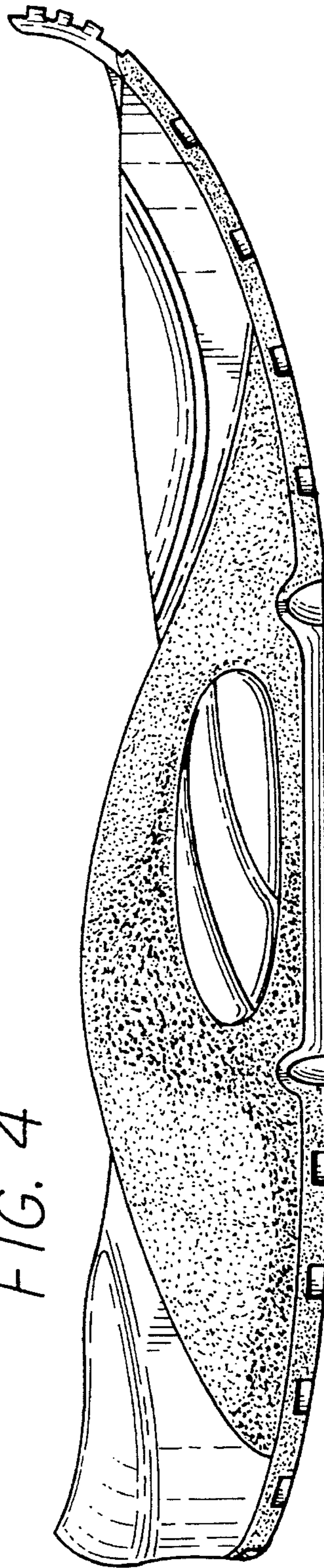

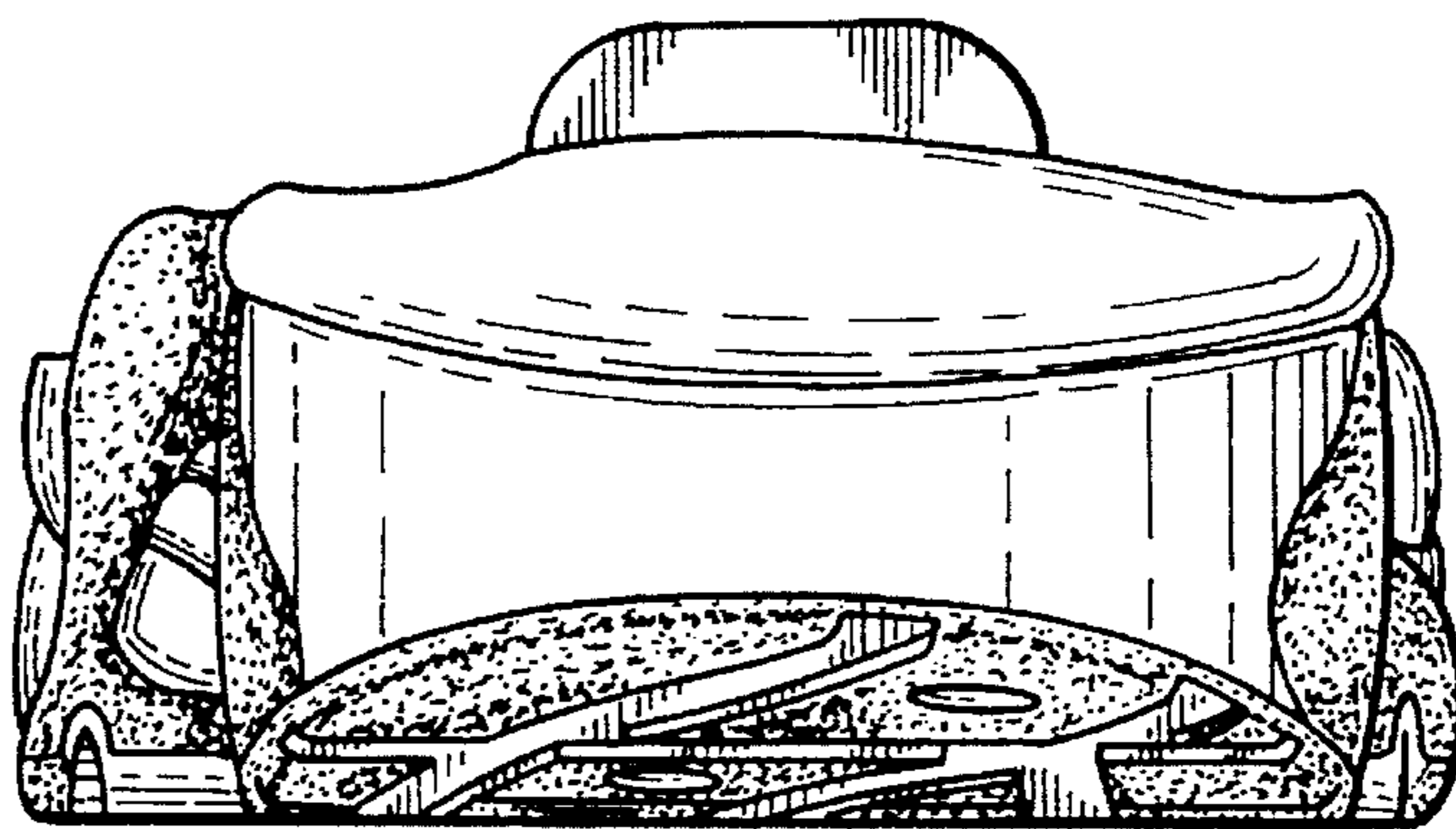
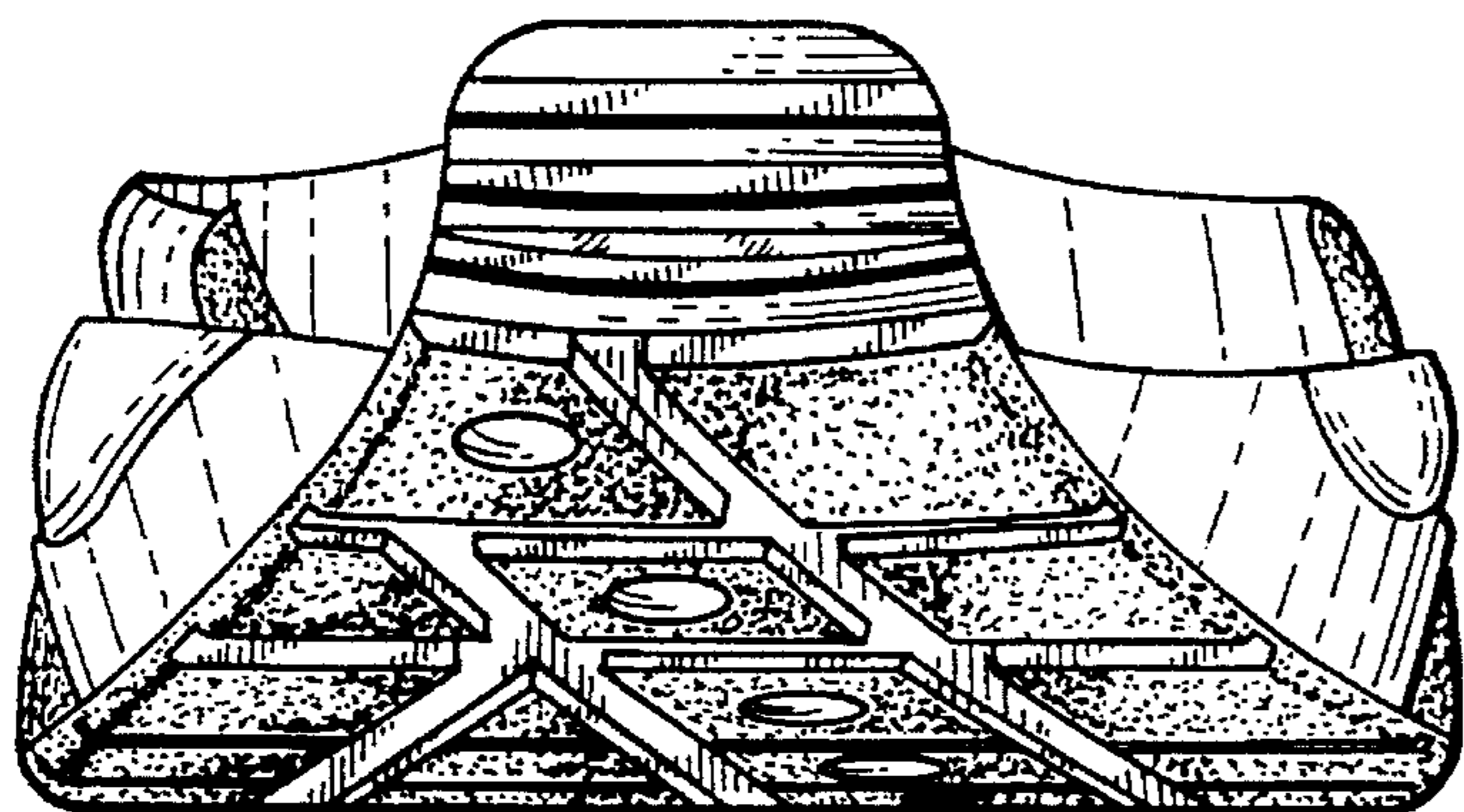
