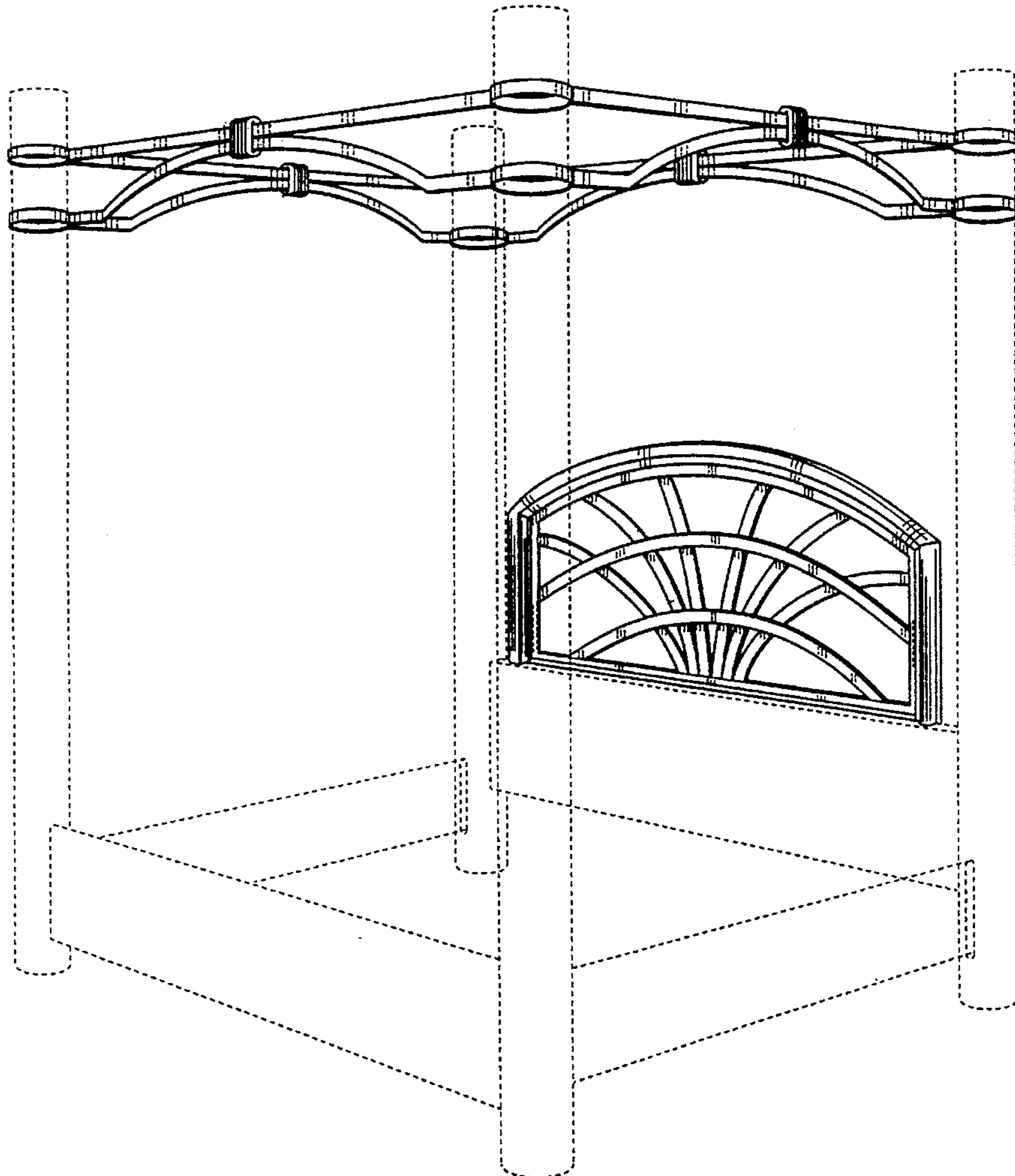
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a headboard and canopy unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a headboard and canopy unit showing my new design, the broken lines shown throughout are for illustrating environmental elements, only; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image; FIG. 4 is a top view of thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

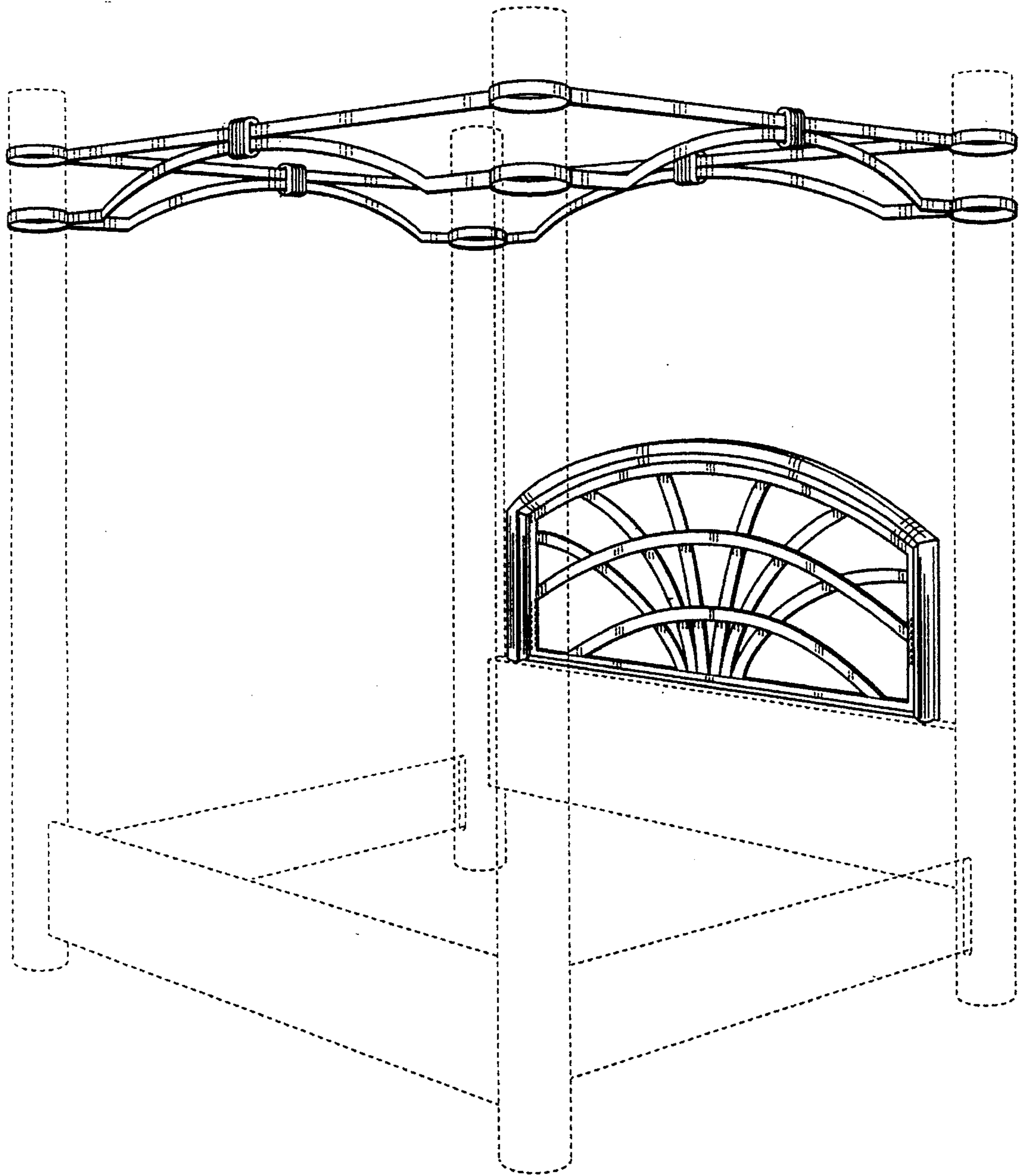

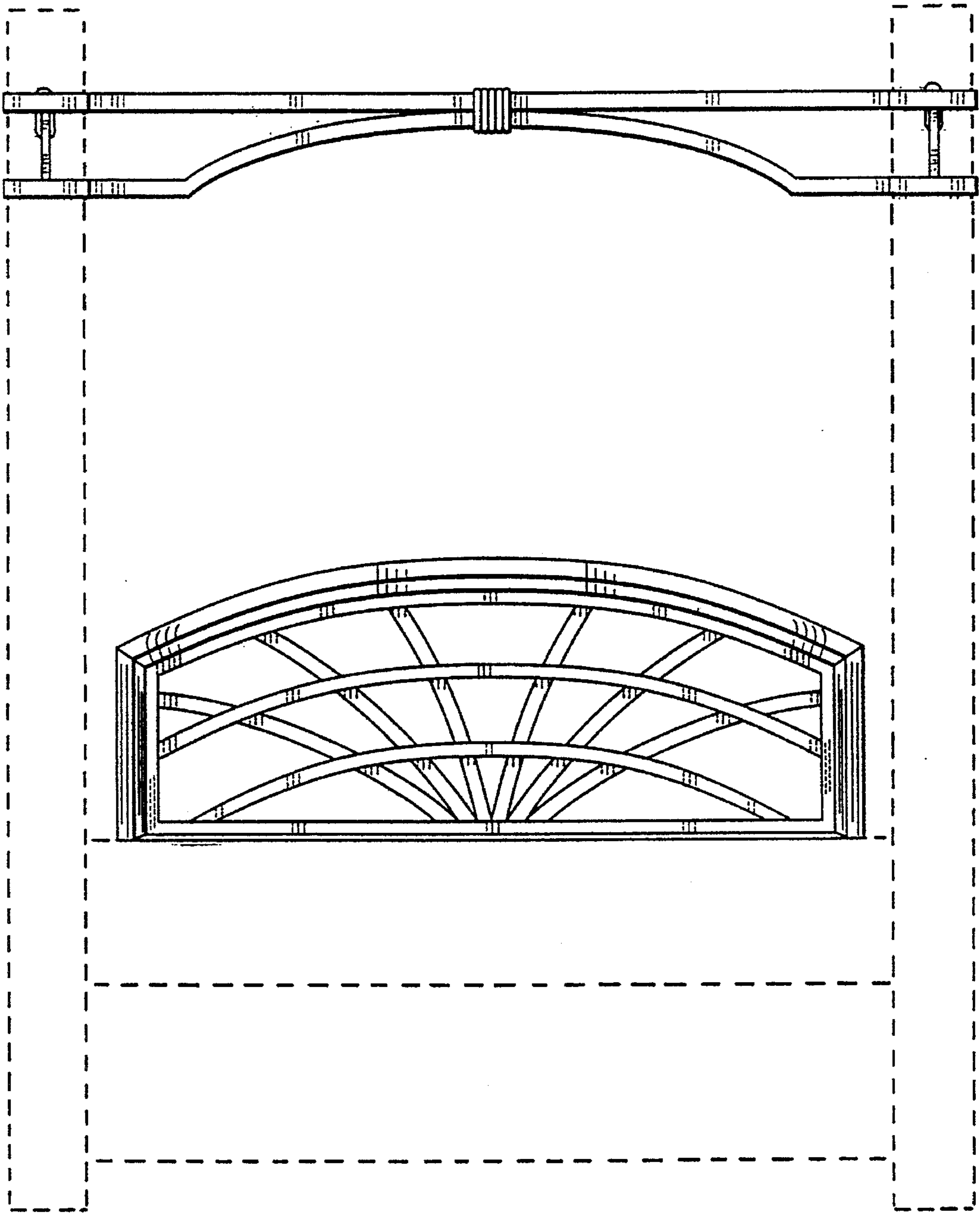

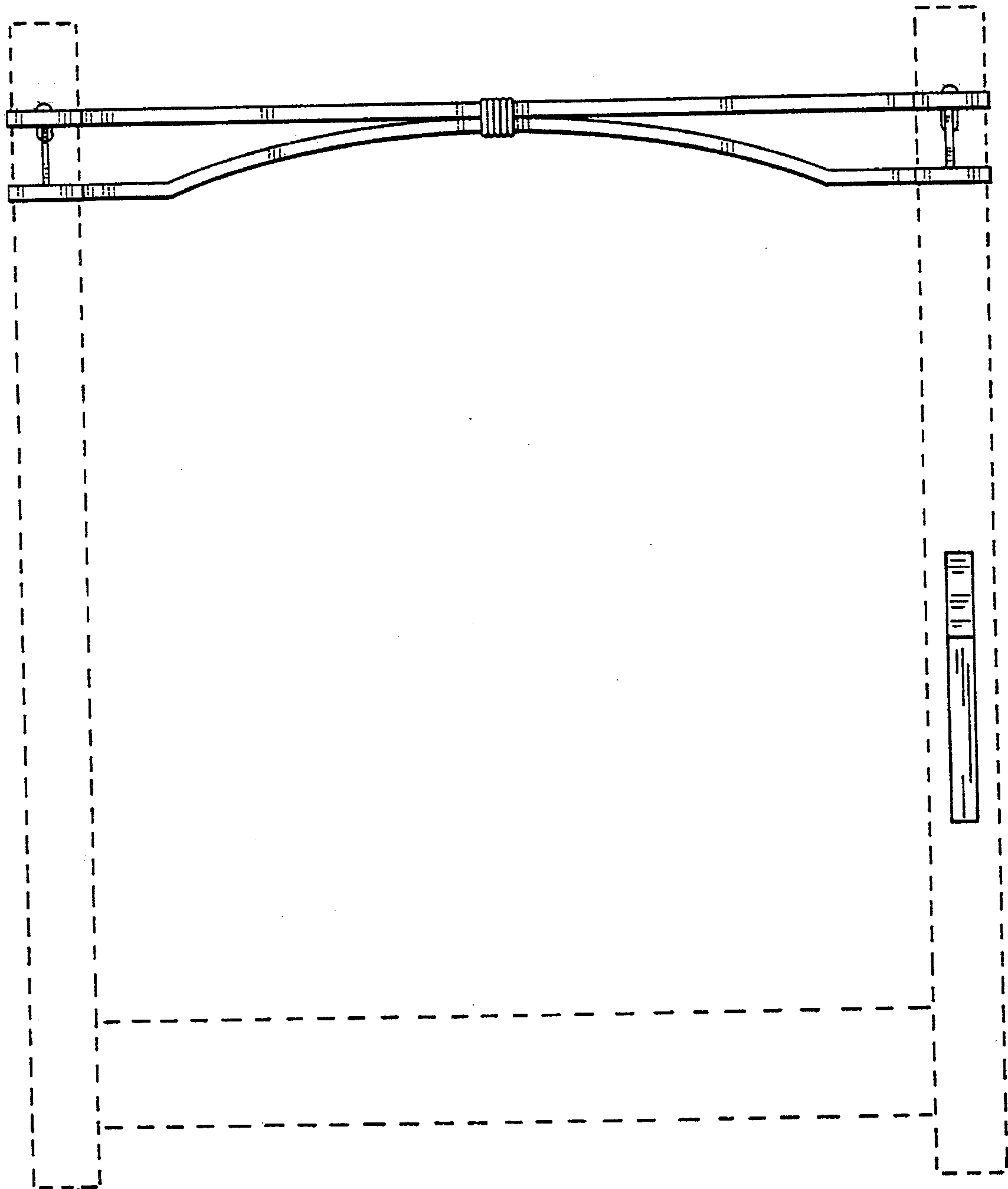

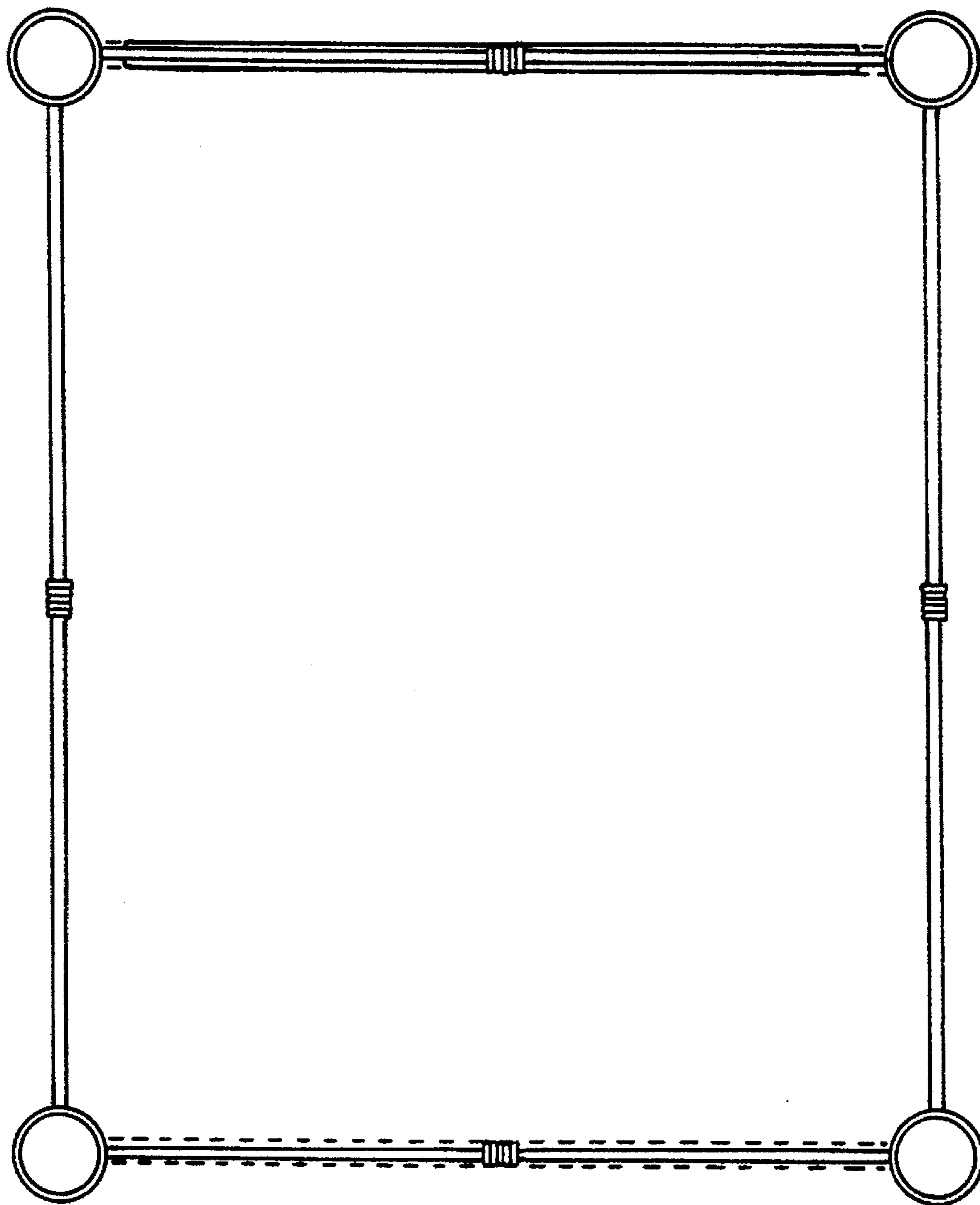

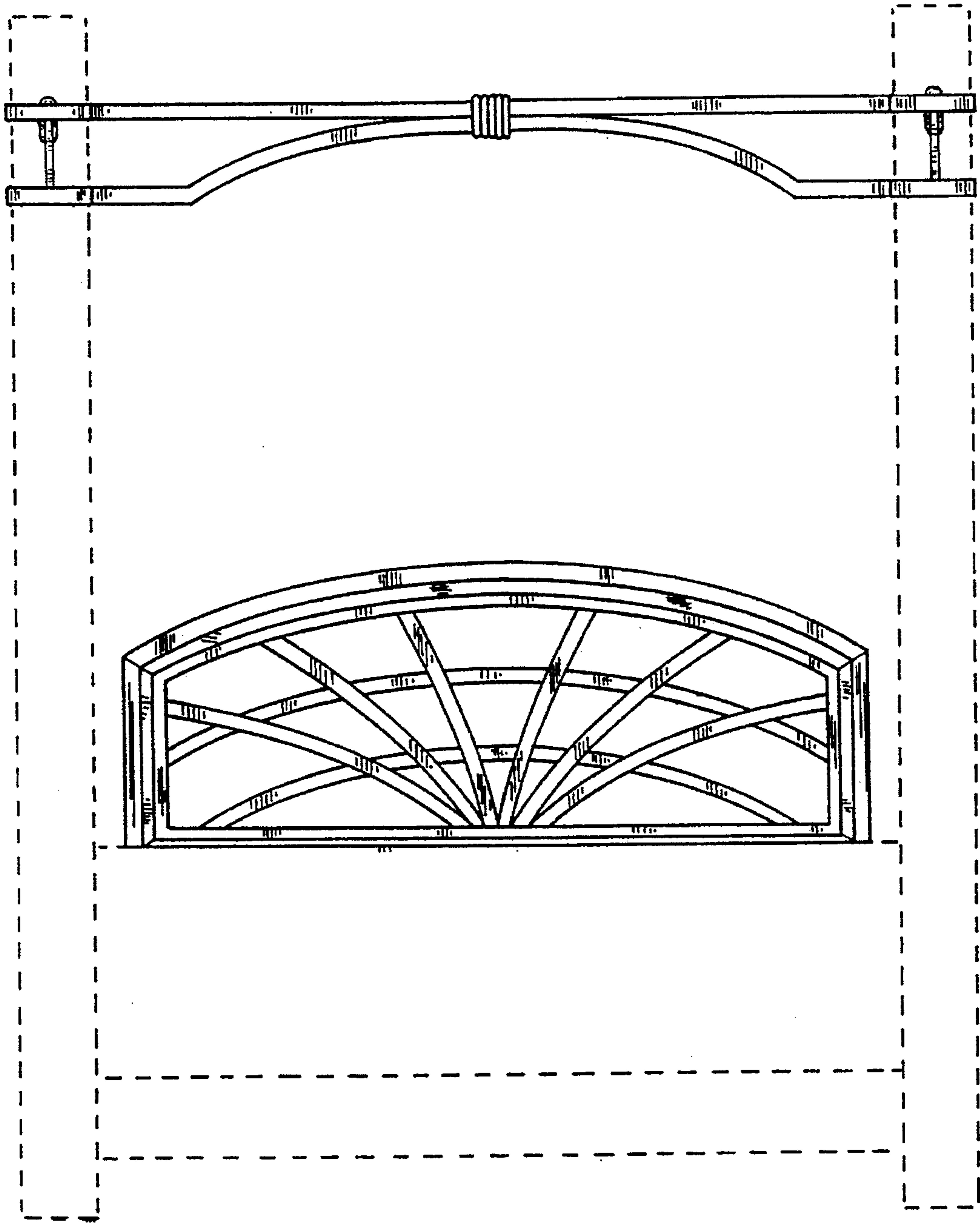
